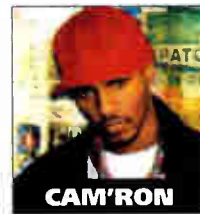

PDs Reveal Their Star-Making Secrets

How do you make your on-air personalities stars? While some have the unique quality that makes them stars on the radio, translating that to how they perform in public situations and build a brand name in the marketplace has its own set of challenges and rewards.

Back in the late '80s and early '90s, when PDs were looking to prove that R&B radio could be as tightly executed as any format, many jocks became mere liner-card readers. But today, the advantages of having personalities who are a complete package—who have a look that says something about your station and a repertoire of off-air activities, interests, and even volunteerism—can put a station above all others.

Reggie Rouse, APD of WPGC-FM Washington, D.C., who works closely with that station's airstaff, says that first and foremost "the jock has to have that star quality in them, and they have to want to be a star. Here at WPGC, we require jocks to do at least one street hit per week, because that puts them out there one-on-one with the listeners. But it's those jocks who are volunteering to do more than that, who are doing three and four events per week, who are the ones more likely to become stars."

Mark Gunn, PD of WGZB (B96)/WBLO (Hot 104) Louisville, Ky., agrees. "Those who go the extra mile are the ones I see becoming stars. And while you can work with a jock to make them better-equipped to deal with situations where they are dealing with the public in person, they have to have a certain quality to become a star. For example, our afternoon jock on Hot has a lot of relationships he has built over the years by doing things for community organizations. He coaches a Little League football team and [does] other things. But these were things he initiated, not the

Radio Groups Prepare For Sept. 11

With slightly less than one month to the one-year anniversary of the Sept. 11 terrorist attacks, radio is gearing up to mark the occasion in many ways, from montages to moments of silence.

Clear Channel's nationwide plan is for each station to pause at 8:45 a.m.—the time that the first plane hit the World Trade Center towers—in each time zone and air a special audio sequence that includes a two-minute memorial titled "Tributes and Triumph: America's Day of Remembrance," followed by two minutes of silence and a special message. That will be followed by special programming throughout the day featuring special guests, artists, politicians, air personalities, and other celebrities. The company plans to have 33 reporters and radio hosts broadcasting live from Ground Zero that day.

Clear Channel is making its resources available to other broadcasters for this event, directing interested parties to visit clearchannel.com Sept. 9 for further details and material.

In New York, three Emmis Communications stations are marking the event in different ways. Adult R&B WRKS (Kiss FM) starts things off the evening of Sept. 10 with a "night of healing and remembrance" at the Beacon Theater. Gospel artists and local clergy will take part in the event. Proceeds from ticket sales will go to charity. The next day, syndicated morning man Tom Joyner

takes his show to downtown New York for a live broadcast to start the station's commercial-free "day of reflection."

Jazz WQCD (CD101.9) will have two moments of silence, at 8:45 a.m. and 10:28 a.m., commemorating the initial plane's impact and the second tower's collapse. The first moment of silence will be followed by Celine Dion's "God Bless America" and the second by Whitney Houston's "The Star Spangled Banner." The rest of the day will feature jazz versions of patriotic songs. Produced elements commemorating the occasion will precede those songs.

WQHT (Hot 97) will also have an 8:45 a.m. moment of silence and then continue the day without commercials or contests.

Emmis' Los Angeles properties will recognize the events of that day as well. R&B KPWR (Power 106) morning man Big Boy will share his memories of last Sept. 11 with comments from listeners and hip-hop artists.

American Urban Radio Networks is offering affiliates programming under the "Operation We Remember" banner. The programming will include an interview with National Security Advisor Condoleezza Rice, as well as discussions with black firefighters in New York. There will also be special reports during the morning and afternoon drive times. **MARC SCHIFFMAN**

'Funny' How Charts Fly For Levert

While the adult R&B airplay chart is now typified by hits that climb slowly then linger for 40 weeks or more, **Gerald Levert's** "Funny" (Elektra) goes top 10 within four weeks of debuting. This week, the title sits at No. 9, just above the last record to rise to the top 10 within four weeks, "Lifetime" by Maxwell. Ironically, "Lifetime" accomplished that feat one year ago, on Aug. 18, 2001. In the year since, "Lifetime" cracked the top 10 and has only dipped twice, falling to No. 11 for a week in May and again in June.

In other chart news, **LL Cool J** returns to the R&B/hip-hop airplay chart with the debut of "Luv U Better" (IDJMG). The last time he charted with one of his own records was Aug. 26, 2000, with "Imagine That," which peaked at No. 38. He last appeared on the chart on the multi-artist "Fatty Girl" last December, which peaked at No. 37.

LL Cool J's highest solo record of the Nielsen/BDS era was the No. 5-ranking "Hey Lover" in December 1995; a year later, he would make it to No. 4 as a guest rapper on **Babyface's** remake of **Shalamar's** "This Is for the Lover in You." LL Cool J's top chart success story was before the BDS era, when he reached No. 1 on the *Billboard* Hot R&B Singles & Tracks chart with "I Need Love" in September 1987.

MOVERS & SHAKERS: The Universal/Motown merger starts to take shape as Universal executive VP/GM **Jean Riggins** resigns... **Phil Quarataro** is named executive VP of EMI Recorded Music. He was last president of Warner Bros.

A Week Of Change At The Top

Clear Channel Radio (CCR) COO **John Hogan** becomes CCR's CEO. He replaces **Randy Michaels**, who moved to a new-media post last month. Hogan will be based at CC's San Antonio offices.

Former Clear Channel senior regional VP **John Fullam** joins Infinity Broadcasting as president/COO. He replaces **Dan Mason**, who exits the company to spend more time with his family, though he'll maintain a hand in the organization on a consultant basis. In other executive news, Dow Jones News reports that a special three-person committee of Viacom's board has been formed to negotiate a deal to keep president/COO **Mel Karmazin** in place. His contract expires at the end of 2003.

Radio One/Boston, WBOT (Hot 97.7), and adult R&B WILD hire **Bart Gayden Horton** as station manager, replacing **Leon Clark**. Horton previously was a partner in a sales-training business.

UMG CAPS INDIE PROMOTION FEES

A source at Universal Music Group (UMG) confirms reports that the company has put a cap on the fees it will pay to independent record promoters. An Aug. 16 *Los Angeles Times* report indicated that UMG would cut such fees by 50%, in a move that will reportedly save the company \$25 million per year. A UMG spokesman declined comment.

FORMATS: BLAZIN' HIP-HOP Y MAS

Spanish **KEBV** Monterey, Calif., segues to a bilingual hip-hop format as "97.9 En Fuego: Blazin' Hip-Hop y Mas" under **Michael Newman**, who also adds **KXJM** (Jammin' 99.5) Portland, Ore., VP of programming **Mark Adams** to his Radio Strategies consultancy and to this project. Elektra artist/WQHT (Hot 97) New York p.m. driver **Angie Martinez** is the voice of the station. **Alex C.** from **KAJM** Phoenix is the new PD.

WMGE (Mega 103.5) Miami, which had evolved from rhythmic oldies into more of a rhythmic AC format, has eliminated most of its '90s and recurrent music under new PD **Tony Banks**, who says that the station's emphasis on '80s disco still sets it apart from most of the now-defunct Jammin' Oldies outlets.

A new study from Interep shows that the percentage of national radio dollars spent on the 25-54 demo is down again to 44.7% in 2001 from 48.5% the year before and 55.5% in 1995. By contrast, 18-49 buys now take 19.3% of all radio dollars, up from 17.5% the year before.

\$5,000 REWARD

In a follow-up to last week's story about **WBFS** Selma, Ala., which had been shut down because of a suspicious fire, *The Ledger-Enquirer* reports that the station's owners are now offering a \$5,000 reward for information leading to the capture of the person responsible.

PROGRAMMING: WOMACK WORKING MORE

WBLS New York MD **Deneen Womack** picks up another job as *Urban Traxx* programmer for Entertainment Group Resources, which produces a monthly CD compilation of new music that is mailed to radio stations across the country. She continues as MD at **WBLS**.

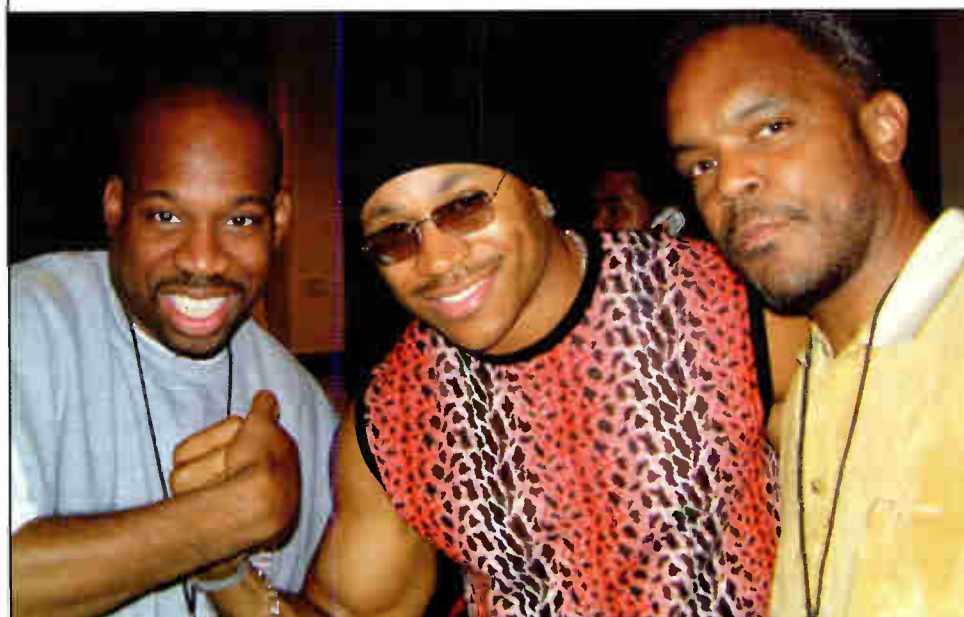
WFXM Macon, Ga., PD/morning host **Derek Harper** returns to Atlanta as R&B oldies **WAMJ** (Classic Soul 102.5) APD and morning producer for **Si-Man**, who debuted Aug. 19 after sitting out a six-month non-compete. Mason previously worked in the market as morning producer for **Mike Roberts** at **WVEE** (V103).

The BBC launched **IEExtra**, its first black music radio station, Aug. 16 in London. The station, available as a digital channel and online, plays hip-hop, dance, and garage music. BBC director general **Greg Dyke** told the British press that he hopes the channel will broaden the audience of a service he called "hideously white" earlier this year.

Kipp Kelly, imaging director for **WMBX** and adult R&B **WJBW** West Palm Beach, Fla., has created a Sept. 11 tribute, featuring the **Brian McKnight** song "Win" and incorporating audio-clips. The song has already aired on stations across the country, as well as *Larry King Live* and *The Oprah Winfrey Show*. works has produced a one-hour tribute to the late singer/actress **Aaliyah**, who perished in a plane crash one year ago. The show, *To Aaliyah With Love*, is hosted by **KKDA-FM** (K104) Dallas PD/p.m. driver **Skip Cheatham**.

Mix-show syndicator **Klub Kiss** adds two new shows to its lineup: a mainstream R&B mix and an old-school mix, both done by top 40 **WKQI** (Q95.5) Detroit's **DJ Marquis**.

PEOPLE: TIGGER'S TOO TIRED FOR TWO CITIES

WJLB Detroit morning man **Tigger** exits. He had been doing the shift via satellite since getting the night shift at sister **WWPR** (Power 105.1) New York. Adult R&B **KMJM** (Majic 104) St. Louis APD/MD **Brian Anthony** exits.

KHXT (Hot 107) Memphis' morning crew—**Doc Martin**, **Tina**, and **Bushwick Bill**—is out.

WRJH (Hot 97.7) Jackson, Miss., taps **Monique Jordan** for middays. She replaces **Simone Party**, now at **WHRK** (K97) Memphis. Jordan was last in middays at **WJXM** (the Beat) Meridian, Miss. Also, P/T **Young Mista Mista** moves to nights, replacing **Lil' Homie**, now in nights at **WBHJ** (95.7 Jamz) Birmingham, Ala.

TIMOTHY WHITE TRIBUTE SET

station. He just does it on his own. Of course, it helps the radio station as well. When you have your people out there making those kinds of connections, it can only reflect positively on us."

Jay Alan, PD of WPWX (Power 92) Chicago, adds that his midday personality, Courtney Hicks, "understands the bigger picture. She realizes that by her being involved in the community, she'll be doing something positive, as well as making a name for herself. She sees the importance of it sometimes even before I see it. She has even asked me if she can leave her shift early to attend a job fair for kids."

That sort of outreach also extends to the local music community, Alan notes. "Our night guys, the Choklit Jox, have a show on Friday nights called the *Chicago Power Hour* that features all local talent. . . . And with this move, the Choklit Jox have made a name for themselves with that large circle of local Chicago artists—so much so that we are even doing a CD featuring all local talent, which we plan to give away in the community." It's a similar move that jocks in other cities have made, such as Funkmaster Flex at WQHT New York, who actually earned a record deal and released a compilation set of new and established artists.

ALL ABOUT THE BENJAMINS

"But not all jocks get it," Alan says. And he's not alone in that opinion. One PD who asked to remain anonymous says, "Making a star is easy, but finding someone who is willing to do what they need to is the hard part. So many jocks don't want to do anything unless they are getting paid. I find this to be the case more so with the new generation of jocks coming up. I think for a lot of them, radio is more a steppingstone to something else, like music or television or something else in the entertainment business."

The PD continues, "At my station, I have a few jocks who have been in the market for years and have built a reputation by doing a lot of volunteer work and community things. Now, they can also command top dollar for other types of events because they are so popular. But the younger jocks only see the money and don't realize the years this veteran jock has put in paying his dues . . . without getting paid."

Alan points out that some jocks may have the desire to do all the right things but simply don't know how. "That's when you have to work with them to build that star quality."

Alan adds, "I will work with some of the less-experienced jocks to show them how to act on-stage and with listeners. Even little things like how you hold the mike to be heard, how to hype a crowd, and how to move around onstage to connect with the audience. I'll have some of my more-experienced jocks coach them. For me, it's like programming the staff off-air as much as it is programming them while they are on-air. I'm a stickler for the basics—things like having proper manners in public, not swearing, and always behaving with class, even on the hip-hop edge."

Ronse says, "Look at the jock's niche and their personality. When Adimu was here, he hosted the slow-jam show. So when he was out in public, everything about him said cool, smooth, and he's the ladies' man—from the way he dressed to the car he drove to how he interacted with the listeners. It all fit his persona. Another example was Tigger, who did afternoons. He was the fun-loving class clown. And he knew everybody famous. That was reinforced when he hosted BET's *Rap City*. In fact, both Tigger and Adimu were doing things on television, which continued their image visually there. You should encourage your jocks to find their own image and style, make sure it fits with their personality, and then play it up in everything they do."

Gunn adds that he tries to "build features into the jocks' show [that] fit their image and then build upon those features in live events off-air. With our midday personality on WGZB, Nikki Love, she has a lot of interaction with listeners through the fax machine, with people at work. [So to build her star quality], we focus on those listeners and work-related events and contests."

MONITOR PROFILE

No On-Air Experience Needed, But Xbox Required

During its 15-year existence, KKFR (Power 92) Phoenix has gone through the same evolution as many rhythmic top 40s, but it got there sooner than most. PD Bruce St. James says that Power "has always embraced the hip-hop world on some level. In the late '80s, it certainly [leaned] more on the dance genre like most of the country, but by '92 or '93, Dr. Dre's 'The Chronic' really changed top 40 radio and how it viewed playing hip-hop. That's when the evolution began here at Power." The station is now part of the *Airplay Monitor* R&B/hip-hop panel.

After making a name for himself as MD at sister KPWR (Power 106) Los Angeles and later as a PD in San Diego at the predecessor of XHRM, St. James joined KKFR five years ago. "Even though the station was doing very well, I decided to make the station less mainstream top 40 instead, claiming the hip-hop image and lifestyle completely," he says. "It took a little while, and we had to make some staff and image changes, but it has worked. When I first arrived, we probably sounded more like our competition sounds now—like a bunch of 40-year-old white guys trying to sound hip and cool—but that doesn't work for very long with this audience."

He's referring to Clear Channel's rhythmic top 40 KZZP, which became 104.7 Kiss FM last year. "Everybody checked them out at first as expected, but now they're back," St. James says. In the spring Arbitron, KKFR was up 4.2-4.9 (and up from 3.9 last spring), while KZZP was up 4.1-4.3 (and up from 3.6 a year ago).

While KZZP does play hip-hop, St. James feels that because "they also play 'N Sync or Britney Spears, that ruins their credibility for the hip-hop audience. You're not really treated as a serious hip-hop station—a station that knows the difference between Jay-Z and Ja Rule."

While hip-hop is its core sound, St. James says KKFR still embraces some R&B. "Our slogan is 'No. 1 for hip-hop and R&B,' with the balance being about 70/30 rap to R&B. From my experience, R&B songs don't drive as much passion as hip-hop. The biggest Ja Rule record dwarfs the biggest Usher record. That's because males tend to like hip-hop more, and overall, they are more passionate about music, whereas girls tend to be more R&B-driven but less passionate about music in general. Or at least that's my observation of society."

But even with that taken into consideration, St. James adds, "our highest-rated four hours on the station is our late-night slow-jam show, *Lights Out Phoenix*. We just added an hour, starting one hour earlier at 9 p.m., and it's hosted by Melissa 'the Midnight Mamacita.' She gets 20 shares and is rated No. 1 in her time slot. This show gives us our R&B credibility." While the show has been on for almost eight years, St. James says it fully bloomed when Melissa took over a few years ago. "She builds the show around the slow jams, dedications, and love advice. She's even getting her degree in psychology, because she feels so strongly about helping people and understanding how to handle their problems."

But playing the right combination of hip-hop

and R&B is only half the battle, St. James says. "If you have jocks on who don't know what a two-way is or who can't get high scores on Xbox, they probably aren't going to relate to the audience . . . [At KKFR], we look like, talk like, and act like our listeners. Our airstaff is young and hip and so

are the promotion kids. Even the station vehicles are Suburbans rolling on 20-inch rims."

In recent months, KKFR has brought in a new four-person morning team, MG's Morning MacHouse, from KDON Monterey, Calif. "MG, Mark Garcia, is very much committed to presenting positive role models for young Latinos, so that's a big part of the show and what he does off-air."

And earlier this year, St. James hired two old friends from Power 106. "Joey and Johnny, also known as 'Da Nutz,' came on board as our after-noon-drive duo . . . I knew them at Power, first as promotion kids, then we put them on weekends, and eventually they became our night jocks. They were most recently in Oxnard doing separate shifts, but we put them back together. The show has all the elements of a morning show, only [it's] in afternoons, and I think they have great potential to one day do mornings at this station or one of our sister stations."

St. James continues, "Like much of my staff, Joey and Johnny are both Hispanic, which is perfect for this market. Over 50% of our listeners are young people with a Latino heritage. But those young Latinos have changed in recent years. They are second- and third-generation, so in their minds, they are American. Their first language is English; they love American music and movies and television. All of my jocks are basi-

cally bilingual, but the most we'll do on the air is use a word or phrase. The important thing is to be able to pronounce words correctly."

In addition to being co-MDs for KKFR, Joey and Johnny also run Power's mix-show department. St. James says, "We run 71 hours of mixes every week. We have eight mixers, and they all have a specific shift. We do a mix in every day-part, and we mix all weekend long—and it's always live. I don't believe in running prerecorded mixes. There is an energy and vibe that develops between the audience and DJ when it's done live. And we always partner the same mixer and jock together as well. So our midday jock is always partnered with the midday mixer on-air and when they go out to club events or community appearances."

Friday and Saturday nights feature a live mix show from the clubs, hosted by the morning show (Friday) and Da Nutz (Saturday). St. James says, "These live appearances create a huge following for the jocks and the mixers."

On weeknights, the mixes take a daring approach by incorporating only new music. "It's called the Future Flavors Mix. We do enough of the familiar stuff throughout the day, so we thought we would take a chance at night, which fits with the younger audience at that time and helps to drive our new-music image."

The on-air personality for the night show is JXXX, who St. James says he found when JXXX was the MC "at a nightclub one night. He was a college kid, and he had that instant chemistry with the audience, even though he had no radio experience. His ratings are double what the second-place station in the market gets in the time slot."

The other key element to St. James' staff is his midday personality, Mini Salas. "She has been on the air for over four years," St. James says, "and she's my consistency."

As for promotions, "since music is what we do, we make that the major focus," St. James says. "We try to do three to four really big concert events every year. In fact, I would say we are the station [that] drives the concert business here in Phoenix. While we might not be as big as other cities, we sell a lot of records in this market, and the labels and the artists themselves take notice. That's why we are able to do so much in terms of concert events."

But St. James admits that the concert business isn't doing as well as in past years. "It's happening across the board, not just at station concerts but with all the big tours. They just aren't selling out. Right now we have no concerts planned for the fall. The last one we held was for Cinco De Mayo, which by no means was a flop, but it wasn't what we would have done in the past."

Instead, St. James says, the station has already started to do "smaller, more intimate events that are free or win-tickets only. We did a Christmas event last December in a 3,000-seat venue and tied in a charity. And last Fourth of July, we did a free concert with I12 and Ray J at a baseball field. We thought we would get a couple of thousand people to come out, [but when] we had to close down admission, there were 200,000 people." **DANA HALL**

KEEPING IT REAL

Gunn adds that it's imperative to ensure your jocks are real. "Being a star in your community doesn't mean acting like you're a celebrity or deserve special attention. In fact, you're better off being like the regular guy on the street. It's like what Dennis Miller's role on *Monday Night Football* was intended to be . . . the everyday guy who speaks for the audience."

Several PDs stress the importance of always acting professionally. One says, "You can't become a star if you have a reputation for argu-

ing with listeners, being involved in drama, or blowing off clients."

But the No. 1 most important tactic in building a jock into a star is to have them connect with the community. Alan says, "I require all my jocks to do as many community events as they can. It has a bigger impact than simply hosting a club event or a concert because the listeners then see you as making a commitment to them, and the result is a sincere connection. It has a much greater emotional impact."

Gunn adds, "[Getting involved with] anything

and everything to do with the kids is the key to becoming a star, because that's usually where the buzz begins. And when you are involved positively in helping kids in your city, not only do you impact them, but you're also touching their parents and their families."

Gunn also cites one crucial element. "You have to be local. You can't be a star if you're not there day to day, every day, living in the community. And even better, if you're a local kid who has made it to the radio, you have the potential to be even bigger."

Spring Cleaning For The Fall Book

The production director at a station where I used to work once cautioned me about complaining that the commercials playing over and over during my shift were tedious and repetitive. That, he said, was precisely the point. By the time we were sick to death of hearing those spots, the consumer was just beginning to get the message.

Maybe that's the point with some of the big fall campaigns that some stations are planning for the upcoming book. Perhaps the belief is that with repetition each year, the station will become "the station that owns the big cash giveaway" in the minds of listeners. But that's tough to do when just about everyone in your market is giving away a similar denomination. It's also tough to do when a contest has been done repeatedly in your market in years past.

What are some of the promotions that our panelists are steering clear of this fall? "Trip a day," country WYVZ Hartford, Conn.'s Annie Sandor says. "We were the first in with this promotion [in our market], and a week later, a competitor is doing their own promotion. Two days later, a third station. It was completely washed out in the market. They say imitation is the best [form of flattery, but it's also the best] way to kill a good promotion."

And some of the tried-and-true giveaways of the past need freshening, according to Clear Channel/Phoenix's Vicki Fiorelli. "Meet-and-greets with the artists are getting boring and tiring. I like to do dinner with the artist backstage with the crew or roadie for the day. How about hanging out with the artists before a big show?"

Country WMZQ Washington, D.C.'s Wendie Vestfall says, "I don't think anybody has really come up with something new in the past 10 years. It has all been recycled from something else. It's a given that listeners want big cash, trips, cars, and a chance to attend unique experiences. It's more about the twist you put on it and how well you sell it. [If you do that], it will seem new to people." And new to Promogandists, which would be a welcome change for Fiorelli, who says, "Listeners are looking for something different, unique, and special. Or maybe I am."

So what are these promotion pros doing to freshen things up this fall? Sandor says, "We always do a big promotion, and it usually centers around a car giveaway or a big trip. This year, we are working on giving away a house, room by room. With the economy the way it is, home repairs and improvements have fallen by the wayside. The room-by-room improvements work for those who live in apartments or condos as well."

While Vestfall's station always participates in the Clear Channel collective cash giveaway and also hosts its annual Chili Cook-Off and concert, she's planning some new things for the show. "We've hired bigger acts, like Shedaisy," she says, "and [we are holding] a local band competition to be their opening act."

For Fiorelli, her stations are staying with what has been proven in the past with one exception, country KNIX, which is "partnering with the city of Phoenix for the Sept. 11 tribute parade in downtown Phoenix. We are planning lots of stuff for the one-year anniversary," she says. In addition, the cluster is participating in cash contests, station concerts, and sponsored festivals.



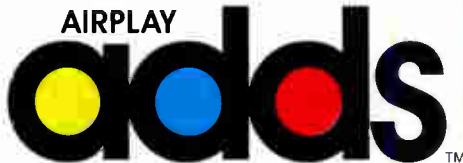
