

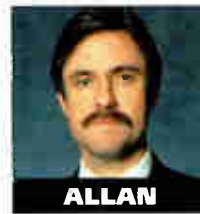

## Radio Still Cares For Aaliyah

A year after her tragic death in a Bahamas plane crash, Aaliyah remains very much a presence at R&B radio, as evidenced by the charts. Aaliyah's current single, "I Care 4 U" (Blackground), advances 22-18 on the R&B/hip-hop chart, earning Airpower honors with the fifth-highest gain in detections (up 288 spins).

"I Care 4 U" also moves up 37-34 at adult R&B, while a jazz cover of "Rock the Boat," by Streetwize Featuring Kim Waters, is up 36-35.

As for Aaliyah's own "Rock the Boat," it's one of several gold titles getting a boost from stations' one-year commemoratives this week. The track jumps 14-6 on the R&B/hip-hop recurrent chart with a 98-spin gain and returns to the adult R&B recurrent chart at No. 18, up 47 detections. "More Than a Woman" returns to the R&B/hip-hop recurrent chart at No. 9, up 141 spins. "Try Again" posted the biggest gain of all of Aaliyah's recurrences, with an increase of 161 spins.

There were also gains on "Are You That Somebody?" (up 101 spins) and "One in a Million" (up 131).

PANEL CHANGES: KPTY Houston is added to the R&B/hip-hop and crossover panels. The new reporter count is now 93 stations on the R&B/hip-hop panel and 89 stations on the crossover list.

## Morning Team Gone, FCC Still Probing

The FCC has sent a letter to Infinity Broadcasting outlining its inquiry into complaints that WNEW New York aired obscene or indecent material, in the form of the syndicated Opie & Anthony show's mid-August sex in St. Patrick's Cathedral incident, in which two listeners were arrested for having or simulating sex in church as part of a station contest. The letter, dated Aug. 22, directs Infinity to turn over any documents or tapes related to the incident within 20 days.

The company must also answer a series of questions, including the names of each employee who "was responsible for the concept of the contest and its subsequent broadcast, or who was aware of the contest . . . prior to the broadcast." The FCC also wants to know "if Infinity has broadcast this contest on other stations, or other similar 'Sex for Sam' contests on this or other stations."

Opie & Anthony were dismissed Aug. 22. WNEW GM Ken Stevens and PD Jeremy Coleman were placed on suspension several days earlier.

### MANAGEMENT: ALLAN EXITS

At Clear Channel/Philadelphia, VP of operations Dave Allan exits after 15 years, following the elimination of his position. He started as PD of WUSL (Power 99) in 1987.

Radio South, owner of adult R&B WTUG Tuscaloosa, Ala., appoints Birmingham, Ala., veteran Davis Hawkins as COO. Hawkins was previously GM of WENN.

### BUSINESS: REGENT BUYS BRILL

Regent Communications has purchased 12 Brill Media properties in a federal bankruptcy proceeding for approximately \$62 million. Those properties are WIOV-AM-FM Lancaster, Pa.; WBKR/WOMI Owensboro, Ky.; WKDQ Evansville, Ind.; KTRR/KUAD and an FM construction permit for Fort Collins, Colo.; and KKCB/KLDJ/KBMX/WEBC Duluth, Minn. Regent is expected to close on the purchase late this year or in first quarter 2003.

### PROGRAMMING: THE SYLK ROAD

WENZ Cleveland PD/p.m. driver Sam Sylk heads back to WGCI-FM Chicago to do afternoons, replacing Devante Stone. Sylk was a weekend commuter to Chicago, holding down a part-time shift while programming WENZ for the past two years.

Citadel/Lafayette, La., PD Darleen PreJean—who oversees KRRQ, adult R&B KNEK, and gospel KFXZ—is leaving to attend medical school. OM James Alexander is searching for her replacement.

Barnstable Broadcasting/Norfolk, Va.—which includes gospel outlets WFOG/WXEZ—taps Cumulus/Flint, Mich., OM John Shomby, whose outlets include WDZZ, as director of programming and operations.

Crossover R&B KQBT (the Beat) PD Scooter B. Stevens adds those same duties over top 40 sister KAMX (Mix 94.7) Austin, Texas. Elsewhere in that market, at KXMG (Mega 93.1), which just readded R&B product to its dance format, p.m. driver Evan moves to mornings, replaced by night jock Miss Kitty. P/T Forrest Bueller gives up some days out, becoming the new night host.

### FORMATS: ADIOS, BENAVIDOS

R&B oldies KAMZ Lubbock, Texas, flips to Spanish after one year. PD Bob Benavidos remains, while the staff exits.

Gospel WQUA (Q102) Mobile, Ala., flips to ABC's children's top 40 network Radio Disney.

WPWA Chester, Pa.—located between Philadelphia and Wilmington, Del.—adds gospel programming to nights and weekends. The station primarily airs Korean religious programming.

### PEOPLE: ENTERPRISING JOYNER

Syndicated morning man Tom Joyner has made Black Enterprise's list of top 10 celebrity endorsers, coming in at No. 10. His current endorsements include McDonald's and Nokia. The top eight celebrity endorsers were all athletes, headed by No. 1 on the list, Tiger Woods. No. 9 was actor James Earl Jones.

WWPR (Power 105.1) New York makes it official by giving veteran rapper Chubb Rock the afternoon shift. He replaces Colby Colb, who exited several weeks ago. Rock had been filling

in since early August. Power is also looking for a promotions manager.

WDTJ Detroit late-night jock Earl McKinney exits.

Cross town at top 40 WDRQ Detroit, Man at Large—last in nights at KKDA-FM (K104) Dallas—is now official in nights. He was working that shift for several months on an interim basis.

Gospel WFMV Columbia, S.C., morning co-host Michelle Harris exits to join the Andy Thomas talk show, which is syndicated regionally in South Carolina. PD Brian Maxwell is searching for her replacement.

Rhythmic top 40 KSEQ (Q97) Fresno, Calif., moves p.m. driver JoJo Lopez to mornings, teaming with new co-host Uzette Salazar, a former morning producer for KZQZ and KLLC San Francisco.

Gospel WMOG Brunswick, Ga., personality John Carter Sr., 55, was found shot to death Aug. 19 in his home. According to *The (Jacksonville) Florida Times-Union*, police arrested his son, Jason Carter, later the same day when he stepped off a Greyhound bus in Jacksonville. He's expected to face murder charges when he returns to Brunswick.

WPGC-FM Washington, D.C., morning man Donnie Simpson recently celebrated 25 years on the air. Simpson was first heard on D.C. radio in 1977, when he joined WKYS for afternoons. He later became PD there. He joined WPGC in 1993.

## Budget Cuts Spur Reliance On P/T

At a recent Country Radio Seminar, I was struck by the number of panels catering to the needs of promotion and marketing directors. I was also saddened by the lack of folks who actually attended. There were panels on quick-and-easy ideas and in-depth sales promotion. Unfortunately, I was among about five people in the room at both panels. It's not that marketing and promotion pros don't want to learn or find new ideas, it's that they don't have the budgets to attend.

Of course, it's hard to complain about not having money to attend seminars when most are simply happy that their jobs haven't been slashed from the budget. But at some point, we need to say that the learning and idea-sharing must continue.

So we march on. Those who did attend heard about recommended Web sites for promotion ideas, such as [lured.com](http://lured.com) and [radioready.com](http://radioready.com). They listened to country KUAD Fort Collins, Colo., promotion director Shelly Heier's idea for Valentine's Day called "Shove Your Love." OK, so there are so many ways to go with that one, but it's really an opportunity to sky dive with your sweetheart on Valentine's Day. And they heard some cool sales-friendly promotion ideas, including calendars and community events.

With budgets for promotion departments being cut to the bone, an increasing number of our panelists are relying on part-timers for help rather than worrying about filling a job that should be full time. But finding good part-timers can be even tougher than finding useful interns.

KSJO San Francisco's Jim Sheehan says he overcomes that problem by ensuring he's "always hiring. Too many people wait until they need to hire, and they have to make hires they regret later." Sheehan believes many people wait because they "probably hate the process or don't think it's part of their job. Hiring is a part of your job. I've always got my eyes open for new promotion talent."

Unlike others who say they have found good part-timers among the fans who gather at station events, Sheehan thinks that can cause problems. "Groupies aren't hired," he says. Those fans can often be too preoccupied with satisfying their need to be close to jocks or artists rather than doing the grunt work at hand. "I look for some college [experience]." Sheehan says, "whether they are still in college or just graduated."

And once on board, how do you keep a good part-timer motivated? Sheehan says radio provides more opportunities to give people a lift in their work than other jobs can. His station has "weekly meetings [with] free food. [We motivate by] recognizing good work [with things like] employee-of-the-month [honors]." Sheehan also gives part-timers the chance to "attend special events as a group that they don't have to work."

### NTR SPOTLIGHT: IS THAT A BIG BUCK IN YOUR POCKET OR ARE YOU JUST HAPPY TO FISH HERE?

WPOC Baltimore NTR director Jennifer Schmidt is organizing her third annual Toy-

ota Big Buck Bass tournament for this September, which has grown each year since its inception. The idea for the two-day fishing tournament came during discussions with Central Atlantic Toyota dealers, who were trying to push their full-size pickups to fishermen for hauling their bass boats. "There's lots and lots of prize money," Schmidt says. "Every hour, all day for two days, we give away \$400, \$300, and \$200 prizes, all for single-weight catches. And the single heaviest weight catch of the whole weekend wins \$5,000."

Schmidt also made an agreement with contest insurer Hole in One to offer "exact catch" prizes. The winner on Saturday takes home a new Toyota Tundra. On Sunday, it's a bass boat, motor, and trailer. To make it bigger than life, WPOC promotes the event all year long, with promo mentions, billboards, ads in bass-fishing magazines, and the event's own Web site, [bigbuckbass.com](http://bigbuckbass.com).

# JOHNNIE WALKER'S COMMUNITY OF WOMEN, 1,250 STRONG

Conceived in 1998 and launched in 1999, the National Assn. of Black Female Executives in Music and Entertainment (NABFEME) has done a lot in its three-year history. Def Jam senior VP of urban promotion and NABFEME founder Johnnie Walker says, "One of the greatest things we've accomplished thus far is the development of our community of women. That was one of our primary goals—to create a network of women who supported one another and connected through a common interest."

Walker says that at NABFEME's launch three years ago, "the group had less than five official members—me, Tory Baily, Michelle Madison, and my daughter—today, there are over 1,250 members." Walker compares the camaraderie to a sorority. "Here, you have NABFEME sisters who you have a commonality with. Even if you've never met a particular executive, if you know she is a NABFEME sister, you feel you can call her, even if it's just to ask her a question."

Walker was inspired to start NABFEME by her own experiences coming up through the ranks of a record label. "For many years in the industry, I never felt I had a female mentor in the business who I could talk to about my experiences," she says. "Even though there were several women at the time to look up to, like Sharon Heyward, I was too intimidated to call her and just talk. Instead, I ended up talking with my male counterparts, who didn't always have the same experiences."

"The other reason I was inspired to create NABFEME was so that we could come together to share information at events such as the conference in Toronto [Aug. 29-Sept. 1]," Walker continues. "Over the years I would go to industry conferences, attend the panels, and yet never feel like I was bringing anything back with me that impacted my daily life or job. It just wasn't useful. I wanted to facilitate change in how we come together as a group, so that people would go away having learned something valuable and maybe even make connections that could truly further their career or personal life."

Walker says NABFEME "went into [its first conference last year] blind, having absolutely no idea what to expect. It turned out better than I could ever have hoped for. And with the conference we were able to take the concept of community to a whole new level. A year later, women I speak with are still talking about things they heard or learned at the first conference. That shows me the impact it has had on their lives; it's not a conference where people talk about who's playing or not playing their records."

"This year, our goal is to further what we started last year," she continues. "With the executives and personalities we have involved—like poet Nikki Giovanni as our

keynote speaker—we hope to create a feeling of empowerment and growth, even in these hard times [that] face our industry. At the end of the day, it's really about who you are as a person, not who you are in business. If you don't take care of yourself first, the job won't make a difference, anyway."

"Take time out to enrich yourself and your family, because if [Def Jam president] Kevin Liles comes into my office and says he needs someone else to do my job, I'd

ban programming] Doc Wynter, for his part in furthering the careers of women at his company. He has been instrumental in appointing a number of women to PD, OM, and other influential positions within the Clear Channel chain."

The conference, which is open to students as well as industry professionals, also offers a collegiate connection "so that our young people can network and communicate among themselves," Walker says. "We created it because sometimes these young people might feel intimidated by a title like 'VP' or 'president' and not speak up in front of us. Here, we encourage executives to come in and introduce themselves but also to simply listen for their ideas and concerns."

Walker says that during the past year, "we've also developed our mentor program. We've already matched 64 young people with 32 executives. These mentors answer questions and guide the students in the ways of the business. It's not about hooking them up with a job—it's about learning what to expect and how to prepare to get a job, and we stress to those in the program that it's really up to them to make things happen."

In addition, Walker says NABFEME is working on a new concept, Intern to Work. "We hope to launch the program next year, which could put as many as 50 students into internship. But it's not just about connecting the two. We train the students for three days—kind of like 'a day in the life of an executive'—to show them what to expect. Then we call around and place them. In addition, we will pay the students for their work, as well as take complete responsibility for them in the workplace. Hopefully, a position like this will help start them on their way to their career goals."

Walker says her main reason for doing a program like this "is to help groom the next generation of executives. A lot of times, if a young person never sees that there is a woman who, say, is the editor of a trade magazine or a woman who is a publisher, then she won't know those jobs exist. But through mentor and internship programs like ours, we expose them to all the possibilities their career path can take them."

The NABFEME convention closes with the Shero Hall of Fame ceremony. "This event and award is the highest honor we bestow upon sisters in the industry," Walker says. "This year, in addition to recognizing the careers of [record industry veteran] Jean Riggins, [publisher] Jamie Foster Brown, and [BET COO] Debra Lee, we'll also give a special commendation to Maria A. Davis for her work in educating the black music community about HIV and AIDS. As someone who has AIDS, Maria's main goal in life now is to help people understand the disease. So for us, it's not always about just recognizing the person with the high-level job or the biggest paycheck. It's about the people making the biggest impact on the lives of people in our industry."

better have my exit plan already in place." Walker adds. "This is what we are trying to help women in the industry with, by giving them the information and the network they need."

The conference will recognize women who have made major strides in their own careers and who have affected others in the industry. The She's Got Game Awards are given in 12 categories to women in the record, radio, and related industries, including the rising executive award, female business owner of the year, and radio executive of the year.

Walker adds that "this year we have enhanced the ceremony by recognizing the contributions of Clear Channel [VP of ur-

# A WOMAN'S INDUSTRY WORTH: THEN AND NOW

Women in the radio and music business have come a long way in the past 20 years. In the '70s, when labels' black music departments were first taking form and such FM stations as WBLS New York were expanding the reach of black music, the generation of women who are now in powerful positions in the industry were just getting their feet wet—as secretaries, on-air jocks, and local field reps. During the three decades since then, women have overcome many challenges and obstacles, misperceptions and stereotypes.

DeDe McGuire, who co-hosts ABC's syndicated Doug Banks morning show, says the roles of women on the radio have changed and continue to evolve. "Doug recently did an interview with *Upscale* magazine [in which] they pointed out that many morning shows, local or syndicated, now have a very strong, opinionated female presence, like myself and [the Russ Parr morning show's] Olivia Foxx. Sometimes these women are just as strong a presence as the male anchor."

But it wasn't always like that. And even now, many programmers have a very narrow view of what a woman's on-air role should be. McGuire says, "From '90-'92, I was doing afternoon drive at [KKDA-FM] K104 in Dallas. It was almost unheard of for a woman to be in that shift. I was also the main jock who filled in for Tom Joyner in mornings when he was on vacation. And that was thanks to [female] PD Terry Avery. But after I left K104, the only jobs I was offered were mid-days or morning co-host. Now, if a man had been doing afternoons in Dallas, do you think he would have been getting those kinds of limited offers?"

"I think that's still how a lot of PDs think," McGuire continues. "You have to have a vision of who your audience is—and most stations still primarily target women—to consider having a woman anchor your prime drive slots. Women do like to hear someone they can identify with on the air."

Tracy Latrelle, PD of XM Satellite Radio's R&B channel the Flow and a 17-year radio veteran, adds that women often have had a harder time earning respect from their male bosses. "I think a lot of women in key roles are second-guessed and watched more closely, more often than men. Maybe part of that is because men are accustomed to women being in less-powerful roles than they are now. In the past, we were more likely MDs or assistants. Now we're PDs and VPs."

Deneen Womack, MD of WBLS New York, agrees. "Although it has gotten a lot better, women are still battling to get the same respect that men get, even when they are on the same level. To overcome that, I think many women have had to take on a more aggressive quality in order to compete in a man's world. When I first started out in radio, answering phones for Johnny Allen at [WRKS New York], he told me, 'As a woman, you have to be extra hard in this business.

You can't be sensitive or mild-mannered."

Women on the label side have encountered similar challenges. Michelle Madison, VP of urban promotion at Elektra Entertainment, says, "As a woman in the music business, sometimes you have to think about how you are coming across—Are you perceived as too overbearing? Are you coming across as a bitch? You have to keep those things in balance but still not come across as weak or oversensitive."

Daisy Davis, OM of Clear Channel's Norfolk, Va., R&B cluster, adds, "One of the things I realize as I look back now is that people may have perceived me as unap-

proachable. I mented them with my stations. I felt if I can't be a part of the recreational aspect of this job to make a connection, then I'll be the one person PDs know they can rely on when they need a promotion or an artist."

Women in the industry have also faced the issue of balancing career and family. But Nicole Sellers, Southeast promotion manager for J Records, asks, "Why can't you have both? There is a misperception that a woman can't be everything. She can have a home, a family, and do her job well.

I'm doing it. Some of the highest-ranking women in the business had very young children when they started out.

proachable. I guess I didn't play the political game—I was just never very good at that. So, while I did become an OM, it took me a long time to get here. I might have made it a lot faster if I had felt I was able to change who I was in order to further my career. I just never wanted to."

Stereotypes and perceptions were not the only challenges our panel faced. The so-called "old-boys network" has been a factor for years.

Cynthia Johnson, senior VP of urban promotion for J Records, explains: "Early on in my career, I noticed there were some things that male programmers would do with other

men that they would not consider doing with their female counterparts—like going to a basketball game or playing golf. . . . So I felt I had to find other ways to make an impact. I had to kill them with my work ethic. So over the years, maybe I wrote more memos than my male co-workers or maybe I came up with 10 more ideas for promotions and imple-

You learn to juggle and balance your life, just as you would in any other industry. You never hear people questioning whether men can handle a family and home life and still travel around the country promoting records. Yet they have to find that same balance with their family. You never see a man penalized or not promoted because he has a family, yet you see it all the time with women."

Madison adds, "When you look at the opportunities 20 years ago when I started in radio, they were few and far between for women, although overall, the industry had a much broader landscape. There were a lot of jobs overall; there were just limited choices for women. But today, while we've seen women make great strides, the opportunities overall have dwindled, and that frightens me."

## FUTURE FORECAST

What does the industry's current turmoil and continued consolidation mean for women's future in music? Madison continues, "I don't want to look negatively on it, but the fact remains that we are all—men and women—going to suffer."

McGuire says, "I don't think we will go backward, with women getting less of the pie. There will just be less pie to go around for

everyone. You can't take away the success that women like [WBLS New York p.m. driver] Wendy Williams or [rival WQHT p.m. driver] Angie Martinez have achieved. We've seen that women can be successful in those positions in major markets. As radio continues to consolidate or move toward more voice-tracking, you'll still see women in prominent roles, but [there] will be fewer women."

Carla Boatner, OM of Clear Channel's New Orleans R&B cluster, adds that "while we are much

better off today, I'm still worried about the future opportunities for women. There's a few female OMs, like myself and Daisy at Clear Channel, and that's because of [CCVP of urban programming] Doc Wynter. He recognizes the talent of his female programmers and moves them up—like [WKKV Milwaukee PD] Jamillah [Muhammad], [WGCI Chicago APD/MD] Tiffany Green, or in Detroit, where [WJLB APD/MD] Kris Kelly and [WMXD PD] Janet G are doing their thing. But not every company has someone with his vision."

Davis also cites Wynter as a key person in developing female talent within Clear Channel, but she adds that "the future is questionable for PDs, period. Who knows if companies will have individual programmers at each station in five or 10 years? Look at us now. I've got four stations, and that's the norm."

Johnson worries that "women in particular could suffer more with the consolidation at labels. I'm also concerned about the elimination of lower-level jobs, like field reps. That's where the training begins and you learn how to do this job. So where is the next generation of promotion people, men or women, going to start?"

## LISTEN CLOSELY

Despite the gloomy predictions, our panel says there are ways to survive, even in the hardest of times. Madison recalls that "the best advice I was ever given was to be yourself. At the end of the day, if you can say you've done your best, that's all you can do. If you keep your integrity, you'll always have a good reputation, and in this business, that is invaluable."

Latrelle says, "We have to learn to put our foot down, to be a bitch when we feel strongly enough about something. Otherwise, we aren't taken seriously. When men want something they believe in, they do whatever they have to to achieve it, and I think women can take a cue from that. So, get ugly if you have to—but that doesn't mean get emotional. Control that urge that women have to implode. To me, if someone calls a woman in this business a bitch, that means she's strong and powerful, and that's why she has made it as far as she has."

Womack agrees that "women have to be more aggressive in the workplace, whether it's stating their position or going after a position. You have to be able to make hard decisions. When you are just starting out in the business, make sure you let the higher-ups know who you are. When I was an intern, I would go into the GM's office to ask her questions and let her know what I wanted to do in radio. I also worked in many different departments to find out what I really wanted to

do... That way you don't spend time on a career track that you decide five years later that you hate."

"Decide what you can live with and what you can't," Davis suggests. "Do you want to change your whole personality to fit into a career path? If so, then remember you'll have to roll with the punches down the road."

But Davis also says that in radio, you've got to adapt to the new landscape. "One of the things I've learned from Doc is [that] the programming game is all about numbers now. It's not about being creative as much. Knowing research, Arbitron, and sales are the keys. So many young people come into this business talking about the streets. Well, the streets are important, but if you don't know the numbers, you're not going to be able to move up."

McGuire, who started in Killeen, Texas, in 1988, says, "Within two years, I had moved to two markets and was in Dallas by 1990. I've been a secretary, traffic manager, PSA director, on air, and a receptionist. If you really love this business, you'll do anything to stay in it. You know you have to work hard and pay your dues. I've moved to five cities throughout my career, and it's not always about working at the hottest, hippest station in town. If you're a professional, you know you can hone your skills anywhere, and that's what you do. It's not about your ego."

Davis notes that in the past, "men would often become more successful in radio, because they were more willing to take chances and move around from city to city. Women often feel tied to a particular market because of friends and family. Sometimes, even when you are comfortable, you have to leave in order to move up, especially if you are being overlooked in your current situation. We are each responsible for what happens in our lives. If you allow yourself to be overlooked because you never make a change, then it's nobody's fault but your own. Get up and go."

Boatner's rule of thumb is to "keep God first, and don't let the business consume your life. Have outside interests that help you keep a perspective on what's really important."

### THE NABFEME TRADITION BEGINS

With the industry changing rapidly and women inside the industry struggling to be all they can be, an organization like the National Assn. of Black Female Executives in Music and Entertainment (NABFEME)—and the conference it has planned for Aug. 29-Sept. 1 in Toronto—can be an inspiration.

Madison, who is also NABFEME's COO, says, "I feel having an organization such as this is important, because it allows women to support, nurture, and promote each other. There are young women just entering the business today who might be intimidated by walking up and talking to someone like [Def Jam senior VP of urban promotion] Johnnie Walker, but in an atmosphere like the

NABFEME conference, it's more relaxed. If I had a group like this when I was first starting out, I probably would have developed a sense of security and confidence much sooner in my career."

Sellers adds that for her, "it's like when you watch the nightly news, and all you see is a certain image portrayed of your people that may not be positive. That's how the industry looks sometimes. But with NABFEME, you see first-hand all the positive things women have been able to do in the music industry and how far you can excel, too."

"It's important for young female professionals to see all facets of the industry—television, film, and publishing, as well as radio and the music industry, to see women at all levels all working and learning from each other," Johnson says. "Just because I have a VP next to my name doesn't mean I can't learn from someone who is just starting out, whose perspective now may turn out to be how we do business in five or 10 years."

Womack says that "NABFEME is a great way to network and to be in an environment with other women who may be facing the same experiences or challenges as you. In a way, it's like a girls club, just like there is a so-called boys club. Only NABFEME isn't exclusive of anyone, gender-wise. Men are just as welcome, and we can learn from them as well."

She continues, "Over the years, I've seen a lot of women in powerful positions who were so concerned about who was coming up behind them who might take their spot that they never wanted to share anything. Now, we see more women like [veteran radio programmer and record executive] Helen Little who are willing to take the time to talk to you and guide you. That's what NABFEME is all about."

Boatner says, "Coming up, there were a lot of male role models in programming for me to look up to. There were only a few females PDs, like Terry Avery, or GMs like Verna Green. So to have a group like this, where you can go

and actually meet women who are VPs, presidents, and CEOs, is something we didn't have before. At the same time, I feel like I can now give back to those who are coming up behind me... Eventually, I want to move to the next level, and if I don't train the next person to take over, who will? At NABFEME, I can meet that next generation of women coming into the business."

McGuire sums it up by saying that "we all know how cutthroat this business can be. But NABFEME is about sisterhood and supporting each other. The catfighting, backstabbing, and hating [that] goes on at times, takes a back seat to respect and camaraderie. I mean, why hate on those women who are paving the way for you? It doesn't make sense. NABFEME highlights the positive aspects of working together and networking, which we all can benefit from."

# SHERO HALL OF FAME

## JEAN RIGGINS

As her tenure as executive VP/GM at Universal Records ends, Riggins has worked with such multi-platinum-selling artists as Nelly and Master P, as well as such breaking acts as Big Tymers and Lil' Wayne. And during her three years as GM, Riggins' purview grew to include artists in other genres, such as the English-language launch of Latin star Paulina Rubio. Sylvia Rhone and Riggins were the only African-American females to hold such a title at any major label group.

Before her appointment as executive VP/GM in 1999, Riggins was president of Universal's black music division. Previously, Riggins served as senior VP of black music at Arista, where she helped guide the careers of Whitney Houston, Babyface, Sean "P. Diddy" Combs, and Aretha Franklin. She also founded the Arista Reaching and Teaching campaign, which assists inner-city community initiatives.

During the late '80s/early '90s, Riggins headed Capitol Records as VP/GM of black music. There she led the team that broke M.C. Hammer, CeCe Winans, and a number of other acts.



## JAMIE FOSTER BROWN

As the founder, publisher, and sole owner of *Sister 2 Sister* magazine, Brown has earned an industry reputation as a woman you need to know. Brown launched *Sister 2 Sister* in September 1988. Based in Washington, D.C., the monthly magazine was one of the fastest-growing in the nation in 2000, with 27% growth in circulation, according to the Audit Bureau of Circulation.

In addition to her magazine, Brown's entertainment report is heard twice weekly on ABC Radio Networks' nationally syndicated Tom Joyner Morning Show, reaching 9 million listeners. At one time, Brown had her own syndicated radio show, *The Sister 2 Sister Celebrity Update*, which aired on 46 radio stations across the country, as well as on the BBC in the U.K.

In addition to her own magazine, Brown is also a published author. Simon & Schuster issued Brown's first book, *Betty Shabazz: A Sisterfriends Tribute in Words and Pictures*. In the book, Brown brought together a collection of prominent women, including Whitney Houston, Maya Angelou, Gloria Steinem, and Dorothy Height, who in their own personal essays commemorate the life of Dr. Shabazz.

Prior to starting *Sister 2 Sister*, Brown was a producer for Black Entertainment Television's *Video Soul* and *Video LP*.



## DEBRA LEE

As president/COO of Black Entertainment Television (BET), Lee is the highest-ranking African-American woman in a Viacom empire that includes MTV, VH1, and Infinity. Lee oversees the cable network's entertainment, news, and public-affairs programming, which reaches an estimated 70 million households, primarily targeting the African-American consumer. Under her leadership, BET's latest season was its best-rated ever, increasing 35% over the previous year.

During her tenure as president/COO, Lee has been instrumental in the evolution of the network, incorporating original movies, documentaries, and special music and concert events, as well as increased news, talk, and public-affairs programming.

Prior to being named president/COO, Lee served as the network's executive VP of strategic business development and also as general counsel of BET's legal affairs department. Before joining the network in 1986, she was a partner in a Washington, D.C., law firm.

A graduate of Harvard Law School and undergraduate of Brown University, Lee has been honored with the Silver Star Award from the American Women in Radio & Television organization and the Tower of Power Trumpet Award from Turner Broadcasting in 2000. She was also named one of the 100 most influential women in D.C. by *Washingtonian* magazine.
