EZ SCORES IN ST. LOUIS. . . . EZ Communications is spending \$48 million to buy another combo in St. Louis to give them two AMs and three FMs in that market. PAR Broadcasting will sell sports KFNS, Wood River, IL and soft AC KEZK-FM, St. Louis which will now combo with standards KSD (AM), rocker KSD-FM, and hot AC KYKY. PAR Broadcasting's group status went as fast as it came as it has now sold its San Diego, St. Louis, and Phoenix combos, which were all purchased in the past year.

"WE ARE THE WORLD . . ." Building on the synergy of Grand Rapids and New Zealand, Clear Channel announced deals to pick up 43 radio stations. It buying two more in the Grand Rapids market with the purchase of talker WCUZ (AM) & country WCUZ-FM from John Dille's Federated Media. No terms were disclosed but the purchase will give Clear Channel two AMs and three FMs in the market with the recently announced deal to buy WOOD-AM & FM and WBCF there. Down under, it will buy all of the stock of Radio New Zealand Commercial, which owns 41 stations, for NZ\$89 million from the government of New Zealand. Radio New Zealand controls about 50% of New Zealand's radio advertising revenues. Clear Channel is partners with two newspaper publishers in that country.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Harry J. Pappas has been granted a one-to-a-market rule waiver for his recent purchase of KFRE, Fresno, from Ralph Guild's EBE Communications. Pappas owns KMPH-FM, Hanford, and KMPH-TV, Visalia, in that market.

Dr. Lynn Remly has been named Chief of the Policy and Rules Division of the Office of Engineering and Technology. She's been the Acting Chief of that division and Chief of the Spectrum Utilization and Economics Branch.

ELSEWHERE

American Radio Systems is buying its second FM in Portland. It will purchase contemporary Christian KDBX, Banks, OR for \$14 million from Salem Communications. ARS recently announced the purchase of Henry Broadcasting's new rock AM KBBT and rocker KUFO, both Portland. Salem will hold on to its religious combo in that market, KPDQ-AM & FM.

Multi-Market is adding a third FM in Hartford. Precision Media Corp. is selling CHR WKSS, Meriden, CT for \$18 million. Multi-Market recently announced the purchase of news/talk WPOP and rocker WHCN, both Hartford, and new rock WMRQ, Waterbury, CT from Liberty Broadcasting.

Point Communications and Midcontinent Broadcasting are merging to become the big cheese in Madison, Wisconsin. The new company will be managed by Point and combine its news/talk WIBA (AM), rocker WIBA-FM, Madison; new rock WMAD-FM, Sun Prairie, WI with Midco's CHR WZEE, news/talker WTSO, and soft AC WMLI, Sauk City, WI. No terms of the deal were given. There's no word on the fate of adult standards WMAD, Sun Prairie, WI, which wasn't mentioned in the release.

Cy Bahakel's Bahakel Communications is upping its group to 11 stations by purchasing Park Communications' Chattanooga and Waterloo/Cedar Rapids properties. Park will sell news/talk WDEF (AM) & soft AC WDEF-FM, Chattanooga and oldies KWLO and rocker KFMW, Waterloo to give Bahakel duopolies in both markets. Total price tag: \$11.2 million. The company already owns standards WDOD (AM) and country WDOD-FM, Chattanooga and standards KXEL and CHR KOKZ, Waterloo.

It's not the duopoly of the week, but still a duopoly--in Cookeville, TN of all places. Paxson Communications is doubling up there with the purchase of country WHUB and soft AC WHUB-FM for \$3.8 million. The seller, M.L. Medley, has owned WHUB (AM) since 1940, and signed on WHUB-FM in 1964. Paxson owns news/talk WPTN and country WGSQ in that market as well as the Tennessee Radio Network.

ELSEWHERE (cont'd)

In a press release received April 1, 1996, Jacor Communications announced it is buying CBS/Westinghouse, Capital Cities/ABC, Infinity Broadcasting, Chancellor Communications, Clear Channel Communications, American Radio Systems, and a combo in Venice, FL. However, further developments at the bottom of the release indicate that only the Venice, FL deal will go through netting Asterisk Communications' oldies WAMR and country WCTQ, Venice in the Sarasota market. Fortunately, Jacor President Randy Michaels commented, ". . . the Venice stations are the linchpin of Jacor's global acquisitional strategy." The deals would have given Jacor 206 radio stations in 39 markets and, according to the release, "annual revenues exceeding the gross national product."

Former financial talk host Sonny Bloch has been ordered to return \$3.9 million collected from listeners who thought they were investing in his radio stations in Florida and Connecticut. A federal judge in New York ordered the repayment even though Bloch has pleaded not guilty to fraud charges allegedly costing investors \$21 million. Bloch faces maximum penalties of 360 years in prison and millions of dollars in fines.

Inside Radio reports WFAN, New York has signed a sports marketing agreement with crosstown talker WOR. For the next five years, it will produce the New York Giants football games for WOR, including sales, programming, and promotion. The deal will expand pre- and post-game shows to a total of seven hours with the play-by-play each Sunday.

Interop released the key findings of its News/Talk radio format research study. Stratford Research was commissioned to conduct the study designed to understand the latest issues and challenges facing today's News/Talk stations. Some of the findings include 77% of all AM News/Talk listeners also listen to FM music stations and 58% of all AM News/Talk listeners do not listen to AM radio more than FM.

Another Interop study released this week focuses on the 49 million adults who are living with physical disabilities. Persons with disabilities clearly represent a large, though often ignored, consumer base. According to the study, persons with disabilities control an estimated \$188 billion of consumer power. Eastman Radio recently released the study "The Best Way to Reach the African American Consumer" designed to allow advertisers to target the African American population's \$250 billion of consumer purchasing power. The study shows African Americans listen to the radio almost 50% more than the general U.S. population. Of all radio listening among African American adults 18+, the Urban format is their number one choice, topping the next closest format by 268%. According to the study, Urban radio has the highest TSL of any national format and tends to have an extremely loyal listener base. For more info, call (212) 424-6947.

Syndicated morning hosts John Boy & Billy have put together a deal to do a thirty minute "John Boy & Billy Rock & Roll Racing Special" to air on The Nashville Network May 18 at 7 p.m. The show will be the lead-in to the Winston Select Auto Race.

Westwood One has promoted Erik Braverman to West Coast Director of Talk Programming. Braverman will oversee the production of all west-coast based talk shows, including "The Tom Leykis Show," which he has worked on since its national launch. He will handle similar responsibilities for the "Ferrall On the Bench" sports talk show, "The Greaseman," and "Love Line." Before joining Westwood in 1994, Braverman served as morning show producer at KOST-FM in Los Angeles.

COMMODORE TAKES A THIRD OF HUNTINGTON. . . . Commodore Media is taking advantage of the new ownership rules in a big way--it's buying eight stations in the Huntington-Ashland, WV-KY market, bringing its total there to ten stations in a 28 station market. It's buying standards WKEE and hot AC WKEE-FM, Huntington WV; sports WZZW, Milton WV; country WBVB, Coral Grove OH; and sports WIRO, Ironton OH from Mike Shott's Adventure Communications. It's also picking up classic rocker WMLV, Ironton OH; sports simulcast WHRD, Huntington WV; and classic rock simulcast WFXN, Milton WV from Simmons Broadcasting (a close companion of Adventure). The total package will cost Commodore \$12 million. Commodore owns market leaders country WTCR, Kenova WV and WTCR-FM, Huntington. LMA's for all the stations begin immediately. The deal gives Commodore 31 stations it either owns or operates.

RADIO'S CHANGING LANDSCAPE. . . . Once upon a time, it was Keymarket. The it was River City. Now, it's Sinclair. Sinclair Broadcast Group, a company known for its television holdings, announced it will acquire the assets of River City Broadcasting, in a transaction valued at around \$1.2 billion. The deal will give Sinclair 29 television stations and 34 radio stations. Sinclair's Barry Baker will run the new group, which will be called Sinclair Communications. River City's Kerby Confer, who currently runs River City's Radio Division, Keymarket Radio, will join the group in an unnamed capacity. Sinclair also has a separate deal pending to buy five other television stations. The acquisition is expected to close by the end of 1996. River City's radio holdings include radio stations in Los Angeles, St. Louis, Nashville, Greenville, SC, Buffalo, New Orleans, Memphis, Albuquerque, and Wilkes-Barre/Scranton.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The Commission has begun proceedings to revoke the licenses of several AM stations it believes have been off the air for over a year. The Mass Media Bureau has either issued "show cause" notices or begun renewal hearings for KGPL, Dermott AR; KMOA, Kensett AR; KCCL, Paris AR; KDLB, Henryetta OK; KUHD, Port Neches TX; and KRDG, Redding CA. WWSK, Kokomo IN is the only FM station has also been served notice. However, KRDG is on the air with a contemporary Christian format. The Commission claims attempts to reach the station have been ignored.

Several AM's lost their licenses this week. They are WGTL, Kannapolis NC; WCLB, Camilla GA; WVKY, Louisa KY; KCTO, Columbia LA; KAPB, Marksville LA; and KMAR, Winnsboro LA. They were not renewed and their call letters were deleted.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK (cont'd)

There'll be new competition in the Richmond, VA market soon. One of the last 80-90 docket allocations to settle happened this week. Over two dozen parties had applied for a new station on 101.1 MHz in Richmond back in 1985. A settlement agreement was finally reached last week between the few remaining applicants that stuck it out. Barbara B. Bennis is the victor, who will have a new 3000 watt FM in the nation's 56th market.

FCC Commissioner Andrew Barrett stepped down this week after serving seven years. He is leaving for a job in the private sector.

ELSEWHERE

David Gingold's Barnstable Broadcasting is reaching out to the Long Island, NY market by acquiring three new properties to combo with its adult standards WHLI and gold-based AC WKJY, both Hempstead. Barnstable will pick up country WGSM, Huntington NY and rock simulcast WRCN, Riverhead and WMJC, Smithtown from Gary Starr's Islandwide Broadcasting. Terms weren't disclosed. An LMA will begin later this month. There's no mention of Starr's silent AM, WRHD, Riverhead in the press release. The deal brings Barnstable's total to 15 radio stations.

Max Media is upping its ownership in the Greensboro-Winston/Salem market to three FM's and an AM by purchasing Murray Hill Broadcasting's black gospel WQMG (AM) and urban WQMG-FM, both Greensboro NC, for an undisclosed price. Max already owns oldies WMQX, Winston-Salem and urban WJMH, Reidsville NC in that market. The sale should close this summer.

On the heels of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 here in the U.S., Canada is easing its restrictions on foreign ownership of broadcast stations. It will raise the limits to 33 1/3 percent from 20 percent. The new limits affect all Canadian broadcasters, including networks, cable and pay-per-view.

Clear Channel Communications had some change left in its pockets after last week's purchase of all those radio stations abroad, so it announced this week it will buy sports KQLL (AM), Tulsa; oldies KQLL-FM, Owasso OK; and smooth jazz KOAS, Broken Arrow OK in the Tulsa market from Federated Media for approx. \$15.4 million, which includes a previously announced purchase of talk WCUZ (AM) and country WCUZ-FM, Grand Rapids, MI from Federated.

Cape Cod's market is getting a little smaller as Boch Broadcasting will purchase AC WCOD, Hyannis MA; and new rock combo WUNX, Harwich Port MA and WUNZ Falmouth MA from Leapfrog Radio for an undisclosed price. The three stations will combo with Boch's news-talk combo WUOK and WXTK, West Yarmouth MA. The official take-over is scheduled for July.

Chicago-based Major Networks has sold off another of its radio holdings, letting Standard News go to the Dallas-based Salem Radio Networks. Standard News is a 24-hour news and sports service claiming 200 affiliates.

May's expected DAB field tests are off, according to Inside Radio, because of a shortfall of approximately \$500,000 worth of "monetary agreements" from the companies competing for the DAB standard. The three groups, Eureka, VOA/JLB, and USA Digital, have until May 7th to get their agreements back to the Electronics Industries Association in order for the tests to be completed.

Children's Broadcasting Corporation, Radio AAHS, announced an advertising partnership with The Southland Corporation, whose operations include 7-Eleven stores. 7-Eleven has purchased a multi-faceted one-year advertising package that includes airtime, an online advertising component through the Radio AAHS website, special use of the Radio AAHS interactive phone system, special joint promotions and several dozen live remote broadcasts in Radio AAHS cities across the country.

ELSEWHERE (cont'd)

Arbitron announced that the redesign of the Radio Market Report has been completed and that the revised radio book will arrive with the release of the Winter survey on April 18. New features of the redesigned report for continuously measured markets include four-book averages in the Target Listener Trends and Target Listener Estimates sections for 20 demographics; a new time spent listening section with five-book trends and four-book average TSL measures; reformatted Metro Market Profiles and an expanded Station Information section. Other changes include consolidating TSA measures into a single section for Spring and Fall measurement only, and deletion of hour-by-hours from the printed reports. A new Arbitrends maintenance release was mailed to Arbitrends subscribers in order to accommodate the redesign of the Radio Market Report. Clients who have questions should call Micro Customer Service at 1-800-543-7300.

Jones Satellite Networks will begin using SpaceCom Systems' SatVantage satellite transmission service to digitally uplink its radio formats using Wegener's MPEG II equipment beginning May 1. SpaceCom's Chicago International Teleport will serve as Jones' primary uplink while they build their own facility. When the facility is completed, SpaceCom will continue to provide transponder management.

M STREET BAZAAR. . . PEOPLE, PRODUCTS, AND PROGRAMMING

It hasn't taken long after the Disney/Capital Cities-ABC merger to close for the management shake-ups to begin. Last week, ABC senior exec. Mike Mallardi decided it was time to leave. This week, Radio President Jim Arcara announced he will retire, as well. Plans are to have Radio Networks President Bob Callahan take over Arcara's duties. Callahan will handle both the radio station group and the networks.

The NAB is offering a comprehensive CD-ROM with exhibitor listings, product information and full text search capabilities to attendees. The CD-ROM contains product literature, video, sound and demonstrations. The CD will run on Macintosh and Windows and features links to exhibitor websites.

The National Association of Broadcasters is taking the show on the World Wide Web. Internet users will be able to view real-time video footage on the NAB's home page. The NAB is using VDonet's VDOLive video server to make this possible. VDOLive is scalable and broadcasts video at 10-15 frames per second with a 28.8 kbps modem. On higher bandwidth networks, the video quality improves. VDonet Corp. is based in Palo Alto, CA, and has developed and markets Technology for Internet video broadcasting and Internet video telephony. Brief segments of the NAB '96 show, including footage of the exhibit halls, addresses and special events will be on-line each day beginning April 15. Footage for the official show will be provided by VISITEL.

Westwood One, "First In Country," will provide special programming to mark the one year anniversary of the bombing in Oklahoma City by offering it's affiliates a live five-minute special feature that includes five seconds of silence followed by Garth Brook's personal reflections on the tragic bombing in association with his current record, "The Change." Country's Inside Trak will also dedicate its program for April 19th to the bombing and include interviews with Garth and fellow Oklahoma native Joe Diffie.

Jones Satellite Networks names Bryan Schock Operations Manager for their newest 24-hour music format, Rock Alternative which is scheduled to debut on May 1. Schock's experience includes KNRX-FM in Denver, KNAC-FM in Los Angeles, WHVY-FM in Baltimore, WLZR-FM in Milwaukee, KGB-FM and 91X-FM in San Diego. He will be responsible for the music programming and host the evening air shift.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

The FCC is proposing taking advantage of the maximum allowable renewal term under the 1996 Telecommunications Act. The Act authorized the Commission to up the renewal terms for radio stations from seven years to eight. Television stations were set at five years under the old rules. The rulemaking proposal will be out shortly.

Comparative hearings for license renewals could be a thing of the past as the Commission plans to implement a new "two-step" renewal procedure authorized by the Telecomm Act. The rulemaking proposal also codifies standards for the Commission to apply when considering renewal apps. Any renewal proceedings filed on or before May 1, 1995 will be subject to the old rules.

The Commission has released a notice of Proposed Rulemaking that revises the Regulatory Fee schedule for Fiscal '96. Under the proposal, radio fees would be up only slightly from last year. Comments on the proposal are due April 29, replies May 9. Proposed radio fees are:

ELSEWHERE

In what was probably an inevitable deal, SFX has agreed to purchase Multi-Market Radio for \$11.50 per share. The deal will create a 77 station group. The deal, which is anticipated to be tax free, calls for SFX to issue class A common stock to MMR shareholders, as long as SFX is trading in the \$32 to \$42 range. SFX's President & CEO Steven Hicks will step aside to make room for Mike Ferrel, who helped run Multi-Market. SFX Chief Financial Officer Geoff Armstrong will be the Chief Operating Officer of the new group and continue as CFO. SFX's founder Robert Sillerman has been the key deal-maker and financier for both groups.

Paxson Communications planned purchase of Spanish-AC WRMA, Ft. Lauderdale and Spanish hits WXDJ, Homestead, FL, took a nose dive after it couldn't come to terms with New Age Broadcasting and The Seventies Broadcasting Corp. The two Miami-Ft. Lauderdale area FM stations were to be an important part of Bud Paxson's collection there. Paxson cloaked the announcement in a re-release of its planned purchase of WSGE and WSRF, which it announced over a month ago.

Albuquerque has been a hot-bed of station trading recently, and this week is no exception. Citadel Communications has agreed to buy Crescent Communications' duopoly of sports KRZY and country KRST, Albuquerque, and country KOLT, Santa Fe for \$23 million. The deal will give Citadel four FM's and three AM's in that market as it owns talker KKOB (AM) & AC KKOB-FM and news-talk KHTL and AC KMGA, all Albuquerque.

Max Media is tripling up in the Greensboro-Winston/Salem-High Point market with the purchase of Murray Hill Broadcasting's black gospel WQMG and urban WQMG-FM. No terms were disclosed. Max owns urban WJMH, Reidsville, NC and oldies WMQX, Winston-Salem.

Noula Pappas, trustee for the Mike Pappas family is letting her duopoly in the Eugene/Springfield, OR market go. McDonald Investment Co. and Bengal Communications are partnering to buy classic rocker KZEL-FM, Eugene, and new rock combo KNRQ, Eugene and KNRQ-FM, Creswell, OR. Bengal recently sold off the last of its properties, which were in Albuquerque. McDonald Investment owns a duopoly in the Montgomery, AL market.

Nassau Broadcasting is adds two more to its collection of stations between New York and Philadelphia with the purchase of oldies WNNJ (AM), Newton and CHR WNNJ-FM, Newton, NJ from Group M Communications for an undisclosed price. Nassau now owns seven stations in that area.

Controversial WABC, New York afternoon drive talker Bob Grant was asked to hit the bricks this week. The station's new owner Disney apparently wasn't too pleased with his alleged racial characterizations of callers and companies. The decision was made during the same week in which Disney is having its board meetings in Florida. WABC fill-in host Curtis Sliwa handles p.m. drive till a replacement is found.

Music of Your Life is alive and well on the bird again as Jones Satellite Networks will market The New Music of Your Life, which is produced by Radio Sales in Los Angeles. The format was introduced by Al Ham in 1978 and features standards classics from the 40's to the 80's. It's Jones tenth format.

Strategic Radio Research announced a new qualitative system named "Qualitative 2000" for selected AccuRatings markets. The Qualitative 2000 service features product and brand categories, plus consumer motivation questions. The service will also feature awareness level tracking of various radio campaigns each quarter. Winter 1996 Qualitative 2000 results for Los Angeles, Chicago, Boston and Dallas/Ft. Worth will be released next week. Spring 1996 markets will include those four markets plus New York, Philadelphia, Seattle and Detroit.

David Kantor has been appointed to the position of President of ABC Radio Networks. Kantor will be responsible for all aspects of Network Programming, Affiliate Marketing, Advertising Sales, Marketing and Promotions, Engineering, Finance, Research, MIS and International Programming and Marketing for the Radio Network. Prior to joining ABC Radio Networks in 1991, Kantor was Vice President of Cox Cable Communications in Atlanta.

TIT FOR TAT AND CASH . . . The big deal this week is the plan of OmniAmerica and Nationwide Communications to swap stations in a duopoly package for both companies totaling close to \$90 million. Nationwide plans to pick up new rock WMMS, Cleveland and oldies WMJI, Cleveland while OmniAmerica gains Hot AC WOMX, Orlando. Nationwide will pay OmniAmerica \$43.5 million cash in addition to swapping WOMX, which is valued between \$40 and \$50 million. Nationwide already owns country WGAR-FM, Cleveland, while Omni has oldies WOLL, Riviera Beach and CHR WXXL, Tavares, FL in the Orlando market. Unnamed Omni principals will receive a \$1.5 million consulting agreement, as well. OmniAmerica also owns sports WHK, Cleveland, but will sell it for \$6.5 million to a yet-to-be-named company. Star Media Group brokered the transaction.

ARS, THE STORY CONTINUES. . . American Radio Systems is buying up Las Vegas, laying down \$8 million for Parker Communications' hot AC KJMZ, Henderson, NV and Crescent Communications' AC KMZQ, Henderson, NV; new rock KFBI, Pahrump, NV; and sports AM KVEG, Las Vegas for \$30 million. The two separate deals add to ARS's plans to buy Nationwide Communications' travel info station KXNO and dance KLUC-FM, both Las Vegas. ARS has an LMA in place for both deals and has just flipped KJMZ from urban and KFBI from classic rock.

ARS is also picking up two more stations in the Sacramento market to add to recently announced purchases there. Secret Communications will let go of sports KMJI and dance KSFM, Woodland, CA for an undisclosed amount. ARS has announced plans to acquire standards KCTC and soft AC KYMX, both Sacramento and news/talker KSTE, Rancho Cordova, CA.

WASHINGTON THIS WEEK

Covenant Media Services, Inc.'s KJUS, Beaumont, TX has been ordered to cough up \$1,000 for an unauthorized assumption of control. The Commission sent a letter on November 6, 1995 to the licensee asking why the station hadn't paid a previously assessed fine for the station's 1993 transfer. The station didn't respond, so the fine sticks.

The Commission has rescinded a forfeiture of \$7,500 for EEO violations against WMAX, Kentwood, MI. The former president of the licensee, WMAX, Inc., asked that the forfeiture be set aside because the station no longer exists and has no assets. The Commission agreed and rescinded the fine.

The Commission has ordered Davel Broadcasting Group's KLZE, Owensville, MO why its license should not be revoked. It's been silent since late 1994.

ELSEWHERE

Midwest Communications is doubling up in the Wausau/Stevens Point, WI market as it will buy Journal Broadcast Group's AC-news WSAU and CHR WIFC, both Wausau. No terms were announced. Midwest owns standards WRIG, Schofield and country WDEZ, Wausau.

Former financial-talk host and station owner Sonny Bloch pleaded guilty to seven counts of tax evasion and perjury after being indicted on several counts of fraud. Inside Radio reports Bloch, who has maintained his innocence until now, will probably face 18 to 24 months in jail, but still must deal with millions of dollars in civil lawsuits as well as other federal charges.

Broadcasters took it on the nose this week as the Supreme Court refused to hear a lower court ruling that overturned the FCC's jurisdiction over the lowest-unit-rate charge for political ads. According to a story in Inside Radio, politicians began suing broadcasters in 1990 over alleged violations. The FCC stepped in saying all complaints must go through it first. Then, an appellate court in Atlanta overturned the FCC decision. The NAB and FCC appealed. The Supreme Court's refusal to hear the case may allow politicians to sue broadcasters without FCC intervention first.

Golden West Broadcasters' alternative KSCA, Los Angeles got hit with a page 13 (formerly page 5B) notice, cover note and tape flag in the latest Spring Arbitron book for a response to a chat room on an Internet Web site. The violation was a response in the "KSCA Conference Room" which asked listeners to participate if someone from a ratings company, especially Arbitron, called on them to keep track of listening.

Interep has released a new report entitled "Radio in Cyberspace/Preparing for the Journey" which provides the industry's first research analysis focusing on radio's compatibility with this interactive medium. According to the study, 23 million Americans explored the Internet last year and the similarities when comparing the demographic profiles of on-line users and radio listeners are striking. Reflecting the upscale nature of Internet users, Classical listeners indexed the highest at over twice the national average for being an on-line PC user. Other formats indexing more than twice the national average are alternative and new AC. Variety, AOR, classic rock, and news/talk also index at over 1 1/2 times the average. A new Eastman Radio study, Radio: Offering Value In All Dayparts!, which used Spring 1995 Arbitron data from the top 50 markets, revealed that while more than 77% of the population listen during morning drive, an even greater 81% tune in during afternoon drive. Midday also scores well with AQH's nearly equal to morning drive and surpassing afternoon drive. In addition, 57% listen to the radio at night, a daypart that is often overlooked or considered less than desirable. Actually, 78% of those listeners who listen in the morning stay tuned for Middays, 86% tune in for the afternoon drive, and 83% are also listening over the weekend.
