What Would A Modern/Adult Chart Look Like? We Find Out

Modern/adult: It's definitely the flavor of the fortnight. But is it a format?

A lot of industrivites have asked that question. Airplay Monitor wondered, too. So we commissioned a special 40-position sample chart from Broadcast Data Systems this week, made up of the 14 monitored stations that best fit that description. (The first chart is on page 6; in subsequent weeks, it'll be available exclusively to online BDS subscribers. The stations used in the sample chart will continue to report to their current formats.) We found that, even with presentational and philosophical differences among stations, there's a surprising amount of consensus.

• Even as modern/adult defines its ground rules, there are already a lot more songs that its relatively small universe of stations can agree on than there are songs that mainstream top 40 or top 40 adult stations can agree on.

• Modern/adult stations are distinguished from top 40/adult and traditional modern stations more in terms of what they won't play than what they do play. While there are only one or two titles at most that can really be said to be indigenous to the modern/adult format—most songs have already developed a story at top 40, AC, modern, or all of the above—there are recent No. 1 records from the top 40 adult and modern rock side in which the new format shows little or no interest.

• In terms of the artists it plays, modern/adult stations usually look for artists who have credibility in the modern format, although there are exceptions. But in most other matters—especially the issue of when they play songs—modern/adult stations resemble top 40/adult stations more than their modern counterparts, with a higher correspondence to the former chart than the latter.

Dahl, Kevin And Bean Salute O.J.

Plans to bring **Howard Stern** back to mornings on **WCKG** Chicago "have not yet been finalized," reports *The Chicago Sun-Times*. However, **Steve Dahl** kicked off his new afternoon drive shift on **WCKG** by driving a white Ford Bronco ahead of a caravan of Illinois highway patrol officers and about "a 100 cars" down the Kennedy Expressway to the station's studios, according to GM **Mike Disney**. Disney says that the ersatz homage to **O.J. Simpson** "got a little crazy around our building" as Dahl arrived for his shift. Speaking of O.J., July 9 was his 45th birthday, so modern **KROQ** Los Angeles morning team **Kevin** and **Bean** sent him birthday cakes in the shape of **Nicole Brown Simpson** and **Ron Goldman's** heads. Show member **Lightning**, armed with a knife and bullhorn, drove to Simpson's home to deliver the gifts, leaving moments before police arrived to investigate.

After 30 years of country, Clear Channel's **KEBC** Oklahoma City flipped to modern July 8. The station, now known as **95X**, will continue to be programmed by **Mike McCoy**, PD of sister top 40 **KJYO**, and will be consulted by **Jacobs Media**. Whether MD **Jeff Scott** and the air staff will stay on has yet to be determined, according to GM **Miles Chandler**. The fate of crosstown **KNOR's** weekend modern programming was "up in the air," says weekend producer **Brian Howard**.

Modern **WIBF** Philadelphia is now officially **WDRE**, the former calls of **WLIR** Long Island, N.Y., which now officially takes those calls from its sister station at 98.5 FM, which flips to **WLRI**. Got all that? Meanwhile, back in Philly, assistant promotion director **Julie Smith** is upped to promotion director; weekender **Gil Edwards** takes the assistant promotion director post.

Talk **KLSX** (Real Radio) Los Angeles names talk **WTKS** (Real Radio) Orlando, Fla., PD **Jay Clark** to that post, replacing **Perry Simon**, who exits. GM **Bob Moore** says the station will continue in its current direction of talk during the week and modern rock on weekends. **Warren Williams**, who programs the station's music, adds creative director duties.

Modern **KTCL** Fort Collins, Colo., has shifted its music approach, becoming what PD **John Hayes** describes as "a little less hit-oriented, less familiar, but more rhythmic," creating what the station is touting on air as a "Hootie-free zone." Hayes calls it the "anti-consultant approach" to modern rock, digging deeper into the library and casting a wider net when considering currents. Album **WAAF** Boston promotion director **Therese Campanelli** joins **KTCL** for the same, replacing **Kate Innes**, who is set to fill the promotion director hole across the street at album **KBPI**.

Triple-A **WXKR** Toledo, Ohio, sees operations manager/promotion director **Trisha Wendel** resign to pursue interests outside of radio. **WXKR** intern **Laurie Kruse** becomes part-time air talent.

A pair of triple-A **WMAX** Rochester, N.Y., staffers have surfaced across the street at album **WCMF**. Marketing director **Lori Baister** assumes the same post at **WCMF**, and former **WMAX** PD **Rick MacKenzie** signs on for P/T and programming department duties. At **WMAX**, co-PD/morning man **Mike Rusinko** exits, replaced by classic rock **WZLX** Boston middayer/production director **Tom Sheridan**.

WPOR-AM-FM Portland, Maine, GM **Bob Gold** adds GM stripes for Saga's other Portland properties, now that Saga has completed its purchase of **WPOR**. Gold will now oversee classic hits **WMGX**, oldies **WYNZ**, and N/T outlets **WGAN/WZAN**. Those stations

had been without a GM since earlier this year.

Mainstream rock **WNXT** (the X) Portsmouth, Ohio, takes a more aggressive approach and names country **WLGC** Huntington, W.Va., staffer **Bubba Baxter** PD/a.m. driver. Middayer **Chris Hollis** moves to p.m. drive; engineer **L.D.** takes middays.

Country **WGAR** Cleveland GSM **Donna Gamblin** has accepted the same post over Louisville, Ky., stations classic rock **WRVI** and oldies **WRKA**. She'll expand those duties to include new acquisition, modern **WXNU**, when that deal closes.

One of Odyssey's L.A.-area trimulcast outlets, modern **KBAX** (Y107), has been granted the new calls **KSYX**. New call applications are pending on the remaining pair . . . Nearly two months after its musical shift to classic hits under the name the Planet, **KMKX** San Diego has been granted the new calls **KPLN**.

Osborn Communications picks up classic rock **WEGW** Wheeling, W.Va., adding to its complement of stations in the market that includes classic hits **WRIR**. Osborn's **Thomas Douglas** says there are no immediate plans for a format change at the station and expects most of the staff to stay on.

Liberty Radio II Inc., parent to album **WZNF**/top 40 **WQOB** Champaign, Ill., buys Z-Rock affiliate **WHZT**.

Howard Stern team member **Stuttering John Melendez** is now doing middays at modern **WXRK** New York. Crosstown **WHTZ** (Z100) overnights **Jeremy the Phone Guy** joins **WXRK** for swing.

Modern **WBCN** Boston taps modern **WDGE** (the Edge) Providence, R.I., a.m. driver **Nik Carter** for evenings beginning Aug. 11.

Longtime album **WMMR** Philadelphia veteran **Pierre Robert** was, at press time, off his morning shift pending resolution of contract negotiations. His last deal lapsed at the end of June.

Top 40/rhythm **CIDE** Toronto morning man **Jesse Dylan** returns to crosstown rocker **CILQ** (Q107), where he's reunited with **Gene Valaitis**.

With modern **WNFZ** Knoxville, Tenn., a.m. driver **Tom Miller** moving to sister country **WOKI**, **WNFZ** moves night jock **Lance McCluskey** to mornings and replaces him with crosstown University of Tennessee **WUTK** jock **Colonel Bacchus**.

Here's the new lineup for **WOXF** (the Fox) Manchester, N.H., which signed on with an eclectic adult rock format last week under PD **Keith Murray**, former APD/MD at AC **WSRS** Worcester, Mass., who will also hold MD/midday duties at **WOXF**. Here's the rest of the lineup: **Dorian Jaye** (last at classic rock **WNHI** Lake Winnepesaukee, N.H.) and **Laura James** (former album **WHDQ** Claremont, N.H., jock) in mornings; crosstown AC **WZID** production director **Katie MacGyver** in afternoons; AC **WLNH** Lake Winnepesaukee morning sidekick **Mike Hatch** in nights. Overnights are automated. Local entrepreneur **Donna MacNeil** is owner/president/GM. Replacing **Jave** as **WNHI** midday jock is former triple-A **WLYT** Boston PD **Frankie Foxx**.

Grant Stein takes on the APD/MD role at classic rock **CFPL** London, Ontario, from the MD post at crosstown album **CFHK**, where PD **Rob Mitchell** has assumed MD duties.

Jason Manning exits album **KQRS** Minneapolis/St. Paul, Minn.'s morning producer spot to replace **Hans Evans** in afternoons at album **KQDS** Duluth, Minn.

At classic rock **KNET** Lincoln, Neb., morning producer **Roger Morrison** will move to evenings.

Will Modern Grab The Next Big Thing?

I got sucked into an abyss known as broadcasting in the early '80s at my college station, **WNYU** New York. That was about the time that college radio was becoming influential in the real world. MTV had just signed on, and the one-two punch of MTV and college airplay was a good way for labels to expose bands ignored by mainstream radio.

Keep in mind that back then, album radio was having all kinds of identity problems, most having to do with either "tightening" up playlists or proving to advertisers that not all of its listeners were "dirtbags" and/or "earthdogs." That begat some truly scary corporate rock bands that kindly paved the way for college radio to have an audience. That led to commercial alternative stations popping up around the country and eventually this nutty thing we call modern rock.

Enough with the history lesson. The fact is

that college radio, compared to 10 years ago, is not even on the radar. While many college stations spin indie- or major-label leftovers whose production budget should have been used to feed the poor, they should still fill the role of devil's advocate for commercial radio.

However, much of the good music on college radio isn't crossing over to commercial modern. And with most modern stations filling or competing for the larger rock position in their markets, sooner or later, somebody's going to want the alternative position.

Are the bands that modern is ignoring the answer to cutting through the noise? These bands are quite different sonically from anything commercial modern is playing, and the more adventurous modern listener is already familiar with some of them. Will **Squirrel Nut Zippers**, **Bikini Kill**, **Reverend Horton Heat**, **Strapping Fieldhands**, or **Come** make some programmer look like a genius in the future?

Warner Bros. ups **Rob Goldklang** to the national manager of alternative promotion slot and **Julie Muncy** to the national manager of college promotion slot. Goldklang had been national college promotion manager at the label since '94. Muncy has been an assistant to VP of alternative promotion **Tom Biery** for the past year.

Capricorn names **Philip Walden Jr.** VP/GM based in Nashville. He'd been director of business affairs.

Columbia ups **Mark Ghunheim** to VP of online and emerging technologies. He'd been VP of video promotion.

Modern/Adult Session Set For Seminar

If this week's modern/adult test chart piques your interest about that format, you'll have a chance to discuss that and other industry hot topics at this year's Billboard/Airplay Monitor Radio Seminar and Awards, set for Sept. 5-7 at the New York Sheraton.

"Modern AC Vs. Triple-A" has the potential to be the most controversial of the rock panels this year. With both formats having only a handful of proven successes, is there enough audience to support either? And what effect will modern/adult have on traditional modern and AC stations?

Other rock sessions include "A Niche In Time: Modern Rock In Changing Times," at which the direction of the format will be discussed, now that most of its core music has become mainstream, and "Rock Of Ages: Album Rock Looking For Its Roots," which will explore how mainstream rock stations set themselves apart from splinter format competitors.

In all-format panels, this year's Monitor Seminar will follow-up last year's popular group-heads panel, "By Next Year One Of These Men Will Own Your Station," with "Group Heads: One Of These Men Owns Your Station." Last

year's session featured Evergreen's Scott Ginsburg, Group W/CBS' Dan Mason, and ARS' David Pearlman. This year's session will offer attendees another chance to hear from the radio execs who are aggressively buying stations across the country before you meet them at your next staff meeting.

Another session, "Four Stations, One PD. And A Telecom Bill: So Who's Listening To The Music?," will attempt to answer the question of what happens in this post-Telecom Act era of consolidation, in which one PD makes music decisions for multiple stations.

DAB, hard-drive automation, digital downloading of music, and the Internet will be among the subjects tackled at the session "Technology Isn't Just For Techno-Geeks Anymore." Find out how these high-profile technical issues will affect radio and its relationship with labels.

Another new session this year will be "The All-Format Market Leaders Panel," during which programmers of the leading stations in major markets will talk about the things they share in common that transcend format.

Returning this year will be the "Air Personality Supergroup" session, in which top-name jocks from all formats tell their best stories and discuss what it takes to be a successful entertainer today. Also returning is the popular "Music Trivia Contest And Game Show," in which Airplay Monitor editor Sean Ross plays Monty Hall with the music of your life and hands out prizes.

The seminar culminates with the annual Radio Awards ceremony Sept. 7. (See story, page 1.)

Why Store: Midwest Flourishes

According to the Why Store's Chris Shaffer, the heartland of America is finally getting its due from the industry. "Right now, the Midwest is flourishing. There's probably 10 acts right now that are going to be picked up in the near future. I'm really proud [they] are friends I've watched grow."

The Verve Pipe is one of the bands from the circuit to make the jump from a regional to a national forum. "We opened for them, and they helped us out in Michigan. Just when we were getting to help them out in Indiana, they got the big deal, before we did. They took off, then we got our deal. Hopefully, we'll work together again."

The Why Store have cultivated a respectable following along the way. The band's mailing list contains more than 7,500 "Whomheads," which, Shaffer explains, is a friend's term meaning "The Whomen belong to the What club for the Why Store, but they don't know why." The singer

adds that the devoted admirers are the band's "lifblood. They come out of the woodwork. It's crazy."

How has the band adapted to playing outside of its home area? "You go from headlining as top dogs, and now we're back at the bottom of the barrel again, opening up again. It's all part of the game, and we understand that. Now, we just work harder than ever. We've got to really put our noses to the grindstone," he says.

Shaffer says the "well-polished" sound of the band is the result of the proficiency of his bandmates. "I learn from them every single day. I'm like a sponge around them. I'm feeding off every lick Michael David Smith plays. [I tell him,] 'Oh man, show me how to do that,'" says Shaffer with a laugh.

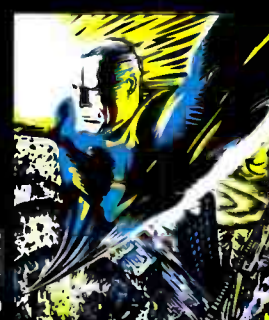

• Although the modern/adult format is, in many ways, the '90s equivalent of the '70s soft rock format, it isn't based as heavily in singer/songwriters as one might think. Female singer/songwriters who would have been comfortable on a '70s soft rock station, from Jewel to Jann Arden to Tracy Chapman to Natalie Merchant, are a major part of the format. But so are bands who broke through a more conventional modern rock route: Smashing Pumpkins, Foo Fighters, Oasis, etc.

At press time, there were 18 large- and medium-market stations that could reasonably be said to be modern/adult outlets. Those included stations that were taking a more top 40 or AC approach to the format, notably the much-copied KYSR (Star 98.7) Los Angeles and KFMB-FM (Star 100.7) San Diego, and those that operate as part of the modern rock community, specifically such "rock alternative" outlets as KXPX Denver and KAEP Spokane, Wash. What we felt all those stations had in common—even before looking at a chart—is that they chose primarily from modern's musical universe, that their target was older than a conventional modern station, and that they played much of the gold that had been excluded to special programming at most moderns.

Of the 18 stations now closest to the modern/adult format, 14 were available through BDS. For the purposes of our custom chart only, we took five moderns—KAEP, KXPX, WLIR Long Island, N.Y.; KZON Phoenix; and WWCD Columbus, Ohio—and four stations from the top 40/adult panel: KFMB, KYSR, WSHE Miami and WTMX Chicago. We also included KQPT Sacramento, Calif. (a triple-A reporter), WDIZ Orlando, Fla., and KRRK Omaha, Neb. (two stations that just switched from mainstream and modern, respectively), and two mainstream top 40 reporters, WTIC-FM Hartford, Conn., and KALC (Alice 106) Denver. BDS is working to monitor three of the format's remaining outlets—WPTF Norfolk, Va., KZZP Phoenix, and KRQR (Alice 97.3) San Francisco; the remaining one, KKNB Lincoln, Neb., is in a nonmonitored market.

Many of those stations may think of themselves as having little in common. But we found a surprising amount of consensus. Within the top 30 most-played titles, 10 songs, or one-third, are on all 14 stations. Another five are on 13 of the 14.

By comparison, only four songs ("You Learn," "Give Me One Reason," "Ironic," and "Who Will

Save Your Soul") were on all 82 mainstream top 40s for a comparable period. Only "Give Me One Reason" is on all 47 top 40/adult reporters.

What don't modern/adult stations play? They differ from top 40/adult panelists by not playing that chart's current hits by Celine Dion, Tony Rich, the Fugees, George Michael, Robert Miles, or Los Del Rio, some of which made it onto one or two of the stations on our custom panel, but none of which were in modern/adult's 40 most-played songs. They differ greatly from conventional modern. On the June 28 modern chart, at least six of the top 10 were cuts that didn't make the modern/adult chart, songs from the Butthole Surfers, Stone Temple Pilots, No Doubt, Soundgarden, Tracy Bonham, Garbage, and Porno For Pyros that are either too hard or new for many modern/adult outlets. By having sat out, in most cases, "Because You Loved Me" and, so far, "Pepper," modern/adult stations have passed on songs that were No. 1 in top 40/adult and modern.

But modern/adult stations will occasionally make exceptions for nonmodern-image artists that moderns cannot. Eric Clapton's "Change The World" is a top 10 modern/adult song with airplay on about 60% of our custom panel. Jann Arden's "Insensitive" is top 15. Donna Lewis' "I Love You Always Forever" cracks the top 40 this week.

Modern/adult stations tend not to play cuts that haven't already broken on other formats. The closest thing to an indigenous modern/adult cut is Radiohead's "High And Dry," which received airplay at top 40 and modern but never became a "Run-Around" or "1979" in either. Another possible exception is Why Store's "Lack Of Water," which charts here largely, but not exclusively, on the strength of modern and triple-A airplay.

The chart you see below covers June 25-July 1, a time frame roughly comparable with the charts in last week's Airplay Monitors. If you want to see what the chart will look like this week, it's available to BDS subscribers who call up the "charts" menu, then select the "adult modern" chart. (Call 800-688-4634 for info on subscribing to BDS.)

At present, we're making this chart available in this issue and via BDS as a service to the industry. With the jury out on whether modern/adult is an enduring format, we won't make this a regular Monitor chart, yet. Call Monitor's Sean Ross (212-536-5264) or BDS' Heston Hosten (212-789-1261) with comments and suggestions.

ROCK GODZ

PD Chris Baker Caps Off KATT's Two Decades With Double-Digit Share

When Chris Baker joined Oklahoma City album KATT in 1993, a friend of his cautioned, "You're the PD of the KATT. Don't fuck it up!"

Clearly, Baker was signing with a station renowned throughout the country as well as in the market. Baker says, "I've never worked at a station where you can go to anybody in [the market] and say 'the KATT' and they know what it is or had fans tattoo your logo on their body. My first weekend at church I was introducing myself, and one of the first things this old man said to me—and he had to be in his 70s—was 'rock'n'roll!'"

Judging by its winter '96 12-plus numbers, Baker's friend had nothing to worry about. The KATT was up 8.4-10.3, for its first No. 1 berth since the Pat Welch days of the late-'80s, says Baker.

Baker had "been an admirer of the station for years. And one of the things that always stuck in my mind was that the KATT is a rock radio station." Initially, Baker says, when he heard

Dream Theater's "Pull Me Under" and other harder tracks in mornings, he chalked it up to that rock stationality. Eventually, however, Baker came to feel such cuts were "just way too hard for us to be playing" at that point in the day.

Now, Baker points out, "dayparting is such a heavy key of everything," as KATT draws from a wide range of genres to be what Baker calls "a more current, intense-sounding [album rocker]." While Baker is enthusiastic about currents from Spacehog or Bush, he believes "there's a lot of good records out there that still deserve airplay, like Jimi Hendrix, Pink Floyd, or Led Zeppelin."

Here's a sample 3 p.m. hour on KATT: Pink Floyd, "Another Brick In The Wall, Part 2"; Silverchair, "Tomorrow"; Led Zeppelin, "Traveling Riverside Blues"; Collective Soul, "December"; Spacehog, "In The Meantime"; Don Felder, "Heavy Metal"; Bush, "Machinehead"; Smashing Pumpkins, "Disarm"; Head East, "Never Been Any Reason"; Nixons, "Wire"; and Aerosmith, "Deuces Are Wild."

"The one thing the KATT has that people can't copy is ... the humor we have with our radio station and our talent," says Baker. "Rick & Brad" in the morning and Slammin' Sam or Jake Daniels. These guys just can't be duplicated. They're just great talent." Night jock Greg Zooback leads the station's talent with a 29.3 share (up from 18.5) for 18-34 men.

"There's just so much more between the records," adds Baker, "like our Bricktown studio and our Twentyfest museum, that keep the radio station exciting."

Twentyfest is the name given to a yearlong slate of events celebrating KATT's 20th anniversary, from free concerts to the give-away of a reconditioned '76 Corvette. Central to the celebration is the Twentyfest museum, a combina-

tion Smithsonian of rock and weekly remote broadcast site. It is based in a storefront at a local mall and filled with KATT and rock memorabilia from the collections of the station and its audience. Baker was floored by the impact KATT has had throughout the years, down to the number of "high school yearbooks [that] have the officially licensed KATT logo."

Maintaining a satellite studio in the Bricktown historical/restaurant district of Oklahoma City is another way KATT extends its presence. The studio has served as site for a "Rockline" installment featuring the Nixons and is consistently used for remotes on weekends and holidays and for special events.

"Rockline" prompted the station to install fold-away bleachers in the Bricktown studios. Baker says, "When we have bands come in, we invite people to be a part of the studio audience."

"Collective Soul was the first to come in," Baker adds. But the KATT twist on in-studio artist visits is growing. Baker recalls, "We've had Seven Mary Three [in] and they were getting off on the crowd being around."

Alice In Chains' Jerry Cantrell was one of those touched by the station in the past two decades. Baker says that Cantrell "grew up south of Oklahoma City listening to the KATT. We met him out in L.A., and he was so excited about meeting folks from the KATT that he gave us some stuff to put in our museum."

Baker gave him an open invitation to guest in Bricktown. When Cantrell took him up on the offer, Baker says the musician "sat in there for an hour and a half, singing a bunch of old Hank Williams songs. It was the coolest thing!"

The next chapter for the Bricktown branch is installing an ISDN line and 36-track studio to create an environment for bands to come in and play live on the air for the KATT, networks, and other stations. The key to this venture, says Baker, is the location. "They call us the crossroads of America. Wherever bands are going, odds are they're going to pass through here."

Among those whom Baker credits with the station's success in the past 20 years is GM Larry Bastida, "the kind of GM who's not afraid to let you learn by making a few mistakes. His door is open all the time, and he's not one of those guys you have to worry about coming in and dropping some bad news, because he doesn't kill the messenger. He's the king. That's what we call him around the station, because he treats people so good, and he takes care of our employees. That's why we don't have any turnover. That's why everybody comes to the KATT and they stay."

Production director Mark McCuen provides the creative extension to Baker's vision. "I can just tell [him], 'Here's what I'm thinking,'" Baker says, "and he comes back with a masterpiece. He can read my mind. But what's scary is he usually makes it sound a lot better and throws things in there that I'd never think about."

Baker had been anticipating that Clear Channel would flip one of its stations to modern, which it did with KEBC this week. Baker says KATT's proactive stance "goes a lot further than the music." He praises promotion director Don Miner as "really plugged into the 18-24 male, which I see as the primary target of a young [modern] station. He battles it out in the street, [doing] a lot of things to market the radio station with that lifestyle in mind."

Baker feels that KEBC "is not offering anything musically 'alternative' that is not being played currently in the market. They are playing songs shared on KJ-103 [KJYO, Clear Channel's] own station, [KYIS] Kiss 98.9, and the KATT." **MARC SCHIFFMAN**
