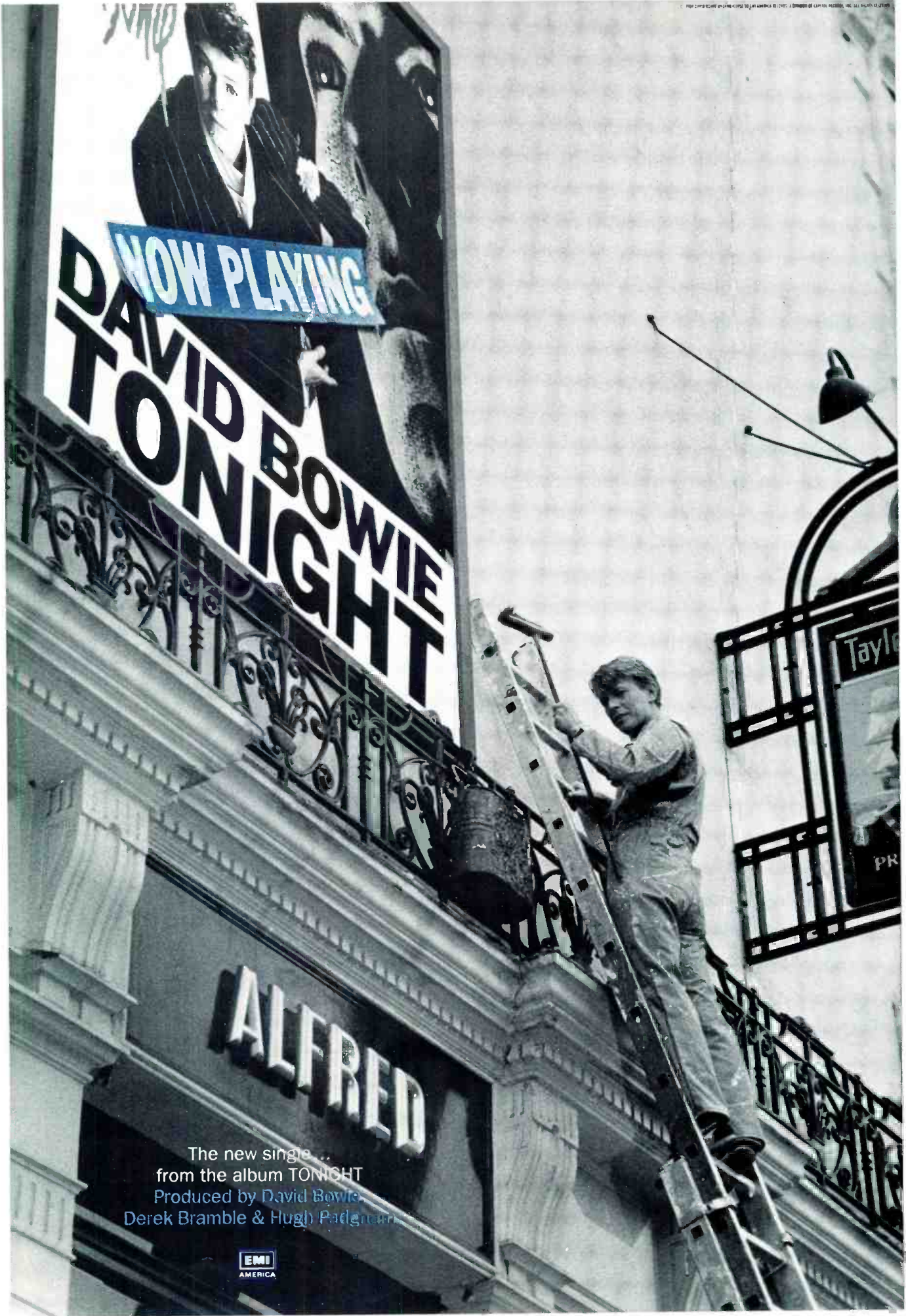

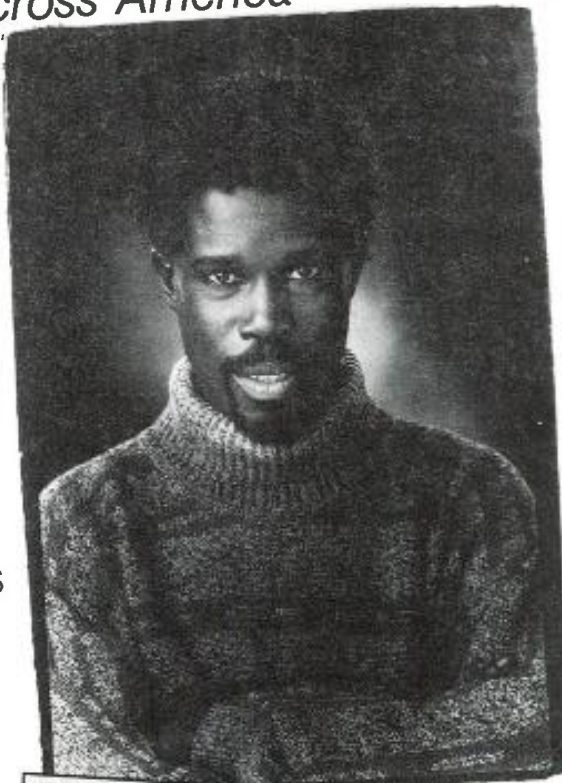

ANALYSIS

Three new entries in the top ten and a new number one song lead off the chart action as the final scenes of 1984's musical picture come into focus. As the year comes to a close (in radio terms that's about another month) expect BENATAR, JULIAN LENNON, DURAN DURAN, MADONNA and BRYAN ADAMS to be the biggies. LENNON jumps another 20 percentage points in "Hit Factor", showing a 51% to 71% increase. WVIC-LANSING reports a move of 24-16, ZZ99-KANSAS CITY 19-15, WHYT-DETROIT 30-21, WSPK-POUGHKEEPSIE 31-23, WDAY-FARGO 22-16, KRQ-TUCSON 18-7, I-95-MIAMI 23-13, KRPL-MOSCOW 15-9, etc. It's been a long time since a record came on as fast as last week's "Certified" record, MADONNA. No doubt now that this will be number one before we go to print with our last report of the year. Top 3 phones most everywhere, after only a few days of airplay. How's this for sampling of movement around the country? KWK 20-5, KMEL 29-10, WCCC 26-7, Z100 20-10, WKPE 12-2, 14K 24-12, B-96 34-14, WHNY 22-16, KGOT 22-10, WRKR 29-16...with a bunch more ready to kick in next week. Even with a holiday week, and a slight drop in total reports, NEW EDITION takes another big gain with a "Hit Factor" of 52% up from 36% last week. BRYAN

ADAMS, as mentioned earlier looking very hot, primed to go top 15 next week. SPRINGSTEEN's third single now charted by 113 of the 194 stations that reported playing it this week. Similarly, the third CHICAGO release is fairing as well as their first two and maybe even a bit better at the same stage of development. Debuts in the top 30 for WYFM, WDCR, KNBQ, KYES, KXLE, KPKE, WFMI, WRIG, KKEZ, KDWB, etc. Only one record qualifies for "Certified" status this week, RAY PARKER JR. His airplay and early chart activity make him the highest new debut this week. Due to the number of queries about the two SPRINGFIELD records, here is the latest info...and it's close: "Bruce" logs 91 reports, with 21 adds, while RICK & RANDY show 83 reports and 24 adds. Slightly more chart action on "Bruce", which has a "Hit Factor" of 3% to a 0% for "Taxi Dancing". But I think it's important to remember that although the same artist may be involved, these two songs are so different, they must be judged separately. "Record To Watch" by ALPHAVILLE gaining weekly in that rough fight for airplay....adds include WQQQ, WSPK, KDWB, KACI, WBLU, WQBZ, WSMT, KIXS and KQCR. Have a safe and Happy Thanksgiving holiday.

JULIAN LENNON: JUST ONE OF THE LADS

At 21, Julian Lennon isn't quite ready to play the role of reluctant bearer of the Lennon legacy. It would be impossible for him to do so. His voice and playful sarcasm strongly resemble his father's whimsical sense of humor. On his new debut LP VALOTTE, Julian's vocal inflections are, at times, an eerie recollection of his famous father. By adapting the same strained reach for the high notes, Julian seems destined for constant comparison.

Yet what's most disarming to even the most cynical non-believer is the high quality of the material—all original or self-penned. According to Julian, most of the uptempo songs were detained, making room for a ballad style album, uncharacteristic of one so young.

The release of the single was actually a low-keyed event. In order to avoid any unpleasant accusations of exploitation, Atlantic Records handled the matter of releasing "Valotte" very delicately. In fact, throughout the making of the LP, the project was assigned an inhouse code name when it came to requisitioning funds for recording and travel. For almost a year, the LP was nurtured under a veil of anonymity.

Julian likes to downplay the complications of having a famous name and his relationship with Yoko Ono (to whom he referred in a Melody Maker article as "Hokey Cokey") in favor of being "just one of the lads."

When we first made contact, he was excited and pleased after just watching himself on Entertainment Tonight, the nightly national news magazine show. That morning he had just done the Today Show. New York City was going through almost a mini-bout with Beatlemania. Prone to boyish exaggeration, and having just endured a day's length of serious questioning, Julian seemed relieved that our chat wasn't just another intense grilling, but a humorous banter.

KZ: *You looked good on the Today Show.*

JL: Really? Well, it was pretty early in the morning. I had trouble with me-ah-my eye that day. The woman who was doing the make-up stuck something in my eye and I couldn't see a bloody thing (laughter). So my eye was half closed.

KZ: *I've got a heavy question for you*

for the first one.

JL: Yeah (with much trepidation).

KZ: *What are those little designs on the inner sleeve of the album?*

JL: Oh, (laughter) on the inside? Well originally, that was going to be the cover, would you believe it (sarcastically).

KZ: *I mean what is this stuff. Video games?*

JL: No it's not a video game. What are you talking about? (laughter) Actually what is is, it's the score sheet, the actual written music, how they do it in Alabama. You know, the group in Alabama, the Muscle Shoals Rhythm Section? They've got their own way of writing everything and I thought it was so unusual. It looks like hieroglyphics. Plus it was the title

track as well. So I thought, well, plunk it straight on there, but it didn't turn out as well as we'd hoped. So they chose to go with the picture.

KZ: *So it's the tablature used by the Muscle Shoals session men on the track "Valotte."*

JL: Yes, the title track.

KZ: *When did you start picking up instruments and playing?*

JL: Oh, I've been playing professional drums since I was two (mockingly). No. I've always played around a little, so to speak (laughter). At about eleven I started playing the guitar.

KZ: *So just a little over ten years.*

JL: Yeah. Something like that. But I gave that up straight away, it was too much trouble. And then I started on the drums, then I was too lazy with that. I played for fun. And then I had one piano lesson, which I gave up immediately. I had one singing lesson which I gave up even quicker than the other ones. The woman who gave me the singing lesson was about ninety years old. She was German and it was like being in the worst part of the army. So I gave that up immediately.

KZ: *What's the first kind of music that hit you?*

JL: I suppose years and years ago, during school times, it was the rock 'n' roll heavy side, you know? Rush ... Van Halen were a big favorite. All that sort of stuff *then*. Now it's slowly matured a little bit.

KZ: *Obviously.*

JL: I went on to Steely Dan and Keith Jarrett. Stuff I still listen to.

KZ: *How did this record come about? I understand (Genesis Manager and Charisma President) Tony Stratton-Smith heard you in the beginning.*

JL: Well, we were playing the demo around. And he got hold of them but heard them without the mention of the name, which was great so that he was able to judge them without prejudice or whatever. He fell in love with them straight away. It just carried on from there. Just flowed along.

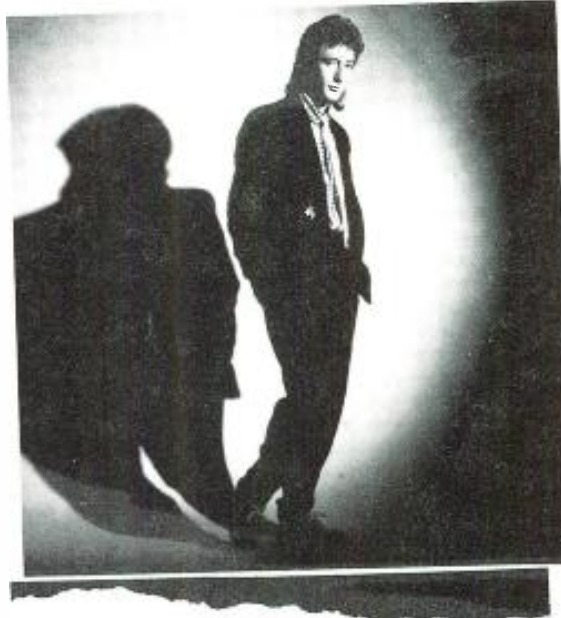

KZ: *Speaking of flowing, how did your style get so balladish?*

JL: I think that was Keith Jarrett's fault, mainly. I've just always had a flair for that. And especially since learning to play the piano by ear, on my own and all, it was easier for me to write like that, instead of mad rock 'n' roll songs, which is still virtually impossible for me, because my hands just don't move quick enough. I've still

got a lot of learning to do before I, you know, go mad. There's a lot of tracks that aren't on the album that aren't ballady in any form ... almost funk, disco stuff, which hopefully will be released later on. We'll wait and

KZ: *Do you listen to any of the music in Britain, any of the fashion-oriented stuff?*

JL: Not really. It just doesn't do anything for me. I mean, if it's on the radio it's okay when you're making breakfast in the morning.

KZ: *How did you hook up with Phil Ramone?*

JL: Well, I had "The Nylon Curtain," Billy Joel's tape and I loved the production. I just went wild and I said 'this is just what I need. It's just the style I'm looking for.' I got in touch with Charisma (Julian's U.K. label) in London and they in turn got in touch with Atlantic here in the states who got in touch with Phil. They sent him the demos, we had a chat after he listened to them and he was all for it. He believed in them, so we went straight ahead.

KZ: *Did you make most of the music in the United States, in all of those studios?*

JL: Well, we recorded them all over here, yeah. All over the place.

KZ: *Whose idea was it to go to*

Muscle Shoals?

JL: That was Phil's idea mainly, to get a bit of variety in the musicianship across America. We went down to Muscle Shoals first, then we went to upstate New York, then into the city itself to get some crazy guys in (laughter).

KZ: *So what do you think of the United States? Did you spend a lot of time here?*

JL: Yeah ... I've been here almost a year.

KZ: *You've been living here?*

JL: No, no, ... on and off. Working. But I do love it here although I prefer England as a home for the time being.

KZ: *What part of England do you live in?*

JL: Right in the center of London.

KZ: *So there seems to be a lot of people who have problems with pronunciation of your single and album.*

JL: It's Valotte ... VAL-LOT (emphasizing the first syllable.)

KZ: *It's a beautiful song.*

JL: Thanks.

KZ: *Is it sad? Everytime I listen to it, I'm trying to think what you must be thinking, how you were feeling when you wrote that song.*

JL: It's mainly about wanting to live in complete happiness in a house that's your dream house. That's the basis behind it.

KZ: *So what are you doing about a band?*

JL: There's two guys I work with constantly, (guitarists) Carlton (Morales) and Justin (Clayton), but I think we'll leave it open for the moment. We're still going to co-write for the time being. Maybe later but not just yet anyway.

KZ: *When you decided to sign with Atlantic and get involved with Charisma, did you sidestep any weird bidding wars or people who would obviously be out to exploit your name?*

JL: Before signing? Well, I did get caught up with a couple of guys ... well, one guy in particular who actually owned a clothes shop and was trying to get into the music business, but failed miserably. I think he's at it still. But that's where I caught up with my manager (Dean Gordon) for the first time. He saw the situation I was in and just pulled me straight out. It was very bad, what I had gotten into. It was because I was ignorant and I didn't know a bloody thing, but I learned from that.

KZ: *So what about the song "Jesse," where did you run across that song? I understand it was originally recorded a little slower.*

JL: Well, the guy who wrote it (China Burton), is a close friend of mine and had already written it and was looking for someone to sing it. I had known

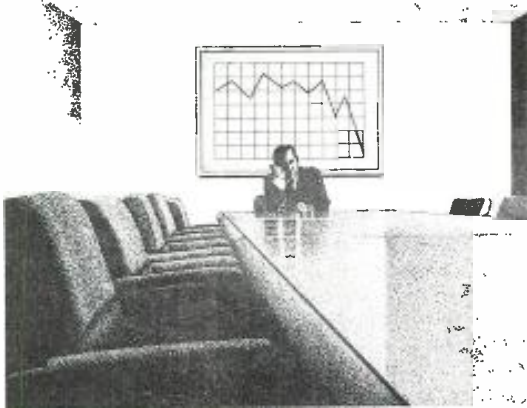

P.D. NOTEBOOK by Eric Norberg



MANAGEMENT STYLE

Eric Norberg

Some of the larger broadcast organizations have made a practice of running their management people through "management training seminars," which is of course a good idea. Helping employees to be better at their job is a good idea.

Unfortunately, often what is being taught is not a whole lot of help. I'm thinking particularly of what is often called "coaching technique." They say Vince Lombardi was a great football coach. They say if you really know the job the people you're coaching are supposed to be doing—know it better than they do—then you can coach like Vince; whether the team likes you or not, and often they don't, they respect you, because you help them win.

That's where the analogy starts to run awry. How many General Managers have you known whose understanding was capable of obtaining that kind of respect from the airstaff? Usually, the way it works out, the GM is trained to coach you, and then you are supposed to follow his/her lead and do the same with the staff under you. Unfortunately, the GM often doesn't really understand the PD and the job he/she is supposed to be doing either, so it may become: GM coaching PD to cheerlead airstaff into doing what GM wants. (Note that this doesn't require that the GM understand the airstaff, merely intimidate the PD into translating

these GM goals into action. No respect arises from those subject to this process.)

I have had opportunities to watch several different management styles in action, and the common ingredient of those that work is RESPECT for the boss. I have never seen the "coaching technique" accomplish that in radio. Unless you're Lombardi, "coaching" in radio leads to an us-versus-them, "the boss doesn't understand" type of attitude in the staff, which is quite contrary to what is intended.

The surest way to achieve respect by the PD of the GM, and by the airstaff of the PD, in my experience, is to "lead the charge" rather than send messages from behind the battle lines! Respect comes from staff perception that YOU set the tone and the objectives, YOU lead the charge, YOU're with them and they're with YOU, and YOU set the example.

Obviously, it helps a PD achieve this sort of team feeling if he or she is able to do what the staff is asked to do, whether it be airwork, personal appearance, writing copy, doing production ... whatever it is. So the PD who constantly seeks to expand his or her horizons and abilities within the business not only becomes more and more valuable to the company ... but also simultaneously becomes more and more effective as a leader as well! ■

In a moment I'm going to use a word I've admired for years ... it's a word that smacks of dignity and professionalism. It's the word which Dan Rather uses when he refers to Mike Wallace or Harry Reasoner. The word is colleague and I think it has a lot of class even though I have no idea what it means. Here goes: Over the course of many columns in The Gavin Report, my colleague, Eric G. Norberg, has offered radio people many wonderful tips on the subtleties involved in getting a job. It's been an ambitious and admirable undertaking and I congratulate my colleague for the public service he's performed.

However, it occurs to this COLLEAGUE-KIND-OF-A-GUY that Eric has missed the boat on some very sensitive and sensible points re job-seeking in radio. As an ex-PD myself, with years of experience at KGOY in Foonman, Ohio and KJEW, in Taft, California under my radio name of Shadow W. Diamond, I feel it's my duty to offer the industry the REAL scoop on how to get hired. Remember this advice and you'll be working til Arnold Schwarzenegger joins the Gay Liberation League:

1. When applying for a PD job, never tell the GM who's interviewing you that his wife reminds you of David Brenner.

2. If interviewing for an Alternative Action slot, don't enter the room humming MANDY.

3. When it's a MUSIC OF YOUR LIFE PD-ship you're seeking, remove your 'BLACK FLAG IS MY LIFE' button prior to the appointment.

4. If asked for tapes of past experience, DO NOT submit material from your college radio days at Oral Roberts U.

5. When trying out for an AM drive funny-man spot, you might be asked if you do humorous voices. If the answer is yes, DON'T audition with your Lyndon La Rouche impression.

6. If the GM conducting the interview is named Lech Walensa, be studious in avoiding all flip one-liners utilizing the word POLAK.

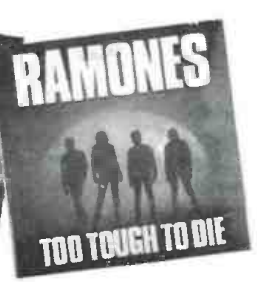
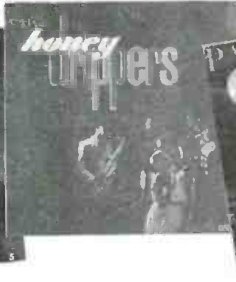

The Boys Of Summer/You Can't Make Love/Sunset Grill-DON HENLEY (Geffen) I remember first hearing "The Boys Of Summer" as a rough mix in BOBBY and LOU's red jeep parked on a street in Tinseltown. GEORGE GERRITY wouldn't leave until we played it THREE TIMES FOR HIM. Each time he would vacate his body, leaving briefly in some kind of mystic trance. Now with this LP, with that SYNTHESIZED STRUM just before the chorus, I can feel the same rush. It's so ironic that DON HENLEY walks away as the surviving, most relevant EAGLE. Upon very good authority, HENLEY is characterized as ... well, intense. Yet his songs portray him as tangible and warm-blooded, paradoxically critical of those who rely on materialism for their ultimate happiness. "The Boys Of Summer" is still PERFECT BEAST's trump card followed by "Sunset Grill" (with bassist PINO PALLADINO) and "You Can't Make Love" with LONESOME LINDSEY BUCKINGHAM. Other notables making the scene include PATTY SMYTH, SAM "AND DAVE" MOORE, MARTHA DAVIS, and BELINDA CARLISLE.

I Want To Know What Love Is-FOREIGNER (Atlantic) The last full FOREIGNER LP was the "Summer of 81" when "4" came out. The biggest hit single off that album was its ballad "Waiting For A Girl Like You" - actually their biggest single ever. The blanketing texture of this slow song is deceiving. It'll be the shortest 4:58 slow ballad you'll have heard this year.

Cool City/Gratitude/It Only Makes Me Laugh-DANNY ELFMAN (MCA) Always taxing at first, DANNY ELFMAN manages to squeeze out an intriguing solo debut outside the official order of the MYSTIC KNIGHTS of the OINGO BOINGO. ELFMAN shows the herky jerky instrumental wit common to the best of an ADRIAN BELEW or a FRANK ZAPPA. By walking the thin line between Album and Alternative (just as OINGO BOINGO always has) ELFMAN braves the choppy waters of individualism. Boingo guitarist STEVE BARTEK does a little squeezing himself, choking some pretty strange ostrich gasps from the neck of his guitar.

Living On A Thin Line/Good Day/Summer's Gone/Do It Again-KINKS (Arista) "Living On A Thin Line" (much different from Huey, no lawyers please) sung by DAVE is the healthiest diversion the KINKS have taken in a while. Plus WORD OF MOUTH is typically strong with lots of uptempo, tongue-in-cheek, timely advise. "Massive Reductions", I think everyone in this business can relate to. What usually happens is that radio goes four deep on any KINKS LP because of the sheer consistency and the infrequency of their releases. WORD OF MOUTH debuts Top Ten and will dwell there come 1985.

Radio Ears/Goodbye Steeltown-Joey G. (Green Dolphin) Former front man from the Iron City Houserockers JOE GRUSHEKY has released an anonymous seven inch; anonymous, that is, until you spin both sides. Side one is a mixture of honest raunch, synths, and a smokin' working class guitar solo. Side two, "Goodbye Steeltown" hits home here because my dear grandfather EMIL LOUIS ZIMMERMAN SR. worked as a steelworker. From what I clearly remember of the old Pittsburgh, PA, this song cuts it. The only address I have is HUGH HACHMEISTER, 103 Cedar #3, Pittsburgh, 15228. Beat 'em bucs.

All the Christmas product is already out, so this is it, folks. SPRINGSTEEN continues a climb upwards. The b-sides have been re-issued so some action may emerge to propel SPRINGSTEEN upward the next few weeks. Outside the Top Ten look for the climbers to be FRANKIE, TOTO, and a revived EUROGLIDERS. Retail reaction is starting to

happen as people finally begin to find out just who the hell is singing that song, "Heaven". No it's not FLEETWOOD MAC tired retail people keep saying. BIG COUNTRY starts its climb up the chart's wide expanse. GENERAL PUBLIC continues to hold onto its status as Alternative Crossover at #24 underlined. Other Alternative Crossovers include U2, BOWIE, FRANKIE, BIG COUNTRY, & LOS LOBOS. Look for an upcoming feature on the LOBOS in an upcoming GAVIN...Many thanks department: to all the people who braved the busy signals & got through (not forgetting those who couldn't), we love you. We had hot buttons around here because those suckers stayed lit all day...had a couple of adds on the 3 STOOGES LP on MCA. At least it ain't the Curley Shuffle. Oooo...Remember the review on LLOYD COLE & THE COMMOTIONS' import LP? Big interest by lots of labels, so I'm told...I found a few typos on other people's work for a change. The middle of the chart reflects little activity, with most of the music being older albums on their way out.

Records to watch include the DEL LORDS, DREAM SYNDICATE, HUNTERS & COLLECTORS, and DANNY ELFMAN (this week's MOST ADDED). All four are relatively new and are still being added at many stations.

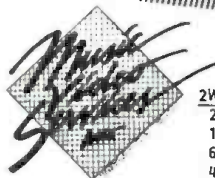

SAN'WICH PHIL

I have always been amazed at the amount of lives one touches while sitting at the business-end of a microphone. One of my favorite characters was a kid we nicknamed "Sandwich Phil."

The Harrison-Halsted area in Chicago was once the pride of the old Italian neighborhood. Not very different than any of the other "Little Italy's" that played their part in establishing the ethnic strength found in most large American cities. The streets were dotted with small specialty shops that sold everything from buttons to bubble gum. The air was covered with a coat of many flavors ... garlic, meats, cheese, bread. Grey-haired women in black talked loudly to each other in their first language. Ethnic pride dictated hanging on to the "old ways." The buildings were mostly old Brownstones that had sheltered families for more than fifty years. But the City Fathers labeled the area a "slum" to be torn down, and in its place erected the University of Illinois Chicago campus. What most Psalm-singing sisters and brothers that run City Hall fail to realize is that what they define as a "slum" is really someone's "home."

That's when I became involved in a "save the neighborhood" campaign. I got caught up in a cause and used 50,000 watts of radio station muscle to speak my piece. One of the buildings slated to be torn down was the Hull House, the first settlement house in the United States. Deep-rooted feelings churned to the surface. As a kid growing up in New York City, a place called the "Henry Street Settlement" lured me away from a pool room and instilled a different set of values. I owed them. So I did what a Disc Jockey does best—raised money for the long legal battle by promoting concerts and dances. It was at one of these dances that I met Phil.

He was just another kid that hung around the bandstand all night, and when the dance was over, we walked out to the parking lot. Phil asked if he could come down to the station. "Any time between 9 and 5," I told him. But that was no good because he worked in his parents' grocery store after school and on weekends.

"Do you want to be a Disc Jockey, Phil?"

"No, I aint gonna be no Disc Jockey. I'm gonna be a lawyer."

There was something about the way he said that! A few days later, about nine thirty in the evening, Phil stood outside the studio window with a big grin on his face, holding a paper bag that had a large grease-spot. His Mother had made a couple of Hero sandwiches for us, and they were fantastic. Phil had found his hook to come back. Once a week an order was phoned in and Phil proudly delivered it. He graduated from high school and went on to De Paul to study law. One summer evening we called Phil as usual, then waited for more than an hour and a half. As he strolled through the door with sandwiches in hand, his face had a hard, determined look. I was about to get a lesson in "How To Deal With the Odds."

"What happened, Phil?"

"Art, I was bringin' you guys your sandwiches on my motorbike. I stop at this red light and a car full of "wise-asses" pulls up alongside me. All of a sudden this guy opens his car door real hard and knocks me off my bike and the sandwiches go flyin' all over the street. So I get back on my bike and catch 'em at the next red light. I put on the kickstand, wrap the



helmet around my fist, walk over to the driver and give him a hit in the head with it. Then I go around to the other side and give that guy a rap in the mouth. I get two guys in the back seat, but I couldn't get the third 'cause he was hanging on to the ceiling. So I got back on my bike, opened the store, and made these for you myself."

I looked at him in amazement. "Phil, there were five of them. Weren't you worried one of them might hit you?"

With a shrug of his shoulders he said, "Who's gonna hit me?"

Phil became a lawyer. He never loses. And I learned to carry a helmet in the trunk of my car every time an ARB rolled around. ■

Remarkable chart jumps for our two "Certified" entries: TEMPTATIONS go 25-16, while MIDNIGHT STAR jumps 23-15, based on huge gains at our reporting stations. Momentum continues to gain on TOM BROWNE's "Secret Fantasy": KMJM-ST. LOUIS #10, WRKS-NEW YORK #11, WANM-TALLAHASSEE 18-12, WDRQ-DETROIT #15, KSOL/FM-SAN FRANCISCO 20-16, WBLX-MOBILE #21, WQKI-ST. MATTHEWS #23, WJKX-MOSS POINT #23, WDMT-CLEVELAND #26, KNOW-AUSTIN #27, WNOV-MILWAUKEE #27, on at WBMX/FM-CHICAGO, etc. RICK JAMES "turns it on" again, getting requests as well as sales. Two debuts on our chart are FATBOYS' "Jailhouse Rap", for those of you who thought (or hoped) that rap was on its way out, and AL JARREAU's "After All" at the other end of the tempo spectrum. Moving right along to the newer selections, programmers are heaviest on two

artists who are both rebounding from great big hits, RAY PARKER JR. and STEVIE WONDER. Both are doing encores from what will most likely be million sellers for them and talk about "hard act to follow".... Another artist who fits in this category is BILLY OCEAN, and his newest release seems to be finding favor with music directors and program directors - airplay is growing. One of our "Most Added" last week, KOOL & THE GANG, looks like a sure shot for a chart number next week, as well as a potential Top 40 crossover pick. The other "Most Added", GAP BAND, is getting its usual novelty/familiar sound airplay and could chart in early December, too. We'll keep an eye on these new adds during the next two weeks: KOKO POP, PHILIP BAILEY/PHIL COLLINS, and GWEN GUTHRIE; all three show encouraging response from our reporting stations and could make some impact before the holidays are over.

KZ: On the liner notes, you thank your mother for coping with you. Were you a handful for her?

JL: Well, I used to bring a couple of friends back to have a couple of drinks in the bedroom, you know, and play the music too loud, the usual stuff.

KZ: Here's a question you'll be asked for the rest of your life and you'll probably answer it differently each time.

JL: Okay ... go for it.

KZ: What is your favorite Beatles song?

JL: I like "A Day In The Life." That's one of my favorites. There's many many more.

KZ: How close were you to your father when you were growing up?

JL: Not so close in the beginning, but we started visiting each other every six months. It got better and better, you know, and then, whoop ...

KZ: Did he ever sit down and teach you singing or playing?

JL: He used to sit down and jam a little with old rock 'n' roll. Teach me a couple of chords. That was about it.

KZ: What would be your favorite song of his that he did after the Beatles?

JL: "Isolation" was my favorite.

KZ: "Isolation" ... you didn't even hesitate.

JL: No chance. ■

WHAM! :FEATURING GEORGE MICHAEL-
Careless Whisper (Columbia) I call this 1984's answer to Spandau Ballet's hit "True". In England, this track was a George Michael solo effort, but is included on The Wham! package for the States. A handful of programmers have been playing it from the LP and receiving heavy reaction, which shouldn't be a surprise to anyone who's heard this magnificent work of art. I'm told a seven inch will follow the release of this twelve inch, but in any configuration it's my opinion that you can now expect Wham! to pull off the nearly impossible these days....back to back number one hits.

FOREIGNER-I Want To Know What Love Is
(Atlantic) Two and a half years have passed since their last studio LP, making the release of "Agent Provocateur" a special event. It's ironic that with so much uptempo product happening these days, a band whose image is heavy rock 'n' roll, should follow their big ballad hit of a few years back "Waiting For A Girl Like You" with another softie. But tempo makes little difference when a record of quality hits the turntable. Jennifer Holliday assists on background vocals; a perfect compliment to the intensity and emotional pitch of the song.

BRUCE COCKBURN-If I Had A Rocket Launcher
(Gold Mountain/A&M) A song that calls attention to the unfortunate conditions of the people of Central America in general and Guatemala in particular. Cockburn weaves his message through this melody that captivated me the first time I heard it waft through the office walls of our Album Editor Kent Zimmerman. It's easy to understand why this song is the one that drives the audience wild when he performs it in concert. Once you hear it, you don't forget it.

THE MANHATTAN TRANSFER-Baby Come Back To Me (The Morse Code Of Love) (Atlantic)
Leave it to The Transfer to extract the essence of what made the doo wop songs of the 50's so much fun to listen to and sing along with. They've dedicated it to The Capris, who some of you may remember released this song on an Ambient Sound series released last year, and had a big hit in 1960 called "There's A Moon Out Tonight". This polished up version is sure to put a smile on all of us who were lucky enough to grow up during that marvelous period.

"Building The Perfect Beast"-Don Henley (Geffen)
Home-tapers must be in hog heaven. With two or three tracks from this LP plus one or two from Timothy B.Schmit and three from the recent Glenn Frey, they've got what could have been an excellent Eagles LP. Adding peaceful easy harmony and acoustic clarity to the bitter wit and high hat, hip-shootin' of our hero puts teeth in the bite of what's left of West Coast Rock. The opening track, BOYS OF SUMMER, is the torch which lights the fickle flame of victory. SUNSET GRILL provides a comfortable vantage point for checking out the traffic in the fast lane. DRIVIN' WITH YOUR EYES CLOSED and YOU CAN'T MAKE LOVE are as close to poetry-in-motion as dear Don is gonna get. That should make it enough to satisfy all concerned.
