Modern's Losses: Market-Specific Changes Or Return To Niche Status?

In recent weeks, Airplay Monitor's modern rock panel has weathered another round of defections, including WAQZ Cincinnati, KPOI Honolulu, and KICT Wichita, Kan., something that led one record exec to quip, "My prediction is that 20 stations will flip by the end of the year. We've only got 13 more to go." The M Street Journal's most recent national format tally shows commercial modern rock stations down to 144 from 150 in July 1997 (although up from 142 this June). And spring's national Arbitron numbers show the format off 4.0-3.8 12-plus after several years in the fours.

When Monitor last addressed the issue of modern defections in February 1997, the handful of moderns leaving the format for active rock was balanced by a number of actives going modern. At that point, many of the issues revolved around music at a time when the formats were sharing a large number of artists and the lines between formats were blurry. Those lines are much clearer these days, but modern PDs now find themselves facing similar issues with their modern adult rivals. (Add stations like KTBZ Houston and KORB Davenport, Iowa, that now

live on the cusp of modern adult, and the list of refugees is even longer.)

Despite these developments, modern rock proponents say that they're generally unconcerned by the recent shifts, attributing them more to market conditions than the overall health of the format. Few see modern rock radio as being in danger of becoming what it was before 1992: a format of 1- to 3-share niche outlets. And many continue to emphasize the need to win through imaging and morning-show strength, given the amount of music now shared with other formats.

"I'm not worried," says Hybrid Recordings promotion director Kalun Lee. "The format is still healthy and viable. Certain stations in certain competitive situations weren't competing well." Lee also notes that in a world with heavy musical sharing, "I'm going to listen to the radio station that has the morning show I want to hear and the street profile. I'm not going to search out the alternative station to listen to Third Eye Blind."

"Is the format over?" asks modern WMRQ Hartford, Conn., PD Jay Beau Jones. "Not as we see it. But it is not the format du jour to be in if

MONITOR PROFILE

CBS Columbus VP/GM Dave Robbins Returns To A Familiar Battleground

It's the stuff of classic drama: Dave Robbins, one of top 40's most renowned programmer-turned-GMs, sees his longtime home, heritage top 40 WNCI, country WCOL, and N/T WFII Columbus, Ohio, acquired by Jacor. Instead of staying with his new owner, Robbins crosses the street to be VP/GM of CBS' triumvirate of country WHOK, heritage rock WLWQ, and active rock WAZU. After years of piloting market leaders, he's now at the No. 7, No. 8, and No. 22 stations.

As the new CBS GM draws up what are, literally, battle plans, frequently expressed in military terms, Robbins says he bears no grudges against Jacor, noting that CEO Randy Michaels tried to find him a suitable position somewhere in the company. "They really wanted me to stay as a GM with a market manager title," he says. "The timing wasn't right. It was my decision to leave, but Randy, Bobby Lawrence, Dave Crowl, and John Hogan went out of their way for me, and I appreciate what they did."

Although he and his wife, Patti, considered working in other markets, Robbins says their preference was to stay in Columbus. "There is so much opportunity here," he says. "I really love the CBS style. Don Bouloukos, our market COO, and Dan Mason are both masters at broadcasting. I have a lot to learn from both of them, and it's exciting to get that chance."

Robbins, who just named former WRNO New Orleans PD Charley Lake PD of WLWQ and WAZU, is currently assessing the three stations' personnel. "The No. 1 thing to assess is your team's desire to win," Robbins states. "If it's there, you'll always find a way to make it happen. We want people who totally thrive on challenge and who have a low tolerance for stability. I want people who willingly steer into stormy waters, looking to be tested."

He asserts that any format changes will be made with the staff's input. "If you can't trust your people, it's because they can't trust you. Our staff hears it all, sees all the research, and participates in major decisions. That's the nature of our management style and why it's so radically different from 'conventional' radio. Those who appreciate that style and the empowerment that comes with it will keep secrets. Those who don't will quickly identify themselves. Distrust breeds distrust, but trust breeds trust. I only know one way to build a legendary team: trust, side by side under fire."

In the recently released spring Arbitron, WLWQ was off 5.9-4.8 12-plus, trailing rival WBZZ's 5.3-5.4. WHOK was off 4.3-4.0 vs. WCOL's 6.2-7.7 rebound. And WAZU was down 1.2-1.1. While one would expect WAZU to be at least a likely candidate for a format flip, Robbins, at press time, denied that he's even contemplating one.

"We're lucky here," he says. "Since we've been in this market for years, we know all

the players, the signals, their strengths and weaknesses. Most important, after years of dropping flares out there, we know the people. So, while it's a given on what we'll do, it's now just about fielding the plan.

"We believe that anyone with a signal is our competition. It is our belief that you should always overestimate the competition in multiples of three. If you're talking about Jacor and WNCI/WCOL, rule one is you never attack strength, you attack weakness. WNCI and WCOL have been built by us to be impenetrable. Don't look for us to attack strong stations like those two."

Robbins cites a classic military-style campaign for the Columbus radio war: "We use and apply the Carl von Clausewitz strategies. You make the competition come to you, so they arrive on the battlefield first, looking for you, or, better yet, convince them to attack you, using their strength and supplies in the process. You allow them to extend the supply line. Then you ambush them at the 'angle.' Every day presents multiple localized battles around sales, image, promotion, etc. Competitively speaking, each day presents many wonderful opportunities to engage the competition, whoever that might be at that moment."

At WNCI, Robbins could use the station's massive cume to smite his format competition, often co-opting rivals' promotions on the theory that the most-listened-to station got credit for them anyway. So what happens when your opponents have the cume advantage? "Bad cume, like a bad infection, is a temporary condition and has a specific cure," he responds, adding that any personal feelings about going up against former peers have little use in the imminent battle.

"Personal feelings indicate emotion, and in time of competitive operations, emotion is useful in your initial charge," he says. "If you make strategic decisions in the heat of battle with emotions, you will pay the price for doing so. Emotion is a tool to be used in an engagement when necessary. The master is never attacked, only invited to dance."

Although he may lack WNCI's ratings, Robbins is backed up by the corporate power of CBS, which has changed the way the game is played. "The most exciting thing to me about consolidation is that there is almost no other way to look at your position other than strategically," he notes. "I come from a background of strategic station positioning, so, yes, it's a critical part of the way we'll do business here."

"The CBS group creates that synergy. It's awesome. I love being back with the biggest broadcasting company in America. There is so much potential with this group that it's scary. I love the firepower associated with such an awesome organization."

Despite all the personnel turnover emanating from corporate transitions, Robbins insists that there is still a place for loyalty in radio. "Loyalty is all there is. No team in history has ever won anything long term without undying loyalty for the leader and the associated cause. When people believe in the cause and have a dynamic leader, they will fight to the death, regardless of how often the leader, the team, or the cause is attacked. With loyalty, the incoming attacks only strengthen the resolve of the team to emerge victorious. Put your team in that mental condition, and they cannot or will not be defeated. There's no turning back."

His ultimate goal for CBS' Columbus triumvirate? "To be No. 1 in revenue, ratings, and cash flow," Robbins states. "If you set your goals any lower, you sabotage your cause."

you don't have clear-cut images and maybe a growing morning show."

WEDG Buffalo, N.Y., PD Rich Wall is one of the few who even acknowledges a change in the format's overall fortunes. "It's cyclical. There's an ebb and flow to every format," he says. Wall notes that if a station's niche "is not very clear and your management isn't supportive of what you're doing, people will question the format that you're under. You have to have the right people doing it and the right support. You have to be able to sell the format as much as get ratings. That's not always the easiest to attain."

Capitol modern rock promotion director Brian Corona says, "There's still a healthy amount of radio stations, but also you've got to raise an eyebrow." During a recent road trip, he heard this issue voiced numerous times. "The numbers are OK, but sometimes the sales staff can't sell it . . . No one has the patience to build up things. That's our biggest problem in general."

And one format veteran lays the blame on ownership that won't put resources into their properties, claiming that the recent defectors were operated on the cheap. "If there's no commitment on a morning-show level or on a marketing level, of course there's going to be loser stations."

In contrast, that observer continues, "I would be more concerned when markets like Seattle, St. Louis, Pittsburgh, L.A., and San Diego bail out of the format . . . It's not necessarily the market size but commitment to the property that makes them winners."

SURVIVAL TIPS

Consultant Tom Barnes says, "These departures are the yield of seeds sown years ago. As was so easily predicted, the music has diffused, or fragmented, if you prefer, across other formats, into older demos, and has become less special. Stations that have exclusive, compelling gold, and images outside of music will continue to thrive. Those that don't, won't."

Modern KDGE Dallas PD Duane Doherty agrees. "Of great concern" to him is "artist ownership." Exclusive artists, he says, are "few and far between . . . Right now, Tori Amos is a great example of that. How long that will be the case, I don't know, but I think you have to take the ball and run. We'll take anything we can own . . . Anything to set you apart from the competition."

Modern WXRK New York PD Steve Kingston calls the current climate for modern a musical recession. The challenge he sees is for programmers to maintain the franchise long enough for the musical tide to turn and then capitalize on the franchise again when the music can support it. Kingston's previous station, top 40 rival WHTZ (Z100), made a similar move, leaning heavily alternative during top 40's format doldrums.

WXRK has been gaining a lot of attention for its recent addition of acts like Guns N' Roses and AC/DC to its library. "A lot of PDs will have to get outside the box and face some of their deepest, darkest fears. Don't worry about how you report and how you're labeled. Today Led Zeppelin is alternative in New York because nobody is playing Led Zeppelin and 17-year-old boys are out buying vinyl on the band at used record stores."

WEDG's Wall adds, "Led Zeppelin would be Jane's Addiction if they came out today. You can call it active rock. You can call it hard rock, heavy metal. The point is, there will always be an appetite for guitar-based pop music. It doesn't matter what you call your format [or] whether you switch your Live deep track for Aerosmith. In the end it's whether you're playing your best songs . . . Before the format came together, you didn't say, 'What a great alternative song.' You said, 'What a great song.'"

IMAGE IS EVERYTHING?

"The reason you may be losing these stations," says WMRQ's Jones, "is because those stations are not clearly defined as the alternative station to the audience. They're not clearly defined to the audience as relevant, based on

heritage, marketing, morning show. A lot of these stations were so new, they didn't have enough time planting roots."

Adds KCXX San Bernardino, Calif., PD Dwight Arnold, "There are too many lame, cookie-cutter stations as it is."

While Jones predicts problems for stations "not winning the alternative station or cool station images," and Hybrid's Lee stresses that "music isn't the main reason why people listen to the radio," at least one programmer dissects.

"There are too many alternative radio stations in the country that are focused on being hip and not focused on playing hits," says modern XETRA-FM (91X) San Diego PD Bryan Schock.

"If this format wants to thrive and survive, there's got to be a marriage between maintaining enough of your hip edge but still playing hit music. It's worked for this radio station, which went from a 2.3-3.7 in two books strictly on playing hit music," he continues. "The masses want the hits," and, he adds, if you don't have the masses, you will not have the money to remain in business.

KPOI'S POSITION

KPOI PD Brock Whaley says music and market concerns triggered his change to active. "A year ago, we didn't have a pop CHR," he says. "We had Alanis Morissette and matchbox 20 all to ourselves. MD Nikki Basque and I used to kid that our slogan should be 'From Tool to Jewel.' [But] even then it was tough to crack a 5 share. The niche in our case is too small."

And even a year ago, the library at KPOI started getting an injection of Aerosmith. "We always did have a real guitar base," says Whaley. And the market exclusivity the station had then with Morissette and matchbox 20 it can now find in active acts. "Let's face it, no one else in town is going to touch Creed," he says. "It's much easier to focus now that I have a niche."

He advises any modern programmer to look at the back of the book and see which station you're sharing the most with, predicting it will be the modern adult. "The problem that we're having now is being picked off by modern ACs. If the music gets more rocky, then the modern ACs are going to be in trouble. A lot of what was originally prognosticated about the modern ACs has come true. The alternatives that leaned on the '80s library got picked off."

A FUTURE OF 3 SHARES?

So, does modern rock have to get used to being a 3-share format again? "God, I hope that's not true," says KDGE's Doherty. He sees the current mission for a modern programmer as setting the station apart from the market. "If artist ownership is going to be a problem, then [KDGE must succeed] through marketing, promotion, and other foundations of the radio station."

"My feeling is that this station can continue to grow," says 91X's Schock. "It's a matter of where are these people focusing their energies. Are they just blowing off the average Joe? Here's my test. Walk into a mall, look around, and tell me how many real hip people you can spot. Is that who you're aimed at? Because if it is, you're casting your fate. You've got to have some regular Joes listening to the station."

But WXRK's Kingston says modern rock's heyday of boxcar numbers, when the station appealed across gender and demographic lines, are over. "You've got to choose where you want to go and superserve that segment of the audience," he says. "Especially with the landscape changing and the influx of modern ACs. No one's going to make their numbers being someone's second choice. We chose to obsess over men, and that's why we're rocking."

"If it doesn't compete in morning drive and find brand benefits beyond being current-driven—yes [modern will be a 3-share format]," says Barnes. "Modern rock will be forced to execute better across all programming disciplines, or its world will be divided among modern AC, CHR, and active rock."

Orgy Thrives On 'Backward Chaos'

Guitarist Amir Derakh may have inadvertently summed up the Orgy ethos when asked what to expect live from the L.A. quintet with the '80s-goth-meets-'90s-cutting-edge sound and glam-boy looks. "We really do things by the seat of our pants, from every aspect of the way we look and record," he says. "We like to keep it fresh and right on the spot and try to come up with things as we're going along. That could change from what I say today to tomorrow. It sounds ridiculous, but that's the way everything sort of works in our band; it just seems to work for us like some sort of backward chaos."

Orgy was signed last September, having been together a mere six months and never having played a gig together. In the group's favor, however, was the band members' familiarity with one another from club gigs and experience in the business. Singer Jay Gordon is a producer, Derakh is an engineer, and a couple of the bandmates, including Derakh, were part of major-label bands in the '80s.

Orgy's debut set, "Candyass," is the first release from Elementree, Korn's new Reprise-distributed label. Gordon and Korn counterpart Jonathan Davis were in a band called Sex Art prior to being their major-label signings and even wrote Korn's "Blind" together (Davis returned the favor by co-writing an Orgy track, "Revival"). Additionally, Orgy will be the opening act on the Korn-led Family Values arena tour, which includes Ice Cube, Rammstein, and Limp Bizkit and begins next month.



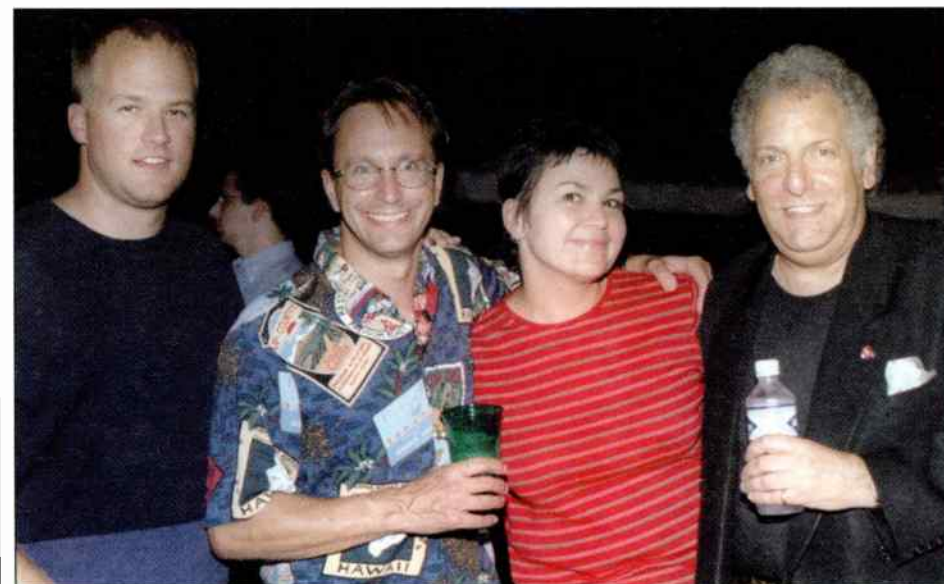
Orgy: Bobby Hewitt, Paige Haley, Jay Gordon, Amir Derakh, and Ryan Shuck

Despite the technical acumen shared by Derakh and Gordon—they knob-twiddled for the likes of Coal Chamber, eels, and new Roadrunner signing Spine Shank—Orgy produced the album in conjunction with friend Josh Abraham and enlisted former Skinny Puppy member and celebrated remixer (Nine Inch Nails) David Ogilvie to mix. Derakh says he wanted the outside input. "It's just hard for me to play guitar and be objective about what I'm doing . . . I like to have someone to bounce off [of], because we're treading into new territory."

New territory in the sense that, of all the genres to be revisited in the '90s, goth and club music from the '80s have been virtually ignored. Orgy freely cops to a fancy for those days of yore, when dance music and metal clubs reigned. What's so funny about New Order (whose "Blue Monday" is covered on the album) and Dead Or Alive and Judas Priest and Ratt, all cited influences on the band? Derakh believes that '80s music has more staying power than it's given credit for. "It's actually very surprising how much the younger generation is into the '80s—and not only metal and goth. Especially after going to the Bauhaus reunion show in L.A. and seeing all the people who were there," says the former club DJ. "Good music doesn't go away; it just continues through cycles to other generations. I think we incorporate a lot of that style and sound into what we do because it's something that we love and definitely a part of what we wanted to be. Maybe reintroducing that to people again in a new and fresh way is sort of what we're trying to do."

Orgy hasn't yet contemplated its own show on the Family Values tour, which is touting big-time, value-added presentation as its lure. But working without a net hasn't hurt the band, and perhaps the tour offers a built-in amenity that none of the other summer tours do. "It's indoors, which is much more appealing to us because we prefer to play in the dark. We don't want to play in the sunlight unless we have to." That's a serious consideration for a band that, today, wears possibly more makeup than anybody. But if you believe Derakh, even that could change tomorrow.

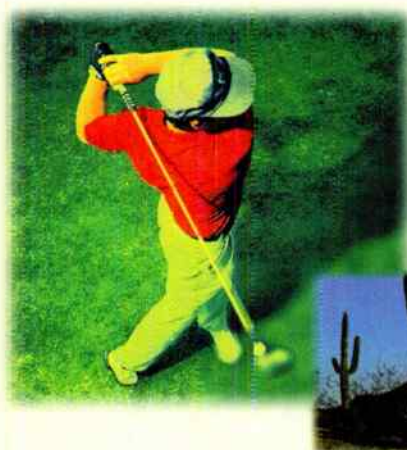
