Radio Authority reveals its White Paper wish-list

GLASGOW — In a radical set of proposals, the UK's Radio Authority (RA) is calling for the abolition of national ownership restrictions within the radio sector, the creation of a single converged media regulator and the introduction of a new tier of "access" radio.

It has also opened up the prospect of a turf war between local radio stations by suggesting that for the first time head-to-head competition should be permitted, proposing, for example,

that more than one station could operate a CHR format in a local market.

The proposals, set out by RA chairman Richard Hooper in a speech to the Radio Academy's Radio Festival in Glasgow on July 4, form the main planks of "Radio Regulation for the 21st Century"—a submission document by the RA to the UK government on what it would like to see in the broadcasting White Paper, due for publication towards the end of this year.

Industry hails new French quota law

PARIS — The revision of France's 1994 radio quota law—passed June 29—gives both broadcasters and the music industry reasons to be satisfied.

The music industry is pleased to have preserved a system that provides a radio window for local acts, especially new talents, although it has to make do with more relaxed regulations.

Sony Music France president/CEO Olivier Montfort welcomes the new law "which marks a serious improvement over what was initially voted by

the Parliament." Montfort says that the industry was "on the brink of a disaster." "We always are surprised by parliament. It shows we need to improve our lobbying capacity," he says.

Broadcasters are positive about an alteration of the initial law, voted in 1994 and implemented in 1996, that takes into account format specifications. Formerly, all stations, regardless of their formats, were required to broadcast a minimum of 40% of French-sung music, half of which had to be by new talent. Now, the

Kylie's star spins around again

LONDON — In at No.1 with a bullet in the UK, Kylie Minogue's comeback single *Spinning Around*, which also debuted at number 7 in M&M's Eurochart Hot 100 singles chart, has been a triumph of precision marketing and promotion for the Australian pop star's new record label Parlophone. Prior to its release on June 19, Minogue had notched up 26 consecutive Top 20 hits in the UK, 20 denting the Top 10, but disappointing sales of her eponymous 1998 album on Deconstruction left her without a record contract, as Parlophone A&R director Miles Leonard recalls.

Unique aims to buy

LONDON — Ten years after its creation, UK radio production and syndication company Unique Broadcasting is reinventing itself as a content producer. On July 3, Unique started trading as UBC Media Group on the Alternative Investment Market (AIM) raising around £5 million to finance further expansion.

The flotation values the company, which produces the UK Pepsi Chart Show, at around £30 million netting its co-founders, chief executive Simon Cole and former Piccadilly Radio boss and UBC programme director Tim Blackmore, around £7 million in shares. UK

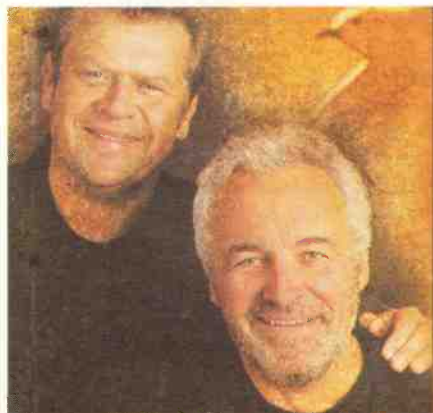

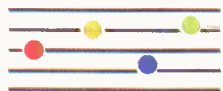

Upfront

Two major European countries are currently revamping their radio regulations and there couldn't be a more different approach.

France, for a start, has finally put to bed a communications bill, which has been two years in the making, and has proved to be as slippery as it could get for the government (Prime Minister Lionel Jospin had to face the embarrassment of withdrawing the original text a year ago when convinced that even his own party wouldn't vote for it).

The French law is 95% geared towards television and the Internet and only a few paragraphs concern radio, and only in its most trivial way—the quotas of French content. Nothing on ownership, nothing on digital radio, nothing on cross-media ownership, nothing on formats diversity.

It sends two messages—that radio is not high on the government's agenda and that the local radio industry is not really good at making itself heard.

New MD for Columbia in France

PARIS — Virginie Auclair has been promoted to the position of managing director of Columbia Group at Sony Music France.

Auclair was previously general manager of Columbia international and senior vice-president of Sony Music France, in charge of the international marketing of local repertoire. She will retain the latter role.

Auclair will report to Sony Music France president/CEO Olivier Montfort, whom she replaces at Columbia.

"We've been working together since 1993," Montfort tells Music & Media. "We know each other quite

well and I think it's a good thing both for the team and for the artists to have this continuity."

Montfort says the French market is "very tense" at the moment and that Auclair, who joined CBS France in the early 1980s, will have to "imprint her own personality on the label."

Auclair has built a solid reputation at Columbia with the development of international acts such as Tina Arena, Celine Dion, Harry Connick Jr and Mariah Carey. Columbia is France's biggest label according to Sony, with domestic acts such as Jean-Jacques Goldman, Francis Cabrel, Patricia Kaas and Anggun. Montfort says that Auclair's new

position should not affect her role as the company head of international development. He says: "Our goal is to continue to break as many local acts as possible internationally and Virginie, with her knowledge of the international marketplace and her understanding of Sony's structure, is the best positioned for this task."

Montfort, who was appointed to the helm of the company at the beginning of the year, says that his next main appointment will be to find an MD for Sony label S.M.A.L.L. The post became vacant two months ago following the departure of Philippe Desindes, who was appointed president of Warner Music France. Meanwhile, Montfort assumes day-to-day management duties at the label.

Act 2000 to relaunch

HAMBURG — A project aimed at getting new German music into the charts is to relaunch, with record companies and radio stations blaming each other for its relative lack of success so far.

Act 2000 is a joint venture between the German Association of the Phonographic Industry and VPRT, the commercial broadcasters association, to promote new national artists. Launched six months ago the project has thus far produced just one hit, French Affair's *My heart goes boom*.

Speaking at the Music City Hamburg seminar on July 23, Tim Renner, president of music at Universal Music Germany said: "Commercial broadcasters and the music industry follow two totally different paths. Commercial broadcasters use music as a tool to increase their audience and to promote their product and their advertising time, which is

absolutely understandable."

Radio stations have criticised the music industry for sending them too much product. The music industry, has criticised radio for not featuring as many Act 2000 songs as promised.

But both sides say they remain committed to the project, which they plan to relaunch in August, with greater collaboration at grass roots level.

General manager of the Association of the Phonographic Industry Peter Zombik said: "We started a very good communication process with some irritations, but that doesn't mean it's going to stop."

Renner, meanwhile, has criticised public service broadcasters, who he says should be promoting new and unknown artists: "In order to put the public stations under pressure we will continue this initiative," Renner says, "even if we are not satisfied with it at the moment."

At the same time, the UK is entering a period of profound change in the organisation of its radio industry. Spearheading the changes is the Radio Authority, which outlined this week in Glasgow its proposals for a radical revamp of the UK's radio regulation (see story front page).

If the RA's plans to lift ownership rules goes through, the UK's radio playground (battleground?) is set to become the most competitive market in Europe, not too different from what the American market has gone through in the past five years. This will put the UK in a league of its own within Europe.

Looking at it from a European perspective, what we have is a highly dysfunctional continent with as many different systems as countries (and even different systems within the same country—see Belgium!). Again and again, this magazine has been advocating for a greater harmonisation of Europe's radio regulations and what is happening in France and the UK is simply giving more ammunition to the argument. But when this is going to happen is anyone's guess.

Cadena 100 ratings fall

MADRID — Spanish AC network Cadena 100 has lost more than 25% of its daily audience in what is being described as a “colossal” change in both the network and its owners’ fortunes.

For the first time in four years the network, which is owned by Cadena COPE, dropped below the one million mark to reach a daily audience of 802,000, according to the year’s second national EGM (Estudio General de Medios) survey.

The change has taken Spanish music radio by surprise. “We don’t understand it and there is no possible explanation,” says Cadena 100’s national co-ordinator Jordi Casoliva. “The drop is colossal and out of the blue and breaks all listener survey logic. Nothing like this has happened in the 14 years of EGM surveys.”

Cadena 100 had been the third most popular music radio network since the April-May 1994 survey. Now, for the first time in six years, Cadena SER’s AC/Gold M-80 Radio network has regained

the third spot from Cadena 100, behind two other SER networks—CHR leader Los 40 Principales, and Spanish-music station Cadena DIAL.

Cadena 100 has long relied on its popular morning show *La Jungla* presented by Jose Antonio Abellan to boost its audience ratings. *La Jungla* lost 123,000 listeners in the latest survey, falling below 700,000 for the first time.

M-80 director Sandro D’Angeli was delighted with his climb to third spot, achieved through a relatively modest increase in listeners, up 27,000 to 869,000. “I cannot comment on Cadena 100’s drop,” says

D’Angeli. “But M-80 is gradually growing and this result vindicates all our changes. For example, we have updated our golden oldies collection to put on mainly hits from the 80s and 90s.

D’Angeli says his target would be around one million daily listeners, but admits “that will be very difficult given that we have just 36 stations and seven of those are in small towns not covered by the EGM survey.”

The other notable result over the Jan-Feb survey was the 163,000 surge in the audience of Spanish music-only Radiolé to 558,000, maintaining its fifth spot in the ratings.

New Dutch broadcaster gets more airtime

HILVERSUM — New youth-oriented Dutch public broadcaster BNN has had its airtime tripled by the Dutch Broadcasting Authority.

BNN has been awarded an extra 900 hours a year, up to 1,200 from 300, by attracting more than 100,000 fee-paying “members” to its service.

Under Dutch media regulations, public broadcasters are granted airtime slots according to how many people subscribe to the service. Newcomers need to pass the threshold of 60,000 members before being provisionally allocated airtime for two

years. After that time, a second threshold—introduced earlier this year—of 100,000 members allows a further increase in hours.

BNN editor-in-chief Laurens Drillich says: “Although we knew it about it beforehand, we were absolutely delighted at the news. Now we have to work out new formats.”

It is estimated the broadcaster will double its 35-strong workforce in view of the increase in hours that becomes effective from September 1 this year. Programming will continue to cater for the young adult demographic, mainly 18-25-year-olds.

Drillich says: “People have come to know us from our ‘naughty’ and youthful approach, which we will cherish—but we will certainly try to widen our scope now.”

BNN broadcasts on public talk/news station Radio 1, CHR/alternative 3FM and cultural broadcaster Radio 5. But it is negotiating to drop its slots on Radio 5 in favour of airtime on AC station Radio 2, which better reflects its current programming policy.

BNN also has an 10 extra hours a week on 3FM through a one-off collaboration with public broadcasting giant TROS.

German station to boost digital uptake

MAGDEBURG — Germany’s first AOR digital radio station Rockland Sachsen-Anhalt is being broadcast on FM in order to boost digital radio listenership.

The move, according to Mario A. Liese, programming director and general manager of Rockland Sachsen-Anhalt, is an attempt to encourage higher penetration of digital radio, which is still low in

Germany, due mainly to the high price of receivers (usually over DM 1000, euros 512.8). “This marketing strategy is looked on with a lot of national and international interest,” Liese says.

The station, which plays hit rock songs from the 70s, 80s and 90s, began broadcasting a year ago. The FM frequencies are provided by the commercial station Radio SAW which is owned by the same company as

Rockland Sachsen-Anhalt—the VMG-group.

The initiative has been praised by VPRT, the German commercial broadcasters association. Head of media policy affairs at VPRT Dr Thorsten Grothe says: “As an association we are still looking at digital radio sceptically because of the low number of receivers. We think it is a good idea to promote digital radio through FM frequencies.”

ON THE BEAT

CHURCH TO CELEBRATE AT ECHO AWARDS

HAMBURG — Classical music stars Nigel Kennedy, Charlotte Church and Isaac Stern will be honoured at the “Echo Klassik 2000” awards to be held in Berlin on October 22 this year, event organisers announced on June 28. The ceremony, which will be taking place in Berlin for the first time, is to be broadcast live from the Konzerthaus am Gendarmenmarkt by the ZDF channel.

SACEM REVENUES UP

LONDON — French rights society SACEM/SDRM collected Ffr 3.688 billion (euros 562 million) in 1999, a 3.9% increase on the previous year, and redistributed Ffr 3.024 bn (+4.7% on 1998). SACEM president Jean-Loup Tournier says 3.9% represented a “reasonable” return after bad figures in 1997 and a recovery in 1998. Although Tournier notes that mechanical revenues suffered from lower record sales, the decline was offset by an 8.1% increase in revenues from broadcasters, which enjoyed a good year for advertising, at Ffr 1.166 bn.

EBU ELECTS NEW PRESIDENT

LUCERNE — Arne Wessberg, 57, head of the Finnish broadcaster YLE, was elected president of the European Broadcasting Union (EBU) for a two-year term, starting on January 1, 2001. Wessberg, who is also president of pay TV channel Eurosport, succeeds Albert Scharf, director general of the Bayerischer Rundfunk (Bavarian Broadcasting Corporation), who will complete his ninth consecutive two-year term as EBU President on December 31. Boris Bergant, deputy director general of RTVSLO, Klaus Berg, director general of ARD/Hessischer Rundfunk, Michèle Cotta, director general of France 2, and Roberto Zaccaria, president of RAI were all elected vice-presidents.

UK MPs RALLY BEHIND SACKED DJ

LONDON — The recent sacking of the DJ Andy Kershaw by the CHR national public broadcaster BBC Radio One has led to protests in the British Parliament. In an Early Day Motion tabled in the House of Commons, 34 MPs have registered their anger at the dismissal of Kershaw, whose contract was not renewed last month after 15 years with the station and whose Thursday night world music show attracted some 170,000 listeners.

MOVING CHAIRS

LONDON — Richard Griffiths has been appointed president of BMG central Europe; he was the division’s executive VP. He retains his title as chairman of BMG UK and Ireland.

Yoel Kenan, who was until the beginning of the year VP international marketing/MCA Records at Universal Music International, has left the company. He is joining California-based Internet company Eveo as managing director for Europe.

Former head of music at Metro Radio in Newcastle, UK, Leyton Bracegirdle has joined Chyialis-backed internet company, Ride The Tiger, as music controller at the music and lifestyle web venture, due to launch later this year.

PARIS — Delphine Jeammet joins France’s international radio service RFI as deputy director of communications, Jeammet was previously head of marketing at music channel MCM International.

Hervé Lemaire, who announced a few weeks ago his departure from music channel MCM where he was programme director, will join in September Virgin France as director of new media.

Paris-based Lucy Smith, who operates as the National Association of Broadcasters (NAB) European contact, has become a consultant for US company Hiwire, which offers streaming audio services.

Dance grooves

DANCEFLOOR DREAM

Florian F's appropriately named *Surreal Brazil* (Expanded/Italy), already being played by Judge Jules on BBC Radio One (CHR), combines the tough, minimalist side of techno with the classic song *Brasil* plus a double helping of percussion and some classic drops. The combination of a ruthlessly insistent groove and the singalong qualities of a classic tune should guarantee maximum dancefloor presence, although it is hard to imagine this one gracing daytime radio.

THE TOAST OF ALCA-PULCO

An altogether different take on the Brazilian vibe comes in the form of Dee Zee's *White Wine in Alca-Pulco* (Prog City/Germany). This smooth, jazzy track employs a chorus vocal and one of the phattest bass synth sounds since Weather Report's *Birdland*. The perfect soundtrack to a lazy summer afternoon, this is no orthodox radio record but the lush production and occasional vocals should give it a chance with some of the more progressive programmers.

POP-CORNY

The follow up to the excellent *Pure* by Cab 'N' Crew is another powerfully attractive tune called *Cityhopping* (Digidance/Netherlands). The main strength of the track is a keyboard line with a similar sound and appeal to the classic synthstrumental *Popcorn*. Although based around a post-gabber style that has come to typify one side of the prolific Dutch scene, this track, with its multiple hooks and playful approach, is yet more proof that Digidance is having a particularly good run right now.

THEM'S THE BREAKZ

The *Dutch Breakz* album (Fluff Girl Wax/Netherlands) is a varied and surprisingly high quality selection of track, submitted and selected through the Dutch Breakz web site. The one unifying element across the album's two discs is a love of breakbeats, whether it be D 'n' B, hip hop or electro, and, in light of the fact that no A&R-ing was done, ie all tracks submitted were included, the worst that could be said is that a few are rather derivative. Others, however, are quite excellent. Headliners' *When Diss Gets Out* is a splendid piece of rabble-rousing rap while *Josefine* by Amp Error is wonderfully strange, experimental D 'n' B.

EUROPE'S CLEAR FAVOURITE

With Crystal Clear's *Live Your Life* (Basement Planet Records/Switzerland) now licensed to over 40 territories and shaping up to be one of the summer's major hits, a new remix from Italy's Harlem Hustlers is making further waves. "The new mix is amazing," Basement Planet managing director Brian Allen said. "I didn't think the track could be improved but they've done it." With its undeniably Ibiza-inspired touches, the Harlem Hustlers mix promises to lend yet more momentum to *LYL*. "Because certain territories want to do something for their public this is the tenth remix of the track," Allen continued. "But it's the only one that has captured that Sa Trincha vibe." With club and radio play building across Europe, Allen is holding back with the follow-up. "We'll be releasing *Funky Diva* at the end of the summer so it doesn't interfere with sales of *Live Your Life*," he added.

Festival focus—Glastonbury (UK)

Over the weekend of June 23-25 the Glastonbury Festival For Contemporary Performing Arts celebrated its 30th anniversary with a superb headline performance from David Bowie. Organised by dairy farmer Michael Eavis, Glastonbury first took place in 1970 with Eavis paying headline act T-Rex a meagre £500 fee at a rate of £100 a month from his milk cheques. Eavis' philosophy and the festival's message of social and environmental awareness has changed little over the years, but the event itself has changed dramatically.

Now the world's largest greenfield festival, set in 700 acres, Glastonbury cost £7 million to stage and attracted 100,000 ticket holders with an estimated 20,000 willing to climb or dig their way in. Consequently, Eavis is planning to invest £1 million in a new impregnable fence. Despite such unfortunate expenditure, £700,000 is given each year to causes—most notably Greenpeace, WaterAid and Oxfam. With seven main stages and a variety of smaller venues to choose from, it's now possible to listen to almost any genre of music at any one time. In fact the only frustration over the three days was the inability to be in two places at once, for example Saturday night saw Travis, Leftfield, Fatboy Slim and Morcheeba simultaneously headline different stages.

As the Festival's full title suggests there are far more attractions than just music, with cinema, theatre, comedy, dance and a circus just a few of the alternatives. As well as a daily newspaper, the site also had its own independent radio station, Radio Avalon, which broadcast traffic reports, news, music and interviews 24 hours a day

throughout the event. UK public broadcaster BBC Radio 1 (CHR) and television station BBC 2 broadcast exclusive live coverage and ran their own stage at the Festival.

Radio 1 DJ Steve Lamacq—a Glastonbury stalwart who presented a show from the Festival on the Saturday and a four-hour special on the following Monday—sees the event as "the most quintessentially British of all the festivals, it's not just about the music but all those mavericks...that's why some bands will virtually do it for free." Of the BBC's involvement he says, "It nurtures the next generation of Glastonbury goers while creating an archive of classic performances. If only the BBC had been there in the first year for T-Rex!"

Phoenix rise from the flames of the '70s

Like the Monkees, Supergrass and the Bluetones before them, French retro popsters Phoenix all live together in the same apartment with their manager. But it is with the era of those manufactured TV stars the Monkees that Phoenix, with their love of '70s rock, guitar solos and disco, have most in common. Given that the French acts closest to breaking the UK in recent times have been Daft Punk and Air, this makes it all the more surprising that Phoenix's anachronistic musical style is proving such a hit across the Channel. As Virgin France product manager Vincent Clery-Melin says: "Phoenix are a pretty historic phenomenon because they represent the first time a French group singing in English has been able to rival English and American groups in anglophone territories."

Sent to radio in early May, the band's first single, *Too Young*, was BBC Radio 1 (CHR) DJ Jo Wiley's Record of the Week and is currently playlisted on Virgin Radio, London Live and XFM. Phoenix have also been well

received in the sometimes fickle UK music press where they were Melody Maker's New Band Of The Week and Uncut magazine elected the group's debut long player *United* (Source/Virgin)—released in Europe on June 12—its Album Of The Week. "Phoenix are very different. No young British bands are making music quite like this—a definite retro rock-based feel but with a very 'now' production. These are early days but I think Phoenix have great potential and make great radio records," believes Roland Hill from independent UK promotions company Anglo Plugging.

Too Young is also playlisted on full-service stations RTL, France Inter and RMC in France, as well as the national CHR P3, in Norway. Meanwhile the video for the single is receiving good rotation on MTV European, MTV Nordic, TMF in Holland, and M6 in France. Phoenix's follow-up single, *If I Ever Feel Better*, will be released in Europe in early September accompanied by a music video by Alex Courtes (Cassius) which they will support with a European tour in October and November.

THE NEW TESTAMENT OF FUNK

VOLUME 3

Acid Jazz

Release date: August 7

Following Volume 2 which was compiled solely by Unique Records in Germany, this collection sees the revitalised Acid Jazz label once again at the helm and with startling results. The label's diverse and eclectic ear is immediately apparent, and with new material and previously unreleased tracks by new signings and label stalwarts alike, it should delight specialist DJs and dance stations across Europe. The opening track *The Piper Cherokee* by The Bobby Hughes Experience sets the tone with a storming funk-fuelled five minutes that can best be described as a mutation of the James Taylor quartet and Jethro Tull. German moog-meister Erobique contributes *Greven Love*, an irresistibly funky slice of synth-infested disco while *Amber Flash* by That Girl Lynn—who seems to have sampled The Cure's guitar sound—is a groove-laden stroke of genius with a lazy mid-tempo bass line. As a compilation, *Volume 3* offers rich pickings for radio. It's rare to come across an album without the odd weak track. CB

When it comes to classic, harmony-laden West coast guitar pop, Scotland seems to produce an inordinately large number of bands. Continuing in the tradition of Teenage Fanclub, BMX Bandits, Eugenius and latterly Travis, Superstar return with their fourth album, this time for UK independent Camp Fabulous. Although they've been around for nine years, Superstar have never really received the recognition their yearning, melodic pop deserves—aside from fellow Scot Rod Stewart covering their eponymous single *Superstar*. And, despite its merits, *Phat Dat* is unlikely to buck this trend. *Someone's Watching Over Me* opens proceedings with a soaring melody that sounds curiously like Queen's *Who Wants To Live Forever*. The Freddie vibe continues on the church organ-led *More* with its elegaic refrain of "If I only had it all right now then I'd have more", while current single *I Love Love*—a tribute to jailbird Lee's legendary '60s LA combo—is euphoric, big chorused pop, crowned by Joe MacAlinden's strong vocals and a woodwind accompaniment. The problem though for Superstar is that their ebb and flow dynamics and tender crescendos are simply too subtle for mainstream tastes. AH

Dance Beat

The weekly dance chart comment by Harald Roth

Three tracks enter the Top 10 of the European Dance Traxx this week for the very first time. Bob Sinclar's *I Feel For You* from the *Champs Elysees E.P.* (Yellow Productions/EastWest), which originally peaked at 16 some weeks ago, entered the German chart last week with new remixes, creating sufficient action for the track to move into the Top 10 at 8, up from 28. The French track is also at number 2 in the movers chart and records the biggest gain in club activity.

Last week's highest debut, *Don't Laugh* (Nervous) by Winx, climbed two places to number 9 and still has some margin for growth.

The third new entry in the Top 10 is Finland's Darude with *Sandstorm* (16 Inch/Stargate) at 10, up from 14, benefiting from chart entry in Norway and retailer support in Germany.

But the biggest contenders to dislodge Black Legend's *You See The Trouble With Me* (Rise/Time), which tops the chart for the sixth consecutive week, could well be Germany-signed ATB's seasoned *The Summer* (Kontor), which gains three positions to 6, and Marc & Claude's *I Need Your Lovin'* (Alphabet City), up one position to 7. The appropriately titled *The Summer* is now a smash throughout Scandinavia and needs some more continental support to move up.

However, Black Legend's *You See The Trouble With Me* seems to be solidly established at the top of the Dance Traxx. The title continues to dominate the chart with an impressive run throughout Europe, with this week's inclusion of The Netherlands and Finland.

Revisiting old hits from the '70s and '80s seem to be paying off. Last year, remixes gave Bob Marley a brand new chart life. This time, the Dance Traxx chart sees the return of Frankie Goes To Hollywood' with *The Power Of Love 2000* (ZTT), which makes a jump from 97 to 11.

And a few weeks after *Koochy* dropped out of the Top 10, American DJ/producer/label owner Armand van Helden already has another smash in the pipeline with *Full Moon* (both tracks on Armed/ffrr). The title is this week's highest Top 100 debut at 20. The tracks are from Van Helden current album titled *Killing Puritans* (Armed/ffrr).

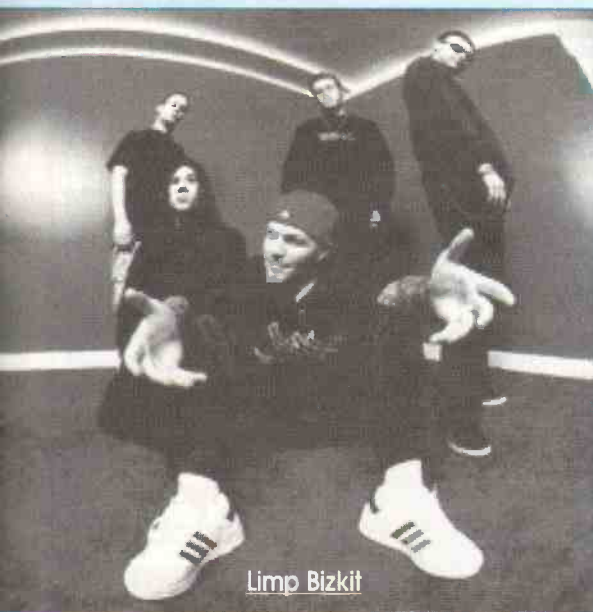

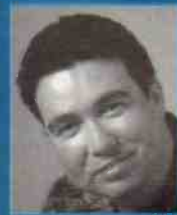

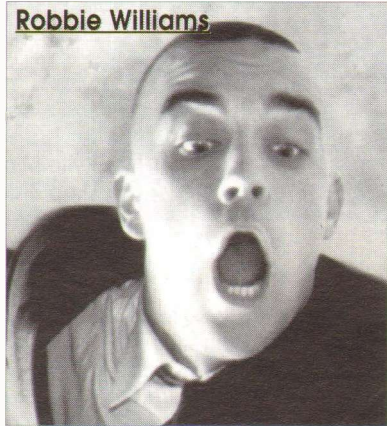

On the air

M&M's weekly airplay analysis column

Out of no less than seven new entries this week in the European Radio Top 50, the lowest of them has got the highest expectation of success. It's the new Robbie Williams single *Rock DJ* (Chrysalis), which enters as most-added at 43 with 15 new additions. Fashionably cheesy, its bassline is reminiscent of Frankie Goes To Hollywood 80's hit *Relax* (ZTT). Williams' forthcoming album, rumoured to be called *Sing When You're Winning*, will also contain a duet with Kylie Minogue, who herself climbs to number 16 with *Spinning Around* (Parlophone).

Matthias Voellm, head of music at Swiss CHR station Radio 105 (One-O-Five) in Basel, reckons: "*Rock DJ* is going to be huge in Switzerland! I loved it right away." The Robbie Williams single is placed on a special 'New For You' high rotation, in which records are played up to four times a day. The other records currently in the same category are *Jumpin' Jumpin'* by Destiny's Child (Ruffhouse/ Columbia), *Why Don't You Call Me*, Macy Gray (Epic) and *Who Do You See* by Swiss R&B talent Leme (Musikvertrieb), who teamed up for the single with Columbia-artist Marc Anthony.

According to Voellm another Swiss record that needs to be heard is *Day Off* by Martin Schenkel (EMI): "He used to be a sitcom actor, but this pop/rock record works well on radio in its own right."

Radio 105 (One-O-Five) is the official radio partner for Switzerland's Love Parade held on August 12 in Zurich. Last year the dance festival attracted 600,000 visitors. The station will broadcast its own party from the Love Parade, to be hosted by top Swiss house DJ Antoine.

The highest new entry, which is doing very well in Spain and Italy, is *Rome Wasn't Built In A Day* by British funksters Morcheeba (WEA) at 31. It's a good week also for Dutch independent dance label Violent which sees two of its acts enter the charts with the dance/pop sound of *Will I Ever* by Alice DeeJay (Violent/Variations) at 37 and the Vengaboys' cheesy reggae track, *Uncle John From Jamaica* (Violent/Variations) at 42.

Other new entries this week are *Californication* by the Red Hot Chili Peppers (Warner Bros.) at 35. *Doesn't Really Matter* by Janet Jackson (Island), taken from the Nutty Professor II soundtrack debuts at number 38, while Superfunk has got a new European radio hit with *The Young MC* (Labels) at 40, following their first hit, *Lucky Star* (Labels).

Likely to enter next week are the aforementioned *Why Didn't You Call Me* by Macy Gray (Epic), the metal/rap of *Take A Look Around* by Limp Bizkit (Interscope) and the guitar-pop of Toploader's *Dancing In the Moonlight* (Sony S2).

Festival security reviewed after Roskilde

ROSKILDE — Organisers of the Roskilde music festival and other big festivals have pledged to work together with the European festival associations Pop Code and Yourope to improve conditions in the wake of the nine deaths at the Danish event on June 30.

The tragedy occurred during US rock band Pearl Jam's set on Friday night, when fans were trampled in front of the stage. Nine young men subsequently died, 25 others were injured. Danish police have confirmed that the organisers will not face prosecution for the deaths, which they regard as accidental.

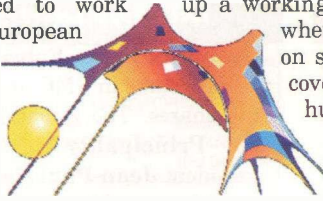
But there was criticism that vol-

unteers, rather than professionals, were used as stewards and security personnel and were allegedly slow to react to the drama.

The Danish government has set up a working group to look into whether special legislation on security is necessary to cover events that attract huge crowds.

As M&M went to press, the head of security at Denmark's second-biggest festival, Midtbybs (July 5-9), was talking to both the organisers of Roskilde and local police about how to avoid a repetition of the tragedy.

The organisers of Scotland's T in The Park were also carrying out a security review, with particular concern over timing of acts' appearances to prevent crushes at the front of stages.

DJ-turned-TV-presenter Noel Edmonds has joined UBC as a non-executive director with a 12% stake.

UBC has also stated it will use part of the money raised to fund its involvement in Wavefinder, the digital news and internet access technology.

Unique also produces programming across the main BBC radio channels, has joint ventures with US giant Viacom and the UK's Ginger Media Group and is a founder investor in digital radio station Oneworld.

Industry hails French quota law

new regulations—passed by the National Assembly as part of a global communication bill—differentiate between gold formats and stations broadcasting current music.

Marc Pallain, managing director of NRJ and president of radio organisation SRN, which includes the main national radio networks such as NRJ, Fun Radio, Nostalgie, RFM and Europe 2, says he is "satisfied" with the changes.

"Of course," he adds, "one can always hope for more relaxed regulations but all-in-all, it's an improvement. It will ease pressure on gold formats and make them easier to programme, and give more flexibility on youth formats. In the end, it is good for the diversity of content, because we will have less similar titles on the various stations."

The new law distinguishes "stations specialising in musical heritage" that will now broadcast 60% of French content, with only 5% of new talent/new production.

Stations "specialised in the promotion of young talent", the official definition for youth-oriented

stations, see their mandatory share of French content drop to 35%, but their share of new talent has been upped to 25%. The other formats will retain the 40%/20% quota rule.

New productions are records commercially released within the past six months, while a new talent is an act that has not yet been awarded two gold records for sales each over 100,000 units.

The initial text of the law called for gold stations to play at least of 10% of new talent/new production, while youth formats were to play 25% of new talent and 10% new production.

The changes in the quota law were originally introduced by the government but were relaxed in a first reading by the National Assembly before being overturned by the Senate and finally voted by the National Assembly in a second reading.

Hervé Rony, director general of industry body SNEP, admits that the regulation is not exactly what the industry expected but "we preserved the principle of quotas, even if we had to accept a compromise."

deal with Deconstruction I thought it was a great opportunity to start a third phase of her career. But it wasn't going back to the PWL years, for me it was about making a pop record that had depth and strong hooks," he explains.

Even so, for Parlophone—home of more alternative acts such as Radiohead and Supergrass—to take on an artist who, to many, was past her sell-by date was not only brave but financially risky.

"When you work on these [pop] acts," marketing & creative director, Terry Felgate, explains, "you spend more money than you would with bands—[you're] spending money to grab people's attention."

EMI vice president, international promotions, special projects, Katie Conroy is involved with overseeing the whole promotional campaign from the UK and reports that the rest of Europe is quickly taking the lead over the domestic territory.

"We had an initial theory to let the UK deliver and let the international come later," she says. "We started with Germany—[Kylie's] been there three times already doing Top Of The Pops and the opening of the Expo 2000 gala—and has MTV support. The record's Green listed at SER in Spain, on MTV hot rotation in Italy, [while] Scandinavia is very strong overall with radio support.

France is going to radio this week and we've done great press [there]," she adds.

At Spanish SER station Los 40 Principales (CHR), music manager Jaime Baro says of *Spinning Around* that "it's a new record by an artist that's always been received well by our listeners. It's got a fresh sound that fits well in our playlist."

In the UK, Galaxy 105 (Dance) programme director Jean Branch believes that the repositioning of Minogue as a mainstream pop artist lies behind her successful return. "They brought her back doing a dance single and there's been a great marketing and promotional campaign," Branch says. "But I think if it had been by an unknown artist it wouldn't have been a hit—it is because it's Kylie."

The 'Kylie' factor was crucial to Parlophone's decision to sign her, says managing director, Keith Wozencroft. "Kylie [has been] the ultimate pop icon in the UK over the past 12 years. We thought that if we're going to work with pop music as a label we should work with her."

Kylie Minogue's follow-up single, *On A Night Like This*, is released through Parlophone/EMI in early September. The album, *Light Years*, will be released later the same month.

aspects of radio," said RA chief executive Tony Stoller, briefing journalists ahead of Hooper's speech.

In the document, the RA says it wants to see the abolition of the current "points" system of ownership for local radio, whereby operators are currently limited to roughly 15% of the potential UK audience.

Instead, it suggests there should be no overall national restriction on the number and size of stations groups can own, although there should be clear rules to ensure plurality of voice in each local transmission area via restrictions on the number of licences a company can hold in an area.

Under the proposals, the maximum number of local/regional analogue licences a company could hold in a single geographical area is four, in areas where 10 or more local analogue licences exist. The number licences permitted vary according to the number of services on air. "What matters is the range of choice [available] where you a listener," noted Stoller.

If adopted by the government, the ownership liberalisation is certain to prompt another significant wave of consolidation within the UK industry.

The RA, however, still recommends some significant restrictions with respect to cross-media ownership, including prohibition from owning a national newspaper or national TV licence and a national radio station.

On formats, the RA thinks that, given the spectrum shortage and the continuing award of licences on merit rather than through auction,

broad station content should continue to be regulated.


According to the RA chief executive, extending listener choice—a guiding principle of the last Broadcasting Act—should now include choices between different stations purveying the same musical format, as well as a greater range of niche or minority-interest formats. It had been widely noted, said Stoller, that "heritage stations are often sitting on monopolies [in mainstream chart music]."

The RA's proposals for what it describes as "access radio" will, if adopted by government, create a new layer of small-scale, non-profit making community radio stations, ring-fenced from the existing commercial sector. In some cases, these stations could cater for specialist music tastes, creating potentially significant new outlets for record company product. Access stations would not be allowed to take advertising or sponsorship, but will be financed by a "Radio Fund" run by the RA.


While some access stations could be granted low-power FM and AM frequencies in area where they are available, Stoller said that many would be Internet-only or digital radio services. The RA chief executive said that he hoped the new tier of stations would "provide the energising [in the radio sector] that we think is missing," and could also possibly bring some pirate broadcasters "into the tent."

As anticipated a few weeks back in Hotline, **NRJ Group** has finally acquired the financially-ill full-service station **RMC** from its current owner **Groupe Pierre Fabre**. NRJ already had a 16.67% stake in RMC and will now own 83.33% of the shares. The remaining 16.67% is owned by the **Principality of Monaco**. NRJ Group president **Jean-Paul Baudécroux** has indicated that he would transform the Monaco-based station into a News/Talk format.

German indie group **edel music** has acquired a 51% stake in **Kontor Records**, home of acts such as **ATB**, and one of the most successful European dance labels. Kontor MD **Jens Jele** will remain at the helm of the label.

James Curran has been appointed head of music at UK Rock station **Virgin Radio**, replacing **Carl Watts**, who is returning to France.

Word around the conference halls at the UK's **Radio Festival** held in Glasgow this week was that **Capital Radio** is locked in exclusive negotiations to acquire central Scotland's Alternative Rock and Dance station **Beat 106**. The station launched last November and posted impressive **RAJAR** audience figures in its first survey.

Also in Glasgow, the **Radio Authority** proposed that it should form part of a new, vertically-integrated single regulator. Although there would still be a single division to regulate radio, it would report to a commission at the top of the all-media regulator. The RA chief executive **Tony Stoller** joked that making such a move was akin to turkeys voting for Christmas.

Following his recent promotion to the post of senior director marketing & promotion at **Warner Music Europe**, **Jon Uren** has recruited **Paul McGhie** and **Jacob Harregaard** as new marketing managers, with respective responsibilities over **Warner Bros. Record Group** and **Atlantic Group/Elektra Entertainment**.

Hotline understands that in France, industry body **SNEP** is reviewing proposals for the compilation of the national sales charts. SNEP has received two offers, one from **IFOP**, which has been compiling the charts for the past years, and another from **Gfk**.

Napster is believed to be in discussion with US music industry body **RIAA** with the aim to find a settlement in the conflict between the music file-sharing company and copyright owners. Napster is being sued for copyright infringement by the RIAA.

US digital rights management services company **Reciprocal** is expected to set shop in Europe in the coming months. The new division likely will be based in Amsterdam, with a sales office in London. Reciprocal is currently in the process of recruiting a president for the new unit, which could employ 50-100 staffers.

Luxury group **LV & Co**, which already owns two French stations, **Gold MFM** and **Dance Voltage**, is believed to have an eye on full-service station **Wit FM**, in Bordeaux.

And for those who haven't have enough of the **Beatles**, **Apple** and **EMI** are working of a new "Greatest Hits" from the Fab Four. The album is rumoured to contain some 25 tracks and is set for a release date in the fall. Let It Be, as they once said.

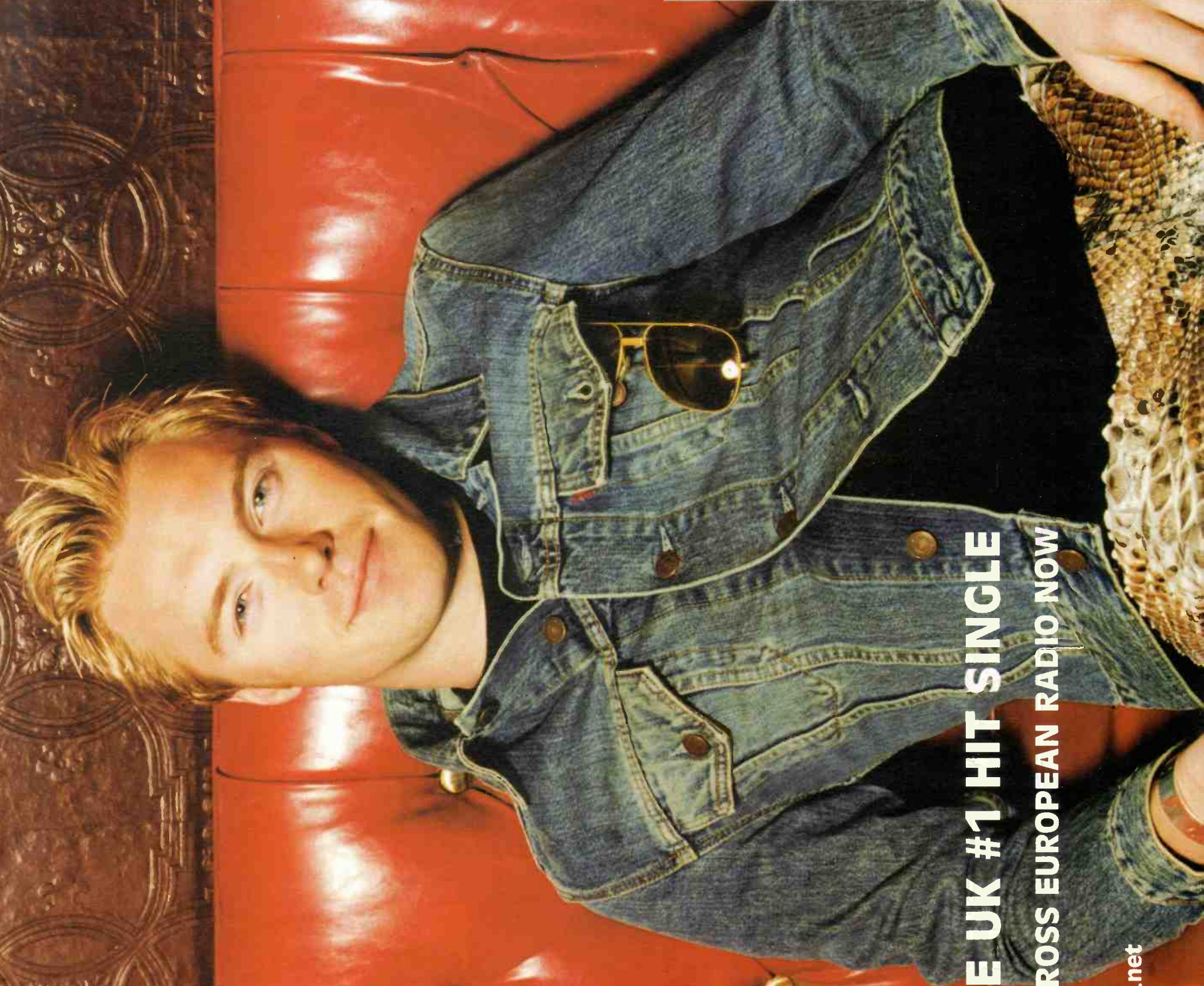

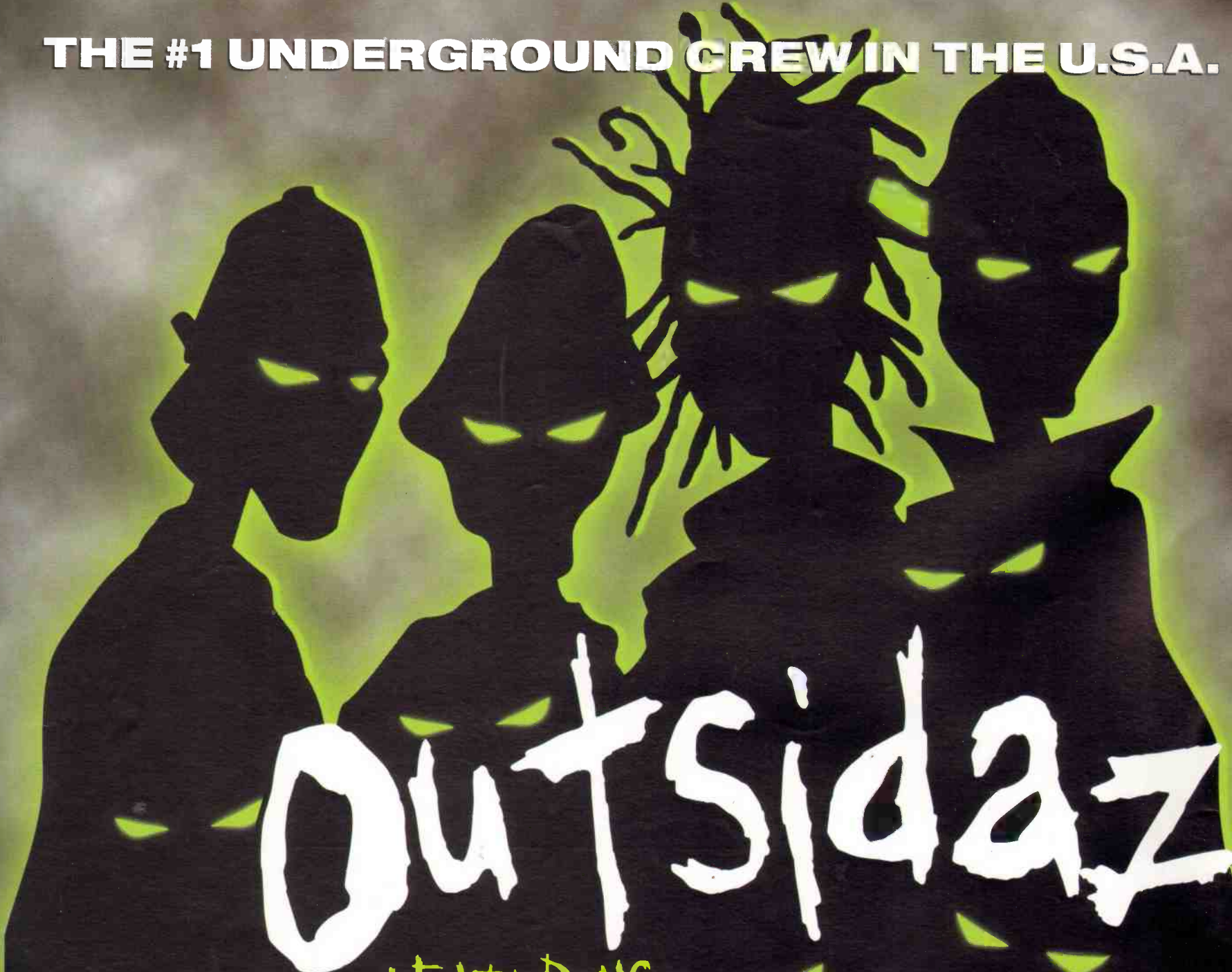
