Possible Expansion For UK TV

London - The number of television channels in the UK looks set to increase, with the additional possibility of 'community' TV stations. This became clear during an unprecedented seminar held between PM Margaret Thatcher, senior ministers and top industry TV executives. The agenda included the possible privatisation of Channel 4, selling off ITV franchises to the highest bidder, and prospects for a new fifth channel.

Some broadcasters pointed out that the aims of tighter control and more competition are contradictory. This is unlikely to divert the government from introducing radical changes in the commercial sector, where advertisers are pressing for more channels to reduce television rates they regard as excessive.

Among other ideas discussed was a plan for new local television channels with a radius of perhaps 20km. James

UK Radio Bodies Make Peace

Independent local radios in the UK gathered last week at a general meeting called for by the Association of Independent Radio Contractors (AIRC) and all agreed to bury their differences.

The budget for the next financial year was also approved at the meeting yet it seems the AIRC is having to pay a high price for what it achieved - it is expected that around 35-40% of the budget is to be trimmed. According to Brian West, Director AIRC, 'three to four people will have to go'; West describes the redundancies as 'unfortunate' but stresses that independent radio now paints a far more optimistic picture than it did only a few weeks ago.

West is also confident that the stations which had earlier

Big Cash Injection To Save Sky

A statement from Sky Channel has given the lie to recent speculations that Rupert Murdoch's News Corporation would be selling the majority stake in the European cable satellite service (see M&M issue 38). Sky is instead to be rescued from its financial difficulties

with a fund of £22.63 million pounds provided by Satellite Television.

The funds are to be raised by way of a rights issue and will be used to repay Satellite Television's overdraft and provide finance for the ongoing operation of Sky Channel.

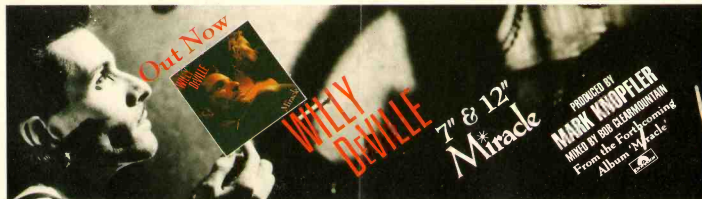

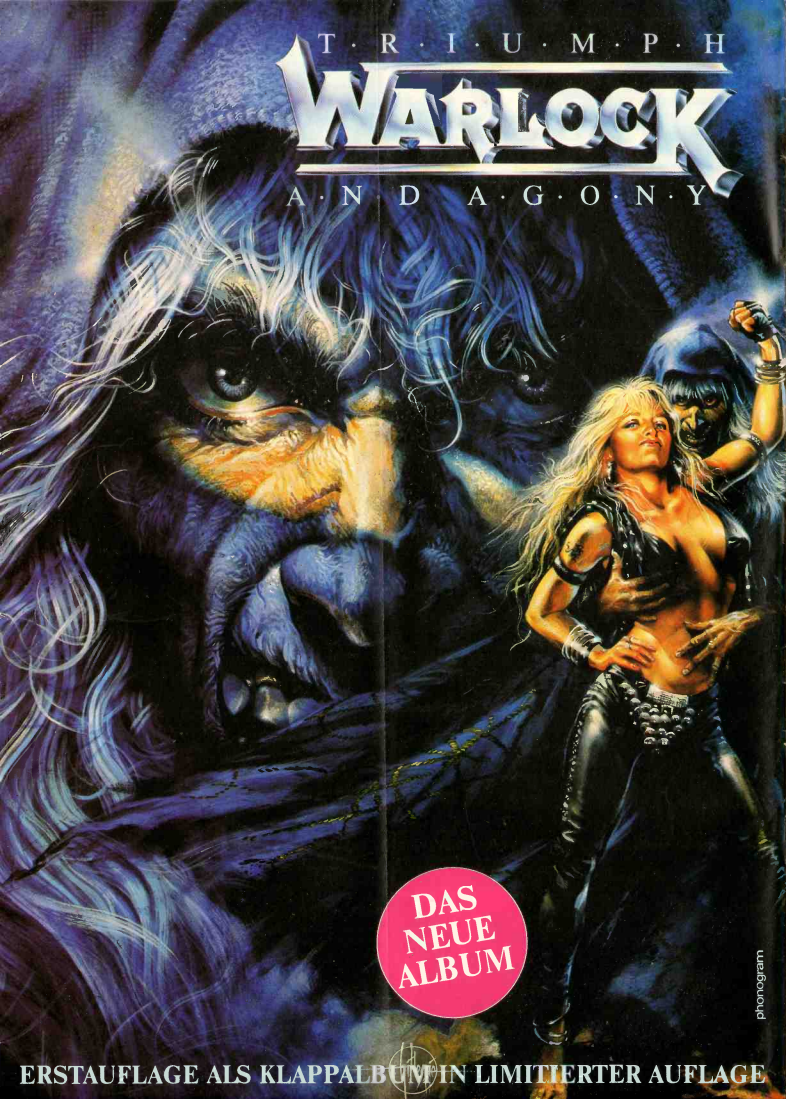

The Making & Marketing Of A Record

All aspects of the record industry were covered in a one-day seminar entitled "The Making & Marketing Of A Record" attended by about 100 delegates in London last week (September 18).

Virgin's A&R manager **Jeremy Lascelles** kicked off the session with some controversial comments on artists' managers. "I am appalled by how generally useless a band's manager can be," he said, "... it can be really easy to be put off signing a band because you take exception to the manager." Lascelles was also critical of producers whom he believes have become far too expensive in terms of advances

and royalties: "Even good producers are negligent and ineffectual when it comes to keeping within a recording budget." And with recording costs for an LP at around £100,000 this was a serious problem.

The cost of producing video clips is also a critical factor for marketing records these days. Polydor's Marketing Executive **George McManus** said that while he considers the video as, "a vital marketing tool", at £20-25,000 for an "ordinary" clip, it was "a mixed blessing".

On the subject of radio promotion, A&M's **Julian Spear** called for BBC Radio 1 to introduce a 'B' playlist and said

HEDS - A New Trade Show For UK

Birmingham's National Exhibition Centre is planning to replace its three-year-old video software showcase **VIDTEL** with a new event covering both the video and record industries. Known as **HEDS '88**, or the Home Entertainment Dealers' Show, it will be staged over three days in May next year.

The show will include sections for record and video distributors, hardware exhibitors and general dealer business, with a programme of seminars, conferences and concerts planned. According to **Dave Willis**, sales director, **HEDS** could

eventually become a rival to **Bernard Chevry's** long-established South of France showcase **MIDEM**, now owned by UK television company **TVS**.

"There's no reason why Birmingham cannot become the Cannes of Britain" he says hopefully. However **MIDEM's** UK representative **Peter Thodes** remains unflustered by a rival. "Basically it sounds like a dealer show so I don't think it is any competition for **MIDEM**. In any case, the NEC tried the same thing about five years ago, and it didn't work then."

Willy DeVille Signs With Polydor

Polydor is undertaking massive marketing and advertising campaigns to celebrate the signing of **Willy DeVille** to the label.

The first product under the new agreement is the title track of the new album, entitled *Miracle*. Produced by **Mark Knopfler**, who also co-wrote one song and is responsible for all the guitar work on the album, the LP contains tracks like *Miracle*, *Assasin Of Love*, *Angel Eyes* and *Storybook Love*, the latter being the main theme for **Rob Reiner's** follow-up

movie to 'Stand By Me', 'Princess Bride'. The European release of the movie is expected early 1988.

Under the band's name, **Mink DeVille**, three albums for **Capital** and three for **Atlantic** were released, until 1985 when the band released their debut **Polydor** album entitled *Spartan Life*. This is the first time the lead singer of that band, **Willy DeVille**, is releasing material under his own name. A promotional tour of Europe is planned for the second part of October.

Many happy returns to **BBC Radio 1** who are this week celebrating their 20th birthday. On September 30 1967 **Tony Blackburn** launched the UK's first national pop music station with the words, "welcome to the exciting sound of Radio 1". The first record played was *Flowers In The Rain* by The Move. Twenty years later, Radio 1 is

marking its birthday by playing the top 100 singles and the top 100 albums of the past 20 years between 05.30 and 20.00 hours. Also at Radio 1, good luck to **Doreen Davis** who is retiring on October 4.

More news on the reshuffling at **Capital Radio**. A surprising resignation from **John Myer** who leaves Capital after 14 years. He has no new moves planned as yet but is apparently leaving Capital on good terms. There are no less than five new DJs starting up the new autumn schedule at Capital on September 28. **Jakki**, a 20-year-old Londoner and Capital's youngest DJ, will take over the 01.00-04.00 hours slot on Saturday mornings. Other new weekend voices include **Pete Tong** who will present 'Soul Session' from

18.00-20.00 hours on Saturdays. **Nell Fox** who will present two weekend shows and **Shirley VI Pat Sharpe** who will share Sundays from 14.00 - 16.00 hours on Capital AM with Mick Brown. The fifth newcomer is **Tim Westwood** who presents an hour of hip-hop dance music from Sunday midnight - 04.00 hours. Two of the station's most popular shows will also move to new times. **Alan Freeman** will present his 'Rock Show' on Sundays from 19.00-21.00 hours and **Paul Gambaccini** will host the 'US Chart Show' from 22.00 - 24.00 hours on Sundays.

Leading French FM station, **NRJ** has just released their third compilation album of international hit singles. Entitled *His Volume III* the LP contains such favourites as

Chris Rea, Images, Nick Kamen, L'Affaire Louis Trio, and Gold. Talking of NRJ, they are busier than ever sponsoring countless tours from now till the end of the year. These include Peter Gabriel in the French provinces (**RTL** are sponsoring Gabriel in Paris), French singer Francois Valery, Cock Robin, Kool & The Gang, Chris Rea, France Gall, Depeche Mode, The Communards, The Cure, Marillion, Boy George and Michel Jonaz!

BBC Completes Local Radio Network

London - The BBC is to complete its network of local radio stations, even though it has had to cut back drastically on its spending because the licence fee has been tied to the Retail Price Index.

It will now spend £13 million on the final seven stations (Glooucester; Hereford and Worcester; Wiltshire; Suffolk; Surrey and Berkshire; Warwickshire; and Dorset) at a saving of 20% on the original costing.

Michael Checkland, BBC

director general, says the stations are financed by savings made at the BBC over the past three years. The BBC has been under great pressure from the government to cut costs. The seven new stations should be completed by the end of 1990.

But Checkland says the BBC will not follow ITV in transmitting television through the night, and will not be involved in community radio. "Our future horizons are nothing if not realistic," he says.

Westwood Signs Deal With Rock Over London

A major trans-Atlantic deal has been struck between US leading syndicator Westwood One and the UK's Rock Over London, the former assuming all distribution rights for the weekly British rock radio showcase. The deal, effective January 1 1988, also incorporates Rock Over London's other regular show - the short form stations and has a feature "The British Wax Museum", and many other ventures between the two companies are confidently expected.

Commenting on the deal, Thom Ferro, Vice President and General Manager of the Westwood One radio network, said: "It's always a pleasure to be associated with great radio programmes and Rock Over London certainly qualifies. Not only does it stand on its own as one of the most influential showcases of British rock music, it's a perfect compliment to all of Westwood One's rock-oriented programming."

Executive Producer Steven Saltzman's response was equally enthusiastic as he explained to M&M: "This is a very exciting period for us and we are delighted. According to the American magazine Radio and

Records, we are currently the fifth most popular AOR programme in the States and with Westwood's backing I believe we could do even better. Westwood is a hungry company and I want a hungry company to be running our products!"

Rock Over London is currently heard on more than 200 American stations and has affiliates in Canada, Hong Kong and Australia.

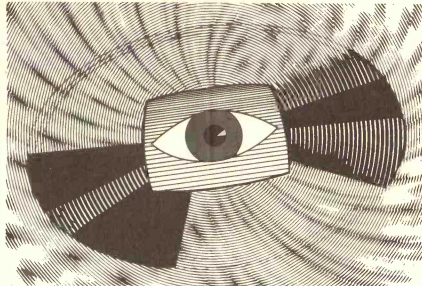

Local French TV Proves Successful

The latest experiment in local television in France has exceeded all expectations. A hard core of five people, three television professionals and two lawyers, joined forces in Deauville to broadcast for 31 days from August 13 to September 13. Once the authorisation was received from the National Commission On Communication And Freedom (CNCL), the totally independently funded project went ahead programming from 08.00 to 21.30 hours seven days a week.

Dominique Farran, General Manager of the project, describes the programming as "heart and soul - M.D.P. Building A Bridge To You Heart - One Plus One New Order The Faith - Tusc Square Highlights - The Press Palace

Although two similar experiments took place in the skiing resort of Avoriaz in January

'86 and January '87, Farran describes this latest venture as a big 'premier' since the success of the project brought to the public notice the possibilities of local television. The group expects to receive the authorisation from the CNCL for an all year round local tv for Deauville by next month, and hopes to eventually set up other stations in different towns around the country. One in Annecy, which will also cover certain areas in Switzerland, has been mooted as the next likely French city.

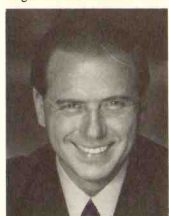
It took a team of 40 people and a budget of £500,000, generously supplemented with sponsorship from local supermarkets and banks. Deals were also struck with local FM radios for fast promotion and some peak hours saw a total of 13 minutes of commercials screened.

UK Cable To Go Above Ground

London - The British government is considering using above-ground transmission systems to speed up the growth of cable television in the UK.

Department of Trade & Industry officials are looking at a multi-point microwave distribution (MMDS), a system widely used in North America. The Cable Television Association

has already had discussions on the subject with parliamentary under-secretary John Butcher.

The advantage of MMDS is that it avoids the need to dig up roads. The CTA believes that if it were adopted in the UK, it would dramatically increase cable penetration and generate the financial resources needed to develop a genuine national cable system.

Cool, Candid And In Control

Mick Jagger Talks To M&M About The Politics Of The Music Industry

By witnessing the birth of British R&R, Mick Jagger has seen rock culture develop from its rebel status of twenty years ago into a common and highly acceptable phenomenon, which is now regulated by a profitable music industry. Jagger has shaped the course of R&R and has managed to come out cool and in control. But how long can a man carry on? The video of Jagger's latest single, *Let's Work*, shows him frantically running along the highway, and tells us to 'be proud and stand tall'. Despite his age (44), he is still regarded by many as a sex symbol. This is just part of the game for Jagger: "All new talent that comes along, be it Prince or Samantha Fox, is to do with sex appeal". So, if R&R in the 80s has been encapsulated by a big money making industry, yet with the themes remaining unchanged, what then is new and different?

The days of 'Sympathy With The Devil' are over. Whereas an interview with Jagger in the 70s would automatically be accompanied by a good bottle of Jack Daniels, mineral water is now the favourite drink. In the 80s we have to get up and work. Live Aid has brought the belief that rock artists carry a responsibility towards such issues as hunger, Aids and Apartheid. Today's artist, the model for many young children, should be aware of his powerful and influential position: the rock artist has come of age.

Jagger only partly agrees. "Let's talk about music: how many songs can you come up with, that deal with South Africa? Maybe one or two. It isn't that common. I have one song on my new album, *War Baby*, an anti-war song, about being born with the ruins of Europe. And I have other

songs that have social comments like *Primitive Cool*, but in the main, political and social themes in popular songs have never been that common. Not only that: they haven't been successful. Especially in the US, music has become the property of big companies. Politics will never be encouraged by them; even if the companies don't realise it, they will just naturally shy away from it. They would rather go for good look-

ing artists, singing about love. The whole industry, including the radio stations, don't even want to hear about reality. We are in a very funny business: we think we're on the cutting edge, but we're not at all. It is a very conservative industry which is just in for what it can get. Of course I'm not saying I am not part of it, but at least I can see it."

Although well informed on the 'business' side of music, Jagger actually despises that aspect of music and prefers to be involved with it to an absolute minimum. However, he has some clear and outspoken views on certain sides of the industry. Many Europeans are concerned by the dominant position that England and America still take in the flow of cultural goods, including music. This does not worry Jagger: "With all these music satellite services, there is a danger of obliterating whatever slight national character there might be in music. But some of these

countries, and I'm not going to mention them, have never produced any pop music of any worth, so the demise of such non-existent music may not be the worst thing in the world. Yes, as far as culture is concerned, Europe is very much part of the American culture. In the worst possible way of course. And that is obviously going to continue."

Jagger is not an avid fan of today's music scene. He hates U2 ("they depress me"), he likes the shows of Prince and thinks The Cure are a nice post-punk skiffle group. The most recent record he bought was a new version of Beethoven's 9th, but: "I do listen to current popular music on the radio. Most of it is crap, just acceptable pap that big companies want to make, and it's always been like that. But I don't like to be a slave to what's current, because I don't really feel that it does me any good."

While other mega stars such as Michael Jackson or Prince hardly give any interviews, Mick Jagger is still on the road. Although plans for a live tour are uncertain, he is currently engaged in a hectic European promo schedule. Does he still like doing interviews? "I don't find them a fabulous pleasure. What I like about it, is seeing all those different towns that I don't go to very much. Like Stockholm, I haven't been there for ten years". Usually Jagger brings his tape recorder to interviews (M&M was excused this threat) to keep track of what people are asking. "The list of questions is hilarious, unbelievably funny!"

In everything Jagger does, recording, the choice of musicians, interviews: he requires absolute control. Maybe that is why he is still alive and well after 20 years of R&R. With regards to the video of *Let's Work*, he feels it is of major importance to understand its technical intricacies. "The making of that video was rather complex. I hadn't understood the technical things involved, it would have been very hard for me to perform in it. Normally the camera more or less follows you, but in this case I had to follow it in order to keep in the frame." Produced by Zbig Rybczynski ("that Lunatic Pole"), the different moves from the extras involved on the highway were recorded with the computer registering those moves. Back in the studio, people were put on conveyor belts and the camera then repeated the moves that were done on the highway. "This is why I had to understand so clearly in the studios exactly what the camera was doing."



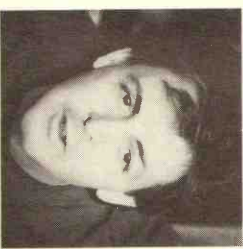

Interesting news from the Paul McCartney camp, where we can reveal that plans call for a great deal more than just his *All The Best* compilation. Since the early seventies, Paul has been talking about releasing an LP of recent singles, b-sides and unsung songs under the title *Kold Kurz*. The idea came back to life earlier this year and upon returning from holiday in August he made it his top priority, entering his East Sussex studio with producer Chris Thomas and engineer Bill Price. The set should now see the light of day in 1988. There's also the strong possibility of a collection of McCartney promo videos to be released before the end of the year, possibly to tie in with *All The Best*.

More McCartney matters: his next single *Once Upon A Long Ago* is expected in November. It will be backed with a song called *Back On My Feet* which he co-wrote with Elvis Costello... it is also rumored that those prolific producers Stock Aitken and Waterman might be working with McCartney in months to come after the quartet all got together at his Buddy Holiday memorial party the other day.

Still with **The Beatles**, another possible video release we've heard about is an official home video collection, approved by Apple and including all the Fab Four promos from *Ticket To Ride* to *The Ballad Of John And Yoko*. Sounds mouth-watering... **Jules Lennon** has moved into a plush house in Montreux, Switzerland, overlooking Lake Geneva, and plans to stay at least a year to write his third album.

The Secret Policeman's

Third Ball is the new Amnesty International benefit album recorded live over four nights at the London Palladium last March. The artists featured include Mark Knopfler with Chet Atkins whose contribution is a gentle acoustic guitar version of *Imagine*, Peter Gabriel sings *Biko*, Dave Gilmour joins Kate Bush for *Running Up That Hill*. Fans of hers will remember that he was very influential in launching her career - and there are familiar songs from Duran Duran, Lou Reed, Bob Geldof, Jackson Browne, Joan Armatrading, Erasme and Nick Kershaw. All royalties from the album will be donated to Amnesty International.

It looks likely that sales of CD singles will once again become eligible for the national chart at the start of November, when the trial three-month exclusion period comes to an end. Some record companies have continued to produce the discs anyway, but often only for promotional purposes, as for example with the current **Hue & Cry** release *Strength To Strength*.

After only a year with Polydor, **That Petrol Emotion** have left the label, apparently disillusioned with changes in record company personnel and the way they've been promoted during recent months. As they plan their next move, *Genius Move*, the song they were set to release shortly is being held back and may have to be shelved due to contractual problems. Their autumn dates are safe but an American tour now looks unlikely. Also searching for the right record deal are **The Pogues**, currently basking in the reflected Celtic glory of U2 as they tour the US east coast. The band are still officially signed to Stiff but have made it known that they're ready to move on. They've just finished work on a new album produced by Steve Lillywhite and hope to find a new home for it by the end of the year.

Rock Over London is the UK's weekly rock music showcase presented by popular DJ Graham Dene and syndicated to international radio. The programme goes across America, Canada, Australia and the Far East with expansion into Europe planned for later this year.

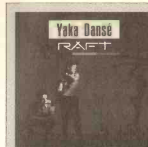

The British foursome continue their nice, lightweight pop full of tuneful harmonies and with a charmingly local feel. Unfortunately a number of lyrics have a piercing, moralistic undertone... Only on the sad song *Johannesburg* does this truly work as it is sung with so much conviction. Also try *I Can't Put My Finger On It* and *Bo Down*.

The Bolshoi

Lindy's Party - Beggars Banquet

Self-written and self-produced by this eccentric British rock band, this is a rather experimental party of highly intriguing arrangements and non-mainstream instruments, shaking a cocktail of 60s, acid rock, punk and cabaret. Key cuts include *Lindy's Party*, *Auntie Jane* and *Barrowlands*.

Shona Laing

South - Virgin

Talented singer/songwriter from New Zealand launches European debut, full of intelligent, emulator-driven pop/rock songs - radio-friendly! (Glad I'm Not A Kennedy) includes speech fragments of JFK and is definitely the LP's striking track. Caught and Docky-rapped on *A River* sound more familiar.

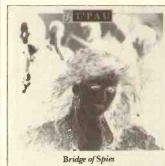
Cliff Richard
