Fueled By Heritage, Olympics, SLC Modern Race Heats Up

So how much more crowded can Salt Lake City's modern rock race get?

First, there was KRRX (X96), the fourth in a line of successive modern rockers that included the now defunct KCGI and KJQN. Then there was modern-leaning top 40 KUTQ (Q99). Now, there is a new arrival, SBR's adult modern KENZ (the End), staffed with a number of former X96 and KJQN players. KENZ, which switched from AC last month, comes into a market that already has a conventional triple-A station, the Dennis Constantine-consulted KUMT (the Mountain), which shares 17% of its audience with Q99 and X96.

X96 PD Mike Summers and the End PD Bruce Jones both programmed KJQN in the late '80s. Now, by debuting a more gold-based adult modern approach, Jones seems to be laying claim to the market's modern heritage. Summers says, "Anybody who wants to claim the modern rock heritage of Salt Lake City is welcome to it, because it was on shoddy signals for however long. X96 is five years old. We got it together so that everybody else is interested in [modern rock]."

At its inception, X96 did well enough with modern rock to force

KJQN out of the format at a time when two modern rockers in one market was unheard of. Early in '95, Q99 wrestled the modern crown from X96, leading by a half share. But by the fall, before the End's debut, X96 led Q99 4.1 to 3.6. That turnaround coincided with Summers' decision to change X96 from being a modern rock outlet dependent on heritage to a more current-based, guitar-driven station.

"One reason X96 moved in the direction it moved in [is because] our past is certainly something we use, but we found we could no longer live on it," says Summers. "It was a slow move we made into a rock area, because the product of the moment dictated it, and I think we've been pretty careful about it. I don't find a lot of people expecting us to take care of the baggage of 15 years at X96. When we have some fun with the '80s, we make fun of the '80s. Because looking back on [the music], a lot of it is pretty silly. A lot of it was one-shots."

As for the Edge, Summers says, "I think they'll succeed, because a lot of 35-year-olds aren't into Gravity Kills, but that's rock music, and a lot of what we play is rock music. We're not dealing in a time anymore when guitars are evil."

Planet 96.3 Names Y100's Michaels PD; Denver Sale Announced; Chicago AC Rocks

WPLY (Y100) Philadelphia PD **Garret Michaels** is named PD at **WHYT** (Planet 96.3) Detroit, replacing **Rick Gillette**. Michael's first order of business is to find a morning show for the station. **Alex Tear**, who was acting PD, will remain at the station as MD. At Y100, APD **Chuck Tisa** is named acting PD. In other Philly news, **WIBF** names **Preston Elliot** to the newly created position of MD/p.m. drive jock. Elliot, under the airname **Kenny Knight**, was MD/p.m. driver at top 40 **WKQB** St. Louis.

After weeks of speculation, EXCL communications has confirmed its purchase of sports/album combo **KYBG/KNRX** (92X) Denver from Century Broadcasting. EXCL says only the AM will go Spanish. **KNRX** was up 1.7-1.9 in the fall book.

As **WTMX** (Mix 102) Chicago continues its segue from AC to a modern-leaning approach along the lines of **KYSR** (Star 98.7) Los Angeles or **KFMB-FM** (Star 100.7) San Diego, the station has started billing itself as "Today's rock mix" and is running promos aimed at crosstown modern **WKQX** (Q101).

Speaking of Q101, The Chicago Sun-Times reports that **Howard Stern** may end up there, stating that agent **Don Buchwald** and representatives of Emmis met to discuss the possibility of moving Stern from crosstown AM **WJJD**. Q101 VP/GM **Chuck Hillier** says Stern is one of several options the station is exploring for mornings and stresses that discussions are in the "exploratory" phase. In another Stern item, The New York Daily News reports that the DJ is attracting an unlikely sponsor—the Republican Party. The GOP is airing recruitment ads for telephone fundraisers during Stern's show on **WJFK** Washington, D.C. The Republican National Committee's **Mary Crawford** says, "This was an experiment. I can't tell you whether anybody here was aware of what programs carried the ads."

More speculation from New York: Reports at press time have modern **WXRK** (K-Rock) New York finally making staff changes, with late-nighter **Maria Malito** the only classic rock staffer confirmed as staying. That's all that PD **Andre Gardner** will confirm. Also, much-watched country outlet **WYNY** New York reportedly will play its last country record sometime this weekend followed by a period of stunting (including **WRCX** Chicago's **Mancow Muller**?) before the unveiling of the real format, still rumored to be top 40/rhythm-crossover of some sort.

KEDJ (the Edge) Phoenix PD **John Clay** has resigned. He will remain on site until a replacement is found. The station also announced that crosstown **KUPD** GSM **Dana**

Beaudin has been named VP/sales for **KEDJ**. The move reunites Beaudin with **GM Reid Reker**, who worked with Beaudin at crosstown classic rocker **KSLX**.

SBR signs **KXPT** (the Point) Las Vegas, currently a conventional triple-A outlet, as a client. PD **Richard Reed** and MD **J.D. Davis** stay on, and no staff changes are planned.

Following Keymarket's LMA of modern **WXWX** Greenville, S.C., sources say **WXWX** will flip to an ABC oldies format within two weeks.

Trumper Communications names **Pat Reedy**, VP/GM of its Charlotte, N.C., stations **WTDR/WLYT**, to the same post at its triple-A **KUMT** (the Mountain) Salt Lake City and duopoly partner **AC KISN**. He replaces **Randy Rodgers**, who exits.

Classic rock **KGB** San Diego picks up a new morning show, hosted by **Jack Silver** and **Brian Whitman**, who were last heard on crosstown '70s outlet **KKBH** (the Beach), which Silver also programmed. They replace the **Dawn Patrol**, which went across the street to **KIOZ** (Rock 102) last year. **Denise Westwood**, who had been filling in since the Patrol's departure, stays on as morning news anchor. The morning show's 12-plus number went up in the fall book 2.8-3.4.

Journal Broadcast Group has closed on its purchase of classic rock **KKHG** (the Hog) and modern **KKND** (the End) Tucson, Ariz., from Apogree Radio. It says no changes are expected. Also, rock/modern combo **WBLM/WCYY** Portland, Maine, picks up a new duopoly partner, top 40 **WZPK**. There's no immediate LMA, so the station won't be the combo's until spring.

WHMP-FM Springfield, Mass., adds **Jill Monson** to middays, replacing former PD **Mike Dion**. . . **Dave O'Brian** is named PD of **WROV** Roanoke, Va., replacing **Ellen Flaherty**.

Album **KIBZ** Lincoln, Neb., names top 40 **KCGQ** Cape Girardeau, Mo., PD **Craig Michaels** production director of that station and sister modern **KKNB**. He replaces **Tim Kelly**, who is now at **KYYS** Kansas City.

Album **WZAT** Savannah, Ga., MD **Kevin Mitchell** adds APD stripes and moves from morning news anchor to p.m. drive. APD/evening jock **Dave Shephard** moves to crosstown **WIXV** for overnights.

Raymond Ciafardini is named GSM at album **WGRX** Baltimore. He replaces **Bob Petit**.

APD **Scott Struber** exits **91X** San Diego no replacement named at press time.

Former **KUKQ** Phoenix MD **Allison Strong** is named MD at adult modern **KAEP** Spokane, WA, replacing **Trip Rogers** who stays at the station as overnight personality.

Fueled By Heritage, Olympics, SLC Modern Race Heats Up

While X96 focuses on 18- to 34-year-olds, the End targets the 25-54 demo, Jones says. "We're not going to lead the way with Ruth Ruth, but we'll lead on Edwyn McCain. If you can hit a home run here with the 25-34 demo, you're going to drive 25-54 and 18-34 numbers.

"Alternative music is much more widely accepted in this market than the national norm," says Jones. "We're approaching this in a very focused way. I know the market really well, because this is where I started in radio. We've done our research. Now, it's just a matter of executing. Every market is different, and this one is certainly unique. It has a future for adult alternative."

Top 40 Q99, which recently brought in top 40 veteran Bill Stairs as its research consultant, has also leaned harder over the past few months and, musically, often bears more resemblance to the modern rock charts than to other modern-based top 40s. Q99 PD Brian Degeus sees himself as more 12-24 focused than his rivals, but he still sees his station as more hit-driven than X96.

"Obviously, the rotation we give records is a very top 40-type of rotation, where X96 is going to be on things a lot earlier—although for any market that doesn't have an alternative station, we're on records pretty early for a top 40 station, but that just goes with the territory of having a modern station in town. They'll break [songs], and we'll try to piece out the *crème de la crème*."

Then there's KUMT PD Zeb Norris, who insists that even with the End positioned between KUMT and X96, the battle will be "a dukefest" between the other three players. "I think the End may impact my ability to get 25- to 34-year-old women, but I'm not particularly focused on that target group anyway, because I'm in a duopoly with a hot AC station. I'm a classic-leaning triple-A and one of the least-alternative triple-A stations in the country, and I intend to keep it that way."

TIME FOR WINTER SPORTS

Salt Lake City is enjoying a boom cycle as it prepares to host the winter Olympics in 2002. The market's total billing has grown about 40% in the past five years. In addition to economic growth, Salt Lake City has been known for having a high birth rate, in part because of its large Mormon population, resulting in one of the lowest median ages in the country—something that probably led to its reputation as a haven for modern rock.

Jones, after leaving Salt Lake City in 1991, programmed KNNC Austin, Texas, and helped sign on SBR's KXPK (the Peak) Denver last year. On returning to the market, he noticed some changes, including an increase in freeway traffic, an indication of the area's growing population of refugees from the West Coast.

KUMT's Norris adds, "Economically, it can't be stopped. Unlike Albany, which has been going downhill for 100 years, this place has been booming for 100 years."

But is that growth great enough to permit three similar stations to survive in a top 50 market?

Summers says, "There's certainly room now for a station that has a calmer presentation and is maybe more gold-based. It was something my owners looked at a couple of years ago, but a sig-

nal wasn't really available."

But, he adds, "there's clearly not enough room for everybody. Business is good now, but the economy won't stay this good forever . . . I think [success] depends on who the operators are of the facilities and whether they're ready to spend the kind of money you need to compete in this market."

Q99's Degeus says, "They're all different types of alternative stations. All gearing for a different piece of pie. The End is really going to hunt X96 and possibly the Arrow station [KRSP-FM], because we're skewing much younger, and X96 has always done a lot better with that older audience."

"I don't think we're totally in the clear. I think we're going to lose a lot of cume to those people . . . because they have the novelty of being new. They also have the novelty of being part of the 12-year heritage of alternative radio in this town. They've got many of the same people who've been doing it for years and kind of set the standard, so they've got some name recognition right off the bat. As for us, we're doing the 12-24 thing. I'm going to lean very young at this point and . . . it's not going to be a huge 12-plus number, but we'll own 18-24 and teens."

Norris says, "Arriving here from Albany, I found the competition to be remarkably uncrowded, because there were 7½ rock stations [in that market]." Despite that, he says, "I don't see that the End has a hole to take advantage of. There's already two places where people have had a chance to be partisans of stations that play alternative music. What I think is going to happen is there are only so many alternative shares in the market, and they will battle to split them up differently. Whenever you have a station in a format come on, you tend to expand the listenership of that format, but there's only so far that could go."

"What I found interesting when I came to this market is that there was no heritage rocker that leaned 25-plus, although there was the Arrow, and there was no rock AC, which to me meant that there was a huge hole for me to be a mainstream adult station. If there is a hole for the End, it's the library stuff of the '80s."

STREET FIGHTER II

Even as the battle for listeners heats up, Jones and Summers insist that the battle for concert presents has remained civil. Says Jones, "I wouldn't anticipate any huge problems. The bottom line in any market is that you're going to have crossover airplay. We're not looking to butt heads. All we want to do is get our fair share and do the best job. This is not the station that's going to scream about presents."

Then again, Q99's Degeus notes, "the owner of X96 is the owner of United Concerts, so there's a big problem there . . . They get a lot of the artists. And I'm sure the End is going to run into this."

Not coincidentally, it's support from ownership that most of the PDs involved see as key to the competition. Norris says, echoing the sentiments of the other PDs, "This market will consolidate down, and there will be four or five key players that will survive. Anybody who's not part of that is going to get crushed."

ROCK GODZ

First There Is A Mountain: KMTT PD Chris Mays' Triple-A Adventure

Anyone trying to navigate the way through the delicate world of triple-A radio will eventually be pointed to Chris Mays, PD of KMTT (the Mountain) Seattle. While that station was off a half-share in the fall book (3.5-3.0), it is widely regarded as one of a handful of the format's success stories. On the air since 1991, the Mountain has evolved from rock AC to full-blown triple-A. And recently, KMTT recruited market vets Gary Crow and Mike West, making it one of the first triple-A stations with a personality-driven morning show.

Crow and West worked together at the late KXXR Seattle, and, at first, reaction to their joining the Mountain was mixed. "There were some fans who were really glad that we reunited them," says Mays, "and there were some traditional triple-A people who were somewhat appalled that we were actually talking between the

the radio station." Once the song became familiar, it found a place on the station.

Here's a sample noon hour of the Mountain: Steve Winwood, "The Finer Things"; Chris Isaak, "Graduation Day"; Natalie Merchant, "Jealousy"; Blues Traveler, "Run Around"; Tom Petty, "A Face In The Crowd"; Toad The Wet Sprocket, "Good Intentions"; Steely Dan, "Pretzel Logic"; Fury In The Slaughterhouse, "Every Generation Has Its Own Disease"; Sting, "Fortress Around Your Heart"; Fine Young Cannibals, "She Drives Me Crazy"; and INXS, "Beautiful Girl."

More often than not, the station has been early on songs by such artists as Chris Isaak, Sheryl Crow, and Hootie & the Blowfish. The latter were part of a morning show promotion in which the hosts, the band, and four listeners played a round of golf together. "And that's when they were opening for Toad The Wet Sprocket," Mays says.

That raises the question of the increasing number of artists that the format has had to share with other formats, including modern, mainstream rock, and the growing numbers of classic rock stations that add current music to their mix. How does that affect a format that once had an arsenal of exclusive acts?

"That aspect has been overplayed," says Mays. "One of the central problems of the format is how to build cume. One of the realities is that the music has to be cume-friendly [and] appeal to a wide variety of people. I don't find the fact that a lot of artists are crossing over to other radio stations to be troubling. I embrace it, that means we're on to something."

"You can differentiate your station by the spice elements and the secondary album tracks you play, [as well as] what you do between the records, how you position your station, and [how you] relate to adults—as adults, instead of young punks or screaming DJs . . . Triple-A probably suffers from being considered too music intensive, particularly in smaller markets. When radio owners get into this format with the vision that the music will support the format and the station will drive itself, that isn't true. That kind of attitude attracts PDs who are really MDs in disguise and who really just want to play the coolest music and whose job isn't necessarily to translate that into the most listeners."

The big issue facing the format, Mays says, "remains a cume question. We do pretty well as a format once we get [listeners] to the radio station [and] as far as time spent listening we tend to keep them for long time and they become loyal fans of the station. But finding ways to market the station, and to explain what the product is in a way that will convince get them to sample the station," is where the work needs to be done. Another challenge to triple-A is "not allowing the priorities of record labels or other formats to distract us from our core [audience]."

With so many triple-A stations becoming adult moderns, Mays says her decision not to go "rock alternative" was "really market-based, in that I think everyone needs to make a decision in their own market as to where the greatest area of opportunity for them lies, and for us, our strongest cell of opportunity has been 35- to 44-year-olds. The triple-A audience is a quality audience, and there's strong brand identification, and it's not very faddish. It's not people who change with the latest hairstyle. A lot of alternative product is more song-based rather than artist-based and tends to be somewhat faddish. In this case, we've made the decision to go for a slightly older target demo for which that music is a factor, but it's not the key ingredient."

records."

But so far, so good, according to Mays. "It's been an interesting project. It's something that hasn't been tried [by other triple-A stations]." The morning show has many features, including interactive spots like "Beat The Toaster," where listeners get a CD for every item they can name in a category before the "toast" pops up, and the self-explanatory "Rumor Or Fact." The show also has a music-driven "Select A Set" feature every morning for which listeners pick three song sets. "The show is really evolving in a positive direction, as far as hitting the lifestyle buttons of our audience," Mays says.

Outside of morning drive, the station's presentation is primarily music-driven, although Mays has added sweepers and production elements not usually heard on triple-As. Mays has also been outspoken when it comes to what triple-As need to do in order to become a permanent button on the dial. Her background not only includes progressive radio but AC as well. "There is a position for playing great music and attracting a large audience, but it does require discipline. It requires knowing who your core artists are and getting back to home base regularly."

That list of core artists includes Eric Clapton, Bonnie Raitt, Sting, R.E.M., Talking Heads, the Rolling Stones, and Tom Petty. For spice the station adds in Los Lobos, Shawn Colvin, Bruce Cockburn, Rikki Lee Jones, Richard Thompson, the Neville Brothers, and others. Those, along with such new acts as Joan Osborne and Blues Traveler, set the station apart from oldies, AC, and classic rockers competing for the 25-44 audience.

Mays calls her musical decisions "part research and science and part gut and intuition." For example, she waited for other stations in the market, including modern KNDD (the End), to break Live's "Selling The Drama," because at the time of its release, it "didn't fit the profile of

I remember going into a record store when I was a sixth grader and being slightly embarrassed by the clerk, who told me the proper title to the single I called "Talk This Way." At least in those days, chances were that my favorite song would be available as a single. How disappointing it must be, then, for the young rock fan today who hears a great song and sees the accompanying video only to find the single unavailable at the store. Where did all the singles go?

Although today's rock radio has become more hit-driven than ever before, many singles are still unavailable. It's not a blanket rule—witness the success of Oasis' "Wonderwall" on the Hot 100 Singles chart—but many modern rock airplay hits remain unavailable as singles and, consequently, ineligible for Billboard's singles chart. Included in that list are many or all of the hits by Live, Pearl Jam, the Dave Matthews Band, Green Day, and Alanis Morissette, although Reprise has finally issued the third single from Morissette's album commercially.

Recently, several much-sought-after Pearl Jam import singles have become available domestically. An occasional commercial single of this type, especially when there are extra tracks, is great for a group's fans, and it's too bad that labels don't see it this way. They see singles as a detriment to album sales, and they worry about a hit single's impact on an artist's credibility, overlooking the hipness among fans of unreleased songs, demos, and covers that could be included on a commercial single. There's no country more artist-image conscious than England, and yet British singles remain an honored tradition at home and highly valued to collectors here. Issuing more collectable singles would certainly be a worthwhile endeavor for domestic labels.

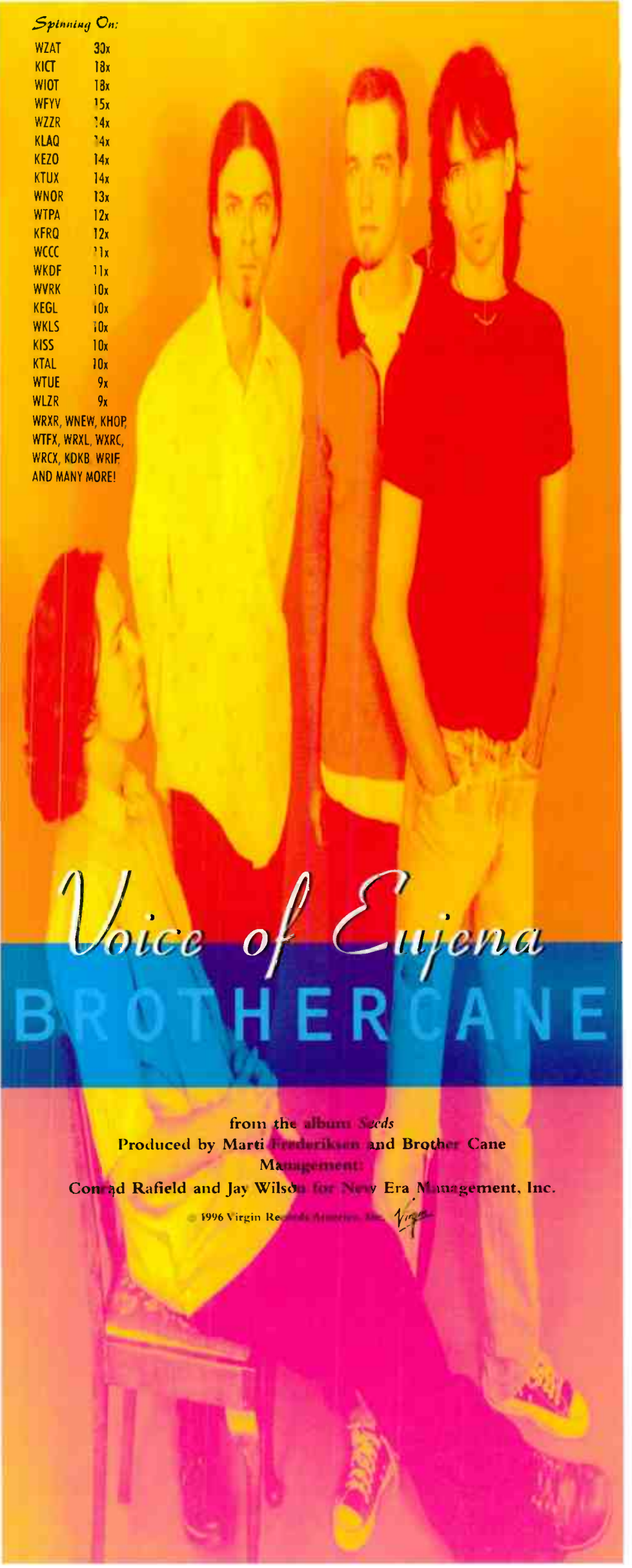

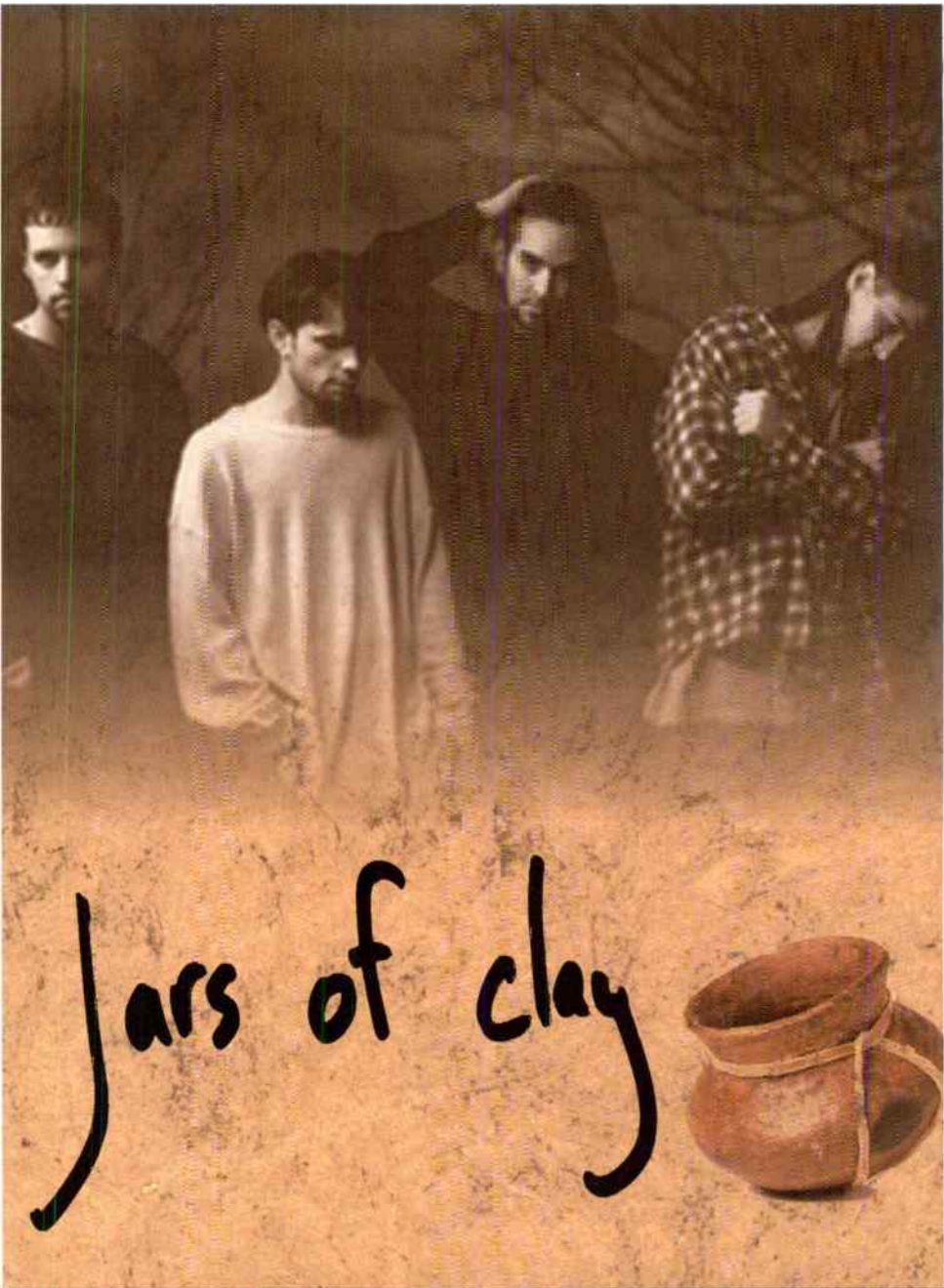
