WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

As this issue of M Street goes to press on August 5, the Federal Communications Commission is hours away from a meeting where it is expected to rule on its long-pending new ownership limits. At press-time, Inside Radio was speculating that the controversial 30 AM/30 FM ownership limit would be scaled back to 20/20 or 18/18 and only two FMs (as opposed to three) in larger markets. Inside Radio also thought the FCC could find another solution to the most controversial part of its program--using Arbitron to determine market control caps.

Radio & Records reports that the House of Representatives on August 4 approved a measure limiting indecent programming to a "safe harbor" time slot--midnight to 6 a.m. The House action now goes to the White House for presidential consideration.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

You're also no longer bound by the 25 percent in-market ownership cap, but the Commission stated this would raise "prima facie concern that would be taken into account by the Commission." Further, you don't need to use Arbitron data--in its place they're substituting "Arbitron, other ratings service, or other published source." If that is "not readily available, publicly available, not in the applicant's possession, or obtainable without undue expense," then you can supply other forms of data to prove a lack of concentration. No effective date for the rules has yet been given.

M Street: We weren't sure it was possible, but the Commission has managed to make it even less clear as to what constitutes a market or what is acceptable proof of undue concentration. In other words--previously if you were in an Arbitron market and had a service like Tapscan, you had a shot at a simple transfer. Now you have to have all those things AND a crafty attorney/lobbyist.

The first "over-concentration" case before the Commission should be worse than an indecency hearing. The parties involved will know they have to justify something, they just won't know what. Who's to determine the level of validity for non-Arbitron ratings used in cases of over-concentration? Can a petition to deny a transfer be based on a different ratings company's interpretation of the numbers (like Willight) for the same period? And so on...

Radio & Records reports that the House of Representatives on August 4 approved a measure limiting indecent programming to a "safe harbor" time slot--midnight to 6 a.m. The House action now goes to the White House for presidential consideration.

The FCC has proposed changing the license renewal dates of FM translators (as well as TV translators and LPTV operations) to those of full-powered FMs (and TV stations) operating in the same state. The FCC has also proposed revising its form 303-S to allow stations to renew their conventional FMs and their translators at one time with a single form.

In a July 28 policy statement, the commission says it will now handle applications from AM daytimers looking to upgrade to full-time status on an "ad hoc" basis without having to go up against competing or mutually exclusive applications. Last December, the FCC amended the Communications Act to ensure that daytimers in markets of more than 100,000 people without a full-time radio station and within a Class I primary service area have a shot at going full-time. There are only 10 stations that now qualify under these provisions.

The complicated settlement/station swap proposal between Press Broadcasting and Jersey Shore Broadcasting involving WJRZ, Manahawkin, N.J., and a new CP for that market got even more complicated on July 29 when the FCC decided to reverse a Review Board decision and allow an appeal by another party, Seashore Broadcasting, that would challenge the settlement. The FCC decision, which accused Press and Jersey Shore of accomplishing "through a settlement agreement what they could not have accomplished directly during the application process," sends the whole matter back to an administrative law judge.

In other FCC actions, the commission has fined KALF-FM, Red Bluff, Calif., \$10,000 for relocating its main studio to Chico, Calif., without authorization, and KRYS, Corpus Christi, Texas \$6,250 for promoting a lottery.

Al Malmberg replaces Ted Byrne in afternoons (2-5 p.m. eastern) on the American Forum Radio network. Former WWDB, Philadelphia programmer Dianne Raymond will do middays (11-2) for the network ... Dallas-based Interview Network International will distribute the European production company Sound & Stations' program "The European Hit Survey" ... Wonder what it looks like where the right and left wings meet? Tom Laughlin, director/star/writer of the late-'60s/early-'70s "Billy Jack" series, has resurfaced as the host of "Grass Roots Radio," scheduled for 8-10 p.m. nightly on the People's Radio Network. The broadcast is intended as a rallying point for cuckolded supporters of former quasi-presidential candidate Ross Perot.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Wondering if the FCC's new take on its new ownership rules will help it dodge the Congressional bullet? Inside Radio reports that Rep. John Dingell and Sen. Ernest Hollings appear willing to live with the new 18/18-heading-for-20/20 ownership limits. Dingell is quoted as saying that the commission "wisely decided to modify its excessive decision" of last March. Which, of course, makes you wonder if the FCC ever really expected anybody to go for 30/30 in the first place, or if that number was just a bargaining tactic.

In its bi-annual survey of U.S. radio salaries, the National Assn. of Broadcasters says the average base pay for GMs was \$56,458. PDs make an average of \$32,953, more, surprisingly than OMs, who make an average of \$30,275. Other sample salaries: ND \$22,352; GSM \$53,983; promotion director \$26,855; AE \$32,184; NSM \$70,394; and on-air personality \$22,471.

The FCC has fined Commonwealth Broadcasting's KMZQ, Henderson (Las Vegas) \$12,500 for apparent violation of its anti-lottery rules. Two Vegas TV stations, KTNV and KVBC, also received similar fines. The Commission has also revoked the license of WDAT, Amory, MS. The station is silent.

Dr. Helena Mitchell, acting chief of the FCC's Emergency Broadcast System, is now official in that position. Mitchell was previously the director of telecommunications development for the National Telecommunications and Information Administration.

The National Assn. of Broadcasters' department of Science & Technology is now accepting presentation proposals for its 1993 Broadcast Engineering Conference and its MultiMedia World Conference, both to be held during the 1993 NAB convention, April 22-23 in Las Vegas. Send the manuscript for your presentation to the NAB's Science & Technology Dept., 1771 N St., N.W., Washington, DC 20036 or FAX it to 202-775-4981 by Sept. 1.

Meanwhile, technology-oriented highlights of this fall's NAB radio convention will feature a demonstration of the NAB SuperRadio, a panel on recent RBDS developments, and, in a sign of the times, panels on the technical aspects of LMAs and on how to deal effectively with a contract engineer. Other newly announced panels include a Sept. 9 panel on "Expanding Ownership Opportunities" featuring FCC Mass Media Bureau Chief Roy Stewart and two chiefs of expanding empires, Clear Channel's L. Lowery Mays and Paxson Broadcasting's Bud Paxson.

For the first time in years, all five FCC Commissioners will be blowing off this year's NAB radio show, according to *Inside Radio*, even though they manage to make the April show each year. Radio is getting the stepchild treatment because the show is too close to the Labor Day holiday.

CANADA THIS WEEK

In the first hint of what it might do--or not do--with the lucrative FM frequencies of the former CKO news/talk network, the Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications Commission last week shot down three bids for the 99.1 Toronto frequency previously occupied there by CKO. Easy listening CJEZ, classical CFMX, and Rawlco's yet-to-be-built new country FM--currently scheduled for 92.5--were all denied an upgrade to the vacant frequency. (Only previously existing stations had been allowed to apply for the frequency.) CRTC chairman Keith Spicer told the local papers that these proposals did not speak to "Toronto's evolving socio-cultural reality." The commission is now preparing a Toronto market study before it does anything else with the 99.1 frequency. Spicer has also suggested that the CRTC might find another technical solution for CFMX's signal problems.

CANADA THIS WEEK (cont'd)

Are you ready for The Big 58? The CHUM Group, which is hoping to add the legendary CKLW-AM-FM, Windsor, Ontario, to its current combo CKWW/CIMX, has announced its intention to flip flop its AM stations if the sale closes. This means that, for the first time in decades, adult standards CKLW would no longer be a 50,000 watt powerhouse, heard throughout the Northeast, but a 500 watt AM. The home of the one-time "Big 8," meanwhile, would carry CKWW's Windsor-oriented N/T format. The CRTC meets in Hull, Ontario on September 27 to consider the whole package of moves.

ELSEWHERE

The Radio Advertising Bureau reports that combined local and national spot sales were up 2% for June from June, 1991. Local revenue was up 6% to offset a 10% drop in national revenue. For the first six months of the year to date, ad revenue was flat, with a 3% rise in local income and a 9% decrease in national. Network revenue was off 13% for both this June vs. last June and the first six months of the year overall. In other RAB news, the bureau has joined forces with the Advertising Council for what it bills as the first PSA campaign on CD--in this case a voter participation campaign featuring Jason Robards and Paul Shaffer that will be part of the NAB's September marketing kit.

After several years as the sturdiest of the all-childrens' outlets, WWTC, Minneapolis will make a new run at going national in October. WWTC has renamed its "Radio Aahs" format the Childrens' Satellite Network and is opening an L.A. office headed by president Bill Barnett and affiliate relations people Rick Lemmo and Bob Ardrey. WWTC's Chris Dahl says he hopes to announce new affiliates as soon as next week.

Satellite Music Network VP/marketing Martin Raab has been upped to that post for the parent ABC Radio Networks. He'll remain based in Dallas. In addition, Group VP/affiliate marketing Darryl Brown is upped to Sr. VP/affiliate marketing based in New York, SMN VP/sales Frank Woodbeck becomes western VP/affiliate marketing based in Dallas. And ABC Information Network director Karen Freeman becomes eastern VP/affiliate marketing, based in New York.

When KOMA, Oklahoma City LMA'd rival KKNG and began simulcasting its oldies format on FM, one of the casualties of the switch was KOMA's Richard "Ricky The K" Kaufman whose Saturday night oldies show was heavy on '60s top 40 formatics and the PAMS jingles that Kaufman now manufactures as his day job. Since KOMA is no longer in the retro formatics business, Kaufman is now trying to sell his show directly to listeners on cassette. There's no telling how this will work since many of Kaufman's most devoted listeners were other radio people, many of whom probably airchecked the show themselves. Still, if you're distraught about losing the only Saturday night oldies show that actually played "Open Up Your Door" by Richard & The Young Lions, call 214-271-7625.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Several weeks after its KMEL, San Francisco fine launched yet another spate of indecency citations, the FCC is now investigating at least four stations over indecency complaints. KLSX, Howard Stern's Los Angeles affiliate, has been given 30 days to respond to a complaint filed last August about a discussion of masturbation that ended with a guest saying that his father has "a hose that goes on for miles." Co-owned WBCN, Boston has, according to Radio & Records, been contacted over an off-color joke on its morning show. WWDC-FM, Washington, D.C.'s Greaseman is being investigated for several discussions of masturbation and the line "I'll bet you'd like to stick six inches of meat into my sausage grinder." And WJXQ, Jackson, Mich. (Lansing), is in trouble for a bit that allegedly contained several permutations of the word fuck. WBCN, of course, is owned by Howard Stern purveyor Infinity Broadcasting and Radio & Records claims that the FCC may be coming after Stern again by the time you read this.

The Commission has upheld the dismissal of the application of Leland Broadcasting Group, Inc. for a new FM station on 94.1 MHz in Leland, NC. The application was dismissed under the Commission's "hard look" policy because the transmitter site map was not accompanied by a reduced copy of the entire 7.5 minute map as required by the rules.

The Commission's review board reversed two ALJ decision for new station grants this week. Delta Broadcasting, Inc. won the grant for a new FM on 107.7 MHz in Santa Barbara, CA after a lengthy proceeding regarding financial qualifications. WHSL Corporation lost its grant of a new FM on the same frequency in Pawcatuck, CT to Saltaire Communications, Inc.

ELSEWHERE

Building up the same sort of goodwill she had engendered as Jane Pauley's replacement, new ABC talk host Deborah Norville spent much of the last year creating p.m. fires for the folks at ABC to put out by mentioning, from time to time, how much she'd really like to get back into TV. Last week, Norville announced her intention to do just that. A day later, ABC announced that it was dropping not only Norville's program, but also Tom Snyder's nightly show, in effect taking ABC out of the syndicated talk business, except for some weekend how-to shows. ABC Radio Networks president Bob Callahan's memo to his staff declared that talk "has not been as successful as we had hoped and is not viable for us as a business."

ABC's move comes on the heels of the elimination, or consolidation, of a number of jobs--many of them involving the elimination of overlap between ABC and its Satellite Music Network. (Rival Westwood One also went through the latest in a series of cutbacks last week.) Two other related notes. 1. With the CBS Radio Network now poised to strike with its nightly Gil Gross talk, Gross' former employer, WOR, New York, has announced that its WOR Radio Network will also offer a nightly talk program from 10 p.m. to 1 a.m., hosted by former Daynetter Dr. Joey Brown. 2. The Chicago Sun-Times has reported that ABC will flip its currently simulcast N/T O&O WLS-AM-FM to country next month. WLS-FM would go contemporary country. WLS-AM would become the long-expected first ABC O&O to showcase an SMN format, perhaps its Real Country. As of August 19, ABC was still denying that this was a done deal. And Radio & Records was suggesting that the recent Infinity deal for country WUSN, Chicago had scared ABC off. But consider the recently increased stock of ABC people at the rest of the network, the fact that ABC no longer has its own nightly talk-shows to clear on WLS, and the fact that Sun-Times radio critic Robert Feder has usually been pretty good with WLS stories.

One other piece of fallout: ABC's Norville and Snyder had been set to host the NAB's Marconi Radio Awards. The new hosts will be KLOS, Los Angeles's Mark & Brian who, judging from their previous track record, aren't likely to be abandoning radio for TV anytime soon.

In other SMN news, the network has settled with suburban Washington, D.C. outlet WMET. SMN had a \$446,000 judgement against the station, had seized "much of the contents of the office earlier this spring," according to a local press report, and was threatening to seize WMET's transmitter. The details of the settlement were not disclosed. WMET still has problems with its landlord, the Montgomery County Parks Board, which wants to evict WMET.

Infinity Broadcasting Corp., who currently owns 18 stations, most of which are in the top 10 markets, are adding three more to their stash. Taking advantage of the new ownership rules, Infinity will purchase WUSN, Chicago, WZGC, Atlanta, and WZLX, Boston for \$100 Million from Cook-Inlet Radio Partners, L.P. In a statement from Cook-Inlet Radio President Dan Mason, the sale of the stations will allow the company to retire most of its debt. An application for transfer of the stations can't be filed until the new rules are printed in the *Federal Register*.

The White Springs, Fla.-based For The People network has added a new 6-9 a.m. daily show, "Morning In America" which will be similar in structure to the former SUN Network show, "American Sunrise." For more info, call FTP at 904-397-4300 ... Business Radio Network is now providing its shows digitally on Satcom C-5. BRN has also added long-form financial talk beginning at Noon eastern time, specifically the shows "Business Day" with Jack Lott & Kerry O'Brien and "Market Wrap" with Bill Bresnan who you may remember from a flap last year at WABC, New York. BRN has also moved its Don McDonald show to 7 p.m.

Dates have been set for next year's Country Radio Seminar which will be held March 3-6, 1993 in the usual CRS venue, Nashville's Opryland Hotel. Exhibitor dates are March 3-5.

The Radio Music Licensing Committee will hold a "Per Program Music License Seminar" on Sept. 11 as part of the fall NAB radio show. For more info, call Dave Fuellhart at 410-866-5594.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The Commission did not release Broadcast Applications or Actions for Friday, August 21.

Radio & Records reports that yet another station is now facing an FCC indecency investigation. WALE, Providence, R.I.'s morning show allegedly referred to city parking ticket writers as "assholes," "dickheads," and "fat black bitches." This is the first time that a racial slur has even figured into the FCC's plans, even unintentionally, since it got back into the indecency business five years ago, an interesting move from a commission that didn't care about WWDC-FM, Washington morning jock The Greaseman's infamous Martin Luther King Day slur, but which would like to prevent him from discussing masturbation any further. Meanwhile, Federal prosecutors in Chicago have finally launched civil enforcement proceedings against Evergreen's WLUP to collect the \$6,000 FCC indecency fine the station was hit with 18 months ago.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

Several weeks ago, the Federal Election Commission shot down EZ Communications' proposal to give political candidates free spot time to circumvent the lowest unit rate rules for air-time. (The FEC actually voted 3-2 for approval, but needed to vote 4-1 for the measure to take effect.) Now the National Assn. of Broadcasters has asked the FCC for a declaratory ruling on what constitutes "reasonable access" for political candidates. The NAB specifically is concerned about candidates wanting TV time in odd increments--i.e., 13 minute programs--or during prime-time.

Besides displaying its Denon "Super AMAX Radio" at this fall's radio convention, the NAB will also be selling the tuner in New Orleans on Sept. 9-12. The NAB/Denon TU-680NAB will be available at a discount at the radio show and afterwards through NAB's member services department. Call 800-368-5644 for more info.

CANADA THIS WEEK

The Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications Commission has renewed the license of CJMF, Quebec City despite the station's failure to lay out the \$20,000 it had committed to for the development of Canadian talent--something the CRTC takes pretty seriously. CJMF had argued that, like a lot of Canadian broadcasters these days, it didn't have the money and, besides, it promoted Canadian talent just by playing Canadian music and hiring Canadian broadcasters. The CRTC has warned CJMF that it will have to start spending money on Canadian talent again if it starts showing a profit again. Concurrently, the CRTC approved the station's application for a programming network consisting of CJMF, CFEI Ste. Hyacinthe, PQ and CHLC Baie-Comeau PQ.

ELSEWHERE

Following a story in the Chicago Sun-Times that suggested that it had all but flipped the switch, ABC has announced that it will not flip its WLS-AM-FM, Chicago to country, meaning that the Satellite Music Network won't finally get the ABC O&O that it's been coveting for years. In other SMN news, the name for the network's new, more adult version of its formerly CHR format, The Heat, will reportedly be "Young Adult Contemporary," although that name won't be used on the air. YAC is expected to debut on October 1.

Lafayette, We Are Here: The Radio Advertising Bureau is offering "sales relief kits" to stations in Florida and Louisiana markets ravaged by Hurricane Andrew. The kits, offered through RAB's member services department, "include marketing information on advertisers who present the best business opportunities in the post-hurricane rebuilding period: home supply stores, lumber dealers, hardware stores, home improvement, insurance brokers, and real estate," according to an RAB release. Also, the RAB is now accepting entries for its Chassie Awards, honoring outstanding automotive industry spots. For an entry form, call 800-232-3131.

Two new ratings services, consultant Karl Baehr's Actual Radio Measurement (ARM) and Kurt Hansen's AccuRatings firm, have added survey markets. AccuRatings, launched with a summer survey for San Diego several weeks ago, will now also issue summer books for Hansen's home market of Chicago and nearby South Bend. If Hansen's telephone survey isn't the Arbitron alternative you were looking for, there's always the ARM survey which, in a throwback to the old Pulse surveys, measures listening in passing cars. Currently, this unique technology measures FM only, but plans are in the works for AM. The system is great for measuring the number of vehicles your station may be in, but won't measure actual listenership by demo. Could be a tough one to get past the Commission. Baehr did a survey in his home market of Albuquerque, N.M., as well as Lubbock, Texas this spring. He's doing Dallas now and plans to do Houston, Phoenix, Denver, San Francisco, and San Antonio in the fall. For more information, call 505-828-0488.
