## Thanks To Adults, Top 40 Posts Best Numbers In Years, Say Summer Arbs

Classic rock and R&B stations continued to show record growth. Top 40, which can usually expect some help from teens in the summer, posted its best numbers in several years, due to gains in adult listening. Country seems to have leveled. And modern rock remained flat overall but showed upper-demo gains, leading one to wonder how, exactly, that format is feeling the impact of the growth of modern AC.

Those were some of the highlights of Airplay Monitor and Billboard's ex-

clusive national Arbitron ratings for the summer '97 book. The numbers are based on a composite of Arbitron's year-round measurement markets.

News/talk stations held at 15.6% of national listening this summer, followed by AC, the perennial ratings leader among music formats, which was off slightly, 14.8-14.6. R&B was up 11.0-11.4, opening up a 1-share lead over former third-place country, which held at a 10.4. Top 40 was up 8.8-9.0, its best 12-plus number since summer '95. Album rock slipped 7.0-6.8 but

## Few FCC Changes Seen Under Kennard

Insiders expect few major changes at the FCC under new Chairman William E. Kennard, whose appointment was confirmed by the Senate Oct. 29.

Kennard, a Democrat, is expected to be cautious in his approach to the deregulation policies favored by the Republican-dominated Congress. However, observers expect his personal style to be less confrontational than that of outgoing Chairman Reed Hundt, who announced his resignation earlier this year.

Kennard served as the FCC's general counsel

for four years. In May, he was named an FCC commissioner by President Clinton to replace departing Commissioner James Quello.

Also confirmed are new FCC Commissioners Harold Furchtgott-Roth, the former chief economist for the House Commerce Committee; Michael Powell, a Justice Department attorney and son of retired Gen. Colin Powell; and Gloria Tristani, who served on the New Mexico Public Service Commission. Commissioner Susan Ness is still serving out her term.

## Chancellor West Coast Mega-Deal Done

After weeks of rumors, KMEL San Francisco PD Michelle Santosuosso moves to Los Angeles as PD of Chancellor's R&B **KKBT** (the Beat), where she was once MD. **Harold Austin** moves over to program rhythmic top 40 **KIBB** (B100), replacing **Tony Coles**, who becomes APD of sister AC **KBIG**. B100 will change format Nov. 19.

KMEL APD/MD **Joey Arbagey** is named interim PD; **KYLD** (Wild 94.9) PD **Michael Martin** is expected to expand his duties to include KMEL, as well as adult R&B **KBGG** (Kiss 98.1), in some capacity. **KYLD** GM **Bob Visotcky** transfers to **KIBB** as GM; **KMEL** GM **Dick Kelley** will now oversee **KMEL** and **KYLD**.

Elsewhere in Chancellor, **Bennett Zier** transfers from the GM slot at **WGAY** Washington, D.C., to same at **WNSR** New York. Other Chancellor news: **WKTU** New

York's "Saturday Night Fever" 20th anniversary party, set for Nov. 1, was washed out due to monsoon-like weather in Brooklyn. The event will be rescheduled, says VP of marketing **Bev Tilden**.

### FORMATS: NEW GIRL NOW

In a world full of Alices, it's time to meet "Jane." Jacobs Media's **Dave Beasing** flips top 40 **WZSK** (the Shark) Ocean City, Md., and Christian **WDNO** to simulcast modern adult as Jane. **Jim McHue**, formerly a newsmen at rock sister **WZBH** (the Beach), is PD.

Bonneville's **WPNT** (Windy 100) Chicago picks up the breezy-sounding **WNND** calls.

Album rock **WMJB** Janesville, Wis., flips to rhythmic top 40 as **WKPO** (Power 105.9). Exiting are PD **Chris Modell** and morning man **Matt Miller**. The new PD is **Doug Hayden**, former PD of sister AC **WLKG** Lake Geneva, Wis. **WLKG** OM **Mike Knar** adds OM duties for **WKPO**. **WLKG** morning man **Shark** becomes morning co-host at **WKPO** with **Liz Andrews** from top 40 **WQPO** (Q101) Harrisonburg, Va. . . . AC **WNHQ** Nashua, N.H., is now simulcasting top 40 **WJYY** Manchester, N.H.

### PROGRAMMING: KAPUGI BOOGIES

After nearly nine years in Tampa, Fla., **WFLZ** PD **Jeff Kapugi** transfers to the PD post at Jacor startup **KSLZ** (Z107.7) St. Louis. No replacement is named in Tampa; look for Jacor top 40 chief **B.J. Harris** to run the show for now. While Kapugi needs an entire staff (especially a creative services director), he's already tapped promotion director **Maria Meckles** from country rival **WIL**.

Veteran PD **Cruze**, most recently morning man at modern adult **KKPN** (the Planet) Houston, is now PD of modern **WFNX** Boston. New Planet PD **Mike Marino** needs a morning show yesterday. **Dave Shakes** of Alan Burns & Associates, adds **KKPN** as a client.

L.A. radio vet **Jeff Wyatt**, last GM of dance **KACD/KBCD** (Groove Radio), is now GM of production house **CMI** (Celestial Mechanix Inc.), which produces TV spots for radio stations.

At **WSTW** Wilmington, Del., PD **Mike Som-**

mers exits, and the station inks a deal with consultant **Randy Lane**. Call Sommers at 302-892-2371. Also, Lane's modern adult client **KLLY** Bakersfield, Calif., won't directly replace PD **Russ Davidson**. Instead, it ups middayer **Mark McKay** to OM and afternoon guy **Jason Griffin** to MD.

**Dale Jones**, OM of top 40 **WQZQ** (the Party) Nashville and country sister **WZPC**, exits. Elsewhere in town, **AC WJXA** (Soft Rock 92.9) is now **Mix 92.9**. **Barbara Bridges** is the new PD/middayer host from sister **WJXB** (B97.5) Knoxville, Tenn. **Mike Padgett** from **WTFM** Kingsport, Tenn., is new in mornings, replacing **Dave Dunaway**.

Children's Broadcasting will discontinue its **Radio Aahs** format Jan. 30. **Aahs** most recently mixed mainstream top 40 with some kids' music.

**WWLD** (Wild 106) Tallahassee, Fla., PD **Orlando** moves to the newly created PD spot at soon-to-be-live R&B

**WHBX-FM**. **Lee Reynolds**, OM of Wild 106 and sister AC **WBZE**, reclaims PD duties for Wild 106.

**Ralph Sanabria**, ex-PD of soft AC **WPAT** New York, is now MD of adult standards rival **WQEW**.

At new top 40 **WJOI** (Kiss FM) Memphis, **Robin Cole** joins for middays from **WZYP** Huntsville, Ala. PD **Chris Taylor** adds afternoons.

With **KALC** (Alice 106) Denver morning hosts **Frosty**, **Jamie**, and **Frank** on the short-list for mornings at sister **KYSR** (Star 98.7) L.A., PD **Gregg Cassidy** is soliciting morning packages in case they get the gig. Also, look for **KYSR** P/T **Brian Douglas** as a bartender on "Beverly Hills, 90210" this month.

**DJ Darryl**, longtime APD/MD at R&B **KMJJ** Shreveport, La., crosses the street for nights at top 40 **KRUF**, replacing **DJ IQ** . . . **KZZU** Spokane, Wash., taps new morning producer **Jaime Pierce** from **KZII** Lubbock, Texas.

Former **KPWR** (Power 106) Los Angeles night jocks **Joey Boy** and **Johnny 5** head to mornings at rhythmic **KHYS/KJOJ** Houston.

**AC WHMS** (Lite Rock 97.5) Champaign, Ill., "Love Songs" hostess **JayCee** exits, replaced by the syndicated "Delilah After Dark" show.

## Finding Tempo Among Fall's Ballads

Been a little listless lately? Wondering why your station that picks listeners up and makes them feel good isn't perking them up quite as much these days? Feeling like you get knocked down? But you get up again? But not as quickly? Or as often?

Spring and summer were great for legitimate hits with tempo. Now, many PDs on both the mainstream and rhythmic sides are noticing a lack of tempo. While tempo isn't a substitute for strength, it's still one of the things folks expect from top 40, and the format's ratings over the past year demonstrate that. And I feel a lot better about "How Do I Live" and "Foolish Games" when they stand out in a top 40 music mix rather than defining it.

So where to find tempo? There are still plenty of titles in the lower reaches of the chart and on this publication's Impact Page with tempo, much of which probably should have come to the fore already, under the circumstances. There's also the option of powering stuff longer. I have no objection to hearing "Return Of The Mack" or "Bitch" or "Semi-Charmed Life" every 2½ hours for another few weeks until we have a few more "Fly's" or "Tubthumping's" ready to replace them.

Then there are the songs that top 40 PDs missed over the past nine months, both because there was such an embarrassment of riches or because those songs were crossing from the wrong format. Some secret weapons—"Jellyhead," "Dreamer," "Tonight Is The Night," "Let Me Clear My Throat," "Naked Eye," "Call Me," "D.J. Girl," etc.—are trekking from station to station on their own volition very nicely, thank you, some of them after more than a year in circulation. But there are others.

Normally, I'd be making my monthly plea for PDs to play uptempo R&B crossovers, but there aren't many available at the moment. There are, however, always the R&B crossovers of the past two years that got overlooked by at least some mainstream top 40s. Most of these secret weapons aren't so secret. They're established hits that should have been even bigger: "You're Makin' Me High," "No Diggity," "This Is How We Do It," "Candy Rain," "Da Dip," "Freak Like Me," "Stomp," "Let's Get Down," etc.

Then there's all that modern stuff that didn't cross over in late '96/early '97. Those songs

weren't any harder or less melodic than today's modern crossovers. They just came at a point when PDs were overcompensating for what they'd done a year earlier. And many of them sound even more accessible after 12-18 months of modern play. Among the candidates:

- **Sublime**, "What I Got": Probably the most accessible of the group's hits from a top 40 standpoint. And thanks to the slightly more refined **Sugar Ray** hit, already a sound with proven appeal at top 40. And while many of the new modern ACs aren't going back for a lot of older titles, they usually are signing on with this one, further helping to familiarize it.

- **311**, "All Mixed Up": With "Down," the group somehow became the definition of a credible modern act that wouldn't be right for top 40 or modern adult radio, an impression reinforced by its subsequent output. But 311's cult following stems from its versatility—sometimes the band is "down," sometimes, as here, it's more melodic. "What I Got" and "All Mixed Up" had the bad fortune of being similar records that went to top 40 about the same time, when that format was, well, all mixed up.

- **Garbage**, "#1 Crush" or "Stupid Girl": The latter got a shot from some PDs. The former was upstaged by that other song from "Romeo + Juliet."

- **Republica**, "Ready To Go": I still hear this at least twice a week on various British top 40s due to the miracle of RealAudio and have to remind myself that it wasn't a hit here. Like many pop songs that went to modern first, there was nothing really alternative about it. It just went to modern first in hopes that it would sell more albums that way. That strategy is working again, but last year it was hurting records at both formats.

- **Fountains Of Wayne**, "Radiation Vibe": A year ago, it was too modern for top 40 and too pop for many moderns. There's still no proof that it really galvanizes civilians like it does industry folks, and, because of the lyric, it might have made better sense as a summer bring-back (when top 40 didn't need it as badly). But I still hear it in stores, restaurants, etc., thanks to the various music programming services, and it still sounds great. And if **Savage Garden** had come first, this could have been presented as the thinking man's "I Want You" rather than calling it modern rock in the first place.

### George Jackson Named Motown Prez

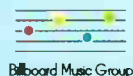

## Thanks To Adults, Top 40 Posts Best Numbers In Years, Say Summer Arbs

held sixth place. It was followed by oldies (flat at 6.3), Spanish (6.3-6.2, showing its first slippage in nearly two years), classic rock (4.6-4.9), modern rock (flat at 4.1), and adult standards (3.5-3.4).

Because this was a summer book, there were certain things you'd expect to find that did, in fact, materialize. Certain formats got a 12-plus boost in middays as a result of redistributed teen listening, among them top 40 (7.4-8.2), R&B (8.7-9.5), and modern (3.4-3.7). The difference, however, was that the usual teen boost in middays wasn't always accompanied by a crash in other dayparts. R&B was down at night (17.8-17.2) but flat in mornings (9.5) and up in afternoons (10.9-11.2). Top 40 was off in mornings (7.9-7.6) but up at night (11.6-11.8) and in afternoons (9.4-9.5).

### MOMMY CAME HOME

In fact, the most interesting thing about top 40's continued comeback is that it's not being driven by the younger end. Top 40 was down very slightly with teens (28.9-28.8), offsetting a teen jump of more than a share in the spring, suggesting that any impact from Spice Girls/Hanson/Backstreet Boys mania probably took place then. And while top 40's overall 12-plus gain only puts the format back where it was two years ago, top 40's gain in the 25-54 demo (7.2-7.5) gives the format its best number in that cell since spring '93. In 35-64, the format was up 4.4-4.8, its best number there since spring '92.

And, by the way, top 40 scored those adult rebounds despite the fact that there were three rap records that charted this summer at mainstream top 40, a format that hasn't made room for more than one or two such tracks since the hip-hop backlash of the early/mid-'90s. All of which suggests that when the right hip-hop track is part of a balanced diet, something top 40 excelled at this summer for the first time in years, adults don't find "Men In Black" so, er, alienating.

The strength of current hip-hop product, and its increased presence at mainstream R&B, also helped that format overall (including mainstream and adult outlets) to its best-ever numbers. Not all the news was good for R&B. It got less of a midday boost and more of a night hit than last summer, but it also went on to record numbers with teens (24.0-25.5), in 18-34 (14.3-14.8), and in 35-64 (8.8-9.0).

(Two program notes on R&B's rise: First, it probably reflects, at least in part, the redeployment of several major-market crossover outlets, most notably KPWR [Power 106] Los Angeles and KMEL San Francisco, to the mainstream R&B column following their continued evolution over the past year. Second, even adult R&B outlets [aka urban ACs] were up a tenth in middays with the kids out of school, again suggesting that listeners use adult R&B stations as a second R&B button, not as an alternate format choice.)

### AC: WHICH ADULTS ARE LEAVING?

Adult contemporary traditionally takes a hit

in summer when the teen/youth format phenomenon drives its midday numbers down. This summer's two-tenths of a share drop was less noticeable than last year's half-share decline. And while the format was down in middays (17.3-16.7), it was off more last year (17.2-16.3).

As AC becomes more contemporary and, perhaps, less adult, it continues to see erosion at the upper end, similar to what country experienced immediately after the peak years of the young country movement. AC was off most sharply in 25-54 (17.3-17.0) and 35-64 (16.6-16.3). It was off a tenth in 18-34 and with teens. That might lead you to believe that not every 25-54 listener is sanguine about some of those surprisingly edgy modern crossovers, but you could just as easily conclude that top 40 is reclaiming some of its adults, who went to AC either by choice or—in markets that had no top 40 for many years—by necessity.

While the growth of the adult modern format over the past year has been noticeable in AC's young-end numbers, it's hard to tell exactly who's being affected most by it. Modern rock stations were flat this summer, celebrating their first full year at a 4.1 share. Modern was down sharply with teens (10.7-9.9) but up or stable in 18-34 (7.6-7.7), in 25-54 (3.7-3.8), and with 18-plus women (2.6-2.8). So while modern AC may be stunting modern rock's growth, it's hardly decimating modern rock in the demos that one would expect to be most vulnerable to modern AC.

There are a couple of possible implications here. One is that the success of the singer/songwriter acts may be driving adults not just to modern AC but to modern rock. As for the teens, maybe they're the ones gravitating to modern AC, since it's so close to top 40 these days. (Or maybe some of the more rock-oriented younger demos objected to the somewhat less guitar-driven feel of the format.)

While modern rock has been flat for the last year, it began the fall book with several highly publicized format changes (or "modifications") that sent several stations back to (or at least toward) the mainstream rock camp. That's the only potential encouragement for album rock stations, which again were off slightly after a spring rebound. The format is also under a 10 share with 18-plus men (10.0-9.7) for only the second time in recent memory. It also had upper-end losses (8.6-8.3 in 25-54; 5.2-5.0 in 35-54).

### WHERE CLASSIC ROCK LIVES

A year ago, many people expected modern to become the new mainstream rock format, with classic rock to become a dwindling niche. Surprise! Besides a record 12-plus share, classic rock had its best-ever numbers in 25-54 (6.5-6.9) and 35-64 (5.2-5.6), giving classic its biggest-ever lead on mainstream rock in that demo. Classic rock was also up sharply in all dayparts.

Country, on the other hand, remained flat in every daypart except mornings, where it was up slightly (10.4-10.5). While this summer found country with an exceptionally down-tempo mix of music, it's hard to see any consistent demo pattern as a result. Teens were up (6.7-7.0), but 18-34 went 9.6-9.5, 25-54 was up 10.7-10.8, and 35-64—the demo where the format has suffered the most erosion over the past few years—spent its third straight book at an 11.9.

### Hip-Hop Lives In Ratings Penthouse As Parker Pumps Up Power 92 Phoenix

**I**t's sweet vindication for KKFR (Power 92) Phoenix PD Don Parker and staff. The station recently hit No. 1 12-plus in the market (tied with country outlets KMLE and KNIX) for the first time ever, jumping a full share (4.9-5.9) in the latest summer numbers, while also scoring No. 1 rankings 18-34 and teens. Call it a nice change of pace after enduring a tumultuous period since Power 92 unveiled its positioning statement, "where hip-hop lives," in May with the help of consultant (and former KKFR PD) Steve Smith.

"When I first got here two years ago, our mission was to get us back to being a rhythmic station," says Parker. KKFR had experimented with several pop-music styles after Smith left to program WHQT (Hot 97) New York. "It was apparent that Power 92 was not meant to be a mainstream station; its best performances had always come when it leaned rhythmic." That rhythmic slant used to contain a fair percentage of dance product, which Parker's research soon found to be so much dead weight. "Although WKTU New York may have sparked a dance boom, every bit of research

in during Bruce Kelly's vacation. "It never made sense for us to do it permanently; not only because of the time difference, but the lifestyle was radically different. Dre and Ed have a very East Coast show. For a week, it was great."

Adding fuel to the fire, the heritage Phoenix radio wars reignited, especially from crosstown rhythmic KPTY, according to Parker, whose staff was under strict orders not to respond. "You always hear about radio guys setting other stations' banners on fire and disrupting their appearances," says Parker. "Then we wonder why newspapers and TV rule and radio gets treated like the bastard stepchild. Radio guys are always getting caught acting immature and stupid—you never hear about one TV weatherman slashing the tires of his competitor—radio people always look like a bunch of spoiled brats, especially to ad agencies and clients. That's why some people feel like our product isn't worth as much. Everybody else appears classier by default."

That said, "stupid, wacky, and obnoxious," is how Parker describes Power's morning show, hosted by market vet Kelly along with lifestyle/gossip chick Tanita and newswoman Beth Fox as the voice of reason. Middays is handled by Coco Cortez, who joined from WBBM-FM (B96) Chicago, followed by EZ Street, who recently joined from WKKV (V100) Milwaukee. MD Mikey Freeman does nights, partnered with Big Willy. Late-nighter Rick Vaughn and overnighter Julian round out the air staff.

Although Parker credits Freeman with having great MD ears, he admits that he still schedules the music himself. "It's been difficult for me to give that up," he says. "I believe that, all things being equal, the flow and balance of a station's music is probably worth as much as a full share." Like most anal-retentive music heads, Parker treats every segue as life and death and gladly spends the extra two hours a day agonizing over the flow.

With that in mind, here's a recent hour on Power 92: Foxy Brown, "I'll Be"; Somethin' For The People, "My Love Is The Shhh!"; Coolio, "Fantastic Voyage"; Next, "Butta Love"; Mack 10, "Backyard Boogie"; Gyrll, "Get Your Groove On"; Ice Cube, "Check Yo Self"; Mariah Carey, "Breakdown"; Montell Jordan, "This Is How We Do It"; LL Cool J, "Phenomenon"; Joe, "The Love Scene"; Lighter Shade Of Brown, "Latin Active"; and Busta Rhymes, "Put Your Hands Where My Eyes Could See."

Parker talks to consultant Smith several times a week. "Obviously, Steve knows this station and this market. He's the ideal consultant because he's totally there when we need him, and he's not there when we don't need him," he says. "The best part is, Steve works for me and the programming department, not for [owner/GM] Fred Weber." Unlike some operators we've known in our collective past, Weber is one owner who has no problem with the format of his own station, Parker says. "Fred just wants this station to be successful. He and I both agreed that this was the direction we needed to go in. Having strong 18-34 and 25-34 numbers, the biggest percentage of our audience is still 15 to 25 years old. Thankfully, our sales staff understands the subtleties of selling a youth-based format."

Now that he's sitting atop the 12-plus pyramid, Parker admits there's more than a little pressure. "Last book, when we were No. 5, we only had 38 stations that wanted to be where we were; now we've got 42 stations breathing down our neck."

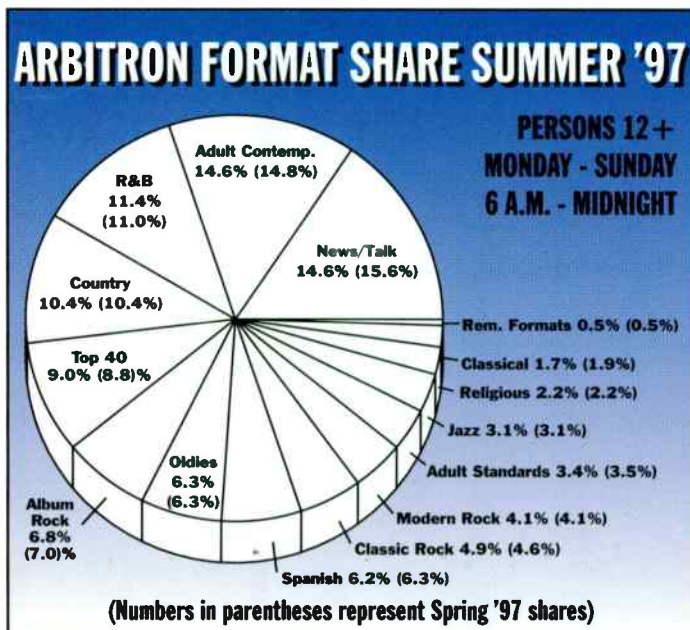

we had indicated that dance music, at least in this market, was on the decline, while hip-hop was growing impressively with both our Hispanic and Caucasian listeners. Hip-hop was clearly the future of contemporary rhythmic music."

Despite the initial industry (and inter-market) perception that Power 92 had changed format, Parker sees it as more of a paint job. While the music looks radically different from two years ago, when he arrived, by early '97 "we had gotten the music pretty much where we wanted it," he says. "Power 92 was already perceived as the station that played hip-hop, but we didn't have the positioning statement that reflected it. And we dropped only two records during the 'big change,'" Robyn's "Do You Know (What It Takes)" and Backstreet Boys' "Quit Playing Games (With My Heart)."

About 10 minutes later, all hell broke loose, says Parker, who fielded nonstop calls from record labels, trade magazines, and concerned mothers asking about Power 92's "format change." In reality, he contends, to the existing Power 92 audience and inside the station, nothing had changed. But it wasn't long before crosstown sales staffs hit the streets, selling against "the new Power 92."

"I never took so much shit in my life," Parker admits of the aftermath. "It was hard enough keeping the people here in focus, but the Internet turned out to be the worst thing for the jocks, who were online reading rumors from other stations in the market saying that everyone was getting blown out or that [Hot 97 morning team] Doctor Dre and Ed Lover were joining for mornings." The tension only increased when Dre and Ed showed up to fill

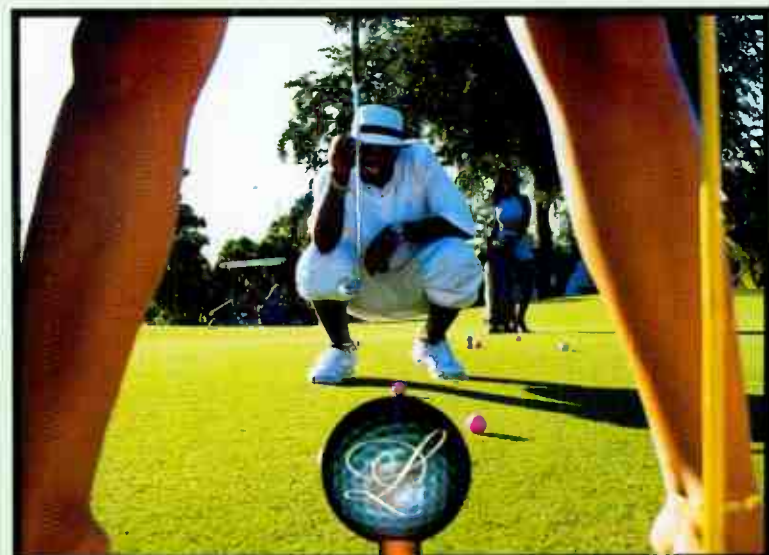

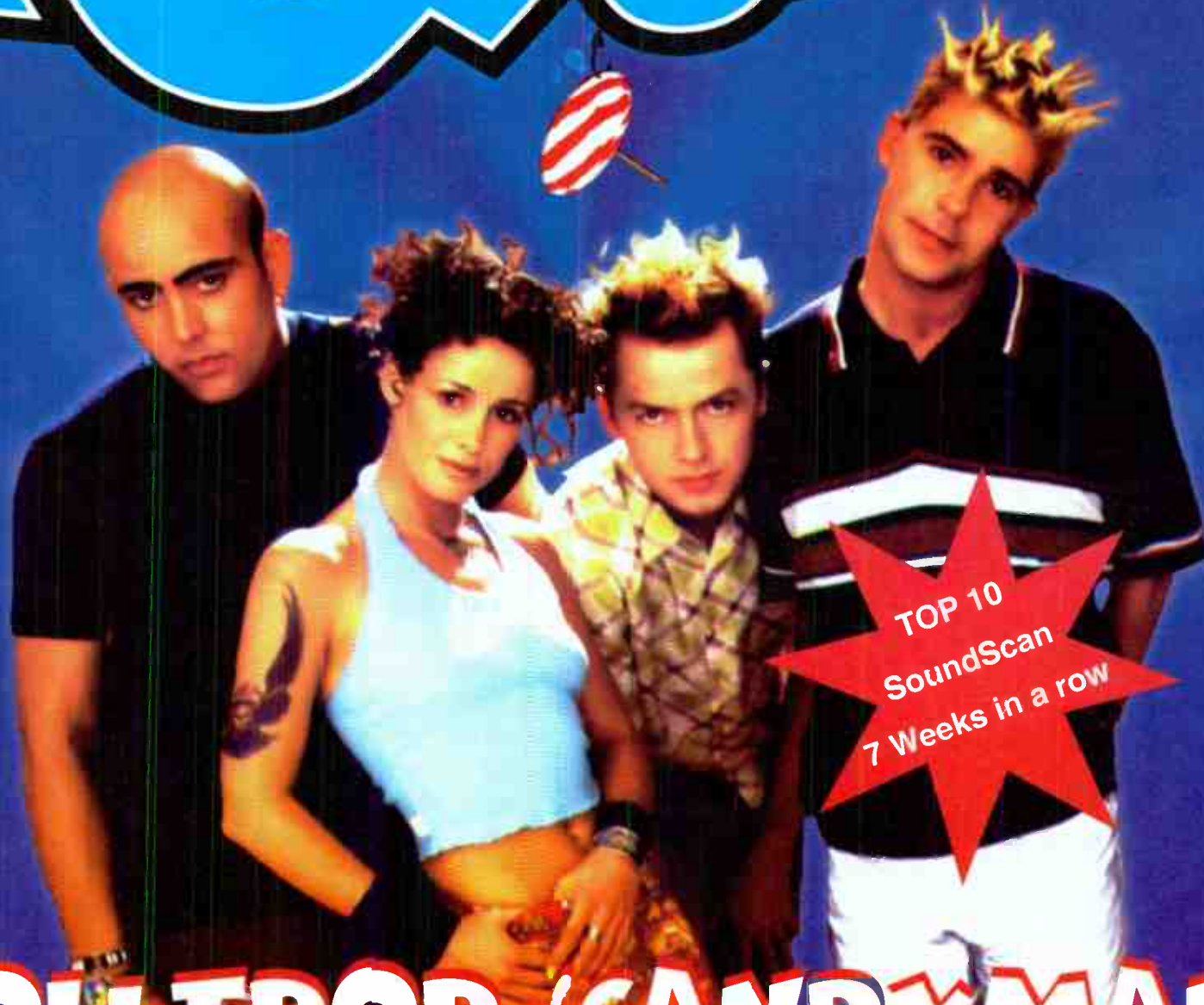
