couple of days after the launch, Richard Hooper, joint Managing Director of Super Channel together with Charles Levison, gave us his reactions.

Worldwide Support For IMMC

More than 150 top industry executives from around the world turned out for the cocktail reception hosted by Music & Media and Billboard at Midem to announce plans for this year's International Music & Media Conference which takes place May 13-16 in Montreux, Switzerland.

Welcoming the guests, Billboard UK Managing Director, Mike Hennessey, said: "In a world of accelerating technology it becomes increasingly important for the music and home entertainment industry to have an annual forum in order to review and discuss the challenges and opportunities for the future."

"The IMMC provides this opportunity and supplements the week

by week tracking of music industry developments provided by Billboard and its sister paper Music & Media."

Theo Roos, Publisher of Music & Media, gave details of the forthcoming conference and said that already many tv stations have committed themselves to making direct transmission from the event and that top industry personalities such as Jan Timmer, President of PolyGram Int., Norman Pattiz, Head Of Westwood One, WEA Int. Chairman Nesuhi Ertegun and Stan Cornyn, President of The Record Group, have confirmed their participation in the panel discussions planned for the event.

Mama Concerts Split

Mama Concerts in Munich, one of Europe's leading concert promoters, have split up. The company's founders, Marcel Avram and Marek Lieberberg, have decided to go their own ways after working together for more than 20 years. No

reason was given for the surprise announcement. Both partners have now established new promo agencies. Avram is staying in Munich and Lieberberg moving to Frankfurt.

Veronica Most Popular Dutch Radio Station

The average Dutch person listens to two-and-three-quarter hours of radio a day, almost half of which is concentrated on the pop channel, according to figures just released by the Dutch broadcasting and advertising foundations, NOS/STER.

The amount of time people listen to any one of Holland's five official channels is divided as follows: Radio 1 and 2 (light entertainment) 65 minutes, Radio 3 (pop) 80 minutes, Radio 4 (classical music) six minutes and Radio 5 (cultural programmes) two minutes.

One of the most interesting findings was that the popularity of the

pop channel has gradually dropped (by about 2%) over the last two years, as has the overall percentage of listeners.

Of the various broadcasting companies operating in Holland, Veronica has the largest proportion of radio listeners with 6.1% of the total followed by TROS (4.9%), AVRO (4.1%), VARA (3.3%), KRO (3%), NCRV (2.9%), EO (0.7%) and VPRO (1.1%). The most popular programme on Dutch radio is Veronica's 'Muziek Terwijl U Werkt' ('Music While You Work') on Radio 2 (19.1%).



Furniture On The Move - The up-and-coming young British band, Furniture, are to tour the Middle East next month on what will be the first ever pop tour organised by the British Council who are trying to up-date their somewhat old-fashioned image. Furniture (Stiff Records) will play dates in Iraq, Jordan, Egypt and Cyprus between February 17 and March 17. The group had a top 20 hit last year with 'Brilliant Mind' and plan to release a new single shortly.

Midem 1987 Biggest Ever

MIP Radio, one of the newest sections of Bernard Chevry's annual Midem music industry market place, is also the fastest growing, according to the final attendance figures released by the Midem Organisation. Last year 149 companies took part, this year the number was up to 233, representing major broadcast organisations in 24 countries.

Prominent among them were Austria's national channel OE, Canada's CBC, Denmark's Radio, Finland's Oy Yleisradio, Hungarian tv and Magyar Radio, Ireland's RTE, Radio Tele Luxembourg, Holland's AVRO and Veronica, Polish radio and tv, Sveriges Radio from Sweden, the BBC, Piccadilly Productions and US syndicator Westwood One. French participation was, of course, particularly strong, with Radio France alone

taking up several pages in the Midem guide and with FM stations also well represented.

Overall, attendance at this 21st Midem was marginally up on last year's event, the number of professionals attending being set at 7602 compared with 7519 last year, and the number of participating companies at 1,987 compared with 1,986 the year before. The number of companies with stands was 825, well ahead of last year's 726, although this large increase is partly explained by the growing number of joint stands putting together a large number of companies who could not afford to exhibit alone.

CD was without question the key theme of the event, with many manufacturers touting for customers and licences for CD product eagerly sought.

was fantastic. We had 100% response from all over Europe. Everyone was over the moon about the programming and the schedules especially the European touches like the Dutch Van Der Valk series, the European "What The Papers Say" (produced by Granada TV) and the review programme about Dutch art. The launch programme with Mrs Thatcher went down very well too. We did have some teaching problems and lost the signal for about an hour on Sunday morning but on the whole the technology has been very exciting. And our first live broadcast, the channel's success seen by our Alex Higgins snooker game went faultlessly."

The opening package was viewed almost entirely in households connected to cable systems and the initial audience was inherited from the old Music Box audience. Since the news that Music Box would change to Super Chan-

nel, it's estimated that the audience has gone from 4.5 million to almost 7 million.

"Our success depends, of course, on cable uptake but we have already added Austria, Ireland and Norway to the countries that should receive Music Box, but our biggest markets are Holland with 2.5 million and German with 1.5 million. Naturally we are concerned about the language problem but we compensate for this by choosing specific sort of material, for example, 'The Orchestra' shown on our first weekend was one-and-a-half hours of mime comedy. We concentrate on visual tv."

Hooper is of course confident of Super Channel's success and sees little to stand in its way, including the introduction of America's MTV in a few months: "I don't think MTV will be any significant competition for us, they still have a lot to learn. They don't have cable or satellite and have to start from scratch. Good luck to them."

Surprise Moves Within French Record Industry

Flarensch Back With WEA

Paris - The last few days have seen some drastic changes within the French recording industry. At Phonogram, Denis Boyer, ex-Director of CBS Belgium, steps into the shoes of Jean Paul Commin. He replaces Commin as managing director. During the 10 years Commin spent at Phonogram, several companies were signed to the major as licensees including Island, Chrysalis and ECM. Commin's future plans are as yet unknown.

Bernard de Bosson is leaving WEA France where he has been president since June 1986. De Bosson has spent 29 years in the industry and was formerly International Director at Polydor. He formed WEA Filipacchi Music with Daniel Filipacchi and Frank Tenot and the company became WEA Music in 1986 following the departure of the

latter two. Luigi Calabrese, formerly president of Polydor France, is to take over as new president. A draft treaty has been signed between Flarensch's President Alain Puglia and his distributor WEA. Puglia has yielded 10% of his capital to WEA with an option on a supplementary though minority share.

WEA will thereby maintain an administrative role within Flarensch and will be able at all times to increase its share or pull out of the capital. The contract is valid for three years.

The independent label Flarensch is proud to have undertaken signing the artists Rose Laurens, Jean Pierre Mader, and the group Images whose 'Demons De Minuit' was at no. 1 for 13 weeks.

Private Stations Popular In Finland

There are plenty of problems, not least financial, for Finland's 18 private commercial radio stations, but a new survey by Tampere University for the Ministry of Communications makes it clear that they are listened to nationwide and are well accepted.

The survey shows around 40% of those asked listen daily to the local commercial stations and around 50% tune in two or three times a week. More than 60% pledge to

listen to their local stations in the future and regard them as good alternatives to the no-commercial transmissions of the State 'Yleisradio' network.

Phone-in programmes are particularly popular with listeners, though their share of total programming schedules still runs at well under 10%. Recorded pop and rock music accounts for roughly half of the total output, most of it by international groups and singers.

Controversy Around New Italian Video Law

The Italian government has passed two laws relating to video cassettes, the first concerning piracy and the second censorship.

In an attempt to eradicate piracy, the government has decreed that all pre-recorded video cassettes must bear the stamp of the Italian Society Of Authors & Publishers (SIAE). Any cassette not bearing the stamp will automatically be considered a pirate and therefore subject to existing anti-piracy regulations. Those found guilty of making or selling pirate videos can be fined between 600,000 and six million lire, and could face imprisonment of up to three years.

The second law is somewhat more controversial. A circular from the Ministry of the Interior has made it clear that the sale and rent of pre-recorded videos are subject to the same censorship laws as films shown in cinemas. It also means home video dealers must obtain a police licence and keep special book-keeping accounts for all cassettes sold.

President of Univideo, the trade association of home producers and dealers, Umberto Virri, has spoken out angrily against the ruling claiming it is unfair, "I feel that since tv

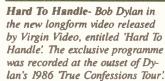

In line with the romantic nature of the song, the clip features a couple dancing together with music by Jackie Wilson performing on the television in the background * The Giblets are also wrapping up a clip to Westwood's 'Sonic Boom' which, shot in a cinema and a studio, it is a live action performance clip inter-cut with animation.

London Conference On Cable TV & Satellites

Speakers include David Mellor, Minister Of State at the Home Office; David Shaw of the Independent Television Companies Association; Rolf Anrim of Eurosatellite GmbH; Super Channel's Richard Hooper; and Michael Checkland, Deputy Director, General of the BBC, who has been standing in for his boss, Alasdair Milne, since he abruptly left the BBC on January 29.

Sony Video Software Goes European

London- Sony's newly set-up Sony Video Software Europe operation, which is London-based and headed by managing director Bruce Wilkinson, has confirmed a March launch for its new video label and first package of titles to be distributed in the UK.

This is the latest development in a Sony link with video software going back to the US in 1982 with the creation of a small software support

group which, among other ventures, boosted Sony's Beta hi fi launch in North America. The Video Software Operations quickly collected notable 'firsts': first videos with a list price less than \$20; first hi fi stereo music videos; first video tour (with Duran Duran); plus a long list of awards, including a short-form video Grammy Award for Duran's 'Girls On Film'. Sony picked up a similar

trophy for David Bowie's 'China Girl' in 1984.

The company was also first to use separate digital audio masters to enhance audio quality. Having concentrated on the US market through to 1985, it expanded to take in Europe. Says Wilkinson: "We're aware that the European video market has survived its first shake-out and is now in a new rational period of substantial growth."

First titles are 'Stripper', from the First Annual Strippers' Convention in Las Vegas, and 'The Boy Who Had Everything' (Jason Connery).

Simply Red Do The Right Thing

New Album & Tour For WEA Act

It's not too often that a band establishes such a firm basis with a debut album as Simply Red did. Preceded by two hit singles, the rendition of the Valentine Brothers' classic 'Money's Too Tight To Mention' and the stomping 'Come To My Aid,' their debut LP 'Picture Book' not only brought the band huge critical acclaim, good sales in Europe and the US, but also a major European sell-out tour.

Ten new tracks produced by Alex Sadkin (Duran Duran, Joe Cocker and recently Robbie Nevil) continue Simply Red's distinctive brand of soul, dance pop and r&b. The first single from the band's new album is called, 'The Right Thing,' (the B-side 'There's A Light' is not on the album) and is out this week followed by the album on March 2. The album features two tracks written by the group's front man, Mick Hucknall and Lamont Dozier, one

WEA UK act, Simply Red has been made into an European priority. The initial shipment figures on the album are already exceeding a quarter of a million in Europe and this justifies such European treatment, explains Jurgen Otterstein, Marketing Director WEA Europe: "We all think the timing is perfect, there is a LP coming in March followed by a tour that will cover most of Europe. The band is available and that is a tremendous help in marketing the record," says Otterstein. 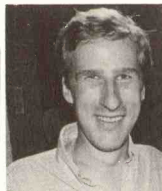
Originally signed through the independent label Kitchenerware

Four more singles followed which were later compiled on a Kitchenerware album, 'Boxed: Long Shot Pymes From Broke Players'. Arista signed them up in 1986 and the first single under the new contract was entitled 'Sweet Sanity'.

The second Arista/Kitchenerware release, called 'If Love Could Kill', is now out, written by Hurrh!'s Taffy Hughes and produced by Gil Norton (Triffids, Echo & The Bunnymen), it's another attempt to

The Euro American Beat focuses on European acts that are hitting big in the American charts. Its author is PAUL GREIN who writes the popular Charbeat column in Billboard. Grein, who reports regularly on pop music for Billboard and Los Angeles Times, lives in Studio City, California.

Duran Duran have extended their enviable string of US hits with the single and album, 'Notorious'. The title track on the group's fifth album effortlessly became the band's seventh top five single at the end of last year making Duran Duran the long-distance champs of the many British acts that emerged from the

1983 British Invasion. Culture Club, the group's chief rival charts at the time, earned four top five hits in just over a year (1983-84), but hasn't made it back to the top five since.

Duran Duran first cracked the top five in March 1983 with 'Hungry Love The Wolf', a song from

A Word About Anya

Video Killed The Radio Star... the Buggles' prophecy has come true for Rocket/Phonogram artist Anya. After starring in Elton John's Ken Russell directed 'Nikita' video, the Singapore born model was signed to Elton John's record company, Rocket.

In that same year, 1985, Anya debuted with 'Moscow Nights', reaching top 10 in the Benelux and some first modest chart placings in other European countries.

Her latest single 'One Word', where a solid up-tempo backing provides the right vehicle for Anya's cool, sensual vocals, is out now in the major European markets. A promotion tour will follow shortly with firm tv options in Holland, Belgium and Germany.



Two big names are under consideration, although Arista's Chrissie Harwood did not want to disclose too many details. One thing, however, is certain; the tour dates will be instrumental in breaking the act. "Not only are they good songwriters, they are also able to carry their live sound onto records; they are not one of those technical-studio based acts but a band that can translate and preserve live excitement on vinyl!", says Harwood.

With the UK preceding, the whole of Europe will go with the single as well and the group's scheduled European support tour will give them a good chance to break the single.

peaked at no 4 in January, 1985.

The 'Power Station' album reached no. 6 in August 1985, and Arcadia's 'So Red The Rose' made the top 15 in early 1986. Both albums also went platinum.

Duran Duran isn't the only British group to land a no. 2 hit on the American charts in recent weeks. Wang Chung's 'Everybody Have Fun Tonight' peaked in the runner-up spot in the last week of December, kept out of the top spot by the Bangles' 'Walk Like An Egyptian', which also blocked 'Notorious'.

Wang Chung first cracked the US top 40 in February, 1984 with 'Don't Let Go'. They landed their first top 20 hit a few months later with 'Dance Hall Days'.

The clue to both of Wang Chung's hits was their strong dance base. 'Dance Hall Days' reached no. 1 on the dance/disco chart, and 'Everybody Have Fun Tonight' was a top five dance hit.

The much-tipped Godfathers have a new single out on St Valentine's Day, February 14, called 'Love Is Dead' * ROL's love affair with World Party continues unabated, but even we have to smile at Karl Wallinger's nerve in claiming the writing credit for the new song on the UK B-side of 'Ship Of Fools'. It's called 'World Groove (Do The Mind Guerrilla)' but it couldn't possibly exist if Junior Walker hadn't been there first - the song is an almost exact copy of 'Pucker Up Buttercup' with new words and a hint of 'Land Of A Thousand Dances' thrown in for good measure * New Model Army's new British release is 'Poison Street' and they're playing five dates here this month to promote it * The latest rock

classic to suffer from the Fuzzbox treatment is 'Bohemian Rhapsody'; the all-female indie band whose singing is only rivalled by their hairstyles have done an a-cappella version of the Queen song for the flip side of their latest single 'What's The Point' *

Speaking of cover versions, we approach the new single by The Colour Field (featuring Terry Hall, one of The Specials) with a little trepidation. It's a cover of Sly And The Family Stone's 1972 soul classic 'Running Away' * Denny Laine is back on the road again. The man who sold his rights to 'Mull Of Kintyre' so that he could buy a ticket to Spain in '82 is currently doing what he calls his Taxman Tour; Denny hopes to recoup a little of the fortune he lost with a show that includes a few of the old Wings songs as well as his new material. However, as he kicked off the tour at a small south London theatre, it looks like the taxman is in for a long wait. Incidentally, he now intends to manage his money more wisely thanks to the romantic influence of one Helen Grant, daughter of the one who managed Led Zeppelin! * Go West have gone west again, the latest stab at a release date for that much delayed 'Dancing On The Couch' album is March 3, but considering the duo are still reported to be writing two new songs for it, that date strikes us as a trifle ambitious. Meanwhile their tour goes ahead and they've just added a couple

more provincial dates * Bob Geldof's spring tour has been postponed. The official line is that the band aren't ready yet and they hope to reschedule the tour for later in the year after a visit to the States. Unfortunately, ticket sales have gone deep in the heart of nowhere! *

Ronnie Wood has signed a \$100,000 publishing deal for a book on his rock 'n' roll life. Due out in the autumn, it promises to divulge plenty of stories about Ronnie's career with the Stones and Rod Stewart and will be illustrated with reproductions of his own sketches and oil paintings * We still get letters at ROL about the fondly-remembered Irish band Siff Little Fingers - now their former leader Jake Burns has signed a solo deal with Jive Records and has a single released called 'Breathless' * Big Audio Dynamite are doing 11 UK gigs this month to warm up for their US tour. They've a single out too - a new mix of 'V Thirteen'. The Style Council will play a fourth night (February 19) at London's Royal Albert Hall this month as the other three have sold out. Talented new band The Bible, who ROL introduced last year, will support China Crisis on their UK tour this month. China Crisis are back in the ROL Top 5 this week with 'Best Kept Secret' - and other record companies would be well advised to follow the Virgin CD single trend as 70 per cent of the early sales of this one were on compact disc *

Wang Chung are also starting their first UK tour since '84 at one of the country's lesser known venues. They play the Peterborough Tropicana this week - a far cry from their last gig at Wembley Stadium! However, they are then coming to London for a couple of dates at the Marquee. They'll be releasing 'Let's Go' over here soon * Slade's 21st anniversary is being marked with the single 'Still The Same'. An album follows soon * A chance to get romantic with Spandau Ballet on February 14 as a 45-minute recording of their December concert in Birmingham is featured on the Tube Valentine's Day Special * Philip Saatchi, younger brother of Mrs Thatcher's advertising men, has released his second single 'Wheel Of Fortune'. This should help him make his own reputation following the success of his countrywide tour supporting Joan Armatrading last year *

Promoters expect 80,000 Paul Simon fans to be disappointed when tickets are allocated for three extra shows at the Royal Albert Hall. Demand was so great that his other three London concerts were sold out even before they'd been announced in the press. Another show at the Birmingham NEC will no doubt also be sold out by the time you read this * The Ward Brothers, whose 'Cross That Bridge' features on Rock Over London this week, have just started touring with the Psychedelic Furs.

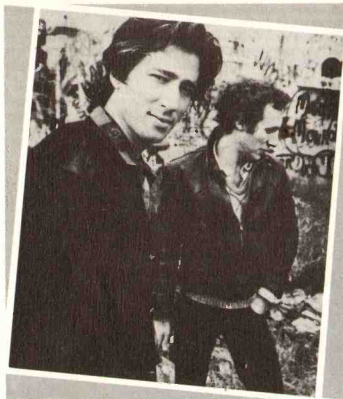

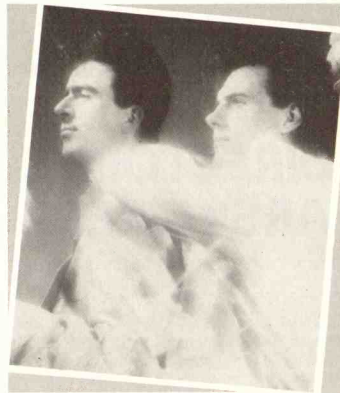

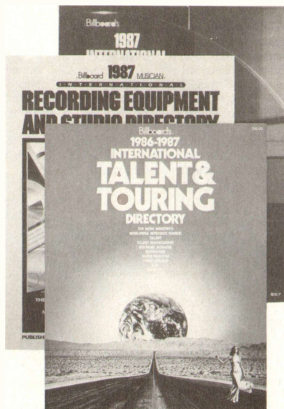

While the lack of new album releases is apparent, a situation troubling the poor reviewer for some weeks now, there are plenty of good singles around.

Worldparty, the band fronted by ex-Waterboys Karl Wallinger, have just released their second single, *Ship Of Fools* through Ensign/Chrysalis. It's a compelling blues based track taken from their highly under estimated (also by M&M) debut album 'Private Revolution'. Apart from the obligatory 12" format, Chrysalis is also releasing the track on a special compact disc single, containing two extra tracks, *Private Revolution* and *Trouble Down Here*. It marks the first time that Chrysalis is releasing a CD single.

After a short stint in London Records, ex-Shalamar female vocalist Jody Watley is now hoping for a glorious come-back along the lines of Janet Jackson last year. On her self titled solo debut Watley teams up with Prince bass player Andre Cymone, David Z. (from that other Minneapolis band Mazarati), Bernard Edwards, Pat Leonard (Madonna) and even George Michael crops up in a duet. With the album coming out soon, MCA issues the first single, *Looking For A New Love*, a very slick, tight and solid tune with a persuasive beat, moulded much like Janet Jackson's 'What Have You Done For Me Lately'.

Ex-Men At Work singer Colin James Hay tries for something new on his debut solo single *Hold Me*. Produced by Robin Millar (Sade and the like), his very vocals are backed by a hypnotic African choir and a hectic horn section. Not the easiest one to programme, so we stay tuned in for his forthcoming album *Looking For Jack*.

We love the new single by the UK trio **View From The Hill**; maybe not the sheer brilliance of their debut 'No Conversation', but again a stirring and polished classic soul ballad. Produced by Stuart Levine (Sade) was behind the knobs for albums from Culture Club and Simply Red), the track is from a forthcoming debut album on EMI.

If you like your pop to be fresh, listened to Kitchener are **Hurrah!**. The band is featured

in an extra Spotlight on page 7 and we urge you to check out the band's knack for writing pure, simple but effective pop songs.

So much for the New Talents, there is also new superstar product from **Spandau Ballet** (who continue their epic and dramatic style with *How Many Lies*), **Tina Turner's** rocking *What You Get Is What You See* (only the Dutch market deviates with another single: the Bowie penned 'Girls'), the new Level 42 single *Running In The Family* (another winner after their worldwide success with 'Lessons In Love'), **Duran Duran's** *Skin Trade* (very moody and sung in Prince-like style) and **Bananarama** (the girls who are always so dependent on production), with *Trick Of The Night*.

In the European Airplay Top 50 **Robbie Nevil's** *C'est La Vie* tops for the third consecutive week and shooting up in the top 10 are **Aretha & George** with their ultra smooth *I Knew You Were Waiting*, **Mel & Kim's** *Showing Out* and **Gregory Abbott's** *Shake You Down*. The latter is currently on a heavy promotion trip across Europe which you can read all about in next week's Spotlight.

The hottest record in Europe is simply **Red's** *The Right Thing*, the single is this week's highest entry in the Airplay Top 50 as **Alton Moyet's** *Is This Love* replacing the eight weeks' chart topper *The Final Countdown*.

BACK CATALOGUE

As mentioned earlier in this issue, the lack of superstar product carries on, even in February. The major labels especially seem to be concentrating on their back catalogue, especially in relation to CD. Good examples include the eagerly anticipated CDs from The Beatles, released by EMI February 26, and Atlantic's superb archive compilations, the Atlantic Rhythm & Blues Box (4 LPs, recently available in CD format) followed this month by Atlantic Blues (eight albums) and Atlantic Jazz (15 albums). A CD release for the latter two is anticipated in the US, although plans for Europe are still unknown. Another label concentrating on its results is Motown which is releasing Two Original Albums On 1 CD' compilation from its own rich musical heritage, featuring The Supremes, Smokey Robinson, The Temptations etc.

Talking about CDs, A&M has released some interesting remixes, on CD only, of Janet Jackson's 'Control', entitled 'Control - The Remixes'. Containing eight tracks, the CD features 'The Video Mix' (very popular amongst soul/disco dj's for its hard hitting beats) and 'A Capella Version' of Control as well as different mixes of the his Nasty (check out the 'Cool Summer Mix'), 'What Have You Done For Me Lately', 'When I Think Of You and Let's Wait A While'.

Although several exciting album releases were expected this month, some of them have been delayed, Whitney Houston's second album is now scheduled for the last week of March, while the release date of Michael Jackson's follow up to 'Thriller' is as yet unknown.

Other new albums expected for the spring include David Bowie, U2, Go West, Simply Red, The Scorpions, Simple Minds and Def Leppard.

The major release this week is the new Style Council album *The Cost Of Loving*. It is the band's third album (excluding last year's live LP) and its range of different musical styles is striking. Side one features funky tunes and side two concentrates on softer and more sensual tracks. With the help of the Valentine Brothers ('Money's Too Tight To Mention') and Curtis Mayfield, Paul Waller's songwriting talent gets good exposure. However, his vocals could have been jacked up a bit as they sound rather dull. Tracks worth checking include the sparsely arranged *The Cost Of Loving* with Dee C. Lee taking the lead vocals, the militant rap *It's Go* (very much George Clinton-like) and the moody *Angel* (done earlier by Anita Baker).

Real American rock comes from John Eddie's self titled debut album on CBS. Although definitely not mere imitation, his music is influenced by Springsteen as Eddie is the first to admit. With help from Springsteen musicians like Max Weinberg and Nils Lofgren, his rock 'n roll style is convincing and auspicious.

Tracks that stand out include the country tinged *Buster*, the sweeping anthem *Jungle Boy* (very much influenced by Eddy Cochran) and the emotional *Hide Out*.

The highest album entry is Esquire's debut *Wonderland*, coming in at no. 33. The duo's success first started in France with 'Oh l'Amour' but real acclaim came with their 'Sometimes' single.

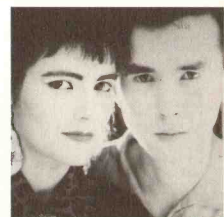

This column will give a weekly update on the progression of M&M New Talent Tips In Europe



Luna Parker

Slightly oriental melody lines, a stomping beat and a good hook, these form the ingredients of **Luna Parker's** *Tes Eias D'Amé ... Eric*, the French duo that were spotted in this section last year (November 29). The Barclay signed duo, Eric Tabuchi and Dominique Dubois, are faring very well in the French charts, their single is currently at no. 11 and also gets heavy plays on both the FM and the AM stations. Check this record out as it is not the usual disco stuff but has, just like Rita Mitsouko's 'Marcia Baila', that artful touch that makes such productions worthwhile. Apart from the French lyrics there should be no excuse for any European DJ not to play, or at least consider, this track.

German independent label Zyx Records currently has three successful records in the German top 75. The label specialises in the typically weird and one-off disco singles and **Off's** *Electrica Salsa*, a shrewd mix of Kraftwerk and Trio, is currently no. 4 in the German charts, 27 in Belgium and about to break in Holland. The label is also successful with **First Patrol's** *The Streets Of Miami* (this week's New Talent tip), currently no. 53, **Koto's** *Jahadh* (licensed from Italian Memory Records), and with the *Isola Box Mex* (a disco mix containing 'Jahadh', **Eddy Huntington's** *USSR* and some others), still top 30. The label is also successful in having the rights for the German market of **Jackie Wilson's** *Reet Petite*.
