GERMANY CALLING

Following the election of Oscar Lafontaine (SPD) as Saarlands new prime minister, insiders expect Germany to be divided in two regions: a medieval media region in the Cologne area with just the normal TV-programmes such as ARD, ZDF plus the regional third programmes and the Saarland area being a cable connected wonderland with at least 24 TV-stations. This second separation of Germany seems even more likely because of Lafontaine's announcement that he is going to reinforce the anti-cable approach of the SPD ruled countries. As a counter reaction the CDU possibly forgets about a general solution and starts with the new media policy on its own. In his speech at the media congress in Mainz on February 27th Bundeskanzler Helmut Kohl emphasized that his party will do everything possible against a limitation of freedom of thought. 'We oppose every attempt to keep the citizen in tutelage', he said.

In March fiction turned into facts: 250,000 households bringing appr. 500,000 viewers, are cable connected with SAT 1. Bavaria was the first country to have almost 100,000 cable households. There is more to come after the elections in North Rhein Westfalen (appr. 200,000) and with the opening of the 'Internationale Funk Ausstellung' in Berlin, August 1985.

As from April 1 onwards ZDF will end its daily TV programs with the broadcast of the national anthem in an orchestrated version with choir. At a press conference at the Interconti Hotel in Cologne, Sony introduced the PAL 8mm video-system. The video cassettes now have the same size as the normal MC. Conclusion: everything gets smaller... Only record companies tend to get bigger. Two of the major ones - Ariola and RCA - finally agreed on a provisional contract for worldwide fusion, a decision speeded up by the positive advice from the German Government Cartel body. As I understood the new partners will almost have a 50-50 split in the European board. In single countries such as Germany, Austria and Switzerland Ariola/Bertelsmann holds 51%, RCA 49% of the votes. In other European countries RCA has the majority of votes with 75%. In Germany the new company is called Ariola RCA Musik, internationally it runs under the name of RCA ARIOLA INTERNATIONAL.

Fifty video companies will organise the '1st German Video Congress' in Wiesbaden Rhein Main Halle from August 30 till September 1. Only two out of the fifty will simultaneously offer their products at the Internationale Funk Ausstellung in Berlin. The reason for this embarrassing counter fair in Wiesbaden is the hard criticism of the video competitors after the IFA '83. Critics complained that almost 100% of all offered videos were pornographic, brutal or just tasteless.

Holger Mueller, previously head of EMI's sister and publishing company Edition Accord, moves to Vienna to take over the duties as managing director EMI Austria. Heide Bieger, a longtime A&M executive, left

Frankfurt. Following the deal between Polydor and the American label, she's now looking after A&M from her Hamburg office. Klaus Roetger who has been in the music business for 12 years became A&R director of Frankfurt based K-Tel.

On March 22 the 'Music-Hall' opened its doors in Frankfurt. The one million Dollar club, owned by four businessmen and equipped with a high tech Laser and stereo system holds 1000 visitors and is designed as a disco and live venue. On the opening night English-American four-piece Katrina & The Waves surprised media people and guests with down to earth rock & roll.

And yes, there's a new DAVID BOWIE clip. Shot in Greenwich with DAVID MALLETT, for David's single Loving The Alien. JAZZY JEFF recorded a new anti drug single called King Heroin. The clip was shot in New York. RICKY SKAGG's videoclips for his latest single Country Boy was filmed in the subway below Times Square. Directed by MARTIN KAHAN. TWISTED SISTER has another video released for their track The Price. The beautiful CHINA CRISIS single Black Man Ray, has a clip to it which was directed by SIMON MILNE. It features the band with some interesting, painted faces. We do like the new NIK KERSHAW clip Wide Boy, in which he's impersonating a popstar through the ages. As a Teddy boy NIK has some very impressing sideburns. As time changes, he ends up sitting on a swimmingpool in California, with fashionable long hair. The clip was directed by STORM THORGUSON. Burning Flame is the title of the new single by VITAMIN Z. It's said to be a very "sensitive" video. A new clip from DON HENLEY for his single All She Want's To Do Is Dance, also taken off the album, Building The Perfect Beast. It has been filmed in a bombed-out Disco which looks like being somewhere in Latin America (actually it was shot in London!). JOHN HIATT is enjoying Living A Little, Laughing A Little in his new clip, shot at Hollywood's Palace. It's a performance/concept piece, with HIATT's duetpartner ELVIS COSTELLO. Another performance/concept piece is DREAMBOY's Contact video. Motormouth DAVID LEE ROTH has a new clip available for Just A Gigolo. This track has been taken from his first solo EP Crazy From The Heat. DAVID's clip may be crazy as usual, but the boy himself is not: I tell you! JIMMY NAIL had his clip to his new single Love Don't Live Here Anymore, directed by ARTHUR ELLIS. While PETER SINCLAIR directed the new EXPLORERS clip for their single Two Worlds Apart.

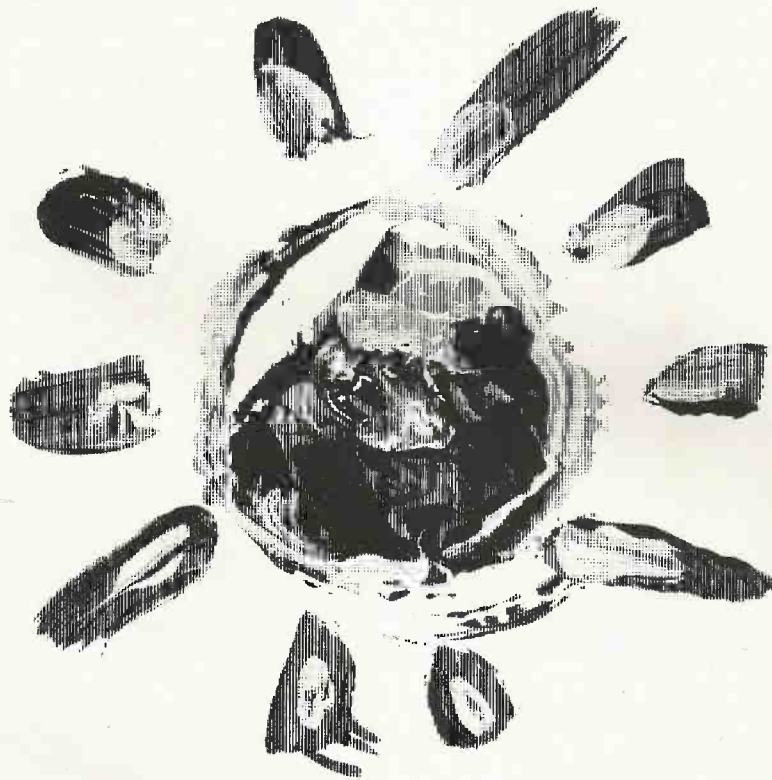

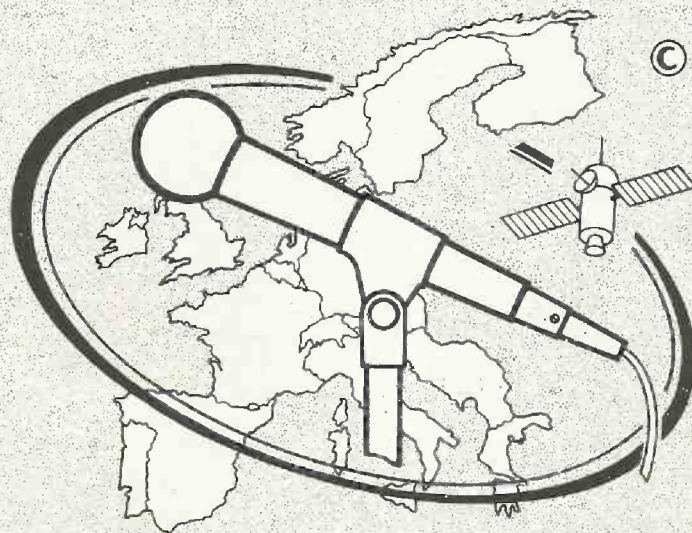



RADIO GUIDE

One phenomenon that will certainly mark the history of the musical year 1985, is that of the band-aid. Soon after Bob Geldoff's initiative the US, Canada (Modern Lights- *Tears Are Not Enough*) and Germany followed with similar projects. Now it is time for France to help the Ethiopian cause. Superstars like Julien Clerc, Jean-Jacques Goldman, France Gall, Axel Bauer, Téléphone and at least twenty others are working under the collective name of 'Chanteurs Sans Frontieres'; the song was written by Renaud and comes out on April 6 (EMI).

It is interesting to see that another French Ethiopia record is picking up a lot of sales in France at the moment. Organized by Manu Dibango a large number of African musicians living in Paris came together for three days just before Christmas and wrote the song *Tam Tam Pour L'Ethiopie*. This single is actually the B-side of the *Starvation* project (see issue 10) in England while for France the A- and B-side are reversed. At the moment Tam Tam has overtaken the Band Aid record there.

Following our earlier talks on classical music (issue 11), it is amazing that *Pie Jesu* is at the moment the third best sold single in England! The song by Sarah Brightman and Paul Miles-Kingston is from Andrew Lloyd Webber's *Requiem*, an album that is also selling vast amounts in England at the moment. The song itself is a beautiful piece of music worthwhile

for you to consider for your daily programming. In the European top 100 Spanish artist Ivan moves further up to 7 this week (due to France, Germany, Belgium and Switzerland), while Austrian band Opus jump right to 45 (from 79). Other Euro-movers include Comanchero, Modern Talking and Alphaville (with their new single *Jet Set*) while Videokids and the other Alphaville hit *Sounds Like A Melody* are still charted in the upper regions of the charts. Obviously with this kind of European success we will even increase Eurotipsheet's focus on local product.

SPINNING UP & DOWN ⁴⁷

The title of Dead Or Alive's hit record at the moment seems to be very appropriate. Already out for more than four months now it really took some time for this record to make impact. It 'spinned' up and down the English charts and is now finally reaching chart positions on the Continent as well: Europe's biggest climber this week, from 13 right up to no. 5.

A large part of today's music superstars are built on 'image', and it is therefore good to see that artists who don't rely on an image and for whom only musicianship counts, are able to have equal success. Phil Collins is (together with e.g. Mike Oldfield) one such example; not only in the US he's top of the bill (both single - *One More Night* and album no. 1) but also in Europe his album is no. 1 in no less than 8 countries and with the success of the *One More Night* single other countries are soon to follow.

Jemaine Jackson's slow song *Do What You Do* is one of those records where the relation

between sales and airplay does not look right. The single is no. 2 in the European Top 100 singles and has high positions in the UK, France, Germany, Belgium and Holland that is at the same time not really one of radio's favourite records: originally only bubbling under the Airplay Top 50, the single came in last week and moves up 10 places to 34. Give it a spin!

Our frontpage tips for this week include some exciting records. First of all the ex-punk formation The Damned have taken a somewhat different musical direction, their new single *Grimley Fiendish* sounds not so 'devil-like' as the title suggest, it has a comforting steady beat with a definite 6T's feel. Could do very well on all different sorts of radio formats.

PLANES IN MY STOMACH ⁸⁹

Gorcy's (Motown) pride DeBarge have a new single out entitled *Rhythm Of The Night*, a medium up-tempo song with a very good video supporting it. King's follow-up *Won't You Hold My Hand Now* is another energetic pop-funk tune. One Euro-Crossover record that needs your special attention is Herbert Groenemeyer's album *4630 Bochum* EMI Electrola (see also special feature in issue 10). Presently the lp holds at no. 38 with a bullet on our Album charts (after 43 weeks!) due to its no. 2 position in his native country Germany. The album sold over 500,000 copies already and now finally starts to get airplay and attention from other countries as well. Although the name of the artist may be unpronounceable check out his emotional and direct vocals on his current single *Flugzeuge Im Bauch* (Planes In My Stomach!).

What a great day it was for **George Michael** recently, at the *Nor Novello Awards*, he was given the songwriter of the year award, and just to prove that even mega stars are human, he actually broke down and cried. It is one of the greatest awards that the record business hands out, and for one so young, it's a great honour. Wham! by the way are to tour China soon.

An interesting court case came to its conclusion last week. Ray Jackson, who in the early Seventies was a member of **Lindisfarne**, had signed a solo recording deal with EMI Records. The deal called for three singles in the first year, EMI only released one single, and according to the artists manager, lost interest in him. The case was taken to court, and has become the first court case of its kind in the record industry. Jackson sued for 'loss of opportunity', and he won. The court awarded him £12,500.00 plus interest which has now earned him a total of £24,000.00. I suspect a lot of artists and their managers will be looking at their recording contracts much more closely now.

New singles to watch out for at the moment from War, the old young Rascals classic it's called *Groovin'* and will be a big hit. The jocks have been playing it on import for weeks; **The Damned**, who for the first time since their formation have signed to a major label (MCA); **Frankie Goes To Hollywood**, which by the time you read this will be high in the charts; **Tears For Fears**, **ABC**, **Foreigner**, **The Smiths** and **Millie Jackson**.

Meanwhile at radio, Radio One jock **Mark Page**, has just returned from vacation in Australia, he will be sitting in for **Gary Davis** who has gone off for a couple of weeks skiing. **Steve Wright** was off for a couple of days with the flu, and **Andy Peebles** sat in for him. **Andy** also sat in for **Tony Blackburn** who was suffering from jet lag after a trip to Washington. At Capital Radio, a couple of members of **Frankie Goes To Hollywood** popped in to see **Kid Jensen**, and Paul King from **King** popped in to co-host the **Gary Crowley** show. **David Jensen** also got struck down by the dreaded flu too.

Good news for **Channel Four**, at long last we are to get a new show which will commence when the Tube finishes its current run. The show is called *Soultrain*, and will be showing clips from the American version. The show will also be booking soul acts from the UK and the USA, the first couple of shows are booked and will have **Cashmere**, **Millie Jackson** and **Loose Ends**. The second show will probably feature **The Cool Notes**. Also, as mentioned in a recent column, **Channel Four** are to run a heavy rockshow called **E.C.T.** By the way **Jeffrey Daniel**, formerly with **Shalamar**, will be the host for *Soultrain*.

The **Tina Turner** shows here in London, with **Bryan Adams**, went down a storm. News has just come through that **James Brown** will be doing some shows in London soon which should be great. Remember I mentioned a band called the **Jesus** and **Mary Chain**, well at one of their recent gigs the police had to be called, and £3,000.00 of damage was done. What is the world coming to?

On a sad note finally, the former lead singer of **Uriah Heep**, **David Byron** died recently. The coroner recorded a verdict of dead by natural causes.

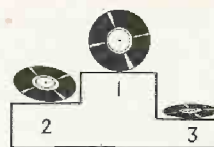

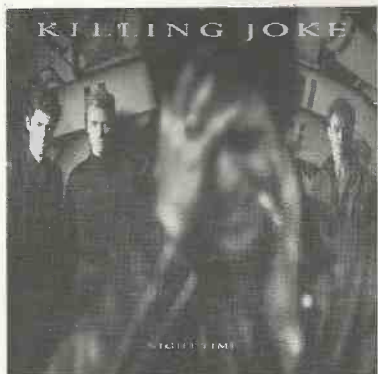

John Parr - John Parr- Mercury
Strong debut album by the rocker Parr already shooting up the US charts. His music exemplifies soul? American influenced rock. The single *Naughty Naughty* is already picking up responses from Euro Radio; other strong contenders are *Magical* (the next US single), *Love Grammar* and *Don't Leave Your Mark On Me*.



Killing Joke - Night Time- EG/Polydor
Sixth album from post-punk formation Killing Joke. And although the album is more structured than ever, the hard-driving guitar sound is still prominent and it is quite amazing they suddenly make impact with *Love Like Blood*. The rest of the material carries the same compelling quality.



Howard Jones - Dream Into Action- WEA
This second album (another Rupert Hine production) continues the line of his first album and establishes Jones as a major talent as a songwriter. His current single *Things Can Only Get Better* is included and further recommended tracks include *Look Mama* and *Elegy*.

Eric Clapton- Behind The Sun- Duck/Warner
What more can we say? We have already discussed this smashing album by Mr. Slowhand some weeks ago and this Phil Collins produced album will be added on all the major European radios by the time of printing. Check again titles like *Same Old Blues*, *Like A Prisoner* and *Never Make You Cry*.



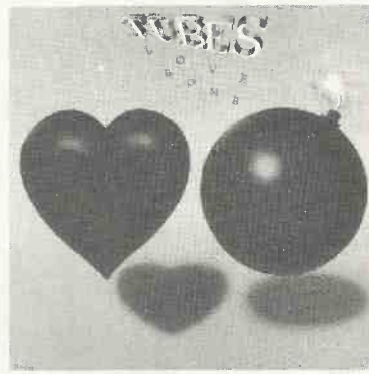
Rose Tattoo - Southern Stars- Albert Productions/WEA
Their fifth album is more varied in its arrangements but still possesses the same basic approach: raw, heavy and straight forward rock. Our advice is: play it loud - cause they are rocking the roof off! Their current single is *Freedoms Flame*.



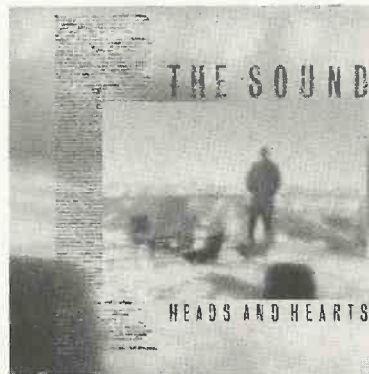
Robin George - Dangerous Music- Bronze
First full length album of this multitalented axeman, who previously played in such bands as Magnum, Climax Bluesband and Roy Wood. Sophisticated heavy rock with a brilliant use of the synthesizer. Check out the excellent track *Spy*.



Vision Quest - Soundtrack- Geffen
We don't need to see the movie to enjoy this soundtrack. A very commercial compilation with tracks from Madonna (*Crazy For You/Gambler*), an oldy from Foreigner (*Hot Blooded*), a strong John Waite track called *Change* (from his Neil Gerardo produced album) and so many more!



The Tubes - Love Bomb- Capitol
The Tubes' pop approach has been given a harder edge by producer Todd Rundgren who is also involved in writing some of the material. The result is very overwhelming and especially tracks like *Night People*, *She's A Beauty* and *Stella* make a lasting impression.



The Sound - Heads And Hearts- Statik
This fifth album could yield the crossover payoff they have been waiting for so long. This album sees them again in a very intimate atmosphere while losing some of its impending doom, that marked earlier releases. Best tracks *Love Is Not A Ghost*, *Burning Part Of Me* and *Temperature Drop*.
