Piracy scuppers Premios Amigo

MADRID — Spanish labels' body AFYVE has said "adios" to this year's Premios Amigo awards, because of "galloping CD piracy that could be near 50% of all sales", according to AFYVE president Carlos Grande (pictured).



The sixth edition of the country's most important annual music event had been scheduled to take place in Madrid on November 18.

"We realised at our July commit-

tee meeting that we are in no mood for festivities," says Grande. "We are demoralised by the whole piracy question. How can the music industry celebrate in dinner jackets when piracy is causing the collapse of music-related businesses, the sacking of label employees, and a drastic downturn in activity? This is a moral decision."

Spain's authors' and publishers' society SGAE, however, has criticised AYFVE for the move.

"We respect their decision, but we do not share the idea that an absence of music is the way to fight piracy," says Paco Galindo, SGAE's complementary activities director and the body's second-ranking executive. "If piracy succeeds in silencing the Premios Amigo, it will have gained more time. Removing music from public spaces is an error. Instead of less music, there must be more."

SGAE organises its own music award ceremony Premios de la Música each spring, and Galindo stresses that this event will go ahead next year "whatever happens". *continued on page 17*

Orton unveils Heavenly offering

LONDON — "Everybody seems to be telling me it's the best album I've made," says Beth Orton. "It's great that people are still saying that when you're onto your third record."

Released on Heavenly on July 29, and throughout Europe via Capitol, *Heartbreaker* is not only the finest offering yet from the UK-based singer-songwriter, but looks destined to become one of the albums of this summer. Featuring guest appearances by William Orbit, Emmylou Harris and the Chemical Brothers, among others, it was preceded on July 15 by the single *Concrete Sky*, one of three tracks to feature Ryan Adams.

"Beth's written a great bunch of songs and she's singing with more conviction than ever before," says Heavenly founder Jeff Barrett, who negotiated Orton's release from her three-record deal with BMG/Deconstruction, which released her first two albums. "She's had a lot of criti-

Beggars swaps Virgin for Naïve

PARIS — Some 20 years after their first deal together, Beggars Banquet founder and CEO Martin Mills is getting back down to serious business with Naïve president and co-founder Patrick Zelnik.

One of the UK's leading independent labels, Beggars Banquet is setting up an office in France and is switching its 20-year-old licensing deal with Virgin France to a new distribution agreement with French indie Naïve, effective in October.

"Beggars was one of the first UK labels I signed when I created Virgin France in the early 1980s," Zelnik recalls. "I am really glad that Martin has opted for a partnership with another independent label."

Zelnik says both Mills and himself are very involved in the independent labels' sector in their respective countries. *continued on page 17*

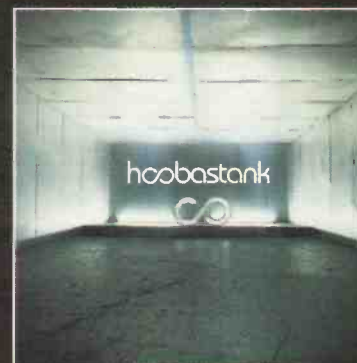

Upfront

What a strange world we are living in.

A couple of years ago, the new economy was setting the pace—and it was a furious one. The Internet bubble was inflating, boosting the overall economy—though artificially—and turning IT geeks, merchant bankers, stock brokers and anyone who had a crazy idea into millionaires. Huge conglomerates—such as AOL Time Warner—were created overnight on the premise that the old economy was a refuge for dinosaurs and that the new model was transforming the world.

It did indeed transform the world—but it was into a madhouse where people fuelled by greed and a sense of total impunity, especially those in charge of big corporations, lost track with reality and no longer had a sense of values. They were living in a world of their own where easy money turned heads too easily, and no safeguards remained. They thought they owned the world, they thought they could do no wrong.

And now payback time has arrived.

With the bubble bursting, attention turned to the brutal reality of sound accounting practices. The viability of

some deals that initially appeared brilliant when business was surfing on the crest of a wave (but looked dubious when cash became scarce and share values went down the toilet) came under intense scrutiny.

What is happening at Vivendi Universal, AOL Time Warner and a few other corporations is a painful—but much needed—settlement of errors and misjudged deals (and in some cases dodgy accounting procedures) from the very recent past.

Management changes at both Vivendi and AOL TW—almost at the same time—signal that playtime is officially over. In the former case, the only way forward is to dispose of some assets to reduce debt; in the latter, it is as much a return to sound financial practices as it is a strategic review of the company's priorities. The AOL guys who were running the show have now been replaced by executives who come from the old model, when content was king and not simply fodder for new platforms.

It will take a long while before we can assess what effect this era will have on the overall economy, but from all this turmoil something good might come—the return to some basic business principles and values. But at a very big cost!

Italy rejects lowering music VAT rate

MILAN — The Italian government has rejected a demand to lower the rate of VAT on music product in the country, despite expressing its support for the principle of CDs being taxed the same as other cultural goods, and for the EU's plan to harmonise VAT rates.

The government's rejection of a call by opposition parties to lower VAT from its current 20% rate came despite assurances to industry representatives in March by culture minister Giuliano Urbani that the government would lower the tax to 10% "by the sum-

mer" (M&M, March 15).

The parliamentary motion called for VAT on music to be lowered to 4%, the same level as that for books and other "cultural products". The government's under-secretary for economics and finance Daniele Molgora cited the EU's directive which allows individual members to lower VAT on certain products, but said that this list did not include CDs.

Molgora did express support, however, for the EU's plan to create a single level of sales tax on CDs across Europe, which would mean a reduction in the case of Italy, which has one of the highest levels of tax

on music in Europe.

Director-general of Italian labels' body FIMI Enzo Mazza (pictured) tells M&M: "The government's rejection of the motion is obviously very disappointing, given the industry's current crisis, even if its support for the EU plan to unify the sales tax has to be seen in a positive light."

● French minister of culture and communication Jean-Jacques Aillagon has also backed the EU's move to harmonise VAT rates across Europe. Aillagon says that while the problem is "complex", he will discuss the issue with his colleagues from the other EU countries to try to reach unanimous agreement on harmonisation.



GMG, Emap make management changes

LONDON — Management changes have been announced in the radio businesses of UK media groups Guardian Media Group (GMG) and Emap.

Following GMG's recent acquisition of Jazz FM, GMG Radio CEO John Myers (pictured) has replaced Richard Wheatley as chief executive of Jazz FM, in addition to retaining the top GMG Radio position. Myers has, however, relinquished his role as chief executive of local radio group Radio Investments, in which GMG has a substantial stake.

Shaun Bowron, formerly managing director of Real Radio/Glasgow, becomes overall group MD for GMG's AC/talk Real Radio brand, although he will remain based in Scotland. Jeff Stephenson, launch managing director of GMG's Real Radio/Leeds moves across the Pennines to become MD of Jazz FM 100.4/Manchester.

Mike Pennington, formerly deputy managing director of the Yorkshire Post newspaper, replaces Stephenson as Real Radio/Leeds MD.

At Emap Performance, David Tighe has departed CHR station TFM/Stockton-on-Tees, where he was programme director, "to pursue other interests," according to a company statement. His replacement is Colin Paterson who, like Tighe, will also be responsible for soft AC AM station Magic 1170/Stockton-on-Tees.

Paterson joins Emap from the Wireless Group, where he was programme controller of AC station 96.3 QFM/Paisley. Emap Performance managing director, radio Mark Story says: "Colin is one of the most exciting young programmers in the UK at the moment. His work on QFM has been acknowledged as outstanding."

Meanwhile, in London, Mark Hassall has been appointed as station director for Emap's dance station Kiss 100 and soft AC service

Magic 105.4, reporting to Story. Hassall has been with Emap for eight years, and is currently head of music magazines at Emap Advertising. He previously worked at Kiss and Magic for two years as commercial director. Says Hassall: "The London radio market is extremely competitive and this is a very exciting time to be returning to two great radio stations."

Emap has also confirmed that it has retained the services of breakfast presenter Simon Hirst at its Hull CHR station Viking FM, despite reports elsewhere that he had signed a contract to present the breakfast show at Chrysalis Radio's dance station Galaxy 105/Leeds.



Nicoli bullish over EMI's position

LONDON — The 70% drop in EMI's share price from a peak in January 2000 is consistent with that of other publicly-traded media companies, EMI Group chairman Eric Nicoli (pictured) told shareholders at the company's annual meeting in London on July 19.

Nicoli said that EMI had outperformed its rivals AOL Time Warner, Vivendi Universal and Sony, and is now positioned to approach the future with confidence, having undertaken wide-ranging restructuring.

• Nicoli countered criti-

cism by shareholders of the £6 million (euros 9.5m) severance package given to former EMI Recorded Music chairman Ken Berry, saying the deal, "however unpalatable", was actually below the levels that Berry's counterparts elsewhere in the music industry might expect. He added that the remuneration system for EMI Recorded Music executives has since been overhauled, with lower basic salaries introduced and bonuses tied to performance.

Describing EMI Music Publishing chairman Marty Bandier as "the best music publisher in the whole

world," Nicoli revealed that the company is set to acquire the remaining 50% of the Jobete catalogue of Tamla Motown songs in early 2003.

On the Recorded Music side, the company wants to achieve an 11-13% operating margin within three years. Berry's successor as Recorded Music chairman, Alain Levy, reported that inroads were being made into the issue of piracy, with new copy protection technology being used, and anti-theft technologies and practices being introduced to counter internet piracy. There was also a drive to promote enforcement measures with governments that he did not see as doing enough to combat piracy.

Greece's Mad TV unveils ambitious roll-out

ATHENS — Greece's only 24-hour domestic music TV channel is planning to move into the Balkan territories with dedicated local channels.

Mad TV already has a presence in several Balkan countries through the re-broadcast of its Greek service in the region, but in the coming months it plans to launch terrestrial TV stations in Albania, Bulgaria, Romania and Macedonia.

The plan is for each country's Mad TV channel to eventually carry several hours of local programming specific to that territory. This, says the company's founder and CEO Andreas Kouris (pic-

tured), "will involve the collaboration with [existing TV] companies in each country."

Catering to the 15-25-year-old demographic, Mad launched in Greece in 1995, going on to become the country's most popular music TV channel. With its programming split between 65% international repertoire and 35% domestic repertoire, Mad TV claims to reach 30% of Greek households daily.

"When we first started out as a small local channel, no-one believed that we would be here today," says Kouris. "But we feel that we've done relatively little so far compared to what we can and should achieve in the future."



News of Mad TV's Balkan ambitions comes shortly after the company agreed a deal with digital satellite TV platform Nova, creating Greece's first digital TV music service, featuring five channels of non-stop Greek music programming and the country's first interactive TV record shop.

Mad TV also has ambitious plans to expand into concert promotion, launch its own radio station, and to create a youth Internet service provider.

As far as Mad's radio ambitions are concerned, Kouris sees this more in terms of collaboration with an existing radio station already on the air rather than applying for new licences, "since our brand name is already very strong."

ON THE BEAT

KILPATRICK BARES ALL WITH NEW VENTURE

COPENHAGEN — Claus Kilpatrick, managing director of BMG Publishing Denmark for the past five years prior to its recent closure, has announced he has opened a Copenhagen-based independent publishing company called Naked Music. The company's first signing is platinum-selling pop artist Jesper Winge Leisner. Naked Music will also have 100% rights to music on the new Living Trees album to be released in September.

FLOUQUIER TO PROMOTE FRENCH MUSIC DIVERSITY

PARIS — French minister of culture and communication Jean-Jacques Aillagon (pictured) has appointed broadcaster and festival organiser Jean-Louis Foulquier to a mission how to help independent label music and self-produced acts gain more exposure on radio and TV, and a greater presence at retail. Aillagon, who was appointed in May, says public broadcasters in particular have a responsibility to reflect the musical diversity in France, and to promote new talent.



DOMESTIC REPERTOIRE SCORES IN SPAIN

MADRID — Seven of the 10 best-selling albums in Spain in 2001 were from domestic artists, according to the 2002 yearbook published by Spanish authors' and publishers' society SGAE. Two further albums in the top 10, Mexican Paulina Rubio's *Paulina* (MuXXIc, 5th) and French-Spaniard Manu Chao's *Próxima Estación: Esperanza* (Virgin Chewaka, 10th)



were Latin albums recorded mostly in Spanish, leaving the Beatles *1* (EMI Odeon) as the only non-Latino album in the top 10. The Spanish albums included *El Viaje de Copperpot* by La Oreja de Van Gogh (Epic); Estopa's (pictured) *Estopa* (BMG Ariola); and *El Alma Al Aire* by Alejandro Sanz (Warner).

RECArt SPLITS FROM EMI IN DENMARK

COPENHAGEN — Danish label RecArt has split from the EMI group after a management buyout. The Aarhus-based label's managing director Jens Ove Friis has acquired the business and created RecArt Music, whose releases will be joint ventures with EMI. RecArt Music will deal with artist contracts, A&R and marketing, with EMI handling sales and logistics. The label has a roster of local acts and a few minor international names, but says it will be looking to sign new Danish talent. RecArt Music says it will also launch a new label, Hothouse, which will specialise in signing and releasing new, experimental music.

MOVING CHAIRS

COPENHAGEN — Gareth Carter is to join Universal Music Denmark as international exploitation manager, effective at the end of August. Currently London-based national accounts manager for Island Records Group/Universal Music UK, Carter will move to Copenhagen, reporting to international exploitation manager Claus Lund Pedersen.

LONDON — Peter Georgescu, chairman emeritus of Young & Rubicam Inc, will become a non-executive director of EMI Group on September 1, replacing Hugh Jenkins, who is retiring from the board.

STOCKHOLM — Kenneth Ruiz-Davila has exited as GM of Zomba's Scandinavian division and managing director of its Swedish affiliate. The news follows the recent closures of Zomba's Norwegian and Danish affiliates. Before taking his job in Stockholm last year, Ruiz-Davila was GM of Zomba in Norway. Ruiz-Davila's Swedish duties will be handled on an interim basis by marketing manager Fredrik Johansson and financial manager Bengt Lundblad, who report to Zomba Europe regional VP Bert Meyer and Zomba International Record Group managing director Stuart Watson.

The first sets of radio ratings for the spring-early summer period have been emerging from the research companies in the past couple of weeks. M&M checks the latest trends in France, Spain and Italy.



Cadena 100 moves ahead in adult market

MADRID — AC network Cadena 100 has regained its historic position as Spain's third most popular music station from SER's AC/Gold M-80 Radio, as the fierce ratings tussle between the two adult music networks continues.

Cadena 100, which dominated the adult music market between 1994 and 2000, belongs to Catholic church-run Cadena COPE, and is the only one of Spain's top five national music radio networks which is not part of the powerful SER radio group.

In the April-June 2002 survey from official ratings body EGM, Cadena 100 gained 48,000 daily listeners compared to the January-March 2002 survey, to stand at 787,000 listeners per day. M-80, on the other hand, lost 106,000 daily listeners at 767,000.

Cadena 100 director Jordi

Casoliva says he is "delighted" by the figures, which show "the consolidation of our presenters and quality of content," although M-80 deputy director José Miguel Ucenda notes that the accumulated EGM figures covering the past 12 months still put M-80 ahead of Cadena 100. He also points out that M-80 only has 35 affiliate stations across the country, compared to Cadena 100's 56. "Our national coverage is smaller than any other generalist network, and station-for-station we have one of the biggest audiences. Our priority is to gain more stations and cover more areas."

SER's CHR market-leader Los 40 Principales, which has in excess of 70 stations, was down by 100,000 daily listeners at 2.8 million, while SER's latino music station Cadena DIAL (80 stations) held steady with nearly 1.6 million daily listeners.

Revival in fortunes for Italian music stations

MILAN — Most of Italy's national music networks, and in particular the Espresso/Elemidia group's Radio Capital, enjoyed audience gains in the second quarter of 2002, according to latest ratings figures from Audiradio.

This was in marked contrast to the figures for the first quarter of 2002 (M&M, April 27), in



which most commercial music networks had suffered a sharp drop in audience. The latest results, based on telephone interviews conducted between April 6 and June 14, revealed an estimated overall daily radio audience in the region of 35.6 million.

Rome-based AC/Gold network Radio Capital saw its daily audience rise by 20%, from 1.4 million to 1.7 million. Capital, like Radio DeeJay, was

originally founded by the legendary Claudio Cecchetto, and was the subject of a major TV ad campaign which began in February. Speaking to media daily, Puntocom, Capital's artistic director Claudio Mancini attributed the network's recent ratings success to "finding the right blend of strong news coverage and classic hits."

Commenting on the figures to M&M, Audiradio's president, Felice Liroy, was fairly upbeat: "It's fair to say that Italian radio in general has grown in this quarter. These figures show that there is a great deal of variety on offer. Listeners don't seem to concentrate on one station, but like to shift around during the course of the day, and I think that's healthy."

Liroy also confirmed that Audiradio's measurement techniques, which have been the subject of some criticism in recent months, will be reviewed in the autumn. But the changes will not be radical—"It is merely a question of technical details for fine-tuning a system which is most reliable," he says.

Mixed messages in France's Médiamétrie ratings

PARIS — The last ever Médiamétrie survey to be based on respondents aged 15-plus (the next survey moves to a lower age base of 13-plus) provided a mix bag of results, with few clear trends emerging.

The figures, covering April-June 2002, showed full-service market-leader RTL losing audience again, down to a 12.8% daily reach from 13.5% in the April-June sweep last year. RTL's public full-service rival, Radio France's France Inter, was up by the same amount year-on-year, from 10.7% to 11.4%. Radio France's all-news outlet France Info also did well, up from 10.5% to 10.7% year-on-year, reflecting France's busy political agenda during the period.

There were mixed results for the commercial news/talk networks.

Europe 1 has dropped by nearly a full point over the course of the year, from 10.6% to 9.7%. But RMC Info was up from 1.9% a year ago to 3.2%, possibly due to the network's exclusive World Cup rights.

NRJ is down by 0.6 points on a year ago to 11.7%, although it is up 0.2 points on the January-March sweep, and the CHR network comfortably remains France's leading music station. The NRJ Group's gold station Nostalgie has dropped back from its impressive 9.1% reach a year ago to 8.0% this time around, although its sister soft AC station, Chérie FM, was up from 5.4% to 6.0% year-on-year.

The rapid audience growth at Lagardère Group's Europe 2, which under Christophe Sabot has switched from AC to CHR, has slowed, remaining stable at 6.1%, the same figure it

achieved in the January-March sweep.

Of the RTL Group's music stations, AC service RTL2 is down from 4.2% from 4.5% a year ago,

while dance network Fun Radio is down from 8.15% to 7.5%, though that figure is up on January-March's 6.7%.

Suomipop focuses on Finnish

With the success of bands such as Bomfunk MC's and HIM, Finnish music has been riding on the crest of a wave recently. Sharing that success has been the American-owned Finnish domestic repertoire station Radio Suomipop, which—as *Jonathan Mander* reports—has tapped into listeners' passion for local music.

The station has become profitable in a little over a year—quite a feat for a Finnish commercial radio station.

Suomipop can be heard in 13 cities around Finland, and it currently reaches 13% of the population every week. Its 600,000 weekly listeners make it the third largest non-national commercial station, just behind NRJ. “As soon as we get more power and more frequencies, we hope to reach 700,000 listeners,” Paarnio says.

Suomipop's launch featured people of several different nationalities listening to Finnish music and making comments like “rather melancholy” (from a Brit) or “well, Swedish music is better” (from a Swede) followed by the slogan: “That's what you think!”

Inevitably, since Suomipop's launch and subsequent success, competitors haven't been slow to steal some of its clothes. Radio Nova now airs a Finnish music chart, and most commercial stations have increased their percentage of local repertoire. Paarnio sees such imitation as a symptom of a radio market lacking in adventure. “If you just look at what others do and never take risks you aren't going to make interesting radio,” he argues.

Within the context of its domestic repertoire music mission, Paarnio describes Suomipop as a rock-leaning AC station, targeting 25-45 year-olds and playing tracks from a database of up to 2,000 songs. About half of the music aired is new music.

Beyond classic rock acts such as Eppu Normaali, Juice Leskinen, Popeda, Yö and J. Karjalainen, who have been around for over a decade, Paarnio considers the station's core artists to be younger acts such as Nightwish, Kemopetrol, Sipe, Tehosekoitin and Kerkko Koskinen.

Suomipop's habit of putting new songs straight into rotation and looking for suitable album tracks to play has made the station very popular with the local record companies. Paarnio says the relationship is very different from his previous experiences at NRJ and Star FM. “Co-operation is easy because we know each other's needs,” he says. He also notes that the music industry is now taking Finnish acts more seriously than before, “and gives them the same treatment as international acts—more singles are now released from albums.”

Paarnio adds that Finnish music's recent export success means that “Expectations are also bigger. Production has improved and there's a lot of new talent coming through.”

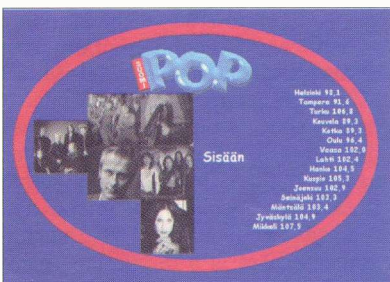

Finland's established commercial radio stations became painfully aware of the full extent of the danger posed by their new competitor this time last year, when Radio Suomipop's summer ratings ranked it among the country's most-listened-to radio stations.

Although the figures levelled-off a bit after the peak summer months, the station launched in March 2001 has found a steady listenership remarkably quickly.

Sceptics doubting the new station's concept had written Suomipop off even before its launch. To many others, however, an all-Finnish station seemed a perfectly natural development, since local repertoire has always

been strong in Finland, with 2001 sales figures showing that over 50% of music units purchased were for domestic repertoire.

The Suomipop concept began life when its predecessor Star FM was bought by US radio group Metromedia. The new American owners gave the station's employees a chance to come up with a format that they considered best-suited for the market.

Suomipop's programme director Petri Paarnio previously worked at Star FM, and says he had suggested an all-Finnish format when Star had launched, but the previous owners had wanted to play safe and go with a hit format that echoed that of existing Finnish CHR stations Kiss FM and NRJ.

“Helsinki alone has 25 radio stations, so to compete in that market you either have to have a lot of money for marketing or an exceptional concept,” says Paarnio. In his opinion, Star FM failed because its owners didn't give it the required marketing push.

Originally, Paarnio had envisaged a station playing 50% Finnish music and 50% international repertoire, “but eventually we realised it had to be all or nothing, and we had to give it a go,” he says.

Taking the risk of going 100% Finnish has certainly paid off.



Suomipop hasn't spent money on massive marketing campaigns. The secret of its success has been word-of-mouth, Paarnio believes. “That is the best kind of marketing. It shows we have loyal listeners.” The station's name alone makes it easy for newcomers to grasp the station's basic concept—Suomipop simply means “Finnish pop.”

Paarnio believes that part of the reason for the station's overnight success is that listeners have a stronger emotional connection to music by local artists than foreign artists, particularly if the song is sung in Finnish. “Finns don't listen to the words of English-language songs, but when it comes to Finnish music they're very demanding,” he notes.

The programmer recalls: “When we were kids the songs we heard, the songs our parents played us, were all Finnish—Eppu Normaali, Juice Leskinen, Popeda. The classic Finnish tunes are a part of our identity.”

This widely-held affection for Finnish music has also protected the station against negative portrayal by other stations. “You can never say that Eppu Normaali, Popeda or Juice Leskinen is bad [music]—I believe that has shielded us,” says Paarnio.

Hard-working A-Ha's 20-year Lifeline

To celebrate their 20th anniversary, A-Ha are working harder than ever on their promotional duties. With album number seven—*Lifelines* (WEA Germany)—still going strong at number 62 on M&M's European Top 100 Albums chart, the band are doing countless press and radio interviews during their full-scale tour of Europe and Brazil.

They opened the current tour on June 8 at the 23,000-capacity Ullevaal Stadium in Oslo, which was the first time a Norwegian band has headlined a stadium gig in their home country. At the time, the band's Magne Furuholmen told M&M: "It was a great way to kick off our tour. It was almost like playing in Rio De Janeiro! We had invested a great deal of prestige and ambitions in this concert, and had been involved in every detail of it, including selecting the bands."

Throughout the rest of June, A-Ha played Holland, Belgium, France, Spain, UK, and Russia, with gigs commencing in August in Brazil, Germany, eastern Europe, and back again in the UK where the tour is closing in the middle of October. "This time we are doing better in some territories, including Sweden and Denmark, than we did with *Minor Earth, Major Sky* even though we are still on the first single," says Pamela Harz, head of international exploitation at WEA Germany. "We've moved a long way beyond the comeback and it looks like the album is going to be stronger than the last one because of the live shows,



which we didn't have to the same extent. We didn't have the extra momentum. This will take us a step further."

During the 10 years between *Memorial Beach* in 1992 and last year's comeback album *Minor Earth, Major Sky*, Morten Harket, Magne Furuholmen and Paul Waaktaar-Savoy had worked on separate projects. Harket released both pop and religious solo albums, while Furuholmen recorded contemporary classical music under the alias Timbersound, and Waaktaar-Savoy developed his rock outlet Savoy with wife Lauren.

Harz says, "The second single everywhere except the UK [where it is the first] will be *Lifelines* out on July 8." Reinhard Baerenz, head of music at CHR station MDR Jump in Halle, Germany comments: "A-Ha have made one of the most sensational comebacks of an '80s band. Their new single continues the high quality standard of previous releases. Recently, I saw them live and they were great. *Lifelines* was really easy to playlist—the band fits in perfectly with MDR Jump and we playlisted the track right away."

A-Ha's management, Brian Lane at Bandana Management in London, is reportedly in negotiations about an album release in the US. "We're in a dialogue with Warner in the US to see if it's possible to release it on another label. The label we're going with there needs to show the right tendencies," says Furuholmen.

Ike's musical redemption

He used to be the music industry's devil incarnate, but it's no longer politically incorrect to say "We Like Ike".

Ike Turner, long demonised for his infamous mistreatment of former wife Tina, became the ultimate persona non grata after his self-confessed misdemeanours were given the Hollywood spin in the 1993 film *What's Love Got To Do With It?* But at the age of 70, Turner has entered a period of belated creative redemption. He won a Grammy nomination, and a WC Handy Award, for his current album of infectious rhythm and blues with his Kings of Rhythm, *Here And Now*, on his Ikon label, marketed in Europe by Continental Record Services in Holland (www.continental.nl).

Turner is currently on his second European visit of the year for live dates which included the month's North Sea, Montreux and Nice Jazz Festivals, affording the opportunity to hear the other side of the story from the guitarist-pianist who can claim to have been present at the very birth of rock'n'roll. "What I'm playing now is just really me," he says. "All my life I've done songs people were familiar with, because you get an immediate response. I never would do original songs—I've



always thought that I would be rejected. I always did Ike Turner through Tina Turner or Jackie Brenston. I waited to get to 70 years old to find out the public really like what I do!"

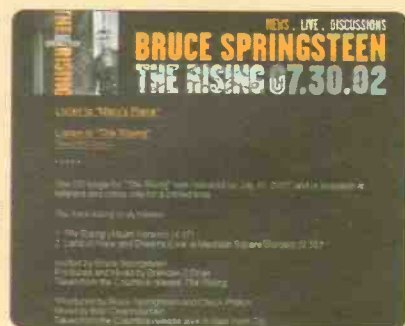
It was with Brenston that he played piano on *Rocket 88*, the 1951 US R&B number one often cited as the first-ever rock'n'roll record. Turner has re-recorded the tune for *Here And Now*, which also exudes the early blues influences of the boy from Clarksdale, Mississippi from Sonny Boy Williamson, Pinetop Perkins and others.

Turner says he only likes two songs from the Ike & Tina years, *Nutbush City Limits* and *Proud Mary*, but ends with an irresistible anecdote about their legendary, enigmatic producer Phil Spector. "On *River Deep Mountain High*, he has 78 voices going 'doop-doop,' and you don't even hear it, he is super-creative. Let me tell you about Phil Spector. He's a fantastic dude if you know him. But he's a schizophrenic, I would say. One time I really got pissed [off] at Phil, I called him and left a message, I said, 'You got all these people around you that's scared to talk to you. I'm not one of those butt-kissers.' I really told him off. Swear to God, next day he sent me a cheque for \$2,000 to take my girlfriend to dinner."

If you'll excuse the pun, interest is again "rising" in Bruce Springsteen, whose first album with the E Street band since 1984, *The Rising*, is out internationally on Sony on July 29. Taking a look at his website—www.brucespringsteen.net—the single



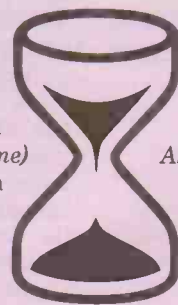

of the same name (released July 15) receives equal billing courtesy of a soundfile and lyric sheet. The site is unashamedly out to "make a buck" with prominent offers of a Limited Edition Deluxe Package or the chance to reserve the standard CD online. For an artist

of his stature, the Boss' website is a little perfunctory with a front page of news that simply scrolls down through a list of options rather than having a single page of links. Other than news—solely about the new releases and a rare TV performance—there is a discussions page, which is empty. Above the Sony Music Entertainment copyright it states simply: "Discussions will be here soon". Adam Howorth

The 20th century closed in style with the climax of mainstream dance. Among names like Stardust's *Music Sounds Better With You*, ATB's *9PM (Till I Come)* (Motor) and Armand van Helden's *You Don't Know Me* (ffrr) Brighton-based dance duo Phats & Small's disco-pop track *Turn Around* (Multiply) was one of the big radio hits in the summer of 1999. The chic chill-out disco wave continued the following year with classics such as

Modjo's *Lady* and Spiller's *Groovejet*. Ville Vilén, head of music at public CHR station YLE Radiomafia in Finland, remembers adding *Turn Around* in July 1999. "There's a place in our station for dance pop," he says. "A lot of young people like the easy dance pop from acts like Sash, the europop sort of thing. This single was one of the best that year, so it was a natural choice. We always need that kind of music. It's now a regular oldie for us—we play it once every two weeks."

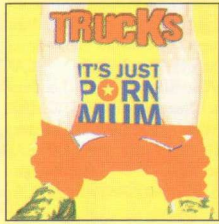

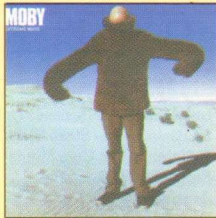

The debut single from Trucks was recorded and produced in Norway at Oslo's Waterfall Studios (Kylie Minogue, M2M, Span, S Club 7) and follows the Blink 182 and Wheatus recipe for success, combining witty lyrics with full-on, loud rock, adding a dollop of sex for good measure. After becoming part of the soundtrack for every summer party in Norway, the teenage-friendly tune went straight in at number six in that country's singles chart on its release at the end of May. Having been embraced in Scandinavia, the half-Norwegian, half-English four-piece are currently preparing their assault on the UK, where they have been picked up by indie label Gut Records. Head of music at student network SBN, Alastair Brown, saw the potential of *It's Just Porn Mum* early on. "When I first heard it, it immediately sounded like something people will pick up on," he says. "There is the obvious Wheatus comparison—the teen thing, and having a laugh. And it's infectious and has a strong hook. Commercially, it could do well. It will be interesting to see which stations will pick it up." He adds: "There are a lot of Scandinavian acts about at the moment, and this is probably the one with the broadest appeal." **SSD**

Extreme Ways, the second single to be released from Moby's latest album *18*—which was released in May this

year and has already achieved an IFPI Platinum Europe Award for over one million copies sold in Europe—is a well-crafted mix of rhythmic electronica and catchy keyboards. The lively yet smoothly-flowing number could be destined to be a late summer hit. The 37-year old north American artist—born Richard Melville Hall (his nickname Moby comes from being a descendant of Moby Dick author Herman Melville)—comes to Europe this autumn as part of his extensive world tour. Heikki Hilamaa, music editor at public CHR station YLE2 Radiomafia in Finland, says: "I think that the sound of it is like a glider in the sky when the weather is fine." He adds: "Your imagination leaves all your troubles behind. I don't know if it will be as successful as his previous songs. But it's a typical Moby song, in the best possible sense." **MH**

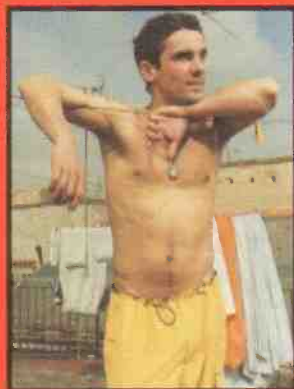

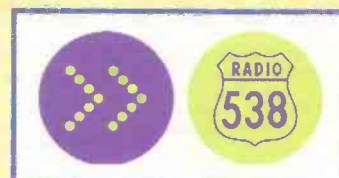

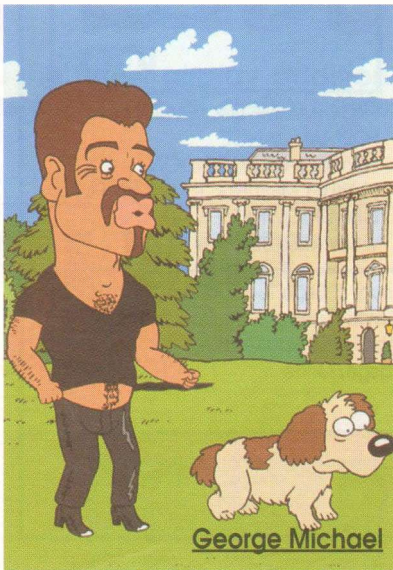

ON THE AIR

M&M's weekly airplay analysis column



A handful of tracks from high-profile acts come into the European Radio Top 50 this week. Moby (pictured), whose *We're All Made Of Stars* peaked at number four on the chart a few weeks back, enters at 35 with *Extreme Ways* (Mute). Henrik Sand, head of music at CHR station Radio Viborg in

Denmark, was one of those to add the track this week. "Personally, I like it," he says. "And it fits in really well with our mix right now. The first Moby track we ever played was *We're All Made Of Stars*—his previous stuff wasn't really for us."

There's a new number one this week, in the shape of Elvis vs JXL's *A Little Less Conversation* (RCA), which pushes Kylie Minogue's *Love At First Sight* (Parlophone) down to number three.

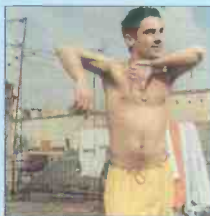
A strong contender for the number one spot, George Michael's *Shoot The Dog* (Polydor), tops the Most Added listing for the second week running, moving from 28 to 14 this week. "The politics of it is not a problem in Denmark," says Sand. "We don't take things like that very seriously." He adds: "*Freeek!* was sharper, more metallic. This one is softer and more melodious—I think it's fantastic."

Meanwhile, Eminem's *Without Me* (Interscope), at four after 11 weeks on the chart, has picked up six nominations for the forthcoming MTV Music Video Awards in the US, taking place in New York on August 29.

Jennifer Paige, who shot to fame with *Crush* back in 1998, returns to radio after a long absence with *Stranded* (Edel). A new entry at 45, the song has been picked up by national public AC/MOR station BBC Radio 2 in the UK and Spanish CHR powerhouse Los 40 Principales, whose sister AC network M-80 is also airing the track. Paige's forthcoming album *Positively Somewhere* will be out in the shops mid-September.

French superstar DJ David Guetta has followed in the footsteps of DJ colleagues Armand van Helden and David Morales to become an artist in his own right. His debut single, the infectious house number *Love Don't Let Me Go* (Virgin) enters the chart at number 48 this week, thanks to support from stations like dance outlet Kiss 100 in London and public CHR station Radio 3FM in the Netherlands.

Last year, world music favourite Manu Chao's (pictured) *Me Gustas Tu* (Virgin) was the definitive summer hit in most of Europe. Following a number of festival appearances, the multi-lingual singer-songwriter is back on the radio with *Mr. Bobby*, also off the album *Próxima Estación: Esperanza*, which came out in July 2001. The track looks a cert to enter the airplay chart in the coming weeks, having already been picked up by stations in France and Sweden.

tries—Mills with AIM and Zelnik at UPFI—and both work at a European level through Impala.

Zelnik is glowing in his appreciation of Mills' achievements. "Martin is one of the 'historic' UK indies. He is the most independent of the independents—he's quite a radical and he is a visionary," he says. "Editorially, he has never compromised and has always managed to develop artists on a long-term basis. There aren't many like him."

Mills comments in a statement: "We are very happy to be renewing our relationship with Patrick Zelnik, and excited about establishing our own presence in France with such a great team. We are grateful to [Virgin's] Labels and Delabel for the successes we have had together, though after long debate we decided that to be a larger part of a smaller and independent set-up was the right basis for our new French operation." Mills would not be drawn further on the deal, as details are yet to be finalised.

Compared to Virgin, which only took on a certain number of Beggars titles, Zelnik says this is "a long-term deal" which includes Beggars' full range of labels, including XL Recordings and 4AD, and which also allows for the possibility of Beggars switching the marketing and promotion of some projects to Naive. Currently, the deal excludes XL act The Prodigy, but Zelnik says distribution of the act will move to Naive when the current licensing deal with Virgin's sub-label Delabel expires.

Zelnik says Beggars will add a vast catalogue of UK indie rock and electronic music to its current roster. "We are going to be extremely involved in marketing Beggars' catalogue in France," says Zelnik. "The identity and the branding of the label in France will certainly grow."

Beggars will operate from an office located close to its new distributor, and will be run by a small team which includes Clarisse Fieurgant as head of promotion and Laurent Rossi Laurent, who joins as general manager from Atmosphériques.

MTG launches all-Swedish station

STOCKHOLM — MTG Radio has relaunched its Stockholm station Metro FM 101.9 with an all-Swedish music format, extending its name to Metro FM 101.9 Svenska Favoriter ("Swedish Favourites").

Metro FM originally debuted in April this year on a frequency previously used by AC network Rix FM, and is run in co-operation with MTG's free newspaper Metro. During its first few months of life it has been run as an AC-leaning 24-hour request station.

The new format is built around Swedish pop, with a special emphasis on Swedish-language titles.

"We play almost entirely Swedish-language songs at the moment—primarily pop by artists such as Tomas Ledin, Eva Dahlgren and Uno Svenningsson—strong and very Swedish acts," says Jonas Sandberg, programme director of Metro FM. "But we also play material from the new fusion between pop and the Swedish danceband [schlager] genre, with

groups such as Friends, Arvingarna and Barbados."

The target group for Metro FM is women over 30, a group which is also catered for by MTG's soft AC Lugna Favoriter (Soft Favourites). MTG now runs a total of four stations in Stockholm, including national AC network Rix FM and CHR/dance-formatted Power Hit Radio.

Sandberg has been deputy group programme director and market coordinator at MTG Radio for the past year. Formerly the morning presenter at the Mix Megapol network, he is also Metro FM's only presenter, broadcasting a marathon 07.00-13.00 daily airshift.

"We haven't really reformatted the station, rather we have focused it," he says. "We noticed that a lot of requests came in for Swedish music. I think that this [domestic repertoire] format is something that has been lacking from the Stockholm market, something that the listeners want and a need that hasn't been met before."

Although Metro FM is dominated

by oldies from the '80s and '90s, some new music from its core artists is being played on the station.

The new direction for Metro FM will be publicised in the Metro newspaper during August. Metro International, which runs free newspapers in 23 markets, de-merged from MTG in 2000. Metro FM is also undertaking major promotions with film companies, including for the new Swedish movie *Grabben I Graven* Bredvid.

pens", adding: "Not only that, we shall make it an occasion to show the public and TV viewers the immense damage piracy is doing to the Spanish music industry."

Top IFPI executives including CEO/chairman Jay Berman and Sony Music Europe president Paul Burger visited Madrid in April (M&M, May 4) and concluded that Spain's piracy problem was "an absolute explosion...a cancerous and criminal disease".

That "disease" is in full evidence on the streets of Madrid and other big cities, where thousands of street-sellers sell illegal pirated CDs at around a sixth of shop prices.

Miguel Gil, chief-of-staff of Spain's biggest broadcasting group Prisa—the owners of Spain's biggest indie Gran Vía Musical as well as radio giant SER—says: "AFYVE's decision reflects the extremely grave state of mind of the music industry.

Piracy is strangling the industry. No other sector could survive in these type of conditions."

The five editions to date of Premios Amigo have attracted live performances from top international acts such as Tina Turner, U2, Backstreet Boys, Kylie Minogue, The Corrs, Texas, Shakira, Paulina Rubio and Enrique Iglesias, as well as leading Spanish artists such as Alejandro Sanz.

Grande says: "We expect to hold the event next year, by which time we hope piracy will be half its current level."

The AFYE president says it has not yet been decided whether or not the 35 Premios Amigo winners in the international, Latino and Spanish categories will still be voted upon. "There are several ideas floating around for some kind of symbolic protest event, but nothing will be decided until after the summer break," he adds.

cal acclaim and strong sales. But that's exactly when you need to spend a bit of money to take it to the next level. That hasn't happened until now."

Orton's debut album, 1996's *Trailer Park*, sold 230,000 copies in the UK, and the follow-up in 1999 *Central Reservation* shifted 160,000 units. EMI:Chrysalis, which now handles all of Barrett's Heavenly roster, believes *Daybreaker* can improve on that.

"We want to position her as a core artist for serious music fans and to give her the best mainstream marketing back-up," says Mark Collen, EMI:Chrysalis MD and EMI Recorded Music's senior VP global marketing.

The record company hopes for an early boost in its campaign with the announcement of the shortlist for this year's Technics Mercury Music Prize. The 12 "albums of the year" will be unveiled the same week that *Heartbreaker* is released. Both of Orton's previous albums received considerable sales impetus from being short-listed.

Orton herself believes she is singing better than ever on the new record. "I stopped smoking making this album," she reveals. "But I don't think the difference is just down to that. I felt a directness and a clarity, which I haven't felt before. There was no nonsense while I was making this record."


Ironically, Orton had set out to make a record with no star guests. "I didn't want to collaborate with anyone. I was going to go off and do it on my own and delve into myself and get really brave," she says. Then William Orbit called up. "I was in LA and we went into the studio together for the first time in eight years. It was great what time had done for us both in between." Orbit added his unique mixing abilities to *Thinking About Tomorrow*.

Next, long-time collaborators the Chemical Brothers called to propose a swap deal. "I sang on one track on their *Come With Us* album and they co-produced the title track on *Day-*

breaker," Orton explains. Ryan Adams, meanwhile, was initially invited solely to contribute backing vocals to *Concrete Sky*, but then offered a song of his own, *This One's Gonna Bruise*. "It was one of the most beautiful things I'd ever heard and I had to sing it. We did it in one take and that's what you hear on the record," she says.

The result is an album that retains the gentle beauty of her earlier records yet has a greater resilience and maturity. "I'm now writing from here and now and not about all this stuff from the past that I had to unload," Orton says. "My songs have become like little 'post-it' notes to myself in the sky."

In the latest and most dramatic twist yet in the Netherlands' frequency auction saga, a Rotterdam court has ordered the Dutch government to go back to its original plan for a cash auction for all the country's commercial radio frequencies, instead of a "beauty parade" system based on economic criteria, which the government had more recently proposed following widespread public opposition to the auction. The government must announce the auction rules by September 16.

AOL Time Warner has admitted that its accounting practices are being investigated by the US Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC). AOL Time Warner chief executive Richard Parsons says the SEC is reviewing a series of transactions made at AOL prior to the completion of its merger with Time Warner.

Vivendi Universal's new chairman and CEO Jean-René Fourtou apparently met in Paris on July 22 with the top management of its US operations, including Barry Diller (chief executive of Vivendi Universal Entertainment), Ron Meyer (cinema) and Doug Morris (head of the music division). Interestingly, also at the meeting was one Edgar Bronfman Jr., who is believed to have been very active in recent months in trying to oust Fourtou's predecessor Jean-Marie Messier. The executives were allegedly quizzing Fourtou about the future of the company's US operations.

Former Labour Party whip Lord David Currie of Marylebone has been appointed chairman of Ofcom, the UK's proposed new "super-regulator." Lord Currie, who is currently Dean of the City University Business School in London and has no previous experience in the broadcasting industry, will be responsible for devising Ofcom's shape and structure. Current Radio Authority chairman Richard Hooper had been among the candidates for the job.

Sony Music has posted an operating loss of \$86 million for the first quarter of its financial year ending June 30. According to the company, the loss is a result of "the continued contraction of the global market, despite implementation of ongoing restructuring initiatives." Hotline hears whispers that Sony Music's French company will be making some management changes in the very near future.

In a surprise move, Randy Michaels will step aside as CEO of US giant Clear Channel Radio to take on new duties as head of the newly-formed new technologies division of parent company Clear Channel Communications (CCC). CCC president/COO Mark Mays adds to his portfolio acting CEO duties for the radio division.

Jordi Finazzi, the managing director of Paris-based Latin music station Radio Latina, is leaving after two and a half years in the job. He is to relocate to Panama, where he will be in charge of Spanish group Prisa's stations in the region.

Finally, best wishes and good luck to M&M's staff reporter Siri Stavenes Dove (pictured), who after nearly five years' hard labour with the magazine is returning to her native Norway to join EMI Recorded Music as promotion manager, radio for Virgin Norway.



Veteran UK producer Gus Dudgeon dies in car crash

LONDON — Veteran UK record producer Gus Dudgeon died in a car accident on July 21 when his Jaguar veered off a motorway near Reading, Berkshire.

Dudgeon's wife was also killed in the crash. Dudgeon, 59, was best known for his 1970s productions for Elton John, which yielded such hits as *Your Song*, *Rocket Man* and *Goodbye Yellow Brick Road*. In a statement, Elton John said he was "devastated", describing Dudgeon as "an incredibly talented producer and a very dear friend for many years". Dudgeon was a founder member of the Music Producers Guild, whose chairman Andrew East says he "contributed so much to our growth as an organisation. Gus never lost sight that it was the music that was important, and continually supported new talent."

As an in-house engineer at Decca Records' studios in his early 20s, Dudgeon worked on

Rolling Stones and Marianne Faithfull records. The first album to credit Dudgeon as producer was UK rock act Ten Years After's self-titled 1967 debut on Deram. He went on to become one of the UK's first freelance producers, and in 1969 was at the desk on David Bowie's first hit, *Space Oddity*. His long relationship with Elton John began on the artist's self-titled 1970 album, the first of 12 they made together, also including *Madman Across The Water*, *Don't Shoot Me I'm Only The Piano Player* and *Blue Moves*. Dudgeon also oversaw albums by, among others, Chris Rea, Lindisfarne and XTC. He had lately been working on a tribute album to erstwhile musical comedy act the Bonzo Dog Band, with contributions "in the can" from both Ringo Starr and the late George Harrison. Funeral arrangements were pending at press time, and a memorial service for Dudgeon is planned for September.
