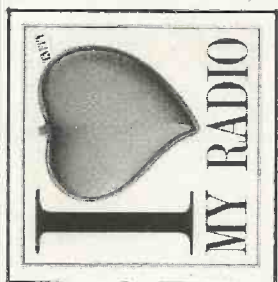

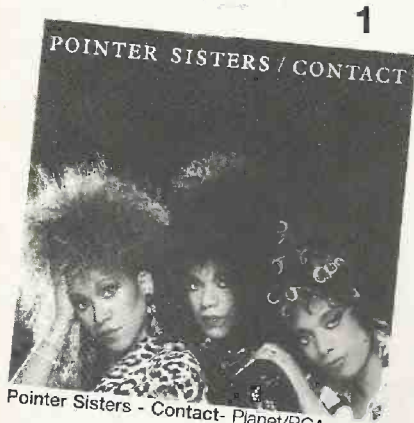
## STATIC TRENDS

Although The European Album chart tends to be very static and hardly no new products making new entries, there are still a lot of established artists having steady album sales over the last few weeks. **Sting, Springsteen, Collins, Eurythmics, U2** (all 4 albums), **Tina Turner, Madonna** and **Prince** show strong sales increases in various European markets. Strongest moves in the European Top 100 Albums for **Sting** (2-4), **Modern Talking** (9-16; new entries in Spain and France), **Pointer Sisters** (31-50; new entries in Germany and Switzerland and moving in Holland and Belgium), our Euro-Crossover from Italy Alice with her 'Stolen Jewels' (*Giocelli Rubati*) (42-52) and a bit lower, **Madonna's** first album. As stated earlier not so many new entries apart from **Michel Sardou** (61), **Aretha Franklin** (67; new entries in Germany, Belgium, Holland and Switzerland and about to enter the UK), and re-entries for

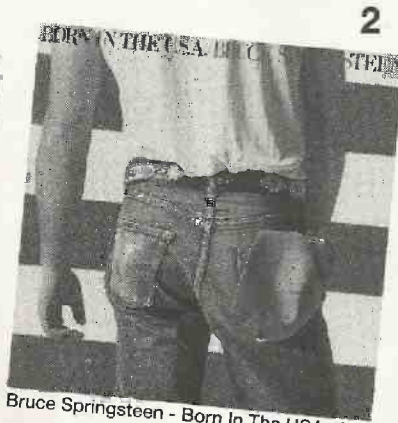
French lady **France Gall**, **Power Station** (91 mainly due to a re-entry in Germany), **Nik Kershaw** (94) and **U2** (97; Live import album). Bubbling under The European Album Top 100 are **Laura Branigan, Beach Boys** and **Philip Oakey & Giorgio Moroder** (See also Review section). Airplaywise things haven't changed that much, **Pointer Sisters** move up to no. 1., **Springsteen** to no. 2. and **Dire Straits** continue to be third best played album in Europe. The Queen Of Soul **Aretha Franklin** is a strong contender for a next weeks Euro-Radio Album Smash as are **Sting, Eurythmics**, and **Tina Turner**. We fully agree with you Mr. Radcliffe (Piccadilly!), it is pity that so few of you hardly pay any attention to **Prefab Sprout's** excellent album *Steve McQueen*. We know it isn't the easiest music to program but tracks like *Bonnie* (VARA Holland has it on its playlist!), *Goodbye Lucille No. 1* and *Faron Young* are examples of the band's unique way of songwriting.

## videonews

Normal summer activities in Europe as far as music television is concerned have always been very 'dull'. Most of the important shows around the continent are closing down for their summer break, some as early as May! One should have expected that with the rise of videos and video programs, it would be relatively easy for the major national television networks to provide continuous service to the TV music lovers. The most popular shows like German Formel 1 and Dutch Toppop are all taken off the air temporarily, while they already use a lot of videos in their programming. It should be easy to continue these programs on a special 'summer schedule'. They already follow their national channels and use the videos as provided by the record companies. The same negative picture applies for many European shows in practically all major countries. A great number of shows is off the air in the UK, France and Italy. France obviously had a special problem this year when videos were banned, due to the fight over payment. Just as they came back on the air they close for holidays! Anyway, in Scandinavia they work on a different time schedule for year-long runs but as a whole the picture looks negative and it is yet another reason why the major record labels hesitate to release important new product.

At the same time this presents a great extra opportunity for the satellite and cable channels and where-ever they are available, they will win fans while the national TV's will loose them. Eurotipsheet urges the producers of these national TV programs to discuss the problem with their stations management to plan it differently next year. The tremendous Live Aid success (a unique broadcasting feast) will be continued as there are various plans for video and film documentaries.

### BILLBOARD VIDEO CONVENTION

An in-depth look at how video music is developing as a major commercial product category, its relationship to the creative community, and the increasing role of music in television and film are among the topics to be spotlighted at Billboard's seventh annual Video Music Conference. The event is scheduled for November 21-24 at the Sheraton Premiere Hotel in Universal City. A breakdown of 10 panel discussions set to take place includes:

- 'Video Music: From Promises To Profits'
- 'The Multi-Channel Matrix.' A status report on cable, broadcast television, pay-per-view, syndication and other mushrooming transmission avenues for music video;
- 'RPM To Frames Per Second'; record label activity in music video;
- 'Rolling The Credits', discussion state-of-the-art video craft;
- 'Future Rushes.' A glimpse into the startling technology;
- 'Releasing The Final Print.' Legal issues.

After the tremendous success of Rambo (Sylvester Stallone's successful film) in The States, the film is now opening all over the Continent. The film theme, Peace In Our Life caused some controversy. Singer and younger brother Frank Stallone recut the video, which originally was made up of segments from the movie. Presumably Frank found it too much of trailer for his brother's movie and not enough trailer for himself...the singer. Talking about ego? So look out for this one. ★ **Weird Al Yankovic's** Madonna imitation clip for Like A Surgeon is our favourite for this month and very funny! And for the real fans a long form video will be released by CBS Fox this fall. ★ Good to see Dutch band **Time Bandits'** video for their last years release I'm Only Shooting Love. It looks like Columbia is breaking the band in the US now. Strange that winner of the Best Video Clip Award of the **Montreux Golden Rose Television Festival** this year was **Tom Petty & The Heartbreakers** for Don't Come Around Here Anymore. Not strange that this great clip won the award but a surprise as Petty has still not really broken through in Europe.

### ANIMATE YOUR SCREEN

The lovers of animated videos should be happier all the time as more and more video producers choose this form of presentation. Many of the latest clips are either totally animated, or use it in parts as can be seen by one of this week's Euro Clips Endicott from **Kid Creole & The Coconuts**. It brings new art to videos and especially with the help of new cartoon technology it provides refreshing pictures. This form is becoming very fashionable and is accepted extensively by European TV producers as can be seen by **Dire Straits'** Money For Nothing, **Prince's** Raspberry Beret, **Five Star's** All Fall Down, **AC/DC's** Fly On The Wall and **A-Ha's** Take Me On. It also helps the video directors to overcome creative fatigue as it becomes more and more difficult to present artists in a original manner. However, one should note that good animation is very expensive and can therefore only apply to top groups. ★ A very pretty clip

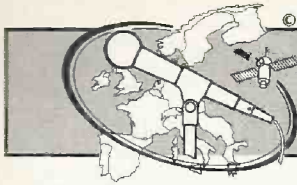
**Freddy Jackson - Rock Me Tonight** - Capitol

## Singles Guide

As you can see on page 5 we are introducing from now on a weekly feature called **Highlights** giving you the most important records, breakers and other chart action in each separate market. We will also keep our ears open for new Euro-Crossover records and will keep you posted on their development in the different countries. In this way we hope to be more and more able to give you the latest updated chart happenings in Europe.

This week it wasn't hard to decide which Euro-Crossover record came in consideration for the frontpage. German band **Nena** came up with the second single from their *Feuer Und Flamme* album entitled *Haus Der Drei Sonnen* (CBS), a stirring song with a beautiful arranged orchestral part and their best since long. Apart from being heavily played in Germany the track is already record of the week on the Dutch stations Veronica and NCRV. Italy brings us the

duet of **Mike Francis** and **Amii Stuart**, their collaboration is entitled *Together* (RCA), a nice soul disco outfit where the piano part on the end lends itself very easily for a 12" re-mix. Our last Crossover tip comes from Spain; The band **Radio Futura** is getting heavy airplay and it is not hard to understand why. The single *La Ciudad Interior* (Ariola) has a brooding guitar piece in the best New Order tradition.

One of the most added new singles this week (new at the European Airplay at 17) is **Kate Bush**'s *Running Up That Hill*. Not quite the sound we expected but very strong indeed. It gets strong backing on Capital, RTL and Piccadilly in England and KRO, NOS, AVRO and VARA in Holland. Not yet entered in the Airplay Top 50 but already getting lots of tips (Capital Climber, Record of the week at RTL Luxembourg and a new entry for Radio Babboleo in Genova Italy) is **Thomas Dolby**'s latest project **Dolby's Cube**. (See also Alexandra's Corner). We were particularly struck by the single of **Topper Headon** the ex-Clash drummer who re-worked an old Gene Krupa track of the 1940's entitled *Drumming Man*; Big Band sounds back on your airwaves! Other interesting new

releases for **Finn & Mason** (ex 10CC and Pink Floyd members featuring also Dave Gilmour; favourite on SWF-Baden Baden and RTL-London), **Billy Ocean**'s new single from the Suddenly album is called *Mystery Lady* and is already Record of the week on a lot of English stations and finally **Air Supply** getting tips from the UK and Italy (Sound International and Antenna Della Stretto).

The top of the European Top 100 Singles is ruled by Euro product; **Opus** still at 1. and **Baltimore** moves further up to 2. Meanwhile **Hardcastle** sticks to number 4. and it is interesting to see that his social comments are taken seriously, the single is charted in all European countries. We also heard both Japanese, French, German and Spanish versions of this track.

Saleswise **Madonna**, **Eurythmics**, **UB40** and **Kool & The Gang** all have the strongest moving singles this week (Why did Kool take so long to chart outside the UK?). Other moves, although taking place in lower regions of the charts include **Bad Boys Blue** (one of our Euro-Crossover tips now finally making impact also in Austria, Switzerland, Denmark and Belgium), **Madonna's Holiday**, **Patrick Sebastien** and **Nik Kershaw**.

# - Highlights -

Hq L10

Welcome to the first **Highlights** in which we hope to provide you with information on the major movements per country. It will also give us the opportunity to spotlight local productions earlier, in other words, before they cross over to other markets. This column will be useful to active radio and television producers but also to international **A&R Experts** and **Music Publishers** looking out for good new product!

This first week we only **HIGHLIGHT** the three biggest European territories. Read about the smaller, but equally important countries next week.

## UNITED KINGDOM

Biggest new powerplays on UK airwaves are for **UB40 & Chrissie Hynde**, **Billy Idol**, **Pointer Sisters** and **Nik Kershaw**. **Axel F** disappeared from most radio playlists as **Harold Faltermeyer** releases his new success *Fletch*. Airplay on **Tina's** *Hero* is great all across the UK. Other favourites continue to be **Eurythmics**, **Madonna**, **The Cure** and **Phil Collins** (*Take Me Home!*).

No Top 20 new chartmakers on the **Singles** side this week, although good old **Dio** makes a surprise entry at 42 with his *Rock and Roll Children*. Our toptip in the **Singles** *Route* of last week, **Propaganda's** *P.Machinery* is the third best entry in the UK at 55.

**Madonna** rules the British charts this week with *Groove* at no 1 again and *Holiday*, a two year old recording! jumping from 32 straight to 5. *Crazy For You* went down, but still is in the first 15. **Dire Straits** enters the Top 5 (*Money*), while **Billy Idol** comes close at 6 with the re-released *White Wedding* (from 11). Other major moves for **Amazulu** (25-35), **Phil Collins** (28-38 and not yet released in any other Eurocountry), **Lisa Lisa** (39-53), **Princess**(31-54) and **The Cars** (32-56). Dutch group **Mai Tai** break again with their first Dutch hit *Body And Soul* which jumps to 43 from 64.

Album wise the UK charts is 'summer-static' with the first 4 unchanged (**Straits-Bruce-Eurythmics** and **Tears**), but the highest entry is for **Phil Oakey & Giorgio Moroder** at 52! Although the **Live Aid** projects wasn't meant to deliver profitability for the artists involved, they still fare very well with continuous rise for **LP's** by **U2** (Note the jump for the importive album *Wide Awake In America* which goes from 75 to 37), **Tina Turner**, **Phil Collins** and last but not least **Madonna!** Obviously superladies **Tina** and **Madonna** are further helped by current new hitsingles.

## GERMANY

German productions are doing well this week on German radio with **Purple Schultz** and 'Beach Boys' **Die Strandjungs** getting massive backing, while **Black Foeoess** moves into the **A-lists**. **Tina** is this week's overall winner also in Germany where she receives no less than 85 plays according to **Media Control**. **Falco** is doing well in all regions. Moving into the national airplay **Top 20** are also **UB40**, **Huey Lewis** and **Rick Springfield**.

**Johnny Logan** is breaking in the north with his *Ginny*, likely to do well nationwide soon, as will be the case for **David Knopfler**, **Nik Kershaw** and **Sandra**. *Rock Me Amadeus* stays at no 1 in the **National Charts** followed by **Tina**, **Baltimore** and **Round One**. Our **Euro-Crossover** tip *Maria Magdalena* enters the **Top 10** and should hit in many more countries. Biggest jump is for **Madonna's** *Groove* (12-50) followed by the **Fine Young Cannibals** (16-31), **Blaeck Foeoess** (21-65).

The new chart entries this week include **Kool & The Gang** (*Cherish* at 28.. finally), our front page tip **Nena** (44), **Laura Branigan**, **Eurythmics** and (we are very proud of this one!) **Alice**, one of our earlier crossover tips entering at 61. **Boss Bruce** stays on **Top** in the **Album Chart**. For the rest the **Top 20** is very static apart from **Madonna's** jump to 6 (from 10) and **Eurythmics** (18-24). Nice by the way to see the **Beach Boys** enter in the lower regions with their latest offering.

German schlager music has lost its battle with homegrown pop and rock productions long ago, as can be seen once again in this week's albums hitparade; the best positions by local produced artists are for pop-rockers **Nena**, **Modern Talking**, **Jennifer Rush**, **Herbert Groenemeyer**, **Opus** (although Austrian), **Phil Carmen** (Swiss!), **Purple Schulz**, **Rodgau Monotones**, **Spider Murphy Gang** and heavy metal **Warlock**. So don't you dare to say anymore that German productions are insipid!!

## FRANCE

During summer French radio stations tend to stick to playlists that are quite static and do not make lots of room for new releases. This is especially true for **AM** stations like **RTL** and **Europe 1**. Another **AM** station **RMC** (**Radio Monte Carlo**) increases audience ratings considerably during the summer months, due to millions of Frenchmen moving to

the southern shores during July and August. A few years back we could have almost printed one playlist for all these 8 summer weeks, but with the rise of the **FM** stations this has changes quite drastically.

**Jean-Jacques Goldman**, the **CBS France** young superstar, who had a major hit last year with *Long Is The Road* is undoubtedly this month's radio favourite as he tops both **AM** and **FM** playlists and even starts to break in other countries (tipped by various correspondents in Germany and Holland). His new single *Je Marche Seul* (*I Walk Alone*) could finally provide the French with a **Euro-crossover** hit!

Other French productions are doing also well on radio, mainly on **AM** level with special emphasis for **Marc Lavoine**, **Etienne Daho**, **Gold** and **Rita Mitsouko**. All in all only 5 international hits make it in the **AM** airplay **Top 20** as reported by **Media Control**.

**FM** is more accesible to 'foreign culture'. **Sting**, **Alphaville**, **Al Corley**, **Baltimore** and **Rah Band** are amongst the favourites.

Looking at the **French Singles** chart (a combination of various French charts compiled by Eurotipsheet to give a really adequate French sales chart), we immediately notice a very different kind of musical preference. Very few rock productions can ever make it to the top of the singles sales lists. All in all the major sellers are either from French origin or softer international Pop or MOR releases. At present especially singles from Euro countries are doing fine in France with **Opus**, **Raggio Di Luna**, **Modern Talking**, **Baltimore**, **Al Corley**, **Scotch** and **Alphaville** all positioned in the **Top 20**.

## NORTHERN EUROPE

Although it is hard to treat the 4 Scandinavian countries as one common market, there are both single- and album wise artists doing equally well in all the four markets. **Hardcastle's** hip hop documentary is charted in all countries, just like **Duran Duran** and **Opus**. European productions continue to do well in Scandinavia; **Maria Magdalena** by **Sandra** is no 1 in Norway (**Opus** is at 3). In Sweden **Opus** is still in the **Top 5** as is Italian **Scotch** with *Delirio Mind*. Denmark has the biggest amount of Euro records charted; **Baltimore** is **Top 3** this week and **Sandra**, **Opus** and **Falco** are **Top 10** while **Modern Talking**, **Fun Fun** and **Bad Boys Blue** all take dominant positions in the **Top 20**.

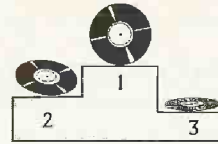
