## UK RECORD INDUSTRY ON THE UP

The April-June quarter for the British record industry has "moved forward to the levels of growth experienced over the past two years", according to British Phonographic Industry (BPI). After a relatively flat period over the first three months of the year, sales are now up 17% at \$2.1 million pounds compared with 70 million pounds in the same time last year.

BPI says single sales in particular appear to have made a good recovery with unit sales up 3%. According to Gallup figures, the ratio between 7" and 12" singles retail sales was 69 to 31, similar to the position in the second quarter of 1985.

## Launch Of UK Radio 1 Rival Radio 1½ To Play 60's/70's Classics

station, and has had talks with possible interested parties including UK record company heads.

Mike Read, The Radio One disc jockey who recently revealed plans to launch a rival station playing pop classics of the '60s and '70s, has been offered £1 million backing by businessman Tim Hudson, formerly manager of England cricket star Ian Botham.

Says Hudson: "I've got the money and I'm willing to invest. I think the idea is a winner, and I agree with Mike Read that there is a vast opening in the market for this sort of music. I listen to Radio Two and all I get to hear is Nat King Cole. I'd really like a station where I could hear some old Bob Dylan or J0cc."

He has also approached the BBC itself, but the Corporation says there is no question of it adopting the plan. Now Read intends to go to the rival Independent Broadcasting Authority for

support, a move which it is thought may jeopardise his position at Radio One. If the scheme comes to fruition, it is also believed that he may try to persuade fellow Radio One disc jockeys Simon Bates, Anne Nightingale, Dave Lee Travis and Steve Wright to join him.

## Pirates To Return To North Sea

Pirate radio ships may soon make a comeback in the North Sea. The MV Communicator, former floating home of Radio Laser, has been refitted by new owner Ray Anderson, and the Nansen, also known as Stereo Hits 576, has acquired two stereo transmitters while in the Spanish port of Santander, where Radio Caroline's Ross Revenge was also converted.

Anderson, who sells Radio Caro-

line merchandise, bought the MV Communicator in April this year after it was impounded by the UK authorities. "We're planning to keep it as a radio station," he says, "but we'll sell it somewhere it can be used legally."

The Nansen, meanwhile, is to be sold to an undisclosed buyer and will reportedly broadcast two American-managed stations, one a Laser-style rock station, the other devoted to black music.

## Dutch Record Event '86 To Maximise On Budget Turner, Rush In Live Gala

Amsterdam - The sixth edition of the annual Dutch Ten Days' Record Event will be held October 8-18. It's an initiative of the Dutch Ten Days' Record Event Foundation, headed by Jan Gaasterland, a former highrank employee of EMI. The event is being supported by all Dutch record companies and the majority of Holland's record retailers.

The main aim of the event is to increase the sales of recorded music: albums, music-cassettes and Compact Discs. With a budget of 1.5 million Dutch guilders a varied promotion campaign has been set up, which will

mainly aim at consumers of 25 years and older. Says the foundation's spokeswoman: "They are the people, who can spend money on sound-carriers".

The campaign includes all kinds of display material for the record retailers and advertising in the national, regional and local daily newspapers. People, who buy recorded music at a price of 27.50 Dutch guilders (H US\$ or more, get a free premium album or music-cassette.

A total of 300,000 copies of that premium album and 100,000 m.c.'s will be manufactured, entitled "Warm (advertisement)

Aanbevolen" (Highly Recommended'). The album/m.c. features 14 acts, including Don Williams, Willie Nelson, Billy Ocean, Astrud Gilberto, James Last, Chris Rea and Cock Robin and Dutch celebrities like Gerard Joling and Frank Ashton. All 14 acts will be featured in full-colour in a special music magazine, which will be printed in a circulation of 400,000 copies.

To create maximum interest in the record event and its premiums, 15 radio commercials of 30 seconds each and 8 television commercials of 25 seconds each will be transmitted October 2-18.

As usual the record event includes

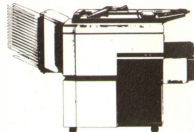

## TVS PROMOTES SAT DISHES

TVS, the UK independent to contractor which recently acquired Bernard Chey's Midem Organisation for £4.9 million, is backing the launch of a new network of satellite antenna dealers across the country.

The idea comes from Bristol-based Satellite Technology Systems, in which TVS has a 47% stake, and is intended both to generate sales of reception dishes and stimulate interest in satellite TV generally.

Receiving equipment costs currently start at around £1,100 but are expected to fall by 50% within the next two years as demand grows. At the moment viewers with dishes can pick up 17 stations on the Intelsat and ECS-

satellites, but the number should rise to almost 30 by the end of the decade. Commercial and educational users are also likely to show strong interest.

decline and the lp volume fell by 6% to 97 million units. Value fell 4% to a turnover figure of 25.3 million which reflects a minor increase in average trade prices.

Cassette sales also recorded a fall in the second quarter with prices down 1%. However, the gap between cassette and lp sales has widened considerably, with tape deliveries to the trade over 3 million pieces ahead of lp discs. For the first time cassettes contributed higher revenue than discs.

Compact discs continued their steady rise with nearly 1.5 million being delivered in the period, on target for the predicted year-end total of 6 million units. CD prices have increased on average 8%. In the past year, 54% of the industry's revenue has been achieved by CD sales and more than 11% of all turnover has come from CD's.

Total revenue from all formats in the first half of the year was 154 million pounds, an increase of 10.4% over last year's figures.

"I started the programme 'Rock-department' five years ago with features on young new Swedish rock bands intermingled with demo's, interviews, etc. At the moment the programme is produced by Marianne Christenson and I deliver many interview specials for them. At university I studied journalism, where I learnt to set up proper research and interviews. For 'Rockdepartment' I produce one hour specials, mostly twice a month, which takes me a lot of research and travel. The emphasis is mostly on Anglo-American artists, in particular those artists who have something to tell and have been around for a long time. I produced specials on Tom Waits, Sting, Bryan Ferry, Robert Plant, Gino Vanelli and lately Van Morrison, which is unique because he hasn't done an interview for years. The IMMC in Montreux was a wonderful opportunity to interview many artists. I try to make those specials not only on the terms dictated by the record business, but try to concentrate on the personality of the artist. I think the record industry centers too much on trends and fashions and radio and tv seem to reflect such an attitude. On



the average, press is better and, consequently, more independent.

The European market is still too much influenced by the US and the Pan-European market as such is still not really natural, it is more a created concept. The US is one nation, we are 25. At the same time this explains why Swedish local bands have such problems in crossing over. They remain local, if they were from English territories, many of them would have been successful. Take for example Mats Ronander, once the Abba guitar player on their US tour, now a solo artist in his own right. He is extremely talented, but writes in his native language and therefore never makes any impact abroad, which is a crying shame."

Berlin-Private companies RTL-Plus and SAT have recently seen their audience ratings increased on the Berlin cable and entered a direct competition with the public service channel ARD and ZDF. ## VIDEO DIRECTOR PROFILE MGM's MANIC MONTH

This is the first in a series of spotlights on video producers and directors and tv producers. These will focus on the art of video making, specific techniques and new development in television.

Clive Richardson- Video Director, Richardson Films, London  
Clive Richardson is director of his own video production company, Clive Richardson's Films, which he manages alongside producer Melissa Stokes. Richardson moved from the Chelsea School of Art where he studied sculpture to the Royal College of Arts where he immersed himself in an environment media and from there to video art.

After a few years building stage sets for bands and four years travelling with Yes, he started in video production in 1976 and has since been prominent for around 60 videoclips.

Richardson is best known for his Depeche Mode video promos including the latest 'A Question Of Lust' and he also shot a one hour film of one of their concerts in Hamburg. He has directed 8 of Siouxsie and The Banshees' clips as well as others for Fleet Of Seagulls, Blancmange, Marillion, Tears For Fears, Bonnie Tyler, Steve Winwood and Kid Creole.

"I tend to do a lot of mixing in my videos, what we call in the trade 'same-ing', short for non-additive mixing. This basically means I mix three or four images and choreograph them together by overlaying the different images. One which I personally feel to be my best and which shows this particular technique is Depeche Mode's 'People Are People' filmed on a battleship on the Thames in London.

Siouxsie Depeche Mode's sound concentrates on the synthetic with their emphasis on keyboard playing. I use a video fairlight machine which is a video synthesizer. I feed a lot of different sounds into the synthesizer, take out different sounds and key things on to it.

I still believe that performance pieces are amongst the most valuable of videos today and I think that anima-



tion is a fad of the moment, a fashion which will soon be outdated.

Video directors should always work closely with the musicians and when this happens the combination of a good track with a good clip should have the ability to double the impact of the record. Clips certainly aren't detrimental to music but are an art form in their own right. With both sound and vision interacting, there is great potential around.

On average I take between two and three weeks to complete a videoclip. I am at the moment working on a clip to Craiff's 'You're The Best Thing In My Life' at Bavaria Productions, in Munich."

The new Thompson Twins' single, 'Nothing In Common', the title track from a new film to be released by TriStar Pictures, has a clip to accompany it, directed by Merrit Ayres of Midnight Films. The video is divided into three parts: live performances by the Thompson Twins in Chicago, clips from the film and shots of the Thompson Twins with Tom Hanks.

Nicholas Brand of Fugate Films has also been very prolific, directing no less than 4 videos in only 6 weeks. His latest for 'Tina Turner's 'Gone With The Marble' was shot at Stone Park in the UK over 24 hours and includes forward and reverse motion footage.

Also at Fugate, Christopher Robin Collins has just completed directing the promo clip for Five Star's 'Rain Or Shine' \*

Steven Lanhoff of Electric Rainbow Productions, has directed his 2nd video for D. & The M.C.s. He was responsible for 'Spirit In The Sky' and has now just completed the promo clip for their latest, 'Burn'. Lanhoff mainly works in documentaries and has done a lot of directing in the States. He has worked on pop videos for MTV in New York and has recently completed a documentary on the psychedelic 'Revival In The '80s' for MTV \*

MGM has been busy with several hot new videos. Bryan Grant has directed the video for Tina Turner's new single 'Typical Male' for Capitol Records. Matt Forrest was responsible for Daryl Hall's 'Dreamtime', Russell Mulcahy has been working in LA on Billy Joel's 'A Matter Of Trust', David Mallet has done AC/DC's new single 'You Shook Me All Night Long' and Jim Yukich directed Genesis' latest, 'I Don't Deep' \*

Duncan Gibbins of Jump Productions has just completed the video promo to the new Communards' single 'Don't Leave Me This Way'. Filmed in a warehouse at the Victoria docks in London it had a massive 200 extra and was rumored to have cost between £60,000 and £80,000 pounds \*

## NEW TALENT UPDATE

This column will give a weekly update on the progression of M&M New Talent Tips in Europe

The most successful Dutch local product storming into Europe is MC Miker G & DJ Sven's *Holiday Rap*, a rap version of Madonna's *Holiday*, out on the Dutch record label Dureco. Currently no. 1 both in Belgium and Holland and already selling over 120,000 copies in the Benelux alone. In Germany the single was highest entry last week at 37 (released through the indie Rush Records) and in France the airplay is exploding (out on Carriere). It is a typical example of a summer hit, many holiday goers heard the single in the discos/benches, especially in southern France and Spain. Master now only available for Greece and Portugal!

We are very pleased to see Virgin France's *Rita Mitsouko* finally getting a release in the UK as well. It was already M&M's long time favourite way back in March 1985 and apart from the UK, there is also very strong interest in the United States. Sire Records released the single and 12" to a very good response and the accompanying video has already been bought by New York's Museum Of Modern Art!

M&M's New Talent tip *Trio Rio* (see issue 28/29) are enjoying lots of success in Germany at the moment. The single *New York-Rio-Tokyo* is no. 7 on the Media Control airplay hit parade and the album already entered the European Hot 100 Albums due to its high entry in the Germany album charts last week. Dutch radio station AVRO already added their bossa-nova tinged pop single to their playlist.

M&M's New Talent tip of 27, Figgo with their cheerful poppy tune *Maikaefer* will release the English version of this song, entitled *Wanted Dead Or Alive*, through Carriere beginning of October. The record will be out in France, Belgium and Luxembourg (Carriere) as well as in The Netherlands through CNR. The group will record their new single *Rumgeschutt* end of this month.

The amazing fact happens this week that 2 of Modern Talking's singles move into the European Top 10. Due to the good sales *Brother Louie* is enjoying in the UK, it zooms from 13 to 8, even improving on the position it earlier achieved 2 months ago when it stuck at 9. *Atlantis Is Calling* follows straight after it due to the sales increase in France and steady positions in other European markets. Apart from *A-Ha*, never before in the chart history of M&M, has a Continental European act succeeded in having 2 singles charted at the same time in the European Top 10. The Norwegians reached this feat in February this year when both *Babe On A Bear* and *The Sun Always Shines On TV*, stayed 4 consecutive weeks in the Top 10, reaching high positions of resp. 1 and 10.

Lots of good singles out this week to make up for a lively European Airplay Top 50 the following weeks. Paul Simon releases his first single for a long time entitled *You Can Call Me Al*, from his upcoming album, scheduled for the fall (WEA will organize a European press meeting on this new release end of this month in London). The single carries a complicated pattern of different rhythms, from African to Caribbean, coupled with a very good hook. Certainly not one of his easiest ones to programme but sure to pick up lots of radio reactions the coming weeks.

Ex-Mat Bianco singer Basia is getting considerable UK airplay at the moment with her Portrait single *Prime Time TV*. Although very much in the same vein as Matt Bianco's cocktail-pop bag, the single is sure to sit fire to a lot of Continental European radio playlists as well.

Another Record Of The Week for Andy Taylor's *Take It Easy*. After Arcadia, The Power Station and John Taylor's 'I Do What I Do', one more solo venture or splinter that Duran Duran has propelled. Taken from the OST American Anthem and produced by Roy Thomas Baker, the sound gears towards hard rock with its square hooks and heavy guitars.

More hard-hitting power from Brooklyn trio Run DMC on a P. Profile/London single *Walk This Way*. With additional help from Steve Taylor and Joe Perry (from Aerosmith) the single displays an amazing mix of hardcore guitar overtones, rap vocals and a blasting production. A

definite winner!

Killing Joke release their first single for over a year through EG/Virgin entitled *Adorations*. With its brooding, black atmosphere and guitars upfront, the single is assured of good exposure on Euro-radio.

The Stranglers, another survivor from the punk boom, release a new single on Epic, *Nice In Nice*, after a one and a half year's gap. Taken from their upcoming album 'Drumtime', this punchy single continues along the lines of their earlier works and could bring them back on the map.

A&M UK new signing Thrashing Doves collect another M&M Sure Hit with their TR-influenced glossy pop single *Matchstick Formula*.

More Sure Hits for Anna Domino's *Summer*.

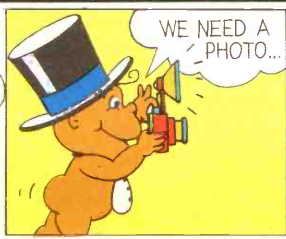

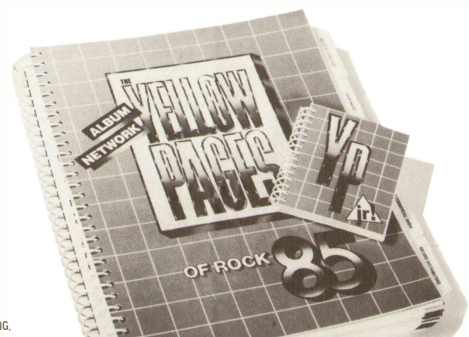

## HAPPY ENDING

Happy ending or a new beginning? Daryl Hall sounds more confident than ever on his second solo album *Three Hearts In The Happy Ending Machine*. Whether this is a happy ending from his long time partner Oates or a happy beginning as a full time recording solo artist is still an open question but who cares if there's so much strong material to choose from. Produced by Hall, Dave Stewart and Tom "Bone" Wolk, Hall has chosen for a more study slant than the blue-eyed pop on the Hall & Oates works. Euro-radio will certainly click on tracks like *Only A Vision*, *Footish Pride*, *Someone Like You* and *What's Gonna Happen To Us* (watch the beautiful guitar-solo from Pretenders' Robbie McIntosh). Hall's talent as a composer and singer combined with the right type of production make this an outstanding and perfect album that is sure to pick up lots of attention.

The European airwaves will be heated by yet another hot album release, that of the eagerly anticipated 3rd album by Lionel Richie, *Dancing On The Ceiling*. The album kicks off with the title track, already on its way to the top of the European Top 50 Airplay and it is immediately followed by another single contender, the convivial calypso-pop of *St. Lu*. The album is simply abundant with quality songs. *Balama & The Angel* is a sweet and salty ballad in the best Richie tradition, while side 2 opens with *Deep River Woman*, a gospel-blues influenced ballad. After *'St. Lu'*, another likely single candidate is *Love Will Conquer All*, a lovely, slightly teasing late-night dance song. Look out for massive consumer reaction next week!

Virgin UK released a compilation of *Heaven 17's* best hits entitled *Endless*. A cassette version

only, it is the best introduction we can think of for those who are not acquainted with their superb material. A wonderful mix featuring his like *Le Me Go*, *Temptation*, *He Don't Need This Fascist Groove Thing*, *Crushed By The Wheels Of Industry* and new versions of *Let's All Make A Bomb* and *Song With No Name*. Intriguing and very danceable music that never received the consumer response in Continental Europe that they were fully entitled to.

After four years silence, *Bonnie Raitt* is back on Warner Brothers with a new album, *Nine Lives*. A brooding mix of r & b and contemporary pop as exemplified in the Bryan Adams/Imi Yallance written *No Way To Treat A Lady*, *Who But A Fool*, *Excited* and the romantic *Angel*.

The Swedish trio *Sound Of Music*, led by Peter Grolland (the son of ABBA's Benny Andersson) have just released their debut album to unanimous acclaim from the Swedish press. "The best Abba pop since ABBA", was the headline in one of Scandinavia's largest dailies. Light weighted, well produced sounds, directly aiming at the top 40 mainstream market. Ask Alpha Records for a copy and listen to tracks like *Dazzle Light*, *One More Lonely Night* and *West Indies Nights* and you'll find out what we mean.

*Tena Marie* started her career on Motown, where she met "the best boy of punk funk" Rick James, who further boosted her career. Her new album *Emerald City* was written, arranged, produced and performed by Marie alone and the result is amazing: bright, shimmering and percussive dance fun!

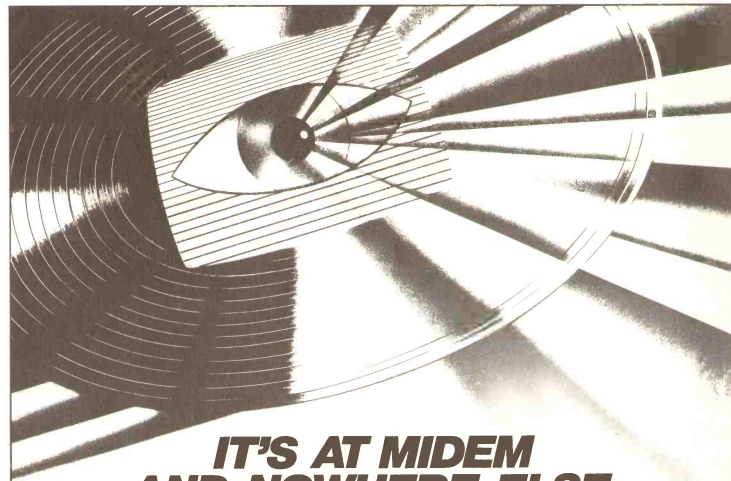

UK'S BPI FORMS  
COMMITTEE WITH MU

The British Photographic Industry (BPI) and the Musicians' Union have agreed on the formation of a joint Standing Review Committee, which will meet regularly to handle disputes and ways in which the record industry and the musicians can further co-operate.

"This reflects and reinforces the generally good relations between the two," says BPI.

Agreement has been reached on new session fees for musicians working on recordings. As from July 1, the going rate for a three-hour session rises by 37% in the UK to £55 (previously £52).

Schlager Festival '86 Gets

Amsterdam: Nineteen acts have been signed for the 15th edition of the annual Schlager Festival, which will be held September 5-6 at the Roda Hall

All acts of this year's festival will be featured on a double album, which will be released by Arcade in the first week of September. "To create maximum interest in the LP, 13 television commercials of 20 seconds each will be transmitted.

And in November Arcade will release another double album, featuring acts who have performed at the festival in the past 15 years.

This year's festival will result in a 135 minutes television special, to be transmitted by Dutch national broadcasting organization TROS, September 15th.

The Belgian BRT-2 will pay attention to the festival with two one hour television specials, the French language RTL-plus with a 135 minutes radio special and the German station Deutsche Welle also with a special.
