BBC 1 PLAYLIST REINSTATED?

BEERLING SEEKS TO WIDEN MUSICAL COVERAGE

Johnny Beerling, who became controller of BBC Radio 1, the pop music network, last year is thinking about restoring the weekly record playlist which was dropped by the station in the early 1980's.

His view is that Radio 1 plays too many oldies and that there is room for a greater sense of 'musical adventure' in its day-time programming. The playlist was, in its day, criticised for being too restrictive and in fact curbing efforts of producers to introduce new talent, new releases and emergent styles

of music.

In a recent interview for 'Broadcast' magazine in London Beerling said: "I think we do play too many oldies, but our audience (and the network has a 33% share of the national audience) is older. So here we are in the 1980s playing records from the 1960s and being criticised bitterly if we don't".

Seeking to widen musical coverage, Beerling is considering organizing a black music festival this year. There is also likely to be

UK'S TUBE TWICE A WEEK

CHANNEL 4 BOWS TO POPULAR DEMAND

TV's top live rock show The Tube is to become a twice-weekly event - by popular demand. Channel Four bosses have finally given the go-ahead for repeats of the award-winning pop programme, presented by Paula Yates and Jools Holland.

The usual 90-minute package of live music, interviews, special film reports and exclusive videos from Tyne Tees Television is currently transmitted on Channel Four on Fridays at 5.30 p.m. Now it will be given a full re-run the following Tuesday, beginning on 18th February at 10.30 p.m.

The repeat season starts in style with the chance to see a 30-minute film special on Simple Minds in Rotterdam, including an interview with band leader Jim Kerr by presenter Muriel Gray.

Tyne Tees Television chiefs are delighted at the late night Tuesday repeat slot. Tube Executive Producer Malcolm Gerrie said: "It's something we have been keen to secure since the show began on November 5th 1982. From the thousands of letters we have received we realise that one of the problems of viewers has been getting back home in time to watch it. We have had countless requests to see again various performances and interviews. Now they will be able to see a full repeat of the early evening programme in a late-night slot." It is the best present Channel Four could have given The Tube for 1986 and I find it refreshing at a time when the BBC is cutting back its pop and rock output that Channel Four is prepared to extend its own."

50 MILLIONTH CD

NARM BOARD VISITS POLYGRAM PLANT

Hannover - Polygram's Hannover plant produced its 50 millionth Compact Disc January 18th - just three days before the group hosted a visit to the factory by the board of America's National Association of Record Merchandiser.

Before touring the plant, the delegation was given an audiovisual presentation on the history of the CD system and learned that the factory produced 28.7 million CDs last year. By the end of this year, total production since opera-

tions started in August 1982 will have passed the 100 million mark and output will be in the region of one million units a week.

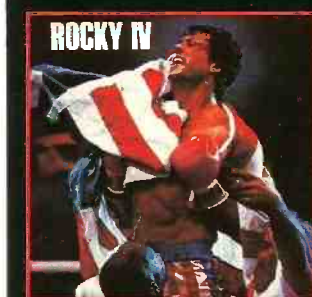
Speaking at a gala dinner at the Hotel Fuerstenhof in nearby Celle, Polygram president Jan Timmer told the NARM party that the Compact Disc was the sound and video carrier that would guarantee the future prosperity of the music industry.

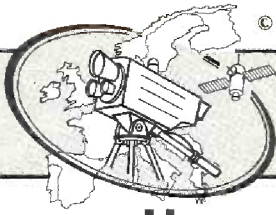

Picture Music released a 60 minutes music video of Saxon's tour in Spain in preparation for their forthcoming UK and European tour, in June '86. The music video is entitled Life Innocence and was directed by Noel Oliver ★ On February 24th Picture Music will also release a video on John Lennon's only major U.S. concert between the Beatles' 1966 tour and his death in 1980. 'John Lennon Live In New York City' is a 60 minute programme filmed on the 30th of August 1972 at Madison Square Garden in N.Y. when Lennon together with Ono performed for the benefit of the One To One Organisation to aid mentally handicapped children. ROCKY IV BEATING IN

The fastest moving album in the Hot 100 this week is the Soundtrack *Rocky IV* with two hit singles occupying dominant positions in the Singles Hot 100 (see Singles Guide). With the album selling well in six European markets, it is clear that the soundtrack could become just as successful as last year's *Miami Vice*. This strong move from 47 to 18 is in fact the only really important one in this week's Hot 100. There are still no new hot releases and therefore, due to this lack of competition lots of LPs are re-entering the Hot 100.

One of those re-entries is the album by the New York folkie Suzanne Vega whose debut album re-enters due to positions in the UK, Germany and Benelux. We think the album is still a good choice for your album programmes with tracks like *Small Blue Thing* (recently released in the UK as the new single), *Freeze Tag* and *Marlene On The Wall* as programme tips. Another American folkie is Marti Jones and she is on the A&M label as well. We recently did a review on this impressive debut album and both her songwriting and vocal diction come very close to those of Suzanne Vega.

Peter Frampton comes alive again with his new Virgin album *Premonition*, his first LP in nearly 4 years. Nine tunes, all Frampton originals, ranging from the outstanding rockers *Lying* (the first single) and *Stop* with its driving hook, to punchy ballads such as *Hiding From A Heartache* and *All Eyes On You*. Frampton is in very good shape and delivers an album bound for the charts. He is assisted by bassist Tony Levin, drummers Steve Ferrone and

Omar Hakim and keyboardist Richard Cottle.

Scorpions drummer Herman Rarebell tries on his own with a little help from some of his friends. Nicknamed 'Herman Ze German' heavy weights like Don Dokken, Steve Marriott and Ratt's Bobby Blotzer and Juan Croucier, give their support on this Capitol album. Completely in line with the recent trend by heavy and hardrock artists to cover classic rock 'n roll songs (think of Twisted Sister's *Leader Of The Pack* and Motley Crue's *Smokin' In The Boysroom*) there is a raucous version of the 1963 Surfaris instrumental *Wipe Out*.

Vogue Records in Belgium recently issued an album by singer Victor Lazlo entitled *She*. Contrary to what the name implies Lazlo is a female singer operating in the jazz-cocktail style with undercooled and restrained arrangements. Victor Lazlo was discovered after appearing extensively in the Belgian club scene by Lou De Pruyck, the producer of Lou & The Hollywood Bananas. She had her first hit end of '84 with *Backdoor Man*, also included on this album. Other stand out tracks comprise the striking cover of 'Cry Me A River' in a French version entitled *Pleurer Des Rivieres*, the classic Julie London track (which was a hit for Mari Wilson in 1983) and the 40's classic *Put The Blame On Mame*.

The Staple Singers currently have their 1974 single *If You're Ready* covered by Ruby Turner. Now they come up with a new LP full of funky and exciting material. Watch the covers *Are You Ready* and *Life During War Time* (Talking Heads) as the definite stand outs. Another song that immediately strikes is the funky *Back To The War*

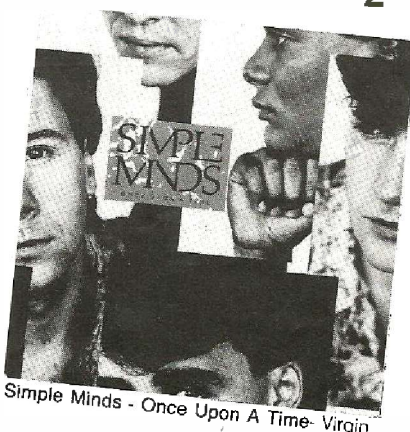

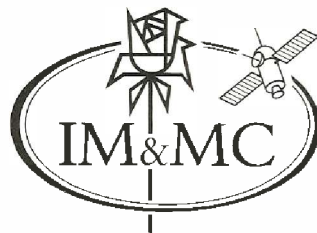

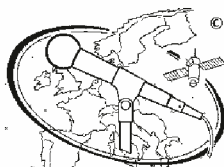

BBC 2 SHIFT TO MOR

WINNING BACK THE OVER 40'S

The BBC's Radio 2 network is to concentrate primarily on music for the over-40s in a bid to win back listeners said to have been "lost" through the increased use of Top 40 pop in recent years. As from Easter, the schedules will be completely re-vamped to put a solid emphasis on middle-of-the-road music.

Frances Line, the station's head of music, while denying that these are 'panic' moves because of slashed listening figures, says: "Radio 2 has been drifting about without a sufficiently clear music policy. The youth audience has been somewhat overindulged and now we must go back to win over the over-40s."

She's building up a new roster of disc-jockeys to carry through the new plans. One is Paul Jones, former singer with the chart-topping Manfred Mann group and recently established as an actor, who will host a new series principally featuring blues and country music.

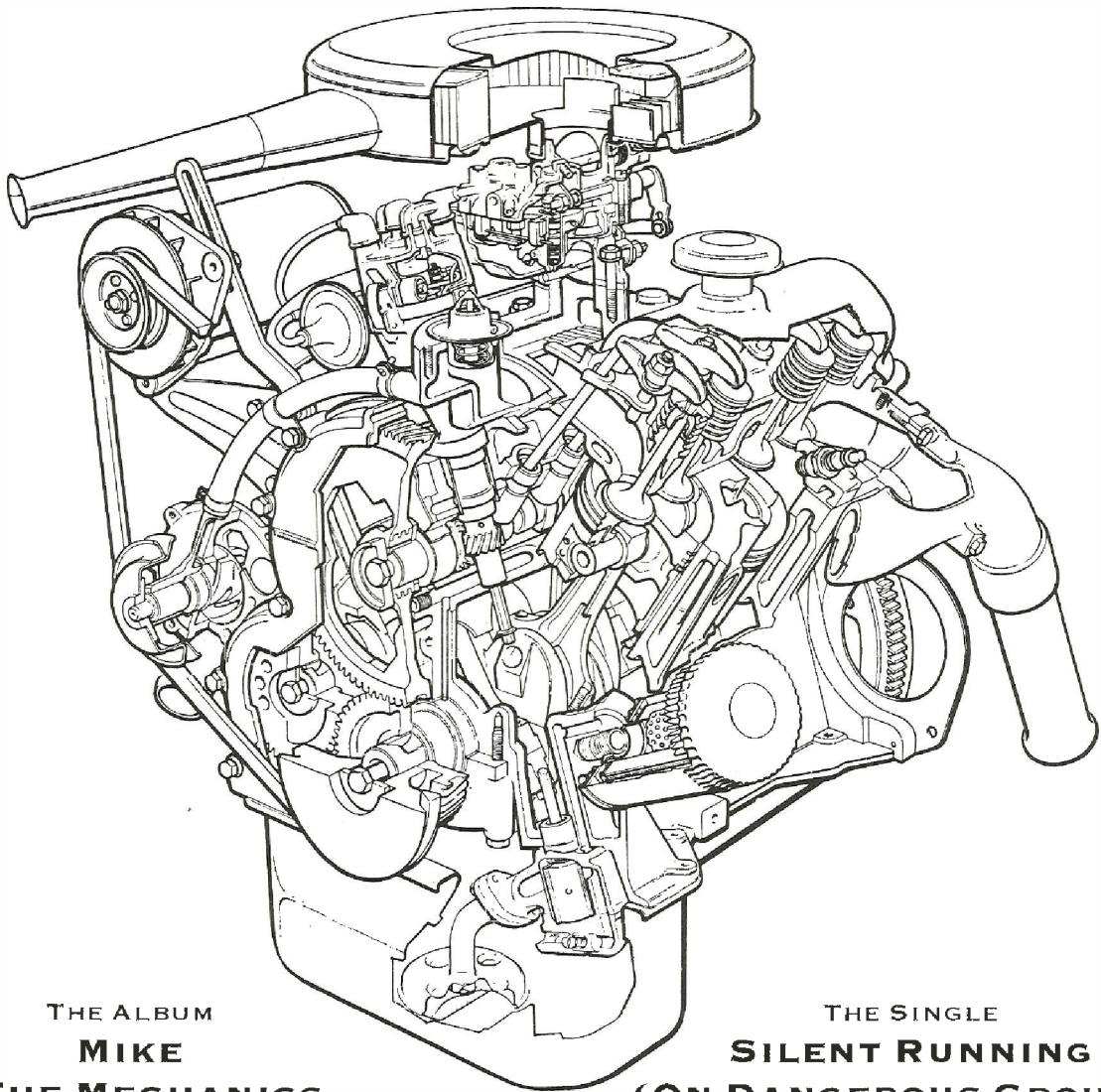
6TH FRENCH CHANNEL

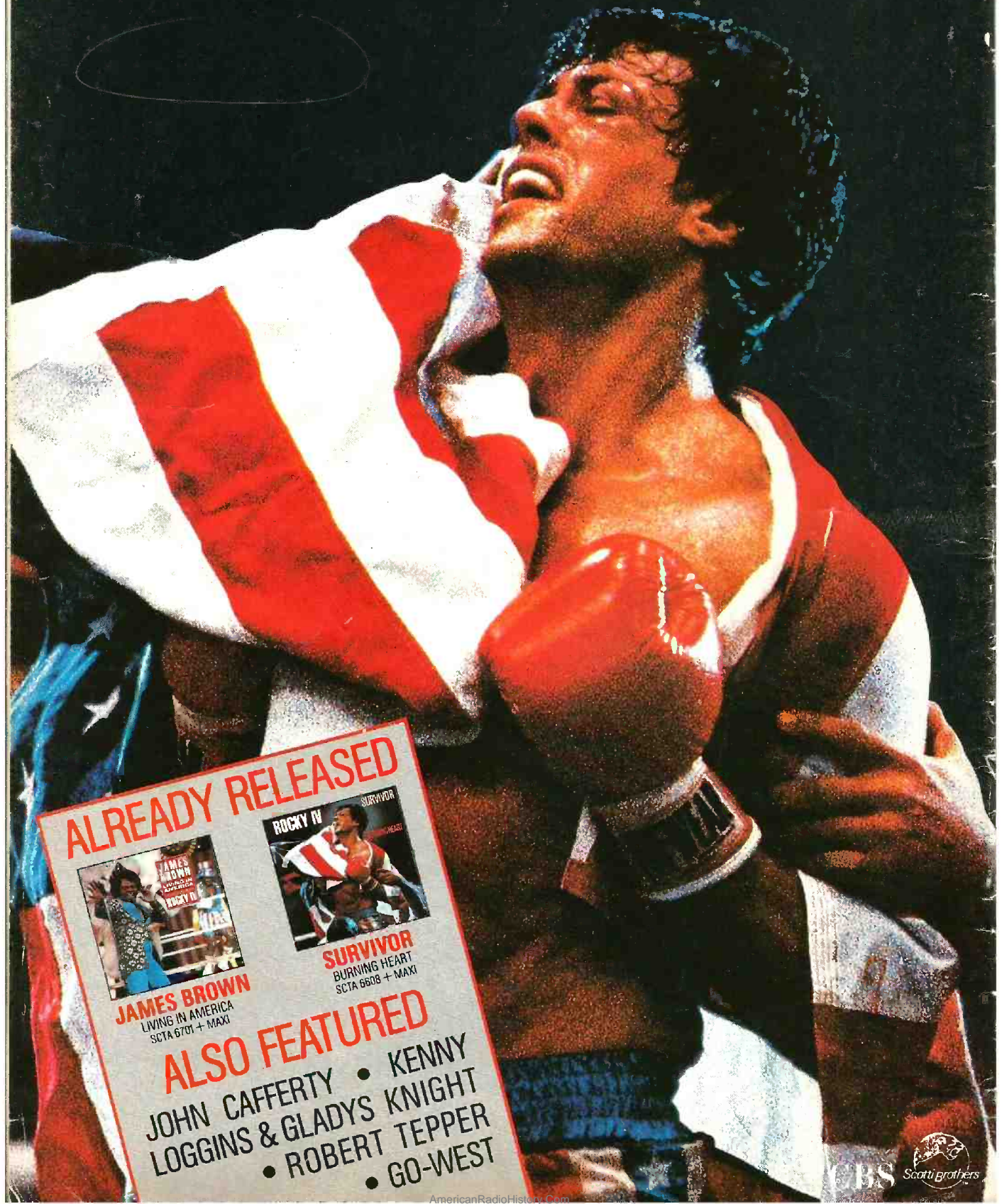

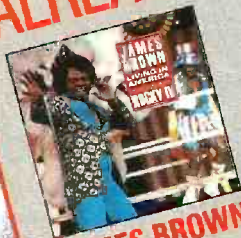

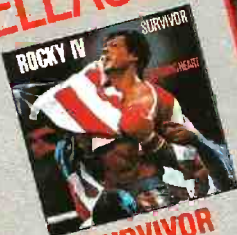

UK CO'S JOIN FORCES

by Peter Jones & Nick Robertshaw

A concerted effort by five major record companies in the U.K., starting in March, to promote modern country music nationwide is predicted to produce spin-off sales effects through other European countries.

It's the first time the British record industry has come up with a generic campaign of this kind. Involved in financing the package are EMI, WEA, MCA, RCA and CBS/Epic, the whole marketing promotion co-ordinated by the Country Music Association's London operation.

A compilation album, featuring tracks by the artists highlighted by the campaign, is to be made available for promotional use through Europe, and it is certain that some of the artists will visit Europe to help make the campaign a success.

Says Cynthia Leu, CMA's European manager: "The main aim is to try and get rid of the old image of country music as performed by cowboys in stetson hats and boots-with-spurs. It's clear the teenage record market is declining and the record companies are looking closely at the over-25 age group.

Through a multi-media campaign, taking in television, radio and press, we're aiming at that market which traditionally is more receptive towards country music.

Momentum for a multi-company campaign started to build in 1984 after a CMA-sponsored survey produced the unexpected finding that country music was second in popularity among musical genres only to pop music itself. But it also found out that country music in its modern styling, performed by artists such as Johnny Cash's daughter Rosanne (CBS), needed strong promotion in order to place it apart from the old "Western cowboy" image.

Artists involved in the promotion include Alabama, Rosanne Cash, Exile, the Judds, Gary Morris, Oak Ridge Boys, Sawyer Brown, George Strait, Don Williams and Hank Williams.

The recent pan-European growth in country popularity is evident by the success of Mervyn Conn in taking his annual Easter weekend Wembley country festival to other countries.

ITALIAN RADIOS JOIN FORCES

MR. MISTER GETS COMBINED CAMPAIGN

In Italy's complex radio system it doesn't happen too often that two radio stations combine their forces in a mutual campaign. Recently however the two major stations Radio Dimensione (from Rome) and Radio DeeJay (Milan) invented a promotion campaign for the American RCA act Mr. Mister who will play at the illustrious San Remo festival February 12-14. It will be the 36th time the festival will take place and Mr. Mister will be one of the

many international stars performing at the televised spectacular.

The first 2 weeks of February continuous publicity jingles will be aired to remind the audience of Mr. Mister's presence at the festival. The following 2 weeks various contests are being organized and 22 winners will be chosen. In order to advertise this campaign, 80,000 circulars will be distributed throughout the schools in Rome and Milan.

Billboard International Music Industry Conference in Athens in May 1982," Timmer said, "I was almost physically attacked for talking such bloody nonsense. But I'm sure I don't need to tell you who are in the record retailing business what a tremendous success story the CD has been - and will continue to be."

Polygram's Hannover plant, which will become part of the Philips Du Pont PDO joint venture when the formal agreement between the two companies is signed in Eindhoven on March 24, is currently producing 5,000 CD titles for 280 labels. Eighty per cent of its

CD production is exported and the balance between classical and popular repertoire is at present 60/40 in favour of classical music.

The Hannover plant currently has a total capacity of 105 million sound carriers annually - 10 million singles, 30 million LPs and 12-inch singles, 20 million cassettes and 34 million CDs. The daily value of its output at dealer value is 7.3 million marks - and that represents 300,000 hours of music manufactured every day. By far the biggest selling CD worldwide to date is the Dire Straits album, Brothers In Arms which has sold in excess of 640,000 units.

system not only as an audio-video carrier but as a high density storage medium. "It also has a future as a videoclip carrier which could ultimately replace the black single. We can have a CD single which would have a 15 minute audio track and a 5 minute video track carrying the clip.

"I also believe that the laser-read videodisc is the prime future carrier for feature films because of its high definition picture and excellent sound quality. This means that videotape will be used principally as a time-shift device, that rental of video film features will decline and that the videodisc will become an increasingly important sales item."

Says Beerling, noting growing influences from continental European countries in today's pop world: "We'll buy in concert material from countries other than the U.S., providing the price is competitive and the music quality is there."

But though BBC 1 is getting its own VHF transmission at long last, Beerling feels the station is held back by needletime restrictions which permit him just 83.5 hours of commercial discs out of a total 126 hours weekly on air.

A very strong melodic pop song by this Norwegian duo, named after a poem of Robert Browning. Single appeared originally on the Scandinavian Easter Productions label but is now picked up by Virgin UK. Dave Allen (producer of The Cure's latest LP) did the remodelling and the result is fresh, original and highly addictive.

Sound of Music - One More Lonely Night (Alpha Records) Sweden

A very commercial single, aiming at the mainstream Top 40 market. Strong vocals in a synthesizer-dominated production. A sound evoking comparisons with Abba, which isn't surprising since the son of Abba's Benny Andersson, Peter Gronvall, produces and writes most of the songs for SOM and nearly plays all the instruments. SOM is one of the 3 acts that Alpha has for the Swedish finals for the Eurovision Song Contest. If they win, they could take Europe by storm.

Randy Bishop - Two Hearts On The Loose (Aura Records) UK
publ. The Grand Pasha. Master owner: Aura, tel. 1-7413197.

A very powerful offering from this Portland, Oregon born musician. Both in looks and music, a strong resemblance to Bryan Adams; a hook-laden song, a killer production (Spencer Proffer) and a line-up of good musicians like Earl Slick (Bowie's fretman) and Frankie Banalli (Quiet Riot). Not mere imitation of American AOR, but with just the right mix of familiar ingredients to create an exciting song: a hit.

Pernilla Wahlgren - Love On You (Alpha Records) Sweden.

Commercial MOR pop produced by Chris Porter (known for his works with Wham!), this week new at 13 in the Swedish charts. The songs lean on a slight reggae-tinged rhythm supporting a bright sing-a-long chorus, certainly appealing for the Benelux and Germany. The writer of the song, Simon Darlow, worked for UK duo Dollar and recently on the latest Grace Jones album.

Juan Ban - Con Las Luces Apagadas (Discos Victoria) Spain.

Dutch indie Megadisc with the first release of Amsterdam body artist Richenel, who plays, both in visuals and in lyrics with the man/woman images. Too eccentric for Top 40 programmers, but a must for those on the look out for something different. UK indie 4AD will release and the master and publ. is available on the Continent excl. Benelux.

Kent - Cosimo Liparti (Barclay) France

A very pretty and good natured party melody, with an effective accordion and some clear vocals. The best track from the mini-album Embalao, from this audio-visual French artist Kent, who also designed the inner sleeve. Joachim Witt - Moonlight (D.G.G.) Germany.

Monique Emmen - Music Box

Monique Emmen is the presenter of *Time Out For Holland*, an ID TV - Music Box Co-production, broadcast every Thursday at 11.00, 17.00 and 23.00.

"Apart from the usual hits and clips, our purpose is to spotlight internationally unknown Dutch groups and help them by giving them the chance to do a clip which they couldn't afford to do themselves. Also we tape a lot of live concerts and my favourite so far is the Blues Rock festival in Tegelen featuring a.o. Ivy & The Terrace Stones. People living out of Holland like the show too as we receive so many letters and fanmail. I'm very interested in today's music and I enjoy informing people about it since music after all influences people a great deal. Concerning *Time Out For Holland* we plan to alter the form of presentation, doing it with a new humorous view, creating funny characters, adding sketches. All of this and more if the future budget allows us to.

As for Euro-crossover groups, I'm still very fond of already established groups like Mai Tai, excellent singers combined with trendy music, and *Time Bandits*, all good musicians complemented by the unusual voice of lead singer and composer Alides Hidding (who is at the moment busy writing stuff for Julio Iglesias). They are really good and therefore already recognized by audiences in several countries throughout the world. Another not so well known group that really deserves some international attention is *Media*. I found their single "Under Your Wings" astonishing. In my opinion *Mr. Mister* is capable of establishing itself throughout Europe as one of the superbands during the rest of the 80's and *Simply Red* and *Feargal Sharkey* could be very big in the States. Amongst my personal faves are *Hail and Oats*, *Prince*, *Tina Turner* and *The Tubes*. The greatest clip ever for me is *Special AKA* with "What I Like Most About You", really funny!"

UNITED KINGDOM

A-Ha for the 2nd week at 1 closely followed by the surprise hit of this year, Nana Mouskouri's *Only Love*. *Walk of Life* sticks at 3 and after having hit the UK top 10 8 times last year (!), Madonna collects her first Top 10 UK single with *Borderline*, from The First Album. After entering last week at 28, Billy Ocean brings his theme to The Jewel Of The Nile up to no. 6. More dramatic moves for Sarah Brightman & Steve Harley's *The Phantom Of The Opera* (12-21), James Brown (19-31), Clannad & Bono (20-29) and Whitney Houston (23-36). Simple Minds have at the moment 3 singles charted in the UK: *Sanctify Yourself* new at 17, *Alive And Kicking* at 99 and *Don't You at 77*. 2nd best entry for Ozzy Osbourne with his single *Shot In The Dark* new at 29.

GERMANY

Despite the ban, Falco's Jeanny holds at 1 (and his LP at 2). CBS act Muenchener Freiheit is up to no. 2 putting *West End Girls* back to no. 3. Straight in the Top 10 come A-Ha (5-21) and another Top 10 entry for Bronski Beat (8-14). The Rocky theme *Burning Heart* by Survivor moves up to 16 (from 23) followed by Dire Straits' *Walk Of Life* (17-33). Highest entry for local production Karel Gott & Darinka- Fang Das Licht (30). Other entries for Max-Him (Italian disco on Zyx), Collins & Martin, C.C. Catch, Billy Ocean, Sade and WEA act Paso Doble.

FRANCE

A new no. 1 as Papa Chanteur replaces Jean-Jacques Goldman's *Je Te Donne* from the no. 1 spot. Papa Chanteur is a lovely chanson and we even heard it on the Dutch NOS Avondspits from Frits Spits. While Pierre Bachelet (*L'An 2001*), A-Ha and C. Jérôme

maintain their positions from last week, Maria Magdalena shoots up the French charts everywhere and is this week at no. 6 (from 9). Italian production *I'm A Lover* is a breaker as well (8-11) and the single is a hit in Belgium as well. Further good moves for Sting, Noe Willer (*Femme Publique*), The Communards (21-31), The Cure (32-43), Kate Bush (33-41) and Wham! (new at 48).

HOLLAND

After a long domination by Elton John's Nikita Feargal Sharkey has finally taken over and moved to the top in the Dutch chart. Mr. Mister is now completely 'broken' and moves up with a bullet to no. 3 while the Pet Shop Boys follow at 4. The Dutch are very keen on the Clemons & Browne corporation. *You're A Friend Of Mine* moves up from 9 to 7. The Madonna-like *Baby Talk* by Alisha is another mover (8-11) as are Anita Meyer & Lee Towers (the two popular singers in Holland in a love duet), Billy Ocean (10-15), the Italian tv tune (Discoring) *We Just* by Moses, female trio Mai Tai with *Female Intuition* from 25 to 14 and the Jamaican reggae topper *Girlie Girlie* by Sophia George in a good move from 26 to 16. Highest entry for the 'Those Where The Days'-inspired *Moscow Nights* by Anya. Anya plays Nikita in the Elton John video.

AUSTRIA

Sportstars making pop records seems to be the fashion in Austria. Hans Orsolecs (ex-European box champion in 1972) is in the top with *Mea Patsch Erbs Leben* (My Unlikely Life) and Hans Krankl (football star) has with his *Lonely Boy* a chart topper as well, so reports Walter Groebchen of OE3. Other chart busters for Falco, Jennifer Rush and STS.

SPAIN

Stevie Wonder continues his chart supremacy with *Part Time Lover* already for 11 weeks at no. 1! Apart from Stevie, especially Madonna's *Groove* and Propaganda's *P. Machinery* are the top sellers in Spain. The biggest move in the Spanish chart is Bruce Springsteen's *Janey, Don't You Lose Heart*, the B-side of *I'm Goin' Down*, a single not released in all European countries. It moves up this week from 16 to 4. Another good move for local act Sergio Y Estibaliz with their *Cantimero De Cuba* (5-12). Sandra is doing very well with her first single *Maria Magdalena* moving up from 22 to 13 while Arcadia's *Election Day* follows straight after (14-19).

SWEDEN

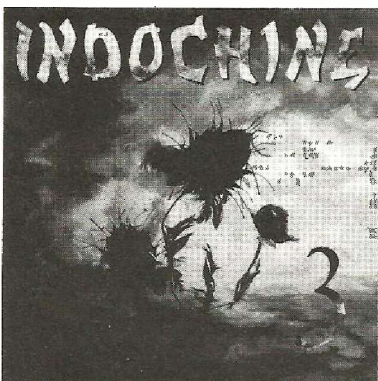
Lionel Richie stays at 1 and he is followed by the Swedish act Imperiet and Jennifer Rush's *Power Of Love*. Starship make a good move to 6 (from 9) and Elton John hits Top 10 (10-12). Highest entry for Pete Townshend at 15 and other entries include Mr. Mister and the Italian H-NRG production *Tonight* by Ken Lazlo.

NORWAY

Three soloists hit the top in Norway being Lionel Richie, Elton John, and Bryan Adams (still with his *Christmas Time* song). Other popular singles include Jennifer Rush (*Power Of Love*), West End Girls and the second A-Ha single.

On the album front it is Jennifer Rush's first album that tops the album chart followed by Elton John, A-Ha and Bryan Adams.

This album is already out for a few months but has become topical again due to the release of the new single *Jeme Sexe*, a strong song with a driving beat and a pleasant course. On tracks like *Cannery Bay* and *A L'Assaut* this solid mix of new wave and rock is continued. Check 'em out!



Joachim Witt - Moonlight Nights- DGG Germany
The German new wave rocker recently changed labels and henceforth a change in style: from casual new wave to contemporary Top 40. English lyrics will certainly help. The whole album breathes a very international atmosphere. Best tracks: *Cool Down*, *Moonlight* and *How Will I Know*.



Kent - Embalao- Barclay France
The track *Cosmo Liparti* is one of our favourites in the New Talent section. His music seems to be a logical extension of his abilities as a cartoonist: funny and comic pop music with a lot of musical 'gags'. Check out good natured tracks like *On Veut Des Heros* and *Barmileke*.

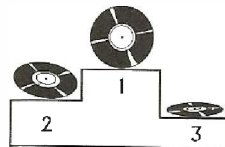



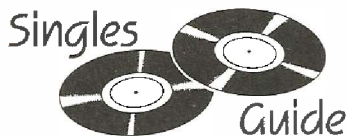

After the Norwegians ruled the Hot 100 for 9 weeks, this week Russians have taken over the power in Europe. It took **Sting** exactly 8 weeks to achieve this feat. The competition however is strong with **Mr. Mister** moving from 6 to 3, coinciding with their European promotour and the second **A-Ha** single also moving up 3 places and definitely bound for higher positions the coming week. Chart action continues with both **Dire Straits** and **Talk Talk** hitting Top 10 this week.

Apart from moving up 3 places in the Hot 100, Mr. Mister have their new single *Kyrie* entering the Airplay Top 50 at 28 (highest entry this week) and to top it all, they have again for the second week best played single in Europe leaving **A-Ha** and **Pet Shop Boys** behind.

Film themes are doing very well this week with **Billy Ocean's** *When The Going* moving up to 13 (from 48) and the two **Rocky IV** themes making dramatic moves as well: **James Brown's** *Living In America* is already up to 14 (from 34) and the obvious hit track *Burning Heart* by **Survivor** beating in as this week's highest entry at 19.

After their smashes *Don't You* and *Alive* and *Kicking Simple Minds* are back again with the big beats, *Sanctify Yourself* as 2nd highest entry at 42. As expected **England** and the **Benelus** were the first to chart the single in its first week and no doubt the rest of Europe will follow next week.

This is definitely the season of re-releases and covers (see London Calling section) and one record that has good chances of doing better the second time around is the **Mike & The Mechanics** track *Silent Running*, now being re-promoted to tie in with the upcoming film *Dangerous Ground* in which it features. Another re-issue for the 7 piece London-based band **Latin Quarter** signed to **Rockin Horse Records**, distributed by **Arista**. The *Radio Africa* single in fact dates from September '84 when it was released on the band's own **Ignition** label.

The **Costello Show** (yes, **Elvis Costello**) have a very popular single in the UK at the moment with a moody rendition of the 1965

Animals track *Don't Let Me Be Misunderstood*, produced by **Texan Henry (F-Bone) Burnett**. It is also worth checking the b-side as well, *Baby's Got A Brand New Hairdo*, typically **Costello** up-tempo Mersey pop. The 12" features as a bonus the c&w-tinged *Get Yourself A Fool*, produced by **Nick Lowe**.

With the love duet between **Phil Collins & Marilyn Martin** moving up the Hot 100 this week to 28 (from 44), **Martin** now comes up with her own single on **Atlantic Records** entitled *Night Moves*. The single is definitely not a continuation of the sound on *Separate Lives* as this single features a vocal cross section between **Pat Benatar** and **Olivia Newton-John**; a very strong AOR- based song that could do very well in Europe.

Johnny Rotten's group **Public Image Limited (PIL)** release their first single for over 2 years entitled *Rise*. The single was recorded in the **New York Powerstation Studio** and produced by **Bill Laswell**. **Mr. Lydon** is expected to visit Europe for promotional work very soon.

Very good reactions for *What You Need* the second single from the **Listen Like Thieves** album by the **Australian INXS**. This rough and funky track gets good reactions in Europe and enters the **Airplay Top 50** at 43.

To tie in with the current success of **Whitney Houston**, **Asylum** released the old slow and soulful duet of her with **Teddy Pendergrass**, *Hold Me*.
