UK Commercial Radio Continues Ratings Gains

UNITED KINGDOM

As UK commercial radio prepares to celebrate its 20th anniversary in a few months, proof that it is coming of age is evident in the latest RAJAR survey results, which show the continued defection of BBC networks' listeners to independent national and local stations.

Figures for the second quarter of this year reveal that overall listening to the BBC's five networks slipped to 45.9% from 48.9% compared to RAJAR's first survey for the fourth quarter 1992. Although it remains the most popular national service, BBC Radio One FM suffered the biggest losses across the board. The EHR network's share dipped to 19.9% compared to 22.4% six months ago. The net's weekly reach is also down two points to 34%. Overall listening to BBC Radio (national, regional/local) is

down 1.2 points to a 57.2% share. In contrast, listening at independent local radio stations show a 2.2 point increase in national share to 33.4%. The listening share of national commercial radio (Classic FM and Dublin-based EHR long waver Atlantic 252) slipped 1.1 points to 5.5% since the fourth quarter 1992. Atlantic 252, which covers 66% of the UK population, saw its share slide 0.9% to 2.8% for the

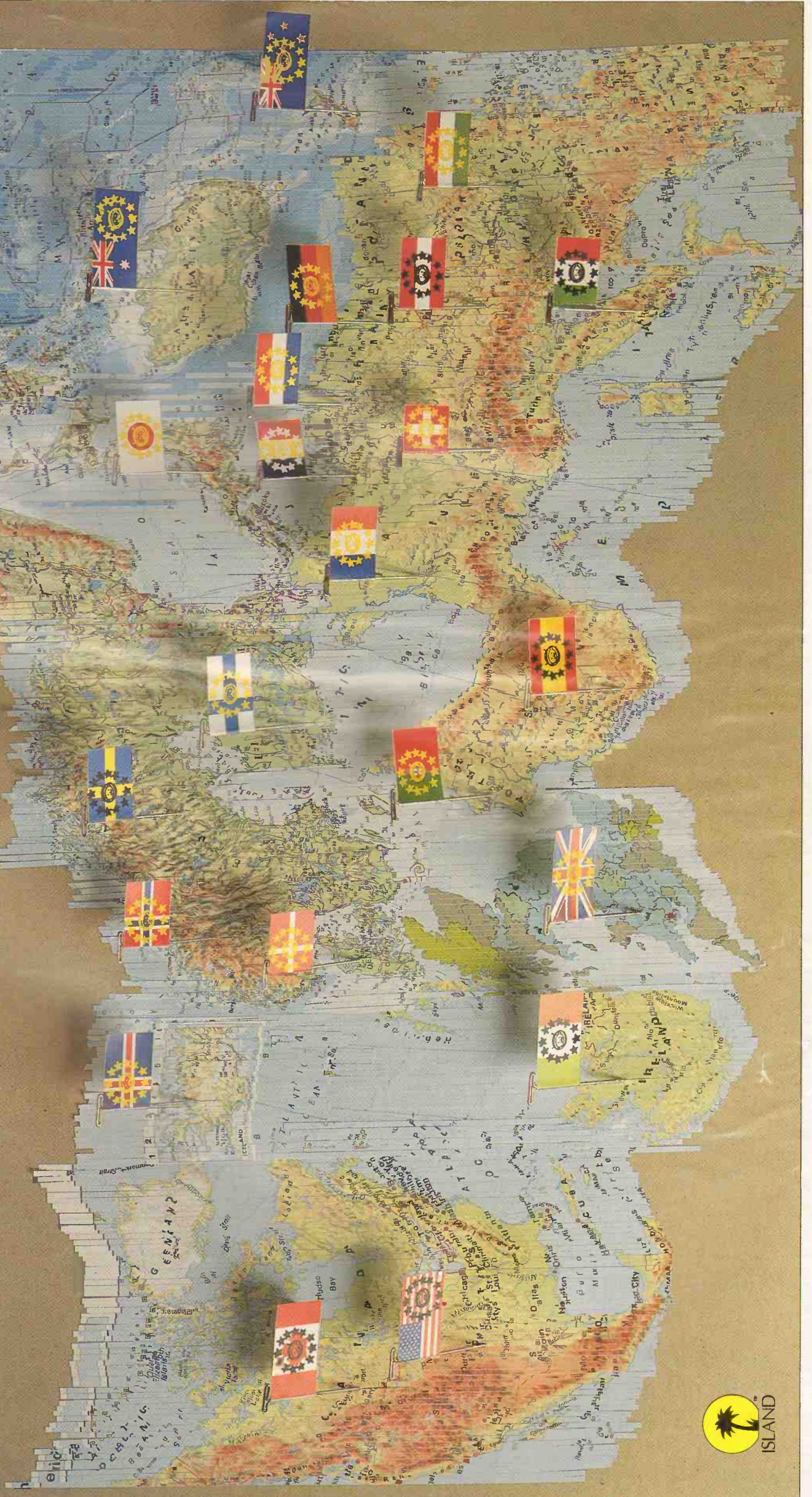

Outsiders To Clean Up The RAI; Dematté Elected New President

ITALY

A new board of governors, president and director general have been appointed to run Italy's state broadcaster RAI. The new executives have been labelled "The Martians" by RAI staff as they are all outsiders mainly from the academic world, with no previous broadcasting experience.

Claudio Dematté, an economics professor, has been elected president by his new boardroom colleagues: **Feliciano**

Benvenuti (lawyer), **Paolo Muraldi**, (journalist and historian), **Elvira Sellerio** (publisher) and **Tullio Gregory** (philosophy professor). The new five-member board of governors replaces the old 16-member board with a mandate to reform public broadcasting in Italy.

Despite requests by the RAI's unions for an "insider," the new board elected **Gianni Locatelli** as the new director general.

Locatelli, who was editor of the influential financial newspaper *Sole 24 Ore* had been tipped

months ago for the job.

RAI's new president Dematté says the task facing him and his colleagues will not be easy. "Our priorities in restructuring and reorganising will be to de-politicise the organisation and to eradicate the large fiscal deficit estimated by the old board to be L130 billion [app. US\$90 million] for 1993." Union estimates put the deficit at L300 billion for this year.

The de-politicisation process will involve dismantling the old favours system, whereby principal political parties controlled the networks through the appointment of sympathetic directors. Shortly after his appointment as president, Dematté called for the resignation of all network heads and news chiefs for TV and radio. He then suspended their resignations until after a new policy document on the future of the RAI is published this autumn.

A national debate is now underway over which direction the reformed RAI should take, with a spokesperson from RAI **Radio** saying it was too early to speculate. Dematté has indicated that although management structures will be modernised, the RAI's role as a public broadcaster would be reinforced, with particular emphasis on restructuring the news departments. "The RAI should become to news and information what the Banca d'Italia is to money: a safekeeper of the national heritage," he says.

PolyGram Rocks Ahead With 19% Profits Gain In First Half

Thanks to an increase in European market share, worldwide music and entertainment group **PolyGram** reported a 6.1% increase in sales to Dfl 3.17 billion (app. US\$1.66 billion) and a 19.3% jump in net income to Dfl 204 million for the six months of 1993. Pre-tax operating income rose 5.9% to Dfl 319 million, with operating margins moving accordingly, up to 10.1% from 9.0%. European sales accounted for 54% of total turnover and 71% of income.

Comments president/CEO **Alain Levy**, "PolyGram made excellent progress during the first

six months of 1993. Despite unfavourable exchange rates, we were less affected by recession in continental Europe than expected, thanks to an increase in our European marketshare and the fact that our sales rose almost everywhere."

PolyGram's biggest-selling pop album in the first half of the year was **Sting's Ten Summoner's Tales**, which sold over three-million copies. **Dire Strait's On The Night** sold over one-million outside the US. PolyGram also benefited from multi-territory hits from debut European artists such as Sweden's **Ace of Base** and the UK's **Dina Carroll** and the **Stereo MCs**.

Stansfield Appointed Music & Media's New UK Correspondent; Dezzani Tapped To Cover Italy

BELGIUM: RTBF Adds Two More Morning Hours To Radio 21

French-language pubcaster **RTBF's** EHR network **Radio 21** will be adding two-and-a-half hours of extra broadcasts starting in September. Contrary to earlier rumours of possible cuts, the **RTBF** has agreed to give the 06.30-09.00 slot to **Radio 21**. There are suspicions that **Regie Media Belge** had a part in the decision, which will allow them to attract more advertisers to the already tightly booked **RTBF Radio**. Until then, **Radio 21** continues to broadcast **Bruxelles Capitale's** morning programme, which also runs on **Radio 2**. **Marc Maes**

FINLAND: BMG Ariola Creates Local A&R Post

BMG Ariola Finland is increasing its emphasis on local production with the appointment of former **YLE Radiomafia** DJ/producer **Asko Kallonen** as producer/A&R manager. **BMG** made its first local recording late last year and has since signed four local acts, **Anita Pajunen**, **Dance Nation**, **Teppo Nuorva** and **Jayday**, all of whom will be releasing albums this year. **Kari Helopaltio**

FINLAND: Fazer MD To Shape Up National Opera House

Former MD of **Fazer Music Inc.**, **John Eric Westo** has taken over another top job in the Finnish music industry, moving into the temporary post of administrative director of the **Finnish National Opera**. **Westo** will be working on improving the internal organisation, operational strategies and profitability at the company. **KH**

SPAIN: SGAE Signs Agreement With Canal Plus

Performing rights association **SGAE** and Spain's only pay-TV station, **Canal Plus**, have signed an agreement which covers author's rights, the fight against piracy, and cultural cooperation between the two organisations. The accord is backdated to the beginning of **Canal Plus'** broadcasts in 1991, and is valid until 1998. **Howell Llewellyn**

ITALY: Virgin Joins Other Majors At FIMI

Virgin Dischi has become the last major international label in Italy to join the **FIMI** industry group. In a widely expected move following their departure from **AFI** last June, **Virgin** officially became a **FIMI** member on July 30. **FIMI** was formed when most of the major labels split from **AFI** last year after claiming they were under-represented in relation to their market shares. The international industry organisation **IFPI** switched recognition to represent Italy from **AFI** to **FIMI** earlier this year. **FIMI** now claims 18 members representing over 80% of Italy's market share, while **AFI** still represents 150 domestic and independent labels. **Mark Dezzani**

UK: Chrysalis Appoints Ferrera Head Of A&R At Echo

Chrysalis Music Division has appointed US producer/songwriter **Steve Ferrera** as head of A&R at its new label **Echo**. **Ferrera** will report to **Jason Guy**, former marketing director at **A&M UK**. Also joining the A&R division of **Echo** is **Cheryl Robson**, who joins from **CR Management**. The launch of **Echo** follows the sale by the **Chrysalis Music Group (CMG)** of its remaining 50% stake in **Chrysalis Records** to **EMI** in November 1991. Since then the music group has operated without a label imprint. Apart from **Echo**, **CMG** includes a TV compilation company, **Chrysalis music publishing** and some studios, including a share in **George Martin's Air Studios**. **Machgiel Bakker**

Commissioner Appointed To Reform SIAE Voting System

Italian author's rights society SIAE will be managed by a commissioner appointed by the prime minister following a decision passed by the country's Supreme Court. The move marks the culmination of a legal battle concerning election rules which arose in 1989 between the society's management and a group of members—artists and producers from the Association of Performers and Authors (APA), who attacked the association's voting system as "obsolete, complicated and bureaucratic."

Commissioner Carlo Gessa, in charge until October 31, is entrusted with reforming SIAE's rules in

accordance with a sentence from the Council of State ordering the SIAE to change its articles so that all members would be represented in the society's offices. The society's appeals against the sentence were rejected contrary to expectations.

On Gessa's arrival, SIAE president Roman Vlad (also president of the international federation of author's rights societies CISAC), had to step down, as did all other managers and committee members who had been elected in 1990.

Problems between the two groups centred on the voting system in the association. The author's society has some 52,000 members, but of these only those who could prove they make a living from

their intellectual works—some 1,300 associate members—are entitled to vote and to be elected onto the society's boards and committees. In 1991 the Council of State judged that this represented a discrimination between associate and ordinary members, and the Supreme Court agreed.

SIAE, which deals with both mechanical and public performance rights in Italy, is considered one of the most efficient collection societies in the world. It has increased its income by 30% in the last two years, and has lately signed important deals with both Silvio Berlusconi's Fininvest group and pubcaster RAI, obtaining remarkable increases in royalty payments for music on TV.

European Attendance Up At NMS

After a couple of difficult years, the New Music Seminar is back on track. The 1993 edition, which took place July 20-24 in New York, saw a sharp increase in attendance, new location, refocused content, and more emphasis on new talent.

This year's NMS was also the first to be fully managed by one single director after the decision of co-founder Tom Silverman to focus on his label Tommy Boy, leaving the management and the

ownership of the company to his long-time associate Mark Josephson [the third co-founder of NMS, Joel Weber, died six years ago.]

This year—the 14th edition—was attended by 7,400 people, an increase of 1,000 from last year. While international attendance was slightly down, at 1,500, attendance from many European countries such as Germany and France increased."

Says Josephson, "Our hope was that this year we would be able to overcome the effects of three or four years of bad mismanagement in which the event's usefulness was

eroded—also leaving us in serious debt. This year we are breaking even and paying off our debts."

Josephson admits that the event was hit by on-going recession. "Advertising is down, stands are up, income from the shows is up and so is income from the hotels," he says, "but major companies are investing less because of tight budgets and an increasing number of similar conventions."

The NMS retained its attraction for bands this year, attracting a total of 520 acts, of which 120 were unsigned. Compared with the previous years, there were fewer international bands, a trend which Josephson blames on the bad state of the economy on both sides of the ocean, expensive costs to fly bands from overseas, and the fact that fewer expenses are being shouldered by NMS.

Next year's convention will be held at the same location in July, but the final dates will be announced later.

Oredam Plans Radio Tango Relaunch

Michael Breines Oredam, former MD at AOR station Radio Tango, is planning to relaunch the station on another frequency following its format change into classic rock/gold Radio Classic 102 on June 14 (M&M, June 26). The station changed its name and increased gold programming in anticipation of national EHR station NRK P3 and national private P4 this autumn.

Oredam remained a member of the board at Tango, although he was replaced as MD by Harald Hjort, appointed last year to steer the company out of bankruptcy. Oredam has now announced his intention to withdraw from the board, sell his shares in the station and set up another Radio Tango. The only difference would be that the station will broadcast on FM 98, instead of FM 102, targeting the 15-35 age demo instead of 25+. It seems likely that Oredam's colleague at former Radio Tango,

Fredrick Ransell, will be appointed head of music.

Oredam owns the legal rights to the Radio Tango brand and has, in partnership with two other investors, Oystein Olsen and Andre Smedsrud, already made a deal with Oslo-based EHR station Radio Ung to buy 51% of the shares. The proposal has yet to be approved by the local radio authority, Nærkringkastingsnemnda, with a decision expected in the autumn.

Oredam is clear about his intentions for the station. "I'm in the radio business because it's fun. I have no intention of making the station number one in Oslo; instead we will be making good rock radio with a cultural blend. There is definitely a need for such a station here."

The programming plans would offer variety in the Oslo area where there is already a popular EHR station (Radio Oslo), an EHR/Gold station (Radio Oslofjord), a classic rock/gold station (Radio Classic) and a hot ACE station (Radio 1).

Newsmakers

GERMANY: Two new faces at East West Germany—Werner Theurich is the new head of press. Theurich formerly worked in the press department at WEA. Also Claudia Neufert has been appointed as promoter for the mid region of Germany.

GERMANY: Hans-Herwig Geyer has been appointed head of press and communications at performance and mechanical rights body GEMA.

UK: Lucian Grainge has been appointed to the newly created position of senior director and GM at Polydor UK with specific responsibility for all artist and repertoire and legal and business affairs matters.

Bulgaria Okays Copyright Law

The long-awaited copyright law has finally been passed in Bulgaria, bringing the country's record industry a step further in line with the rest of Europe.

The new law limits reproduction and copying of whole or parts of recordings without the author's permission. Manufacturers and importers of blank soundcarriers will now pay 5% of the total value of these carriers to the authors rights association, 20% of which goes to the ministry of culture.

The copyright is protected until 50 years after the author's death in line with European legislation.

The new law opens up new rights to the producers in the country, giving them the right to authorise reproduction, copying, lending, public performance and broadcasting of their works. Meanwhile radio and TV stations must give permission for the rebroadcast, recording, reproduction and distribution of programmes. Penalty for contravention of the law could lead to fines of US\$15,000 and closure of the shop/studio or venue in question.

Decision On Zurich Licences Expected Next Spring

A number of private radio licences are to be put out to tender in Zurich next year. Further details will only be made public, however, following a decision by the Swiss government on how many frequencies can be made available in the city—expected in late spring 1994.

Head of local radio at the Bundesamt für Kommunikation (BAKOM) Marcel Regnotto explains, "There are economic and technical problems which must first be resolved. The government has to find whether the Zurich

market can support an additional three to five commercial stations. After this decision is made, then we can open up the license to bids from interested parties."

One of the hopefuls is Steve Thomson, who wants to set up a rock-formatted station called Power Station. Thomson did a 30-day test run in May which he said went very well. "We got 60% of the 15-25 year olds tuning in. The test run was a big success and I think we've got a good chance of getting the licence. Sixty percent of records sold in this country are rock, so I think a rock format radio is needed."

Programmers Discuss Recurrent Strategies

Staying current is the name of the game for EHR and Hot ACE programmers. But with the traditional summer slowdown in product releases, programmers have to look to different ways of keeping the station's sound timely, and maximising the recurrent rotation is one way to achieve that.

To allow him some flexibility, Chris Moore, head of music at Red Dragon FM/Cardiff, has no specific guidelines or rules for recurrents. "As far as we're concerned, recurrents are playlisted songs which sound good and are right for Dragon," says Moore, whose station targets a 16-34 demo. "That's the most important criteria. Normally they are big hits and would be top five or top 10 in the charts. It's rare, but it could also be a song which didn't do anything chart-wise but we playlist it for quite a while because of good listener response; a song that just sounds right on your station. k. d. Lang's *Constant Craving* is a good example. We played it a lot when it first came out, but when it was re-released we put it on as a recurrent."

To make sure recurrents sound fresh again, Moore gives the songs a two-three month rest period on average, but that changes with the record's success. "It really depends on the number of weeks it had as a playlist song," says Moore. "If you're talking about a song that was playlisted for 10-12 weeks, then the gap is going to be bigger for the sake of repetition and boredom. It's normally two-three months when you go through the songs that you've taken off the playlist the last couple of months."

Moore programmes about two recurrents per hour. "Recurrents are put in the general programming framework for each hour. They are placed with the currents and oldies and tend to turn up at the same point every day. In that sense it's very structured. You have your image songs, the current stuff, your '80s and '90s, and your recurrents. And they all go in there hour by hour. Placement of recurrents varies from

hour to hour and from show to show because each presenter would meet with the head of programmes and plan each hour of their show. We have something between 20-30 songs available as recurrents.

"On our breakfast show, for instance, the recurrents normally occur around 20 minutes past and 20 minutes before the hour. They are pretty well separated.



Recurrents during breakfast tend to come off the back of an ad break or news. We want them to hear something familiar after the ads or news.

"Normally we don't keep songs on recurrent for a terribly long time. They normally get moved

into another category. In some cases it could be a matter of months, in some cases a couple of weeks because we do look at the recurrents quite regularly. But it wouldn't be any longer than that."

How old can a record be to be classified as a recurrent? Moore says he wouldn't go back two years, probably much less. "What we've found out with our oldies is that they're all split into categories and they tend to get enough plays at that level without having to put them into recurrent."

Hervé Lemaire, programme director at French Hot ACE net Fun Radio, goes back six months when selecting recurrents

for his station's 15-30 demo. "For example, now in France a big hit is Snow's *Informer*," he says. "Maybe in one month the single will be burnt out. Then probably around February or March I'll test the single to find out if the burn-out is over. If it is, then I'll add it again as a recurrent. I wait that long because it's my experience that a burn-out takes at least six months to wear off."

Lemaire programmes about 14 songs

per hour, with one or two being recurrents. He also leans heavily on the weekly call-out research Fun conducts. Fun tests 35 songs, with about five of those being recurrents. "The people who listen to Fun tune in for a long time," he says. "They don't listen for just 10 minutes. I think our audience wants to hear more recurrents because they remember when they first heard those songs on Fun."

"Where the songs appear on the clock changes every hour, but mostly they appear in the second half-hour. It's not every time that a recurrent follows a hit or a gold record. A recurrent is unique—it's not a current hit and it's not yet a gold."

"It's very important to have a big first half hour, so we don't place them there. When you want to make a transition from the top hits, you play a recurrent."

One programmer who's just starting to better structure his use of recurrents is Poul Foged, head of music at EHR Radio Viborg/Viborg in Denmark, whose station targets a 15-49 demo.

"Earlier on we didn't do too much with recurrents," he says. "But lately we have found out that people want to hear the hits from six months ago. So we had to try and fit them in without sounding too dated. It's an important balance between the brand new records and the oldies, and recurrents help fill the gap."

Like Moore, Foged relies more on his playlist than chart positions in choosing recurrents. "We tend not to look at the charts," he says.



"We select records that have received substantial airplay, which means a playlist record on active rotation; and it's not necessarily always a hit single. Peter Gabriel's *Steam* received a lot of airplay on EHR; but we didn't play that song much, so

we won't classify it as a recurrent. If the song is good and if it has been on the playlist, then we'll use it as a recurrent."

"We don't have a strictly defined list of recurrents. We take a record off the playlist if it has been there for several weeks. If we had it on the 'B' playlist for only a couple of weeks and it didn't really do very well, then it goes straight into the archives."

Since Foged is just getting structured, he doesn't have a set timetable for bringing a song back as a recurrent. "It obviously depends on the record and can be anywhere from six weeks to three months," he says. "Also, in the past we've had a quick rotation of records. Since we started in 1984 we have always wanted to be a radio station that was first with new music. But we found out that if you put in a lot of new things people tend to turn away and tune into stations where the hits are on a regular basis. It's a careful balance. We have changed and don't rotate records that quickly these days." Foged will go back about one year to choose recurrents.

While Radio Viborg doesn't conduct callouts, it relies on its request line for listener feedback. "Our request line has a major effect on how many recurrents we play," says Foged. "We programme at least one an hour, but usually we can fit in two. Callers on the request line leave a message on our answering machine and we try and play two of these per hour. Normally, these songs are records from the playlist,

but there is a tendency to ask for recurrents. When I go through this list we can find the ones that have been asked for a lot."

Foged also is working on a more set policy in placing recurrents in the clock hour. "There is no set place," he says. "It's more looser and a little freewheeling. We are not a computerised station [with music scheduling]. The DJ has the freedom to choose songs within the category, but recurrents are a part of the playlist."

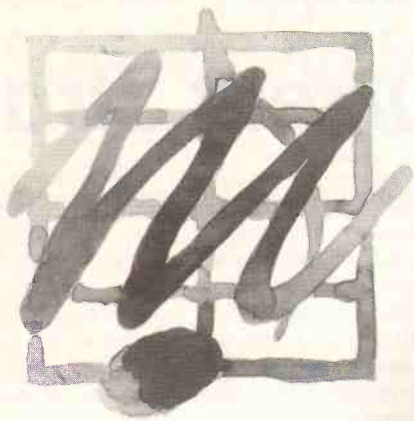

GROOVE MIX

Traces Of A Groove On Spanish Night-time Airwaves

SPAIN

by Terry Berne

Spain is one of the few countries in Europe still without a single dance-formatted radio station. Although it is true that radio support for dance music in Spain is sporadic, it's also certain that on any given night dance rhythms can be heard outside the clubs. The airwaves, especially once the sun goes down, are increasingly devoted to danceable grooves. Leading the way are major EHR nets **Los 40 Principales**, **Onda Cero Musica Cadena 100** and **Cadena Top**, each having late night shows with their own particular style.

At the moment, **Onda Cero** is the only station with a nightly show at national level. Produced by **Toni Peret**—known also for the popular *Mega-Mix* album series—the show is broadcast Monday to Saturday for an hour beginning at 23.00. Titled "It's

Your Time," the programme is firmly techno based, but in keeping with its slogan, "The Most Danced," Peret and his crew try to satisfy a broad range of tastes. Phone calls and letters mentioning favourite tracks are encouraged, and major trends are always catered to, as are current hits.

But Spanish product plays an expanding role, much of it originating in the Mediterranean city of Valencia, where the club scene is particularly molten, and where a thriving studio scene has sprouted and matured alongside it. "Techno culture in Spain is growing," says Peret. "And dance music is the only area that has maintained healthy sales levels despite the recession. Groups like **J. Y Zona Industrial** and **A.O. (Farmlopez)** are bringing Spanish techno belatedly into the '90s."

Cadena Top/Barcelona also presents a nightly programme of exclusively dance sounds, hosted by ubiquitous DJ/producer **Quique Tejada**, responsible for

the best-selling *Bolero Mix* albums, among others. "Ponte A Top" ("Put Yourself On Top") lasts an hour every Monday through Friday starting at 21.00. The show will be broadcast nationally beginning early next year, as digital sound improvements are completed at the net.

Covering the entire dance spectrum from reggae and house to techno, the programme is directed at 15 to 25-year-olds. "Kids are going to the clubs at a much younger age than before," points out Tejada. Where 18-year-olds were the vanguard a few years ago, 15-year-olds have now joined them. "Club DJ's also tune in to hear the latest import material.

Tejada plays club hits, though it usually works the other way around. "A song like **Ace Of Base's** *All That She Wants*, for instance, we first played on the show five months ago." Tejada plays a majority of imported product, such as **Snow**, **AB Logic** or **Capercaille**, though Spanish artists such as **O.B.K.** (whom he has produced) and **Santuario** also get airplay. "Dance music is more

commercially viable all the time," he insists, pointing out the huge sales racked up in Spain by compilations and mixes.

40 Principales' Ferran Disco hosts "World Dance Music" every Friday from 22.00 to 24.00. It is a mixture of styles specifically oriented toward a high energy, weekend mood. The programme deliberately reflects what is happening in the clubs, and Disco sees himself as a nexus between the music and the club scene. "My obligation is to support club DJs," he affirms. "They often play music which is not yet available or never released in Spain, so they get minimal feedback from a wider public about their discoveries."

As such, all tracks spun on the show are current club spinners, such as **Haddaway's** *What Is Love* or **2 Unlimited's** *Tribal Dance*."

One of the show's aims, he says, "is to demonstrate that dance music is no longer an alternative but is more and more often occupying the top positions of regular pop music charts. And, in Europe at least, dance hits regularly outlast other genres on the charts, a phenomenon unthinkable just a few years ago."

Two solid hours of dance music without spoken interruption is the concept behind **Cadena 100's** groove-dedicated programme on Fridays from 22.30 to 24.30. Directed at a young audience, **Cadena 100's DJ Jorge Plane** nevertheless tries to programme an uncommon cocktail of songs and artists, based on funk, house and rap, that often evades the most commercial styles. Playing 90% new music with little or no artist profile, Plane spices the mix with classics from the '70s or '80s such as **James Brown** or **Chic**. New values, such as the jazz-rap of

Guru or **SWV**, find quick acceptance at **Cadena 100**.

"We try to give the audience something a little different," comments Plane. "Contacts in the US and the UK, advance copies from record companies and club recommendations all contribute to the selection we make." An interesting quirk in the Spanish market, he notes, is that Spanish product is often launched in Spain as though they were imports, both to realise a bigger profit from import prices, and to gain easier acceptance on the dance floors.

These four programmes are Spain's dance radio flagships. They vary in content and concept, but together are proof that dance music cuts across aesthetic bound-

aries with its clear and singular function. With sales of compilations and dance mix albums such as the *Skateboard*, *Mega-Mix* and *Bolero Mix* series selling in the 200,000 range (double platinum in Spain) there is no doubt about the popularity or demand for dance music of all shades.

underground comes **Victor Simonelli** remixes of Miss Joi's *Goodbye*. Dripping with bass, this track combines a cool piano, a touch of brass and soulful vocals. Rhythmic, melodic and ready for airplay. The vocal mix is the obvious choice for radio.

ISNADI

Alex Party - Underground Music Movement
PRODUCER: Visnadi
Italy continues to house up the airwaves and offer assorted parties for all seasons. The *June*

Party Mix is good for then, now or later. A carefree celebration, it promotes a light, dance-filled atmosphere. The *September Party Mix* strikes a deeper chord and has a more hypnotic effect.

STARWITNESS

Should've Known Better - Swingstreet Records
PRODUCER: Lil' John Coleman
The universally understood lyric "I should've known better" is dropped deep into this Chicago track by vocalist **Alva M.**. The song focuses on a warm bass and

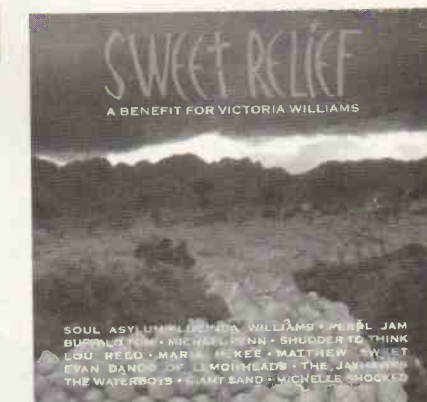

A Benefit For Victoria Williams - Columbia **R/A/ACE**

Peers from the American rock fraternity pay tribute to folk singer/songwriter Williams, who has been diagnosed as having multiple sclerosis and unfortunately has an insurance. All 14 acts provide comfort and excel in their own special way. The **George Drakoulis**/**Brendan O'Brien** productions have something undefinable extra though. From **Maria McKee** (*Opelousas: Sweet Relief*) to **Soul Asylum** (*Summer Of Drugs*), **Pearl Jam** (*Crazy Mary*) and the **Jayhawks** (*Lights*), these people sing intrinsically fragile Williams songs in the authentic campfire spirit, but amplified and more direct. They might inspire album rock programmers to look for the original versions.

OFF THE RECORD

THE SECRET EUROPLAY IS OUT

Spanish band **Los Secretos** has been selected as the new **Europlay** record for the month of August. Their single *Mi Amiga Mala Suerte* (WEA) will be played in heavy rotation on EHR stations such as **Cadena 100/Madrid**, **BRTN Radio Donna/Brussels**, **M40/Paris**, **Het Station/Hilversum**, **YLE 2/Radiomafia/Helsinki** and **SR1/Europawelle Saar**. The Europlay record of last month, **Dinky Toys' Out In The Streets** (Creastars/BMG) is currently climbing the **EHR Chartbound** section with 25 reporting EHR stations.

VIVA PRESENTATION SCHEDULED AT POPKOMM

Viva is to hold a special press conference at this year's **POPKOMM** on August 20. It will also be part of the official opening of **POPKOMM** and will present a new talent concert "Back To The Future" including bands **Terry Hoax**, **Poems For Leila** and **Throw That Beat In The Garbage Can**.

lion for **Motown**, the leading R&B record company in America.

The deal covers the entire recorded music business of Motown, including its current roster of 30 artists and back catalogue of 30,000 album recordings, as well as its TV, film and video production interests, its merchandising arm and the rights to the Motown trademark.

In addition to expanding the Motown's music sales worldwide, PolyGram also hopes to exploit opportunities in merchandising and possibly theme parks and restaurants. PolyGram valued the Motown trademark at US\$50 million.

Sales of Motown records, which last year reached US\$134 million, have proved difficult in Europe. For the first six months of 1993, the label earned both a European album and singles chart share of 0.5%, based on M&M's

chart survey. European sales have been at low levels because, according to insiders, the music has traditionally sounded "too American" for European tastes. (M&M, October 5, 1991).

To bolster its European presence, Motown recently opened an office in London headed by GM **Nicki Denaro**, who reports to LA-based senior VP International **Karen Sherlock**. The office is seen as an A&R source of British talent for the US.

PolyGram was appointed Motown's US distributor in 1991 and its licensee for the rest of the world in January 1992.

The deal values Motown, less the US\$50 million for the trademark, at around 1.9 times sales. In comparison, PolyGram paid an estimated 3.2 times turnover (US\$272 million) for **Island** in 1989 and 2.1 times sales (US\$460 million) for **A&M Records** one year later, while **Thorn EMI** purchased the **Virgin Music Group** for about 1.7 times turnover (£560 million) in 1992.

tions, such as **2 Unlimited**, **Dr. Alban**, **Leila K**, **Ace Of Base**, **Haddaway** and the **Captain Hollywood Project**. Likely to join the ranks soon is **Stakka Bo**, signed to **Stockholm Records** and attracting promising radio airplay. Although his debut single *Here We Go* needs a few more weeks to appear in M&M's formatted-airplay listings, first signs are very auspicious.

Backed by **MTV Europe** since this May, regional crossover airplay is starting to build in the German-speaking territories and the Benelux. And with the recent addition of dance-formatted **Kiss FM/London**, hopes are high the UK market will tune in as well. **M&M TrackFax** data shows the record playlisted on 24 European stations on varying formats.

Here We Go was featured on the eight-track **Stockholm** compilation *Gold* recently mailed to key European radio stations. **ORB/Fritz/Berlin** was the first non-Scandinavian radio station to pick the single up. After hearing the track, head of music **Bernd Albrecht** ordered five more

copies for his staff. "That is the fastest way to put it in high rotation right away," he says. "It's so good, I really couldn't wait a minute longer for an official German release."

What makes the single so special? According to **Kiss FM/London** record librarian **Alex Donally**—who reports to head of music **Lindsay Wesker** at the dance station—the record grows on repeated plays. "It's a very bright and different record. It has elements of **Stereo MCs** in it: a brash and funky sound with a rap on it that's not particularly clean. You wouldn't know they emanate from Sweden, it sounds very 'street' and very credible."

EHR pubcaster **YLE 2/Radiomafia/Helsinki** has been programming the song for six weeks. According to head of music **Jukka Haarma**, the song has that sort of "immediacy" that translates very well to Finnish audiences. "The record offers a sound that is missing from the local artist scene. Finland is not at all dance-oriented. But we are playing a lot of the Swedish dance stuff; they make records that are very suitable for airplay."

six-month period. Overall commercial listening (national and ILR stations) increased 1.1% in share to 38.9%, according to the **RAJAR** results.

Separate figures were compiled for **Richard Branson's Virgin 1215 AM**, the AOR national service which launched April 30, half way through the survey. Based on the results of the station's first full seven weeks of operation (May 3-June 20) Virgin garnered a 2.2% share within its total survey area, which is 93% of the UK population. The **RAJAR** results also show Virgin with a weekly reach of about 3.3 million adults. Sixty-four percent of those listeners represent the station's demographic target of 25-44 year-olds.

Virgin's CEO **David Campbell** says he is encouraged by the results because they are in-line with the station's predictions made six months before its launch when it promised advertisers a weekly audience of about 3.3 million listeners.

"The **RAJAR** figures put us almost precisely where we want to be. They prove that we were right in identifying a huge audience who felt disenfranchised by

what was on offer elsewhere. We are getting right to the heart of the core audience we wanted," **Campbell** claims.

In the UK's largest market, **EHR Capital Radio FM/London** maintains its position as market leader although its share dipped slightly, as did its weekly reach. **Capital Gold** remains ranked fifth in London.

MOR BBC Radio 2 overtook its sister network **N/T BBC Radio 4** for the number two spot in the London market.

Also in London, dance format radio is alive and well as **Kiss FM** reversed its downward trend in audience share for the past two **RAJAR** surveys. The latest sweep shows the **EMAP**-owned station with 3.5% share compared to 2.3% last survey and 2.8% for the last quarter of 1992.

Radio industry analyst and researcher **Jonathan Arendt** of London-based **Hallett and Arendt** says that although the increase in the number of commercial radio services licensed by the **Radio Authority** over the past two years is bound to pull listeners away from the BBC. "There is a sense of inevitability—as far as increased choice and taking listeners from the **BBC**—because the services the **Radio Authority** are licensing have special interests which will

appeal generally more to **BBC** listeners than to **ILR** listeners," he says. "However, I think a lot of stations sound better and tighter. I don't think we have had better commercial radio stations. Musically they are easier to listen to. They present you with a diet of good stuff."

Arendt also points out that the lack of music on **BBC Regional/Local** services in the morning could be a contributing factor to the increase in commercial listening.

several from Norwegian radio stations and one from a New York-based company, **RTT Media Incorporated**. Auctions will be held sometime during **September**, according to **Peter Schierbeck**, a spokesman at **SLR**, the regulatory agency in charge of allocating licences.

The heaviest concentration of

applicants is in the **Stockholm** area, followed by **Uppsala**, **Norrköping** and **Liköping**. Among the parties competing for the 10 spots in **Stockholm** are **Radio City Stockholm**, **Kinnevik-backed Radio Z** and **Bonnier-backed Radio Megapol**.

Once the franchises go on the auction block, the party with the highest bid is obliged to pay that amount immediately, the minimum fee being **Skr20,000** (app. US\$2,800). Once a licence is

obtained, the owner has then to apply to national telecommunications company **Telestyrelsen** for a permit to use a transmitter. Winners have six months from the date of the licence to start broadcasting, with the risk of being drawn in by the **SLR**. The same applies if the licence holder does not broadcast, or broadcasts too little during a period of at least four weeks.

Dutch EHR pubcaster **Het Station/Hilversum** was the first to play the song in Holland. According to PD **Jan Steeman**, there are no deep philosophical thoughts involved in the selection of the track for the playlist. "It's just a very radio-friendly record," he says. "Well-thought out, useful and clearly manufactured." Steeman notices an increasing number of Swedish product landing on his desk, probably fuelled by the recent activities of the **Export Music Sweden** organisation (M&M June 26).

MTV Europe manager of music programming **Jan-Pierre Millet** was ready to pull the track off its "Breakout Rotation" after three months, but, in the light of its recent radio developments, he's ready to reconsider. "We probably started too early," he says. "But it would be stupid not to start playing it again. People do not always realise to what extent we're actually supporting continental European music, but we really try to stick our neck out." Millet mentions German

artists **Terry Hoax** and **Sven Våth** as other recent examples of this policy.

Stockholm Records—a joint-venture with **PolyGram**—was launched last year by **Ola Hakansson**, a musician and veteran producer of the Swedish music scene (**Lili & Susie**, **Army Of Lovers**, **Jerry Williams**). **Hakansson** places great value on the art of engineering and producing, always attracting young and up-and-coming specialists in the field and training them in-house.

The label excels in producing catchy dance music that is vibrant and infectious. "The dance scene

here in Sweden is very vital," comments **Hakansson**, "not in the least due to the great number of immigrants. Just like **Stakka Bo**, we will be producing more of that urban kind of hip hop."

Apart from **Army Of Lovers**—the ruling kings and queens of camp disco—**Stockholm** productions currently attracting radio airplay include **Cool James & Black Teacher** (*Thank You Thank You*) and **Chilly White & Kenny Peach's** cover of Jamaican singer **Errol Dunkley's** '79 UK hit single *OK Fred*, the label's best bet for a future crossover.

not been named as an investor in Viva, though he is reported to be "still interested" in the project.

Insiders say the financial plans were signed at the end of July, just before a meeting with the North Rhine-Westphalia media authority **Lfk**. As Viva has put

forward concrete investment plans, the way is now clear for the channel to be granted a national broadcasting licence when it meets with the **DLM** (directors of all media authorities in Germany) at the end of August/beginning of September. It is now expected that the channel will go on air on November 1 this year.



How Long?

The distance between UB40 and their competitors is becoming shorter and shorter during their sixth consecutive week of chart reign. 4 Non Blondes come closest with *What's Up*; they managed to collect 18 first-time reports during their sixth charting week, producing a 19% spreading angle—very good for a record already in the top 3. Especially in Denmark and Germany, the 4 Non Blondes have continued to expand their support base this week.

Madonna and Billy Joel stay neck on neck but have moved up their battleground to the top 10. Their distance in terms of chart points remains slight and both artists collect a great number of additions (27 and 24 respectively) but Madonna's roster ends up measuring nine more stations as she benefits from a slightly faster moving pace. She thus qualifies as fastest mover of the week and enters the top 5 with a 15-position slipstream, leaving Joel "stuck" at number 6. Take That join the queue of new top 10 entries at number 7.

Kim Wilde's and Janet Jackson's new singles are also making good progress, both climbing the top 20 with favourable figures. Wilde's current gain is notably yielded in the Scandinavian territories, while her penetration level is best in Austria, the UK and Switzerland (100%, 90% and 80% respectively) with most other countries varying between 30% and 70% rotation acceptance. Janet Jackson has 100% of M&M's EHR reporters in Holland, Luxembourg and the Czech Republic to her disposal and 75% in the UK.

Highest new entry (at 28) is a subtly reggae-fied version of Ace's 1974 hit *How Long* by Yazz & Aswad. EHR has not been very quick in picking up on this single; remarkably enough it was already released about half a year ago. The song was also revived on Undercover's 1992 debut album *Check Out The Groove*. The Yazz & Aswad version is notably doing well in the UK, the Czech Republic, Sweden, Switzerland and Austria (50-80% penetration).

Yazz & Aswad are closely followed (at 29) by *Living On My Own*, posthumously credited to and centered around a vocal track recorded by Freddie Mercury for what first became a minor hit in the UK in 1985. Now the recording has been re-worked into a state-of-the-art dance version. Holland, the Czech Republic, the UK and Belgium are the best supporters of this production.

It is interesting to see Ace Of Base's *All That She Wants* chart for the 23rd consecutive week, as yet the third longest ever (Shanice's *I Love Your Smile* stayed on the chart for 26 and Bryan Adams's *Everything I Do I Do It For You* for 25 weeks). Right at the top of the **Chartbound** section and armed with a 46-station roster, Ace Of Base's follow-up single *Wheel Of Fortune* is still waiting for its entrance in the **EHR Top 40**.

Most Added leader of the week (32 adds) as well as "A" Rotation Performance leader (91% heavy rotation) is Mariah Carey, whose *Dream Lover* is definitely set to enter the Top 40 next week. She enjoyed five EHR hits before, of which 1991's *Emotions* went highest, peaking at 2. Her last hit *I'll Be There* (1992) made it to number 3. *Pieter Kops*
