Dance Mix Boosts 'Third Rock'

Labels More Selective With Club Versions

It's a fine line that separates a No. 1 single from the rest of the pack—49 spins, to be exact, in the case of Joe Diffie's "Third Rock From The Sun." And Epic Records Nashville points to a timely dance mix of the single as a major reason the record was pushed to the top spot.

Though other factors contributed to the track's success—the song's overall high quality, leading consultants' recommendation to add the record to high rotation, and Diffie's many station visits, to name a few—the ultimate success of "Third Rock" sends a strong signal to Music Row that the right dance mix at the right time can give promotion and marketing departments the ultimate sales pitch: "We've got a No. 1 record." For example, one extra spin per week, on weekends or evenings, at fewer than half of the monitored stations, would have made the difference between "Third Rock" and Tim McGraw's "Down On The Farm."

Releasing dance mixes isn't anything new. Many in the industry point to the success of the club version of Brooks & Dunn's "Boot

Scootin' Boogie" as the beginning. Alan Jackson's remarkable gains with a "Chattahoochee" dance mix proved that established artists can also benefit from such mixes. The ascension of "Third Rock" to the top spot should seal the argument, executives say.

Veteran dance remixer Wynn Jackson, who is also president of dance-club promotion company Country Club Promotions, says, "Arista has proven their [dance mix] value more than once, and now Diffie's proving that by planning ahead and releasing a dance mix at the most opportune time, you can take a record that's cruising along on the charts and radio and retail, and shift it into high gear.

"There's been a period of learning [how to produce] with dance mixes. After 'Boot Scootin' Boogie,' everybody wanted to do dance mixes, and there were some hits and misses. There was no research to show what worked.

"We learned in the last year and a half how to do it—which ones to do, and how to use them once we've done them—and we've gotten it to a

Arista Plans New Label In Early '95

Staffing And Structure To Be Worked Out

The country music industry continues to sprout new labels, and the latest to join the crowd is a new imprint planned by Arista Records Nashville. Arista expects to debut the label around the beginning of 1995.

Arista VP of promotion and artist development Jack Weston says the company has been talking about rolling out a new imprint for about a year. "We feel, based on the influences in the marketplace, and the atmosphere and cli-

mate in the marketplace right now, it might be the best thing to do for the business," he says.

Artists currently on the Arista roster include Blackhawk, Brooks & Dunn, Linda Davis, Diamond Rio, Rodney Foster, Alan Jackson, Dude Mowrey, Lee Roy Parnell, the Tractors, Pam Tillis, Steve Wariner, and Michelle Wright.

Because plans are still in the early stages, Arista is holding its cards close to its vest regarding the structure and strategy for the new imprint, which will be based in Nashville.

Says Weston, "There are sound business reasons, but I'm not going to share them with the community until we have everything in place. We haven't decided when, or the structure, or even decided who the people are going to be."

Arista ranks No. 2 in market share so far in 1994, with an 11.3% share. It trails MCA's 22.4% and is ahead of Liberty's 10.9%. The only other labels close to it are Atlantic (9.1%) and Curb Records (8.2%).

Arista is also No. 2 in the singles market, with a 12.0% share. It trails MCA (14.5%) but is ahead of RCA (9.8%), Atlantic (9.3%), and Epic (8.7%).

RADIOACTIVE

During the 1994 Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Seminar, Infinity Broadcasting CEO Mel Karmazin dropped some pearls of wisdom.

- Commenting on why morning and afternoon drive shows will prosper, he said, "Traffic is going to get worse instead of better, and there's nothing on the horizon that's going to change that."

- On the need to increase training: "Clearly the number of qualified PDs is not sufficient to meet the needs of the industry." His remedy—use weekends and nights to train personalities.

- On supporting an increase in the 20 AM/20 FM station ownership limit: "Why should a company like Gannett Corp. be allowed to own hundreds of newspapers, or Ted Turner be allowed to put five channels in every home while we're limited to 20 AMs and 20 FM's?"

On the Billboard/Airplay Monitor panel on "How To Get The Best Out Of Your Personalities," WSIX Nashville PD Doug Baker offered this advice: "Personalities seem to end at morning drive, but people still want to be entertained throughout the day. We decided to build morning shows throughout the entire day." Said WPLJ New York PD and morning man Scott Shannon: "You better protect your station in ways other than the music, and personalities is one of the best ways."

Format flips and changes: KYGO-AM Denver and KILT-AM Dallas have both dropped country in favor of sports. KILT has signed on as a Prime Radio Network affiliate. Tennessee stations WUSK Knoxville and WUSJ Johnson City, which were both simulcasting the same country signal, have flipped to soft AC. WGCX Mobile, Ala., has dropped album rock for country and changed its calls to WDWG.

Capricorn Records Closes Country Operations

While one label (Arista) is planning to expand, another is cutting back. Capricorn Records has shuttered its country division.

The label's country promotion staffs have all been let go, including promotion coordinator Tammi Brumfield, Northeast promoter Thom Williams, and Southwest promoter Kay McGhee.

No word yet on who will pick up the label's roster, which includes Kenny Chesney.

The company did not return calls at press time.

COUNTRY CONFIDENTIAL

Another myth has been uncovered. There has been much talk about the amount of product being released by the labels of Music Row. The perception has been that the number of labels increasing significantly in the '90s has led to a larger number of releases by a growing number of artists, creating the illusion that radio is being forced to deal with more product. Notice that I used the word "illusion." The reason I used "illusion" is because that is exactly what has been created. The facts were revealed in the Sept. 24 issue of Billboard by Ed Morris. In researching the labels' artist rosters, he found that the number of artists is actually down. In polling 16 labels, Morris found that they were carrying a total of 173 acts. Prior to 1990, less than a dozen major labels had total signings of about

200 artists.

Is it easier to break an act in the '90s than in the '80s? Probably not, but not for the reasons you might think. In the '80s, the country industry was somewhat lethargic, living off a group of established stars that dominated both radio and the touring segments of the business. This also contributed to the difficulty in getting any kind of media exposure for new artists. Then along came **Clint Black** and **Garth Brooks**, and at the same time CMT began to evolve as a major player. Other factors entered into the mix, obviously, but the gates were all of a sudden wide open. As the marketplace shifted from '80s philosophy to the '90s Hot New Country mindset, labels were racing to discover new talent. For certain the price of poker has gone up. And the winning stakes have more than doubled. But there are fewer competing for the pot.

KSAN San Francisco Goes In-House To Replace "Bill & Bill" Show

In a move to kick some more life into its presentation style, KSAN San Francisco has promoted two personalities and hired two veteran DJs.

Exiting the station is the morning team of Bill Gardner, Bill Taylor, and Betsy O'Connor. Replacing them are former afternoon personality Charlie Wilde and midday DJ Frank Terry.

Taking over at midday is Teri King from WCLB Boston, and Glenn Boychuk from WBOB Minneapolis joins KSAN to do afternoons.

ON THE ROW

Coors and Liberty Records have teamed to release "Banding Together For Literacy," a special country cassette that features songs by Tanya Tucker, Suzy Bogguss, Chris LeDoux, and Cleve Francis. During the launch of the project last week, Liberty's John Berry performed for the first time "The Bottom Line," a song he co-wrote about one man's struggle to learn to read. The project is part of "Literacy. Pass It On," a program to raise money and awareness about the nation's 40 million functionally illiterate adults.

Contemporary country music's appeal continues to grow in Europe. The latest success story is Mercury artist Kathy Mattea's debut on Germany's charts with her single "Walking Away A Winner," which is No. 72 with a bullet. It's all the more impressive given that she has not yet performed or appeared in person in Germany to promote the record. She is expected to visit Europe this winter.

The T.J. Martell Foundation offers two ways for fans to help the foundation and be VIPs during the Friday (23) Crown Royal concert featuring John Berry, Tracy Lawrence, and

Marty Stuart. The foundation will hold a silent auction during the concert, and VIPs can purchase Gold Circle tickets for \$75, entitling them to reserved seating, a catered party with complimentary food and drinks, and access to the performers. Both promotions are sponsored by WSIX Nashville and Tom Kats Inc., with support from Pepsi, Budweiser, and Crown Royal.

Twenty-nine performers will appear at four talent showcases during SRO '94 Oct. 6-8. Scheduled to perform Oct. 6 (from 2:30-6 p.m.) are Rick Trevino, Dixie Chicks, John Berry, Dawn Sears, Kenny Chesney, Jesse Hunter, and Blackhawk, followed that evening at 7:30 p.m. by Victoria Shaw, Asleep At The Wheel, Russ Taff, Mark Collie, Turner Nichols, Skip Ewing, and the Mavericks. Set for Oct. 7 from 1-4:30 p.m. are Daron Norwood, Chely Wright, Somebody's Darling, George Ducas, Lisa Brokop, John and Audrey Wiggins, Ken Mellons, and Orrall & Wright. The Oct. 8 (1-4 p.m.) lineup includes David Ball, Riders In The Sky, Deborah Allen, Mike Henderson, Pearl River, Bryan Austin, and James House.

Naomi and Wynonna Judd will not participate in the Elvis tribute concert scheduled for Oct. 8 in Memphis. According to Wynonna's manager, the two stars had expressed interest in the event, but their participation was never confirmed and their names apparently were included in advertising and publicity materials by mistake.

science." Labels are also learning how to time the release of dance mixes. Epic worked with WSIX Nashville and WAMZ Louisville to get initial feedback on the dance mix of "Third Rock" on Aug. 1, about three weeks after it went for add.

Epic Records Nashville VP of national promotion Jack Lameir says, "After we released the single, we started to get requests from radio saying... 'Why don't you do a dance mix?' So we went back into the studio and put it together and re-serviced the single as a completely separate shot.

"Sometimes we'll do an edit, a dance mix, and the regular single for radio, to take away any questions they have as to how they want to program the song," he says. "In this case, it came back from radio that they wanted [a dance mix], [so] we took care of their needs, and it helped take ['Third Rock'] to number one."

Labels are also capitalizing on dance mixes to jump-start new artists' careers. In addition to the normal meet-and-greets, Asylum is closely watching club and radio reaction to the dance mix of Bryan White's debut single, "Eugene, You Genius." The Tractors also picked up key airplay with a dance version of "Baby Likes To Rock It" early in that single's life.

Asylum Records VP of promotion Denny Mosesman says, "If we can really get something drummed up at the dance clubs with this record, then it's going to make the radio stations take a closer look. We had seen what other people had done with dance mixes, and we thought this song was perfect for it, and so did [Country Club Promotions' Jackson]. At KMLE Phoenix, the station played the dance version while Bryan was there, and the station immediately got requests. And that's exactly what we want to accomplish."

Yet the plethora of other factors that contribute to getting records to chart has raised doubts on Music Row as to whether dance mixes are worth the effort and money. After all, skeptics say, the sonic differences are not that significant between the regular edit and dance version.

Warner Bros./Reprise Records Nashville VP of A&R Paige Levy says, "Our research shows there aren't enough radio stations willing to

play dance mixes that would warrant spending the time and money to go back in and alter the tracks to make the mixes."

Like most labels, Warner Bros./Reprise jumped on the dance mix bandwagon, but backed off because it didn't "see enough evidence that it was making any difference one way or another," says Levy. "The bottom line is, [however], we all want airplay, especially for our new artists, and if doing dance mixes is going to achieve that, most certainly we would consider doing more."

These days, though, the dance-mix craze seems to have tapered off. KSAN San Francisco PD Lee Logan says, "We've rolled them back from other dayparts. We used to air them consistently in the evenings and afternoons. At this point, they get played only on the [Saturday night show] 'Party Palace.' But if a good version really surfaces, then we'll give it more play, but we really haven't had anything pop out like that in a while."

Tim Closson, OM for WUBE/WYGY Cincinnati, says, "For a while, it seemed that every song had a dance mix attached to it. There's less out there now, and that's OK because I think it was getting diluted." Dance mixes aren't programmed at mainstream WUBE, but they are at the more contemporary WYGY.

"Dance mixes can give a song limited extra plays, because it really gives the audience a different spin on that record," he says. "Dance mixes help keep the record fresher, which may extend the life of the record."

Despite the inability to quantify the impact of dance mixes at radio, Jackson has the data for the nightclubs. "We issued a questionnaire a couple of months ago, and two things emerged. Ninety-five percent of the DJs said they would listen to a new song from an artist before others if we included a dance mix in the package we ship; the other [point] was that 95% of the DJs said that dance mixes entice club patrons to request and inquire about an artist."

"With regard to radio, you have to let the single get established first. There have been instances where the mix has garnered some airplay on the more progressive stations that might not have picked up had we not had a mix there to tweak their interest in the beginning."

COUNTRY PROFILE

KIKK's Candea Ups The Ante In Houston OM Institutes Hotter, More Uptempo Music Policy

It's war, and KIKK/KILT Houston OM Rick Candea is leading the charge.

Heritage station KIKK has fired the first salvo in what will probably be the most closely watched country radio battle in years. It also will be the hottest battle in country radio ever, especially when it comes to the number of spins records get.

"KKBQ has never been challenged in the past until now," says Candea. "Now they are big time. They don't have a hold on the new generation."

Upstart KKBQ shook the Houston market two years ago with a strategy in which top-rotation records were played 50-55 times per week, and the result was a ratings winner. Now KIKK has upped the ante considerably, averaging some 70-plus spins per week on top singles—the highest in country radio by a long shot, and in the same company as the hottest top 40 sta-

PD Carl Geisler and KIKK/KILT assistant OM/MD Debbie Murray to implement the changes. "We've increased the music mix to 60% current, 30% recurrent, and 10% gold. A while ago, it was probably more 50-50. We're also going to play a lot more album cuts, so you're going to have to watch for yourself to see what happens. We've got some things planned for the next few months that will add an incredible edge and enhance our hot rotation on the street.

"Any radio station with a strong tradition has to realize that it needs a blood transfusion every once in a while," he adds. "Just because you're traditional or heritage doesn't mean you can't have that edge.

"You can't do business like you did in 1970 in the '90s. The marketplace has changed, and now we've changed with it," Candea says. "We've repositioned the station. That doesn't mean we're blowing off our listeners, because, based on our research, they've asked for this." It's also precisely for that reason that Candea is not worried that the changes will push listeners toward the competition.

Listeners' evolving musical tastes, and the output from Nashville, have also contributed to the change, says Candea. "We appreciate the product that's coming out of Nashville right now—it's very powerful. While it's the responsibility of the music industry to continue to deliver good product, it's also our responsibility—the radio stations—to handle that product properly, in [terms of] timing and how we offer that music to our listeners. The only reason we can do what we're doing at KIKK and KILT is because the music industry continues to blossom and grow."

Candea has noticed that KIKK's listeners are also growing and changing with the times. "When we took over this station about one year ago we thought, there's a tradition there—let's see if it holds," he says. "When we tested our music, we saw some tradition, but that changed after that July and through September. They didn't care about Conway Twitty anymore. They were getting that traditional element in country music because of what's coming out of Nashville."

The future is in a hotter, more current music mix in markets like Houston, according to Candea. The older artists have to realize that their time in the spotlight is about over, he says. In fact, all the public complaining about older artists not getting airplay might spur the new wave of country artists to produce better records.

"They [older artists] all had their time," he says. "We're glad they came along, but they should be tipping their hat to the newcomers who are carrying on the tradition and who have that edge. We can't stop this growth. I'm glad some of these older artists are saying what they're saying, because it will make all the new artists go into the studio thinking they can't just lay down some rhythm tracks and expect hits to happen."

Since one ratings point equals about \$1.5 million to \$2 million, and KIKK is only in the initial phases of repositioning the station, Candea obviously is holding his cards very close to his vest in terms of what the future holds. He is, however, adamant that the move is not a smokescreen designed to confuse the competition. The rotations, tempo, and the current/recurrent/oldies mix are permanent.

"We want the [music] industry to watch what we're doing and to show them that KIKK and KILT are alive and well," says Candea, who's working closely with KIKK
