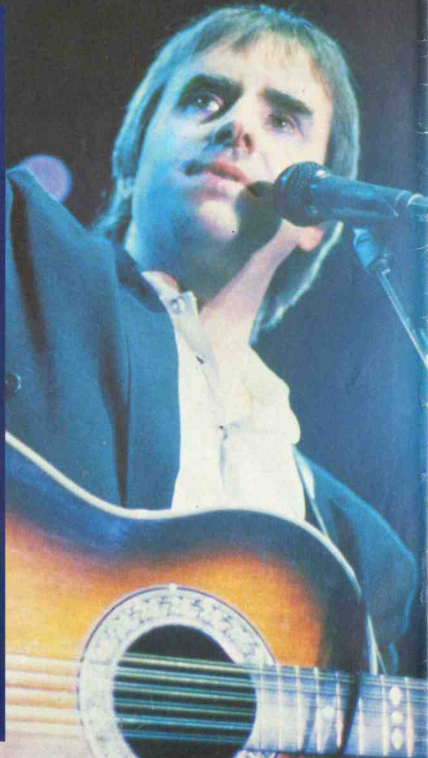

Specialist Radio - The Key To Success?

Is specialist radio - or "narrow casting" - the future for European broadcasters? The popularity of the oldies format in France (Nostalgie, Europe 2) and the success of Sky Radio's "mellow adult contemporary format" could mean targeted formats are the key to survival in a competitive market.

This has led Ton Lathouwers, Sky Radio's Operations Manager in Holland, to suggest the launch of two new outlets, Sky Rock and Sky Classic. Lathouwers: "The infrastructure is ready and we could start with these new formats within a month." But News International, which owns 51% of Sky Radio, feels it is too early to add new services.

Meanwhile, West German radio consultant BCI points to the private station Antenne Bayern, which adopted a strict adult con-

CLT To Buy Into Tele 5?

Munich - Luxembourg-based CLT says it is on the verge of buying a stake in the West German private TV station Tele 5. This follows a bid for the majority of Tele 5 shares by Axel Springer (see Music & Media issues 9 & 12).

According to CLT's General Secretary, Gaston Thorn, negotiations with Tele 5's owners - Silvio Berlusconi (45%), Herbert Klotjer (50%) and Wolfgang Fischer (5%) - have already taken place. "We have come to terms on a price and the deal is almost complete."

Thorn says the final deal will be a package between the existing partners and CLT. The latter expects to buy between 20-25% of Tele 5. The size of the stake is partly dependent on a decision by the West German media council which will specify how much CLT is allowed to acquire. CLT already owns 48% of RTL Plus, another West German private TV station.

And Thorn stressed that CLT's interest in Tele 5 does not imply that it wants

to give up its stake in RTL Plus. "However, I believe that four general stations (RTL Plus, Sat 1, Tele 5, Pro 7) is simply too many." He says he would like RTL Plus and Tele 5 to complement one another rather than compete.

Tele 5 joined Sat 1 and RTL Plus on a terrestrial frequency in Munich at the beginning of April. □

Nimbus Moves Into Europe

Nimbus Records plans to expand its European operations this summer and will open an office in Paris. Nimbus Records Paris will act as a bridge into Europe for all aspects of the Nimbus operation: CD manufacture, the Nimbus Records label and CD ROM.

The new office will be headed by Serena Woolf, currently Manager Public Relations Nimbus Records International, based in the UK.

Count Labinsky, Nimbus President: "Since the creation of a new marketing department early last year, the Nimbus Records CD

label has established an important foothold in the European marketplace and turnover has doubled. This new and crucially timed step will enable us to make further inroads into Europe on all fronts with the aim of the fast-approaching new market of 1992." □

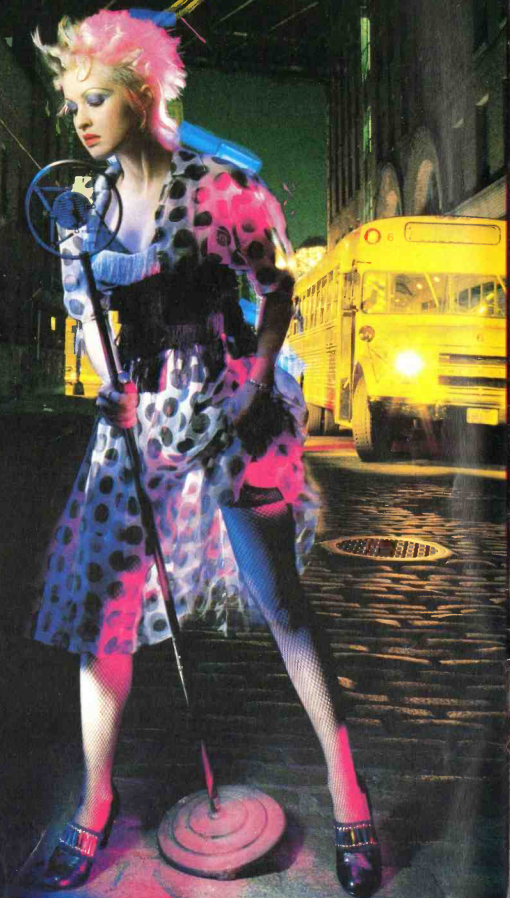

The Heavy's is a compilation

of excerpts from classic metal hits performed by a star-studded group of hard rock veterans. Excerpts include *Smoke On The Water*, *Jump* and many more, adding up to a total running time of 15 minutes on the 12".

Bruno Huber, Head Of A&R BMG Ariola Switzerland: "We

think this joint venture stands a very good chance of being very successful, since hard rock is an ever-growing market. The idea of having the watch advertisement and the record sleeves share the same design is very promising."

Zappa Plans World Orchestra

Frank Zappa's company, Why Not, is planning to recruit a World Orchestra to perform at the World Expo '92 in Seville. Zappa: "I hope to have 12 musi-

cians by the end of the year. The idea is that they should be ethnic musicians able to read music - no easy task.

"Our first move will be to

film a video to give the artists pre-promotion prior to exposure. They will then perform occasional concerts at smaller festivals. And after that I will recruit a backing orchestra of either 40 or 80 musicians and by late 1990 we will record an LP."

Zappa is inviting composers around the world to compose five to eight minute classical pieces, but the initial concerts will also include a strong element of popular music - some of which may be accompanied by lyrics.

DJs Are Exchangeable!

Does a playlist limit or improve a station's identity? According to Louis Verschuur, Head Of Programmes for Dutch VARA radio, playlists might be "boring" (DJs Massaging of Radio Stockholm in last week's Rap) but they are a necessity.

The Dutch radio (and TV) system is well known for its complexity: eight broadcasting organisations have to share one pop channel, Radio 3. This obviously does not build loyal audiences. Verschuur: "And that is why you must have a playlist, to create a certain identity for the listener. It is very important to make Tuesday - the day that we broadcast on Radio 3 - a very special one."

Verschuur sees the playlist as a means of streamlining daytime

programmes. "And this may sound rude, but the personality of the DJ is completely interchangeable! The main thing is to create an identity for the station and the DJ is of minor importance to that."

VARA's playlist has 15 records compiled by nine DJs with Verschuur as a consultant. Half of the records are the so-called "Verrukkefijke 15" (The Delicious 15) which are voted for by

the audience and the other half are the DJs' choices. "Our playlist definitely anticipates trends and covers a broad base of the musical spectrum."

With the singles market declining, many DJs wonder if the policy of programming singles should still be dominant. If albums and CDs are the sound-carriers of the future, why not play a lot more album tracks? Verschuur: "The fact that singles sales are decreasing doesn't mean that listening habits (for singles) decreases too. VARA is an organisation that should appeal to everybody. So during the day we programme a lot of singles while the evening/night-time format allows for album tracks."

Pepsi Stays With Madonna Ads

Despite the commotion caused by Madonna's video clip *Like A Prayer* (see Music & Media issue 14), London-based Pepsi International says it has no reason to discontinue airing the 30 and 60 second commercials featuring Madonna.

This is in contrast to the US where Pepsi, in fear of public confusion between the advertising spot and the video, has withdrawn its commercials. According to a spokesman for Pepsi International in London, each market is entitled to decide for itself whether to scrap the commercials or not. Pepsi's 'Make A Wish' commercial, starring Madonna, is currently on air in Europe.

Va Bank Tour

Top Russian rock group Va Bank are currently doing showcase gigs in West Germany and France in the hope of creating interest for their new LP *Va Bank* is released on the Finnish label Polarvox. Va Bank were introduced to the international media at this year's MIDEM.



READ ALL ABOUT IT

MCA, who has an exclusive record distribution contract with WEA, is about to make an announcement on a possible joint venture involving the USSR. Details were expected at a press conference in New York last week.

Radio Monte Carlo (RMC) is believed to be on the point of taking a 10% share in the French music TV channel Euromusic which has applied for a transponder on the TDF1 satellite (see page 12). NRJ is the only other radio station with an interest in the channel and is the second biggest shareholder with 14% (Generale Des Eaux has a 15% stake).

The list of European TV crews planning to report from the MIDEM is growing. These include: La Cinq, Rapids, Tele 5, VideoMusic, Super Channel, Music Box, Veronica and Moscow TV & radio. And two major press conferences have just been announced by Stevie Wonder and Sting who will talk on behalf of the Rain Forest Foundation.

It seems the official French Top 30 album chart is shortly to be expanded into a Top 50. The chart is compiled by Nielsen Marketing for Canal Plus, Europe 1 and the record industry.

The notorious US heavy metal band W.A.S.P. appear to have gone weak at the knees. If you look very carefully, you will see a difference on the US and European covers of *The Headless Children* LP. Both versions picture a selection of the world's buddies such as Idi Amin, Hitler and - on the US cover - Ayatollah Khomeini. The decision to change the European sleeve came from the W.A.S.P. management and BMI Records in Europe "due to the political climate". So you see, the band whose stage performance is an obsession with death are probably not normal boys underneath.

France's subscription channel Canal Plus doesn't seem to understand the concept of free concerts. When the station gave on-air info about one of the concerts promoted by OCEI FM and the Ministry Of Youth (without naming the sponsors), it failed to mention that the gigs were free of charge. A fact which did not stop Canal Plus from offering tickets as prizes in a Canal Plus/Mintel competition!

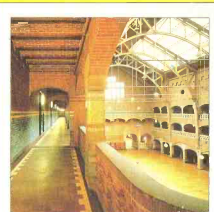

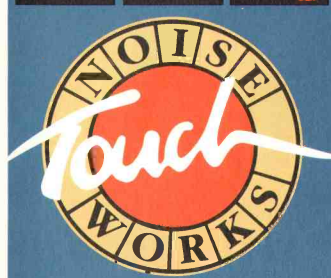

Super Gold Satellite Service Planned

A new satellite-delivered radio service, Super Gold - The Oldies Channel, is to be launched on July 1. Super Gold's Managing Director, Graham Kentley, told Music & Media: "We have been talking to six IR stations and two English-language 'expatriate' stations in Europe."

There will be three distinct segments to Super Gold's operation: a daytime service from 06:00 - 18:00 hours; an overnight service from 23:00 - 06:00 hours; the remaining hours will be used for tailor-made distribution of commercials, interviews and special features.

Despite the recent closure of former satellite service Radio Nova International and Radio Radio's alleged problems, Kentley

believes that Super Gold can be a viable operation. "We have done a lot of market research, and an oldies formula is required by AM oldies stations."

Also, unlike Nova and Radio Radio, Super Gold will be charging its subscribers. The fee will be based on the stations' advertising rate cards. There will also be two minutes of network advertising each hour, which stations will sell themselves.

Super Gold's Programme Director will be Tony Gillham, an experienced broadcaster currently freelancing for Bristol-based Brunel Radio and BBC Radio Bedfordshire. According to Kentley, Super Gold is looking to move to Astra in the future. □

Global Interest For 'Big World Cafe'

London-based distributor Picture Music International (PMI) has sold its world music series 'Big World Cafe' to Bravo Cable Network in the US and is negotiating licences with "a substantial number" of other broadcasters, according to Dawn Stevenson, PMI's TV Sales Manager.

Stevenson says discussions are at an advanced stage in Denmark, Italy, Holland, Spain, Australia, the Far East and several other countries. "It's proved an immensely popular show - audiences all over the world are beginning to tune into music from beyond their own national bound-

aries and this is obviously a highly accessible show," she added.

'Big World Cafe', currently airing on the UK's commercial Channel 4, is a series of 10 one-hour shows featuring performances by global artists recorded live at London's Britten Academy and location specials from various countries.

The series is produced by UK independents Zenith Norman, Spellbound Pictures and has presented acts such as Tabu Ley from Zaire, Fishbone from the US, Germany's Dagmar Krause and the UK's New Order. □

The Ivor Novello Winners

London - Some of the biggest names in pop received trophies at the 1988 Ivor Novello Awards, presented by the British Academy of Songwriters, Authors & Composers (BASCA) and sponsored by the Performing Right Society (PRS).

Paul McCartney was rewarded for his outstanding services to British music and Cliff Richard received an award for "lifetime achievement" after 30 years as a chart artist. There were two winners in the songwriter of the year section: the "hit factory" team of Stock, Aitken and Waterman and George Michael, who col-

lected a second Ivor for *Faith*, which was named international hit of the year.

The most performed work of 1988 was the Stock, Aitken and Waterman creation *I Should Be So Lucky*, by Kylie Minogue. Sting collected the best song (music and lyrics) award for *They Dance Alone*. The best film work was *Two Hearts* (Theme From 'Buster') by Phil Collins and Lamont Dozier.

John Isles and Mark Knopfler were also at the Grosvenor House Hotel to be honored for Dire Straits' outstanding contribution to British music. □

UK Radio Is Depressing
Says Kershaw

London - This year's Radio Academy Music Awards, held on April 5, seemed a fairly safe affair to many delegates. BBC Radio 1's Andy Kershaw set the mood of the conference by admitting, "I find radio generally very depressing".

When examining the differences between daytime and evening programming, Kershaw said: "We've forgotten how to listen to the radio." He also said he was against specialist programmes. "Generic radio is not only bad for music, it is also bad for radio," said Kershaw. "While it may make good business sense, in terms of packaging a product, it means that more stations are competing for the same listeners, with a tendency to go for the tried-and-tested soft option."

Adam White, former Editor-in-Chief of Billboard and currently International Editor of Music Week, gave an insight into the state of US radio, while warning about some of the dangers. "The breadth of popular music is better catered for in the UK, so let's be careful about importing America's tendency for narrow formatting." However, White said he

liked the sense of outrageousness, fun and activity on US radio.

As an example he mentioned KIQQ in Los Angeles which recently hired Scott Shannon from New York's top station, Z-100, on a salary of US\$ 2 million (plus bonuses). Westwood One, who owns the station, describes KIQQ as "an out of control screaming Ferrari with no rear-view mirror!"

The issue of whether the UK should adopt the US practice of including airplay details when compiling charts was also discussed. The US charts are less volatile, but many delegates felt this practice could retard the development of music.

A topic that emerged during several sessions was that the tastes of older audiences are not really catered for, by radio programmers or record companies. BBC Radio 2's David Verevor said he was, convinced there was money to be made by concentrating less on the charts and looking more closely at record companies' back-catalogue and repertoire. □

Cliff Richard adopted an unusual method of choosing the next - his 100th - single this week. He invited members of his fan club to join him at the London Palladium where he played them new versions of six new tracks and asked them to vote for their favourite. However, three songs tied in first place so there is still no final decision.

Five Young Cannibals, Roland Gift was recently the host of a new Channel 4 TV show called "Star Test" in which celebrities are interviewed by a specially designed computer.

Deacon Blue, the band who brought you the song *Chocolate Girl*, now take choicobolism one step further with a promotion for their new LP, *When The World Knows Your Name*. All you have to do is consume five chocolate "Pix" bars, save the wrappers and get UK10.50 off the LP in the US Orange stores.

There is talk of a live extravaganza by Stock Aitken & Waterman in the summer. They are planning a package featuring some of the stars who have helped them almost take over the charts in the last few

Looking ahead, EMI assure the first UK band to announce pre-Christmas singles. They will spend December promoting the fourth album and instead of Wembley, have included the new London Docklands arena on their itinerary. The men with the most painful wrist in rock this week - no jokes, please - must be the Tani fronted of Black Sabbath who celebrated the release of the band's new single *Headless Cross* and his survival as the only original member of the band by personally signing 2,500 copies of the record? □

Rock Over London is the UK's weekly rock music showcase presented by Graham Dove and produced on international radio. The programme goes across the US, Canada, Mexico, Australia and the Far East.

Biggest Campaign Ever
For Simple Minds

Street Fighting Years, the new Virgin album by Simple Minds, will be accompanied by the biggest marketing campaign in the band's 10-year recording career. Released on May 2, it is their first studio LP since 1985's *Once Upon A Time*.

Advertising will begin in the national and music press. Virgin, Our Price, Woolworths and other stores will place advertisements in the newspapers and there will be co-operative radio advertising with HMV the week of release.

The following week, commencing May 8, will see a nationwide TV advertising campaign. Throughout the two weeks

there will be a poster campaign with HMV plus a national in-store display campaign. Simple Minds' Marketing Manager, Julie Durrant: "This is only the basis of our campaign. We are likely to add more press and possibly TV, especially around Christmas and around the time of their summer dates." The band will play at three major venues during the summer (see Tour Page).

The album's first single, *Bel-fast Child*, topped UK charts earlier this year, giving the Scottish band their first ever no. 1. Durrant: "You can't have a better marketing tool than that." □

The Cult - Above Underground Status

New NDR Shows
To Compete With
Privates

Hamburg - Public broadcaster Norddeutscher Rundfunk (NDR), whose latest slogan is "the best thing about the North", has launched a new programme structure on its four radio channels.

In response to competition from the numerous private radio stations within its area, NDR's pop channel has launched a new show.

"Club Extra" presents concert recordings, new releases and special features as well as general information and artist interviews. The show, which goes out daily from 2000 to 2200 hours on NDR 2, is hosted by different DJs including radio personalities like Klaus Wellershaus, Andreas Schulz, Matthias Boehm, Peter Urban and Rudi Rockenschaub.

At the same time NDR 3, the channel dedicated to classical, jazz and world music, has

introduced a new programme called "Zwischentöne" (Inter-mediate Tones), which features avant-garde, jazz-related and new age repertoire.

NDR 4, with six AM and five FM transmitters throughout the states of Schleswig-Holstein, Bremen, Saxony, Hamburg and Lower Saxony, went on air at the beginning of the month. While absorbing a number of talk programmes that can be heard on NDR 1's various regional services, NDR 4 will also offer in-depth discussion shows, programmes for foreign listeners and educational programmes. The new channel will also feature music - everything from nostalgic music from the US (Music Hall), show music ("Showtime"), international folk and mediative music ("Ohrenweide") to schlager, operetta and rock & roll evenings.

RB Launches 'Flip'

Public broadcaster Radio Bremen 4 (RB4) has increased its daily output by introducing a new breakfast show starting at 0600 hours - three hours earlier than before.

Called 'Flip', the programme features music, interviews, games and quizzes with pop stars and politicians. The show is hosted by three presenters: Brigitte

Peteregi who moves from SWF, Lou Richter who was formerly at Radio 107, and RB4's Axel Sommerfeld.

RB's daily evening show is also starting one hour earlier at 1900 hours. Its format will be amended to include more album plays and longer specials and interviews. □

RSH Gold Awards Presented

Kiel - State-wide private Radio Schleswig-Holstein (RSH) hosted a star-studded show to present the second annual RSH Gold awards.

Head of Music Sabine Neu says the station's listeners in Hamburg as well as Schleswig-Holstein, were asked to pick their favourite songs produced in West Germany, as well as the best German-language artist. The winners included Sandra, who with the help of her producer/husband Michael Bohlen, has become an international star.

Other artists to win were former Rainbow keyboard player and Peter Mafay's current partner, Tony Carey, with *Room With A View*; rappers Edelweis; the legendary re-formed Rattos; Austria's Macho Macho; Rainhard Fendrich; Frank Farian-produced Milli Vanilli; novelty song stars Klaus & Klaus; and generation-bridging crooner, Engelbert.

The show, during which 70-schlager stars Marianne Rosenbergs and Ricky Shayan presented new songs produced by Dieter Creutz, was recorded by the Munich-based private Tele 5. □

Bertelsmann Predicts Soaring Profits

Gutersloh - Bertelsmann, the West German media giant whose interests include BMG Music, says it predicts a net income for the year ending 30 June 1990 to soar to £1.64 billion. This compares with a figure of £132.4 million for the fiscal year ending

June 1988, and a projected £114.1 million for 1989.

The company acquired RCA Music in 1986. As previously reported, Bertelsmann is currently issuing profit-sharing certificates worth £73.5 million to improve its equity ratio. □

Bonnie Bianco - Straight From The Heart

Whether it is a soaring ballad or a sizzling dance groove, love is a topic that Bonnie Bianco has been singing about since her debut single nine years ago. The subject of her latest single, *Straight From The Heart*, is the same. The track comes from Bianco's WEA debut album *True Love, Lory*.

For LP Bianco worked at 10 studios in West Germany and the UK with the cream of West Germany's songwriters and producers for the LP. They included Christian Widmer (Sally Oldfield), Gunter Mende and Alexander Derouge (Jennifer

Rush), Johan Daansen and Diemar Kawohl (Vision Fields), Hubert Kemmler and Markus Loefer (Sandra), Juergen Fritz, Armand Volker and the UK's Gus Dudgeon. And the result is an emotionally charged and mature set of songs that will appeal to a wide audience.

When Lory Bianco was 17, she and her sister Holly formed The Bianco Sisters. The single *Tender In Love* was released in 1980. A year later, she was discovered during an audition by the Italian hit composer/producers, Guido and Maurizio De Angelis.

In 1983, Bianco played the leading role in a four-part TV film, "Cinderella '80". This modern fairytale of a young American rock singer who goes to Italy and falls in love with her keyboard player (Pierre Corso), was shown in West Germany in 1987. It was so popular that the soundtrack album reached no. 3 in the charts, while the single *Soy*, went to no. 1. Bianco's first solo LP, *Just Me*, followed in the same year on the Metromone label. □

WDR Gives Green Light To Co-Productions

Cologne - Public broadcaster Westdeutscher Rundfunk (WDR) says there are no legal reasons why it should not produce a co-operative programme with private companies in NorthRhine-Westphalia.

WDR holds 20% of the shares in the planned private station Radio NRW which will provide a 24-hour state-wide programme matrix. It will be broadcast in

part by the 45 local private stations to be licensed this year.

Other major shareholders in Radio NRW are Pressfunk (65%), a joint venture of the state's newspaper publishers, and the media giant Bertelsmann (15%). Strong objections to this have been raised by the state newspapers office, which has applied for a court injunction. □

The station's format includes Italian and international tracks, plus hits from yesterday. No DJs are employed and only CDs are used. The programming format is

experimental until May.

Crudelia is owned by the Tuscan-based advertising consultant Studio 80 which also has interests in television. The company opened Tuscan's first private TV station, RTV 38 in 1975. RTV 38 later merged with Euro TV, which in turn merged with the Milan-based network Odem in 1987.

Mia Martini - Style, Class & Emotion

Mia Martini has style, class and plenty of emotion. When she presented the powerful ballad *Almeno Tu Nell'Universo* (At Least There's You In The Universe) at this year's San Remo Song Festival she won a coveted critics award and many new fans.

Her new album for the Fonit Cetra label has just been released and contains 10 classic Italian songs which shift in mood and rhythm. Recorded at Rome's Triana Studios, *Martini* Mia features Giovanni Sanjust as the artistic director.

Martini is currently working on promotional appearances on TV, including a spot on RAI's



variety show "Europa Europa" and popular live music show "International Doc Club" where she will be featured over three days. A nationwide concert tour will follow.

Martini, who is 41, has been singing in public since she was 12 years old and recorded her first single, *Padre Davvero*, in 1970. The song won the Festival Di Nove Tendenze at Viareggio. Martini withdrew from the music business in 1983 and her appearance at San Remo this year marks her return. □

The competition, which runs from April 4-29, is featured on a special daily 15 minute slot called "L'Echo Del Rock Contest" which is broadcast at 15:00 hours and includes interviews with the participating acts.

Contro Radio's Fabio Crasciole is responsible for the competition which is in its sixth year. Crasciole says it has become an important event for establishing new talent. One of last year's groups, De Generis, has since secured a deal with the local label Sound City Records.

However the region's two main indie labels are not en-

thusiastic about the competition. Contempo's International Manager, Francesco Alaimo, says that most interesting groups already have a recording deal and groups who enter competitions are usually the worst.

Materiali Sonori's General Manager, Giampiero Bizzi, says rock music should not be about winners or losers. But he believes that any initiative in Italian rock is valid. □

NRJ Profits Doubled In 1988

by Jacqueline Escoffier

Paris - Private network NRJ has announced a Frf 68 million profit for 1988 which represents an impressive increase of 107% over 1987. The station's 1988 turnover was Frf 315 million.

NRJ has established a successful top 40 format for its 18-35 target audience and Music Programme Director Max Guazzini sees no reason to change it. "The profits have proved that we are doing it right. Why change something that works?"

This is a view echoed by NRJ head Jean-Paul Bauderoux: "Look at the performance of Europe 1 - they only made Frf 30 million profit. We have a better product. Our profits are the result of good management, dynamic

marketing and keeping the advertisers interested.

"We are now looking around, as a buyer, for radio stations in the rest of Europe. We are particularly interested in West Germany and Spain - notably Munich, Dusseldorf, Frankfurt and Madrid. But we haven't signed any agreements yet, we are still at the early stage of searching for suitable partners."

NRJ's ratings are doing well too; in Grenoble and the Isere region, for example, it has gained third place with 14% and 11% of the audience share behind RMC (15.6% and 17.3%) and leaders France Inter (20.4% and 15.1%). □

Euromusique Outlines Operating Plans

by Neil Watson

Euromusique, the proposed music channel competing for a transponder on the TDFI satellite, has outlined its operating plans to the CSA (see Music & Media issue 13).

The channel, whose shareholders include CBS, PolyGram and radio station NRJ, will have an annual budget of around £ 15.9 million. The company has applied for a broadcasting time between 21.30 and 01.00 hours daily.

Euromusique's prospective audience is the 15-35 age group and programming would concentrate on pop with a promise to respect quota obligations to provide at least 55% of production of French origin and 70% from Europe.

Besides the home dish market, Euromusique would also seek to transmit on French cable systems. Once operative, it might also seek agreements with cable operators in West Germany and Spain.

But executives have made it clear that Euromusique could only survive if granted access to terrestrial TV frequencies, particularly in the Paris region. One possibility is that part of the Euromusique service is carried by Tele Monte Carlo.

There are 12 candidates for the five transponders on TDFI. The CSA was expected to announce the successful applicants by mid-April. □

French Sales Continue To Rise

Turnover for the French music industry jumped by 41.2% in January and 26.5% in February this year compared to the same period last year, according to figures published recently by SNEP.

CDs continued to make a strong impression; sales were up a massive 93% in January and

57% in February. There was also a good showing for cassettes with sales increasing by 61% and 35% respectively.

On the vinyl side, fears were confirmed with the drop in both single and album sales: singles dropped 8% (January) and 11% (February). □

Carrere Moves Into Holland

Independent record company Carrere has started operations in Holland following a deal with the Dutch indie CNR which includes distribution. Erik Deleuw, former Sales Promotor with Carrere Belgium, is the Managing Director of the new company which will be based in Hilversum from May 5.

Deleuw: "One of our key aims will be to attract local and international talent, because no matter what everybody in Belgium is saying, the world is still in touch in Holland. So we may even sign Belgian talent here, for export to Belgium later on. I am

convinced that we will find a good strategy to market new talent with Carrere."

Deleuw says the company's catalogue will feature over 500 titles in the first three months - including pop, rock and light classical music.

"At first we will concentrate on West Germany's Capriccio label, covering the major popular classical repertoire, balanced with less known works. As Carrere Nederland will initially be a CD only label, with cassettes to follow in June, the classical repertoire is an obvious start." □

BRT Radio Around The Clock

Antwerp - Belgium's Flemish broadcaster BRT will be on air 24 hours from May 1 following a decision to extend programming by four hours (02.00 to 06.00 hours) on the BRT 1, 2, and 3 and Studio Brussel networks.

All of the BRT outlets will adopt simultaneous broadcasts from 23.30 to 06.00 hours. Programme Director & Co-

ordinator Karel De Vijver: "The first part will take us to 02.00 hours with rather sophisticated music. From then we will have some more vivid material. It will not be too specialist, and will have lots of variation. We also want to include things like phone-ins, concert reviews etc."

The programme will be broadcast live. □

Disco Dance CDs

Amsterdam - The Dutch TV merchandising company EVA is putting out three double CDs under the banner *The Original Disco Dance Collection* to mark the 10th anniversary of Disco Dance magazine.

The CD packages include tracks from major acts like Hot Chocolate, Rick Astley, Culture

Club, Bryan Ferry and Ike & Tina Turner. A national television campaign will back the release through to the end of May.

EVA was set up three years ago as a joint venture by EMI, Bova, Vinyl Benulex and BMG Arista Benulex. Disco Dance is published by the Dutch Top 40 Foundation. □

New Dutch Indie Launched

Holland has a new independent record company - Provgue Music Productions. The company was set up by Van Jan Der Linden, who helped found Dutch indie Roadrunner Records and distributor Bertus Distributie.

Last month Provgue released two CDs by Nigerian artists: *Get Yer Juju* Out by Chief Ebenezer Oyer and *Dreams Of Passion/The Bear* by Babatunde Olatunji. The label will bring out two more

CDs by African acts in the Benelux before the summer; *King Sunny Ade's Live, Live, Live*, which is already out in the US, and *Invocation* by Olatunji.

The company plans to launch a TV advertising campaign in June and July for the four releases. This will coincide with the European tours of Ade and Ebenezer, which are scheduled for this summer and are almost certain to include Holland. □

About The Rain, Dirk Blanchart's second album and his debut for BMG Ariola, marks a big step forward in this very talented artist's career.

Blanchart describes *About The Rain* as a blues LP. "Blues is not necessarily negative - although *About The Rain* is not a happy album. I just tried to fascinate my audience with a variety of music."

The LP features Blanchart on guitars, bass, keyboards and vocals. The album took almost one year to record and was produced

mainly at Ghent's Studio 1. *Rainway Tracks* was released as a single last year.

From July, Blanchart will do a series of live gigs, mainly in Belgium. "I don't want to play for 20 people just for the sake of playing somewhere outside Belgium. I think that we need a strong build-up before we tour abroad."

Blanchart began his music career with Once More, which was re-named Luna Twist.

Experiments with established producers like Steve Hillage, Paul Hardiman and Ian Brody failed to get the results Blanchart wanted and in 1985 he decided to produce his next LP, *About The Rain*, himself. It is the first Belgian album to make BBC Radio 1's playlist and Blanchart went on to produce Elisa Waut's first album plus numerous tracks for artists including Blanc De Blanc and Richenal. □

Lili & Sussie - Dancing To Success

Lili & Sussie's new LP, a remix retrospective called *Let Us Dance*, is set to be released this month by EMI Sweden. The duo, handled by Sonet outside Scandinavia, are currently on a two-week promotional visit to Japan and start a 25-date Swedish tour at the end of May.

Let Us Dance features the single *Okey Okey* which came out about a month ago and was fifth in the Swedish Eurovision finals. The LP was produced by Sweden's answer to Stock Aitken and Waterman - Ola Hakansson, Tim Norell and Anders Hansson - at Sonet Studios.

"They're definitely one of our most successful Swedish acts of the moment and we anticipate a big demand for the remix retrospective," said EMI Promotions Manager Marie Dimberg. Sisters Lili & Sussie made their TV debut in Sweden two years ago with a song called *Oh*



Mama produced by the same team. It sold over 80,000 copies and was the only domestically produced single of 1987 to go platinum.

However, Lili & Sussie had already achieved recognition in other European countries. Before the release of *Oh Mama*, another single (written and produced by the same team) had already become something of an international hit. It was called *Candy Love* and was released in France, West Germany, Italy and Holland. □

SER Plans 'Gran Musical Europe'

Madrid - Spain's number one pop network, SER's Los 40 Principales, is planning to launch a new European radio show. 'Gran Musical Europe' is the brain child of Director Rafael Revert and Music Co-Ordinator Fernando Salaverri.

SER will link up with other major European commercial radio stations to air a series of

shows featuring one Spanish and one European act per concert. Each show will be broadcast from a different European city by SER and a station in that country.

SER will select the Spanish act and will guarantee two or three months of on-air promotion for the artist chosen by the other country. In return the local station will provide the venue for the concert, a public audience and promotion for the Spanish act.

The concert will be recorded and transmitted by SER and the station in the host country. The Spanish show will be presented by Los 40 Principales' top DJ, Jose Antonio Abellan.

According to SER, a lot of stations are responding positively, including Radio Contact in Belgium, Radio Dimensione Suono in Italy and Renascença in Portugal. □

Canal 33 On Air

The Cure
Lullaby - Fiction

Those of you who feared the worst for The Cure's artistic future after 1986's *Why Can't I Be You and Hot Hot Hot*, can stop worrying. Their new single is serious pop music at its best. The backing is a strong, infectious rhythm with subtle plucked violins and sweeping strings, complemented by Robert Smith's whispering voice. Although this is not the easiest record to programme it has already become many European DJs' favourite.

Simple Minds

This Is Your Land - Virgin

Yet another ballad guaranteed to increase expectations about the forthcoming LP. A similar atmosphere to 1985's *New Gold Dream*.

INXS

Mystify - Mercury

The fifth single taken from 1987's *Kick* is a quality rock song with a definite 70s feel.

Diesel Park West

Like Princes Do - Food/EMI

A storming pop rock number from the excellent debut LP *Shakespeare Alabama*. A strong chance of a hit with a song in the US mood.

Godfathers

She Gives Me Love - Epic

The first single from the upcoming second LP, *More Songs About Love And Hate*, is a seriously catchy number with a characteristic sing-along chorus.

Jevetta Steele

Calling You - Island

BAGGAD CAFE

Baby I Don't Care - MCA

Pure pop in the post-Blondie/Pangles sense of the word with a punky edge. Good chorus as always.

Spinnin' Juke

Lifted from the OST, *Baggad Cafe*, this is a simple and beautiful song. The slow pace and the desolate harmonica break add to the spellbinding effect.

Jody Watley

Real Love - MCA

Late 80s dance music with a Jam/Lewis style of production

and an R&B chorus. Very programmable.

The Neighbourhood

Missing Out - EMI



More offbeat and effective material from this underrated band. An appealing mixture of 60s influenced music and 80s lyrics.

Natalie Cole

Miss You Like Crazy - EMI/USA

Produced by Michael Masser, this is a smooth, keyboard dominated ballad with a dramatic vocal performance.

Transvision Vamp

Baby I Don't Care - MCA

Pure pop in the post-Blondie/Pangles sense of the word with a punky edge. Good chorus as always.

Front 242

Never Stop - RARE

Sparse, menacing dance music with an elastic bass sound and an intriguing, somewhat muddy production. Very 21st Century.

Tom Petty

I Won't Back Down - MCA

Rootsy, very American rock with country overtones. Simple and charming with a nostalgic, early 70s production.



ALBUM OF THE WEEK

Bliss
Love Prayer - Parlophone

You could be forgiven for thinking that Bliss are merely a vehicle for Rachel Morrison's powerful, expressive voice. If that were true a debut album as good as this. Their real strength lies in the quality of their blues-based songs coupled with Paul Ralphes' economical production and the band's love of their chosen musical direction. Try *How Does It Feel*, *Light And Shade* and *I Walk Alone*.

The Silencers

A Blues For Buddha - RCA/BMG

On this, their second LP, The Silencers have proved that the quality of song-writing shown on *A Letter From St Paul* was no accident. If anything, the material is better and their unfussy, guitar-based material demonstrates what can be achieved within a basic song structure. Try *The Real McCoy*, *Skin Games* and *Sacred Child*.

Hithouse

Hithouse - ARS

Produced, arranged and recorded by Peter Slaghuys, this LP consists of eight house tracks with titles like *Move Your Feet To The Rhythm Of The Beat*, *I Fell Acid House Love*, *The Deep Piano House* and the European hit, *Jack To The Sound Of The Underground*. *I Don't Know* is the only conventional song on an otherwise bare and almost instrumental dance record.

Dalla/Morandi

In Europa - BMG Ariola

With a lyric sheet in five languages, this is Lucio Dalla and Gianni Morandi's attempt to conquer Europe with a collection of commercial, keyboard dominated songs. The only problem is that although the arrangements might have been fashionable a few years ago they do sound a bit dated these days. Best: *Viva and Dimmi Dimmi*.

WASP

The Headless Children - Capitol

Another bunch of aggressive and explicit material from this notorious Californian three-piece. Try *Mean Man*, *Thunderhead*, *The Neutron Bomber* and the cover of *The Who's The Real Me*.

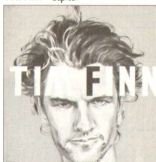
The Neville Brothers

Yellow Moon - A&M

Assisted by Willie Green on

drums, Tony Hall on bass and Paul Stoltz on guitar, the four brothers from New Orleans have produced an inspired and inspiring LP, full of brooding, soulful material. Note the inclusion of Dylan's *The Ballad Of Hollers Brown* and Sam Cooke's *A Change Is Gonna Come*. Also recommended are *Fire And Brimstone*, *100 Doo* and the title cut.

The third solo-LP by the ex-singer from Split Enz consists of 10 intelligent, well-crafted and introspective songs. The production, by Michael Froom, is pleasantly gritty and modern in a refined way. Highlights: *Young Swains*, *Tears Inside*, *Birds Swam*, *Fish Fly And A Little Mercy*.

Phoenix Snow

Something Real - Elektra

The 70s singer/songwriter is back and in good form on her first LP for eight years, an SBK production. Snow's distinctive voice is set to a backdrop of slick but highly professional musicians. *If I Can Just Get Through The Night* sounds like a hit single.

Gail Ann Dorsey's Corporate World

Gail Ann Dorsey's idea of making music is "real musicians in a room with real instruments": The US singer, songwriter and instrumentalist lives up to her idea on her highly acclaimed debut album 'The Corporate World', on WEA.



Unfortunately I did not have my band together in time, so the people came in. But still all the

rhythm tracks were recorded live. When it suits the mood and the purpose of the song, there is a

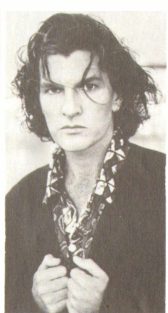
place for computer music. But it disturbs me when it is used to cut corners."

The *Corporate World* was recorded and mixed in seven studios: The Smokehouse, Angel Studios and The Roundhouse in London; Crescent Studios in Bath (UK); Ocean Way Recording in Hollywood; and The Hit Factory in New York.

Dorsey: "We recorded the strings in a different studio for space reasons. To record the vocals, I wanted to get it out of London. We went to Bath. It was a really old studio, which used to be a barn or something. It had windows, so I could look out over the countryside. Nathan took the tapes to Hollywood to get Jerry Hey and the other hornplayers. The mixing on the album was done by Nathan and Ted Hayden, the engineer, and the singles were mixed by Tom Lord Alge in New York." □

The Real Tim Finn

The third solo album by New Zealand singer/songwriter Tim Finn was recently released by Capitol/EMI. It is self-titled and is his debut LP for the label.



In 1972, Tim Finn founded Split Enz with his brother Neil. Twelve years and nine albums later, he left to pursue a solo career. In 1984 his first solo album, *Escapade*, was released and featured the hit single *Friction Too Much Friction*.

It was followed by *Big Canoe*. Meanwhile Finn also contributed to various soundtracks such as "The Coca-Cola Kid" and "Star dust".

Now Tim Finn is out. Jerry Marotta (drums), Tony Levin (bass) and David Rhodes (guitar) accompany Finn on the album which was produced by Mitchell Froom (Crowded House, Los Lobos, Richard Thompson, Tim Scott).

Finn: "Working with Mitchell was an interesting experience. He was I was influenced by English music from the 60s and ear-

ly 70s, but by going to the US and working with Mitchell I got in touch with the music that influenced him. I do not think I would have gone this way without that guidance."

The first single is the romantic *How'n I Gonna Sleep*. The video, shot in Auckland, New Zealand, was directed by Finn. Other highlights include the reggae *Parihaka*, *Birds Swim*, *Fish Fly* and *Crescendo*, which has a rocking chorus and bridge.

Tim Finn is powerful in its apparent simplicity, but below lies a personal struggle. Over the past three years, Finn has spent a lot of time travelling and reassessing his priorities. "I needed to get some distance from myself, because I was getting too serious about my work."

"I think *Big Canoe* suffered a little bit from that, by trying to put everything I could think of in it. In poor countries like Peru and Bolivia you see your selfishness. In this business it is very easy to get really egocentric and competitive."

"I have had both success and failure, probably in equal measure. The song on the new album *Been There, Done That*, refers to

that. I have seen the shallowness of success and the unimportance of so-called failure as well. I do not worship at the altar of success. Still I would like an audience, because I really want to get back on stage."

Finn has just finished two extensive European promotion tours, during which he played acoustic sets. He is now preparing for a US club-tour, which will begin next month, and there is talk of Finn performing at European festivals in the summer. □

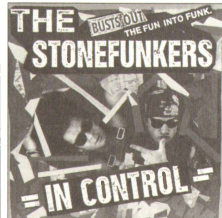

Meanwhile they are now touring there and recently performed at the prestigious Printemps De Bourges festival. In 1988, El Ultimo De La Fila played in front of more than 2.5 million people and became the first group to sell-out the Real Madrid Sport Palace for six consecutive nights.

Sillit in Spain, another ex-Talent Track tip, *Guitarra* by Raul Orellana, has been a worldwide success. So far it has been licensed to companies in the UK, West Germany, Holland, Switzerland, South Africa and Mexico. A remixed version will be released in the UK next month.

Several of the acts from Anders Moren's publishing company Misty Music have recently been signed to major labels. Without

doubt the biggest deal was for Tityo - she has just signed with Arista/BMG UK for the world except Scandinavia. There are plans to release a single in the UK in the summer. It will be *Break My Heart*, her debut effort, or *The Man In The Moon*, due for release in Scandinavia in this month or next on Telegram Records.

Other Misty Music acts currently featured on Talent Tracks that have recently made deals include Rob n' Raz (*Competition Is None*) and Two On Each Camel (*A Brand New Day*) to CBS Spain; and *Out Of The Blue* by Mostly Men which has been licensed to Musica in Portugal. The Scandinavian invasion is gaining momentum. ■

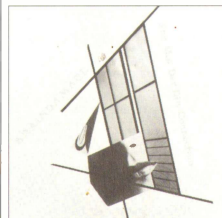

Going Independent...

Indie veteran Danielle Dax, one-time Lemon Kittens member and the star of many notable avant-garde albums, has the highest new entry on this week's chart. Her *White Knuckle Ride* on the Awesome label debuts at no. 20, three slots ahead of Situation 2's *Three Hypnotics*, whose *Justice Is Freedom* enters at no. 23.

The eagerly-awaited album by A Guy Named Gerald has been another major seller in its first week on the market. The LP, called *Hot Lemonade*, includes *Voodoo Ray*, the remixed version of which is again a top 10 indie hit a year after its original success. It enters the indie LP chart at no. 13. But the Rham label release is not the hottest new indie album. That distinction belongs to *Extreme Aggression* by Kreation on the Noise label, which debuts in the chart at no. 4. The big action next week is likely to be with McCarthy's *The Enraged Shark Inherits The Earth*. ■

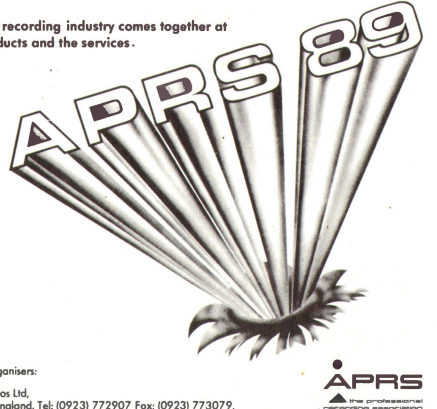
