## 'Regional Breakout' Shows Signs Of Life, But Consultants, Networking Still Key

Long forgotten as a way of spreading a record, the "regional breakout" is again showing signs of life. While it may not be as common for a record to spread through a series of top 40s in adjacent markets as through a handful of networking PDs, or through stations with a common consultant, there are nevertheless several cases of records spreading regionally over the past year.

Until the early '80s, it was common for records to spread regionally, particularly across the South. Warner Bros. VP of promotion Barney Kilpatrick worked at WTTX New Orleans and recalls the sto-

ry of then-PD Bob Mitchell, who was always particularly aggressive musically, calling other PDs in the region to enlist their support for Roberta Flack's "The First Time Ever I Saw Your Face" after seeing it featured in "Play Misty For Me." "To this day, he has a giant trophy in his office that Roberta sent him," he says.

With a few exceptions, most notably West Coast rhythm-crossover outlets, regional successes have been rare over the past decade for several reasons. The advent of MTV meant that much of the country became aware of records at the same time. And the promotion mentality of the '80s emphasized tonnage—

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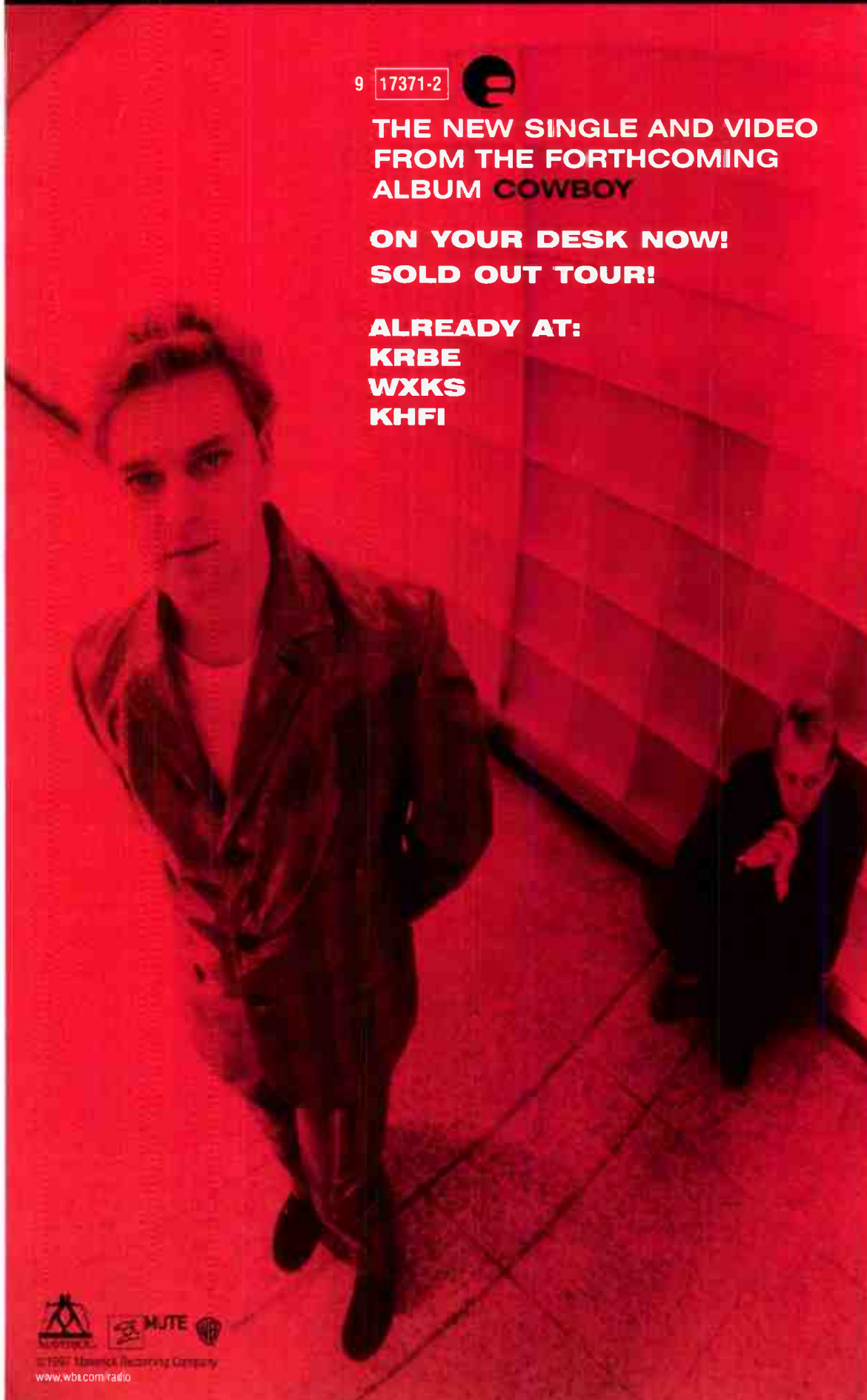

**WFHN** (Fun 107) New Bedford, Mass., GM **Steven Bogue** exits radio.

**KIOI** (K101) San Francisco PD **Casey Keating** exits after one year to start his own voice-over, production, and consulting company, Keating Media Services. Clients include **K101**, **KVI** Seattle, and others.

**KLYV** Dubuque, Iowa, PD/p.m. driver **Andrew Zepeda** exits for mornings/APD at **WKSZ** Green Bay, Wis. Former **KLYV** PD **Scott Thomas** moves from nights to afternoons.

After less than a month in the house, PD **Vince Garcia** is steering modern AC **KMGQ** (Magic 106) Santa Barbara, Calif., toward adult top 40.

Mainstream top 40 **WAOA** Melbourne, Fla., is now leaning decidedly closer to hot AC.

Longtime hot AC **KRLB** Lubbock, Texas, becomes classic rock **KCRM**.

#### PEOPLE: LAWSON CROSSES HALL

**KALC** (Alice 106) Denver APD **Jim Lawson** crosses the hall for the same duties at sister AC **KIMN**. Alice midday jock **Mary "Cha Cha" Chavez** is upped to MD.

Rhythmic AC **KIBB** (once B100.3, now just plain B100) Los Angeles hires **Wayne Lewis** as morning-show producer from crosstown oldies **KRTH** (K-Earth), replacing **Mike Danger**, who returns to college. **Rick Hummer** moves up from P/T to the night shift, replacing **Jammin' Jeff Scott**, who moves from nights to overnights, as **Tom Banda** becomes producer of **Chaka Khan's** late night show, "Romance After Hours."

Taking his first step in rebuilding Q106's air staff, new **KKLQ** San Diego PD **Mark Todd** rehires **Karen K.** from crosstown **XHRM** (the Flash) for an air shift to be determined.

### Country Evolves; Top 40 Gets Happy

**G**REETINGS FROM MUSIC ROW: With top 40 again moving forward nicely and country having been the subject of the same sort of doom and gloom articles as top 40 did for the last seven years, you might wonder why I'm filing this dispatch from the Country Radio Seminar. One would think with top 40 having found acoustic-based singer/songwriters who fill the same need that country did in the early '90s (real instruments, lyrics you can understand, etc.), we could all move on. As the lack of country-to-top 40 crossover suggests, most top 40 PDs have always regarded country as being "over there." And now that top 40 PDs don't have to take country jobs as jobs are again available in their own format, that perceived distance is likely to increase.

But the most recent Billboard/Airplay Monitor national Arbitron numbers show that country (like AC and R&B) still has a larger audience share in top 40, even in the top 100 markets. And there are some things taking place in country now that you should know about.

One is that after several years without a lot of acts to ignite 12-24 listening, save **Shania Twain**, country has several, and those have the CD sales to prove it. One is **Deana Carter**, whose breakthrough hit last fall, "Strawberry Wine," had an adult loss-of-virginity lyric but also spoke to teens in the same way that **Trisha Yearwood's** "She's In Love With The Boy" did in the early '90s.

Another is **LeAnn Rimes**, who, nearly a year after "Blue's" shock success, with a No. 1 set and another in the top 10, has proved to be at least more than a novelty one-shot. There's still a

certain amount of hostility toward Rimes—the Grammy press room groaned audibly when her best new artist win over **No Doubt**, **Jewel**, et al., was announced. It's also not fair to expect a 14-year-old to have an *oeuvre* and vision for the format in the way that **Garth Brooks** did, but Rimes is still creating excitement, and it's a good thing for top 40 that, for once, she's not doing so at a time when top 40 has no image artists of its own.

For top 40 the implications of the other major development in country are less clear, but it's still worth noting that after decades of stubbornly resisting fragmentation, there are finally signs—albeit subtle ones—that country might finally be recognizing that one size doesn't fit all for country listeners. Country gold, which was never able to establish much of a foothold during the era when even 60-year-olds liked "Achy Breaky Heart"—has now been embraced by several major group owners as well as a second satellite network. To the left of center, there's now considerable national publicity around progressive country, although there are fewer signs of it finding a quorum among owners, at least so far.

Over the last three years, the reaction of most country PDs and owners to the realization that upper demos were starting to feel burned out on all the new rock-leaning acts in country has been to put more of the format's '80s/early '90s oldies back in. That had the helpful (to top 40) effect of chasing most 12-24s away just in time for them to rediscover top 40, or at least modern. If older gold becomes the keystone of another format, instead of mainstream country, that would free up mainstream country to compete head-for-head

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## BARNESTORMING BY KEN BARNES

### The 1996 New-Artist Honor Rolls

**L**ast column, all I had room for were general observations and stats on the number of new acts broken or crossed to new formats in '96. This time, the focus is on the acts themselves, the formats where they broke, and the labels that broke them (sounds like a tagline for the next "Oprah").

**JANUARY:** Top 40/rhythm led the way, as the **Barrio Boyz** (EMI), **Click** (Jive), **Denine** (Metropolitan), **Devone** (Wing/Mercury), and **Lina Santiago** (Universal) debuted for the first time. Modern welcomed **Salt** (Island), **Son Volt** (WB), and **Stabbing Westward** (Columbia), and mainstream rock bowed **Gren** (IRS) and the **Nixons** (MCA).

Crossing from R&B to top 40/rhythm for the first time were **Deborah Cox** (Arista) and **Yvette Michelle** (Loud/RCA), while adult top 40 embraced **Jann Arden** (A&M), who'd charted AC previously, and the **Tony Rich Project** (LaFace). **The Badlees** (Polydor/A&M) made it to triple-A, and **Folk Implosion** (London/Island) crossed from modern to mainstream rock.

**FEBRUARY:** The pace slowed a bit, but not in modern, where **Gravity Kills** (TVT), **Jars Of Clay** (Silvertone), **Ruby** (Work), and **3 lb. Thrill** (550 Music) all debuted. **Dog's eye view** (Columbia) and **Rust** (Atlantic) bowed in mainstream rock, and **J'son** (Hollywood) hit top 40/rhythm.

**Dog's eye view** immediately crossed to triple-A and modern; **Son Volt** and **Stabbing Westward** made quick transitions to mainstream rock (the former also hitting triple-A, which made its Monitor debut in mid-January). After some time charting elsewhere, **Oasis** (Epic) joined the adult top 40 ranks, as did the **BoDeans** (Reprise), who'd charted in other formats years ago. Same for **Joe**

(Mercury), who made his top 40/rhythm debut.

**MARCH:** More rock action: **Ammonia** (Epic), **Tracy Bonham** (Island), and **Verve Pipe** (RCA) joined modern rock; **Dishwalla** (A&M) and **Hog** (DGC/Geffen) hit mainstream rock. **Tina Arena** (Epic) pulled a double debut at mainstream and adult top 40, while **Angelina** (Upstairs) and **Quad City DJ's** (Atlantic) arrived at top 40/rhythm.

**The Fugees** (Columbia) and **Busta Rhymes** (Elektra) crossed from R&B to top 40/rhythm. **Dishwalla** and the **Nixons** sealed rock success at modern; **Arden** moved to mainstream top 40.

**APRIL:** A highly active month. **Buffy** (Velocity), **Delinquent Habits** (Loud/RCA), **Puff Johnson** (Work), and **Billie Ray Martin** (Elektra) were new to top 40/rhythm. **Goldfinger** (Universal), **Rage Against The Machine** (Epic), **the Refreshments** (Mercury), and **Sparklehorse** (Capitol) hit modern; **Jewel** (Atlantic) bowed at modern and triple-A. **Howlin' Maggie** (Columbia), **Into Another** (Hollywood), and **Marilyn Manson** (Interscope) were mainstream rock's first-timers. Triple-A recruited **Patti Rothberg** (EMI) and the **Subdudes** (High Street), who may have charted on earlier sets had a format existed to house them.

Top 40/rhythm snagged **Junior M.A.F.I.A.** (Atlantic) and **Nonchalant** (MCA) from R&B and got on **Alanis Morissette's** (Maverick/Reprise) bandwagon. **Tracy Bonham** and **Verve Pipe** crossed to rock. **Fugees** found a top 40/mainstream beachhead; **3T** (Epic) went to adult top 40. **Marilyn Manson** went modern; **the Foo Fighters** (Capitol) hit at adult and mainstream top 40 and triple-A.

**MAY:** Rock month again, with modern bow-

for younger listeners again, although that development is still at least a few minutes away.

One more note about country. In the early '90s, it was generally believed that country's success was the way that many listeners were voting "no" on rap. (I believe that the "no-rap" movement at top 40 helped chase off the rest, but that's another column.) Just because rap is no longer a major enough force at mainstream top 40 to be a valid target doesn't mean that country hasn't found one. One of the "future of country" panels at CRS, held March 5-8 in Nashville, was rolling through a list of the reasons people like the format, and one of them was that it didn't play all that depressing alternative music. The fact that top 40 doesn't play it either anymore may not have registered with that audience yet.

**UPS AND DOWNS:** Speaking of depressing songs, you've probably noticed that there suddenly aren't many of them at top 40, even from the modern rock camp. Unless you count "Don't Speak" and "Un-Break My Heart" as lyrical downers (and any sense of depression in the latter is pretty well obliterated by its house mix), you can only find a few angst songs at the moment. One is "A Long December," which ends on a semi-hopeful note; you could also take the same inference from "All By Myself," although knowing that the person singing it is mar-

ried kind of destroys some of the inherent pathos, not that I ever thought **Eric Carmen** was home alone and pining either. The biggest angst anthem is "Barely Breathing" which is at least about recoiling from a relationship as opposed to, say, life itself.

Otherwise, top 40 is "I Lead Over Feet." It believes it can fly. This is its night. And if it makes PDs happy, we like it like that. Even the unrequited-love songs, "You Were Meant For Me" and "Lovefool," are so determinedly peppy as to completely obscure the nature of their lyrics. Same goes for "Everyday Is A Winding Road" which is pessimistic or optimistic depending on, well, whether you're a pessimist or an optimist. Then there's "Don't Cry For Me Argentina," which can't really be pigeonholed given the sort of obscure nature of its subject matter: (Is a Latin dictator's wife contemplating her relationship with her constituency an upper or a downer?)

How did this happen? Maybe it reflects the national mood about the economy, always said to be a good thing for top 40. Or the increased presence of rhythmic music. Or the fact that top 40, rather than turning its back on modern, seems to have learned how to find modern records that fit its needs. In turn, even modern (which was forced to make room for "You Were Meant For Me" and "Lovefool") has changed slightly. It hardly matters. It's not news that being up and energetic is a good thing for top 40, and you can only hope that it's what everybody really really wants for a few minutes more.

ing **Imperial Drag** (Work), **Primitive Radio Gods** (Columbia), and **Solution AD** (Atlantic). Mainstream rock debuted **Jerry Cantrell** (Work), temporarily freed from his **Chains** on a side project, plus **Hazies** (EMI) and **the Hunger** (Universal). Triple-A earned initial credit for **the Wallflowers** (Interscope) and **the Why Store** (MCA). Lone non-rock debut **Robert Miles** (Arista), memorably hit in all three top 40 formats the same week.

Lots of crossover, with multiformat hits by **Jars Of Clay** (mainstream rock, adult top 40), **Los Del Rio** (RCA) and **Jewel** (adult and mainstream top 40), and **Puff Johnson** (Epic; reverse-crossing to adult and mainstream R&B from top 40/rhythm). **Case** (Def Jam/Mercury) went from R&B to top 40/rhythm. **Brandy** (Arista this time) earned adult top 40 credentials, as did **La Bouche** (RCA) and **Fugees**. Gravity Kills moved to rock and Howlin' Maggie to modern. **Paul Westerberg** (Reprise) formally bowed in triple-A, although his earlier set probably would have done the trick at that time.

**JUNE:** Summer's approach plunged new acts to a low. **Nada Surf** and **Superdrag** gave Elektra a modern double, while **the Ghost Town DJ's** and **Nas** earned Columbia the same honors in top 40/rhythm. **Donna Lewis** (Atlantic) got her start at adult top 40, then immediately hit top 40/mainstream, as did **Dishwalla**, which also added triple-A to its laurels, along with **Primitive Radio Gods**. The **Wallflowers** swept into mainstream rock, and **Ghost Town DJ's**, **Quad City DJ's**, and **Nas** (not a DJ) all reverse-crossed into R&B.

**JULY:** Another rocktacular month, with **I Mother Earth** (Capitol), **Tonic** (Polydor/A&M), and **Zakk Wylde** (Geffen) hitting in mainstream rock and **Republica** (RCA) and **Reacharound** (Trauma/Interscope) hitting in modern. **Keb' Mo'** (Epic) charted triple-A, which he had done on earlier charts of this sort. This was **Amber's** (Tommy Boy) month for top 40/rhythm, while **No Mercy** (Arista), notably, debuted in top 40/mainstream. The latter quickly emerged on top 40/rhythm, as did **Donna Lewis**, **Crucial Conflict** (Universal), and **112** (Bad Boy/Arista). **Primitive Radio Gods**, having completed its rock sweep, collected adult and mainstream top 40 numbers, as did the **Badlées**. **Dishwalla** added adult top 40 status; the **Wallflowers** snagged modern honors. The **Why Store** hit mainstream rock; **Garbage** (Almo Sounds/Geffen) finally hit at top 40/mainstream.

**AUGUST:** The big one for new acts. In modern, the roster was **eels** (DreamWorks/Geffen), **Fun Lovin' Criminals** (EMI), **Geggy Tah** (WB), **Sebadoh** (Sub Pop), and **Sublime** (MCA). Triple-A boasted **Jackpierce** (A&M), **Eleanor McEvoy** (Columbia), **Duncan Sheik** (Atlantic), and **Ugly Americans** (Capricorn/Mercury). **The Neurotic Outsiders** (Maverick/WB) joined the crowd at mainstream rock. Adult top 40 popped **Merril**

**Bainbridge** (Universal), **Amanda Marshall** (Epic), and even the veteran **Specials** (Virgin). Top 40/rhythm contributed **Ginuwine** (550 Music), **Ricky Martin** (Columbia), and **Shades** (Motown).

**Bainbridge** quickly added top 40/mainstream. **No Mercy** added adult top 40; **Garbage** covered mainstream rock, as did the **Why Store** and **Reacharound**. **Az Yet** (LaFace/Arista) went to top 40/rhythm; **Shades** crossed back to R&B.

**SEPTEMBER:** A return to relative inactivity, except for "farm" acts. Mainstream rock added **Expanding Man** (Work), **Local H** (Island) (which simultaneously debuted in modern), and **Chalk Farm** (Columbia) (which broke the same week in triple-A). **Soul Coughing** (WB) hacked into modern, while the **Braids** (Atlantic) and, confusingly, **Charm Farm** (Mercury) bowed in top 40/rhythm.

Crossing were **Amber**, **Marshall**, and the **Wallflowers** to top 40/mainstream, with the latter adding adult top 40 to complete a quintet of format conquests. **Dru Hill** (Island) and **Maxwell** (Columbia) roved from R&B to top 40/rhythm; **Ginuwine** moved in the opposite direction.

**OCTOBER:** New acts heated up, with three bowing at adult top 40: **Fiona Apple** (Work), **dc Talk** (Virgin), and **the Wonders** (Epic). **Mo' Thugs Family** (Relativity) and **Westside Connection** (Priority) wrapped up top 40/rhythm; **Qkumba Zoo** (Arista) joined top 40/mainstream as a menagerie. **Darlahood** (Reprise) and **Matchbox 20** (Atlantic) hit mainstream rock, **Kula Shaker** (Columbia) hit modern; **Paula Cole** (WB) hit triple-A.

The least-active crossover month, but the **Wonders** and **dc Talk** speeded to top 40/mainstream, **Mo' Thugs Family** crossed to R&B, and **Chalk Farm** connected the rock dots with modern.

**NOVEMBER:** Deep in the year, new acts still broke in large numbers. Modern spawned **Leah Andreone** (RCA), **Failure** (WB), and **Fountains Of Wayne** (Atlantic); **Ashley MacIsaac** (A&M) sawed away at triple-A; and **Stir** (Capitol) debuted in mainstream rock. **Gina G** doubled up debuts in rhythm and mainstream top 40; debuting strictly rhythm were **Nate Dogg** (Death Row/Interscope), **Crucial Conflict** (Universal), and **112** (Bad Boy/Arista). **Primitive Radio Gods**, having completed its rock sweep, collected adult and mainstream top 40 numbers, as did the **Badlées**. **Dishwalla** added adult top 40 status; the **Wallflowers** snagged modern honors. The **Why Store** hit mainstream rock; **Garbage** (Almo Sounds/Geffen) finally hit at top 40/mainstream.

Top 40s were busy adding crossovers: **Merril Bainbridge**, **Foxy Brown** (Def Jam/Mercury), and **Do Or Die** (Virgin) to rhythm; **Republica**, **Az Yet**, and **BLACKstreet** (Interscope) to mainstream; and **Amber** to adult. **Ginuwine** emerged at adult, **Fiona Apple** was seeded in triple-A and modern.

**DECEMBER:** Its annual hibernation beginning, radio admitted one new act: **Bloodhound Gang** (Geffen) in modern. A few more crossovers took place—**No Doubt** crossed to triple-A, the **Cardigans** snagged top 40/mainstream and modern, **Ginuwine** collected top 40/mainstream honors, **Eleanor McEvoy** broke into adult top 40, and **Failure** succeeded in mainstream rock.

## 'Regional Breakout' Shows Signs Of Life, But Consultants, Networking Still Key

back when records with 60 first-week adds could be considered failures, there was little time to let a record develop one story. And during top 40's doldrums, it was hard to spread a hit to a top 40 in an adjacent market if there was no top 40 in the adjacent market.

It also became the case in the late '80s that a major-market PD often had more power to champion a record than a slew of secondaries. Networking PDs usually talked to other major-market PDs, thus creating patterns like the one that still exists today where KKRZ (Z100) Portland, Ore., PD Ken Benson's edit of Bruce Springsteen's "Secret Garden" can spread to WPLJ New York, WXKS-FM (Kiss 108) Boston, and WKRQ (Q102) Cincinnati, etc., through Benson's networking partners, or, in the case of KHKS Dallas, because Benson shared a recent confab panel with KHKS PD Ed Lambert.

"In this day and age, relationships among programmers are not as regionalized as they might have been," says Kilpatrick. KFMB-FM (Star 100.7) San Diego PD Tracy Johnson "doesn't necessarily just call people in Southern California. He calls Ken Benson or Tom Gjerdrum at WZPL Indianapolis, and these are the guys who end up leading the way."

There's also the reputation that some smaller-market stations picked up in the '80s as purveyors of adds in mass quantities, not as early spotters of musical trends. As one Southern PD puts it, "I don't trust a lot of these stations around me. If somebody tells me that [Atlanta stations]WSTR [Star 94] or [modern] WNNX [99X] are on a song that I happen not to be playing, I'd react to that a lot faster than I would [another secondary]."

Indeed, to the extent that regional patterns again exist, records tend to be radiating from major to smaller markets. One of the most notable regional successes was Tracy Chapin's "Give Me One Reason," which broke in Atlanta to become a hit throughout the South, then exploded nationally. To a lesser extent, one can see a similar Southern pattern on the Nixons' "Sister" late last year.

In Augusta, Ga., where WBBQ was considered a regional starter station for years, Bruce Stevens, PD of WBBQ's successor, WZNY (Y105), says he doesn't see records spread regionally much anymore. But he did see the pattern when "Give Me One Reason" broke. "Elektra had a promotion man, Eric Olson, who was very into the record from the start. That was really a one-man operation to get that thing kicked off, and it did... spread through the South and up the Eastern Seaboard and nationally."

So where else do regional success stories occur?

In the shadow of New York, for one. While WKTU New York did a lot to make America safe for La Bouche, its influence is even more noticeable within a several-hour radius of the market, as shown by, among other things, the spread of Black-out All Stars' "I Like It."

### BACK ON THE NEW YORK GROOVE

A record like the Outhere Bros.' "Boom Boom Boom" now spreads from WKTU not only to cross-town WHIZ (Z100), but also to WPST Trenton, N.J., which made a similar modern-to-mainstream transition. WBLI Long Island, N.Y., has also taken a more aggressive stance on dance product, including adding some titles from Lil' Suzy and France Joli that weren't played on WKTU. Even small-market adult top 40 WSUL Monticello, N.Y., two hours away in the Catskills, has added more dance music as a result of WKTU.

The WKTU influence is sufficient that even in today's atmosphere where many PDs are loath to admit that they even listen to their competition, WBLI MD Al Levine and WSUL PD Josh Summers are candid about New York's ability to help set their musical agenda. "So much of my market either works in the city or has lived in the city that if it works in New York, it might very well work here," says Summers.

"When we see WKTU jumping on a record, and it sells through, we have to respond to what listeners in our area want to hear," says Levine, who notes the influence of WKTU on clubs in his market. And while WBLI is starting to do music research under new owners, Levine says, the amount of research that New York stations did was always a factor. "We always looked at WKTU and before that Z100 and [adult top 40 rival] WPLJ, because they do a lot of

research, and anything they give a lot of time to should be addressed."

### CANADIAN CONNECTION REOPENS

Until the early '80s, it was common to see records spread from Canada through the border markets of Detroit or Buffalo, N.Y., and from Vancouver to Seattle. That pattern became a lot less common when Detroit's powerhouse CKLW-AM, licensed to Windsor, Ontario, and compelled by law to play 30% Canadian content, became less of a factor: Until a few years ago, there was no Canadian music station with significant numbers in a border market. Since then, there's been the presence of Windsor-licensed modern CIMX (89X) in Detroit and moderns CFNY Toronto and CKEY (the Planet) Niagara Falls, Ontario, in the Buffalo book.

The most notable Canadian-border crossover in recent months has been the Barenaked Ladies, who have had four hits on Buffalo's usually rhythmic-leaning WKSE (Kiss 98.5) and whose current single, "The Old Apartment," has not only spread from Canada to WKSE to WPMY Rochester, N.Y., but also to modern WHYT Detroit, which, in turn, helped open the door at WWCK (CK105) Flint, Mich. Previous singles by the act have spread to Syracuse, N.Y.; Elmira, N.Y.; and from there to northeastern and central Pennsylvania.

The Barenaked Ladies, who drew 25,000 to a WKSE concert last summer, are a good example of how a record can spread through several mechanisms at once. Besides the upstate New York and Detroit connections, there was also the link between WKSE and former Kiss PD Brian Burns, now PD of modern-leaning WDCG (G105) Raleigh, N.C. The success of "The Old Apartment" at G105, combined with airplay at WNNX, helped spread it through the South to WRHT New Bern, N.C.; WFBC-FM (B93.7) Greenville; and WSSX (95SX) Charleston, S.C.

"The Old Apartment" isn't the only Canadian record to cross the border at Buffalo. Kim Stockwood's "Jerk" was played at WKSE and WPMY. WKSE also played Universal Honey's "Any Way Back." That act has cut a second swath through the upper Midwest with airplay in Madison and Green Bay, Wis., and Des Moines, Iowa.

Canadian records aren't the only ones that spread from Canada to Buffalo. With Canada having been a stronghold for Eurodance, WKSE MD Dave Universal watches Canadian clubs as well as Toronto's dance outlet CING (Energy 108). OMC's international hit "How Bizarre" spread to WKSE through Canadian club play.

### STRENGTHENED IN NEW ENGLAND

Paula Cole's "Where Have All The Cowboys Gone?" shows a couple of other regional patterns. Warner's Kilpatrick, who notes that the record often tended to go from triple-A to modern AC to mainstream top 40 within a single market, also cites Boston, where "WXKS-FM [Kiss 108] and [modern AC] WBMX [Mix 98.5] both had a big influence on the top 40s in New England."

Similarly, in Denver, where KALC (Alice 106) often reflects the presence of both triple-A KBCO and adult modern KXPK (the Peak), Kilpatrick notes that "there's no question that KKMG Colorado Springs, which tends to lean rhythmic, gave Paula a much earlier shot than they ever would have because of the story in Denver where we had four stations playing the record." An even unlikely triple-A-to-Alice crossover, the Ugly Americans' "You Turn Me On" is not only on KALC but on similarly formatted KIRS Casper, Wyo.

Some other stories: DJ Kool's "Let Me Clear My Throat" began its life on Baltimore's CLR Records. While that artist previously had regional hits on the top 40/crossover and R&B stations between Baltimore and Richmond, Va., one sign that "Throat" was different was that it spread north and south of the usual "go-go" circuit, ending up with airplay from Philadelphia to Fayetteville, N.C., before being picked up nationally; Dreamworld's "Movin' Up" became a hit for WIOQ (Q102) Philadelphia and WNNK Harrisburg, Pa.; Several rhythmic titles have cut a swath across the Northwest from KUBE Seattle to KZZU Spokane, Wash., and KZHT (Hot 94.9) Salt Lake City, although more than regionality is

## MONITOR PROFILE

### KZHT PD Buchanan, Armed With A Van Full Of T-Shirts, Makes SLC Take Notice

"I was supposed to start on May 1 of last year, but I showed up two days early and scared the hell out of everybody," says KZHT (Hot 94.9) Salt Lake City PD Chet Buchanan. Most surprised of all was Hot 94.9's morning jock, who had carefully planned to quit two days before the new PD arrived. Instead, he and Buchanan ended up passing each other in the doorway.

It's been an eventful year for the station by anyone's estimation—three owners in less than 12 months. Bountiful Broadcasting sold the property to Regent, which was recently sold to Jacor. "This place needed a dose of large-market sensibility, discipline, and structure, which Jacor certainly brings to the equation," says Buchanan of the added resources of Jacor VP of programming Tom Owens and WFLZ Tampa, Fla., OM B.J. Harris as a programming brain trust. "It's a little unnerving now that I have to send B.J. my Selector backup disk once a week," he says. "While I appreciate their help and support, when you've gotten used to doing your own thing, it's like moving back home with your parents. But someday I want to be a Tom Owens or a B.J. Harris."

Buchanan was best known for his two stints at KUBE Seattle over six years, and two stints at KKRZ (Z100) Portland, Ore., over five years, all the while waiting for his first PD gig. He says he turned down three programming opportunities before accepting this one, overseeing KZHT and sister KUTQ (Q99), now classic rock KURR.

Here's a taste of what he walked into (aside from the morning-show walkout): "Q99 was basically a pop/alternative station that had been trying to mainstream itself with Eric Clapton and Sting records," says Buchanan. Meanwhile, "Hot 94.9 was leaning very urban and still had over 500 titles in rotation, including stuff like Paula Abdul's 'Vibeology' and 'Just Another Dream' by Cathy Dennis. When I got here, they were playing Weird Al's 'Amish Paradise' 60 times a week." Buchanan has since moved Hot 94.9 more mainstream.

Here's a recent 11 a.m. hour on KZHT: Jewel, "You Were Meant For Me"; No Doubt, "Spiderwebs"; Real McCoy, "One More Time"; Sheryl Crow, "Every Day Is A Winding Road"; Black-out Allstars, "I Like It"; Donna Lewis, "I Love You Always Forever"; Whitney Houston, "Step By Step"; Celine Dion, "All By Myself"; BLACKstreet, "No Diggity"; Ace Of Base, "All That She Wants"; and No Mercy, "Please Don't Go."

Late last year, KUTQ flipped to classic rock as KURR. Buchanan was overseeing it and KZHT until Regent handed off to Jacor. Bill May is now programming KURR, leaving Buchanan happy to focus solely on Hot 94.9. "While I feel it's possible to oversee two, three, or even four stations, I think it's nearly impossible to actively program that many stations," he says, especially considering the extra hours required to perform that most delicate of juggling acts: PD/morning guy.

"[KUBE GM] Michael O' Shea once told me

that the best job in radio is to be both morning talent and PD," he says. "One of my biggest idols, Gary Bryan, was doing it at KKRZ when he first hired me. It really does give you the best overall sense of the radio station."

Buchanan caught a screening of Howard Stern's "Private Parts" last week and was entertained at the portrayal of various PDs in the movie as "controlling assholes," as he describes them. It's that side of Buchanan's personality that is in constant conflict with his wacky morning-guy side. "The PD side in me tells me to be sensible and keep those bits targeted to 18-34 females while playing 10 songs an hour," he says. "The morning-jock side says, 'Do what you want and don't worry, just as long as we don't lose the license. So you only played four songs this hour. Who cares, as long as you're having fun?'"

Handy listener tip: "When we're not having fun, you'll know it, because we'll play 13 songs an hour. That means whatever creative energy we started with just left," he says.

While Buchanan has worked for some heritage outlets, most on his staff are relative newcomers. Morning sidekick Shoe worked at KROQ L.A. as a promotions assistant; this is his first morning gig. Sidekick No. 2, Cameo, had never been on the radio, and fourth member Danger Boy, was a former high school intern "who made us laugh," says Buchanan. Midday jock Dani Curtis came from weekends at KKRZ. Afternoon jock/MD Dr. Doug moved up from nights, making room for newcomer Stevie Wonder (no, not him), followed by Rick Dunn, a former Q99 morning-show intern. Weekenders Chauntelle and the Edge are graduates of the radio program at Weber State University, and Utah Jazz forward Bryon Russell does a slo-jam show Sunday nights, unless there's a game.

Buchanan relates a recent brush with the Twilight Zone involving new GM Tom Sly—the identical-twin brother of his former KKRZ GM, Clint Sly. "How weird is that?" he asks. "Tom is fearless, and he's a big-market guy; he's just what we needed."

Under previous owners, and with no promotional budget, the staff has had to learn to operate under a "chewing gum and bailing wire" mentality to attempt to make their presence felt in a market that is severely over-radioed. "About 43 signals penetrate this market, and at least 24 of those are viable, potential top 10 stations," Buchanan says. Cume duplication with Hot 94.9 in the fall book is virtually all over the format map, including the three hot ACs, KISN (20%), KBEE (19%), KQMB (17%); three country outlets; even the oldies and jazz stations.

"I've always said, 'Give me a box of T-shirts and a van, and we'll beat you,'" he says of his no-frills marketing efforts. "Marketing director Lutisha Robbins is young and aggressive and, like most of this staff, is still new enough not to know where the limits are, which is great. I saw her at the Gavin convention talking to [Arista senior VP] Richard Palmese, who probably wouldn't know me in a lineup. She walked out of there with Real McCoy for our upcoming Pioneer Jam."

He adds, "Needless to say, we're psyched to be working for Jacor." He's looking forward to an impending bump in the budget, plus a move to cushier digs. "I feel our attitude and philosophy is a good fit with theirs. I hope they get to know us when they come here and see how hard we're working. More than anything, I want them to respect us."

probably at work there, since former KUBE PD Bob Case consults KZZU and former KUBE MD Chet Buchanan programs KZHT.

That last fact reflects the point most frequently made by record folks: There's rarely any *one* way that records break. While Kilpatrick notes the regional spread of Cole, he mentions that consultants

Guy Zapoleon and Bill Richards were both instrumental in its spread, too. (Jerry Clifton's ability to spread a record through his rhythmic and R&B clients has long been acknowledged.) As Reprise national director of pop promotion Bob Weil notes, "You just try to find a spark whether it's a PD or consultant or a regional breakout."

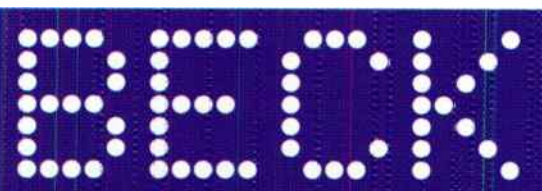
