OUR RELATIVE CHARTING, AS SEEN BELOW, RESEMBLES BASEBALL'S BATTING AVERAGES. IT ESTABLISHES A RATIO BETWEEN THE IDEAL, (HEAVY AIRPLAY AT EVERY STATION WHICH REPORTED); AND THE WEIGHTED COUNT THAT A RECORDING HAS ACTUALLY EARNED. THIS MATHEMATICAL FORMULA IS APPLIED TO EACH RECORD FIRST REGIONALLY, THEN NATIONALLY. A DUAL WEIGHTING SYSTEM IS USED TO DERIVE THE COUNT. IT ADJUSTS FOR MARKET SIZE AND FOR HEAVY OR MODERATE AIRPLAY. THESE CHARTS SHOW THE RELATIVE INTENSITY OF RADIO AIRPLAY FOR BOTH NEW AND ESTABLISHED RECORDINGS.

The Pirates hijack past lore but for a present payout. Merit.)

Jukka Tolonen/A PASSENGER TO PARAMARIBO/Sonet SNTF 768 (As one of the really gifted guitarists, Tolonen is easily able to keep an album full of his soloing

CONCEPTS

With the release of the Rolling Stones song "Miss You" in three versions, a disco mix, a single mix and an album mix, we thought it appropriate and amusing to reprint a Concepts written in Walrus #171 almost 3 years ago.

THE ULTIMATE CROSSOVER RECORD

A combination of the recent Albert Brooks album and an ever growing record production trend leads to an idea for the ultimate crossover record.

This idea follows closely the notion that record companies should gain the broadest possible audience in the most efficient way for its artists. If done scientifically - as we suggest here - most companies could get away with half their artist rosters, thereby saving a mint.

Now this idea is admittedly just the logical extension of what many companies are already doing. It is our point, that they should stop messing with half steps and go all of the way to the ultimate crossover record. Why wait? The technology is here now, well within our capabilities. Without wasting anymore space, here is the formula:

Record Company A - no names please - has just signed a talented singer/songwriter who speaks to the seventies. All of the legal stuff is done, the front money and the lawyers are paid and we enter the studio.

First a moderate rock rhythm track is laid down - piano, bass, guitar, and drums. Then some peddle steel is added. Some electric guitar with only minor electric embellishment (maybe a light blues sound in a baritone voice.) Next the singer/songwriter lays in the vocals. Finally, the sweeteners are added.

Now the ingredients are all ready... in the mix the ultimate crossover record will come together. Actually, in this case, it will be the mixes because with these tracks we will spinoff 5 mixes, one for each occasion.

Mix #1 - A prominent rhythm track with subdued steel and dominant electric guitar and dominant voice. The strings are mixed out or, if left in, are well down in the background. - Send it to the rockers.

Mix #2 - The rhythm section drops a few percentage points along with the electric guitar. The steel stays where it is and the voice dominates sometimes fighting the strings which are now brought way up. - Send it M.O.R.

Mix #3 - Lower the rhythm and electric guitar even more while raising the steel to prominence with the voice and strings. - Send it country.

Mix #4 - Drop the strings, drop the steel completely. Bring up the rhythm section and electric guitar above the rock mix levels and add the voice in the middle of the rhythm. - Send it disco and pray.

Mix #5 - Re-record the vocals with a black man who plays electric rhythm piano. Mix the rhythm hotly around the vocal and piano leaving the strings prominent. - Send it R&B.

Buckminster Fuller's "More with Less" dictum could not be applied to anymore advantage. And Record Company A - no names please - has just saved another ton in studio costs because this album can serve so many audiences at once. Efficiency.

It is so rewarding when one's advice is heeded.

MERIT ALBUMS CONTINUED

- Dean Friedman/WELL, WELL.../Lifesong JZ 35361 (Depth of material is Dean's only problem. He doesn't write an album's worth of top rank songs, the kind he is capable of writing. But, he is a performer. He propels his little operetta's with piercing, distinctive vocals in a jazz-meets-Broadway style.)
- Kidd Afrika/Mellowtime WHSR-1007 (A clean recording and a grooved rhythm feel gives Kidd Afrika life beyond songs which are not intrinsically appealing. They continue the strong undercurrent of R&B music traditional among West Coast musicians. Distributed by Windham Hill, Box 1388, Stanford, Ca. 94305.)
- Little River Band/SLEEPER CATCHER/Harvest SW-11783 (They'll switch, at will, between harmonized mild rock and harmonized MOR. The overall impression is a mite too soft. Still, members of this band are capable of writing exceptionally pleasing songs. They have done it before and they do it again here.)
- Barry Melton/WE ARE LIKE THE OCEAN/Music is Medicine MIM 9007 (A strong folk music thread ties all of Barry's music together. From country Joe & The Fish to this album, Melton has been involved with quality tunes too. Though you won't find flashy arrangements, you will find some easygoing pleasure here.)
- Mtume/MISS THE WORLD GOODBYE/Epic JE 35255 (One of the more stimulating contemporary jazz obscurities of the recent past was an Lp by Mtume. Here he works, expertly, in a funky R&B-jazz fusion. Does this mean he has any limits? Though this album is less of a musical accomplishment than the other, it still shows off an emerging talent, one who will have to be reckoned with in the future.)
- Walter Murphy/PHANTOM OF THE OPERA/Private Stock PS 7010 (The thrust of Walter's extravaganza moves through arrangements which rework the old masters, overwork the sweeteners or let the music work for itself. The Gene Pistilli vocals are the best choices for non-pop purposes. On the whole it stays in bounds.)
- Ram Jam/PORTRAIT OF AN ARTIST AS A YOUNG RAM/Epic JE 35187 (Ram Jam is a most appropriate name to describe the super-charged rock thrust they generate. A few remarkable songs get buried either in the sequence or the overkill or both, but they are there. Their power could use some better controls.)
- Tom Robinson Band/POWER IN THE DARKNESS/Harvest SB-11775 (A few superior melodies should do well by the album. The message requires tunes as powerful. They are not always there. Still, Tom Robinson stands for an important sentiment. The label on the record has the first and last tracks on side one reversed.)
- Rogers & Burgin/A FOOT IN THE DOOR/Waterhouse 3 (Harmonica and slide guitar provide for an organic music setting of easy delight. Rogers and Burgin do not rock you, they roll you in a pleasing whole wheat dough. No BHT here. Write: 1645 Hennepin Ave., Minneapolis, Minn. 55403.)
- Michael Stanley Band/CABIN FEVER/Arista AB 4182 (Michael Stanley has developed into a journeyman rocker. Cabin Fever is consistent at all levels of writing and presentation. No disappointments.)
- Neal Paul Stookey/SOMETHING NEW & FRESH/New World NWS-090376 (Through Stookey's pretty singing and the eloquent accompaniment one must search for the good tunes. They exist but, they do so alongside some disturbingly amateurish constructions, songs which haven't been worked enough. Lots of jazzy feels help the flow. Distributed by Sparrow Records, 6587 Canoga Ave., Canoga Park, Ca. 91304.)
- The Sunset Bombers/Ariola SW 60026 (The attitude is Rolling Stones, the execution is constrained. Still, The Sunset Bombers make it as rockers because they stay inside their limitations thereby avoiding potential problems. Loosen up.)
- Various Artists/OLYSESSES - THE GREEK SUITE/20th Century 2T-1101 (Overall OlysesSES succeeds. The project does trap itself mostly by doing too much. Rather than eloquent arrangements, there are gigantic arrangements and rather than one record transmitting only the best tunes, two records with a lower center of gravity are used. Still, there are some fine songs sprinkled through these 24 tracks. The orchestral rock instrumentals tend to be most satisfying. Top notch execution is a consistent strength.)
- Betty Wright/LIVE/Alston 4408 (A mistaken production decision manages to keep the audience in the mix while blowing away the presence in Betty's performance. There is music trying hard to bust out of this record. A remix would be worthwhile.)

SATISFACTORY ALBUMS

- (Albums of acceptable quality, which, of themselves, require only secondary progressive radio consideration.)
- Tim Duffy/ORCHESTRA OF CLOUDS/Music is Medicine MIM 9005 (Enhanced by delicate arranging touches, Tim gets all the assist he could ask for. Unfortunately his songs are too often not round enough to take advantage of them. Further, the tracks move between several incompatible feels. The album is not a complete thought.)

FRINGE ALBUMS

(Good albums which are not progressive, yet hold some interest for progressive audiences.)

- Bobbi Humphrey/FREESTYLE/Epic JE 35338 (This collaboration of the N.Y. session men and Bobbi Humphrey comes off nicely. The instrumentals are basic rhythm and melody affairs without production excesses. Meanwhile, the songs include a few top rank choices and feature warm Humphrey vocals. Try "Good Tunes.")
- Bob Mover/ON THE MOVE/Choice CRS 1015 (A jazz traditionalist Bob's music has a comfortable 50's feel about it. It does try, in a tentative way, some spacey vocal harmonizations. Nice for the background, though pressing is very noisy.)
- Rosetta Stone/Private Stock PS 7011 (Everything works well together, both the packaging and the production convey the pop rock message. The group's writing serves the purpose with only a few unfortunate exceptions. Clean cut.)
- Larry Williams/THAT LARRY WILLIAMS/Fantasy F-9553 (Larry Williams goes funky. The change is rather abrupt as he adopts the ghetto stance. It loses some musicality, trading off for more mood. O.K.)

SPECIAL PROGRAMMING

(Spoken, poetry - comedy and extraneous musics.)

- Charles Mingus/CUMBIA & JAZZ FUSION/Atlantic SD8801 (Nat Hentoff says that Mingus "has long since transcended categories" of music. Cumbia & Jazz Fusion is testimony in behalf of that sentiment. Consisting of two, vastly different, side long compositions this album presents a striking sense of universality. Fine.)

STRONGLY MERITORIOUS

(We feel that these Lp's have an extra edge.)

Bruce Springsteen/DARKNESS ON THE EDGE OF TOWN/Columbia JC 35318 (Getting beyond expectations is the first problem for the listener because this is not a repeat of previous efforts. The balance of the elements is different. Not the depth. Bruce Springsteen's writing lives a life of rarely paralleled intensity. His music is durable, you don't quickly tire of it. The more you listen, the more you like it. Still, the sublimated Clarence Clemons is missed.)

Various Artists/WHITE MANSIONS/A&M SP-6004 (White Mansions is a musical, historical drama about the American Civil War which gloriously avoids all of the mistakes which most of these massive projects manage to make. The concept is sound and the songs, though they are not eternal, are all very listenable. Everything holds up both individually and collectively. Nothing is overdone, a testament to producer Glyn Johns' taste. Along with the equally thoughtful 28 page booklet, the album becomes a radio programming challenge. It is a chance to do something special, something which carries the indelible mark of a radio station. Rarely is it done this well.)

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS

(All Merit and Merit Plus Albums are recommended for serious progressive radio consideration, recognizing that not all of these recommendations are suitable for all stations. The Merit Plus Albums distinguish themselves with an extra vitality.)

Carillo/RINGS AROUND THE MOON/Atlantic SD 19176 (Here is a new artist worth running after. Both a terrific writer and singer, Frank Carillo hits the quinella with a nicely restrained production. One could argue that the lyrics could be more an expression of contemporary life, but who really cares when much of it feels so good. Carillo si.)

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS CONTINUED

John Coltrane/THE MASTERY OF...VOL. I/ABC Impulse 1Z 9345/2 (More than a decade later 'Trane leaves 98% of the jazz world behind him. In melodic purity and raw energy he is rarely matched by musicians working in any genre, let alone by those in the fragmented jazz/new music scene.)

John Klemmer/ARABESQUE/ABC AA-1068 (John Klemmer's true melodic power comes through on "Arabesque" as it overcomes the popisms. His solos are placed inside those by Pharoah and Gato but, are still instilled with a combination of grit and beauty similar to theirs.)

Martin Mull/SEX & VIOLINS/ABC AA-1064 (In his very finest Cole Porter chic, Martin Mull stars in his cheekiest yet. All of the songs are duly bent, made even more "absurd with a capital A" by the slick orchestrations. Mull projects the only plausible attitude given the circumstances.)

MERIT ALBUMS

AC/DC/POWERAGE/Atlantic SD 19180 (As advertised, Powerage pumps those db's. Without inventing anything new AC/DC succeeds on classic form: hard-nosed rock and roll. No pretense.)

Any Old Time/STRING BAND/A rhoolie 4009 (Any quality old time tune seems to fit into the sights of this band of musical ladies. Their execution is natural and demonstrates a true affection for the material. The presentation is not stylized like the work of Leon Redbone. Write: 10341 San Pablo Ave., El Cerrito, Ca. 94530.)

Rita Coolidge/LOVE ME AGAIN/A&M SP 4699 (A little sterile, but Rita fronts a refined, recorded statement. Fine song selection resting in a mildly slick resolution yield that germ-free feeling. Clean machine.)

Derringer/IF I WEREN'T SO ROMANTIC.../Blue Sky JZ 35075 (By the act of looking for outside material, working with writing collaborators and by going to Michael Chapman for production assistance, Derringer makes a commitment to better albums. This is a good first step. The result is an under control hard rock. The first track is best.)

Don Ellis/LIVE AT MONTREUX /Atlantic SD 19178 (In a thank you note Don comments on the "astonishingly intense energy level" in his band's performance. You can hear what he is talking about and he is right to give credit where it's due. However, the full impact of the performance doesn't get on to the recording. Presence has been filtered out somewhere in the manufacturing process. Still, it is obvious that this big band is cooking.)
