ZDF Pop Programme Ariola Tops German Changes Policy Best Sellers List

Mainz: The monthly German programme "ZDF Hitparade" has decided to programme non-German language records by local artists. Until now records from artists like Modern Talking and Sandra were not programmed in the monthly show produced by Klaus Weising and presented by Viktor Worms. ZDF chief Wolfgang Penk comments: "This new policy is a logical consequence of a new trend in Germany where more and more local artists are beginning to record their material in English in order to get more promotion possibilities abroad. We want to reflect such a

development." The German Music Publishers Association in Bonn is very disappointed by the decision as it feels that German artists with German language titles are again dominated by foreign lyrics. They point out that 80% of the German charts at the moment are in foreign languages. Ralph Siegel, producer and publisher shares these views with his comments: "I am not very pleased about this decision and I also blame the newly emerged private radio stations for mostly playing international material during 1986."

Last year Ariola Eurodisc was again West Germany's most successful record company, according to the year-end analysis of chart placings conducted by the trade paper "Musikmarkt". The Munich-

based company was responsible for nearly 23% of all singles placed in the charts during 1986 and 19.9% of all albums.

In the singles placings, Ariola

Should The BBC Be Sold Off?

Government Paper On The Future Of British Radio

A forthcoming government Green Paper on the future of British radio is expected to reject the Peacock Committee's recommendation that BBC Radio One and Radio Two should be sold off to the private sector, despite enthusiasm for the idea among some members of Mrs Thatcher's cabinet.

Instead, the discussion document, to be published next month, is likely to encourage competition with the BBC by liberalising the regulatory structure under which Britain's independent local radio stations operate. Specifically this

may mean removing control of commercial radio from the Independent Broadcasting Authority and placing it with the two-year-old Cable Authority, a less powerful body.

Editorial and financial constraints on the I.R. stations, many of which are barely breaking even, will also be eased. More advertising and sponsorship deals will be permitted and the major financial burden of transmitter rental payments to the IBA will be removed by allowing stations to own their own transmitters.

Karnstedt Appointed Country Music Chief

Michael Karnstedt, 43-year-old European head of the international Peer Music publishing companies, based in Hamburg, is the first German music business executive to be elected to the committee of the US Country Music Association (CMA) in Nashville, Tennessee.

He aims to set in motion more concert visits to Europe by the country music superstars. Says Karnstedt, "Artists such as Johnny Cash, Dolly Parton and Kenny Rogers now know that Europe is a vital new stage for their music and they'll make financial concessions in order to tour the most important cities in Germany."

In fact, he says, the great country stars have been visiting Germany for many years, but in near-secrecy. They arrive in Frankfurt on late-night flights to play concerts for the US fans before returning to the States early the following day.

In his role as Vice President of the CMA, Karnstedt says: "We want to get the US stars away from the private party routine. Country music in Germany is a five million dollars a year business. We want to see those stars regularly."

He's also hoping to get German country acts invited to take part in US festivals.

Greek Record Taxes Cut

Loud and forceful protests by record company executives and artists have persuaded the Greek government to reduce the projected hefty level of taxation on discs and prerecorded cassettes from the planned 36% to 18%. Experts are saying this success could well have "saved the record industry" in Greece.

As of January 1, Greek consumers were due to start paying the EEC Value Added Tax and the government originally planned the 36% "luxury goods" rate for recorded music. Major negotiators on behalf of a stunned record indus-

try were Makis Matsas, head of local repertoire giant Minos Records, and Ion Stamboulis, managing director of WEA-Greece.

But the bad news is that the 36% rate applies to stereo equipment, including CD software and hardware. The Greek music industry has been showing signs of improvement after a four-year slump. A survey from the national IFPI branch shows that nationwide sales of records and cassettes in 1985 were up 4% in unit terms and 24% in value over the previous year and that the upward trend has continued through 1986.

Elton John Cancels Performances

Elton John hit the headlines last week when he cancelled all his concerts for the coming year following a throat operation. The announcement came during Elton John's month-long Australian tour. According to a spokesperson for Elton John, the 39-year-old singer has had problems with his throat for some time. An operation is necessary because specialists have not been able to discover the cause of the problem and is expected to take place in Sydney this week.

Last month Elton John cancelled a concert in Perth because of an infection and later he fainted during a performance in Sydney.

Mike's 'Holiday Rap' (Rush), Sam Cooke's 'Wonderful World' (RCA), Samantha Fox's 'Touch Me' (Teldec), Bruce & Bongos 'Geil' (Rush), Europe's 'The Final Countdown' (CBS) and Bananarama's 'Venus' (London).

Sky Channel Withdraws From British Cable Services

Following a meeting with British Cable Services on Friday December 19, Sky Channel has withdrawn its programme service from British Cable Services Networks in the UK. Sky decoders at all BCS Networks were switched off from the control stations in London on December 19.

BCS and Sky have been unable to agree on the terms of a new contract for distribution of Sky Channel, in particular, the BCS proposal that Sky should share a cable channel on many BCS Networks with other unnamed programme services. As a consequence, Sky's programmes were unavailable to the UK's 79,000 subscribers over Christmas.

Sky Changes Playlist

Sky Trax, the musical division of Sky Channel, has decided to broaden the channel's playlist, moving away from the former tight Top 40 format. The move comes following a wish to embrace more contemporary European and US music and to place greater emphasis on hit tv. To enable new artists or tracks which are still hot, but due to space problems have had to make way for newer hits, a new section on the playlist has been created called 'current options'. It is the responsibility of each specific show's producer to include one or two tracks from the current option list in each show.

Relaunching A Legend

Deep Purple Grows Up With New Album

A new Deep Purple album, 'The House Of Blue Light', is released this month and is the band's second LP since their successful comeback three years ago. The new album, produced by the band's bassist Roger Glover, was recorded in Vermont USA during the summer of 1986 and contains songs such as 'Bad Attitude' and 'Call Of The Wild'.

"The title, 'The House Of Blue Light', is taken from the song 'Speed King' on our 'In Rock' album. We thought it sounded right and it gave us a good idea for the cover," explains Deep Purple's vocalist Ian Gillan, "it was the only title all five of us like. All the songs have again been written by Ritchie Blackmore, Roger Glover and myself. We have never felt so relaxed and easy during the recording of an album."

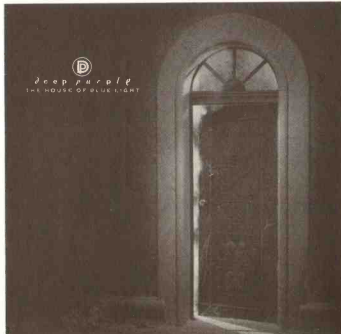
At the end of this month Deep Purple begin the European leg of a new world tour (see dates below). What does Gillan think about the ever-increasing co-operation between European record companies and the media? Gillan, "I think it is a good thing that a kind of 'United States of Europe' is being created. With all these satellite stations this is of course an inevitable development. It's good for us too because now our promotion activities can reach more people at the same time.

Also music lovers no longer have to depend solely on their own countries' radio and television, they can follow musical developments throughout Europe."

Deep Purple was formed in 1968 in England by keyboard player Jon Lord and guitarist Ritchie Blackmore; the original band included drummer Ian Paice, Gillan and Glover, the same formation that makes up today's successful lineup. Deep Purple's first three albums were a reasonable commercial success, especially in the States, and the singles 'Hush' and 'Kentucky Woman' were big hits. In 1970 the band decided to change direction and became more hard-rock oriented releasing the 'Deep Purple In Rock' LP one of the classic rock albums of the 70s.

"Suddenly things moved very fast," Gillan recalls, "we didn't have any spare time left. Everything we touched turned to gold."

After the albums 'Fireball',



'The House Of Blue Light' inspired by the legendary 'In Rock' album is released this month.

'Machine Head' and the extremely successful double LP 'Live In Japan', things started to go wrong for Deep Purple. There were many disagreements within the group and the pressure eventually caused a break-up in 1973.

"There was an amazing amount of money coming in which we had no time to spend in a sensible way so we just let it up, not thinking of the consequences," says Gillan. "At a certain moment it went to our heads and we split up. We were too young for such big success."

Ever since the split up there have been rumours of a reunion but the members of the band were always too busy with other projects. Then in 1984, more than 10 years after the break-up, the five original members of the band got back together and Deep Purple, one of pop's most legendary hard-rock bands was back on the road. As well as touring, the band released an out-

standing very successful new album, 'Perfect Strangers', produced by Glover.

"The reunion exceeded all our expectations," says Gillan, "it was something all five of us very much wanted but of course we didn't know how the public would react. 'Perfect Strangers' was a very spontaneous thing. We were full of ideas and before we knew what was going on, the album was finished. When we went back on stage after such a long time it was just great, all of a sudden the early '70s had come back."

"All five of us have learned a great deal in those 10 years. You might say that we have grown up. After Purple broke up we all had to take a few steps back - which was a good thing. We now know that success does not come naturally, you have to work very hard for it. Even then it is not guaranteed."

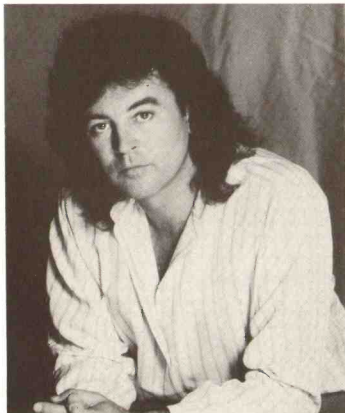

Guaranteed to play to packed houses, audiences will have the advantage of giant video screens for close-ups of what promises to be a spectacular show from Tina Turner. The four month tour, which is sponsored by Pepsi Cola, includes all the main European venues and finishes with four days at London's Wembley Stadium.

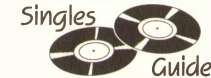

Although the holiday season has definitely come to an end, many European deejays are still on vacation and because there are so many new releases abroad, there is not much to report, making the station reports rather limited this week. Indeed, record companies are waiting with their hot releases and even the stations that are back in full force have not so much new material to add to their playlists.

There are no less than four prime movers in the Top 10 European Airplay. With Madonna holding the top position for the third week, *Kool & The Gang*, *Bangles* (a new one is also coming up; see below), *Alison Moyet*, *Erasure* and *Robbie Nevil* are all showing up, making the Top 10 very lively this week.

Other hot movers include *Orn* "Julius", *Jones* "The Rain" (5-29), the new *Paul Simon*'s single *The Boy In The Bubble* (16-40) and the seasonal' single of the year: *The Housemartins* with the a cappella rendition of *Caravan Of Love*.
The highest entry in the European Airplay Top 50 this week comes from a singer who returned to the English charts after 29 years: *Jackie Wilson* with "The Finest Girl You Ever Want To Meet"; *Beer Prite*. An original UK hit in 1957, the single reappeared in the English charts, making them on "The Classic Jackie Wilson Compilation". Now the continent is keen on the record as well and due to airplay on the major European market, the single is entering at 37.

Bangles release yet another single from their 'Different Light' album following the rather unexpected success of "Walk Like An Egyptian". The US company seems to be hesitant about releasing this single, although the Benelux companies have won the battle in the end. And not without success: no 1 Benelux, no 1 Germany and later a cross-over to the UK. The new single enters at 47 in the Airplay Top 50 of this week.

Our UK correspondents are reacting favourably on Rosie Vela's *Magic Smile*. The single has already been out on the continent for a few months (the album was favourably reviewed in M&M August 16, 1986) but only

now are the single and album ("Zazu" being released in the UK). If the single breaks on the UK stations, it might influence the continental programmers and/or the record company to give the single another push and to give Rosie Vela the success she is more than entitled to. At the moment the single makes a cautious entry in the European Airplay Top 50.

The rather late discovery of this continental single is further proof of the fact that, despite England's leading trendsetting role, they are not always the first to discover new talent. Although we are not referring to the occasional cross-over singles (like Baltimore's "Lazaro Boy", Double's "The Captain Of Her Heart" and M.C. Miker "G" & Deejay Sven's "Holiday

Rap") there are numerous examples of major talent that need a breakthrough on the continent before being accepted in the UK. The most obvious example is Simply Red and others include Europe, the Top Gun soundtrack (including Berlin's "Take My Breath Away") and Cock Robin.

Although not yet out on the continent at present, Eric Clapton's *Tearing Us Apart* (with Tina Turner on additional vocals) is already getting some good reports from our correspondents. The solid, blues based tune with the unmistakable drum sound of Collins (who also produced it) will probably get another push on European radio with Clapton being in the middle of an extensive European tour.

UNITED KINGDOM

Jackie Wilson is still at no. 1 with *Reet Petite*, this single is the oldest ever to return to the charts (29 years). Wilson died in 1984 after being in coma for a long time. *Reet Petite* is followed by *The Housemartins* and Alison Moyet. *The Gap Band's Big Fun* is the only addition to the top 10 (9-12). Due to the festive season there are not many changes in the British top 50; the only two new entries are London signed *Stevie Silk Hurley* with *Jack Your Body* at 18 and *Swing Out Sister's* latest, *Surrender*, at 38. Good jumps for *Elkie Brooks* with *No More The Fool* (11-18) - her album moves this week from 56 to 33, *Garry Moore's Over The Hills And Far Away* (20-31), *Lionel Richie's* newest *Ballerina Girl* (24-33) and *Robbie Nevil* with *Cesà La Vie* (32-42). This static situation is also reflected in the Albums chart. There are several re-entries and unexpected moves, e.g. *Simple Minds' Once Upon A Time* moves from 64 to 39, *Suzanne Vega* re-enters from 113 to 59 and *Robert Palmer's Ripride* re-enters from 180 to 81.

GERMANY

An unchanged top three with *Bangles* on top, *Mel & Kim* in second position and *Stephan Remmler* in third. Two additions to the top 10 are *Erasure* (6-12), their single *On L'Amour* jumps from 34 to 16 and *Dan Johnson* (9-14). Highest new entry is *Clowns Und Helden* (*Clowns And Heroes*) with *Ich Liebe Dich* (1 Love You) who are in at 23. *Bruce Springsteen* is in at 38 and so is *M.C. Miker "G" & Deejay Sven's* *Celebration Rap* at 39. Further good jumps for *Off* with *Electric Salza* (17-30), the *Communards' So Cold The Night* (22-31) and *Bon Jovi's Living On A Prayer* (31-42).

FRANCE

Three 'E's rule the waves in France; at no. 1 is *Elsa* with *T'En Va Pas*, followed by *Europe* and *Emanuelle* with *Premier Batzer*. Only two new entries; *Modena Talking's Geronimo's Cadillac* and *Douchka* with *Basil Detective Prive*. Good jumps for *Les Bisounours* with *Les Bisounours Chantent Noel* (20-33), *Status Quo* with *In The Army Now* (24-30), *Jean Luc Lahaye* with *Il Faudrait Que Tu Reviennes*

(26-40) and *La Compagnie Creole* with *Ca Fait Rire Les Oiseaux* (29-46).

HOLLAND

Still unbeaten, at the top for the sixth consecutive week are the *Bangles* followed by *Mel & Kim* (coming from no. 4) and *Spandau Ballet*. With *Bruce Springsteen* in the fifth position, CBS rules the top five. Two new additions to the top 10 are for *Madonna* (although a jump of only three notches, 9-12) and *Genesis* (10-13). Highest new entries are for the *Communards' So Cold The Night* (in at 23) and *Erasure's Sometimes* (in at 24). Best move is for *Red Red Red For America* (16-35). Other good moves for *Bon Jovi* (11-17), *Alison Moyet* (21-31) and *New London Chorale* with *Stay With Me Til* (22-27).

SPAIN

Modena Talking is still at no. 1 with *Geronimo's Cadillac* followed by *M.C. Miker "G" & Deejay Sven* whose *Holiday Rap* jumps again, this time from 18 to 2. In third position are *Level 42* with *Lessons In Love*. At no. 4 is another extremely good jump for *Europe's The Final Countdown* (4-34). Not many other changes in the Spanish charts; only two entries, *Depeche Mode* with *A Question Of Time* and the legendary *Joy Division* (currently *New Order*) with *Love Will Tear Us Apart*. Jumps worth mentioning are *Toreros Muertos* with *Yo No Me Llamo Javier* and *Duran Duran* (18-36).

AUSTRIA

A new no. 1 this week, *Mixed Emotions* moved from 15 to 1 with *You Want Love*. *Mixed Emotions* is a duo consisting of *Drati Deutsch* and *Oliver Simon*. In second position is *Europe* followed by *Al Bano & Romina Power*. Highest new entry is for *M&M's* love *Stephan Remmler* with *Keine Sterne In Athens* (in at no. 5). Other entries are *Cutting Crew*, *Pet Shop Boys*, *Bangles*, *Tina Turner* and *Sandra*. A good jump for *OMD's Forever Live & Die* (7-20).

DENMARK

An unchanged top three with *Kim Larsen* on top followed by *Dodo & The Dodo's* and *Eu-*

rope. *Cutting Crew* and *Status Quo* are additions to the top 10, respectively 10-13 and 9-16. Highest new entry is for *Stacey Q* with *Two Of Hearts*. Other new entries are *Michael McDonald* with *Sweet Freedom*, *Nick Kamen*, *Samantha Fox's I Am All You Need* (which has still not been charted in the Hot 100), *Status Quo's Dreamin'* and *Alison Moyet*. *M.C. Miker "G" & Deejay Sven's Celebration Rap* has the only good jump from 22 to 15.

FINLAND

Finland is still at 'War'. *Bruce Springsteen* is at the top for the fifth consecutive week but competition can be expected next week from *Iron Maiden* with *Stranger In A Strange Land* and local artist *Topi Sorsakoski* with *Vihreat Niityt* who entered straight in at second and third position respectively. Entries too for *Billy Idol*, *Huey Lewis & The News*, *Fancy* with *Lady Of Ice*, *Bangles* and *Kiki Graham*.

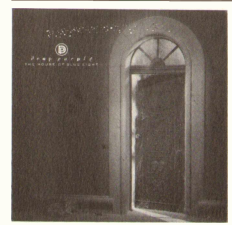
PORTUGAL

Europe is still at no. 1 for the sixth week. *Europe* has now been charted in all countries in Europe. In second place is *Berlin* followed by *Status Quo*. *Huey Lewis* and *Peter Cetera & Amy Grant* are both additions to the top 10, respectively 9-12 and 10-24. Highest new entry is *Paul Young'sWonderland*. Other entries are *The Police*, *Nuno Camara Pereira*, *Strangers* and *Bruce Hornsby*.

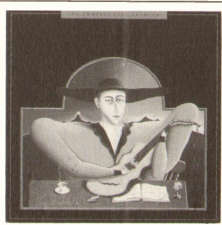
GREECE

While *Modena Talking's Geronimo's Cadillac* creeps to no. 1, *Duran Duran* enter straight in at 2 with *Notorious*. *Frankie 'Rage Hard'* at 3 (coming from 7) and *James Brown* is the second newcomer to the Top 10 with *Gravity* moving from 12 to 8. It's striking to see the amount of 'Euro-pop' records charted in the Greek charts, apart from *Modena Talking*, records from *Sandra (Hi/Hi!)*, *Samantha Fox (Touch Me)*, *C.C. Catch (Heartbreak Hotel)* and *M.C. Miker all fare well in the Top 30.*

Album Top Runners

1986 had seven different number ones in the European Hot 100 Albums, two less than the previous year. While 1985 had an artist with two different albums at the top (Sade, first with 'Diamond Life' later with 'Promise') the number ones of 1986 were all by different artists. Also in 1984 (bearing in mind the European charts were only initiated in March), not one artist occupied the top slot twice in a row.

Dire Straits still hold the record for being the longest no. 1 runner in the Hot 100, although not for consecutive weeks. The *Brothers In Arms* album stayed on top for no less than 25 weeks and this album released in '85 is, in some countries, still selling! Madonna's *True Blue* is still occupying the top slot for the 24th (consecutive!) week and it is more than likely that it will surpass Dire Straits' record. Michael Jackson is the third runner up with 22 weeks. The following lists are based on top positions maintained for consecutive weeks, unless indicated (*).

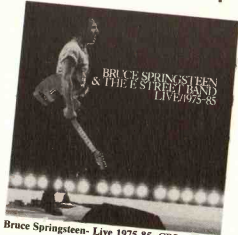

ing 1986. Australia and Canada both yielded top five hits. Australia's INXS reached no. 5 in April with 'What You Need' and Canada's Glass Tiger climbed to no. 2 in October with 'Don't Forget Me (When I'm Gone)'. Another Canadian act, Loverboy, reached no. 10 in March with 'This Could Be The Night'. And of course Austrian artist Falco occupied the no. 1 slot for three consecutive weeks with the Bolland & Bolland produced 'Rock Me Amadeus'.

But there was no hit streak in 1986 to compare with the amazing run in 1985 where eight consecutive no. 1 hits were by foreign acts. Although nothing that dramatic occurred in 1986, at one point, four consecutive no. 1 hits were by foreign acts. The string began in July with Billy Ocean's 'There'll Be So Sings', and continued with Simply Red's 'Holding Back The Years', Genesis' 'Invisible Touch' and Peter Gabriel's 'Sledgehammer'.

Genesis and its past and present members were responsible for six top 10 hits during the year. The group weighed in with 'Invisible Touch' and 'Throwing It All Away' (no. 4 in October), while former member Peter Gabriel had 'Sledgehammer', current singer Phil Collins had 'Take Me Home' (no. 7 in May) and Mike Rutherford's Mike & The Mechanics hit 'Silent Running' (no. 6 in March) and 'All I Need Is A Miracle' (no. 5 in June).

'Take Me Home' and 'All I Need Is A Miracle' were both posted in the top 10 in May, marking the first time two members of an ongoing group were listed in the top 10 simultaneously since December 1981 when Fleetwood Mac's Stevie Nicks and Lindsay Buckingham both made the mark.

Numerous members of the British "old guard" landed top 10 hits in 1986, including Paul McCartney, the Rolling Stones, the Moody Blues, Elton John and Rod Stewart.

McCartney's 'Spies Like Us', from the hit movie of the same name, climbed to no. 7 in February, though his subsequent single, 'Press', failed to crack the top 20. The Stones' 'Harlem Shuffle' hit no. 5 in May, nearly 21 years after they landed their first top 5 hit, 'Satisfaction'. The Moody's 'Your Wildest Dreams' hit no. 9 in July, also nearly 21 years after their first top 10 hit, 'Go Now'.

The Moody's are responsible for one of the most unusual distinctions in pop history. They're the only act to land its first three top 10 hits in successive decades. Their first top 10 hit, 'Go Now', came in 1965, their second, 'Nights in White Satin', in 1972, and their third, 'Your Wildest Dreams', in 1986.

Elton John landed two top 10 hits during the year. He was featured on Dionne & Friends' 'That's What Friends Are For', the no. 1 single of the year, and on his own 'Nikita' which hit no. 7 in March. And Rod Stewart climbed to no. 6 in August with 'Love Touch', the theme from the film 'Legal Eagles'.

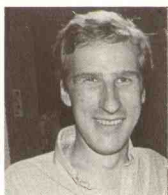
But probably the most dramatic impact by a member of the "old guard" was made by Steve Winwood. Winwood's 'Higher Love' reached no. 1 in August, 20 years and six months after he first cracked the Hot 100 with the Spencer Davis Group's 'Keep On Running'. Only two acts have had longer gaps between their first chart appearance and their first no. 1 hit: Tina Turner (24 years) and Robert John (20 years and 11 months).

'Higher Love', which featured backup vocals by Chaka Khan, was, in fact, Winwood's first single to crack the top five. The Spencer Davis Group's highest-charting single, 'Gimme Some Lovin', reached no. 7, as did Winwood's 1981 solo hit, 'While You See A Chance'.

Other long-serving British acts to add to their top 10 tallies in 1986 included Dire Straits, which hit no. 7 in January with 'Walk Of Life', Human League, which reached no. 1 in November with 'Human', and Duran Duran, which seemed headed for no. 1 with 'Notorious' as the year came to a close. Four hits reached no. 1 in both the UK and the US US 1986, through mid-December: Whitney Houston's 'Saving All My Love For You', the Pet Shop Boys' 'West End Girls', Madonna's 'Papa Don't Preach' and Berlin's 'You Take My Breath Away'.

Euro American Beat

This is the first Euro American Beat column, which will focus on European acts that are hitting big in the American charts. Its author is Paul Grein who writes the popular chartbeat column in Billboard Magazine. Grein, who reports frequently on pop music for both Billboard and the Los Angeles Times, lives in Studio City, California.

Los Angeles- When you think of British acts monopolizing the top 40 in the American singles chart, you think of the British Invasion of 1964-65, or possibly the British synth-pop boom of 1982-83. You probably don't think of 1986, when the headlines in the US went to home-grown stars such as Whitney Houston, Madonna and Van Halen.

But whether it generated headlines or not, the record for the most British artists in the American top 40 was set in June 1986, when exactly half of the top 40 hits were by British acts.

Listed in the top 10 that week were Mike & The Mechanics, OMD, Level 42, Billy Ocean, and George Michael. Posted in the top 20 were Culture Club, Howard Jones, Simply Red, Boys Don't Cry and the Pet Shop Boys. Charting in the bottom half of the top 40 were the Outfield, Phil Collins, The Moody Blues, Robert Palmer, Peter Gabriel, GTR, the Dream Academy, Genesis, Simple Minds and Tears For Fears.

Britain wasn't the only foreign country to produce top 40 hit makers dur-
