WEA UK Encores The Tubular Bells

History repeats itself. Twenty years after the release of the album *Tubular Bells*, which heralded a new genre of instrumental pop with the artistic depth of a classical piece, multi-instrumentalist **Mike Oldfield** has come up with *part II*. The difference this time is the label on which it will be released on August 31.

The first *Tubular Bells* was released on **Virgin** in 1972 and sold 16-million copies; the sequel, co-produced by **Trevor Horn**, will be out on **WEA**. The first single off the album, *Sentinel*, will be released in mid-September.

The music and sleeve design follow the well-known format of the original album. **WEA UK**

international marketing **Mark Crossingham** says he is confident about the simplicity of the billboard promo campaign, which features the **Michael Nash**-designed tubular bell symbol.

"Because the image is so familiar, we didn't put the name of the artist on it," he says "We thought it speaks for itself.

"The album is a top priority for all our European affiliates," he continues. "The real starting point will be the concert at Edinburgh Castle on September 4, when Oldfield will perform the album in its entirety, accompanied by 17 top session musicians. [All proceeds go to the **Prince's Trust**]. We'll bring in 100 media people from all over the globe, of which seven will be from Taiwan alone.

Sony UK Sets Executive Line-Up

Sony Music Entertainment (SME) UK continues the restructuring it started four weeks ago (*M&M* August 1). As expected, chairman/CEO **Paul Russell** will run the **Columbia** label while deputy chairman **Tony Woollcott** will take control of **Epic**.

This will be the first time that both Russell and Woollcott take over the day-to-day responsibilities of a label. Ex-Epic MD **Andy Stephens** has been appointed VP of European repertoire at Sony's international office at London's Red Place and is to report to **Sony Music International** president **Bob Summer**. Stephens will assume overall responsibility for the international marketing of UK and European repertoire outside that material's country of origin.

Although this round of senior management reorganization has been completed, Russell confirms that "this is not the end of the changes we will be making.

There will be more fine-tuning along the line."

S M E employs 760 people (including the Dublin-based **Sony Music** and the **Hit Factory**) and the restructuring will reportedly not involve any redundancies. Over the second quarter of 1992, SME's album market share fell below 10%, from over 12.5% during the same period last year.

NRJ MD Nathalie Briant Dies In Plane Crash

Nathalie Briant, MD of French FM EHR network **NRJ**, died on August 14 in a plane crash in Corsica at the age of 31. Her husband, right-wing political leader **Yvon Briant**, her son and the pilot were also killed. The family was flying to Corsica to attend a political meeting. Reasons for the crash have not been determined.

A former tax consultant for law firms on both sides of the Atlantic, Briant joined **NRJ** as general secretary at the end of 1985. She was in charge of the

day-to-day administration of the company and all the legal aspects, with the special responsibility of developing **NRJ** in foreign markets.

While her efforts were concentrated principally in Germany, she was to a large extent responsible for **NRJ's** investment in **Radio 2000** in Berlin.

Briant was also one of the principal movers in guiding **NRJ** (continues on page 18)

Cyrus Crosses Over; Can Other Country Artists Follow?

Billy Ray Cyrus is climbing the charts across Europe with his catchy single *Achy Breaky Heart*, spurred on by a current 12-week run at the number one spot in the **Billboard** US Top 200 with his album *Some Gave All* on **Mercury**.

"Achy Breaky," which is number 14 in *M&M's* **EHR Top 40**, is the first country-influenced single to break in Europe in years. The cross-over pop music appeal of the single has boosted airplay across Europe, especially in the UK, Sweden, Denmark, Switzerland and Germany. Cyrus' success across the Atlantic has other country music supporters hoping that US country giants **Garth Brooks (Capitol)** and **Clint Black (RCA)** can also cross

Paul Gambaccini, **Margaret Howard** and **Nick Bailey** have joined the team of presenters at **Classic FM**, according to an announcement made by programme controller **Michael Buhkt**. He also confirmed the official launch date as September 7, at 06.00 precisely.

Howard, well known as editor and presenter of **BBC Radio 4's** "Pick Of The Week," will be presenting and editing daily news, music and arts programme "Classic Reports" from 18.00-19.00. Winner of numerous broadcasting awards, she has worked as a classical music presenter in the US.

The weekday 06.00-09.00 slot will be hosted by **Bailey**, an experienced presenter in the UK and abroad, working recently with **Radio Television Hong Kong**.

Meanwhile **Gambaccini**, journalist broadcaster and media personality, will present the "Classic FM Saturday Chart Show" on Saturdays from 09.00-12.00.

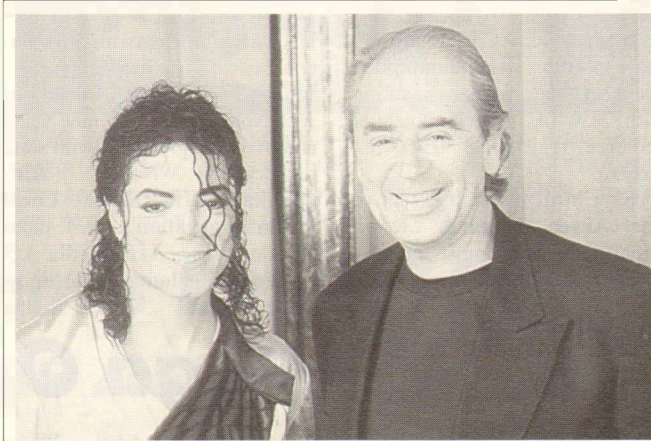
Trained as a classical pianist in his native New York, **Gambaccini** presented **BBC 1's** TV show "It's A Great Life" and has been a regular contributor to **TV-AM's** show "Good Morning Britain."

Other announcements included the appointment of **Chris Vezey** as senior producer. **Vezey's** 19-year career includes stints at **BBC Radio 1** and **2**. Meanwhile, **Anne Gregory** has been appoint-

ed as music organizer, overseeing library and output. Before taking over as label manager for **Collins Classics**, she worked for **RCA Classics**, **The Really Useful Group** and **PolyGram Classics**.

Madeleine Kasket, former classical music PR officer at **RCA Records** and **EMI Television Productions**, will become artist and events co-ordinator.

Comments **Buhkt**, "My production team comprises high-calibre staff whose combined experience covers our requirements for top radio production skills and a working knowledge of classical music. In recruiting our team of presenters, I have deliberately gone for top broadcasters, who are leaders in their fields but who aren't necessarily music specialists. Our philosophy is that good music is to be enjoyed and the task of our presenters will be to give that music to our listeners with wit and style. We shall be informative, but without being pedantic."

Charivari Leads Local Private Stations In Nuremberg Ratings

Local private AC station **Radio Charivari** is top of the private local stations in the Nuremberg area, with 108,000 daily listeners, despite a downturn of 1.8%. This puts it in third place behind the two public broadcasters hot AC/news/talk-formatted **Bayern 3** and MOR/news/talk **Bayern 1** and statewide private EHR giant **Antenne Bayern** (broadcasting from Munich). That is according to the latest ratings produced by **Infratest**. Meanwhile, MOR/gold-formatted **Radio F** continued to top the locals in average daytime hourly listeners, coming second in the daily listeners ratings with 100,000.

Charivari PD Scott Lockwood is pleased with the station's results, adding, "We also have the most regular listeners [more than four days a week]. Our market share soars in the evening. We have a very popular love song show called 'Heart Murmurs' from 20.00 to 02.00 hours, which we are now extending to 04.00 hours.

"Charivari does not primarily target the teens. Our playlist focuses mainly on melodic music sung in English. We play absolutely no 'schlager' and very few German songs. **Radio F** provides the market with that type of programming and we don't feel we have to imitate them."

Comments **Radio F PD Scott Hoga**, "Our primary target is 30 to 59, with a mix of MOR, oldies and German schlager with 30% local language. We're the only local station with its own news service. We cover the local area and also put together our own national and international news coverage."

N1 PD Cetin Yaman explained his station's downturn, from 46,000 to 42,000. "We just aren't as well-known as **Radio Gong**. We changed our primary target from 14-to-24 to 14-to-29 and lost some of the kids. We dropped the cutting edge rap and techno material. We never played heavy metal. Our former dance-oriented EHR format is now mainstream EHR with personality DJs. We're convinced that this formula will draw more listen-

ers and more advertisers."

Many local radio executives were surprised that **Radio Gong** had held up so well in the tests. Remarks **Lockwood**, "Gong is well-known, and it benefitted from **N1's** mistaken efforts to attract an older audience. **Charivari** also did some fine-tuning, getting a bit older, and expected to lose a few thousand people under the age of 25. We just didn't know where they'd go. We know now that they went to **Gong**."

Radio Gong PD Marc Stingl attributes the strength of his station to a "back-to-the-roots" approach. "When **Arno Müller** [now PD at **RTL-Berlin**] was PD he ran a strict rock-oriented hot AC format. When he left, the direction of the station changed more to EHR with

a shorter playlist and a different approach. I've changed things back to the good old days. We feature regular contests and are in touch with our listeners with our monthly 'Radio Gong Parties,' drawing anything from two to 2,500 fans. The results are that we lead the local stations in the 14-to-39 age group as well as the 14-to-29 age group."

Nevertheless, despite the strength of local stations providing innovative new target-oriented programming, the top two positions are occupied by two regional stations. **Radio F's Hoga** sees a very simple explanation, "They have better reception. The local stations here in Nuremberg have a maximum of 300 watts and the **Bayerische Rundfunk** is beaming in with 25,000 watts."

Radio 1/Oslo Leads Private Broadcasters In Norway

Oslo-based private station **Radio 1** continues to command the EHR market in Norway, capturing the highest number of daily listeners, with 109,200. That is according to the newly released survey carried out by research firm **Markeds og Mediainstituttet (MMI)** in Oslo, conducted between early September 1991 through to the end of March 1992.

The station comes third overall behind state broadcaster

NRK's classical, news/talk-formatted **Programme 1** and R&B, news/talk-formatted **Programme 2**, which clocked up 1.725.000 and 975.000 daily listeners respectively.

Meanwhile, AC/EHR-formatted **Radio Grenland/Skien** achieved the best penetration with 21% of its total potential audience, registering 30,450 listeners.

Says MMI research executive **Tor Aksel Ødegård**, "Radio Grenland is the most popular radio station in its area if you

look at the percentage of potential reach. It has a higher percentage than Radio 1, with 21% against 14%. But, as there are more people living in Radio 1's licence area than in Radio Grenland's, Radio 1 gets more listeners."

The survey was conducted with Norwegians aged nine years and over by agreement with state broadcaster **Norsk Riksringkasting (NRK)**, the **Local Radio Association (NNF)**, radio ad sales houses **Aria Media A/S** and **Fram Reklamebyrå A/S**.

Mega Opens Office In Oslo

Danish dance label **Mega Records** will open an office in Oslo in September, adding to its existing Scandinavian bases in Sweden, Finland and Denmark. The move follows negotiations begun in July.

With the establishment of the new office, Mega Records—currently working with acts such as **The Shamen**, **De La Soul**, **Alagami**, **Zapp Zapp**, and **Dr. Baker**—will start handling its

own distribution in Norway, previously dealt with by **EMI Norsk**. However, EMI will continue to service retailers with orders of Mega Records repertoire.

The Norwegian operation is headed by **Nina Theresa Lauritzen**, formerly EMI Norsk promotion assistant for three years, who will be assisted by a yet-to-be-named sales person. Says Lauritzen of the launch, "When it comes to dance music one has to work differently with the repertoire from the way the larger labels do. Major labels usually give priority to other genres. When we concentrate on only dance music, we can push the repertoire harder [towards media and consumers]."

"Norway needs a change of attitude towards dance music. I feel it is dangerous to overlook it. Even though Norwegians are slow on picking up new music, they

always follow. There is a generation in this country which is interested in dance music, but it gets no service from the media. Most journalists are 30 years and older, and dance music isn't interesting to them. They won't write about artists unless they are Norwegian, **Elton John** or **Tina Turner**."

Lauritzen intends to focus marketing on clubs, radio stations and television starting with a party in Oslo (yet to be scheduled). Another promotional plan is to organize a monthly tour of Norwegian clubs by different Mega artists.

Lauritzen also welcomes demo-tapes from new dance acts, though there are currently no immediate plans of launching any local repertoire. "Both Sweden and Denmark have good dance acts, so I see no reason why Norway shouldn't have any." **KRO**

Cathy Dennis Makes Her Mark In The Italian Market

Following last year's initial wave of excitement throughout the radio sector over **Polydor UK** artist **Cathy Dennis**, key national commercial station **Rete 105** has been the first to seize upon the artist's new single *You Lied To Me*, which acts as a prelude to her second album *Into The Skyline* slated for a September 14 release. The station rotated it exclusively in its **Grundig**-sponsored "Discolancio" slot which ensures airplay four times a day for a full week. Rete 105 promoted airplay with a quarter-page advertisement in leading daily newspaper *La*

Repubblica.

No one at the station could be reached for comment at presstime. Says Polydor marketing manager **Giovanni Arcovito**, "Rete 105 was very keen on the single and I'm very pleased about that because Dennis is a priority artist for us. She has perhaps been perceived as just a dance artist in the past, which is quite wrong. The new album is much deeper than the debut *Move To This* and if we don't achieve crossover success with *You Lied To Me*, we are confident we will follow up singles which will be mid-tempo ballads."

Dennis may not have set the domestic sales charts on fire to date, but she attracted enough interest last year to prompt the

formation of a fan club, a rare feat for an international newcomer. Dennis' 1991 debut single *All Night Long (Touch Me)* was a major radio hit and although Rete

105 was first to the punch with *You Lied To Me*, other influential stations believe in an impending Dennis breakthrough.

"Heavy radio airplay has let the public know that Dennis exists," says **Radio Dimensione Suono** programme director **Bruno Ployer**. "She's a good artist and an interesting person. Facts won't go unnoticed by the public when she releases her second album."

Comments **RTL 102.5 Hit Radio** head of music **Grant Benson**, "There's no doubt about her breaking big in Italy. It's just a matter of translating radio hits into sales success."

RTV 2000 Starts FM Indie Lobby Group

Local Catalan radio and TV station **RTV 2000** has spearheaded the creation of an association of independent FM stations, called the **AEIFM**.

The association was launched following the exclusion of **Radio 2000 Antena Joven** from among the local stations awarded FM licences by the Catalonian regional government last summer. Asso-

ciation head and EHR PD **Luis Daniel Ramirez** complains of favouritism, saying, "Ninety percent of the licences were granted to companies and networks with ties to the Catalan government." He adds that more than 800 bids were submitted to the government for the 28 licences. "The association has arisen from the need to lobby for greater fairness and allow for the medium to be run by professionals and not by politicians."

The AEIFM is currently contacting local and foreign independent stations, and hopes to extend membership to a pan-European level. **AMdIF**

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NOS Board Of Directors Criticized For Inefficiency

Just six weeks before the major overhaul of the Dutch public broadcast system is scheduled to go into effect, the NOS board of directors has come under sharp attack from its own chairman, **Max de Jong**.

In an internal working document, the chairman calls for a total restructure of NOS upper management, saying the board is "less than constructive" and that it "often fails to inspire sufficient action and viable solutions."

The current board is responsible for all of the administrative decisions for the public system. The working paper maintains that the lack of leadership of the NOS board has a trickle-down effect on the whole system, causing divisiveness at a time when the pubcasters must work under "aggressive conditions." It concludes that NOS spends too much time on management decisions and in focusing on individual broadcasters.

De Jong's criticisms of the highest levels of NOS management come at an awkward time for the pubcasters, which have been banking on the restructure—expected to go into effect on October 1—to combat increasing competition from commercial radio and television stations, particularly CLT-backed **RTL-4** and **RTL Radio**. Satellite station **RTL-4** has grabbed more than 50% of the TV ad pie, and more than 30% of the viewing audience in less than three years.

The report calls for the creation of a newly tiered NOS management, with one board handling liaison with the government and NOS upper management side and the public television nets, and yet another board to supervise the three TV nets. NOS press spokesperson **Andre Matthijse** reports that one additional board will probably be formed to supervise the radio side of the public system.

Copies of the report are currently being considered by individual broadcasters. The present board of directors consists of eight representatives of Holland's leading broadcasters, an independent chairman, a vice-chairman and three members appointed by the Ministry of Culture.

Amsterdam's Extra 108 Broadcasts As City FM

The former **Extra 108** station in Amsterdam, operated by youth radio association **WAPS**, is now broadcasting under the new name of **City FM** in an effort to win back its listeners.

The station produces its own programmes under the control of **Salto**, a local radio council founded by the city of Amsterdam to deal with the broadcasting situation in the city.

This is the second name change for the station in a week. In an effort to revamp the station's image, chairman **Koen van Tankeren** decided on the name **Radio Contact**, which he felt would give the broadcaster a more commercial feel. But as soon as the station launched under the new name on August 1, **Salto** banned the station broadcasting as **Radio Contact**, saying that the **Radio Contact** net in Belgium would profit from the Amsterdam station's use of their name. "We have no commercial link with **Radio Contact** in Belgium," protests Van Tankeren, "We just thought the name would help us win back our listeners. **Salto's** decision meant that we ended up broadcasting nameless for a week, losing even more listeners."

Headed by Van Tankeren, the station has a narrow-cast

dance/swingbeat format targeting the city's 15-35-year-olds. The station formerly broadcast on both terrestrial and cable frequencies, but **Salto** reallocated **Extra 108's** terrestrial frequency to **Radio Amsterdam**, leaving the station with a cable-only frequency. Says Van Tankeren, "Our listeners went down from

150,000 a day to just 30,000, because they didn't know where to find us."

Van Tankeren says that **City FM's** strategy to win back its listeners is to stick closely to its old format. "We are the only real youth station in Amsterdam and our listeners are gradually finding us again."

Contact Is Top Private In Romania

A survey carried out by **IRSOP**, the official Romanian ratings bureau (June 1992) reveals that **Radio Contact's** Romanian outlet **Radio Contact Romania** is currently topping the private stations list in the Bucharest region.

The 40-page study covers both state and private broadcasters, including **Radio Contact**, **Radio Fun**, **Radio Uniplus** and **Delta**.

Number one on the popularity list is still the Romanian pubcaster's first channel, **Programul 1**, news-oriented, with a 30% share of the market. **Contact** comes second with 16% and **Fun** has the third spot with 13%.

Radio Contact started broadcasting in the Bucharest region 18 months ago. Today the station, owned by a mixed Belgian-Romanian company, has passed the break-even figures, with advertising handled by **IP-Romania**.

The Romanian operation is supported by the **Belgian Radio Contact** stations with programmes and industry sample records shipped to Bucharest.

Fear In France Grows For The Country's Top Venue

The music community in France is beginning to fear for the future of Paris's most famous concert hall, the **Olympia**. Concern about the venue began a couple of months ago when promoters discovered they had problems confirming bookings for after 1993.

The venue is owned by state bank **Société Générale**, and rented by an operating company founded by the late **Bruno Coquatrix**. Fears are that the **Société Générale** will try to increase the rent when the lease comes up for renewal in 1993.

Reportedly, a vast real estate operation has been planned by the **Société Générale** in the area around the **Olympia**, one of the most expensive in Paris. The plan is said to include the demolition of the 2,000-capacity concert hall, replacing it with offices, and building another venue nearby.

These rumours have prompted quick reactions from concert promoters and artists. The general assembly of **Fonds de Soutien**, an organization regrouping concert promoters plus the ministry of culture, and various other organizations including performing

rights society **SACEM**, issued a statement expressing their fears regarding the venue's future.

The **Société Générale** has so far declined to comment on its projects, but two meetings have already been held between the bank, the Ministry of Culture and the **Fonds de Soutien**. In addition, over 50 well-known French artists have sent a petition to the minister of culture **Jack Lang**.

A possible solution would be for the Ministry of Culture to

classify the building as a historical monument. This would prevent any destruction of the premises, but would also freeze any possibility of modernization.

Olympia has played a key role in the history of music in France, being its most important concert venue in the '50s and '60s. Several French artists have played there, as well as the **Rolling Stones**, **The Animals**, **Bob Dylan**, **Jimi Hendrix** and the **Beatles**.

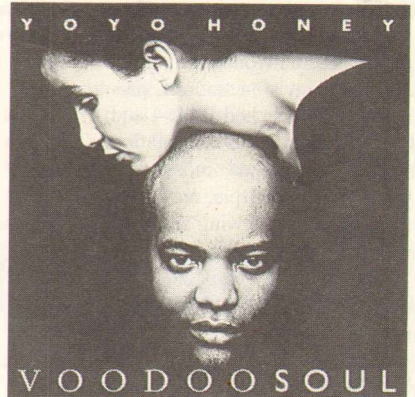

Roland Offers RSS Processing System For Radio/TV Broadcast

Roland's Sound Space Processing System (RSS) is being headlined as an ideal enhancement for radio and TV broadcasting, giving a three-dimensional environment over a conventional two-speaker system. Roland has overcome the problem of left/right aural crosstalk—the way in which a signal, destined for the right ear only, will also be heard by the left ear. The only way in which this can be eliminated is by using headphones. This is, of course, not ideal and also prevents the listeners from

placing sounds in front of them. To overcome this, Roland has incorporated a separate "transaural processor" in the RSS system. This, along with a near-standard binaural processor, have allowed Roland to provide a usable three-dimensional system without headphones.

One of the main advantages with the RSS system is that the listener needs no decoding equipment, an improvement over older "surround sound" systems such as Ambisonics and Quadrophonics.

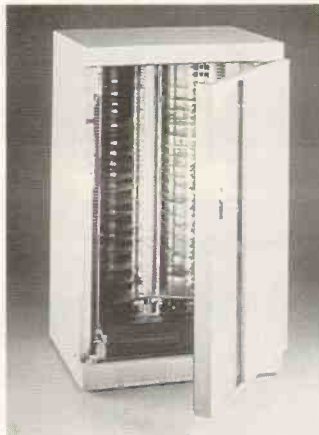

British quartet the Christians are returning this autumn with a new album *Happy In Hell*, and top management at Island Records decided to go on tour to support the project. The album, scheduled for simultaneous worldwide release on September 14, features the single *What's In A Word*, which hit the stores on August 24.

Island Records International MD Phil Cooper and Island UK MD Marc Marot visited offices in six countries involved in the project to present the album, from which they had picked out five other potential hit singles—*Father*, *The Bottle*, *Storms*, *Uninvited* and *Learn To Love*.

In four days the two executives covered Italy, Spain, Germany, Holland, France and Scandinavia. Distribution for both the single and the album, will be handled by BMG offices throughout Europe, except for France where it is distributed through Island/PolyGram, and through PolyGram for the rest of the world.

Says Cooper, "All we have done is to

present our plans as far as the world market is concerned, so that the regional offices can adapt them to suit each market, and also make additional marketing plans on their own. Everybody has to look at their own market as an individual territory, and to use the tools we provide them with."

Though marketing plans in most of the national branches have not yet been finalized, BMG Munich product manager Michael Rank says he will be conducting a "huge advertising campaign," which will include in-store advertising in 250 stores and an extensive fly-posting campaign. Meanwhile, a spokesperson at BMG Spain revealed that the album will be promoted via TV-ads and spots on private EHR net *Los 40 Principales*. The album will be shipped to all the national stations in September and will coincide with a promotional visit by the trio.

Marot is very enthusiastic about the album, "We only make these trips when we have something special. The last album [*Colours*] did extremely well in Europe [in 1990], selling 400,000 copies in France and 100,000 copies in Spain."

In 1989 the band enjoyed a hit with *Words*, one of the most successful singles off the *Colours* album. The band's first album *The Christians* entered the British Gallup chart in 1987 at number 2.

Radio stations received the single *What's In A Word* on August 7, which will be followed by the second single off the album—*Father*. Kai Roger Ottesen

About 600 billboards and posters are an effort to shed the net's "dusty institution image," according to the ad company.

CAPITAL INVESTMENT: **Capital Radio** has hired **Saatchi & Saatchi** subsidiary **Zenith Media** to handle £2 million of advertising campaign for **Capital FM** and **Capital Gold**.

KICKING TOGETHER A HOT ROSTER: German publishing, promotion and management company **Kick Musik** has signed American recording artist **Garland Jeffreys** to its roster of artists, which already includes **Westernhagen**, **Herbert Grönemeyer**, **Pe Werner** and **Pur**.

MOVING CHAIRS: **Phonogram** Holland's **Ria Makker** is moving from press promoter to product manager, where she will be responsible for the marketing and exploitation of repertoire from **Phonogram UK** and all continental product. Her replacement is yet to be named.

READY FOR A CHANGE: **Lionel Richie** signed a long-term, worldwide contract with **PolyGram** label **Mercury Records**. Richie is currently under contract with **Motown**. His association with **Mercury** begins when Richie starts recording his next album.

Tim Bowen will head the newly created **Strategic Business Division**, responsible for Sony's non-music interests (**Hit Factory**, the **Milton Keynes Bowl**, **Renaissance Films**). **Sony Music Publishing**, headed by **William Booth**, will also report to Bowen, as will the legal affairs and music video departments.

Russell says the new division will capitalize on business expansion and diversification in the entertainment world, including new technology and broadcast systems. Russell says he expects the peripheral business interests to make up half of SME's overall profits within two to three years.

Apart from **Columbia**, **Epic** and **Sony Music Publishing**, the company's two other label divisions—**Sony Soho Square** (headed by **Muff Winwood**) and the **Licensed Repertoire Division** (**Jeremy Pearce**)—will continue to report to Russell. Pearce recently concluded a joint-venture deal with UK independent label **Creation**.

Russell points to the continuing national recession as well as the lack of cross-border possibilities for UK talent as the main factors behind the changes. "The economy is lousy at home," he says. "A number one album in the UK sells 15,000-to-20,000 copies a week, where it should be selling 40,000-to-60,000. And I don't see any signs that things are going to be wonderful after the summer."

With regards to the international marketing of UK artists, Russell

sees a more active role for UK labels. "We have to sit down with the heads of our affiliates in Europe and the rest of the world at a much earlier stage," he says. "We can't just sit back in the UK and hope everything will come automatically. We have to get some cohesive force behind the artists very early on."

But the other problem, notes Russell, is the lack of credibility of the UK chart. "The charts are so volatile that they become almost unbelievable. As soon as you sell 20,000 albums you go into the top 10. As an international marketing tool, the chart is counter-productive."

Asked about suggestions for improvement, Russell feels the creation of sub-categories within the sales chart is inevitable. "We might establish sub-divisions, such as genre charts, debut album charts, indie charts or something along the lines of *Billboard's* 'Heatseekers.' These may lead to some interesting programming ideas."

We're negotiating with various radio and TV stations across Europe about the possibility of carrying a direct broadcast."

So far the company has secured direct link-up deals with the **BBC**, both on radio and TV. **BBC 2** will televise the concert. Two days later **BBC Radio 1** will broadcast the event from 20.00 onwards.

Spanish EHR network **Cope Cadena 100** has planned a live transmission, while New Age/Jazz-formatted **Radio Monte Carlo**/Milan has scheduled an Oldfield special for September 7, with excerpts of the concert plus interviews.

Warner Music Spain is optimistic about the project. Comments label manager **Eva Dalda**, "We'll fly over eight media people to Edinburgh. On August 25 we had a big launch of the album at **Cope Cadena 100**. Also, we're still working on a TV campaign."

Most territories are running TV campaigns, with Germany leading the pack. In conjunction with retail chain **WOM**—which listed *Tubular Bells II* as "Album Of The Month September"—**Warner Music** Germany has bought 60 ad spots on **MTV Europe** for September 5-13.

WEA Germany marketing manager **Alexander Maurus** says the company has doubled its normal activities with regard to TV and billboards. "We're very happy that Oldfield is appearing on September 25 on popular **ZDF** TV programme 'Wetten Dass.' It will be the first show with new host **Wolfgang Lippert** following the **Thomas Gottschalk** era. That again amounts to two times the normal number of viewers."

By the end of the year Maurus expects total sales of 300,000-400,000 copies.

On August 10 the German affiliate premiered the album at a launch party in the **Musik Halle** in Hamburg attended by 200 key journalists and retailers, plus another 100 members of the public, all prize winners in a competition co-organized by **OK Radio**/Hamburg and daily paper **Morgen Post**.

to country music and change people's attitudes. "I think that people like him and his music, and they probably don't even think of him as a country artist," he says. "We still have a problem getting exposure for country music artists, especially radio airplay. I don't think we'll ever break country music as a genre, but individual artists have more of a chance now."

Wootton says northern Europe has traditionally been the place where country music fares best outside the US. "In Holland, all the Scandinavian countries, Austria and Switzerland there is some enthusiasm for country music," he comments. "Germany has always been something of a red herring because of the American servicemen based there. I personally don't think Germans really go for country music at all." As for France and the southern European countries, he says he doesn't see any chance for country music breaking through. "I think it is very hard for people in these cultures to relate to country music." He sees Brooks as the artist with the most potential in Europe.

However, **Phonogram** UK product manager **Shaun Bye** disagrees with Wootton, and says he thinks Cyrus' success will certainly help break down the barriers which people have in the UK towards country music. "In the UK there is not much of a country scene, so we treat him as more of a pop/country artist. The real factor behind his success was the TV exposure we got on *Top Of The Pops*. Right after that **BBC Radio 1** began playlisting the record."

PolyGram International exploitation manager of US repertoire **Peter Schultz** says the company has not yet released the single in southern European territories. **PolyGram** has decided to wait until the summer period is over, but the single is already being serviced to clubs and bars. Schultz says the promotional strategy for Cyrus has been to make a point of not mentioning the word "country" in advertising, deliberately steering his image away from that genre. "Many Europeans have a very clichéd image of country, but I think there is a small market for country music everywhere," he says. "I think that record companies will look more closely at their country acts now and we will see more aggressive promotions."

EMI product manager **Thierry Pannetier** is another label executive who says he thinks the record could help break other country artists in Europe. "Billy Ray Cyrus is the only country star over here who is getting radio airplay and TV exposure," he says. "I think the fact that Cyrus is from Nashville will help us promote Brooks in the Autumn and will maybe make things easier when we're trying to get radio programmers to play country records. Whatever you think about his music, he's what we need to put Nashville back on the map for UK broadcasters." **EMI** is releasing a second album by Brooks on September 21, and the artist is coming over to the UK in November to make promotional

appearances and start his tour.

In April, **EMI** partnered four UK labels—**WEA**, **Sony Music**, **MCA** and **BMG**—to launch the "New Stars On The Heartland" project to promote country artists in the UK. An album of the same name was released and included tracks by Brooks, Black, **Vince Gill** and **The Judds**. Pannetier says the company was pleased with the success of the campaign and is now planning a follow-up.

Despite the **BBC Radio 1** airplay, head of music at EHR-formatted **BRMB/Birmingham Robin Valk** says he thinks *Achy Breaky Heart* is a summer novelty record. However, Valk still says he thinks several contemporary American country artists have a chance of success in Europe. "Artists like **Rodney Crowell** are producing melodic records with great cross-over potential and its only a matter of time before they get the support of radio behind them." Valk is less enthusiastic about the chances of Brooks and Black, who he says don't fit **BRMB's** format as well. Valk's tip for the next country cross-over in the UK is the **Roy Orbison/k.d. Lang** duet *Cryin'*. "It's really a matter of fighting against the prejudices of record companies and radio programmers towards country music and drawing the alienated older middle-of-the-road music buyers back into the stores."

Head of music at Swedish EHR station **City Radio/Gothenburg Lars Bodin** says the success of Cyrus in Sweden will break a country wave. He adds that 10 years ago there was a local country scene in Sweden with lots of local bands imitating the country style. "The music got so bad that the scene collapsed after a year," says Bodin. "After that you couldn't even mention the word 'country', even if it was a good song. Two years ago I wouldn't have dared play Cyrus, but this single has a real commercial feel to it and the market place has changed." Bodin says he is playing tracks by Brooks, Black and other country artists on morning shows to see how his listeners respond.

Presenter of the weekly country show "Country Trail" on Dutch public service radio station **EO/Hilversum Wim Pols** says it takes a long time for new country artists to be accepted in Holland and that the old favourites such as **Emmylou Harris** and **Johnny Cash** are still popular. His show, which has been going for eight years, attracts around 300,000 listeners. "The problem is that a small number of DJs in Holland determine what is going to be a hit," he says. "Younger DJs in Holland still see country as cowboys and indians music and don't accept it as a serious form of popular music."

Pols says artists such as **Alan Jackson** and **Black** could break in Holland if they got airplay and TV exposure and the right backing from their record companies. "There is definitely a market for country music here; it just needs to be developed."

Who Starts Competing With Madonna?

Madonna's *This Used To Be My Playground* continues to crown the EHR Top 40 for the fourth consecutive week with a record 109 stations under its belt (close to 90% of the total EHR roster). Meanwhile, competition is heating up. Who stands the best chances of overtaking Madonna?

Jimmy Nail has managed to drastically increase his cumulative chart points and *Ain't No Doubt* is currently the second best-played single on EHR. And although Roxette's *How Do You Do* has the same amount of total reporting stations as Nail--and only slightly less chart points--the number of stations that have moved Nail's single "up" (to powerplay and/or "A" rotation) is significantly higher than for Roxette.

The fastest increase in chart points this week goes to Lionel Richie's second single off the *Back To Front* album, *My Destiny*. The UK, Norway and Denmark take the lead and together with Annie Lennox's *Walking On Broken Glass*, the track scores the highest number of new additions this week (14).

Lennox has booked the highest debut of the week (22) mainly due to a very strong impact in the UK (over 90% penetration), and to a lesser extent, Sweden (over 75%).

The category "New Top 20 Contenders" (for those records debuting for the very first time on EHR) is always a good barometer for programmers in search of new talent. This week's upcoming new artists in EHR include ragamuffin artist Shabba Ranks with the smooth *Mr. Loverman* taken from his second Epic album *Rough & Ready-Volume 1*, UK's newest kiddie act Take That with *I Found Heaven* (RCA) and Undercover's *Baker Street* (PWL Int.), a cover of Gerry Rafferty's late '70s hit single.
