DESCRIPTION OF COLUMNS AND TERMS USED IN THIS LIST:

H: Use this column to track Mexican Stations which you have heard.

FREQ: This is the assigned frequency of a station on the AM Band

CALL: This is the call letters assigned to the station in the AM Band.

CITY/STATE: Exact city-of-license is given where known. The following abbreviations are used for Mexican states:

POWERS: "-1" = station power is unknown. Other negative numbers indicate presumed, suspected, or estimated powers. Many of these listings are a result of the fact that stations seldom publicize their night powers. Directional antenna patterns (U2, U3, etc), when known, are listed in the "Notes" column.

SLOGANS: May include frequently-used network names. For new CPs, the licensee organization is listed here if known. "R" = "Radio." "LV" = "La Voz." Announced frequencies in slogans need to be clear on the exact text; i.e., 860 is Ochocientos Sesenta but 8-60 is Ocho Sesenta. This difference is important for identifications and for DXers who have limited Spanish language skills. For FM frequencies, the decimal point "." is *punto*. Some stations will identify by their call letters and this is not always listed under slogans.

SCHEDULES – ALL TIMES ARE IN UTC (Coordinated Universal Time), also known as GMT (Greenwich Mean Time), except for the supplemental spreadsheet where local times are used to describe the time(s) at which stations broadcast the national anthem. All Mexican states use UTC minus 6 hours (GMT-6) except Quintana Roo (GMT-5), Baja California Sur, Chihuahua, Nayarit, Sinaloa, and Sonora (GMT-7); and Baja California (ex-Norte) (GMT-8). Note that all states observe Daylight Savings Time (except Sonora and Quintana Roo), so subtract 1 hour from listed schedules from the first Sunday of April (2 AM local time) to the last Sunday of October (2 AM local time). The following border cities begin daylight savings time on the second Sunday in March and end on the first Sunday of November: Mexicali and Tijuana in Baja California, Juarez and Ojinaga in Chihuahua, Acuna and Piedras in Coahuila, Anahuac in Nuevo Leon and Matamoros, Nuevo Laredo and Reynosa in Tamaulipas. ">" in place of a dash means that the station stays on later than the second time listed, but exact sign-off time is unknown. Similarly, "<" indicates that the station is on the air by the first time listed, but the exact sign-on time is unknown. Many stations in Mexico now broadcast 24h/day. However, many also sign on at 0500/0600 hours local time and run to 2300/2400 hours' local time. The schedule column has been updated when a schedule is known. Please keep in mind that this column isn't absolute in some cases and the actual schedule may differ from the listed schedule.

Music may be in English (E), Spanish (S), or English-Spanish (E/S).

NETWORKS: The networks below range from satellite-fed simulcasts (eg, Radio Fórmula) to stations which do not simulcast but use identical jingles and promotional announcements (eg Nucleo Radio Mil). Smaller regional networks of 2 to 5 stations may simulcast at times. These networks are often identified by a common slogan in the "Slogans" column (eg, Radio Sistema Zacatecas). Groups of stations which merely use the same advertising agency (Corporadio, Sociedad Mexicana de Radio) are no longer listed as networks, because the names of these "networks" are virtually never mentioned on the air. There are many more minor local ownership groups and networks than listed here, but these have been selected mostly because they may be mentioned on air.

Regional affiliates and lesser-known national affiliates are listed in the "Notes" column. SA, "EH-she ah," is widely used in corporation names in Mexico, and means roughly the same as "Inc" in the US or "Ltd" in Canada.

NOTES: This column includes regional networks, FM parallels, and other details to help identify a station, as well as the station's FM migration status if known. The following abbreviations are used in the "Notes" column:

Network web sites are listed in the network abbreviation legend above.

Mexico has adopted IBOC as the standard for digital radio. A list dated April 18 2012 has 10 stations authorized to use IBOC. Watch for IBOC from these stations and report them. XEKAM Tijuana on 950 kHz has used IBOC for several years.

The main development since the last edition of the Log has been additional progress on the FM migration. The June 2019 IFT list shows only 399 stations (including CPs for future stations) remaining on AM. This is probably very close to correct, and the number of stations actually on the air as this edition goes to press is probably about 350, with the remainder being silent stations and new CPs. A large number of Mexico City AMs have been silent in recent years (specifically XERC-790, XEQR-1030, XERED-1110, XEJP-1150, XEDA-1290, XENET-1320, XEEST-1440, and XEINFO-1560, with XEDA and XENET's licenses reportedly expired; XEINFO has migrated to FM). XEQR-1030 and possibly XEJP-1150 reportedly returned to the air as this year's Log was being finalized. See notes under each of these stations for details.

Negotiations have apparently taken place to allow most stations in smaller markets along the US border to receive an FM allocation (often, but not always, in the 88-92 MHz segment). In major cities where there are not enough FM slots available to allow all AM stations to migrate, the available allocations (if any) have been awarded, and it can generally be assumed that any station in Mexico City, Guadalajara, Monterrey, Puebla, Tijuana, Toluca and other congested markets which do not currently have an FM allocation will remain on AM indefinitely. At this time, it is believed that 4 Mexican states have only one AM station remaining (Aguascalientes = XEEY-660, Morelos = XECTAM-1390 plus a CP for XEJOEP-1190, Querétaro = XEQJAL-1200 plus a CP for XEQRMD-1310, and Tlaxcala = XETT-1430). Some AM frequencies, including 670, 880, 890, 1320, 1330 and 1580, have no stations left, and many channels only have 1, 2, 3 or 4 stations remaining.

It should be noted that the purpose of the FM migration is ***not*** to vacate the AM band. We know this for at least 3 reasons:

1. It would be impossible. Even after changing the required spacing for FM stations from 800 kHz to 400 kHz, it was obvious from the start that markets such as Mexico City, Guadalajara, Puebla, etc, would never have enough available FM slots to allow all existing AM stations to move.
2. Existing AM licenses that are vacated by stations moving to FM are put up for auction (85 more were released for bidding on 8/26/2019), and a few dozen CPs have already been issued to new licensees for those recently-vacated AM stations.
3. Applications for brand-new AM licenses are still being accepted and granted (see XEJAGC-720, XECSCGU-1620 and XECSCA-1670, among several others).

The purpose of the FM migration is surely to maximize the utilization of the FM band (as well as the related license fees!), with the challenge being how to divide the available FM slots fairly between existing commercial AM licensees and other groups (indigenous and "social"/"community" broadcasters). To this end, the FM spectrum between 106 and 108 MHz has been allocated for social, community and indigenous stations, and wherever possible, commercial stations in this frequency range are being moved to lower frequencies on the FM dial.

A total of 207 stations have directly told us they have turned off their AMs, but web stream monitoring and other related research (eg, license renewals, network affiliate lists, granting of replacement CPs, reviewing Facebook photo history to see when the AM frequency was removed from station logos, etc) indicates that the actual number of stations that have left AM is about 600. The number of stations that have been told that they must keep their AM stations on the air (or find a new owner, most likely a non-profit community organization, to take over the AM), because the smaller coverage of their new FM station would result in entire towns no longer having radio service, has more than doubled, to 61. (It appears that in a handful of cases, the stations in question may have ignored this mandate, as they have told us directly that their AMs are gone). As stations have vacated their old AM licenses, the IFT has placed these frequencies up for auction, and about 25 CPs have been granted to replace AM stations that have migrated. In at least one case, a station has repurchased its own former AM license (XEMU-580, reportedly granted a new license as XELRDA but still IDing as XEMU in the summer of 2018).

A few cases have been reported of stations "granting themselves" a CP to FM, ie, simply moving their stations to a vacant FM frequency (allegedly without a CP) and changing the "XE" in their calls to "XH." A few university stations are said to have done this. Some stations are said to have continued operating with expired licenses for years, whereas others (eg, XEQC-1390) have been shut down. The current administration in Mexico has been friendly toward pirate broadcasters, often granting them licenses, so not surprisingly, pirate radio activity has increased sharply, and is no longer mostly limited to the southern states of Oaxaca and Chiapas. (Most pirate activity in Mexico is on FM). On the other hand, stations whose licenses have expired recently are being ordered by the IFT to shut down, and several lawsuits pertaining to this new stricter enforcement have already been filed.

Stations reported by two or more sources to have left AM have been removed from this year's list. Readers are encouraged to consult last year's list for information on these removed stations.

Another surprising development in the past year is the appearance – and disappearance – of a new X-bander, XECSCA-1670 Tarandacua, GJTO, which existed from January to April of 2019 before moving to FM in another market about 20 miles to the east. There are no known reports of any DXers hearing this station while it was on the air.

Under the new call sign conventions adopted by the IFT, virtually all new licenses are assigned 6- or even 7-letter calls, the first 7-letter call having recently been assigned to the new CP for XECSCGU-1620 in Guachochi CHIH.

There are a number of "formats" ("La Mejor", "Ponte Exa FM", etc) which could be more accurately described as marketing services. These services provide branding and marketing support (eg, web sites and Facebook pages with a standardized look-and-feel, and pre-recorded slogan IDs to use on the air) rather than actual programming. (A few US stations use these services as well; for example, KSUN-1400 uses "La Mejor"). Some networks (such as Radio Fórmula) continue to provide programming.

Speaking of Radio Fórmula, it should be noted that this network operates 5 stations in México City (3 AM and 2 FM), and the lines between the 3 traditional ORF1/ORF2/ORF3 networks are becoming quite blurred. A fourth network called "Trion," drawing some of its programming from ORF's 2 FM stations in México City, is starting to appear on some AM stations, and even the ORF1/ORF2/ORF3 stations can sometimes be heard with programming from one of the FM stations. In markets such as Guadalajara and Monterrey where there are not enough FM allocations available, we are noting an ongoing "juggling" of ORF1/ORF2/ORF3/Trion programming in these markets, perhaps with the goal of moving the ORF3 or Trion format (which might appeal to younger listeners?) to the one AM station in that market that has been granted an FM allocation. Also note that at least 2 US stations (KNRV-1150, KNUV-1190) carry Radio Fórmula programming, even including the Mexican national anthem, and can thus easily be mistaken for Mexican stations. The most

recognizable program on Radio Fórmula is surely Estilo de Vida, which usually airs at Midnight and 6am (right after the national anthem) on ORF1 and occasionally ORF2 stations. About 20 seconds after the top of the hour, and several more times throughout the hour, this show runs sections of the "I Dream of Jeannie" theme song, "lifted" directly from the TV show (it even contains the "smoke" sound effects where Jeannie enters or exits her bottle).

Musical formats have evolved quite a bit over the years, and the lines between the different formats seem more blurry than ever. Even the stations themselves often use two or three different terms in describing a single format. Norteña music seems much less prevalent than it was 25 years ago, and is often lumped in with ranchera. The Romántica format, which used to be indicative of multiple acoustic guitars and beautiful harmony singing, now often consists of shallow adult contemporary or dance club music. The Grupera format can range from sophisticated musical arrangements with talented brass musicians (somewhat similar to the traditional Tropical format) all the way down to cheap synthesizer music, with all the brass instruments replaced by very disappointing electronic imitations.

National newscasts are far more common today than they were even ten years ago. DXers with little or no Spanish language skills are especially cautioned not to fall into the bad habit of hearing (for example) "mentions of Chiapas" on a station, and concluding that the station heard was the one in Chiapas.

Accurate and complete information about Mexican stations has always been very hard to obtain, but the situation appears to be improving. The new IFT station lists, which initially seemed almost as unreliable as the old SCT lists, are now much closer to reality. Lists kept by the American FCC, while they do appear to have improved in recent years, should never be considered a reliable source of station information. Lists published by broadcasters, advertising agencies, and other organizations are also quite contradictory. Network affiliate lists, when available, have generally been pretty accurate. To get the best possible information, we have attempted to contact each station directly wherever possible. Approximately one third of the stations have responded to our inquiries. We have also attempted to listen to every station's web stream (if one exists) and visit every station's web site and Facebook page to validate the information in this list. A small number of stations (especially in BC Sur and along the Rio Grande Valley) still appear to have no web presence. Stations that were suspected to be silent in the early versions of this list back in the 1990s have been cross-checked, and if they still have no web presence or other evidence that they actually exist, they have been removed. Stations known to have moved to FM since the last edition of the list was published, or reported to have moved by multiple independent sources, have been removed as well. See the "Notes" column for details. When it comes to latitude/longitude listings, no two sources agree on the location of most stations, but obvious errors from past editions have been researched and updated to reflect the most credible recent source available, and a few entries have been updated in response to well-publicized transmitter moves.

Information in this log (and the supplemental spreadsheet described below) is updated to **September 1 2019**. Thanks to all the DXers who report their loggings to the IRCA, NRC and ABDX. Those loggings were used along with network lists to compile slogans and FM parallels along with formats. It should be noted that most of our efforts in this edition of the list have been focused on getting the formats, networks, slogans and FM migration status of each station up to date. Other data, especially night powers, hours of operation and the information in the supplemental spreadsheet, need additional research. Anyone who wishes to assist in this effort (by monitoring station web streams, or the stations themselves if they are audible from your location) is encouraged to volunteer.

SUPPLEMENTAL SPREADSHEET – Along with this edition of the Mexican Log we are posting a spreadsheet with supplemental information that may be useful to DXers trying to identify weak signals from Mexican stations. This spreadsheet is a work in progress extracted from the editor's personal station list. It shows the URLs (when known) for each station's web page, live stream, and Facebook page. These links can be especially useful for DXers using SDRs, to quickly pull up a web stream to see if it matches a

signal being heard on the radio. Users are cautioned that we have occasionally found station web sites to be hacked, and it is the sole responsibility of each user to ensure they have adequate virus protection on their computers before clicking on any link in this spreadsheet. Surprisingly, close to half of these URLs had changed from just a year ago, and a few had changed more than once. This is largely due to the ongoing station rebranding associated with the FM migration. The spreadsheet also reflects the editor's efforts (through DXing with beverage antennas in Chula Vista CA and near Baker NV, as well as monitoring station web streams) to learn what type of national and/or state anthems each station plays in the morning and evening (typically, but not always, around 6am and/or Midnight local time). With some frequencies having only a few stations left, knowing the type of anthem played on each station can be very valuable in helping to identify the station being heard. Users are cautioned not to employ this technique on Sunday evenings, when most stations air a common version of the national anthem from the National Hour program around 11pm local time, and to remember that there are a few US stations such as KNRV 1150 AM and KNUV 1190 AM which also air the Mexican national anthem as part of their network programming originating in México. Finally, note that web streams on Mexican stations may perform very poorly (excessive buffering), have extended outages, be well out of synch with the on-air broadcast, or not be compatible with some mobile devices.

NOTES FOR SUPPLEMENTAL SPREADSHEET: The following abbreviations are used in the "WEB", "LIVE", and "FB" columns:

- Defunct - Last time we checked (8/19), web site was no longer there (or owner had not paid annual domain registration fees?).
- DJ - The station does not seem to have a current Facebook page; the page in this link belongs to an individual announcer.
- EMPTY - The last time we checked (8/19), this web page was essentially "empty" (contained no useful information).
- FB - (LIVE column): This live stream must be accessed via Facebook.
- FM - This site is for the station's FM, and may or may not contain useful information about the AM.
- INDIV - Station has set up an individual Facebook page instead of a business page.
- NET - Page is for the entire network or ownership group, not just this station.
- NG? - The last time we visited this URL (8/19), it was not working. Generally this implies the page has worked in the past.
- STALE - The last time we checked (8/19), this site seemed well out of date. Watch for format/slogan changes and new pages.
- UC - Web page was under construction the last time we checked (8/19).

A QUICK GUIDE TO THE SPANISH LANGUAGE

By Bill Hardy, revised by Guillermo Glenn Hauser, 2019

When you hear Mexican radio stations, you may hear letters, numbers and slogans. If you know a little basic Spanish, you'll be ahead of the game. Spanish pronunciation in Mexico is fairly straightforward. While "long" vowels in English are actually diphthongs, in Spanish each vowel letter has one pure sound: a = "ah", e = "eh", i = "ee", o = "oh", u = "oo".

Consonants mostly resemble their English language counterparts, with some notable exceptions. "H" is silent. "J" sounds like our "h," but stronger, as in "José". "X" may sound like our "x," as in "éxitos," but in Mexican place names such as México (MEH-hee-koh) or Oaxaca (wah-HAH-kah), it sounds like our "h." "ñ," enye, has the "ny" sound of "Señor" (seh-NYOR). Double "l" sounds like "y," as in "Vallarta" (bah-YAR-tah). "B" and "V" sound the same in two different ways depending on whether they are initial in a word: like our B; or amid a word, like our V. R is slightly trilled especially if initial, and more trilled if double. Like "radio" (RRAH-dhee-oh). D unless initial sounds like "th" in our word "the". Better rendered as "dh", also as in "ciudad" (twice).

The sounds of some consonants depend on the next letter. For instance, "g" can sound like the hard "g" sound of "Gómez" (ga, go, gu) or our soft "h" sound of the Spanish "j" (ge, gi). "C" can sound like "k" (ca, co, cu) or "s" (ce, ci). "Cu" plus a vowel (cua, cue, cui) makes a "kw" sound, as in "frecuencia." "Ch" equals English "ch," as in "mucho." "Qu" (que, qui) sounds like "k".

Accents in Spanish are very regular. A word ending with a vowel (a, e, i, o, u), or "n" or "s," is stressed on the next-to-last syllable, such as "cinco" (SEEN-koh) or "Variedades" (bah-ree-eh-DHAH-dhehs) without any acute accent mark. Words ending with any other consonant are stressed on the last syllable, such as "festival" (fehs-tee-VAHL) or "Ciudad" (cee-oo-DHAHDH). If a word is stressed on any other syllable, an accent mark is required, such as "éxitos" (EX-ee-tohs).

On this page are charts of Spanish letters and numbers. These should help you pronounce station call letters, plus numbers such as "5-70" (cinco setenta) in the slogan column. Note that B and V sound alike, and there are two ways to pronounce the letters V, W and Y. Also note that numbers 21-29 are compound words and not separated by a "y" (and). This combining applies only to the 20's (21-29)
