Gavin's Gab

Roger Hartstone, Director of special purchasing for the Lee Hartstone owned Warehouse stores in California, has instructed his store managers that "no store employee may give sales reports to radio stations." His order directs that "Only the main office will supply such reports." Apparently such sales reports are to be available for individual areas, such as San Diego, East Bay, San Jose, etc. The lists to be reported to stations will be localized by areas but will not provide sales from individual stores. Such centralizing of sales data, while simplifying the collecting of quantitative sales info, prevents the depth researcher from obtaining qualitative reports, in which his knowledge of each location's demographic pattern enables him more accurately to determine the impact - the kind of impact - that any particular record may have. Some radio people also point out that one voice, representing so many stores, has much more leverage in hyping records to the stations, if in doing so, it might obtain a more advantageous discount from suppliers.

WIP-Philadelphia is having fantastic results in adapting the "Pollyanna" system of gift giving to a Christmas campaign for charity. A "Pollyanna", in case you didn't know, is the arrangement of having each person in an office (or class, or whatever) draw someone else's name and provide a gift for that person without revealing the identity of the giver. Station requests listeners to send in cards of gifts, to be distributed by the United Fund. Each hour six or eight names of donors are acknowledged on the air with thanks. At the end of the hour one of those names is announced as winner of a gift from WIP. Results have been phenomenal - truckloads of gifts every day from the station to United Fund's office, over \$1000 in unsolicited cash contributions, ranging in size from 90¢ to \$100. According to delighted United Fund workers, the whole town is talking about it, giving most of the credit to United Fund. Good enough, but the rest of the world should know that the whole thing was Dean Tyler's idea.

In the Davenport (Iowa) -Quad Cities area the KSTT disc jockeys put on a Christmas Crusade for the needy and in just seven hours raised \$3,500.

KCRA-Sacramento joins Pacific Southwest Airlines in a "Flight To Tomorrow", winding up with gourmet dining, wining and dancing at the International Hotel. MC's are News Director Larry Page and Traffic reporter Dann Shively.

KEZR-San Jose, off the air due to a transmitter fire, is back on again (last Fri. at 5:15 PM) due to the kindness of Bob Kieve, manager of KAKA (FM), sister station to KLIV (AM). KARA loaned KEZR the use of its 5000 w. back up transmitter - going to show that competition does not necessarily breed enemies.

Correction: Our research report last week showed WLS charting the Road Apples record at #8. Wrong. The station is not even playing it. Our tabulator erred in placing the "8" opposite the WLS spot when it should have been the adjacent spot, occupied by WLOB.

I've mentioned before the unique project of prison convict rehabilitation being attempted at one of the Georgia State Correctional Institutions. In other words, a state prison. In Walker County, the Institute is installing a low wattage FM transmitter and has placed radio pro Steve Hunter in charge of making it operational. Authorities hope that through involvement in broadcasting convicts will be strongly enough motivated toward a law abiding life that they'll stay out of jail. SANTA JAWS- Homemade Theater (A&M) Parody on "The Night Before Christmas" has the shark with a white beard and jingle bells on his dorsal fin and eight tiny reindeer - except that as it turns out he ate tiny reindeer - chomp! chomp! A sure fire short term phone sensation anywhere.

IN THE WINTER-Janis Ian (Columbia) The re-service goes back to the original LP mix, which is much richer. An elegant song, beautiful music, sensitive lyrics, just too great not to be widely played. First single mix already pulling some airplay.

Signs of the times: As a sample of the currently expanding emphasis on sex as a sales stimulant in the record business, comes now the color photograph decorating the jacket of TAKE ME by Grand Funk Railroad. Since sex-visual - sells such publications as Penthouse, Playboy and Cosmopolitan, and - audio - LOVE TO LOVE YOU BABY-Donna Summer, why not combine the two and have audio-visual sell a record?
