More Crossover From Triple-A, Less From R&B Mainstream Top 40 Hatches More Of Its Own Hits; Rhythmic Top 40 Supplying More, Too

You've heard a lot in the last nine months or so about mainstream top 40 PDs wanting records their stations could own. For the first time in recent memory, mainstream top 40 is starting more of the records it plays than any other format.

Top 40 Airplay Monitor took a look at every record on last week's mainstream top 40 chart and where each song charted first. Mainstream top 40 was responsible, counting ties, for 13 of the songs on that week's mainstream chart, trailed by rhythmic top 40 with 12. They were followed by triple-A,

which was first (or tied for first) on eight songs, and adult top 40, which was first (or tied) on seven songs. Modern was fifth with five songs, including ties, followed by mainstream R&B's four.

If you look at which format was first to chart the most songs outright, top 40/rhythm-crossover and triple-A are tied for first with seven, followed by mainstream top 40 with five, modern rock with four, and then adult top 40, mainstream R&B, and adult R&B tied with two.

All this represents a significant change from six months ago, when

Capstar Celebrates Its Birthday With Deals

Capstar Broadcasting, one year old next month, starts celebrating early by absorbing Patterson Broadcasting and its 36 properties for a reported \$215 million, giving Capstar 156 stations. Patterson CEO Jim Wesley will be Capstar chairman.

After lunch, Capstar buys the eight stations of New England-based Knight Quality Radio, including ACs in Worcester, Mass., and Portsmouth and Manchester, N.H., for \$70 million.

For dessert, Capstar does a combination swap/buy with SFX. Capstar buys SFX's stations in Biloxi and Jackson, Miss., some of which were in the original Capstar empire, for \$60 million. SFX then trades WGNE Daytona Beach, Fla., and KKRD/KRZZ/KNSS Wichita, Kan., for Capstar's country/album combo WESC-AM-FM/WPTT Greenville, S.C.

In other station trading this week, ARS and EXCL make an equally complicated deal that gives EXCL jazz KSSJ Sacramento, Calif., and the frequency of AC KBAY San Jose, Calif. ARS gets triple-A KINK Portland, Ore., and the frequency of Spanish KBRG San Francisco. KBRG will move to KBAY's frequency. KBAY will then swap frequencies with classic rock sister KUFX.

MANAGEMENT: A HIGHER HILL

WPGC-FM Washington, D.C., GM Ben Hill officially adds those duties for co-owned gospel/R&B combo WCAO/WXYV Baltimore, replacing Bob Woodward.

WBIR-TV GM Chris Gallu is named GM at AC KKLT Phoenix, replacing Mark McCoy.

Less than two weeks after the departure of WAOA Melbourne, Fla., GM George Mills comes word that PD/morning jock Rocky Borden has been downsized to overnights. APD/MD J.T. Daniels is handling mornings and programming for now. Fourteen-year station sales vet Paul Brooks, who had left briefly, returns as GM. Middayer Bill Robbins goes to afternoons.

KOOL Phoenix GSM Thom King is the new GM at AC KBBY Ventura, Calif.

Congrats to Robin Barbaro, upped from GM to COO at syndicator SuperRadio. Senior rep E.J. Gore is upped to VP/director of sales.

PROGRAMMING: LINDSEY LANDS

After several months as interim PD of sports WQAM Miami, top 40/R&B veteran Duff Lindsey is officially PD, replacing Andrew Ashwood.

Mike Edwards, most recently OM at top 40/AC combo WBHT/WMGs Wilkes-Barre, Pa., is named PD of modern AC, WSJZ (Alice 92.9), Buffalo, N.Y., replacing Steve Weirsmann. This is Edwards' second tour of duty in Buffalo; he programmed top 40 WKSE from 1989-93.

AC WLHT Grand Rapids, Mich., hires former R&B WIZF Cincinnati PD Bill Bailey for the same duties, replacing Steve Dirksen.

Morning news host Michele Allen is upped to PD at suburban New York AC WFAS-FM. She was also MD at AC WHYN Springfield, Mass.

WDJB (the Storm) Fort Wayne, Ind., drops modern AC for WWI adult standards as WSHI under new owners. PD Trip Simmons exits.

PEOPLE: AFTER THE FOX

WKSS Hartford, Conn., MD/middayer Christine Fox is reportedly headed to KUBE Seattle for middays, replacing Lindsey Cipicic, now programming country KBUQ Phoenix.

WPRO Providence, R.I., PD Chris Shebel names late-night jock Davey Morris interim MD and moves him up to cover the afternoon shift recently vacated by Tony Mascaro, now ensconced in his palatial new digs at WPLJ New York.

WFLZ Tampa, Fla., fills its coveted MD/late-night slot by going to the bullpen: Former WFLZ assistant production director/swing jock Domino returns after five months as OM at Steve Kingston's WILN/WTBB Panama City, Fla., replacing Tom Steele. PD Jeff Kapugi still needs a producer for the M.J. and B.J. morning show. Speaking of Kingston, he buys triple-A WRNR Annapolis, Md., this week.

WJMH (102 Jamz) Greensboro, N.C., flips morning host M.C. Boogie D., and p.m. driver Busta Brown. Tanya Jones, who produced TV spots for a local hair care company, joins Brown in the new morning show.

Modern AC KQPT (the Zone) Sacramento, Calif., welcomes Kim Kaplan for nights from crosstown modern KWOD, replacing Cindy Stevens. Production director Rick Shannon joins from crosstown KFBK/KGBY.

WLSS (Loose 102) Baton Rouge, La., loses APD/MD middayer Spencer Kane next month, as he and his wife relocate to Portland, Ore., for her teaching career. T&R to OM Chuck Geiger.

After less than a month, former XHTZ (Z90) San Diego MD/night jock Jeff Nelson exits overnights at KHTQ Spokane, Wash., and reportedly returns to San Diego. KHTQ PD Scott Shannon (the other one) now co-hosts mornings with Kit Mann.

KLYV Dubuque, Iowa, snags Jerry West from KDST Des Moines as morning co-host, replacing Jason Hillery. . . . WHOT Youngstown, Ohio, night jock Mike Thomas adds MD stripes.

WSPK Poughkeepsie, N.Y., PD Stew Schantz orders himself to do mornings permanently, adding ND Sean Ford from WOXF Manchester, N.H., while Sue Turk is upped from P/T to middays. . . . WKTI Milwaukee night jock Luke Sanders exits.

WZPL Indianapolis PD Tom Gjerdrum is rapidly losing what's left of his mind (and his airstaff). Latest casualty: night jock Adam Ritz, who crosses the street to modern WRZX. Gjerdrum (who's still doing mornings for maternity-leaver Julie Patterson) also needs overnights and a promotions director. Won't you help?

KZMG Boise, Idaho, MD/night jock Carl Ballance exits, replaced by Ed Parreira (ex-KWNZ Reno, Nev.). . . . Former WJJS Roanoke, Va., night jock Flyin' Brian heads to nights at new top 40 WVYB (the Vibe) Daytona Beach, Fla.

Lotsa movement at WHZZ (Z101.7) Lansing, Mich. Afternoon jock John Hammer moves to mornings, teaming up with APD/MD Woody Houston. Night jock Scott Adams shifts to afternoons; overnighter Dominic is now in nights. The station needs T&R for all dayparts.

Congrats to Ed Shane on the 20th year of his consultancy.

Records Don't Burn If You Can't Hear Them

It took me nearly six months to get burned out, even slightly, on "Lovefool" by the Cardigans. Not burned out to the point where I punched out, but sufficiently burned out that maybe I didn't stay in a parked car to hear it or dart across the room to turn up the radio.

If you believe that listeners only become familiar with songs about the time that media people start to tire of them, then "Lovefool" probably has another three months to go. But even with the live to 12 months of current airplay that megahits get these days, it's seemingly hard for songs to truly turn crisp. Growing up, I remember that any megahit—even my five—would reach the point where I couldn't listen to it anymore. Not now.

Ultimately, that may be because a hit gets less exposure in 1997, even with extended airplay. While fragmentation may offer listeners more choices, it means there are fewer places to hear the hits, even megahits.

Consider Washington, D.C., where there are four stations that might play "Lovefool" at the moment—top 40 WWZZ (Z104), modern WHFS, and two of the ACs. Compare that to Washington in 1979, when there were three top 40s (WRQX, WPGC, WWDC-AM), one of the first hot ACs (WASH), a full-service AM that played reasonably hip music (WMAL), one of the earliest moderns (the original WHFS), and an R&B/disco hybrid (WKYS). That's seven stations. I tried it again for 1984—a time when rotations were higher than they are now because top 40 played very little gold—and got six stations on which "Lovefool" would have fit.

Then I tried New York, which had up to 10 outlets in 1979 that might play a megahit: top 40 WABC, WXLO (99X), and WNBC; AC WYNY; R&B/disco WKTU and WBSL; oldies WCBS-FM (which still played "future gold" at the time); early modern FM WPIX; and maybe even album WNEW-FM or WPLJ. I tried it again for 1984 and got nine stations. No matter how you count, there were more than the six stations that will play "Lovefool" now. (Even if you add MTV and VH1, you have to add them to the mid-'80s, too. So the number is still higher.)

I tried it for "You Were Meant For Me" by Jewel in New York. Eight stations in '79. Nine in '84. By comparison, there are four New York stations where you can hear it now: WHTZ (Z100), WPLJ, WDBZ, and suburban modern AC WLIR. (I included WLIR as a New York station because it functioned as such in the '80s, when it was the only modern in town.) And pop/modern crossovers are supposedly the most-shared songs.

"Wannabe" by Spice Girls would have been on at least five D.C. stations in '79 or '84. Now it's on two—Z104 and WPGC. BLACKstreet's "No Diggity" would've been on seven D.C. stations—three top 40s and four R&Bs—in '79 and '84. Now it's on three. The same song would have been on six New York stations in '79 and '84; now it's on four, and only because it's one of the rare hip-hop-based songs that became so big that adult R&B WBSL briefly took a flier on it. Otherwise, the fragmentation of R&B has cut down the outlets for anything that's not specifically adult in nature.

That said, the situation is probably better now than three years ago. Then, there were some markets where nobody would've played "Wannabe." And the top 40 might have been a 3,000-watt suburban outlet with a 2 or 3 share 12-plus. During the top 40 doldrums, a hit could usually count on airplay somewhere in the market between modern, album, and R&B, but only the latter would give a song the kind of rotation it might have received at top 40.

Modern rock was particularly light on rotations back then. Records would come and go. Not only would I never burn on them, but even when those songs were monsters, I'd never feel like I'd heard them enough. (I can probably still count the times I heard "Smells Like Teen Spirit" on the radio. So how much could anything else have gotten played?)

How much, for that matter, can anything be expected to sell today in an environment where there is less overall exposure even on the biggest songs? And imagine how hard it is for a pure top 40 record that isn't reinforced elsewhere in the market. While Crush's "Jellyhead" rarely sold as well as it tested, it was rarely on more than one station in a market. Indeed, its appeal to some stations seemed to be their ability to have it to themselves. Against a small sample, it was deeply loved. Against the broader audience, it arguably never got a fair shot at reaching critical mass.

Unlike many industry folks, I don't begrudge radio its right to hold on to songs for six months. Top 40 can't sell *any* records if it doesn't stay in business. As previously stated, I don't begrudge them the right to rely heavily on research either. But even if this isn't 1980, when call-out smashes were the most-innocuous records available, you still hope that records are hanging in for six to 12 months because they're smashes, not just because it takes that long to reach critical mass or because they're too neutral to burn. Many of top 40's winter book records were its fall book records. The numbers are back now, so we'll know soon if that approach worked.

NEW STATIONS AND OTHER REPORTER CHANGES FROM BDS & AIRPLAY MONITOR

World Radio History



Mainstream Top 40 Hatches More Of Its Own Music; Rhythmic Top 40 Supplying More, Too

Airplay Monitor last looked at where mainstream top 40 hits came from. At that point, adult top 40, feeling a new infusion of energy from modern AC, was an easy No. 1, with or without ties, suggesting that a lot of the songs that might have started at either modern or triple-A were now being brought to modern AC first.

By contrast, rhythmic top 40—despite the publicity around the dance revival—was first on only six songs last November, about half of what it's responsible for now or what it had six months before. All rock formats, including triple-A, saw their influence wane between last spring and fall. Now, modern is roughly the same, triple-A is up sharply, and mainstream rock—which was barely on the map—has fallen off completely, contributing as few songs to mainstream top 40 as country. R&B radio, which was barely able to start any records toward mainstream a year ago, had struggled into contention. It's down slightly now.

Mainstream top 40 was first outright to chart En Vogue, Real McCoy, OMC, Erasure, and the second Spice Girls single. It was tied on Jewel, Gina G, Wild Orchid, Crystal Waters, Hanson, "Wannabe," Celine Dion, and, assuming you count only its current, post-"Jerry Maguire" incarnation, Bruce Springsteen's "Secret Garden." Mainstream and adult top 40 were tied on "Secret Garden" this time, although adult top 40 charted it separately two years ago.

Rhythmic top 40 was first on Blackout Allstars, Babyface, Mark Morrison, BLACKstreet's "Don't Leave Me," Az Yet, Joose, and Crystal Waters. It was tied on "Wannabe," Monica, R. Kelly, Wild Orchid, and Gina G.

Triple-A was first on seven songs, more than twice the three songs it claimed possession of six months ago. It was first to chart the current hits by the Wallflowers, Paula Cole, Sheryl Crow, Duncan Sheik, Counting Crows, and U2. It tied with modern and adult top 40 on the current INXS.

Adult top 40 was first on two acts, Savage Garden and the Cardigans. Its ties included Springsteen, INXS, Hanson, Celine Dion, and Jewel. Mainstream AC was first on Jon Secada and tied on the current Celine Dion. (Six months ago, it also had one outright first—Streisand and Adams—and a tie on "Change The World.")

Modern was first on four songs and first including ties on five; that's down a hair from four and six last fall, and still off sharply from 10 outright and 12 with ties a year ago. It was first on

"Don't Speak," White Town, Luscious Jackson, and Leah Andreone, with a tie on INXS. In a graphic illustration of the much-vaunted "changing face of modern," all but one of those songs are rhythmic in nature. By comparison, the songs started by modern for top 40 a year ago included hits by Everclear, Oasis, the Foo Fighters, the Gin Blossoms, and the Red Hot Chili Peppers.

Mainstream R&B was off from three starts, five with ties, six months ago to two starts, four with ties, this time. Its starts were "No Diggity" and Keith Sweat's "Nobody." Its ties were Monica and R. Kelly. Adult R&B, which was also tied on R. Kelly, was first on both Toni Braxton singles—"Un-Break My Heart" and "I Don't Want To."

TO THE SHORES OF TRIPLE-A

So what's changed over the past six months?

- Mainstream top 40 was already starting to realize the power of records it could own, and labels began to respond in kind. And while some of the songs owned by mainstream top 40 (or by mainstream and adult together) may not have sold in the same quantity as R&B or multiformat titles, it helped the format's cause that there were at least enough successes last year that "mainstream top 40 record" was no longer synonymous with "turntable hit."

- PDs in adult top 40's modern AC camp have become more aggressive during the past six months. That may be because as the format and the buzz around it grew, they felt more comfortable reaching deeper into the triple-A world for music. It may be because so many albums by established artists ran their course so quickly last fall that they had no choice. In any event, the news was good for Duncan Sheik, the Wallflowers, Paula Cole, et al.

- Despite the R&B-to-top 40 stats, mainstream top 40 seems more willing to take a chance on R&B music; it just seems to prefer that it not come from R&B radio. Of the seven songs that rhythmic top 40 charted first, one, BLACKstreet's "Don't Leave Me," is a mainstream R&B record that rhythmic top 40 just happened to get to first. Most of the others—Babyface, Mark Morrison, Joose, Crystal Waters, Az Yet—are poppier R&B records that got some, but not as much, support on the mainstream R&B side. Rhythm-crossover radio had a handful of those a year ago (Coolio's "I-2-3-4," Tony Rich Project's "Nobody Knows," Color Me Badd, 3T), but only the Quad City DJ's fit that category last fall.

MONITOR PROFILE

DeFrancesco Fondly Recalls Gannett Radio's Seventeen-Year Run

In the mid-'80s, Gannett Radio was rivaled only by CBS for its top 40 dynasty. Gannett's KHS-FM Los Angeles was one of the format's most copied stations, especially after it became the market leader in summer '83. Gannett would then launch top 40s in Detroit, San Diego, Seattle, Houston, and Dallas.

By the early '90s, those stations had segued to other formats. KHS became virtually a hot AC in 1992-93. Even then, Gannett was influential in a second format revival, switching its Dallas jazz station back to top 40 as KIKS.

For the past 18 months, however, Gannett Radio—which was dwarfed in its own company by larger TV and print divisions—has appeared in the trades primarily as a potential seller, coupled weekly with buyers that didn't materialize and some, eventually, that did. With half its properties already traded to Jacor, the April 10 sale to Evergreen of KIKS, WGCI Chicago, and KKBQ Houston ends Gannett Radio's 17-year run.

Gannett Radio president Gerry DeFrancesco joined the division in 1980 as PD of KSD-FM St. Louis and, with the exception of a year at WYXR Philadelphia, has been there ever since, serving, among other things, as PD and station manager

a cash-only restaurant. Frank Sinatra had celebrated his birthday there the week before, and everything he'd ordered there was in the Sunday paper. So we thought we were cool. We went and ordered what Frank had... Wally opened up a KHS account, and that's how we got out of there."


Like many who programmed top 40 at the time, DeFrancesco remembers radio as less niched and top 40 as able to play more variety "because of the energy of the music... Maybe it's selective memory, but it seems like the extremes were not as extreme as they are today."

Despite this, he says that KHS' much publicized switch to hot AC was never a vote of no-confidence in the format, just an attempt to pre-empt hot AC rival KYSR (Star 98.7) before it could dent KHS's 25-34 women. Shortly thereafter, Gannett would research 25-34 women in Dallas and be "shocked. I had never seen such a strong appetite for current product." Hoping to avoid the "three-way teen battle" in which a previous incarnation of KIKS was mired, Gannett put out the word that KIKS was mulling a format flip so that potential competitors could make their move first. None did.

KHS was No. 1 by the 1994 NAB convention. Almost a year later, during budget reviews, Gannett decided that, rather than pay 15-20 times cash flow to expand, it "was going to have to begin taking a more serious consideration of the offers that were just getting so high." While many deals were heralded in the press as almost done, DeFrancesco says that until the real story was announced, there was always "more than one player" for the Gannett properties.

Not surprisingly, "it's been an emotionally trying year in dealing with the rumors and the issue of being in play for so long. But none of our managers, none of our key people in sales or programming or any other department, bailed out. And we had created such a strong sense of Gannett Radio culture and pride, [which] is driving me to take this to the very end. I joined the company on day one. I moved into my office before Joe Dorton moved into his, and if somebody's going to turn the lights out, it's going to be me... At this point, my focus is managing these properties to the benefit of Gannett and the future benefit of Evergreen. When that's over, I'll take some time off and figure out what the next step is."

Like a lot of radio folks, DeFrancesco recalls the '80s as more enjoyable than the megapoly era. "But I hate to say that, because there [were] moments through all of our stations where we were all in tears because we were laughing so hard." Even now, he says, "in this industry you find just the funniest salespeople and sales managers and GMs and air talents. I think the industry attracts fun people, and all things considered, I've never once thought of not doing radio." **SEAN ROSS**

of KHS and national PD, then president, in 1992.

So what does he remember fondly? The debut of KSD as one of the first hot ACs. The No. 1 25-54 success of WUSA Tampa, Fla. The No. 1 across-the-board success of R&B WGCI. Seeing country KKBQ become Houston's No. 1 biller. And, oh yeah, the day KHS went to No. 1 in a book that was expected to go to then-Dodgers flagship KABC. "Back then, you used to get the numbers over the phone... I stepped out, and everybody was waiting in the hallway, and I said, 'We're No. 1,' and the place went nuts." That moment was "emotionally bigger" than when KHS got a 10 share in 1984.

Another story: "[KHS GM] Wally Clark and his wife and me and my wife went to Chasens to celebrate a ratings book and didn't realize it was




