# RADIO STATS

OUR RELATIVE CHARTING, AS SEEN BELOW, RESEMBLES BASEBALL'S BATTING AVERAGES. IT ESTABLISHES A RATIO BETWEEN THE IDEAL, (HEAVY AIRPLAY AT EVERY STATION WHICH REPORTED); AND THE WEIGHTED COUNT THAT A RECORDING HAS ACTUALLY EARNED. THIS MATHEMATICAL FORMULA IS APPLIED TO EACH RECORD—FIRST REGIONALLY, THEN NATIONALLY. A DUAL WEIGHTING SYSTEM IS USED TO DERIVE THE COUNT. IT ADJUSTS FOR MARKET SIZE AND FOR HEAVY OR MODERATE AIRPLAY. THESE CHARTS SHOW THE RELATIVE INTENSITY OF RADIO AIRPLAY FOR BOTH NEW AND ESTABLISHED RECORDINGS.

## SATISFACTORY ALBUMS CONTINUED

The Gregory James Quartet/ALICIA/Inner City 1050 (Light weight. They are trying to play a very subtle, delicate style of jazz which sounds a step or two beyond their ability to control. Especially in the rhythm section, things don't seem to jell easily.)

## FRINGE ALBUMS

(Good albums which are not progressive, yet hold some interest for progressive audiences.)

The Cryers/Mercury SRM 1-3734 (White bread. Enriched, pretty pop rock. The Cryers have a batch of decent tunes but the presentation is the issue. It lacks grit. Stay in the corners, the opening and closing tracks of each side.)

The Harold Danko Quartet featuring Gregory Herbert/Inner City 1029 (A lively be-bop set issues from this breezy quartet. The phrase "featuring Gregory Herbert" is especially true, for it is Gregory's sax which is the centerpiece. He is an earthy player who will be heard from in a leadership role.)

Dan Fogelberg-Tim Weisberg/TWIN SONS./Epic-Full Moon JE 35339 (Dan Fogelberg and the Moody Blues have special dispensation to sweeten beyond normal limits of endurance. Both can do it because their melodies are often especially alluring. That is certainly true with this Lp. However, the thrust of this Lp is downright easy listening. Pretty, but easy listening. Try "Tell Me To My Face," "Hurtwood Alley" and "The Power Of Gold.")

Henry Gaffney/ON AGAIN OFF AGAIN/Manhattan Island MR-LA 861-H (After an inspired remake of "Mack The Knife" Henry slips into his own mental ballad music. It feeds a depression which only the lonely know well. "Breakout" rocks a little. Distributed by United Artists.)

Stephane Grappelli/UPTOWN DANCE/Columbia JC 35415 (Blessed Stephane Grappelli can fit into any musical environment but, he is favored when in a swingin' setting. Claus Ogerman's big arrangements sometimes have trouble getting out of the way. Grappelli comes through loudly and clearly as a man of extraordinary sensitivity. This album is the best thing to happen to easy listening in years.)

The Moirs/STATE OF SHOCK/Rocket BXL 1-2956 (Easy listening with fair songs and soprano harmonies.)

Phyrework/Mercury SRM 1-3738 (As a pop R&B band, Phyrework holds only secondary interest for us. But, one instrumental track called "Mystic Mariner" shows some unexpected depth. If they wanted to do something less standard, that track points the way.)

Jimmy Ponder/ALL THINGS BEAUTIFUL/LRC 9322 (ROR jazz. Clean production and excellent playing set the scene for Jimmy's light guitar stroke. "Chasing That Face" is the only heated element. Distributed by T.K.)

The Rockspurs/DJM - 15 (Rockspurs' pop rock runs its course on side one. The second side needed more in the tune department. One song sheds the gloss, "Rock N' Roll Killer.")

Jorge Santana/Tomato TOM-7020 (Pop to disco in feeling this Santana's band has a light, resilient quality to it. Not as Latin as you might expect, the tunes are O.K.)

Lalo Schifrin/GYPSIES/Tabu JZ 35436 (Like an impotent Latin lover, Lalo's music has a manicured facade but it comes across as being sterile. All spontaneity has been exorcised out by a thorough perfection process. The music does not sound like a sincere expression of an artist yet, it is not flawed technically.)

Space/DELIVERANCE/Casablanca NBLP 7111 (In an effort to distinguish between the formula followers and the innovators in disco music, we offer Space. Decent songs are found throughout the Lp and the tunes are treated with interesting, non-stock arrangements. Thoughtful disco.)

Joe Thomas/GET IN THE WIND/LRC 9321 (Pop jazz pap.)

Sonny Throckmorton/LAST CHEATER'S WALTZ/Mercury SRM 1-3736 (A new name for the pop country genre. Sonny has something extra, a down to earth rockin' sound which is not at all phony. Touch down on "I Wish You Could Have Turned My Head," "I'm Knee Deep In Lovin' You" and "I'm Turning You Loose.")

## SPECIAL PROGRAMMING

(Spoken, poetry - comedy and extraneous musics.)

Linda Cohen/ANGEL ALLEY/Tomato TOM-7010 (Her music is on the melancholy, down side. Her best tunes are gray in tone. Linda's classical approach to the guitar commands respect and her uniqueness does too. Intelligent background.)

Don Pullen/MONTREUX CONCERT/Atlantic SD 8802 (Pullen moves to the outside. First he plays the real time melody then he slides laterally into the pianistic ozone layer. Montreux is associated with a more traditional brand of jazz. Two long pieces of inner-space music make up the Lp.)

Synergy/CORDS/Passport PB 6000 (Just as Boston releases an album with a categorical denial of the use of computers and such, Larry Fast admonishes that his Lp "was recorded using only electronic music devices." Cords is powerful, forefront music. Our only criticism is one which extends through all Synergy Lp's. That is that the music misses drums, acoustic or synthetic, to drive it.)

# CONCEPTS

## OIL & WATER ARE MIXING

Television and rock n' roll have had a weird relationship. Neither medium has ever trusted the other fully. It's always been The Suites against The Streets. The few long term relationships existed due, primarily, to a person like Dick Clark who was, somehow, able to bridge the gap. But on the whole it's been a twain that rarely would meet.

Things are changing now because the record business is changing. Prime time T.V. is now carrying commercials for record albums. Not K-Tel amalgomes, but current hit Lps by current stars.

One of the early ones on prime time was Fleetwood Mac. Recently, Gerry Rafferty has been on the tube and we understand that a Springsteen spot is on its way.

A few interesting points to be made are that big hit records of today are now big enough to justify the expenditure of a T.V. advertising campaign. Another point is the timing of this advertising. In the case of both Fleetwood Mac and Gerry Rafferty the ads began running after the Lp's had pretty much run their course. The idea was to reach out to those people in the passive audience. Those people who, though they may appreciate the artist, had not purchased an Lp. If all of the radio play, on the album and the single, hadn't moved them, it was time to bring in the heavy hitter, prime time television advertising.

As the inter-relationship of movies and records is changing, so too is the relationship of T.V. and records. The music business has grown past its adolescence and has joined its adult peers, finally.

## MERIT ALBUMS

- Jay Boy Adams/FORK IN THE ROAD/Atlantic SD 19195 (The moods of the south and the west co-mingle in Jay Boy's music. Fork In The Road has a loose feel to it and string glaze in spots. That gets a mixed reaction. The songs are good.)
- Willie Alexander & The Boom Boom Band/MEANWHILE...BACK IN THE STATES/WCA 2052 (Well the boom boom is in place even if the album isn't dominated with great songs. The attitude is even more important and it does dominate.)
- Ken Bloom/Flying Fish 051 (Showing us everything he can and cannot do is the result of this diverse album. Ken is obviously a super player, one of those natural musicians who can play anything he picks up. But, he shouldn't sing lead out of the shower. Folk music is the base from which all of the ideas emerge.)
- The Boyzz/TOO WILD TO TAME/Epic JE 35440 (If you saw the movie, you'll love the cover. If you like rock density, you'll love The Boyzz. When they hit the songs at the right angle, these midwest blazers connect solidly. Try "Hoochie Koochie" and "Shady Lady.")
- The New Brubeck Quartet/LIVE AT MONTREUX/Tomato TOM-7018 (Though only lightly electronicized The New Brubeck Quartet generates some significant heat. Dave's discipline is pervasive and the drive of his sons is relentless. They make a nice package. There is no letting up on side two.)
- Chavin/JET LAG/C.P. JL 777 (Though Chavin's album has ups and downs, his ups are worth some effort to acquire. This recording rocks with authority. Side one starts with surprising strength while side two is more spotty. Write: Box 7142, Berkeley, Ca. 94707.)
- Fapa John Creach/INPHASION/DIM-18 (Contrasting textures are the key to Inphasion. There is fuzzed rock, lighter rock and a few lovely ballads on side two which represent the Lp's best writing. It's all capped with the countryish "Southern Strut." Pick and choose.)
- Dyan Diamond/IN THE DARK/MCA 2053 (An industrial grade diamond, to be sure. In The Dark presents a believability problem. Is the Lp's rootedness a product of Kim Powley or is it an outgrowth of Dyan? The need to ask the question predicts the answer. Dyan's songs are O.K.)
- Fonda Fingold/Mercury SRM 1-1721 (The torch singer class increases steadily. Fonda adds her unusual name to the list with a decent but colorless album. Individually the tracks work well enough, without being overdone, together they won't rivet attention.)
- Alan Gordon/ALLEY & THE SOUL SEEKERS/Capitol SW-11845 (In an unusual marriage of style and technique Alan Gordon makes a standout first side. Rooted sunk deeply into the rhythm and blues of the 50's, Gordon's style is predestined. Yet the recording approach is strictly the most up-to-date. The result is a thoroughly modern record with a long history. Side two, however, falls apart stylistically. It has none of the class of the old days, it's shallow by comparison.)
- Happy The Man/CRAFTY HANDS/Arista AB 4191 (Album number one had serious arranging flaws which implied serious compositional problems. More much of that is resolved in tunes which have beginnings, middles and ends. Still Russian, Happy The Man employs drama as a major arranging ploy. Nice stride.)
- Dan Hill/FROZEN IN THE NIGHT/20th Century T-558 (Dan Hill's music is a wrenching emotional experience. It requires similar experiences in human relations for full appreciation. Co-writing with Barry Mann is healthy. All tempos are mediums and all arrangements are flawless, they go by the book.)
- The Chris Hinze Combination/BAMBOO MAGIC/Atlantic SD 19185 (The thrust of Chris' work has been in a hot combo setting. Bamboo Magic develops whole tone poems, washes of sound in broader strokes than a combo could generate. This style has broader appeal and, although the combo is in evidence, this style is more than merely an extension of the Hinze combo.)
- Tommy Kocher/LEADING YOU TO BELIEF/London PS 719 (An interesting voice and a punchy accompaniment take Tommy's basic songs a long way. Still there is a feeling that more could have been gotten out of the mix.)
- Janis Ian/Columbia JC 35325 (The overproduction of Janis' last Lp is gone in a sparse, delicate Joe Wissert production. Instead monotonic tempos and textures tend to work against this album. The really strong Janis Ian writing ability is evident here and there but not everywhere. One of her best "Silly Habits" tends to get lost at the end of side one.)
- Steve Khan/THE BLUE MAN/Columbia JC 35539 (Khan plays with more command and gall than ever before. He does it to the accompaniment of the perfection of the N.Y. studio aces. But, he is really offering six extended solos as melodies - there is a difference. His solos are pleasing at the moment while a melody always has a chance for eternity.)
- Listen featuring Mel Martin/GROWING/Inner City 1055 (Though a hard pressing sometimes makes it hard to listen, the potency of Listen is easy to hear. A vast array of influences fills their music with variety yet, they maintain continuity with raw determination.)

- The Jeff Lorber Fusion/SOFT SPACE/Inner City 1056 (Soft Space is a good name for this soft fusion album. Jeff has one foot planted firmly in jazz while the other points toward rock. His melodies are pleasing and the rhythms swing.)
- Bobby Lyle/NEW WARRIER/Capitol SW-11809 (Two separate themes run through this album. One is Bobby Lyle the rhythm and blues singer, distinguished by a great baritone voice and good songs. The other is Bobby Lyle the untamed jazz fusionist keyboard master. A couple tracks on each side prove that Lyle deserves an album for each of his abilities.)
- David Mallett/Newworld NWS 042977 (Basic folk music appeals to basic folks. David's songs follow classic lines which makes them easily digestible. His singing is pleasant too. Write: South Blue Hill, Maine 04615.)
- Chuck Mangione/CHILDREN OF SANCHEZ/A & M SP-6700 (Record two is the place to go. It solves all of the musical and radio format problems which work against record one. The tracks are short and in many cases musically stronger. When Chuck sticks to his simple melodies, he communicates best. Complexity in concept or execution is antithetical to the Mangione nature. Children Of Sanchez is a project which blows hot and cold.)
- Mantilla/Inner City 1052 (Combine top-notch Latin percussionists with solid jazzers and you get a blend of taste and heat. Jeremy Steig produces this album with care to keep Ray in proper perspective. Percussionists tend to wrongly dominate their own Lp's. Side two is more involving.)
- Jimmy McGriff/OUTSIDE LOOKING IN/LRC 9320 (It seems as though everyone solos except Jimmy McGriff. This spunky little album throbs on a disco-like beat and takes off on the solos. While it doesn't out 'n' out rock 'n' roll, it sure enough borrows liberally. Distributed by T.K.)
- Willie Nelson/FACE OF A FIGHTER/Lone Star L-4602 (Pictures of the current Willie Nelson grace the cover of the album which was recorded in 1961. But, that's not quite as misleading as it seems because his voice and the subtlety which he is able to bend it around a lyric are intact. Some new famous sidemen are also impressive here. Quality aged country music.)
- Michael Nesmith/LIVE AT THE PALAIS/Pacific Arts PAC 7-110 (With a very solid rockin' band behind him, Michael's easy songs are placed in their best setting. The quality of his writing still goes underappreciated. The mix tends to put the Nesmith droll in an audio hole. Natural.)
- Pierce Arrow/PITY THE RICH/Columbia JC 35307 (Pierce Arrow is a mildly successful attempt at synergy. It brings together several musical loose ends to make a group bigger than the sum of its parts. Smooth and harmonized songs are the appeal though they could use a contrasting rough edge.)
- Player/DANGER ZONE/RSO RS 1-1035 (A solid pop-rock band, Player creates nothing new but, contributes to the overall quality of the medium. Songwriting rather than style is their forte.)
- David Pritchard/LIGHT-YEAR/Inner City 1047 (Playing a fusion influenced guitar in a traditional jazz setting up sets standard balance. But, it succeeds in bringing the older form into this era. Dexterity and melody fight for dominance.)
- Various Artists/THE FESTIVAL TAPPS/Flying Fish 068 (Featuring many of the top non-Nashville pickers - John Hartford, Byron Berline, etc. - this album represents both the field and the 1977 version of the Telluride Bluegrass Festival. Recording quality is pretty fair. Fun.)
- Frank Weber/AS THE TIME FLIES/RCA AFL 1-2963 (A male torch singer. As The Time Flies is an experiment in psychoanalysis by songwriting; only the listener lies on the couch. Frank's sublimated libido unravels in the grooves of his record. But, are his melodies worth the time? Make it the same time next week. That'll be \$50. "Straighten Up And Fly Right" is best.)
- Gregg Wright/KHAMSIN/The Record Co. Of The South MCSA 1001 (Immediately striking is the feeling Gregg gets in his arrangements. The instrumental strength of this album is proven further in the two hot, jazzy instrumentals. Wright is a fine guitarist and a fair songwriter. No address given.)
- O.V. Wright/THE BOTTOM LINE/Hi HLP 6008 (Rhythm and blues, in the classic sense, is out of style only to those with a limited perspective. The music of O.V. Wright and Willie Mitchell is timeless, it is core. Fine songs taken in easy time.)

## SATISFACTORY ALBUMS

(Albums of acceptable quality, which, of themselves, require only secondary progressive radio consideration.)

- The Boppers/Fantasy F-9562 (The ever-growing list of competent but fundamentally empty bands is extended by The Boppers. They have little to say musically and nothing to say lyrically. But, the play and the production is first rate. It's hard to figure out what you're listening to.)

(These records, which, in our opinion, deserve special mention because they come closest to perfecting their musical genre regardless of progressive radio application.)

### STRONGLY MERITORIOUS

(We feel that these Lp's have an extra edge.)

Blondie/PARALLEL LINES/Chrysalis CHR 1192 (You don't think of new ravers as using understatement but, that is precisely the winning device which distinguishes Ms. Harry. She sings several enchanted melodies with calculated disinterest. Projecting a careless attitude she rides a wave of intense accompaniment. It's a chancey style because some great tunes can get lost on the casual listener. Fresh.)

Plastic Bertrand/CA PLANE POUR MOI/Sire SRK 6061 (Could Plastic Bertrand be the first French rock act to mean anything in the States? Infectious rhythms and melodies spiced with originality just might be enough to overcome the language barrier. The single was just the beginning. A crack in the boredom.)

### MERIT PLUS ALBUMS

(All Merit and Merit Plus Albums are recommended for serious progressive radio consideration, recognizing that not all of these recommendations are suitable for all stations. The Merit Plus Albums distinguish themselves with an extra vitality.)

City Boy/BOOK EARLY/Mercury SRM 1-3737 (Soaring harmonies put a shiver into densely mounted songs. Simple it is not, hot it is. The final peg is that with City Boy the material warrants the effort. English.)

Coryell-Catherine/SPLENDID/Elektra 6E-153 (A veritable guitar festival. Larry seems to benefit most from this association in that he has been known to get lost in all of the things he can do. Philip helps him focus his energy better. The result is an enormously skillful collusion which is magical and also musically satisfying. They are working at a higher level.)

### MERIT PLUS ALBUMS CONTINUED

Faith Band/ROCK 'N ROMANCE/Village VR 7805 (Strategically placed through Rock N' Romance are some very special songs. Given that Faith Band is unusually gifted instrumentally and Carl Storie is a top rank vocalist, those songs are all they need to step out of the crowd of rock pretenders. Write: 6325 Guilford Ave., Suite 4, Indianapolis, Ind. 46220.)

Daryl Hall & John Oates/ALONG THE RED LEDGE/RCA AFL 1-2804 (A unique style of writing and a vocal approach perfectly suited to it yields a one-of-a-kind Hall & Oates. A very well ordered production by David Foster presents the songs at their best and keeps a host of important sidemen under control.)

John Lee Hooker/THE CREAM/Tomato TOM 2-7009 (The real thing is so much better than you remember it, that each return trip is as rich an experience as the original. Hooker is a unique character and his music reflects that. Notice how a real blues player rarely rushes it.)

Rezillos/CAN'T STAND THE.../Sire SRK 6057 (Starting with an Lp title which takes advantage of the love/hate feelings for punk music, The Rezillos show some cleverness. That follows through in their quite good pop punkish rockin'. Hot throughout the 13 songs.)

Spheroe/Inner City 1034 (Spheroe approaches its fusion style properly. They establish rich melodies before they go onto the riffing. Jazzers these days too often do little more than establish a feel before leaping into their solos. Treat Michel Perez's guitar with the respect of a McLaughlin. This European band is worth the time.)

Jack Tempchin/Arista AB 4193 (Assuming that the tinny test pressing we listened to will be corrected, it is a fine Jack Tempchin Lp which is presented here. Along with the inviting flavors of the southwest, he has packed his album with songs of consistently high quality. Easy.)

The Who/WHO ARE YOU/MCA 3050 (Though this may not be a great Who Lp, an enormous explosive potential resides in all of their Lps. Their songs have a tendency to grow more appealing as you hear them repeatedly. The power here is centered in the first half of each side.)
