**WASHINGTON THIS WEEK**

FCC Chair Al Sikes proposed in congressional testimony last week that broadcasters pay over \$20 million in "user's fees" to help finance FCC operations each year. The fee structure, if approved by Congress, would vary depending upon the size of the station, with assessments of up to \$500 annually for radio stations and \$3000

per year for television outlets. Fees would be based on station facilities, but not on market size. While relatively mild in its potential impact, the proposal is remarkably similar to recent congressional initiatives for a "spectrum tax" on broadcasters, and could easily be expanded in future years. The proposed fees are:

The FCC has announced that its comprehensive new FM translator rules were to go into effect on March 1, 1991. As part of the order implementing the new rules, a freeze on new FM translator applications on the commercial FM band was continued through May 1. Applications that have been deferred pending the outcome of the proceeding must be amended to conform to the new rules within sixty days after the freeze is lifted, or by July 1, 1991.

The Commission has denied the appeal of WROV Roanoke to reduce the \$5,000 fine assessed against the station for EEO violations. In other decisions this week, the FCC: dismissed a request for reconsideration by MaryMc Broadcasting Co. for a new FM station in Temple TX; denied reconsideration of an earlier decision granting a new FM in Beaumont TX to Beaumont Skywave, Inc.; affirmed an earlier grant to Daniel S. Stratemeyer of a new FM station in Mount Vernon IL; denied Commonwealth Audio Visual Enterprises, Inc., reconsideration of an order amending the FM Table of Allocations for Churchville and Luray, VA; and upheld the dismissal of Classic Media, Inc.'s application for a new FM in Oro Valley AZ.

Another FM pirate was shut down by the FCC. U.S. Marshals seized the transmitter and other station equipment owned by Archie Bruton of Miami FL. Bruton's station, "WMAB," operated on 91.9 MHz and allegedly was causing interference to nearby air traffic control frequencies.

ELSEWHERE

Seattle-based radio format syndicator Broadcast Programming has purchased its major tape-delivered competitor, Drake-Chenault Enterprises of Albuquerque, for undisclosed terms. BP has in recent years already bought Peters Productions, Radio Arts, the tape division of Century 21, Kalamusic, and the Media General tape division of TM/Century 21. The acquisitions leave Broadcast Programming with about 850 stations under contract for at least one of 24 different CD or tape delivered radio formats. Drake's satellite services have been assumed by partner Jones Intercable and will continue to do business with its 200 affiliates from Albuquerque as Drake-Chenault-Jones.

The Orlando-based preteen Kid's Choice network, known as the Imagination Station, has suspended operations. Metroplex flagship station WPRD-1440 has switched to CNN's Headline News; the only other station signed up in KC's year of operation, KKDS Salt Lake City, plans to continue the format locally. Two other preteen formats that started up last year - Ragan Henry's "Kidwaves" network and CD Broadcasting's WWTC Minneapolis - have also failed to expand the format. Both networks have run into considerable difficulty financing their startups. Meanwhile, an innovative format for an unserved audience has three stations. Compare this to M Street statistics that show over 700 AM stations (nearly one of every seven in the U.S.) are full simulcasts of their FMs, while another 200 or so AM stations are off air entirely...more casualties of radio's fear of risk-taking.

Also closing its doors last week was the Northwest Talk Radio Network. Launched eight months ago, the regional talk network had gained over a dozen affiliates in Washington, Oregon and Idaho but couldn't overcome financing and start-up cost barriers.

Al Ham's "Music of Your Life" format, scheduled to be dropped April 15 by Unistar, will continue as a purchasable license available to any station - even Unistar and SMN affiliates. Ham has bought back the rights to the format he pioneered in the mid-1970's. The package will include music flow charts, club kits, jingles and customized beds. MOYL's music will also be distributed by Ham, on tape.

ELSEWHERE (Cont'd)

RAB's aggressive new anti-print advertising campaign has struck a raw nerve. According to Inside Radio, a roadblock campaign of the spots on all Spokane area stations at 7:30 AM, 12:30 PM and 5:30 PM has drawn cease-and-desist orders from the local newspaper, the Spokane Chronicle/Spokesman-Review. The SC/S-R letters claim use of ABC circulation figures may represent a copyright infringement; refer to the "cooperative nature" of the campaign (implying anti-trust violations) and seek removal of the spots until statistics contained in them can be "checked." The newspaper also pulled an ad campaign of its own, just placed with several Spokane radio stations, and rescheduled the campaign for television. So far, no stations have responded to the letters.

The General Assembly of the state of Virginia has passed legislation providing a tax credit for radio and television stations airing public service announcements on substance abuse. The bill is believed to be the first time a state has approved tax credits for station programming.

Radio & Records reports that commercial DAB broadcasting will make its North American debut on May 1 in...Mexico City. A pay audio service will cover that city with seventeen channels of announcerless audio, provided by Digital Cable Radio of Philadelphia. The Mexico City system is intended strictly for at-home listening and is not presently being considered for any U.S. applications.

This week's intriguing station sales include Bonneville International's purchase of KMEQ AM/FM Phoenix from Group W. The purchase represents the first addition to Bonneville's group in some time. Group W, meanwhile, is said to be interested in trading up to a larger market such as Miami. The sale may also be the first of many to come among large groups, in a slow sales market, positioning themselves for the potential expansion of 12-station ownership limits that FCC Chairman Al Sikes is pushing. Another potential motivation for massive station buying emerged this week: a commitment to good skiing. A group of Denver investors, as Gardiner Broadcast Properties, has agreed to buy six Colorado stations in five separate, adjacent resort markets: Aspen, Vail, Breckenridge, Snowmass Village and Steamboat Springs.

Seattle-based King Broadcasting has placed its six-station radio group up for sale - again. King had been peddling its TV, cable and radio operations as a combined buy, but this week sold TV and Cable to the Providence Journal Co. King still intends to sell its six stations as a group, and - according to company principals Priscilla Bullitt Collins and Harriet Stimson Bullitt - insure that KING-FM's unique commercial classical format in Seattle will be preserved.

KIKK AM/FM Houston has lost a trademark infringement lawsuit it had filed against KYKR-FM-93.3 Port Arthur TX. The country-format "Kicker" is one of three FMs - the others being KHYS-98.5 and KWIC-FM-107.9 - which has moved its transmitters to make the 90-mile leap from Beaumont to become fringe Houston stations. KIKK claimed that KYKR's Houston move-in caused audience confusion and taking advantage of the long-time market dominance of country "Kick." The court disagreed, noting that KYKR had an equally long-term fifteen year usage of the slogan and format, and refusing to set a precedent for what happens when conflicts arise from existing station "moves" into adjacent markets.

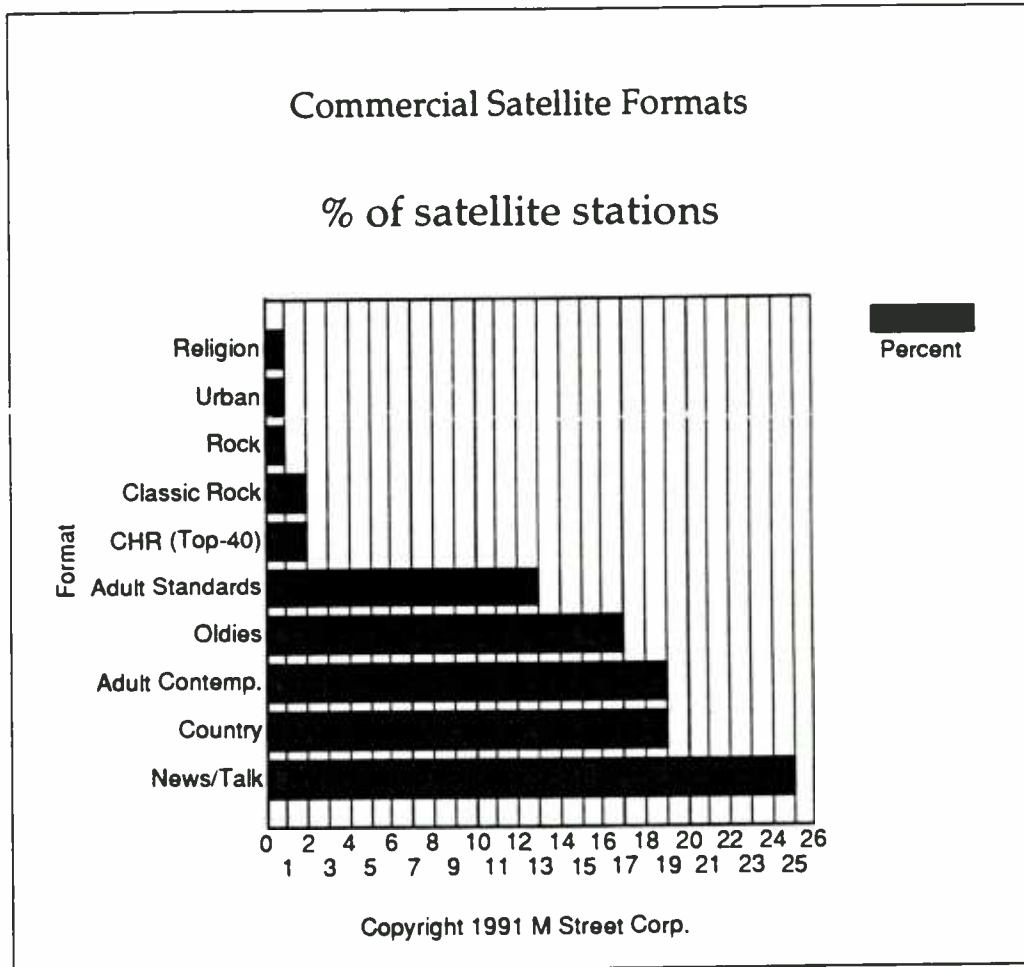
By April 1, radio stations in Delaware and Pennsylvania should file renewal applications on FCC Form 303-S and attach Form 396 (EEO). Annual Ownership Reports (FCC Form 323) should be filed by stations in Indiana, Kentucky, Tennessee, Texas, Delaware, and Pennsylvania.

Stations on a calendar year should file individual returns and personal income taxes by April 15. Quarterly tower light inspections should be held, and the Issues/Programs List for first quarter 1991 should be placed in your station's public inspection file.

Reminder: the FCC must be notified within 30 days of a station change of address.

The addition of several new syndicated talk networks in the last three years has helped fuel the rapid expansion of satellite-delivered news-talk programming. CNN's coups in the recent Persian Gulf war have added further momentum to the format.

**WASHINGTON THIS WEEK**

The FCC has dismissed a petition for reconsideration of a proposed sale for WETV, Channel 13 in Key West FL. The sale was denied because the FCC has pulled the allocation and reassigned it to the U.S. Information Agency for TV Marti to use to broadcast to Cuba. The U.S. has taken a great deal of criticism in the past two years from international agencies over its operation of TV Marti, which has not used any internationally recognized allocation; so the solution was, as WETV's operators noted, to "violate the Communications Act, and deprive the Key West community of its only authorized operating television station." In addition to the ruling's obvious implications for federal use of eminent domain over any broadcast facility (including radio or television), the permanent installation of TV Marti also risks drawing high-power Cuban AM radio interference in retaliation.

The FCC this week also: denied the request of WROV-1240 Roanoke VA to reduce its \$5000 fine for previous owners' violations of EEO regulations; reversed a previous reversal and granted an application for upgraded facilities for WLGC-FM Greenup KY, denying the competing upgrade proposal of WXTQ Athens OH; dismissed Classic Media, Inc.'s petition for reconsideration of the dismissal of its new FM application in Oro Valley AZ; dismissed a petition for extraordinary relief filed by Pamela R. Jones in a new FM proceeding in Macon GA; concluded there was no need for a hearing in connection with the license renewal of WPOM-1600 Riviera Beach FL; and extended the time for file comments on a new FM proceeding in Bowling Green KY until March 13.

The FCC has released figures showing that a record 1,410 reports were filed for Emergency Broadcast System activations in 1990. KGNC-710 Amarillo TX led the country with 355 EBS activations last year - over 25% of the national total! The breakouts by station show that standards for use of the EBS system vary widely from market to market and state to state: hence tornado-prone Missouri has had 1,473 EBS alerts in the last fifteen years, while adjacent and even more tornado-prone Kansas has had exactly 43 EBS alerts in the same fifteen years.

**ELSEWHERE**

First results are in: simulcasting your station on another can produce big results. WNEW-FM-102.7 New York began last fall leasing up to 164 hours a week on eastern Long Island's WWHB-107.1 Hampton Bays; for the most part, listeners cannot tell from the programming that they're not listening to WNEW-FM. In Birch Radio's fall non-monthly market report for Eastern Long Island, WWHB scored a first place finish with a 7.8% share 12+, Mon.-Sun. 6AM-midnight. The #2 local station, AC formatted WBAZ, came in with a 7.0. New York stations don't cover enough of the market to do well, yet WNEW-FM itself showed up with a 4.3 share - one of only four New York FMs to show in the book. (The next highest, WLTW and WRKS, each scored a 0.9 share.) The lessons: WNEW-FM's lease agreement seems to have generated a large audience increase for both the leased and the originating station. Several New York FMs have been waiting to see how WNEW's arrangement worked out before going after their own simulcast opportunities. These results may be a green light.

After years of faithfully dispensing advice, Neil Meyers needs a job. The 10p-1a (EST) host at Talknet has been dumped in favor of Lee Mirabal. Mirabal is best known for having worked at almost every radio station in San Diego. Meyer's contract was apparently not renewed by Westwood One.

M Street has just returned from the 1991 Country Radio Broadcasters meeting in Nashville. While there's little "hard" news to relate, we must say that it is an unusually well done show. CRS gives country broadcasters a chance to talk to each other, meet the artists they play on the air and get to know the record companies. Everyone comes away with something, and has a good time as well. We recommend the show to anyone interested in country music.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Two requests have been filed with the FCC for declaratory rulings regarding security interests in radio stations. The first asks that lenders be allowed to take a limited security interest in an FCC license. The second seeks clarification of the phrase "right of reversion in the license" and asks that the FCC initiate a rulemaking proceeding to specify when lenders may exercise the right.

The FCC has reopened and remanded to an ALJ for further action the proceeding for a new FM station to replace WNWK-105.9 in Newark NJ. The interim licensee, Comserv Broadcast Group, has been pushing hard to try to retain the license.

The FCC this week dismissed the application for renewal of license of KJMB-1450 Blythe CA; and affirmed a Review Board decision upholding the grant of a new FM station to Aspen FM, Inc., in Aspen CO.

ELSEWHERE

Canadian Prime Minister Brian Mulroney has announced his intention to preserve Radio Canada International, the shortwave service that has been removed from the CBC's 1991-92 budget as part of fiscal cutbacks. Without separate government funding RCI is due to cease operations on March 31. The CRTC opened hearings this week to examine the CBC's cutbacks, which have become a center of enormous public controversy in Canada since being announced last December.

Last Friday's format switch of CKEY-590 Toronto to "Country 59" CKYC has restirred another CRTC controversy. CKEY made the preemptive move ahead of Rawlco Communications' new Toronto FM, scheduled to debut with a country format next summer. The awarding of the license to Rawlco last year, over several competing black-owned local applicants, prompted a public dissent from the decision by CRTC head Keith Spicer, and criticism of the CRTC by a number of cabinet ministers. While Canada continues to have no black-owned radio station, the basis of the CRTC's stated preference - that the lack of a country station licensed to Toronto was a more important void - has been undercut by CKEY's move.

Cap Cities/ABC has discontinued its latest stunt at WYTZ Chicago after a firestorm of local and industry criticism. "Hell Radio" was intended to create a hip image and street buzz for WYTZ's retooled dance-CHR format - but instead merely came off as being stupid and in poor taste. While the market already has plenty of poor

taste (e.g., WLUP's Steve Dahl), it is one thing to have a controversial air personality and quite another to champion an offensive image for the entire station. WYTZ is now in its sixth week of stunts and gimmicks intended to reimage and draw attention to itself.

The Washington Times reports that EFM's Rush Limbaugh is looking at developing a television counterpart to his syndicated radio show. Limbaugh has signed a 90-day agreement with media consultant Roger Ailes (best known for his work with presidential candidate George Bush) to identify potential distributors and develop a format for the program. Meanwhile, according to Inside Radio, Limbaugh has told affiliates who aren't running the third hour that EFM added last summer that they have until next August to schedule the entire program - or they will be dropped.

More talk news: Sally Jesse Raphael is leaving ABC Talkradio effective May 31. No word on why she is leaving, or who her replacement might be. (Luckily for ABC, we hear that Neil Meyers - who replaced Raphael at Talknet several years ago - is once again available.) And Chuck Harder's consumer-oriented "For The People" talk show is leaving SUN Radio Network April 1 and will be distributed independently, through FTP studios in White Springs, FL.

Jay Guypher is the new Vice President of Sales & Marketing, Radio Station Services, at Arbitron.

In a reversal of the usual pattern of lease agreements (leasing an FM to make an AM's format more competitive), Fairmont Communications' KMXI Portland OR has leased out its uncompetitive AM. KVAN-1550 (licensed to Vancouver WA) is now being operated by the National Broadcasting School in Vancouver. KVAN had been simulcasting Mix 106, but is now programming a full service local AC format. Vancouver gets a radio station back; Fairmont gets some income for a station that was producing no revenue; and broadcast students get experience at a real, operating station. It's an idea that deserves some attention in other markets.

The NAB has announced four sessions on digital radio at its upcoming convention in Las Vegas. The sessions, aimed at managers and engineers, will explore various facets of DAB and their implications for the industry. Expect also some heavy promotion of the NAB's designated choice for digital broadcasting, the Eureka 147 system. The convention will be held April 15-18 in the Las Vegas Convention Center. As usual, M Street will be there - look for us at the RRN, Inc. booth!

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The FCC has reversed its 1990 decision and decided to allow WIOI-FM, Brunswick GA, to build and operate a high-power booster station (WIOI-FM1) 60 miles to the south in Jacksonville FL. According to the FCC, the grant for the booster station CP was rescinded because the station was 54 channels from WJCT-FM Jacksonville, and did not have the required separation for such stations stipulated in a 1987 FCC Order. WIOI's owner, Nelson Broadcasting Corp., won its reversal of the reversal by claiming the 1987 Order was invalid because it had never been published in the Federal Register.



WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (Cont'd)

The 54 channel issue was viewed by some as a smokescreen for the FCC's reluctance to license a booster station that would clearly be the primary operation of the station. WIOI has been trying to compete in the Jacksonville market with a marginal signal; an 8 kw booster in a top 50 market, where the station's main studio and sales facilities are located, clearly makes the station much more valuable and runs against the FCC's strictures forbidding translators or boosters from originating programming. The reversal of last year's reversal - both on technical grounds - could open the gates for other marginal signals adjacent to larger markets to test the same path.

Ironically, the decision comes a bit late for WIOI. Having lost its bid for a better signal last year, the station has gone through three formats and, only two weeks ago, leased its facility out to EZ Communications. EZ replaced WIOI's two-month-old oldies format (competing directly with EZ's WKQL-FM) with a simulcast of EZ's Jacksonville AM, news-talker WOKV-600. The booster decision will now, in effect, give EZ a better simulcast and a second Jacksonville FM.

Perhaps the longest-running legal saga in FCC history has officially closed. The Commission this week gave its approval to a settlement agreement for KFRC-610 San Francisco, ending RKO General's ownership of its last broadcast facility a full 27 years after FCC proceedings against RKO began. In the agreement, RKO's renewal application for KFRC was dismissed; the mutually exclusive applications of Gold Coast Broadcasting, Inc., Paul J. Growald, and Gold Mountain Broadcasting Co. were dismissed; South Jersey Radio, Inc.'s mutually exclusive application for 610 KHz was granted; South Jersey's license was transferred to Bedford Broadcasting Co.; Cozzin Communications Corp. will dismiss its appeal of a previous FCC denial of its competing application; and Bedford will acquire the physical assets of KFRC. To close the deal, Bedford will make payments of \$8 million, of which RKO retains \$4,193,000 and the other applicants will share the \$3,807,000. Bedford last year also purchased KXXX-FM-99.7 (now KFRC-FM) from Emmis, and so is creating a major new combo with the sale.

The FCC's rationale in closing the deal - similar to one made last year for KHJ-TV in Los Angeles - was to end the long, bitter battles surrounding RKO licenses. But M Street can't help but notice that Bedford Broadcasting's coming in at the end of the deal - after RKO and its competing applicants had spent literally decades waiting for the case to be resolved - is exactly the sort of arrangement the FCC has prohibited in cases involving comparative hearings for new, contested FM stations.

KJME-1390 Denver has been fined \$5,000 by the FCC for overpower operations. Representatives from the FCC's Denver field office found KJME to be operating as much as 450% over licensed limits. The usual fine for such violations is \$1,000; however, the fine in this case was increased due to continued violations after KJME was assessed a previous fine in February 1990.

Also this week, the FCC: affirmed the grant of Aspen FM, Inc.'s application for a new FM station in Aspen CO; denied Sharron Annette Haley's appeal of a ruling dismissing her application for a new FM station in Sumter SC; affirmed a Review Board decision granting a CP to Sandpiper Broadcasting, Inc. for a new FM in Englewood FL, and denying the competing applications; and denied Domenic R. Bianco of Reedsburg WI the right to continue operating his pirate radio station. "KUSA," operating on 7.411 KHz, was shut down and Bianco fined \$1,000.

In one other, remarkably convoluted case, Palm Bay Radio, Inc. has been awarded a new noncommercial FM CP in Palm Bay, FL "over the objections" of the Florida Institute of Technology. Follow along if you dare: initially, Central Florida Educational Network filed an application for a new noncommercial FM at Palm Bay, and was placed on a Public Notice which established the "A" cut-off date for the filing of applications mutually exclusive with Central's. In response to the "A" cut-off date, Palm Bay filed its application. Central's application was subsequently dismissed for failure to prosecute. Pursuant to Commission rules, Palm Bay's application should have then been placed on a "B" cut-off list. However, due to staff error, a second "A" list was established which erroneously solicited applications, including FIT's, that were mutually exclusive with Palm Bay's. FIT's application was returned as inadvertently accepted for filing since it was filed beyond Central's initially specified "A" cut-off date and was therefore not entitled to comparative consideration. In the meantime, Palm Bay amended its application to comply with television Channel 6 interference provisions.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (Cont'd)

The Commission denied FIT's request for review of the dismissal of its application. FIT appealed the Commission's decision to the U.S. Court of Appeal for the District of Columbia. FIT's appeal has been held in abeyance by the Court pending the Commission's decision on FIT's petition to deny Palm Bay's application.

In its petition, FIT argued that Palm Bay's amendment rendered void its protective cut-off status. FIT contended that the FCC should have either dismissed Palm Bay's amended application as untimely, or assigned a new file number to Palm Bay's application connected to the major change amendment date, and acknowledged the erroneous second "A" cut-off date as a valid cut-off date for Palm Bay's amended application. FI also contended that: 1) Palm Bay failed to establish its eligibility to operate as a noncommercial licensee; 2) Palm Bay's proposed weekly programming schedule failed to meet minimum operating requirements; 3) Palm Bay's issues/program exhibit did not reflect the needs and concerns of the community; and 4) Palm Bay failed to comply with the Commission's reporting rule.

In granting Palm Bay and rejecting the petition, the FCC basically upheld its earlier decisions and threw out the other issues FIT raised. The whole case now goes on to the DC District Court of Appeals. This is how broadcast attorneys become wealthy.

ELSEWHERE

Budget cutbacks and a recent fire have hit hard at Pat Robertson's conservative NTR talk network. NTR this week canceled most of its programs, with the exceptions of Battleline and a new program to be hosted by Sonny Block. NTR's problems do not affect parent CBN or its CBN Radio network; there's no word as to what programming will be substituted at the three network-owned stations in Washington DC, Charlotte and Oklahoma City. NTR currently has about 30 affiliates; the changes take effect April 26th.

Interrep Radio Store has announced two worthwhile projects. The first is a plan to network country formatted stations as part of a joint marketing effort; networks for other radio formats will follow. Interrep also plans a study of childrens' radio and programming targeted to kids, who have been long underserved by the industry. An Interrep committee will look into the multi-billion dollar market aimed at ages 6-11. Both efforts are being undertaken as part of Interrep's "Radio 2000" campaign.

Global intrigue came to radio last week, as a leading Cuban radio programmer defected to the U.S. while on a tour of the studios of WQBA Miami. Romel Iglesias Gonzalez, PD at Cuba's Radio Progreso, was immediately interviewed on the air by WQBA as soon as they realized what was happening. Iglesias, 47, entered the U.S. on a tourist visa with his wife; they plan to file for political asylum this week.

Two more state-level initiatives aimed at broadcasters have been turned back. The West Virginia Attorney General has ruled that a state ban on beer advertising is an unconstitutional infringement of freedom of speech, and overturned the regulations imposed by the state's Beer Commission. In Florida, that state's House of Representatives voted down by a 74-37 vote an amendment to levy a 0.1% tax on all advertising revenue as a way to provide funding for statewide election campaigns.

Inside Radio reports that WHTO-FM in Williamsport PA is now broadcasting out of the GM's office of CHR competitor WFXX AM/FM. HTO was burned out of its studios last week by a fire that began in an adjacent storefront, but was back on the air within hours while lining up replacement equipment and broadcast space.

Claude Thomlinson, morning personality for WIVK AM/FM Knoxville, has announced his retirement after 38 years at the station. WIVK's morning show and country format regularly draw 35-40% audience shares, making Thomlinson perhaps the single most dominant air personality in any top 100 market in the country.

The National Religious Broadcasters, a lobbying and trade association for evangelical Christian, has announced that it will be leaving its Parsippany NJ offices next year for a new headquarters in Washington DC. The move will be made to allow NRB to be closer to the FCC, Congress and other government officials.
