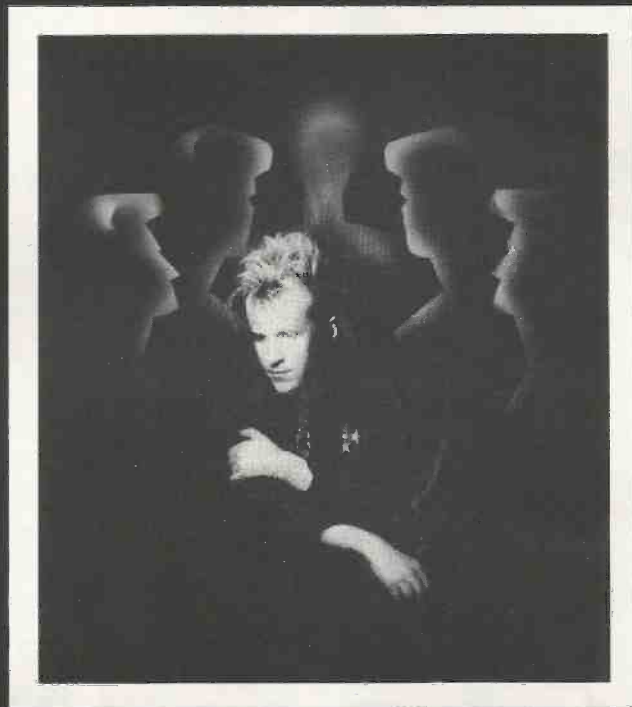

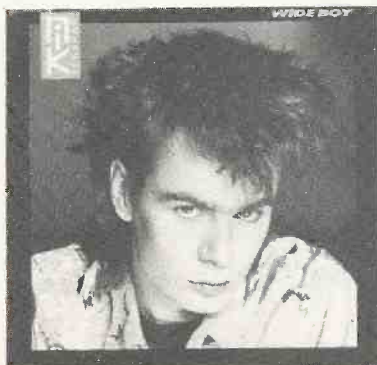

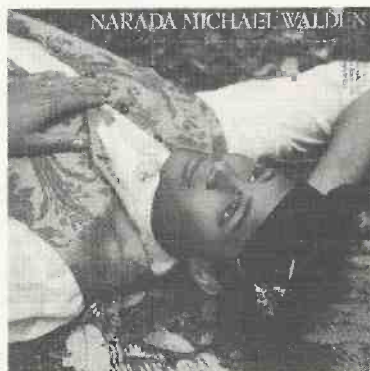

Walden combines his skill as ex-drummer of the Mahavishnu Orchestra, Weather Report and producer for Sister Sledge in his debut for Warner. The album could do well on all radio levels with tracks like *Gimme Gimme Gimme* (the MOR duet with Patti Austin), *That's The Way It Is* (commercial disco), the main stream qualities of *Lift It Up* and the cheerful reggae *Wear Your Love* (with Olympic track star Carl Lewis doing the backing vocals).



The Blasters - Hard Line- Slash/Warner

Try the Blasters, a true American-made R&R band. With their exciting mix of boogie, blues, Tex-Mex and C&W, it is about time, they get the radio response they deserve. With a more 'compressed' sound (a necessary sound quality these days to get played on US radio) radio should consider tracks like *Colored Lights* (written by John Cougar Mellencamp), *Trouble Bound*, the cajun *Hey Girl* and *Rock And Roll Will Stand*. Authentic sounds on your radio!

We received a few questions about our weekly Euroclips listing. This rotation chart indicates the video broadcast of no less than 52 European Television programs. It includes the known nationwide pop programs such as Top Of The Pops (UK), Formel Eins (Germany), Toppop and Countdown (Holland), Tocata (Spain) and DeeJay Television (Italy), but also international cable and satellite shows like Music Box and SkyTrax as well as all kind of other programs carrying music videos. Countries included are Scandinavia, Germany, U.K., Germany, Benelux, France, Italy, Spain, Switzerland, Austria, Luxembourg and Portugal. Extra points are given for broadcast on the major Nationwide TV Shows. Euroclips always includes the broadcast lists of the current weeks programs so it is really up-to-date.

The battle over payment for video rights between Television and Recordcompanies is continuing, especially in France, Switzerland and Belgium. In France the so-called News programs are now allowed to show music videos as is Canal Plus, who have agreed to pay for each showing. It will be interesting to watch this situation and to see if French artists/songs will gain in popularity as obviously French artists are more available for the live-programs. In Switzerland the recordindustry does not seem to be in a hurry to bring their financial demands down as both SkyTrax and Music Box are now covering the major Swiss cities so there still is more videomusic on the air than ever before.

Heaviest rotation on the U.S. MTV channel will undoubtedly be given to the USA for Africa clip and we expect this video to get plenty of attention in Europe too. JOHN PARR's video Naughty Naughty, which for so many weeks was heavily featured on MTV should start screening now around Europe as Phonogram is releasing the single and album. The album of this English artist was one of the most constant new climbers in America over the past 3 months. Apart from continuing to direct the Extrature Bremen TV show, famous German TV Producer Mike Lackebusch also breathes new life in his wellknown TV show Musikladen. Mike is now producing the show freelance from the amazingly equipped studios at his home and it will include videos. Although the show will be broadcast regionally there are already some heavy German areas committed as well as Swiss TV, so it looks like it will once again become a top rated show. Incidentally Mike will be using our European Top 100 throughout the program. Picture Music International is filming the successful PHIL COLLINS worldtour for later use with shots taken in Europe, Australia, Japan, USA and Canada. A picturesque clip is organised for tribal sounding track Take Me Home with shots from all the world tourist centers like the Eiffel Tower etc.

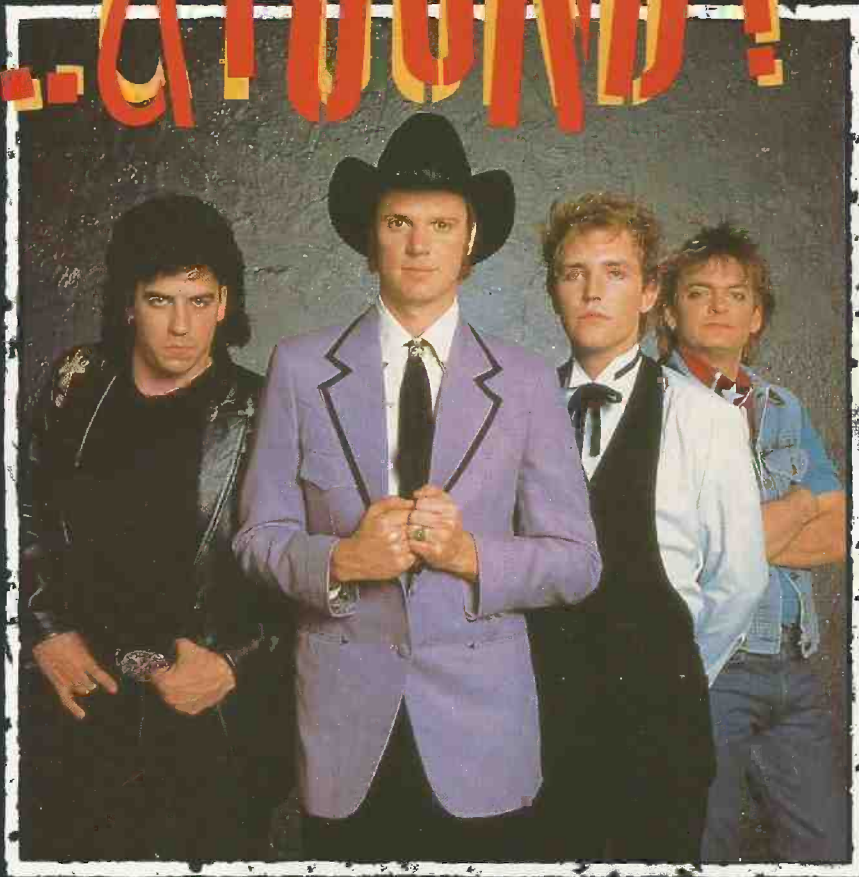

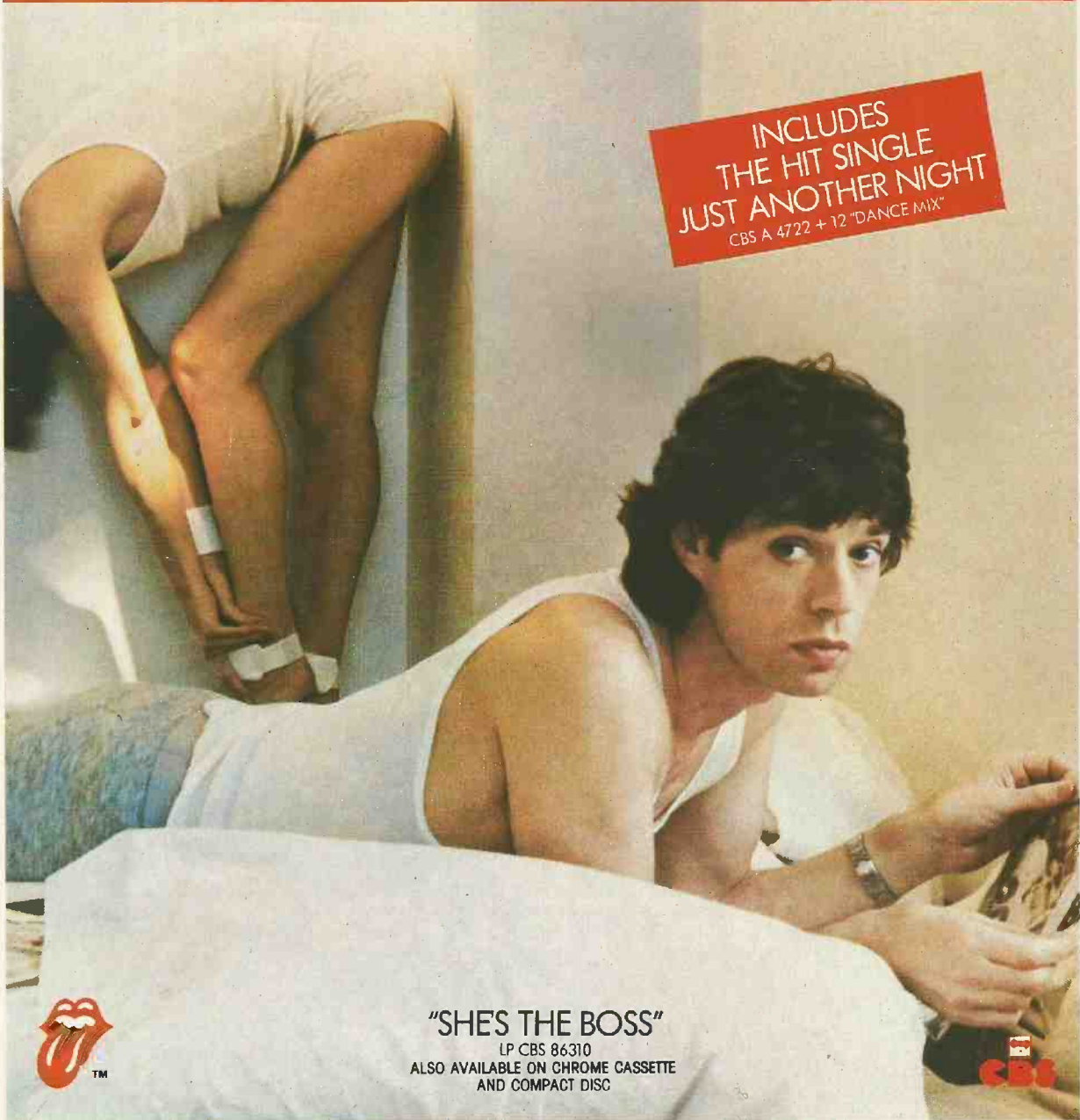

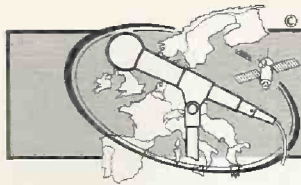

RADIO GUIDE

Euro Radio will certainly welcome Clapton's long awaited new album *Behind The Sun*. Produced by workaholic Phil Collins (apart from 3 tracks produced by Ted Templeman and Lenny Waronker), radio can work with tracks like the steady and solid rocker *She's Waiting*, the 'Layla' phrasing in the single *Forever Man*, the lazy and laid-back *Never Make You Cry* (with romantic guitar work of Mister Slowhand) and *Same Old Blues* (indeed, them good old blues again). Already almost finished 8 months ago, Warner Bros took a long time releasing this lp.

The Tubes' new album *Love Bomb*, a production of Todd Rundgren, is just been out and already getting masses of tips from Germany. Lots is expected also from the new Howard Jones album *Dream Into Action*, another Rupert Hine production.

Added to the European Airplay Top 50 are first of all Nik Kershaw's *Wide Boy*, proving again Kershaw's ability to write catchy and well-crafted popsongs, Shakin' Stevens' latest *Breaking Up My Heart*, Stephan Duffy's *Kiss Me*, another kiss from David Cassidy and French artist Michel Jonasz with his song *La Boite De Jazz*. Bubbling under the Airplay Top 50: China Crisis' latest *Black Man Ray*. (produced by Walter Becker from Steely Dan fame). Who could give us the clue to what this song reminds us of? Producer Robin Millar is very much in demand

these days. After earlier productions for Sade, Everything But... and recently The Kane Gang, he is now involved in two new productions; one for the soul-jazz band Working Week with their re-make of the Marvin Gaye classic *Inner City Blues* and secondly for a brandnew English band called Fruits Of Passion. Their debut *All I Ever Wanted* is one of those records that immediately sticks into your mind, a solid composition and splendid vocals by Sharon Dunleavy. Give it a spin!

CLASSICAL MUSIC

With the recent interest for American rock 'n' roll (Los Lobos, Jason & The Scorchers, The Blasters - see review section, ZZ Top and the return of John Fogerty) it is also interesting to see that other musical styles other than directly related to pop music, are making a return in the charts. Who would have thought that after cool jazz (Sade, Everything But The Girl, etc.), acoustic folk (Aztec Camera), blues (e.g. Alison Moyet's remake of the Billy Holiday classic *That Ole Devil Called Love*) now even classical music make people run to the shops! With the success of the *Amadeus* movie, the demand for Mozart's requiem is so big that retail can hardly handle the orders in some countries. It would be interesting to see which European stations are actually programming classical music amongst their daily pop material (Amadeus album is no. 54 in the Album charts and charted in Belgium, France and Holland). We have added four new singles from local artists to our European Crossover list. The most obvious one is Alphaville's new single *Jet Set*, a new recording of the album track by famous remixer John 'Jellybean' Benitez.

Austrian band Opus is our second choice, whom we discussed last week already, and the remaining two crossover candidates include Dutch jump and jive band Gigantjes with their cover from the mid Fifties *Yaki Taki Cowah!*, a sort of Honeydrippers Volume Two (single is about to be released in the UK as well); and Miko Mission, *The World Is You*, likely to do well on the continent with its 'Vamos A La Playa' chorus.

Whitney Houston, the niece of Dionne Warwick, has great chances to become the newest Queen Of Soul. *All At Once* is a beautiful love song in which her breathtaking voice shines like a diamond.

A NEW LIFT

The Isaac Hayes' classic *Theme From Shaft* has been giving a new lift by two versions both coming from the Benelux. There is one version by Dutch band Eddy & The Soulband, while the other one is by Belgian group Van Twist.

Over to some chart action now, a lot is happening in the European Album Top 10: Jagger moves from 30 to 10, Alan Parsons moves 3 notches to no. 8 and Collins is new at no. 1 with a record that is exploding at retail level at the moment. Album entries for Bailey, Shakatak and Santana. The same Bailey is still no. 1 in the European Top 100 Singles mainly due to his No 2 in the UK and Jermaine Jackson streaks right into the Top 10 this week jumping from 11 to 3 (we must admit that we never expected this song to chart that high). Other records with bullets include *Fotonovela*, *Love And Pride*, *Breaking Up My Heart* (Shakin's latest), *Material Girl* and *Let's Dance Tonight*.

ABOUT THE CHARTS....

THE EUROPEAN TOP 100 (SINGLES/ALBUMS):
 In many European countries one chart is recognised by the
 music industry as the "OFFICIAL" hit parade and is therefore
 used for the compilation of the EUROPEAN TOP 100. However
 there are other countries where various charts are in existence
 and often equally important. For these countries we have
 compiled a number of these charts into one representing the
 sales in that market.

Each chart position for every country then receives, relevant to
 that position, an equal points rating which is in turn multiplied
 by a factor determined through the latest known sales
 percentage of total singles (or album) sales which that country
 holds in relation to the rest of Europe. There are different
 percentages for singles and albums. These figures are kindly
 provided on a regular basis by the industry-organisations such
 as IFPI-EP- Gallup-Deutsche Phonoverband etc. For the
 EUROPEAN TOP 100 SINGLES 25 charts are used from 16
 countries, for the EUROPEAN TOP 100 ALBUMS 20 charts
 are used from 15 countries. Since the sales percentages of a
 few countries are too small to get their hits into the
 EUROPEAN TOP 100 (provided these records are not charted
 in any other territory), we are also printing a TOP 3 IN EUROPE
 list each week.

The EUROPEAN AIRPLAY TOP 50 is compiled through all our
 correspondents tips received this week. (*)Records of the week
 receive extra points. The airplay lists of the airplay report
 organizations within some of the European countries are also
 used in the calculations, as well as playlists of major radio
 stations. (*)Please note that not all received tips appear in
 Eurotipsheet but they are all used for the calculation of the
 Airplay Top 50.

THE EUROCLIPS LIST shows the music-videos most aired on
 television throughout Europe in the week prior to publication. It

NEW PLANS

We are planning to extend the information which is presented weekly in Eurotipsheet. First of all we want to become more and more a news center for the European Media and therefore need the help of all our correspondents!! Please send us YOUR news on special programs, format changes, changes in personal, important happenings in your market. It will all be used for our Media Corner and your colleagues from other countries are very interested to read about your news. As you will be able to see we are more and more extending the number of pages of our Basic Report (16 instead of 12) enabling us to present a number of new features. This has already started with the introduction of our biweekly Video News column next to the Euroclips rotation list.

In the Video News column we talk about new videos which become available for programming; interesting facts about video productions, video rights as well as new video tv programs in Europe. We will also continue and in fact extend our Spotlights on important Media people.

COMPACT DISC AND DANCE REPORT !

Within a few weeks we will start a biweekly CD page, concentrating on the programming of CD's. There are already a number of European Radio Stations which carry interesting CD programs both concentrating on the music side as well as giving information. We plan to have a CD recommendation list as well as new releases and technical developments. So here is once again: Correspondents!! give us your CD News.

We will start with a European Dance Report as already announced earlier. This will talk about danceable music suitable for both clubs and radio. It is our aim to keep on improving this page and even reserve more space for European Crossover records; to establish an Independent Route (more attention to

Europe's independent labels... thank you Axel Sommerfeld...) and to give more guide lines where to find those records.

Apart from that, more features are to be expected on European radio stations, the people behind it and their style of programming.

For those of you who have not yet returned the questionnaire please do so as soon as possible, your comments are appreciated and it is the only way to make EUROTIPSHEET your magazine, the only way to use it as a platform for an exchange of ideas, music and programs. During the last few weeks we have again added a number of correspondents from amongst the important radio and tv personalities in France, Germany, U.K., Scandinavia and Belgium.

A warm welcome to Radio Gong, the new cable station from Munich, Germany. In fact Radio Gong is the first private radio in Germany that was created upon the foundations of a magazine, in this case, Gong, the actual weekly TV guide (also published in Austria, Italy, Luxembourg, Belgium, Switzerland and France). Walter Freiwald is the program director and Radio Gong has amongst its d.j.'s people coming from Radio M1, Radio Xanadu and many correspondents from abroad (including the popular American d.j. Rick Dees, who presents every Sunday evening from 6 till 9 o'clock the American Top 40 in his program, entitled Die Americanische Nacht).

We are happy to include Polskie Radio in Warsaw, the national Polish radio and our correspondent, the disco and radio d.j.

Bogdan Fabianski, who plays the International Top 10 Singles every Saturday afternoon. As you can see, the type of records that are played on the national channel do not differ that much from other European stations.

Added to our list of correspondents is also the local Danish pop station Radio Viborg, with Stig Hartvig Nielsen as the station manager reporting to us on a regular basis. Speaking about Denmark, the recently established Copenhagen based Channel 2 provides a music service similar to that of the US station MTV. And although working on an experimental basis until April '86, the stations' music video outlets is already beginning to be a serious competitor for the national television network, Denmark's Radio.

Other new correspondents include Gerard Saudan, who's head of music for Couleur 3 in

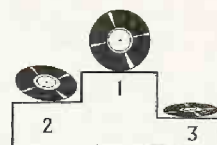

GERMANY CALLING

The Media Conference which recently took place in Mainz where politicians, program directors, radio editors and other people talked about the future cooperation between private and government owned radio and tv, resulted in opposite views. The CDU (Christian Democratic Party) ruled regions are very much in favour of legalization of the private radios and cables whereas the SPD (Socialist Party) seems to hesitate and to regard private radios as serious competitors to the government owned stations.

A funny thing happened in the south of Germany on Radio 89, a private cable connected radio station; one of the jocks had a woman guest who by some super national powers taped an interview with the deceased filmstar Romy Schneider (hearing lines like "...It wasn't suicide, I was murdered..."). As a result the telephone lines of the station were blocked due to continuous calls and the whole event was covered heavily by the 'yellow' press in Germany.

More serious now, Radio Dortmund, a local cable radio and tv station, starts its program on the first of June 1985. The TV channel Kabelfunk Dortmund, starts off on the 12th of May, parallel to the elections in the Nord Rhein Westfalen area.

A recent Investigation revealed that Baden Baden station SWF 3, spends most of its radio time to concert, book and movie reviews in comparison to WDR 2, NDR 2 and BR 2.

Some moves: Wolfman Kramartz previously with Deutschland Funk moved to WDR as dj and program editor while Herman Stuerpert moved from the Saarländische Rundfunk (SR) to a free private radio

Lausanne, Switzerland; *Ernilio Mora Gimenez*, coordinator for **Radio Alicante**, part of the Spanish Cadena SER channel; and *B. Thorsbakken*, yet another d.j. from the local station **Radio One** in Oslo. Two new names from France, *Jean Martinelli* and *Catherine Costa*, working for the new FM station in Paris, **Hit FM 106**. This new station was created by *Ramon Blumenthal* and financed by UGC (one of the largest movie productions and distribution companies) and RSCG, a top advertising company in France. Its programming will consist of only Top 40 hits, with no d.j.'s presenting and only news that concerns movies is broadcast.

We will also keep you updated on another new Paris FM station, called **Radio Liberation**, which has just started and is financed by the newspaper **Liberation**. This station mostly contains news, interviews and new music. Not only on the radio side, but also on the TV, lots of things are about to change. Recently *President Mitterand* gave his approval for independent TV to start under certain restrictions. Only the very large and powerful media and communication companies will be able to apply. At the moment the popular station **NRJ** is thinking of starting a music channel with a set-up very much alike that of MTV, the US music channel.

Gilbert Foucaud, producer of **Channel 1 (TF1) Cote d'Amour** will from now on give the weekly contents of his Wednesday evenings tv show. The program features all types of music, from reggae, pop, rock to funk and contains short interviews and own recordings of artists. **Musicbox**, the only Trans-European all-day music TV channel, have just turned on Holland's second largest city, Rotterdam, which means that **Musicbox** will be available in 205,000 extra homes.

The music cable station from Germany, **KMP Musicbox** (no relation to the above mentioned) is expanding its operations. From August 1985 onwards West-Berlin is (after Munich and Ludwigshaven) the third major city in Germany to turn on to this music program. On top of this, **Musicbox** will have a daily one hour music program on the first German satellite TV **SAT 1**, reaching approx. 250,000 cable homes.

RADIO GA GA ?

The first ever UK Music Radio Conference as organized by The Radio Academy (based in Bristol) which was held in London, touched upon many interesting subjects. **Paul Gambaccini**, one of UK's leading music writers and broadcasters, gave his personal assessment of what music radio should be. In his own words, a deejay should be able to translate his enthusiasm for music, his intelligence and his ability to speak to time, onto his audience. He should be able to create "a world" in order to be part of people's imagination. As an example he played a famous Orson Welles presentation on the invasion of creatures from Mars which was broadcast in the Fifties and this caused such a shocking reaction in America with people running out of their homes onto the streets. Paul used it as an example of how deejays can exert a tremendous influence on people's lives. **Tony Hale**, head of music for Capital Radio, gave an examination of presentation and programming: "Putting on the style". Music radio should be a combination of art, craft and science and for a station broadcasting whole days it is essential to identify your audience and to choose the right record on the right time for the right kind of person. But not only a profile of your audience is necessary, but one should also take into account the way records are programmed; some records just don't fit together in tempo or atmosphere, some records are not suitable to wake up your audience early in the morning and some records do better during mid day. One issue that continues to raise conflicting opinions, is the extent to which radio should be programmed on the basis of sales charts. **Robin Valk**, music manager of the Birmingham based station **BRMB** took a firm stand against statistical programming. Charts are used too much as a promotional tool, very often the fact that a record jumps from e.g. 50 to 32 doesn't mean automatically that significant sales are reflected behind such a

move. Good positions are no justification for airplay and stations that rely too much on charts will become computerized radio stations.

To give an indication of the fluctuation of sales with regards to a number 1 position and the huge difference between a no. 1 and a e.g. no. 30 position **Robin** presented some examples of sales figures correlated with chart positions (see figures below).

The first lines indicate approximate national sales, the second lines are sales for the **BRMB** (Birmingham) Area.

Both the **Foreigner** and the **Band Aid** single were no. 1 but the difference in sales was huge. The same applies for the difference between a no. 1 record and the no. 30: good positions do not justify airplay and do not give a direct indication of sales.

In fact charts should be used over an extended period of time, one should keep track on what is happening to a particular artist over a year's period, together with a sales index; artist-ranking lists could give a more reliable indication on how an artist album or single has developed over an extended period of time. Unfortunately we don't have the space available to give all the speakers the credit that they deserve, we picked out those issues that could have importance for radio stations on the Continent and therefore skipped out technical matters of PRS, music radio's relationship with the copyright bodies, needletime and the way the English (Gallup) charts are compiled (although we are planning to include such a feature in one of our upcoming issues).

Definitely an initiative that deserves a follow-up.
