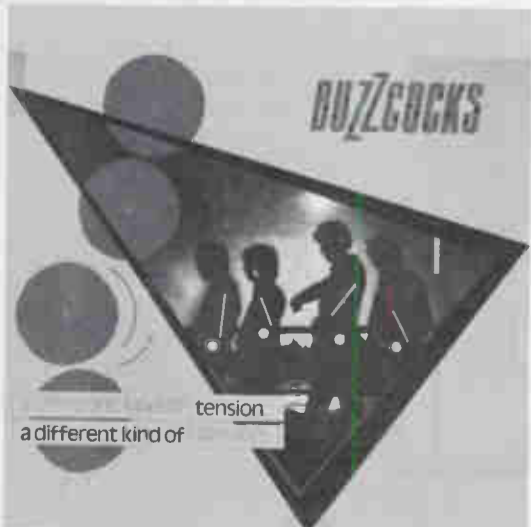

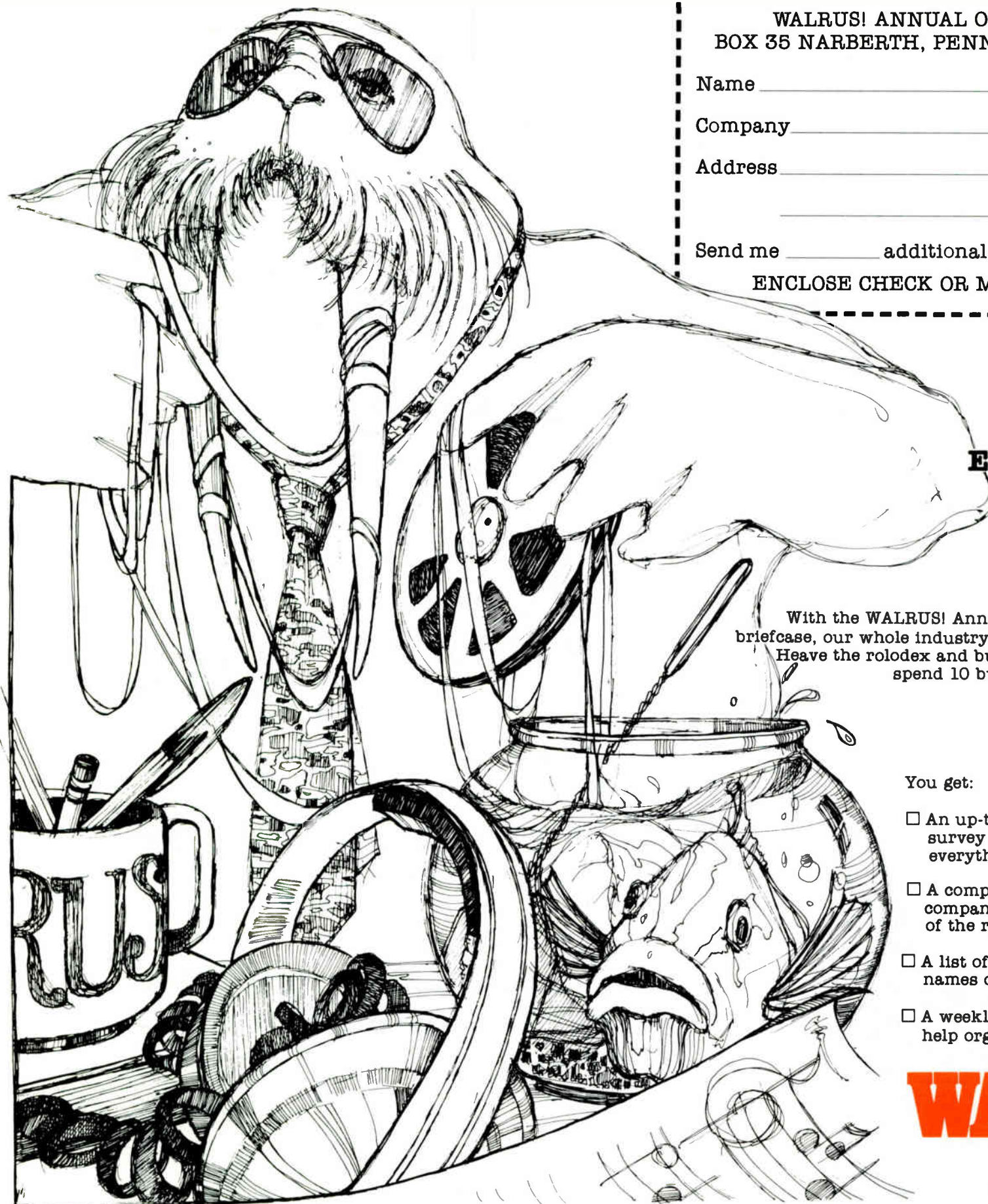

I'VE GOT BAD NEWS AND I'VE GOT BAD NEWS

If people in both the radio business and the record business understood research to half the degree they imply, we'd all be a lot more sane. A specific case in point is the Warner Communication study of the music business done a few years ago. It is one of the few studies done on the music business and, since it was so recent, it will likely stand as the final statement for some time to come.

Unfortunately, the study has been widely misread and misinterpreted.

As an example, you will remember that one of the findings was that \$9.98 was determined to be the consumer resistance point for LP pricing. The whole record industry, buoyed by their new knowledge, allowed costs and contracts to escalate partly because they knew it all could be made back. And so started the march, a dollar at a time, to the current price.

The misreading comes when the phrase "consumer resistance point" is deemphasized while "\$9.98" is emphasized. Just reading the \$9.98 part was wishful thinking.

That's all old business.

The new idea is that yet another area of the WCI study now seems incorrectly understood. The study showed that, in reverse of prior trend, people continued to buy records beyond their early twenties. To that point, accepted music sociology had suggested that once a teenage music lover got involved with family and work his discretionary income got used for purposes other than records. He slowly lost interest until he was heard to say that, "This music today is nothing like when I was a kid." The WCI study says that trend has changed. People well into their 30's were still buying records.

So the record industry assumed that their potential audience was finally widening. Unfortunately, that is a misleading interpretation.

What the surveyors didn't understand was the true sociology of pop music, that it is an 18 year old's medium. It was an 18 year old's medium during the swing era (Benny Goodman), during the crooner (Frank Sinatra), during the early rock era (Elvis Presley), and during the second rock era (Beatles/Dylan). The critical difference is to know that the Beatles/Dylan era lasted from 1964 to 1978, fully 5 years longer than it should have. As a result people well into their twenties and some in their thirties could still relate to pop music. The music hadn't changed into an alien being on cue as it had every other time. Eighteen year olds of the 1970's had no music of their own, so the people from the 1960's could still understand.

Because the study was done in 1977-78 it picked up lots of older, still interested people. But, that was just because the cycle had lasted too long.

One of the lessons of 1979 is that the Beatles/Dylan cycle began to break down. It will continue to do so.

It therefore follows, that if the WCI study were done today it would find people in the late 20's and early 30's dropping out of music again, unable to buy the vast majority of new rock music. They don't hear it, it has turned into the alien being. Popular music is being returned to the eighteen year olds from whom it came.

This scenario explains many of the difficulties of radio programming today. How much new music can be played? Which artists fit in with the older, established artists? Which older, established artists are just plain out of style? The answer to these questions is not simple, for it depends on which city and which part of the country a station is in. But, the



reality of this dilemma is pointed out by the emerging existence of a New Rock n' Roll Underground. This new underground consists of music which is too radical for radio and is best exemplified by our new NEW R N'R UNDERGROUND chart.

The scenario pictured above also explains some of the difficulties the record companies are having in selling records. The older rock audience is increasingly alienated by what it hears. The new music is the departure which they will not adjust to. It has turned into the alien being for them. At the same time the new music speaks to the younger audience but it does not do so on a universal level—at least not yet.

On one hand you have older rockers detaching while you have the younger ones just beginning to define their own terms. These cultural uncertainties do not help sales. They do account for such a soft market in general and for the turntable hit phenomenon seen with so many of the newer bands which do get airplay.

A trend is happening, however slowly in some areas of the country. Old trends don't fall off the ends of the earth with the appearance of something new. Old trends phase out as new ones phase in. Some transitions are smoother than others. This transition is resulting in a record business depression on the scale of the national depression of the 1930's and confusion on a radio level.

So much for the bad news.

CHART ANALYSIS

BY GEORGE MEIER

These charts represent some enthusiastic radio. The top ten records have been infiltrated by fresh music, strong enough to depose Tom Petty and to threaten the great wall of Floyd. It is Pink Floyd's western flank which is coming unglued first.

That is one of several distinct patterns of activity which comes out of this issue's Centerfold.

Another is the pattern noted here before in which new music gets base support in the northeast. This particular week makes that statement very definitely. Check the relative radio strength of the Pretenders, The Clash, Elvis Costello, the Ramones, and The Specials. The enduring point is that if these kinds of artists don't make it in the northeast, they have little chance of breaking into or out of some other region.

Zevon stands out in the northeast as does Gary Numan. But, Numan is even stronger in the midwest.

Notably, ZZ Top and Robin Trower are soft in the northeast.

The south is also contributing to certain careers. Heart, Bob Seger, and Mahogany Rush are starting there first. One of the sons of the south, Dan Fogelberg, is in general retreat on the radio side, but his sales continue to improve.

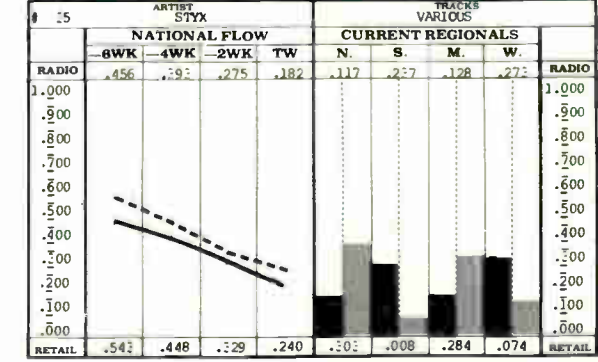
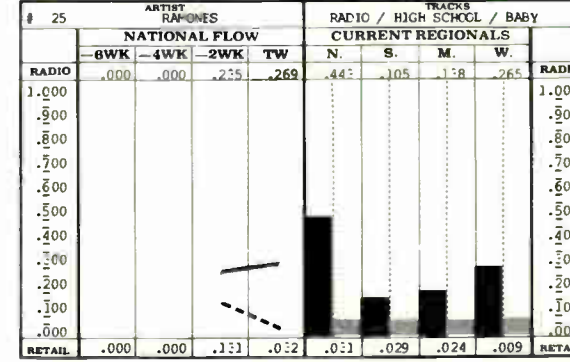
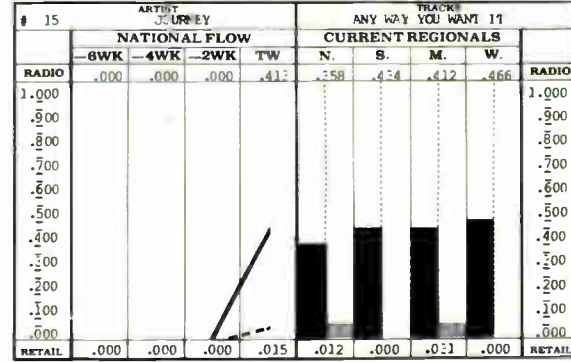
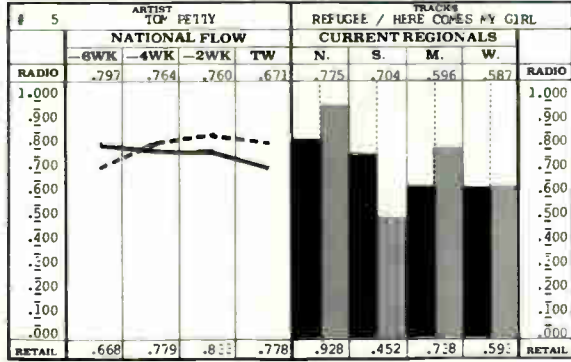
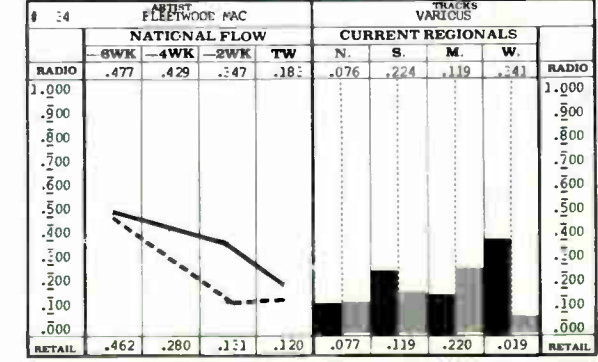
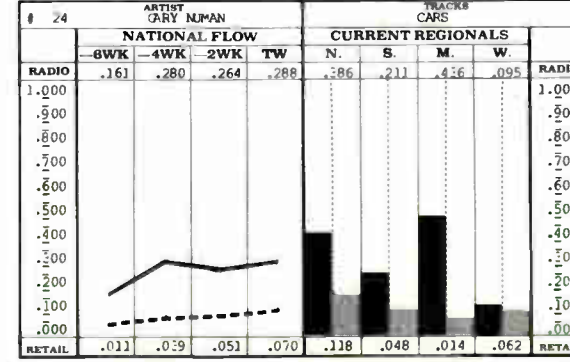
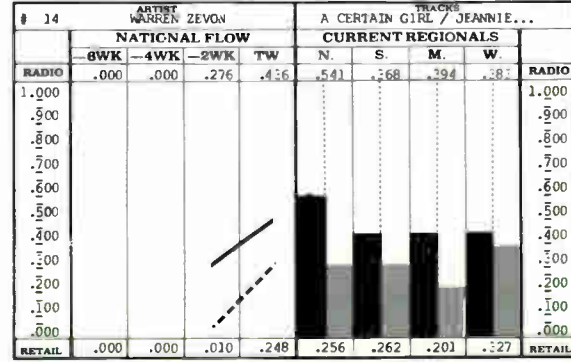
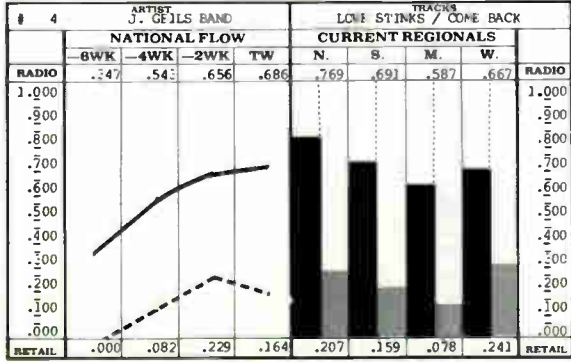
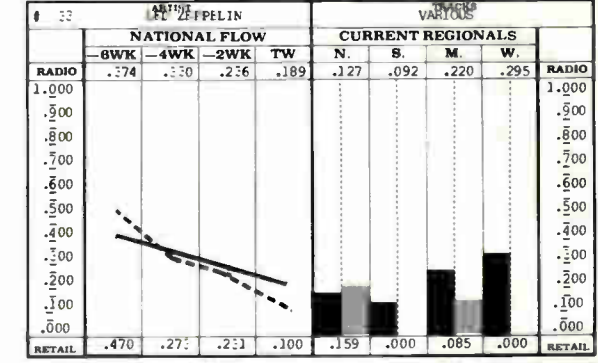
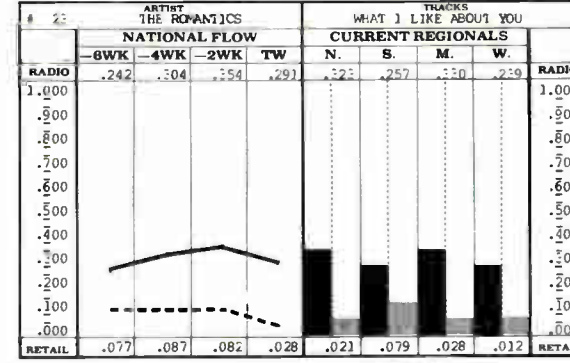
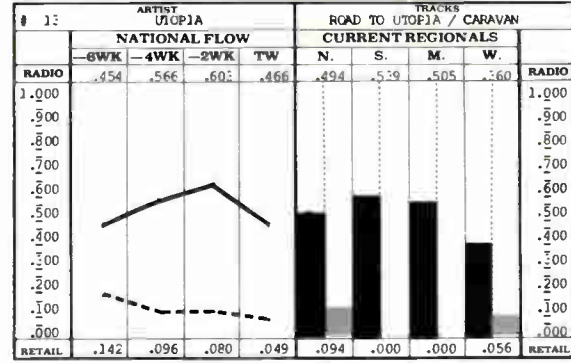
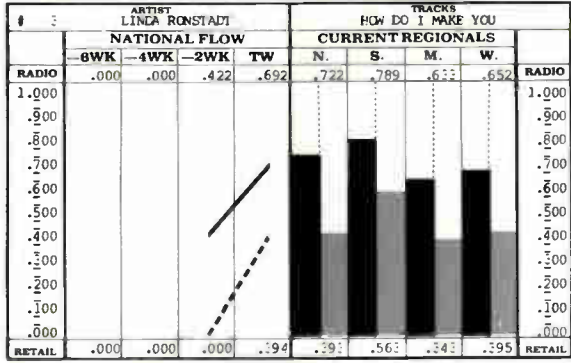
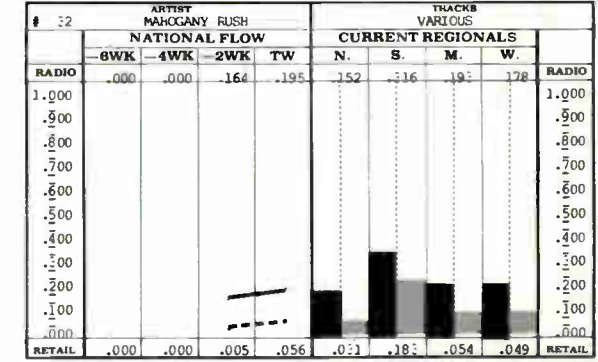
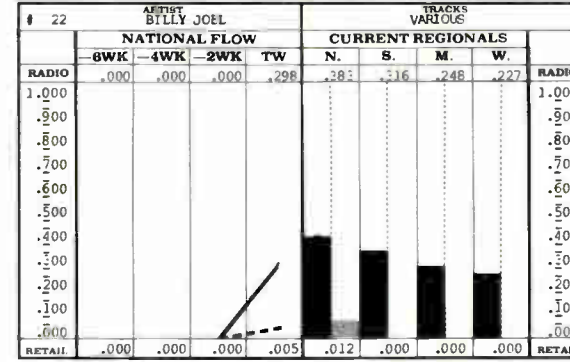
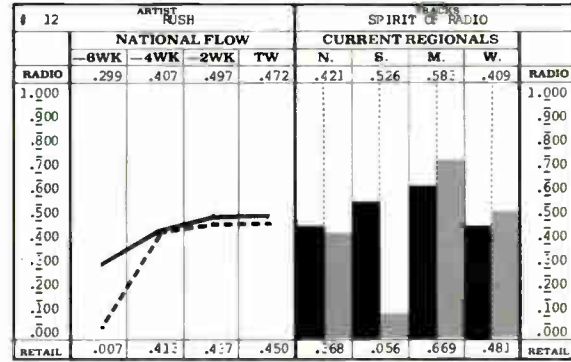
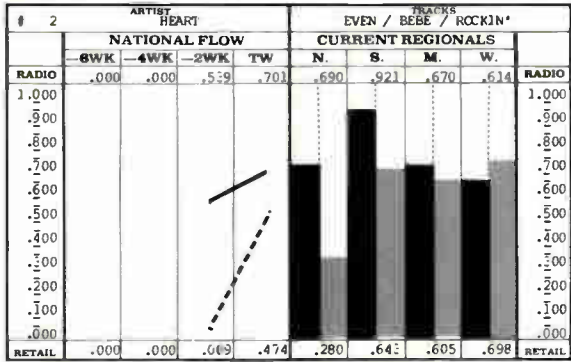
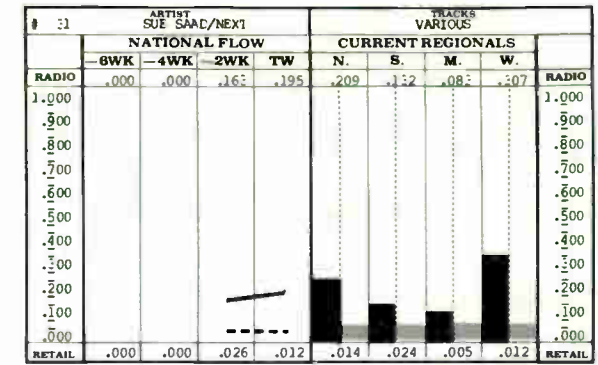
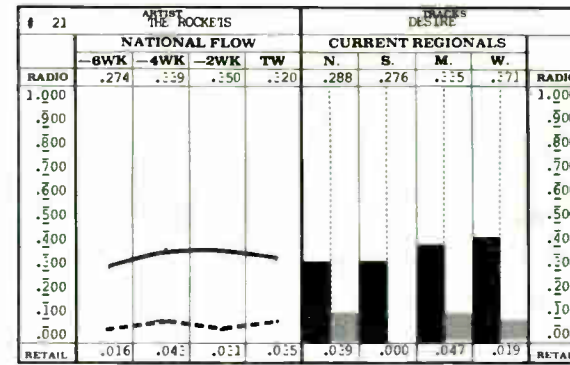
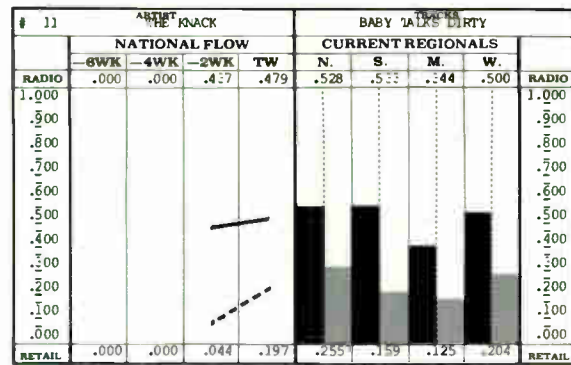
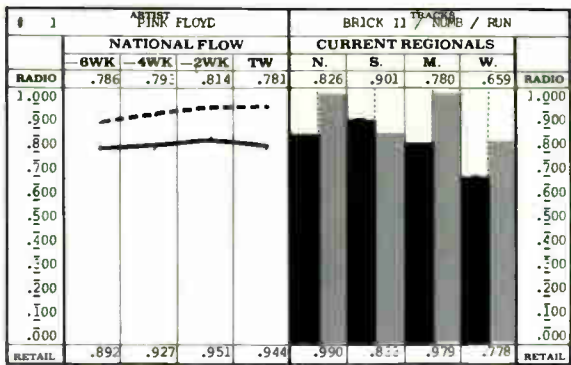

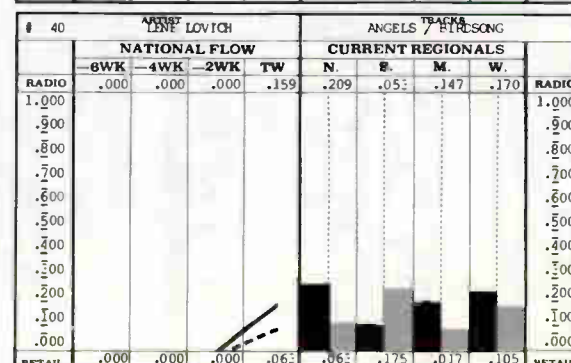
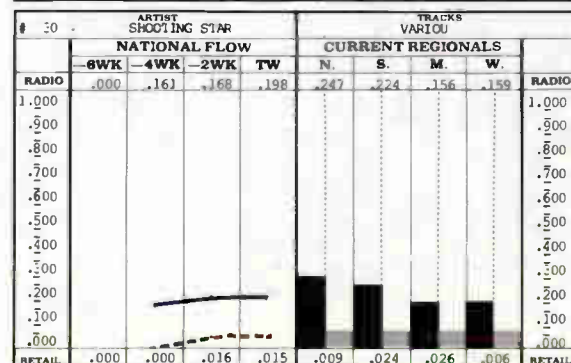
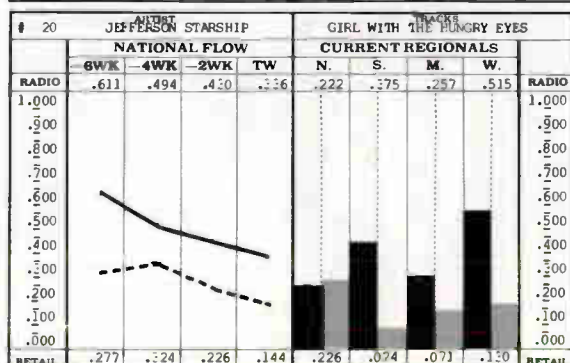
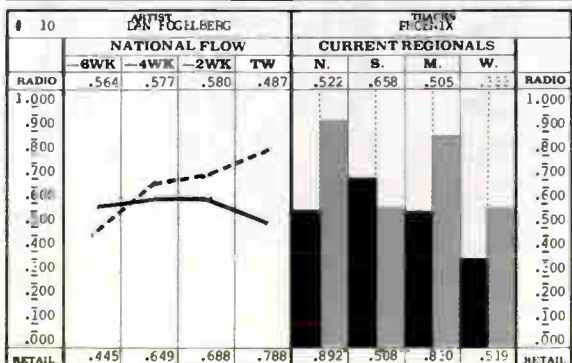
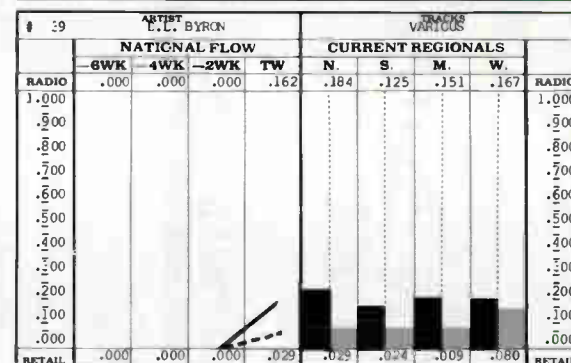
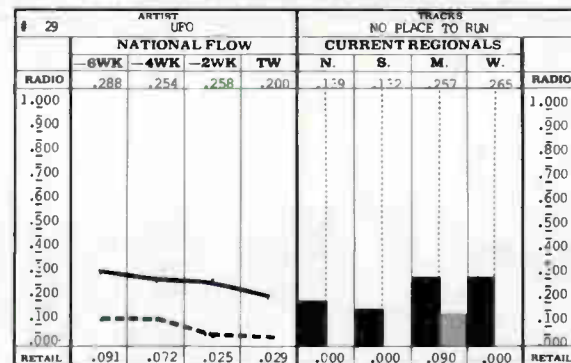
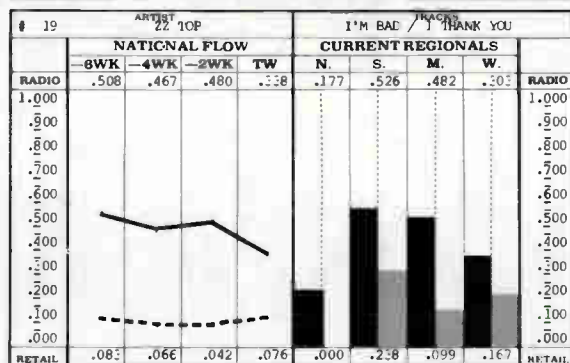
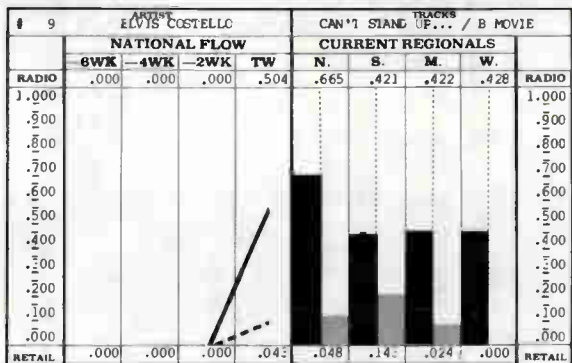
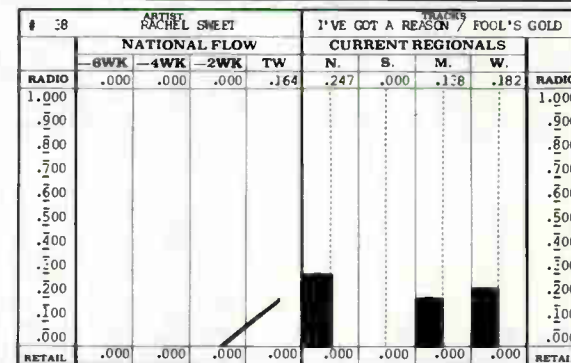
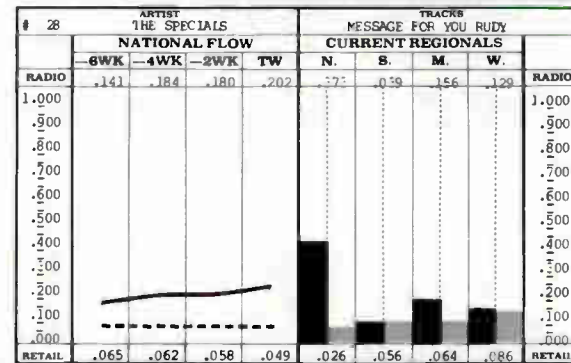
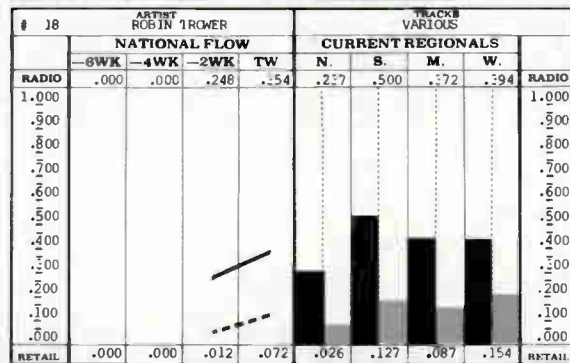
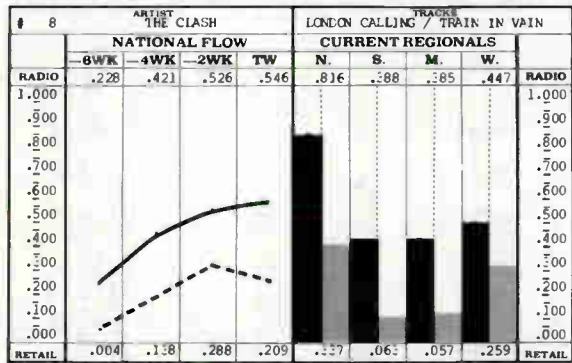
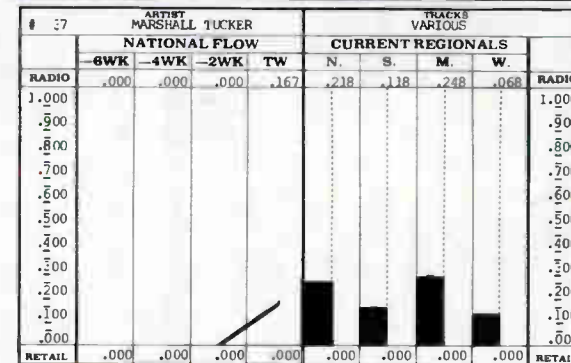
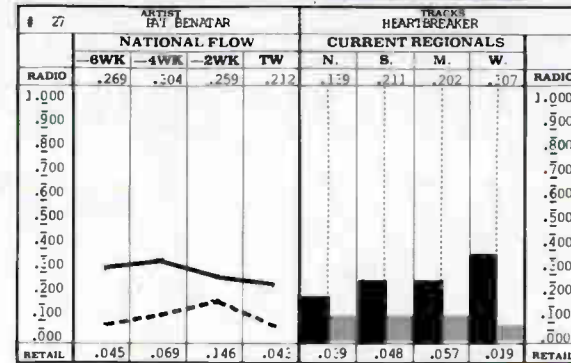
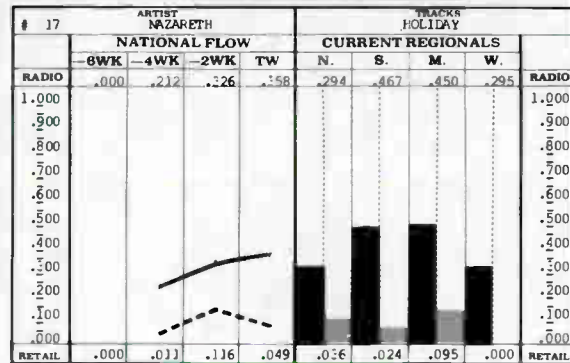
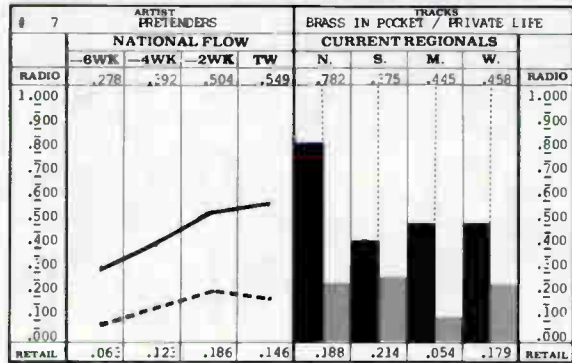
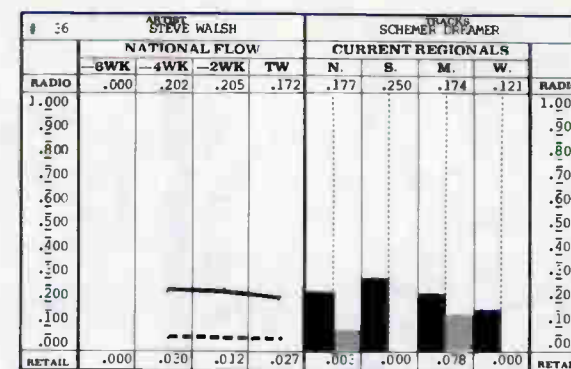
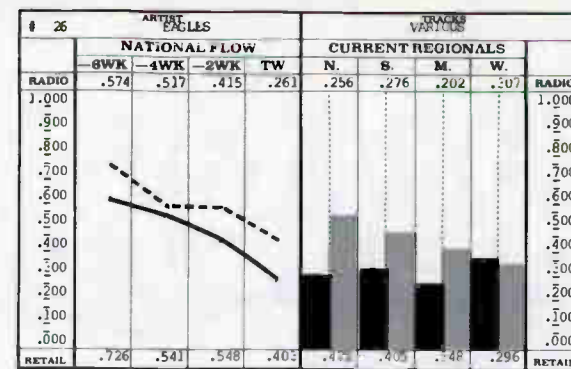
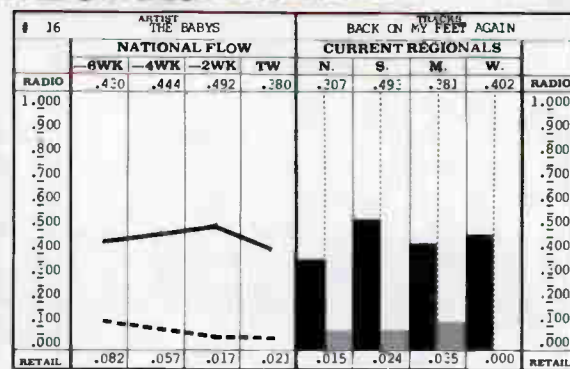
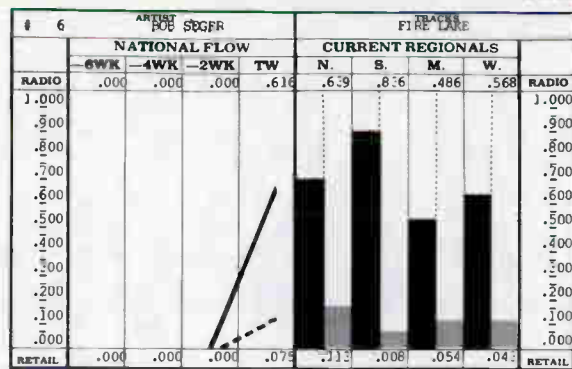
Yet another pattern we see is the discrepancy between airplay and sales on several records. Most notably among them is the J. Geils Lp. It does not seem to translate to the street in proportion to its radio approval. The same seems to be true, on a lesser scale, for Utopia, The Babys, and The Rockets.

Finally, it is interesting to note the effect new music is having on our older stars. Both Linda Ronstadt and Billy Joel respond by adopting a new music manner. It remains to be seen as to whether this is perceived to be genuine evolution or merely an attempt to stay on the constantly moving bandwagon.

RADIO CITY

That Bekins truck pulls up to begin the oft repeated process of packing up and leaving. Live light, travel light is the standard byword of the radio business. One must always be prepared, like a Boy Scout, to move and adjust. The last Radio City column explored those notably mobile programming people and how they cope with the changing climates. Our impression of the jock-as-gypsy is the standard but it is not the only variety in the species. There is a whole class which resembles the homebody pretty closely. These fellows, who have been in the same city for many years, have problems too. How does one manage to stay fresh in what can be a stale situation?

Denton Marr, long situated at Cincinnati's WEBN, thinks that staying hot is an "ongoing problem for someone in (his) position. Part of it is that there are no models. MOR radio (has) hundreds of jocks and programmers who have been at the same station for a long time. Part of it is that we do a lot of the same things from year to year. For example, right now we are in the midst of our 9th annual WEBN Winter Blood Drawing. We get people to donate blood . . . we offer them a small bribe to donate a pint of blood and then they have a shot at winning a big expensive stereo system. Over the years we've come up with around a thousand pints of blood, which is about 50 grand worth of blood."

"Some people might say, 'How can you get up for another blood drive?' I ask myself that sometimes, but part of the challenge is to get up for it, is to find a new twist on it. After 5 or 6 years, you've said every clever thing you can about blood. 'Roll up your arm and bend over.' 'Let it bleed.' 'We all need someone to bleed on' . . . I find that it is a challenge to come up with new ideas for the same theme, a new twist on a project, some new surprise to it."

Marr reflects on his years of success in Cincinnati by correctly thinking that it "may be more difficult to sustain and maintain something than to build it in the first place. You get the rush of being in a new town, in a new radio war . . . But for some, once (it) happens, then the thrill is gone."

For KBPI's **Frank Cody**, "boredom is a concept which is very foreign to me." He is rather philosophical about it. "A thing that I'm overwhelmed with is that we're sending thought, human thought and emotions through the air invisibly. That's magic." Like Denton Marr, Cody thinks about how you continually bring new ideas to an old situation. He notices that "the more you pull out of the well, the deeper the well seems to go. The creative ideas that come through my mind, stimulate my mind. It's sort of a natural process. I always laugh at these people who go out to L.A. (to) tape all the

PIXILATED

A sense of *deja vu* links many memories as the news that WPIX's experiment in new wave radio is sacked. Joe Piasek, Dan Neer and Meg Griffin are out and the station's new format is not clearly defined, although Top 40 is the operative phase.

For weeks rumours of an Abrams takeover have floated around, bolstered by claims by some prominent jocks that they had been offered PIX airshifts by the man.

It turns out, however, that Todd Wallace enters almost as a signal not to believe anything until you see it.

The shift seems like a case of management's over-expectations. Programming music at the edge tends to draw a noisy, though limited, cult audience. That was true in Alan Freed's day and in Tom Donahue's day. It is true, too, for Piasek and WPIX. They were successful, given their programming philosophy.

Someone, mistakenly, expected more, again.

stations. They come back and try to copy the rotation and copy the promotions . . . People who copy forget where ideas come from, that ideas come from a working mind, not a mind that can just duplicate."

Still, Frank has friends from whom he can draw. "Occasionally someone will do a great promotion and they'll pick up the phone and call me . . . the idea may be so hot that I may think, wow, I'd like to adapt that."

No man is an island, and Frank notes that a "good program director surrounds himself with a complement of people who enhance the best traits and also maybe make up for your weakest traits." He needs time away from the station too. That helps to recharge the batteries.

Contrasting that draw-from-within-yourself approach is eternal Bostonian **Tommy Hedges'** approach: "I do a lot of travelling to other markets, just to sit down and listen. I think that has a tendency to keep you fresh in that it gives you an example of what's going on in other markets. Getting airchecks from other Blair offices is another thing we're able to do . . . I think that you can really get a feel for what's going on in a relatively short period of time by doing a quick check like that."

There's a point to be stressed in Hedges' thinking. He is obviously strong on open mindedness: "I think that there

are times where you might have reached the point where someone's going to say just because this hasn't worked here before, this could work (now)."

Years ago **John Gorman** left Boston to program the now legendary WMMS in Cleveland. He has maintained the station's intensity by treating everyday as a new day. If you have a daily newspaper, his analogy goes, it's filled with fresh news everyday. "We play on that same kind of feel . . . It's a case of not losing touch with the street. Of not just getting tied up in the industry bullshit. I've seen a lot of people come and go at other stations who just get tied up in not following the city but going to one promotion party meal after another, where it doesn't take long before you lose touch with what the street actually is . . . You have to really know what (the street) is because all the research input you can have doesn't mean anything if you can't translate into exactly what your city is." For John the formula is simple: "live on the street."

Chicagoian **Mitch Michaels** reflects the same feeling while bringing a special exuberance to the task. "This city is so hot it's always happening. I'm excited about the people who live here. This is not a town that's easy to live in. It's colder than hell, there's a lot of snow, you're not a wimp if you live here. There are strong people here. I like that feeling too. There are a lot of very intelligent, articulate people here in a lot of different walks of life. Politics is always interesting. The whole atmosphere here is always going and the city's bubbling more now than it ever has. The music scene has bubbled under for a long time and finally has broken out in the last 18 months. I'm talking about local music in clubs. I think what happened with Steve (Dahl) and the whole anti-disco movement. We've seen numerous discos turn back into rock and are drawing quite a few people there now than when they were discos and they were starving to death for the last year or two. So that situation has opened up a whole new venue for local bands to play again which has then in turn turned more people on to rock and roll."

Michaels argues, "you talk about a format that works here and works there, well, formats have to be geared locally. You can change the sound of the radio station but if it's not geared directly at what that marketplace is personally, locally, you're in trouble."

In a real way it's the same if you have been in a market for a long time or if you are new to it. Finding a town's heartbeat is the eternal problem.

Frank Cody said things one rarely hears in programmatic discussions. He complains "that people in radio forget that it's show business . . . we're here to entertain people . . . This is a medium of imagination."

NEW YORK AND LOS ANGELES

GREAT BUILDINGS, TEXTONES AND MORE LOCAL DOINGS: After several months of heated record company vying, Columbia is closing in on Great Buildings. By the time this column sees print, the L.A. foursome will probably be part of the CBS roster . . . The Scooters, another Angeleno aggregation, have inked with EMI/America . . . And the Orchids, an all-girl quintet guided by rock impresario Kim Fowley, have pacted with MCA . . . 20/20, whose debut disc came out on Epic last fall, have apparently been bought out of their two-album deal there. Word on the street is that the band's new demos weren't to the Epic staffers' liking. Undaunted, 20/20 are playing around town as much as—if not more than—ever . . . Code Blue are in London, recording their Warners debut with Police producer Nigel Gray. Code Blue bassman Michael Ostendorf left the band prior to the sessions and has been replaced (for the LP only) by former Roxy Music bassist Gary Tibbs . . . The Textones have a three-song EP out in Britain on Chiswick/EMI (Jem's expecting to ship plenty Stateside). Two Textones' originals jostle with a heretofore unheard Tom Petty track, "I Can't Fight It" . . . X have just completed a Ray Manzarek-produced platter for local diskery Slash Records . . .
