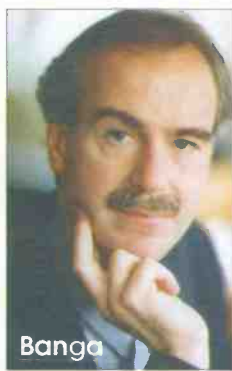

Dutch stations fume at public auction plan

HILVERSUM — The Dutch government has finally unveiled the details of its controversial radio frequency auction which it intends to press ahead with over the summer, despite the increasingly frantic protests of the commercial radio sector.

Under the plans, all commercial stations currently broadcasting terrestrially are required to bid for their frequencies in a public auction process. In the first round of the auction, scheduled for the end of June, eight "national" FM licences

(each with around 70% coverage) will be on offer, although one of these is reserved for a news station. The second round will see 14 medium wave frequencies up for grabs, and the third will see 59 regional FM frequencies auctioned off.

There is a special clause in the legislation to prevent a cartel forming among the bidding parties, in order to prevent the kind of disastrously low bids which were submitted to the government last year in the country's mobile phone *continued on page 21*

SER makes music radio switches

MADRID — Spain's biggest commercial radio group, SER, has made a number of executive changes at its music networks in a bid to strengthen Los 40 Principales' TV offshoot, and to put clearer blue water between the music content of its two Spanish language networks, Cadena DIAL and Radiolé.

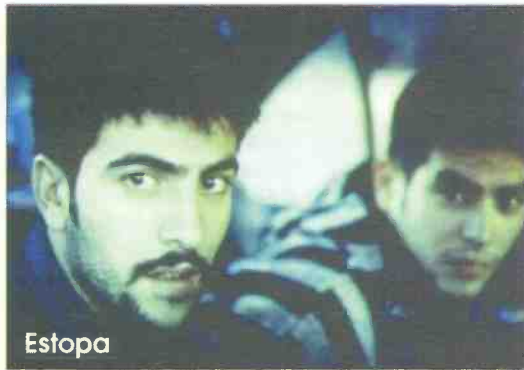

Europe ready to rumba-rock

MADRID — Parts of Europe could about be about to succumb to Estopamania, writes Howell Llewellyn.

The phenomenon first gripped Spain in 2000 after brothers David and José Muñoz quit their jobs at a car factory, formed Estopa and went on to sell a cool one million units of their eponymous debut album on BMG Ariola.

The rumba-rock album became the first ever in Spain to hold the number one spot over summer as well as at Christmas, and is likely this spring to become the top-selling Spanish debut album ever—only Rosana's 1996 debut *Lunas Rotas* has sold more, at around 1.3 million units. As a result, BMG will make *Estopa* (which is released in the rest of Europe in March) a priority in France and Italy,

where Spanish acts traditionally perform well.

Estopa's following cuts across age, sex and social class. Singer David Muñoz, 25, jokes "our public is very varied. Kids, adults, rockers, people with glasses, bald people, normal and weird folk."

Debut for Italian Music Awards

MILAN — According to Marco Giorgi, director of operations (Italy) for the Sugar label, the purpose of the inaugural Italian Music Awards, held at the Milan Auditorium on February 5, was to "create a television event".

"Music has an increasingly hard time getting TV airplay and the awards were clearly intended to create a focus for the record industry," says Giorgi.

That the Italian Music Awards achieved their declared objective of giving Italy a cohesive set of music awards for the first time is undeniable—but the jury is still out as to whether a truly effective TV event was created.

The ceremony was broadcast by public TV channel RAI2 in recorded form at 23.00 on the same evening.

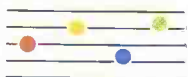

Upfront

It could be time to rock again.

While the genre's revival seems to be quite regularly predicted (usually by incoming programme controllers at the UK's Virgin Radio), the '90s were on the whole not a good decade for guitars, save for the relatively brief intermissions of US grunge and Britpop.

The current optimism about a new rock wave revolves around the "sportz metal" imports from the US, most notably Limp Bizkit, plus a reasonably healthy crop of UK indie guitar bands such as Coldplay, Ash, Travis and Doves. The return to form of established rock giants such as U2 and Bon Jovi has also reminded the industry that the potential audience is still there for this genre, not to mention the spectacular success of The Beatles' back-

catalogue over the Christmas period.

One of the main problems rock has faced in Europe in recent times has been the lack of radio stations carrying the format, particularly compared to the number of stations specialising in dance or "rhythmic hits". But radio companies aren't stupid: the lack of such stations merely reflects the relative lack of consumer demand in recent times. CHR, AC and dance formats have all proved more attractive to operators, despite the potentially lucrative ABC1 male audiences which rock tends to attract.

But with more licences becoming available in most European territories, plus of course the development of digital radio, maybe the current rock wave will inspire the creation of a few more rock services, be they classic rock, mainstream rock or alternative/modern rock. The material is certainly out there.

Bertelsmann to become RTL owner

HAMBURG — Europe's most powerful music and media group is set to be created following Bertelsmann's announcement that it plans to acquire a majority stake in Luxembourg-based pan-European broadcaster RTL Group.

BMG Entertainment parent company Bertelsmann, which already owned 37% of RTL Group, is proposing to take a majority 67% shareholding in RTL via a share-swap deal with Brussels-based Groupe Bruxelles Lambert (GBL). In exchange for GBL's existing 30% shareholding in RTL Group, GBL will receive a 25.1% stake in Bertelsmann.

GBL, headed up by entrepreneurs Albert Frère and Paul Desmarais, will receive two seats on Bertelsmann's supervisory board. Under the terms of the deal, GBL also has the option of floating its stake in Bertelsmann on the stock market—in whole or in part—three to four years from now. If that happens, 25% of Bertelsmann will be listed on the Frankfurt

stock exchange, effectively putting a stock market value on the privately-owned company for the first time.

"All parties involved agree that Bertelsmann has found a groundbreaking new way to adjust to changing [market] conditions and to use its own shares as acquisition currency, while still retaining its entrepreneurial independence," said Bertelsmann chairman/CEO Thomas Middelhoff in a statement. He adds that Bertelsmann's executives have "been planning and developing this step for sev-

eral months...with the active involvement of Reinhard Mohn." Mohn is Bertelsmann's post-war founder who has a 17.3% stake in the company, and has previously been keen to keep Bertelsmann as a private concern.

The RTL Group was created in April 2000 through the merger of CLT-UFA and Pearson TV. It operates 22 TV channels and 18 radio stations in 11 countries—its radio portfolio includes French market leader RTL (full service), Berlin Hot AC 104.6 RTL and Ireland/UK CHR/dance station Atlantic 252.

The share-swap agreement is subject to approval by the GBL board, Bertelsmann's board, and regulatory and anti-trust authorities.

Sources in Brussels tell M&M that the European Commission's competition department is likely to launch an investigation into the implications of the deal. Bertelsmann's entertainment division BMG is currently in talks to merge its operations with EMI—a deal which would also require the green light from EU authorities in Brussels.

Deejay goes live with music TV channel

MILAN — Italy's leading commercial radio network, Radio Deejay, officially launched its spin-off digital satellite TV channel, Deejay TV, on February 1.

The channel actually began broadcasting in December, with 120 videos being shown on rotation. But following this soft launch, the CHR network is now using its existing radio presentation team to provide additional content on the service.

Programming-wise, the channel is also being looked after by the same team as the radio network: Dario Uselli is director of music, while Linus is artistic director. Says Linus: "Our aim is to entertain

as much as possible, and music is just one way of achieving that goal.

"The target group is young, although in the broadest sense of the term—'young at heart' is probably a more accurate description."



Dario Giovanni, promotions and marketing manager with the indie label Carosello, welcomes Deejay's move into TV. "I think it's a highly positive development," he tells M&M.

"The great thing is that this is still in the experimental stage and so they don't have to worry about things like audience and share. The

Deejay crowd have already shown what they can do with radio, so I look forward to seeing how this progresses. I don't see this as a rival to [terrestrial music TV channels] MTV and TMC2 so much as an addition."

Sandor Mallasz, head of promotions at V2 Music, is similarly enthusiastic. "Opportunities for music on the main TV channels—particularly for a small label—are few and far between, while the music video channels can be limited in their choice. I think satellite adds an extra dimension—for example Deejay TV have asked us for the Granddaddy video, while their radio station has never expressed that much interest."

Radio Deejay's move into satellite TV follows similar recent ventures by national repertoire network Radio Italia SMI (Video Italia), and Hot AC network RTL 102.5 Hit Radio.

Emmas reflect export success

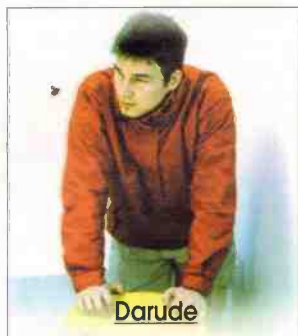

HELSINKI — Export achievements took centre stage at the annual Finnish music awards, the Emmas, on February 3 in Helsinki.

During the past year Darude, Bomfunk MC's and HIM have all enjoyed significant success across Europe. "When the nominees were selected, export achievement was one of the characteristics we looked for," explains Arto Alaspä, operations manager at local labels' body AKT. "These are innovative and interesting bands. The winners are prophets only not only abroad, they have also succeeded domestically."

Metal group HIM took the awards for best band and best album for *Razorblade Romance*. Although the Bomfunk MC's album *In Stereo* was released in 1999 and won best debut album a year ago, the band didn't have to

leave empty-handed from this year's ceremony. The single *Freestyler's* impressive sales—two million to

date—were recognised by the award of this year's Export Emma.

Darude equalled the Bomfunk MC's feat last year by receiving three Emmas, while Jaakko Salovaara who produces both bands won his third consecutive producer of the year award. "I am happy that those who choose the winners believe that I've continued to improve in what I'm doing in ways that allow them to give this statue to me for the third time," he said.

Couleur 3 changes musical shade

LAUSANNE — Swiss public alternative station RSR Couleur 3 has repositioned itself with a new rock-pop format, relegating specialist programming to weekend and evening slots.

"We realised the audience had difficulty in keeping up because we were playing too many diverse genres throughout the day," admits Couleur 3's new head of music, Patrick Rouiller. "So we have tried to update our format, but we still have themed, specialist shows."

Couleur 3 was launched in 1983 with the broad

remit of targeting 15- to 35-year-olds, and has traditionally championed new and alternative music. The latest changes mean more of a rock/pop bias during the peak daytime hours,



with specialist house, rap, electronica and trance tracks being moved to off-peak specialist shows.

"We haven't decided to become a rock station," says Rouiller. "It's just that

by removing the more specialist tracks, pop/rock is what we have left. During the day we play anything from U2 and Moby to Linkin Park, At The Drive In and Limp Bizkit. But the new format also includes acts like Fat Boy Slim and Outkast."

Rouiller took over from previous head of music, Thierry Catherine last year. Catherine, who had been at Couleur 3 for 10 years, has become head of programmes for all four RSR stations. He says that although Couleur 3 is now "95% rock or pop" it is still "more alternative than most stations."

New name, format for Radio Magdalena

BRUSSELS — New Flemish repertoire will have a significant new outlet following the flip of Gold station Radio Magdalena to a national music format from March 3.

Cable-only Radio Magdalena, which will be rebranded as Radio 7 following the change, launched two years ago. Co-founder Serge Hadermann says Magdalena originally wanted to launch a second national repertoire channel to complement its Gold service, but those plans were put on ice a year ago. "We

absolutely want to break cable radio here and therefore decided to implement a drastic change: Radio 7 will be the new station, offering a mix of 80% home-grown product and 20% oldies," explains Hadermann.

Radio 7's music policy will be overseen by a programming committee, featuring Flemish artists and musicians such as Johan Verminnen, Luk Steeno and Eric Melaerts. "We will go for local product in general, not only Flemish [language] product," says Hadermann. "We will leave K's Choice and dEUS for the more alternative sta-

tions, and the heavy house tracks as well. But the playlist will include material by Axelle Red, Jan Leyers and Milk Inc. They all fit the format and will be part of our profile."

The new station will be formally announced mid-February at a national press conference in Brussels. "By March 3, we will have a new logo and partnerships with print media to launch the station," says managing director Diederik Van der Veken, who says that Radio 7's launch will be accompanied by a generic campaign to promote cable radio in Flanders.

ON THE BEAT

NO TOTP REBRAND

LONDON — BBC TV's historic pop music show Top of the Pops (TOTP) is to get a change of set, but is not being rebranded, according to a corporation spokesperson. The comments come following speculation that the show was to be relaunched. Spokesperson Carina Trimmingham admitted that TOTP is moving studios and "and we will need a new set, so that will change." She also tells M&M that the show may be moving from its current Friday evening slot. Meanwhile, the international rollout of the TOTP format continues, with an Australian version set to air very shortly and a US version under discussion.



MEISTER MOVES TO LONDON

LONDON — Ronnie Meister, formerly marketing director for Columbia Germany, has been appointed VP marketing Columbia, based in London. In his new role, Meister will be responsible for co-ordinating all the marketing activities within Europe for artists on the Columbia label, and will report to Julie Borchard, senior VP marketing, Sony Music Entertainment Europe. Meister joined Sony Music Germany in 1998, overseeing a number of highly successful campaigns for both international and local artists including Mariah Carey, Cypress Hill, Celine Dion, Die Fantastischen 4 and Jennifer Lopez.

DR INCREASES AUDIENCE SHARE

COPENHAGEN — Official radio ratings from Gallup covering the fourth-quarter of 2000 show public broadcaster DR increasing its market share from 63.7% to 65.4%, quarter-on-quarter. Commercial radio saw its share drop to 30.9% from 36.3% over the same period. Of the larger commercial players, only CHR station Radio Uptown bucked the trend, up 0.1% to 0.7%. DR's regional full-service network P4 turned in a particularly impressive performance, up from 31.3% to 34%.

SONY'S DANCE MOVES

BERLIN — Sony Germany's Dance Division, formerly part of Sony Music Media, is coming under the auspices of Epic. As a result of the change Sascha Lindemann, head of the Dance Division, moves to Columbia as its new A&R director. He will not be replaced in his former role. Meanwhile, Dirk Dreyer, senior product manager dance, will now report to Jörg Hacker, general manager Epic. Senior A&R manager, dance Tania Cappelluti (pictured) and product manager, dance and local Christian Behrendt both now report to the local marketing director at Epic, Frank Uhle.



MOVING CHAIRS



BERLIN — Ludger Wicher (pictured) has been appointed to the board of Germany's Music TV channel Viva. Wicher, who was previously project manager of the RTL Group's Free TV Germany in Luxembourg, will be responsible for co-ordinating all Viva's international interests.

LONDON — Liverpool alternative rock and dance station Juice 107.6 has appointed Michael Dobson as managing director. He joins from Capital Radio's AC/talk Century Radio in north east England, where he was sales director.

COPENHAGEN — Anne Marie Buch Rühne is leaving her position as manager of Denmark's Have A Cigar label to take a new job as press and product manager of the Radio Underholdnings Orkestret, the in-house orchestra of public broadcaster DR.

Telefonica to launch music network

MADRID — A new 100-station music radio network is to be launched in Spain in September by telecoms giant Telefonica, in what amounts to the first serious challenge to the domination of Cadena SER and its five music networks.

Telefonica Media last year bought the 300-station Onda Cero Radio (OCR), Spain's second biggest commercial radio group, and followed it up at the end of last month with the signing of a 10-year "strategic alliance" between OCR and the 70-station Radio Blanca.

Blanca is owned by businessman Blas Herrero and was, until now, Spain's

biggest independent radio company not linked to any larger media group. The OCR/Blanca deal means that Telefonica will now have plenty of stations on which to broadcast its proposed music network.

A Telefonica Media statement confirms that the alliance "is a step by Telefonica Media, through Onda Cero Radio, towards the formation of a major business group within the Spanish radio sector." Says OCR communications director Javier del Castillo: "This is the start of a rival radio group to Cadena SER with Onda Cero's know-how and Telefonica's resources behind it."

Apart from the new music network, the deal foresees "cooperation in

exploring new radio formats based on the stations that both networks already own."

Del Castillo says the music network is still in the early stages of planning, and so far has no name. "It will have about 100 stations initially and will probably be a hits-based network, something like [SER's CHR network] Los 40 Principales or [Cadena COPE's Hot AC network] Cadena 100," he reveals.

OCR currently operates the 35-station MOR Onda Cero Musica network, which is automated and presenter-free, and the 30-station Europa FM which plays Soft AC music. Del Castillo says it is probable that both will disappear in order to accommodate the new network.

NRJ's Vedal crosses border to City

OSLO — When Sverre Vedal moves to Stockholm at the end of this month to take up the position of music director at the SBS-owned Hot AC network Radio City, he will be no stranger to the Swedish capital, which he has been travelling to frequently in his current job.

Vedal, former music director at the French-owned CHR network NRJ in Norway, will be rejoining his old colleague Håkan Morland, who was the Stockholm-based music director and deputy PD of NRJ Sweden from 1994-2000, and is now the overall programme

director of SBS's three stations in Stockholm (Radio City, Easy FM, and Rock Classic). In addition to Morland, Vedal will also report to Radio City PD Joakim Ljungqvist.

"Because Stockholm is one of Europe's most competitive markets, there's a real shortage of [programmers] who have the supreme competence that Sverre has," says Morland of his move to tap the Norwegian executive.

In Stockholm, Radio City targets females aged 20-40 with the strapline "Stockholm's Best Hits—With No Rap Or Techno," currently playlisting artists such as

Lee Ann Rimes, Craig David and Wyclef Jean.

"The market in Stockholm is a lot more professional than Oslo," notes Vedal. "The stations stick to their proclaimed format. If a station claims to play the best mix of '80s and '90s music, then that is what the listeners get. In Norway, most stations want a bit of everything, and the output becomes more uneven."

He adds: "Even NRJ Norway has become softer in its output than in the beginning. Initially, we were focusing heavily on the 9-19 age demo. Now, it's more in the direction of 15-25."

STARS LOBBY EU ON COPYRIGHT DIRECTIVE

BRUSSELS — Pop and rock artists from around Europe have sent a letter to Members of the European Parliament urging them to take into account artists' welfare when voting on the forthcoming EU Copyright Directive. Revisions are still being made to the directive, on which MEPs will vote on February 14. The letter calls for "private copying to be kept truly private" and says that, "as artists, we are particularly concerned that mass scale, unauthorised copying could totally undermine the livelihoods of everyone in the creative community." Signatories to the letter included Italy's Eros Ramazzotti, Spain's Alejandro Sanz (pictured), Ireland's Westlife and Ronan Keating, plus Germany's Marius Müller Westernhagen.



NEW MUSIC CENTRE FOR FLANDERS

BRUSSELS — A centre for Flemish music, Muziekcentrum Vlaanderen, was officially opened by representatives of the Flemish Cultural Ministry on January 18 in Brussels. It aims to be the official body representing music in Flanders, promoting local music and providing an information and documentation centre. There are also plans to create a music industry database which will include details of Flemish musicians, composers, promoters and managers.

Ö3 DOWN IN VIENNA

VIENNA — Austrian public CHR station Ö3 has seen its market share in Vienna dip, according to the latest official radio ratings covering the second half of 2000. The station dropped from a 34% share of local listeners in the second half of 1999 to 32%. Despite the fall, however, Ö3 remains market leader. The top Viennese commercial station, AC outlet 88.6, also saw its market share slide, from 12% to 10%, while the second-strongest station, Radio Energy (CHR), climbed from 5% to 6%.

OCR LAUNCHES DIGITAL SPORT

MADRID — Spain's Onda Cero Radio group has signed a deal with newspaper publishers Recoletos and Unedisa, both of which have digital radio interests. The first result of the deal was the digital launch (on February 1) of Radio Marca, Spain's first 24-hour sports network. Marca took the station's name from the Recoletos-owned sports newspaper, the biggest in Spain with daily sales of around 450,000.

DANCE GROOVES

PALM IN THE HIP HOP PICTURE

It's unsurprising that a label like Palm Pictures should start to get involved in hip hop, given the current quality of underground rhyming. An early indication that the label is on the money is *They All Fall Down*, taken from the sampler of Grits' debut album, *Grammatical Revolution*. While Grits are quite unique in their use of (melodramatic, cinematic) music there are some interesting and complementary similarities to acts like Mike Ladd and People Under the Stairs. Top stuff.

HUMPS AND HITS

Already making waves in the UK club and airplay charts, getting rotation on MTV Nordic and on *The Voice/Copenhagen*, and Radio Mafia in Finland, *Camels* by Santos (Flex Club/Denmark) is an absolute cracker. A dynamic, highly immediate groove and a series of strong hooks make this classic crossover material. The drops are perfect, the melody is seductive and the production deep and rich.

BARK AT THE MOON

Whether Lupine Howl (pictured) got their name from their much talked-about frustration as "the men behind Jason [Pierce]" in *Spiritualized* is not clear. They do, however, make a stunning, angry noise that on *Vaporizer* takes the form of a Spencer Davis Group/Steve Winwood-style soul shoutalong.

The chorus has qualities that are definitively velcro-like, and the organ sounds like it is about to meltdown. In short, it is everything music should be—groovy, visceral, and deeply personal.

The debut album, *Carnivorous Lunar Activities of Lupine Howl* (Beggars Banquet/UK) is due out in April. In the meantime, the video of the track *125* is to be serviced to MTV and the other music TV channels later this month.

MIAMI MONKEY BUSINESS

A rare thing indeed, *Monkey Business* by Les Gros Minets is an artist album from Miami-based SFP. Although globally known for singles by Antoine Clamaran, Kluster, Wicked Phunker and Robbie Rivera, long players have not, until now, been high on the label's agenda. Even rarer is the fact that the album is made by a group who play as opposed to programme. The set kicks off with a delicate, funk 'n' strings intro (*The 4th String*) which leads into the genteel bossa-flavoured shuffle of *Nino Managua*. With its rolling flute solo and hiccuping percussion the track is smooth, sophisticated and on the mark in terms of targeting the older "horizontal dancer" demographic. The laidback atmosphere continues with the title track, a spacey, film score piece with a superb muted-trumpet break and celestial keyboards. *Formula London Funk* is, alongside being about as typical of London as sushi, somewhat formulaic but *Tornado!*, with its opening American Indian chant, is "armchair funk" personified. It all starts to get much thumpier on *Booyakasha*, where a churning bass figure leads the way into tinkling Rhodes keyboard and a fine, tricky arrangement. *Rio Jaxx* keeps the pressure up with a subtle but insistent Brazilian feel while *Jazid's Tribe* sees a return of the jazz vibe. Not a record that will provide many unifying anthems for anti-corporate militants, but splendid music nonetheless!

Muse turn on, plug in and sell out!

The new Radiohead? A reincarnation of Jeff Buckley?

The one certainty about Muse is they are not short on hype. But what sets the young guitar band from Devon, England apart from their "indie" peers is international sales of over 500,000 units for their debut album *Showbiz*. Sales are consistently high across the territories for the Mushroom act, particularly in the UK, Ireland, Australia and New Zealand, as well as Germany where they are licensed by Motor, and the US where they come out on Madonna's Maverick label. A key factor in this early success is a commitment to touring which saw Muse play 40 European festivals in 2000.

Paul Anderson, a DJ with London alternative station Xfm, was taken with Muse from their first single. "When Xfm first played their record *Muscle Museum*, nearly two years ago now, everyone looked at each other and went - 'Yep, huge', Anderson remembers. Muse's new single *Plug In Baby*, released March 5 has been A listed by Xfm for the past four weeks and was single of the week on Jo Whiley's national BBC Radio 1 (CHR) show at the



end of January. "It's a fearsome record and the sound of a band moving it up a gear, taking themselves onto another level," Whiley believes.

Having won music paper NME's Best New Band award and been nominated in this year's Brit Awards as Best Newcomer, Jo Whiley says "Muse are set up to be one of the breakthrough bands of this year".

Ian Westley, general manager of the Mushroom UK labels, describes the act as "a remarkable, uncompromising guitar band with enormous potential. When we first signed them we concentrated heavily on them as a live band and marketed them as such. Now they are becoming established, we'll concentrate more on promoting them through the media," he says.

Following the release of *Plug In Baby*—which is the first track to be taken from their forthcoming, as yet untitled second album—Muse are set to hit the road again in April on an extensive European tour. With the biggest UK date at London's Brixton Academy on May 29 selling out in two and a half weeks, it augurs well for the band. As Paul Anderson rightly says: "Muse are an ace band caught up in a new power prog movement, and they are here to stay."

Scots' hard house enters the Public Domain

Scottish four-piece Public Domain have achieved the impressive feat of scoring a pan-European hit with their first ever release.

Operation Blade (Bass In The Place) went straight to number five in the UK, number one in Australia, has peaked at four in Germany and is climbing the charts in most European territories. The track samples a remix of New Order's *Confusion* which appeared in the 1998 vampire film *Blade* starring Wesley Snipes, hence the title. *Operation Blade* has so far peaked at number two in the European Dance Traxx chart. With release dates spread out from last December through to the end of January, the single looks likely to enjoy a lengthy stay in the European charts.

Originally signed to UK-based label Slinky, Public Domain had their hard house track picked up by Xtravaganza last November and released on its Xtrahard imprint. The dance label is fully independent, but has a licensing deal with Sony. "The bidding war was six figures high," says Xtravaganza managing director Alex

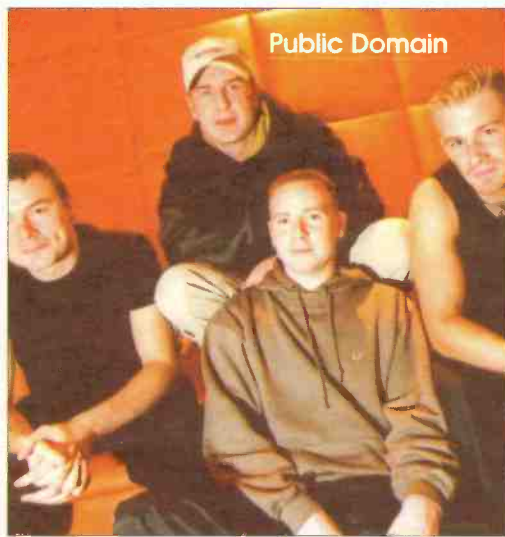
Gold, who reveals that the single was out in record time. Six weeks after signing, the track had hit the number five spot in the UK singles chart.

Head of music at CHR station Radio 105 in Switzerland, Matthias Völm, expects *Operation Blade* to make an imminent

entry into the Swiss sales chart. "It's doing really well in the clubs here," he says. "It's also done well in Germany which is important in Switzerland." Völm does concede though that he can only play the single in the afternoons and evenings. "It's not really a radio song," he explains. "[It's] good, but I don't think we will see a lot of this kind of mix of house trance and hip hop getting airplay."

Public Domain embark shortly on a club tour of the US, which will include a performance at renowned Miami club Space the Friday before the opening of the Miami Winter Music Conference.

In the summer, the act have confirmed a residency at 7,000-capacity Ibiza club Privilege. Xtravaganza's Alex Gold reports that Public Domain's debut album is scheduled for an April release and will feature "a roster of superstars"—possibly including Public Enemy.



French music's roll of honour

If the aim was to make more room for new acts, then the rejuvenation plans for the Victoires de la Musique seem to have been crowned a success.

The 16th edition of the French music awards ceremony, which takes place on Saturday, February 17, will feature a line-up of some of France's new up-and-coming artists, faithful to what Victoires chairman Marc Thonon calls the event's "platform for new talent".

Nominees for this year's awards include rappers Saïan Supa Crew; singer De Palmas; electronica acts Saint Germain, Demon, Etienne de Crecy, Bob Sinclar and Mirwais; chanteuse Helene Segara, Lynda Lemay, and Alizée; and alternative rock act Louise Attaque, among many others.

Thonon says the shift towards newer acts was started last year and should pay full dividends this time too. "Thanks to the Victoires de la Musique, last year prime-time TV viewers discovered artists such as Linda Lemay, M and Saïan Supa Crew, as well as the musicals Romeo et Juliette, Ali Baba and Les 10 Commandements," he says. "In previous years the Victoires helped break Arthur H, Andrea Bocelli, Laurent Garnier and Zazie."

New categories

Thonon, who is founder and CEO of independent label Atmosphériques, says the Victoires 2001 boasts four new categories, including Best First Stage Performance, Best First Album, Best Rock Album (replacing Best Band), and Best Internet Site, which are tailored to make more room for new acts.

"The creation of these new categories should help to make this 2001 edition the most complete, representing every musical style and means of expression," he says.

This year, the category for Best Song will be voted for by the public only, from five songs pre-selected by Academy members. The Best Internet Site category will be voted for by internet users of 87 sites. A one ballot vote will insure that Academy members' votes are straightforward and easy to understand.

More and narrower Victoires categories illustrate the diversity of French music but sometimes create cross-genre blurs. For instance, the artist Saint Germain is simultaneously nominated in the categories of Best Jazz Album, Best Electronic Techno or New Sounds Album, as well as Best New Jazz talent and Best First Stage Performance. This edition of the Victoires will also honour the Virgin act Renaud for his contribution to French-language songs.

This year's multiple nominees include veteran singer Henri Salvador and MOR act Patrick Bruel

The 16th Victoires de la Musique will take place in Paris on February 17. The official French music awards show is hailed as a real platform for new talent, as *Millané Kang* reports.

(each with three nominations), rock icon Johnny Hallyday, pop singer Etienne Daho, Mylène Farmer and Françoise Hardy (all with two). There is also a larger variety of labels than in previous years, from indies like Atmosphériques, Naive and V2, to all the majors.

Thonon says that the Victoires are unique in the field of music awards shows in that they are fully live on stage (no lip-sync, as all the bands play live) and broadcast live on primetime on French public TV channel France 2.

Live broadcasts

The show will also be broadcast live simultaneously on AC radio network Europe 2 and through www.mcity.fr, the music portal of the Lagardère Active Broadband group, which has designed the official Victoires website, launched on January 19 (<http://lesvictoiresdelamusique.mcity.fr>).

"The show is broadcast live, which creates multiple constraints, but also entails a formidable challenge," says Thonon. Set at the prestigious Paris venue Olympia and hosted by Jean-Luc Delarue, the awards ceremony boasts a budget of Ffr 12 million (€1.8m), financed by various music industry organisations as well as the TV channel.

Adds Thonon: "From the public's point of view as well as that of the TV industry and some music industry people, the Victoires de la Musique are first and foremost a TV show, even though I don't totally agree with that statement. This year more than ever, at a time when competition [for TV audiences] is so fierce, it's our duty to throw a real party for the artists and give the TV channel that welcomes us a great show worthy of the time slot that has been given to the event."

Yves Bigot, director of entertainment for France 2, concurs. "Last Christmas Eve, [TV host] Michel Drucker presented a two hour TV special [on France 2] entitled 15 Years of Victoires in Song, a retrospective of the most moving, surprising and amusing moments of the Victoires de la Musique since their first edition in 1985," he says.

"More than the simple pleasure of revisiting mythical moments in television [history], it was above all an occasion for France 2 to reaffirm its support of the only ecumenical and consensual event of the whole of the music industry."

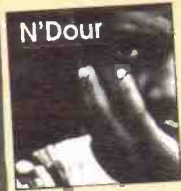

Die Fantastischen Vier are considered the pioneers of German language hip hop who put "Deutschrap" on the musical map with the release of their debut album *Jetzt Geht's Ab* 10 years ago. A combination of gripping hip hop beats and intelligent, sharp lyrics touched a nerve with young, middle-class Germans, sparking a new wave of German-speaking hip hop acts. *Sie Ist Weg* is the second single to be taken from the band's seventh album *Die Fantastischen Vier Unplugged*, only the second MTV Unplugged album by a German act. *Sie Ist Weg* is a groovy, upbeat track driven by funky rhythm and acid jazz percussion. Henry Gross, head of music at public CHR station N-Joy Radio in Hamburg says: "Die Fantastischen Vier are the 'granddaddies' of German rap/hip hop. I very much like the single *Sie Ist Weg* as well as the whole album. Musically it is fantastic. This track is a very interesting interpretation of the hit, which was first released about five years ago."

Tree. The record was originally released in Belgium last August, but Sony decided to re-release it with a new video, following the band's extensive touring in Europe. The trio's musical style has attracted many different descriptive labels ranging from electronica/pop to trip hop and lounge music. Orchestral string arrangements and singer Geike Arnaert's haunting, Portisheadesque voice create a brooding, sultry, film noir-like atmosphere. Unsurprisingly, Hooverphonic's music has attracted the interest of various film and television producers and they have featured on several film soundtracks including *Stealing Beauty* and *Shades*, as well as TV shows such as *La Femme Nikita* and a Jaguar TV ad. DANCE BEAT

The weekly dance chart comment by Harold Roth

French act Daft Punk re-write dance chart history again this week, as *One More Time* (Labels-Virgin) holds at the top of M&M's European Dance Traxx chart for the eleventh week. That equals Mousse T's record for the longest-running stay at number one, with the French duo now only one week shy of setting a new record.

Currently number one on the Movers chart, Danish act Safri Duo's *Played-A-Live (The Bongo Song)* (Universal) stays at number two. The track is bolstered by chart entries in the UK and Ireland. Support is also massive in Germany, the Netherlands and throughout Scandinavia as well as Eastern Europe.

Bootlegs, which often feature unlicensed samples, generally don't see the light of day in shops in large quantities due to their very illegality. Cleptomaniacs' *All I Do* (Soulfulic Trax) came into this world as a bootleg using a sample of Stevie Wonder's original, but now features (legal) re-recorded vocals by Bryan Chambers. It has jumped from number 16 to number nine to number three during the last fortnight and currently ranks second on the Movers chart.

Signings from the Netherlands now rank fourth behind Britain, Germany and Italy on the Dance Traxx chart, based on last year's figures. Despite that, Dutch repertoire has found it difficult to crack the Dance Traxx Top 10. This cycle has been broken, though, by Blue White Records' *House Some More* from Lock 'n' Load, which storms up the chart from 28 to number eight this week. UK DJs are usually the first foreigners to fall in love with Dutch tracks, and this one has been no exception.

Also entering the top 10 for the first time is Warp Brothers' *We Will Survive*, a master owned by Dos Or Die, the same company that licensed the Lock 'n' Load track for Germany.

This week's Top 100 welcomes only 11 new entries, and three of them are Belgian signings. DJ Wout, who also records under the monikers Liquid and Sylver, debuts at number 83 with *Island Of Trance*. Club Connection, a new project of one of the guys behind successful Belgian act Outworld, debuts at 92 with *Into My Mind* (B Quadrat-Byte) and, also on Byte, Stromtraxx's *My Acid Dream* is new at 97.

M&M's weekly airplay analysis column

Valentine's Day is upon us, so another opportunity for radio stations to mark the day with various types of stunts. At Norwegian Hot AC Radio 102 in Haugesund, listeners will be reading love poems to their better halves over the airwaves, while love songs will make up most of the music content. In its lunchtime slot, Radio 102 is setting up a big bed in the middle of a shopping centre, which will be the prize in a competition where shoppers get the chance to ring their partners live on air, trying to lure them to the shopping centre without being allowed to tell them about the prize.

Music-wise, head of music Egil Houeland has just added Kings Of Convenience's (pictured) *Winning A Battle, Losing The War* (Source). "It's very low key, but our audience is eclectic enough for it to work for us. We were very early with Coldplay's *Trouble* as well," he notes. Dido's *Thank You* (Cheeky/Arista) is another favourite with the station at the moment. "We decided to go with this one and then do *Here With Me* at a later stage," says Houeland. "It's a wonderful song, absolutely beautiful." Houeland's tip of the week is Sondre Lerche's *You Know So Well* (Virgin), an 18 year-old whose track was used on the soundtrack to the film *Lime*.



The 102 programmer is also excited about veteran rockers Aerosmith's *Jaded* (Columbia), the highest new entry on the European Radio Top 50, at 34, after weeks of bubbling under. CHR station Wit FM in France, Radio Maximum in Russia and Radio Sky + in Estonia have also gone with the track this week.

After nine weeks at number one for *Don't Tell Me* (Maverick/Warner Bros.), Jennifer Lopez

(pictured) knocks Madonna off the top spot with *Love Don't Cost A Thing* (Epic). It's a double whammy for Lopez this week, as parent album *J.Lo* (also Epic) has managed to hold onto the top spot on M&M's European Top 100 Albums chart for a second successive week.



Stations of all formats, including AC network M-80 and CHR powerhouse station Los 40 Principales in Spain, have picked up Fun Lovin' Criminals' chilled, summery offering *Loco* (Chrysalis), which is new at number 44. British boyband BBMak, (who play their own guitars!) come in at 46 with *Back Here* (Telstar). Supporters this week include CHR outlets DR P3 in Denmark, Sunshine 855 in the UK and Danubius Radio in Hungary.

Canadian-Portuguese songstress Nelly Furtado's *I'm Like A Bird* (Dreamworks) is starting to get noticed in Europe, and looks likely to enter next week's chart. Northern Ireland's Ash are back with *Shining Light* (Infectious), and could also be a good bet for next week, although you'd be safer putting your money on Westlife's new track, *I Lay My Love On You* (RCA).

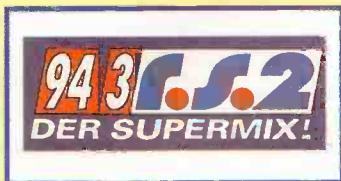

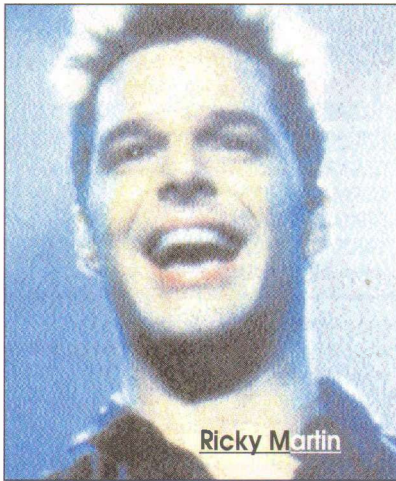

frequency auction.

The new licences will run for a period of eight years, commencing September 1, 2001. For the seven non-format specific national FM frequencies, the minimum bid required by the government is expected to be at least Dfl 20 million (€ 9.1 million), although this figure was still to be confirmed as M&M was going to press. There will be no minimum bid laid down for the news station. One company will be allowed to own more than one national licence, providing that they propose different formats for each.

In an attempt to mobilise public opinion against the plans, commercial radio trade body VCR has taken out full-page advertisements in national daily newspapers during the past two weeks, calling on the government to halt the auction. Protest campaigns have also been running on air at many stations.

"This is a unique case: an auction of frequencies which are already in use," says VCR president Martin Banga, who points out that, in situations where the incumbent station is outbid for its frequency, the auction winners will unfairly benefit from the

goodwill and audience loyalty built up by the previous occupant of the frequency.

Says Bangra: "The stations are willing to pay more for the licences than we do at the moment, but only Sky Radio [Soft AC] and Radio 538 [CHR] are able to pay such large sums of money."

Bangra paints a grim scenario for the industry if the auction process goes ahead. "We've shown the government that if they press ahead with an auction, they shouldn't expect too much corporation tax [from the radio sector] for the coming years. I predict a downward spiral in listening figures, advertisement revenue, and ultimately tax revenue."

Despite the government issuing an auction timetable, the September start date for the new licences is unlikely to be met, since the VCR has begun a number of legal challenges in the Dutch courts and at a European level in Brussels.

Meanwhile, Banga denies reports in the Dutch press that a joint offer of Dfl240 million from the existing commercial stations has been made to the government in order to "buy off" the auction.

marketing director, notes that word-of-mouth worked so well in Estopa's case that the first 25,000 albums sold without a single being released, and the first 100,000 units were shifted without any radio support. "The amusingly delinquent nature of the songs, about hash smoking or with titles like *The Slit In Your Skirt*, for example, initially had negative connotations for commercial radio," he says.

"Radio didn't understand that rumba is just a form of Spanish pop music. [Spain's CHR market leader] Los 40 Principales didn't play Estopa until they had sold 400,000 CDs."

Luis Merino, head of programming at SER's five national music networks (including Los 40), explains that Estopa were played "from the start" on Spanish-language music station Cadena DIAL, as it was a "hybrid ethnic music well suited for DIAL," but that "Estopa's sound would at the beginning have created an undesired reaction from the Los 40 listeners."

However, Merino says that once the act had broken on DIAL, their singles began to receive heavy rotation on Los 40, which gave them a new public and a return to the number one sales spot at Christmas. "Going from DIAL to Los 40 is a natural process which has also happened successfully with Monica Naranjo, Chayanne and Juan Luis Guerra," notes Merino.

As recently as the end of 1999, the Muñoz brothers were working 12-hour shifts at a car components factory in Cornellà, the Barcelona industrial suburb where they were born. To enliven the tedium, they made up songs and recorded them at home.

The swimming teacher of a girlfriend said he would hand a demo-tape to an A&R contact he knew at a record label, and *Estopa* was subsequently released by BMG Ariola Spain in October 1999. In addition to the platinum sales they have achieved, *Estopa* won three Spanish music awards last year—two Premios Amigos for new Spanish artist and group, and one Premios Ondas for new artist.

"We have decided that now is the moment for *Estopa* to tell their stories outside Spain," says BMG Ariola Spain international exploitation director Sonsoles Armendariz. "*Estopa* was a cult group that has now become a phenomenon of the masses."

brand extension of Spain's CHR market-leader Los 40 Principales, and goes out on the Canal Satelite Digital (CSD) digital platform. D'Angeli will strengthen the existing 40TV team led by director Jorge Flo.

Replacing D'Angeli as M-80 director is Jesús Portela, previously co-ordinator of music stations at SER's Radio Vigo in the Galicia region.

At SER's two Spanish-language stations, former DIAL deputy director Manuel Dávila has been appointed director of Radiolé plus Radiolé Tropical, its four-station outpost in the Canary Islands. Previously, Francisco Herrera was director of both DIAL and Radiolé, but will now only be responsible for DIAL. He will be joined at DIAL by a new deputy director, Juan Carlos Chaves, who was formerly co-ordinator of music stations at Radio Sevilla in Andalucía.

According to official Auditel figures, the show achieved an audience share of 10.19%, with average viewing figures of 986,000.

Enzo Mazza, director general of Italian labels body FIMI (which created and organised the awards) says: "We had been told that 8% would have been a reasonable result, so we're pretty pleased." Massimo Giuliano, managing director of WEA Records Italy, agrees. "The audience share was better than expected and, given that this was the first time out, it's a satisfactory result."

The show saw 12 awards handed out over the course of two hours, and included live performances from Max Gazzé (jamming with Bluvertigo), Carmen Consoli (backed by Quintorigo), Morcheeba and Shivaree.

However, Milan daily paper *Il Corriere della Sera* described the event as "a bit boring," while an even less charitable view is offered by RTL 102.5 Hit Radio presenter Grant Benson, who watched the show on TV at home: "I switched off pretty quickly. Dollybirds in bras asking inane questions—sometimes I wonder whether Italian TV in general and [public broadcaster] RAI in particular deliberately try and make a potentially great event

as bad as possible."

FIMI faced a number of logistical problems in putting on the Italian industry's first ever "official" awards show. "We originally wanted to stage the event in November, which is generally a more appropriate month, but various problems forced it to be delayed until February," says Mazza. "That timing led some observers to wonder whether the organisers were actually trying to upstage the Sanremo Song Festival, which begins on February 26, but this was clearly a coincidence."

In the awards themselves, Lunapop swept the board, winning the four key domestic categories of



best album, best single, best group and best new act. Carmen Consoli took home two awards—best female and best video. Luciano Ligabue was also present, to collect his best tour award, although best male artist Adriano Celentano did not attend. None of the three international winners were present, although U2's Bono and Anastacia sent video messages.

Following the managerial changes, DIAL will now concentrate more on Latin American and US material, with Radiolé focussing on Spanish folk and roots.

Although this difference between the two networks has always officially been the case, it will now be accentuated, with DIAL dropping Spanish roots music (such as flamenco) altogether, and focusing much more on Latino music from artists such as Ricky Martin, Enrique Iglesias and Jennifer Lopez.

Radiolé will continue to play some Latino music, but only roots and not contemporary Latino pop. "Radiolé will now incorporate more sophisticated programming to make it more measured," explains Dávila. "We shall look much harder at Spanish and Latin American roots music such as the copla, flamenco, bolero,


ranchero, and so on. But although we won't be playing contemporary Latino music, we hope to provide an educational service by showing listeners the sources of contemporary Spanish pop music."

Dávila adds that the Radiolé Tropical brand (which features salsa, merengue and Canarian music) will be extended to the Spanish mainland, certainly to Galicia and Andalucía, before the end of the year.

Luis Merino, director of SER's music radio division Cadenas Músicas, says the personnel and policy changes are "part of the constant dynamism self-imposed by SER to improve its products."


Merino adds that he expects to be able to announce shortly a replacement for his former deputy Javier Pons, who left SER to join TV production company Elterrat in December.

It now seems certain that, from May, German music TV channel VIVA will be taking over MTV Italy's broadcast slot on Italian TV channel Rete A. Rete A is terminating its existing contract with MTV at the end of April, leaving the latter (for the time being at least) without a terrestrial home in Italy.

Meanwhile, Germany's Comet music awards, which are organised by VIVA, will return to Cologne's Popkomm this year, after last year's ceremony was held at the EXPO in Hanover. The awards' ceremony, organised in collaboration with public broadcaster ZDF, will co-incide with the opening of the trade fair on August 15.

International labels' body IFPI has been lobbying hard for changes to be made to the EU Copyright Directive, just days before the text is expected to be finalised during a plenary session of the European Parliament. The IFPI's regional director for Europe, Frances Moore, says the definition of private copying is still too broad and that the directive doesn't help labels "build new services to provide consumers with access to the creative works of their choice."

Italy's Vitaminic, the international online music service provider, has clinched a deal to offer the Universal Music Group's digitised catalogue on its US site. From next month, Vitaminic.com will feature bluematter, UMG's online multimedia service that allows fans to download biographies, lyrics and other content as well as tracks by big name acts such as Shania Twain and Marvin Gaye. The UMG agreement follows similar deals with BMG Entertainment and Sony Music.

Hotline hears rumours in the UK this week that the managing director of BBC Digital Radio, Glyn Jones (pictured), has resigned. Meanwhile, UK commercial digital multiplex operator Digital One and its partner, NTL, have switched on four new transmitters, bringing commercial digital radio services to a further 2.8 million people.



EMI Norway has released *Trouble—The Norwegian Live EP* by Coldplay. The five-track CD is for sale exclusively in the Norwegian market, and was recorded at the band's sold-out December 1 concert at Oslo's Rockefeller Music Hall.

Sascha Lindemann is the new A&R director at Sony Columbia in Germany, reporting to Columbia's managing director Martin Brem. Hotline can reveal Lindemann's first signing is the young R'n'B artist Nelifer.

In Belgium, Flemish public broadcaster VRT has been doing its bit to raise money for the victims of the Indian earthquake. As part of the initiative, VRT's classical channel Klara organised a charity concert in Antwerp, while CHR station Radio Donna had a "pay for play" day, with listeners paying to hear their favourite tracks.

And finally, avid readers of M&M's Top National Sellers listings (page 12) will note that the first nine positions in the top 10 of the Hungarian album chart this week are occupied by recordings from one artist, popular crooner Zámbo Jimmy. It's the Hungarian public's response to Jimmy's untimely death from a firearm accident few weeks ago.

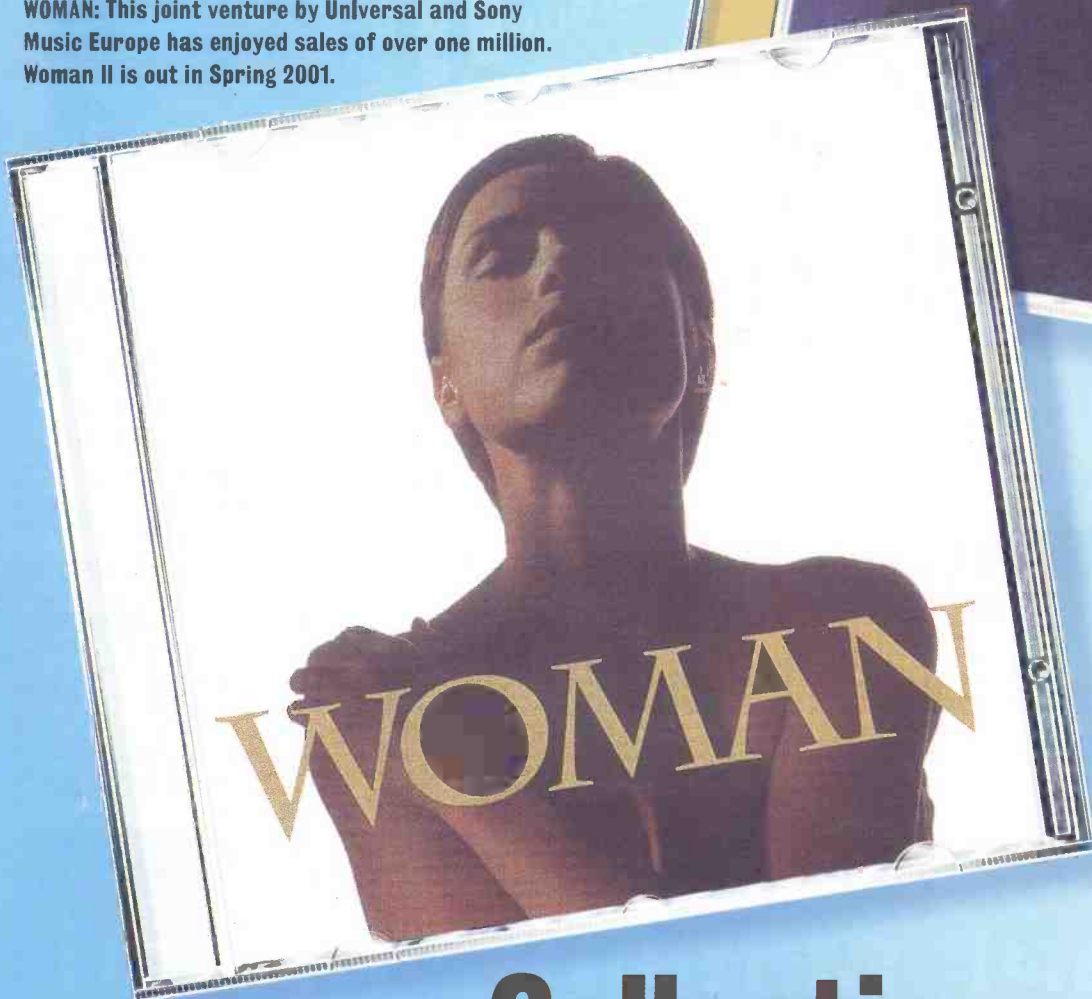

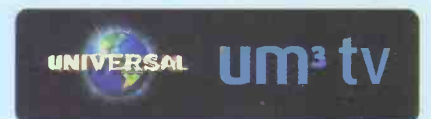

single, "With Arms Wide Open," which is No. 3 in overall radio airplay. Britney Spears is at No. 5 with "Oops... I Did It Again," selling 271,000 units, gaining 31% from Christmas gift-giving and the strength of the album's third single, "Stronger." The new single is top five on MTV and No. 17 on the Mainstream Top 40 airplay chart.

Tim McGraw's "Greatest Hits" is No. 6 with 266,000 units (up 29%), fueled by his No. 1 country single, "My Next Thirty Years." Shaggy joins the top 10 at No. 7 with "Hotshot," as his huge top 40 and R&B single "It Wasn't Me" drives sales up 53% to 264,000 units. The single is second only to "Independent Women" by Destiny's Child in overall radio airplay. Shaggy's radio audience cracks the lofty 100 million mark for the second week in a row.

Rounding out the top 10 are rock, pop, and classical albums. "Chocolate Star" by Limp Bizkit holds at No. 8 (259,000 units, up 34%) as "Rollin'" keeps rolling at rock radio. It's No. 10 at mainstream rock and No. 4 at modern rock. "No Strings Attached" by N Sync adds another 245,000 units, bringing its total to 9.2 million. It will be the No. 1 selling album of the year, since No. 2 "The Marshall Mathers LP" by Eminem is far behind at 7.6 million. This week, N Sync is up one position to No. 9 as "This I Promise You" remains top 10 in overall radio airplay. The No. 10 album, down one place in rank but up 16% in sales to 237,000, is "Dream A Dream" by teenage classical star Charlotte Church.
