RADIO STATS

OUR RELATIVE CHARTING, AS SEEN BELOW, RESEMBLES BASEBALL'S BATTING AVERAGES. IT ESTABLISHES A RATIO BETWEEN THE IDEAL, (HEAVY AIRPLAY AT EVERY STATION WHICH REPORTED); AND THE WEIGHTED COUNT THAT A RECORDING HAS ACTUALLY EARNED. THIS MATHEMATICAL FORMULA IS APPLIED TO EACH RECORD—FIRST REGIONALLY, THEN NATIONALLY. A DUAL WEIGHTING SYSTEM IS USED TO DERIVE THE COUNT. IT ADJUSTS FOR MARKET SIZE AND FOR HEAVY OR MODERATE AIRPLAY. THESE CHARTS SHOW THE RELATIVE INTENSITY OF RADIO AIRPLAY FOR BOTH NEW AND ESTABLISHED RECORDINGS.

CMF news also discovered that the agency, "The Senate Commission for the Blind and Visually Handicapped," threatens blind residents with reprisals if they don't go along with agency decisions. We also discovered that the agency provides no services for children under the age of 14 and this quite often affects their ability to lead normal lives.

Difference alternates fusionist tunes, which include many of the recognized jazz stars, and very personal statements performed as solos and some rather avant music too. His tunes are good but not as good as the playing. Merit.)

Dire Straits/Vertigo 9102 021 (Imagine a smidgen of Lou Reed and Dylan in the most alluring, light Southern rock musical setting. The tracks on this Lp are killers. A single weakness is in the vocal treatment. Merit Plus.)

Lindisfarne/BACK AND FOURTH/Mercury 9109 609 (Gus Dudgeon puts lots of movement in the rejuvenated folk-rock of Lindisfarne. A few top-notch songs and a crystalline presentation are all you can ask. Merit Plus.)

Little River Band/AFTER HOURS/EMI EMC 2546 (Copyright dates show After Hours to be a vintage 1976 recording. Some of the personnel has changed but, not anyone at the core. Their soft rockin' feel is intact and so are their easy flowing tunes. Merit.)

The Lurkers/FULHAM FALLOUT/Beggar's Banquet BEGA 2 (Titles like "Total War," "Then I Kicked Her" and "Self Distruct" tell you that this is no Sinatra croon. The Lurkers are, however, your basic punk band. Their songs are O.K and are not drowned in a sea of audio fuzz. Merit.)

Markusfeld/LE DESERT NOIR/Egg 900.528 (Rock guitarist Alain Markusfeld shows his stuff. These instrumental tracks drive from underneath while they are filled with guitars on top. Skillful playing and good tunes find an ear. Merit.)

Patrick Vian/BRUITS ET TEMPS ANALOGUES/Egg 900.541 (Though Patrick's music is electronic and spacey it never really leaves an earth orbit. Only the first track on each side is hard-boiled. The rest are background explorations. Merit.)

- Norton Buffalo/DESERT HORIZON/Capitol SW-11847 (Nearly every place that the stylus touches down an appealing melody reflects back. Naturally derived performances fill Desert Horizon. However, it is the title song which strikes gold in this album.)
- Caldera/TIME AND CHANCE/Capitol SW 11810 (Changing complexions, Calera moves more toward outright jazz than they have been. Their light fusion is unusual and requires some adjustment. The Latin rhythm is there but subdued, while the melodies have gotten more athermal. Only the guitar has a sting to it.)
- Johnny Carroll/TEXABILLY/Rollin' Rock LP 014 (Most of the current rockabilly undercurrent seems to attract young kids who somehow revere the old days. Johnny Carroll, on the other hand, was around the Texas scene that fostered Gene Vincent. This Lp is evidence of Johnny's continuing ability. Write: 6918 Peach Ave., Van Nuys, Ca. 91406.)
- Champion/Epic JE 35438 (A frog-throated lead singer who can stretch from street (ala Graham Parker) to Southern rock is an asset. Champion puts out a rock haze which surrounds him. The album opens and closes with its best material.)
- Coup de Grass/RHYTHM & BLUEGRASS/Adelphia AD 2012 (Though the performance isn't quite as resilient as we've heard before, Coup de Grass plays an always appealing brand of bluegrass. All members are devotees and accomplished pickers yet the sense of generation loss is unescapable.)
- Fagen, Becker, Diaz/SOUNDTRACK - YOU GOTTA WALK IT/Visa IMP 7005 (Pre-Steely music should not be totally embarrassing to Fagen & Co. Further, it is not so outmoded even though it is the product of the early 70's. Even the movie music is O.K.)
- Kingfish/TRIDENT/Jet JZ 35479 (Trident provides an easily digested array of songs. Side one, especially, collects some nicely harmonized levelies. The album is solid in all areas of presentation too.)
- Klaatu/SIR ARMY SUIT/Capitol SW-11836 (Production and arranging aficionados will appreciate the constructions included in this new Klaatuness. Romantics, those who want to whistle the tunes and not the scenery will find less inspiration in Sir Army Suit grooves. The Beatle harmonizing remains. "Dear Christine" comes close to the proper balance.)
- Leo Kottke/BURNT LIPS/Chrysalis CHR 1191 (The essential Leo Kottke is allowed display space. This Lp's attitude is somber and it recalls that an important ingredient of Leo's first album, probably his most acclaimed, was its humor. It was downright funny. That has been missing in most of the rest of his recorded work. The guitar tracks are killers, especially the last track.)
- Joachim Kuhn Band/SUNSHOWER/Atlantic SD 19193 (Resting on its imposing musicianship alone Sunshower has the power to grab you. The melodic level is less potent, though it rarely dips to the negative. Of the tunes, "You're Still On My Mind" is the most arresting. Both the straight-forward melody and the Kuhn's piano solo are elements which endure through many hearings.)

- 1994:/A&M SP 4709 (Their name is the most encouraging thing seen in a long time. Maybe we have a future after all. Jack Douglas' production gives 1994 the assurance of veterans. Power rock with decent tunes and a great album cover.)
- Lee Oskar/BEFORE THE RAIN/Elektra 6E-150 (Lee has a way with a simple melody. He knows how to embellish it so that meat is put on the bones without it resulting in musical obesity. Stick with the hot rhythms.)
- Savoy Brown/SAVAGE RETURN/London PS 718 (Counting the comebacks of Kim Simmonds can put you to sleep like counting sheep. Here he is again and his rock rucks. The music takes a straight course through the rock diameter.)
- The Shirts/Capitol SW-11791 (Starting with a strong impression is important, a great name and smart cover design establish The Shirts positively. When into their music the band isn't quite as captivating. Their performance is O.K., though not fresh, while their songs are the same O.K.)

MERIT ALBUMS CONTINUED

- Various Artists/ROLLIN' THE ROCK VOL. 3/Rollin' Rock LP 015 (If you still desire a sense of fun in your music don't miss this California Rockabilly stuff. It's obviously a trend sweeping Van Nuys, Ca. These performances are strong too. Write: 6918 Peach Ave., Van Nuys, Ca. 91406.)

SATISFACTORY ALBUMS

(Albums of acceptable quality, which, of themselves, require only secondary progressive radio consideration.)

- Tempest/Earth (Suffering from frailties of material Tempest loses listener interest in spite of their good points. Jeff Wells shows he can play his axe and Barbara Pennington can sing, though she is forced to oversing to make the songs work. More interesting arranging would have helped. Write: 2036 Pasket, Houston, Tex. 77092.) (ER 0378A)

FRINGE ALBUMS

(Good albums which are not progressive, yet hold some interest for progressive audiences.)

- Scott Hamilton/2/Concord Jazz CJ-61 (Twenty-three year old Scott Hamilton is a great 1940's saxophone player. The haze built into his horn playing gives him a gritty, bluesy quality like that associated with Coleman Hawkins. This record grooves.)
- Moe Koffman/MUSEUM PIECES/Janus JXS-7037 (At its core Moe's music is a mellow sort of elegant form of jazz. It has its more explosive moments and those moments are our focus. Side one centers around "Rocks" and side two's "Dinosaur" strikes with some force.)
- Tony Orlando/Elektra 6E-149 (One hard truth is that Tony Orlando's name is an album radio negative. Another truth is that the production approach applied here would place this record on the fringes with or without Orlando. Finally, another truth is that these songs are all classics and some of the tracks would fit well in an album radio context and because of truth number one, they probably will get less time than they deserve.)

SPECIAL PROGRAMMING

(Spoken, poetry - comedy and extraneous musics.)

- Philip Glass/SOLO MUSIC/Shandar 83 515 (Your VU meter doesn't move much under the hypnotic drone of Glass' ever evolving repetitions. They are mesmerizing and spaced at the same time. Electronic music without a plug.)
- Tahuantinsuyo/MUSIC OF THE ANDES/Adelphi AD 3001 (A warm, mellow Spanish flavored music blows through this ethnic album which has a jazzy, contemporary feel to it. Pleasing sounds.)
- John Williams & Friends/TWO GUITARS, TWO MARIMBAS & BASS/Columbia M 35108 (These beautiful classical pieces are contemporized by these arrangements for the instruments listed above. They remain stately but, ring with the warm clarity of meticulous craftsmen. A relief.)

(All Merit and Merit Plus Albums are recommended for serious progressive radio consideration, recognizing that not all of these recommendations are suitable for all stations. The Merit Plus Albums distinguish themselves with an extra vitality.)

Boston/DON'T LOOK BACK/Epic FE 35050 (Ditto.)

Joe Cocker/LUXURY YOU CAN AFFORD/Asylum 6E-145 (Contrary to his apparent decline, Joe has made several fine recordings recently. This is one of them. With Allen Toussaint's guidance and choice of material Joe just has to take care of singing his guts out. And he does. Each side starts stronger than it ends.)

Tim Curry/READ MY LIPS/A&M SP 4717 (Just reading the list of songwriters from whom music was chosen provides the clue to a very diverse Lp. Tim Curry's big voice is applied to a range stretching from Roy Wood to Joni Mitchell to Irving Berlin. "Sloe Gin" is suicidal while "Anyone Who Had A Heart" is Tom Jones. Go figure it. Tim does manage to break the boredom, he's a singer with many voices.)

Greg Kihn/NEXT OF KIHN/Berserkley JBZ-0056 (Previously reviewed as an import. With a tune like "Remember" Greg's music shifts to a post-naive stage. He makes the change easily in a natural progression. Super writing and a high quality performance make the Next Of Kihn significant.)

MERIT PLUS ALBUMS CONTINUED

Jean-Luc Ponty/COSMIC MESSENGER/Atlantic SD 19189 (Consistency is the key phrase here. Ponty's fusion band is truly fused to the music and the music is always "B" quality, never "C" and never "A". Some of the soloing reaches beyond.)

Gil Scott-Heron & Brian Jackson/SECRETS/Arista AD 4189 (It was a time for change. The loose recording style had been done. So the move to Malcolm Cecil's T.O.N.T.O. studio was wise. However, the heavier dose of production has an inhibiting affect on the vitality of the music, a vitality which Heron and Jackson are noted for having. Still, they start at a higher level and this is a satisfying album.)

Robin Trower/CARAVAN TO MIDNIGHT/Chrysalis CHR 1189 (A ponderable in the universe of rock music is that more guitarists haven't learned the lesson a Robin Trower teaches. That is to find a special way to express yourself. Trower's guitar is forever enticing. Placed in the context of so many better than average songs, it becomes luminescent. Robin is making music which can stand up to repeated hearings.)

MERIT ALBUMS

The Allstars/TIP YOUR WAITRESS/Adelphi AD 4112 (A certified blues band. The feel and the tunes are good but the Joplinesque vocals of Lucille Schoettle stand out. She's potential dynamite in a band that makes a medium bang.)

The Bees Kness/Derrick DRC 1000 (A glossy rock venture by The Bees Knees are lead by their pretty harmonies. Wisely they do not oversweeten the sound with orchestrations. Instead their quite acceptable material is allowed to find its own place. The labels are pressed onto the wrong sides of the album. Write: 4447 N. Central Exprwy., Suite 440, Dallas, Texas 75205.)

Louis Belson & Walfredo De Los Reyes/ECUE/Pablo 2310 807 (In a certain way Latin-jazz is timeless. Its rhythms were hot in the '50's and they remain so in the '70's. Here the electric and acoustic soloing carries a strong enough melodic message to hold it together.)
